**DESCRIPTION**

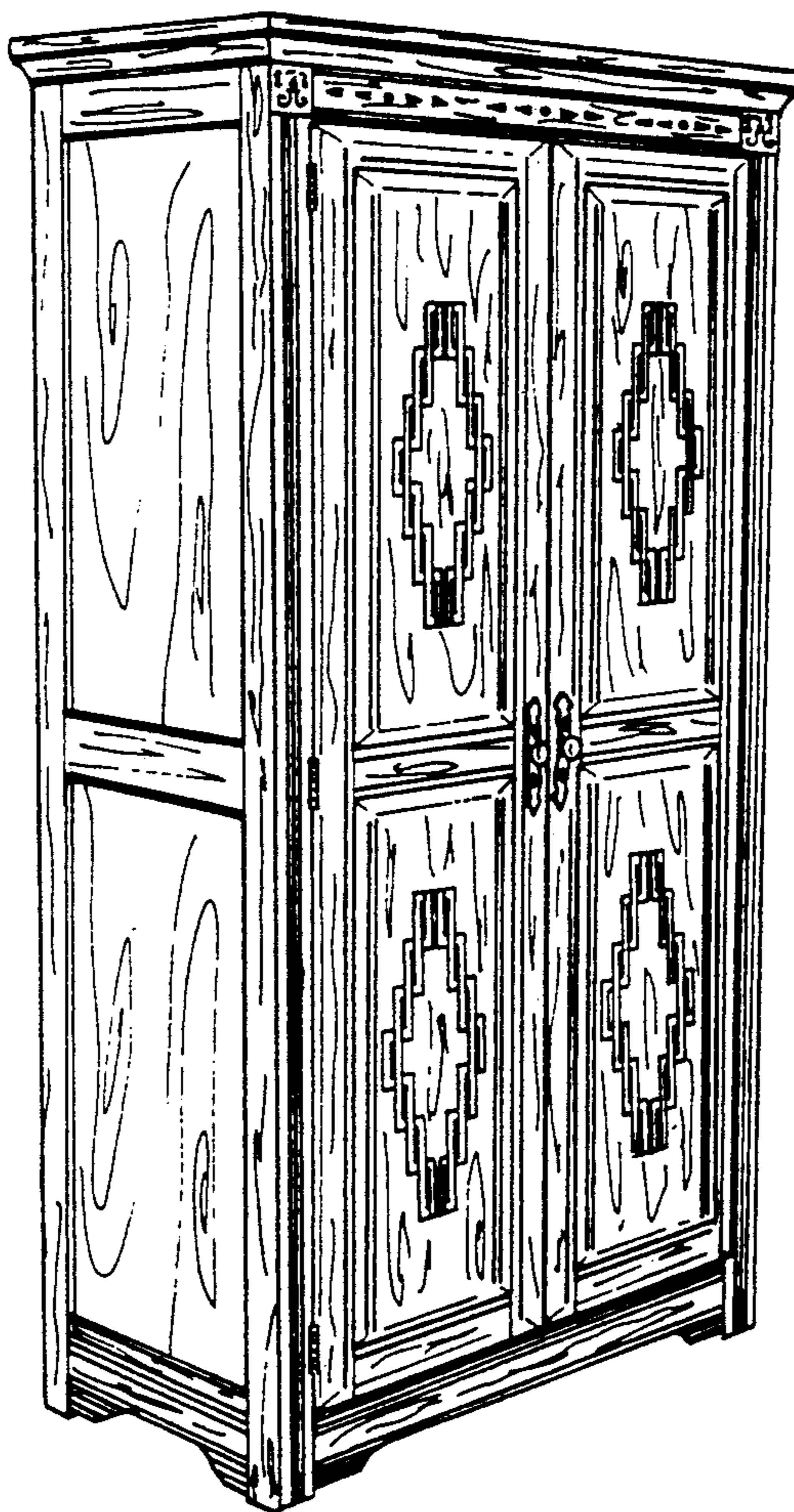
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an entertainment center showing my new design;

The rear view being flat and unornamented.



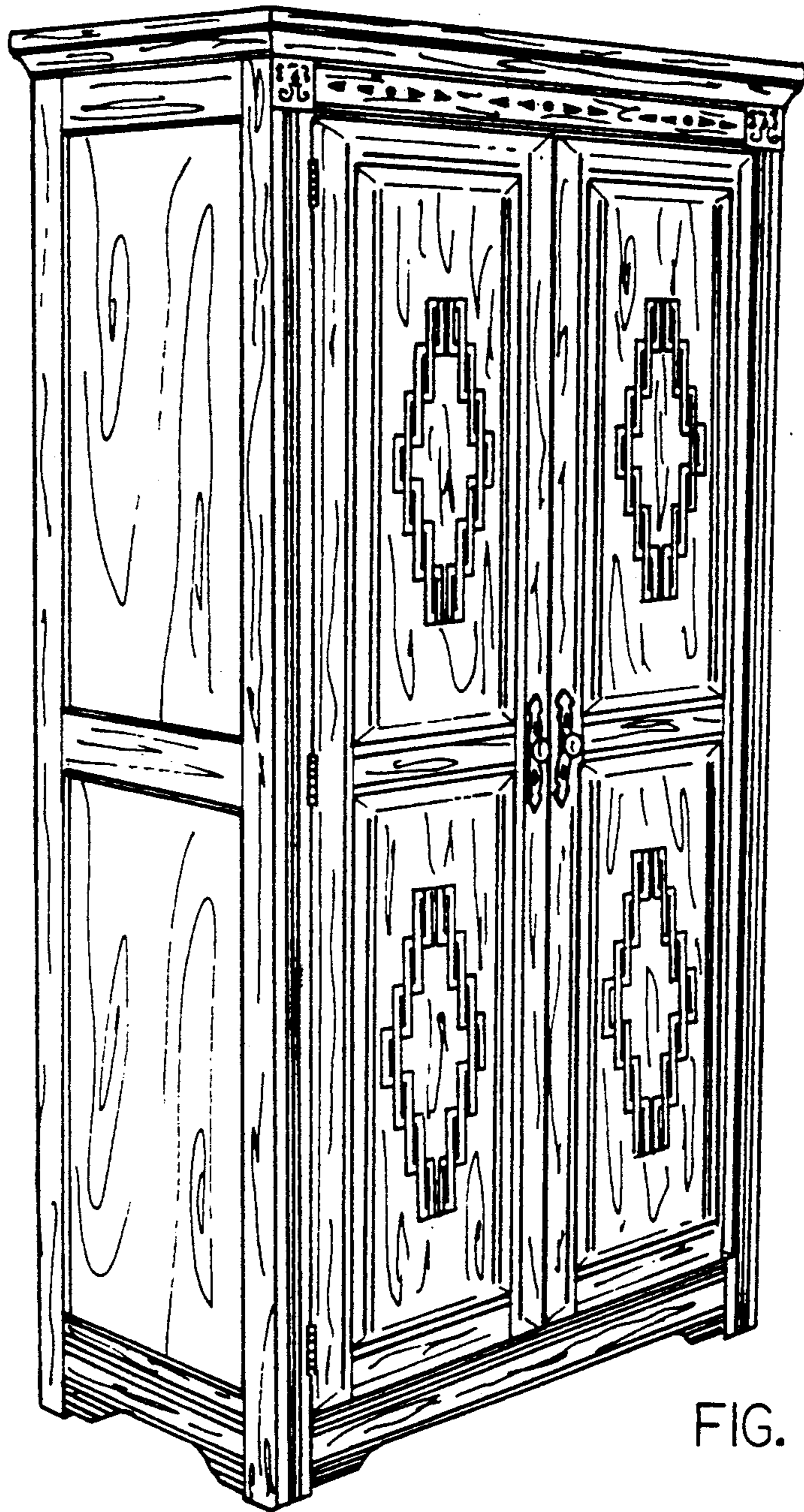
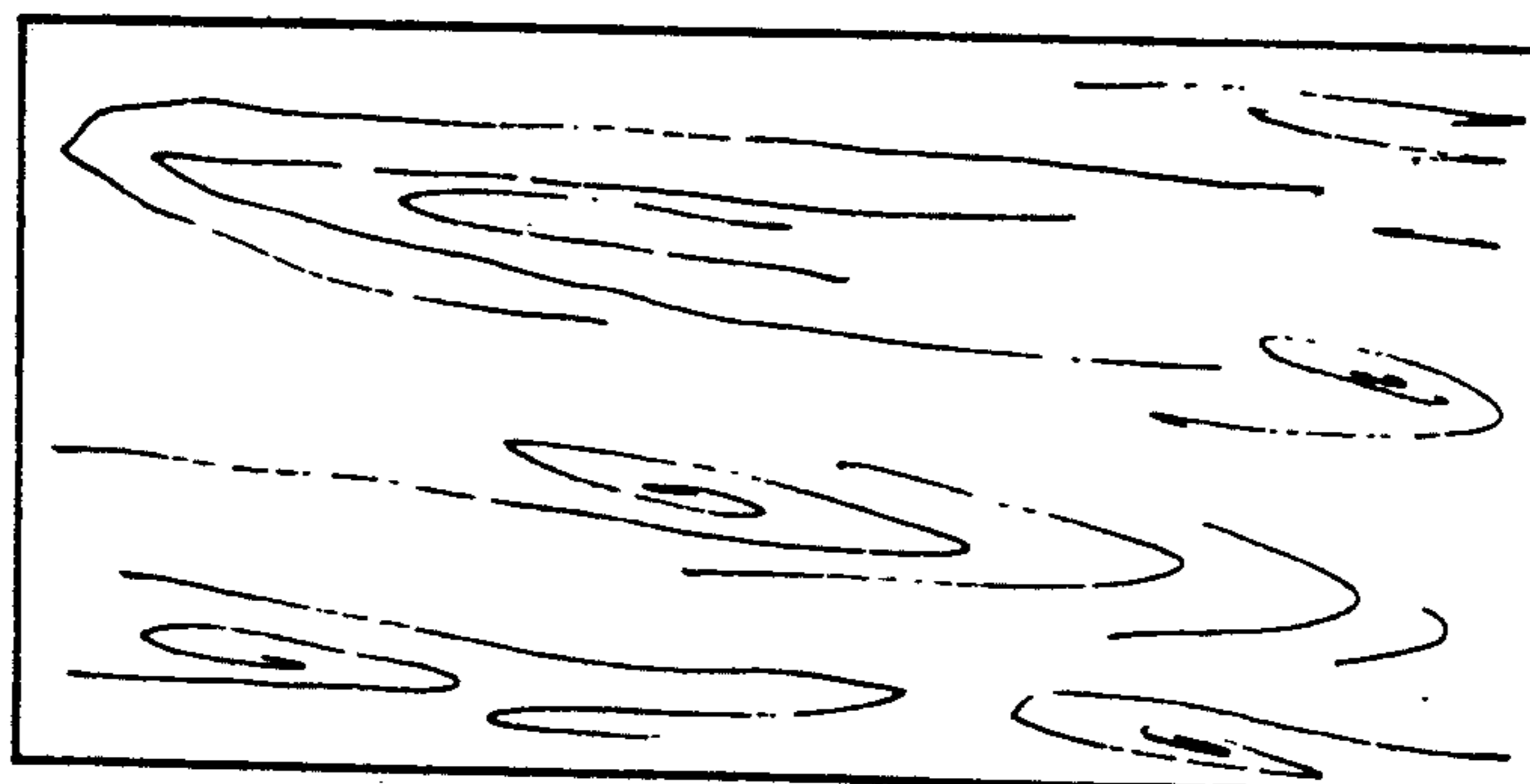

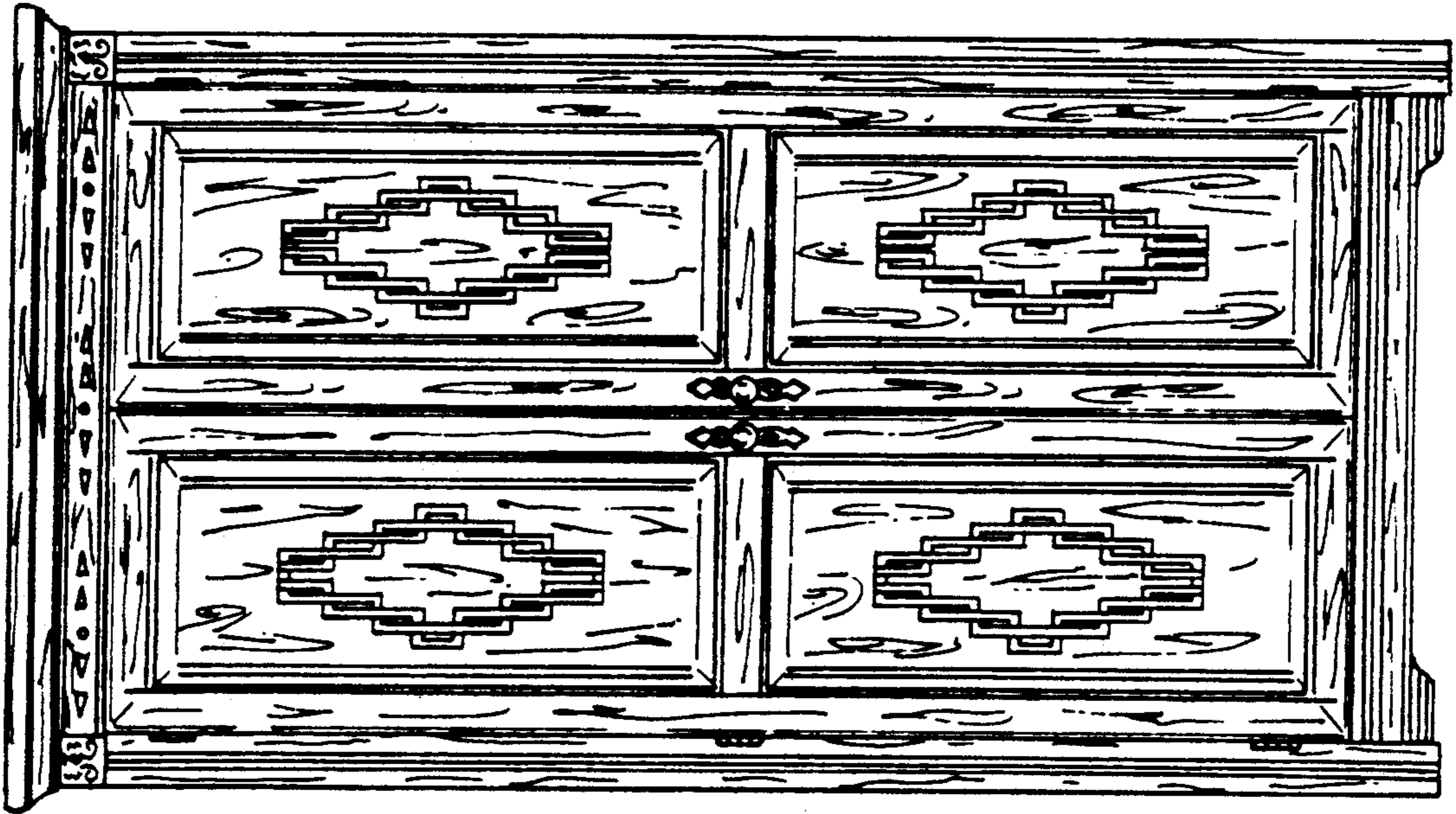

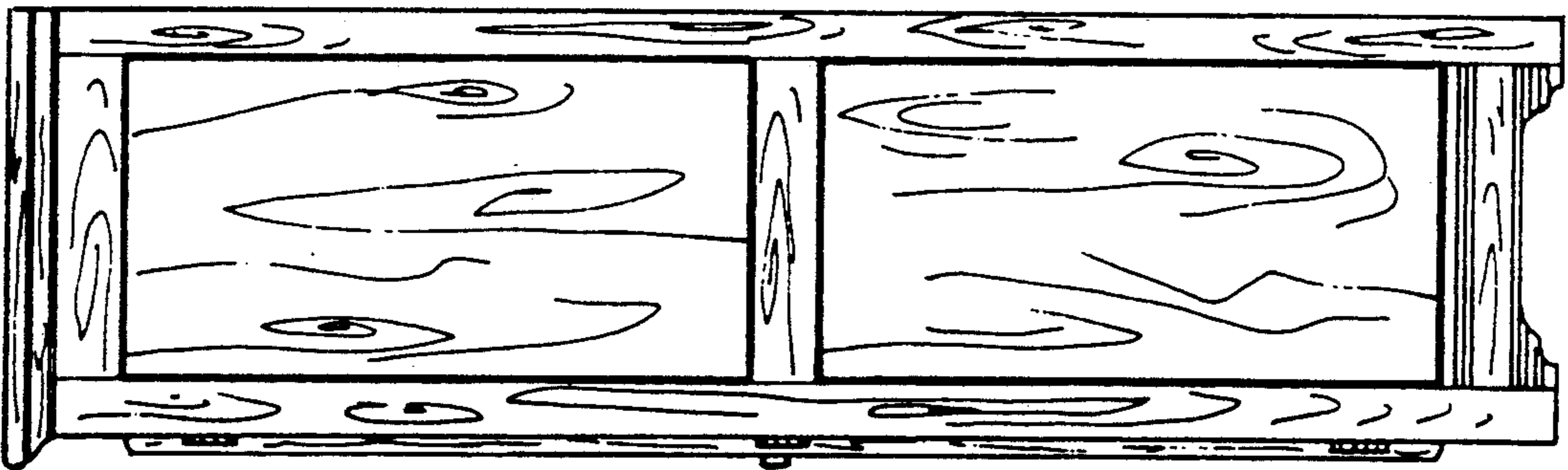
