The ornamental design for a vial container, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the back, side and top of a vial container, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side elevational view being identical thereto;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof, the front elevational view being identical thereto;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of a third embodiment of FIG. 1.

FIG. 8 is a perspective view showing the back, side, and top of the second embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of the second embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view of the second embodiment of FIG. 1, the front elevational view being identical thereto;


FIG. 11 is a side elevational view of the second embodiment of FIG. 1, the opposite side elevational view being identical thereto;

FIG. 12 is a perspective view showing the back, side, and top of the third embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 15 is a side elevational view of the third embodiment of FIG. 1, the opposite side elevational view being identical thereto.






































