The ornamental design for a infant seat for use on a pew, as shown and described.

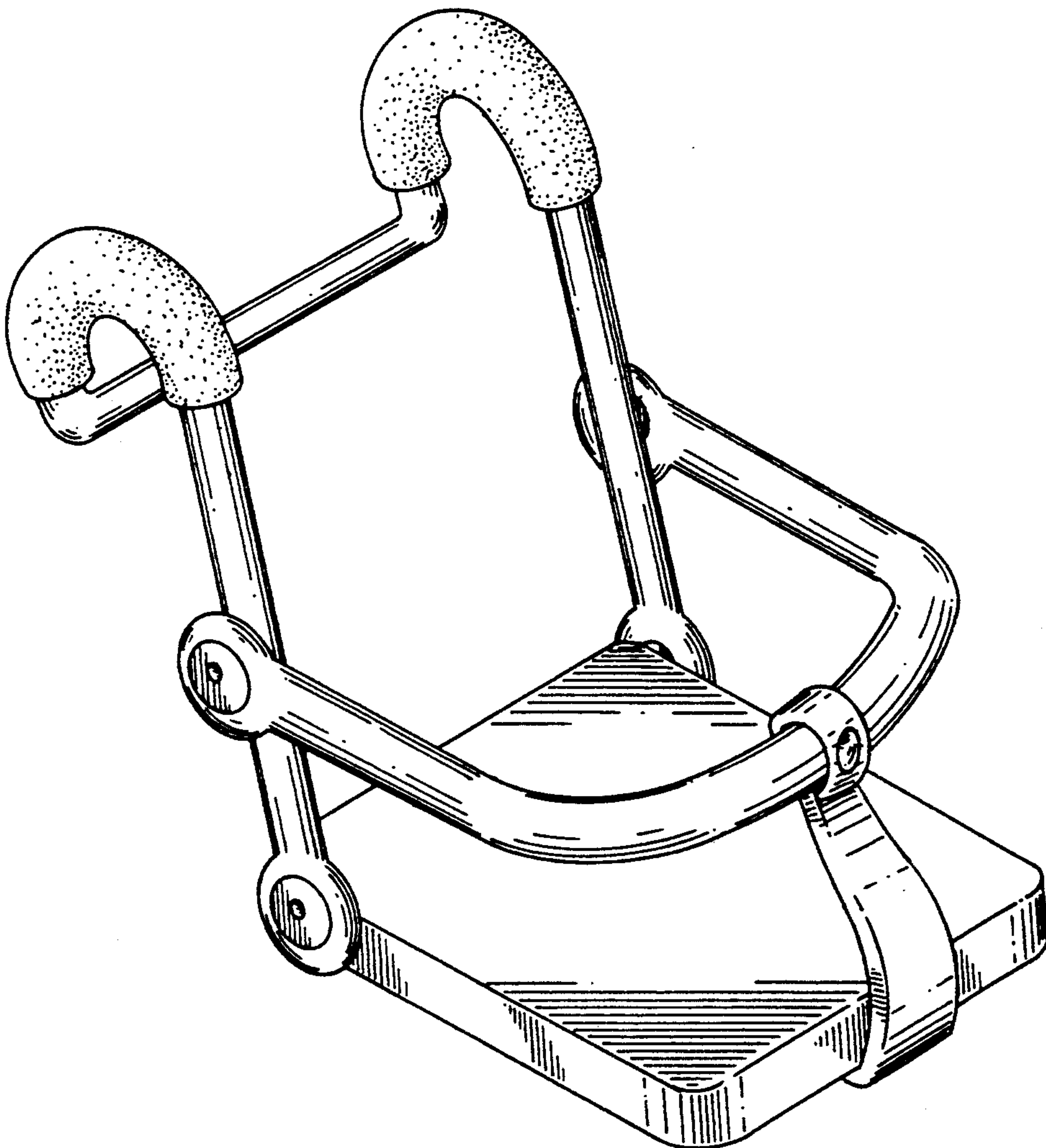
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DESCRIPTION

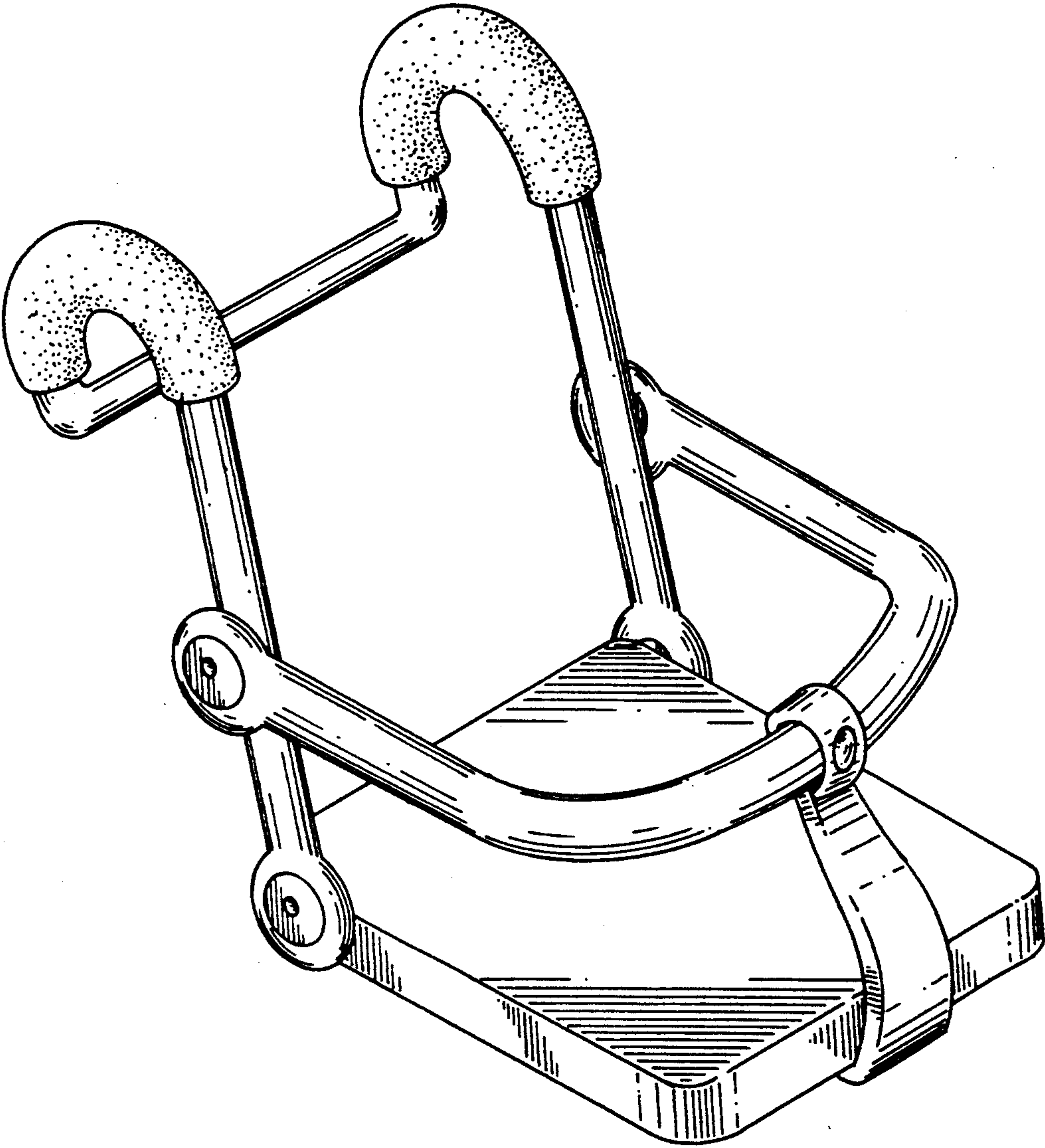

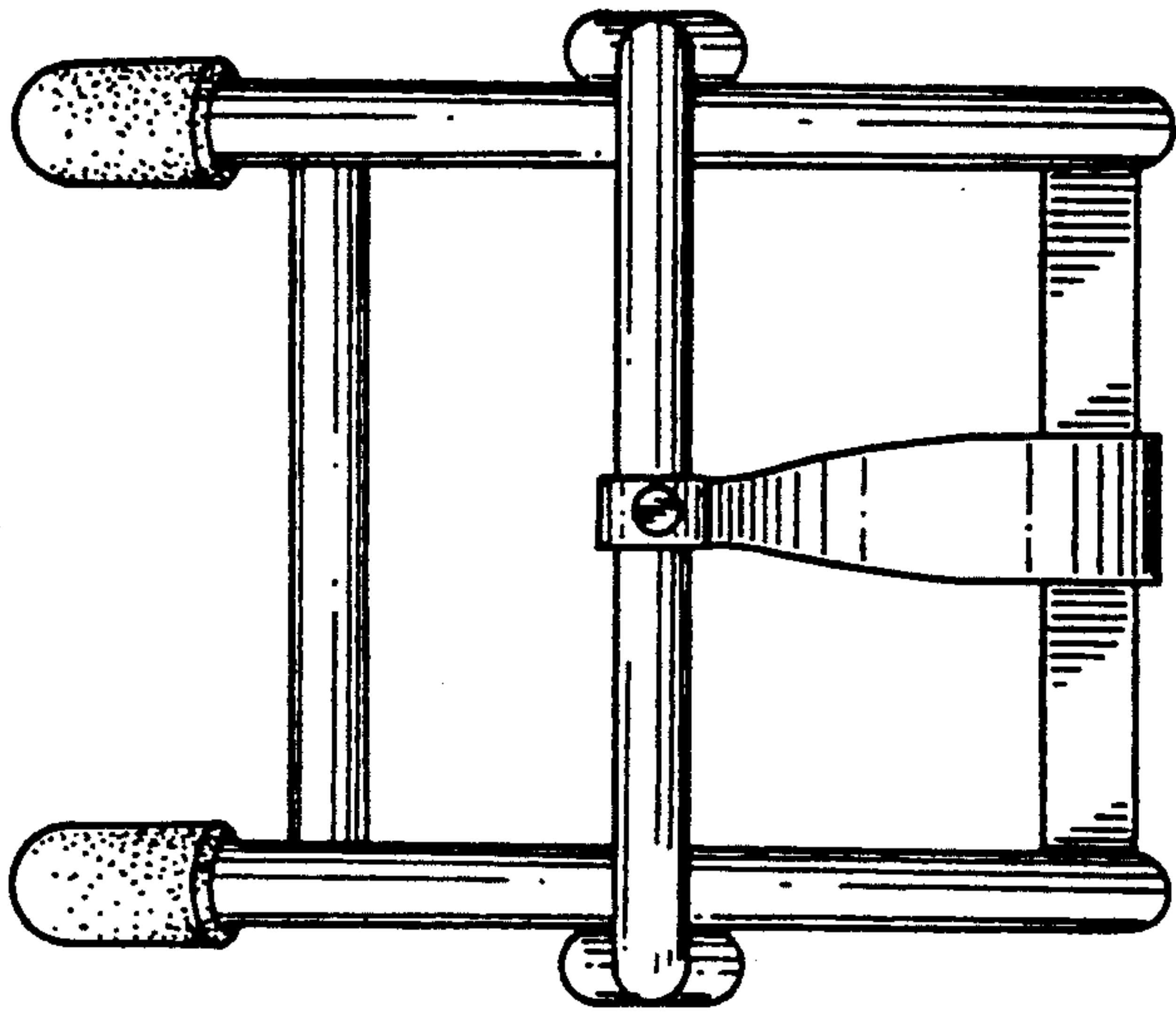

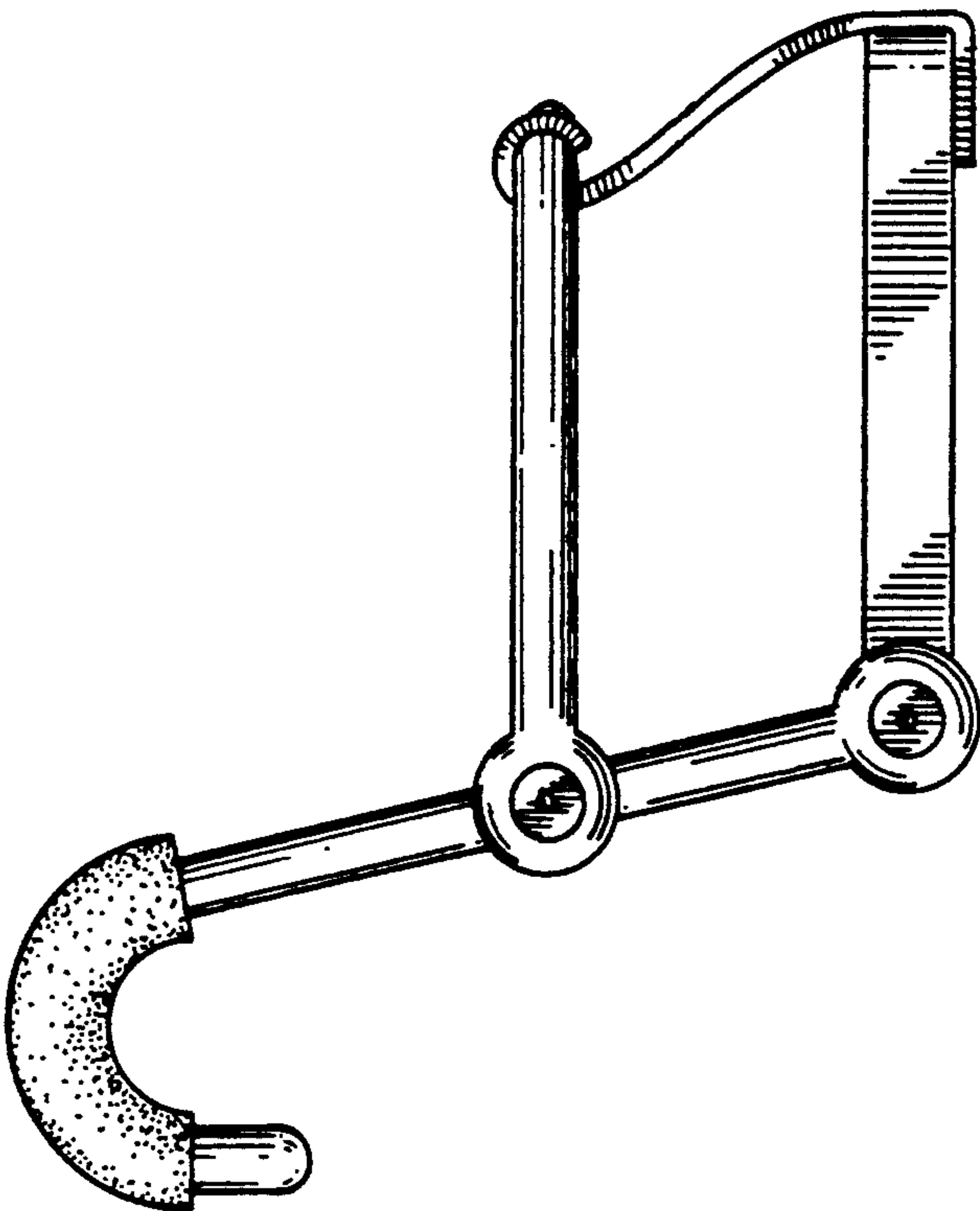

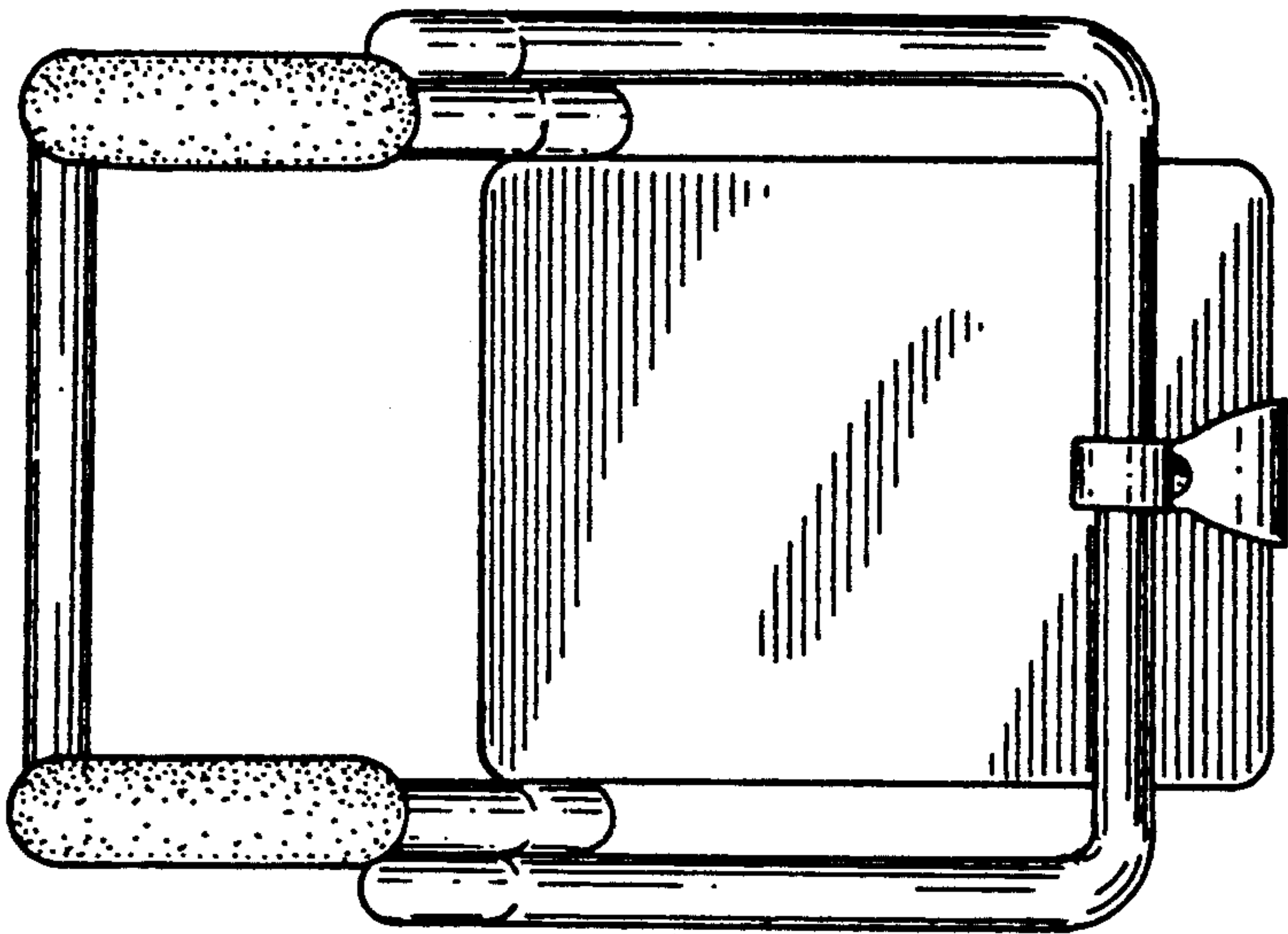

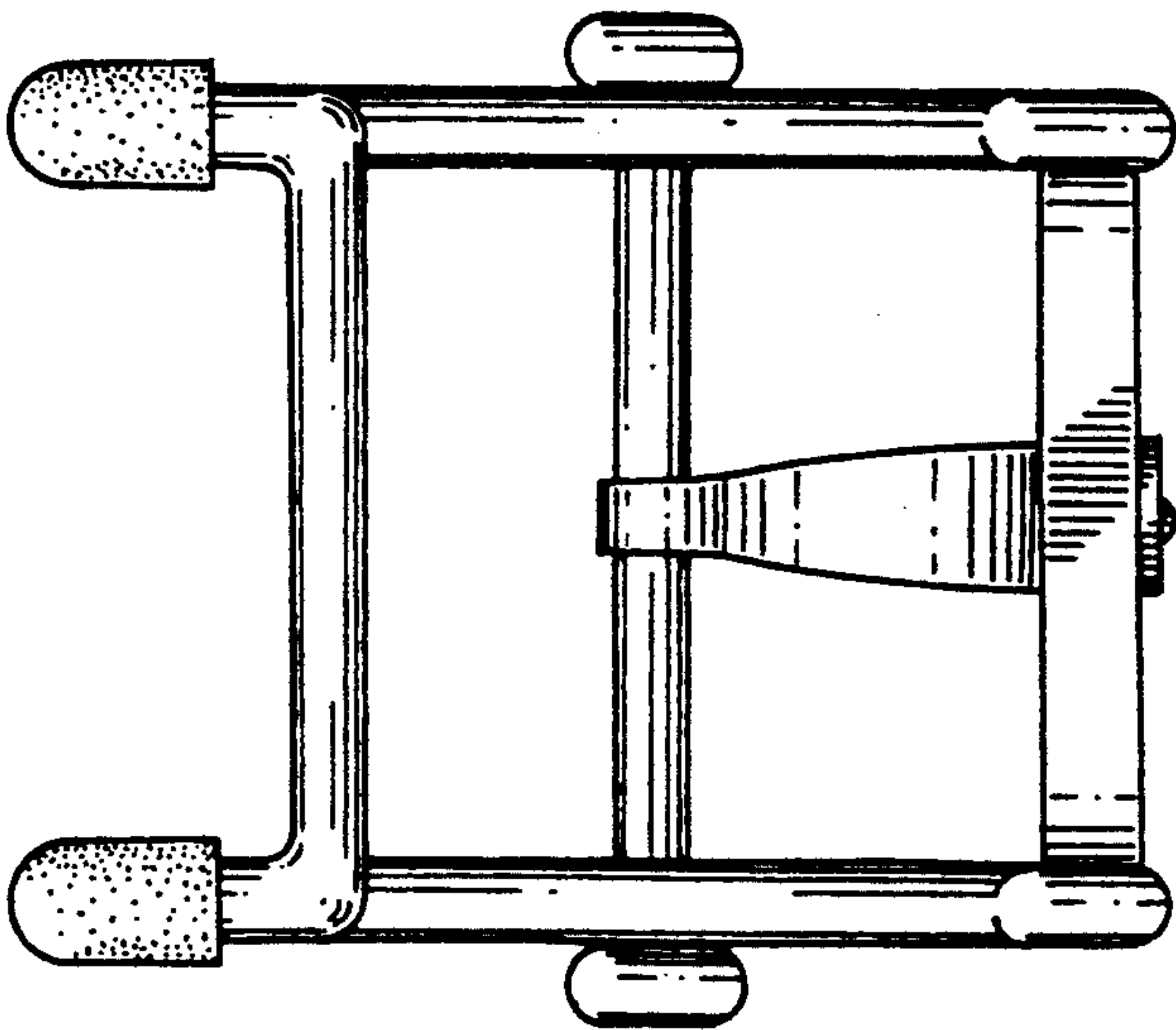
