FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; and,

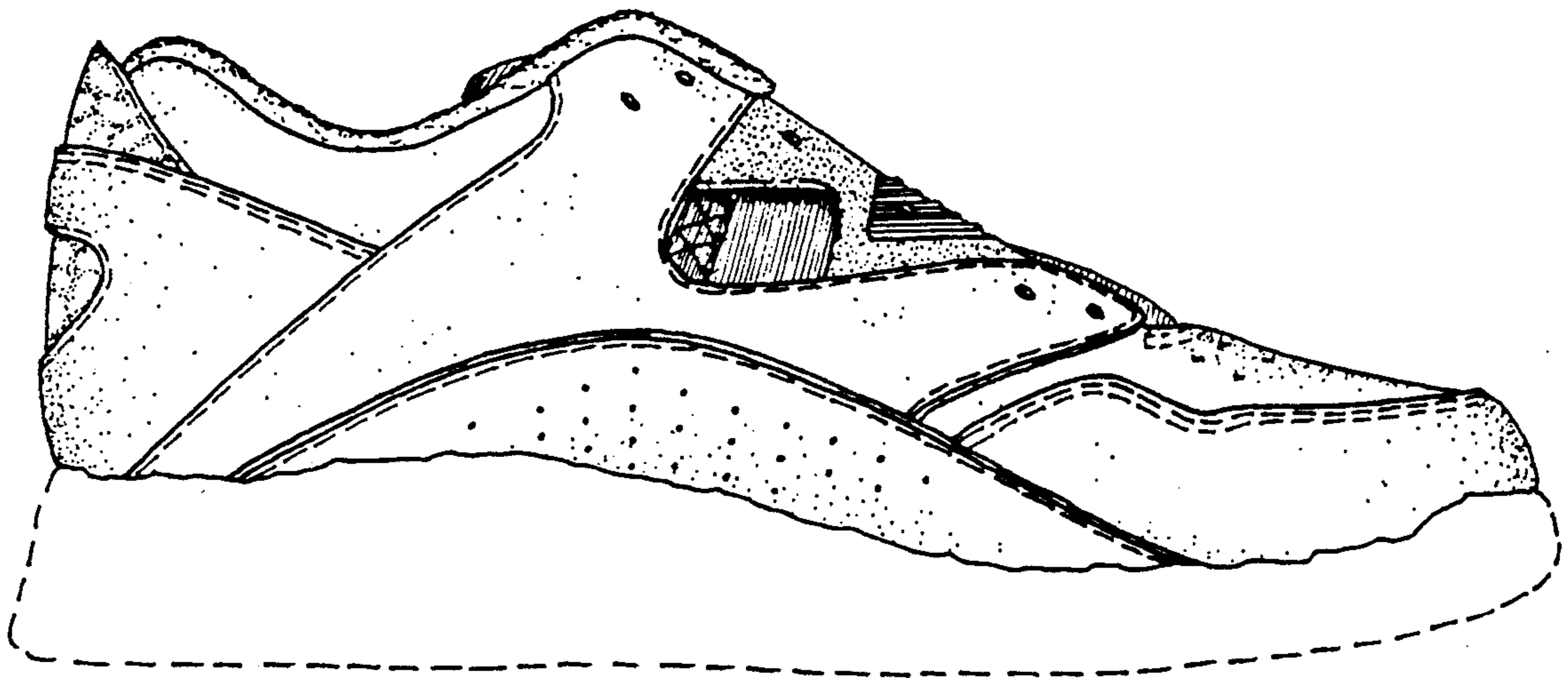

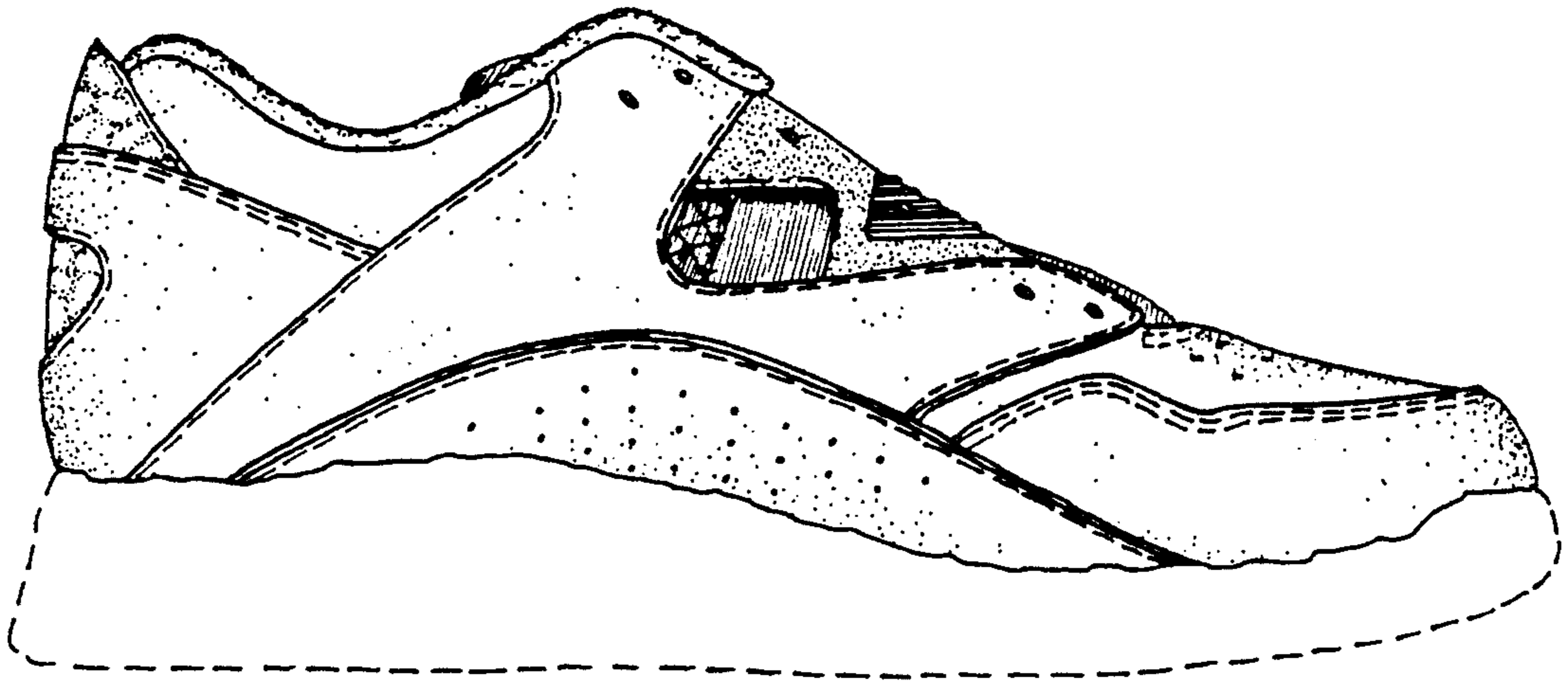

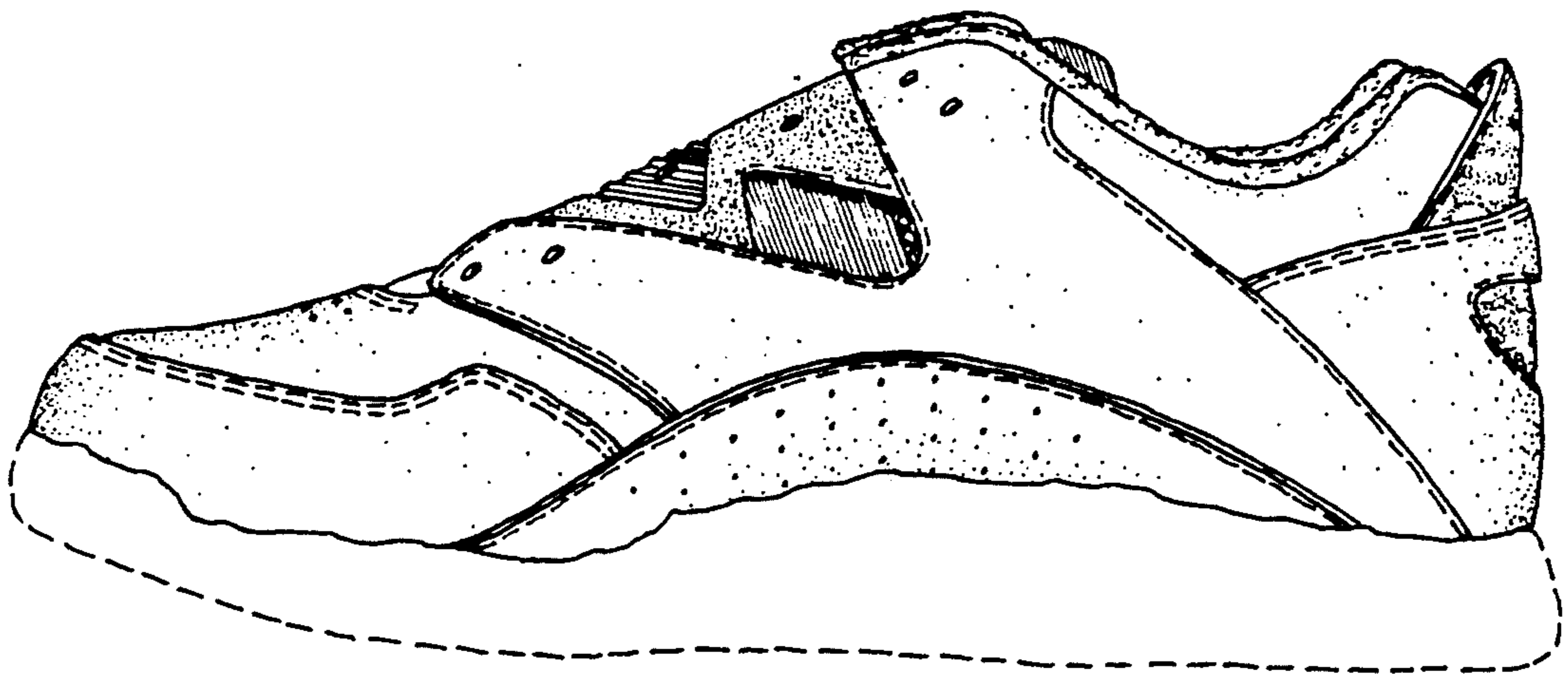

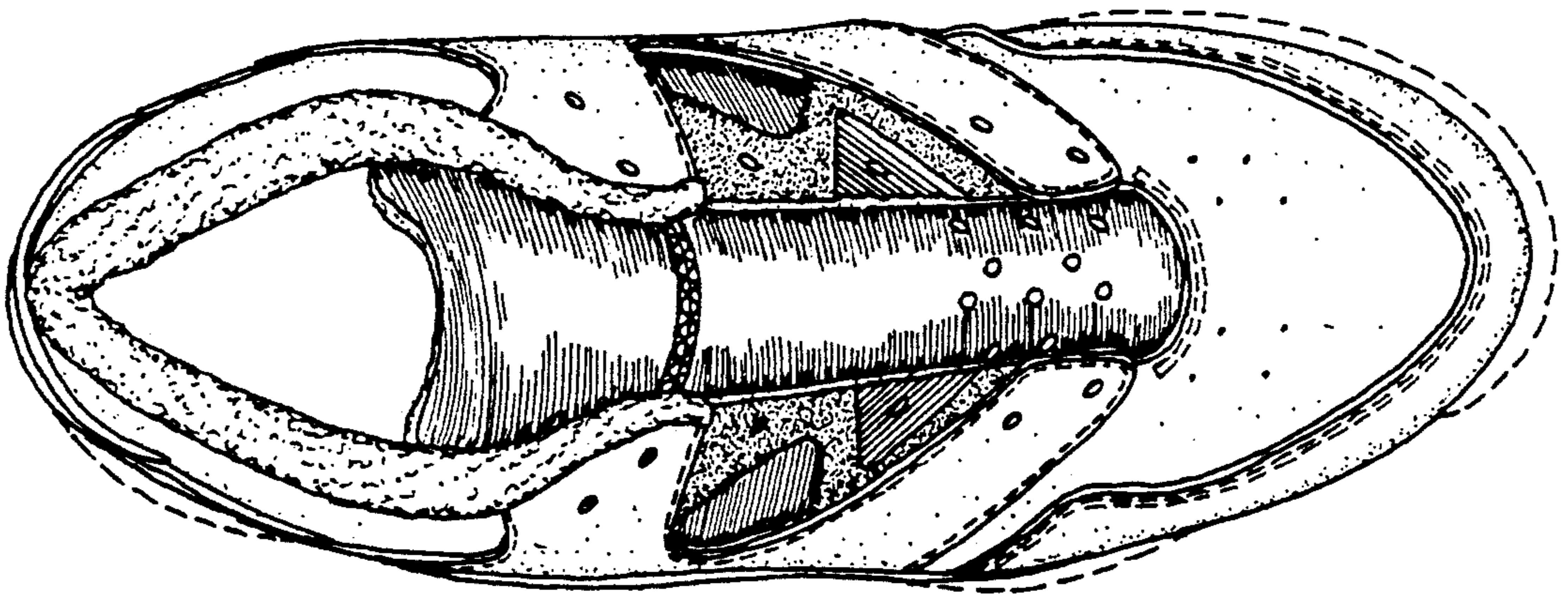

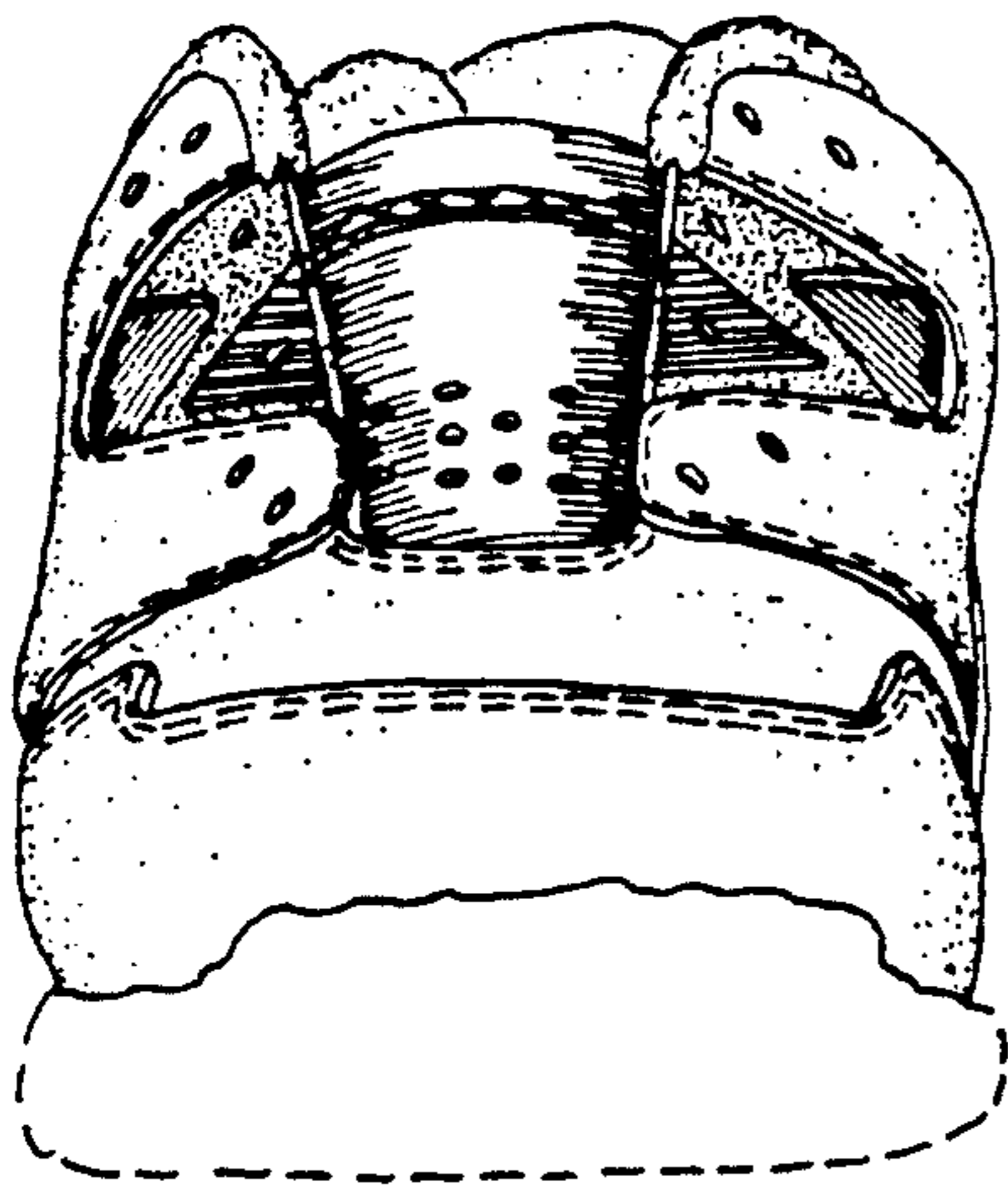

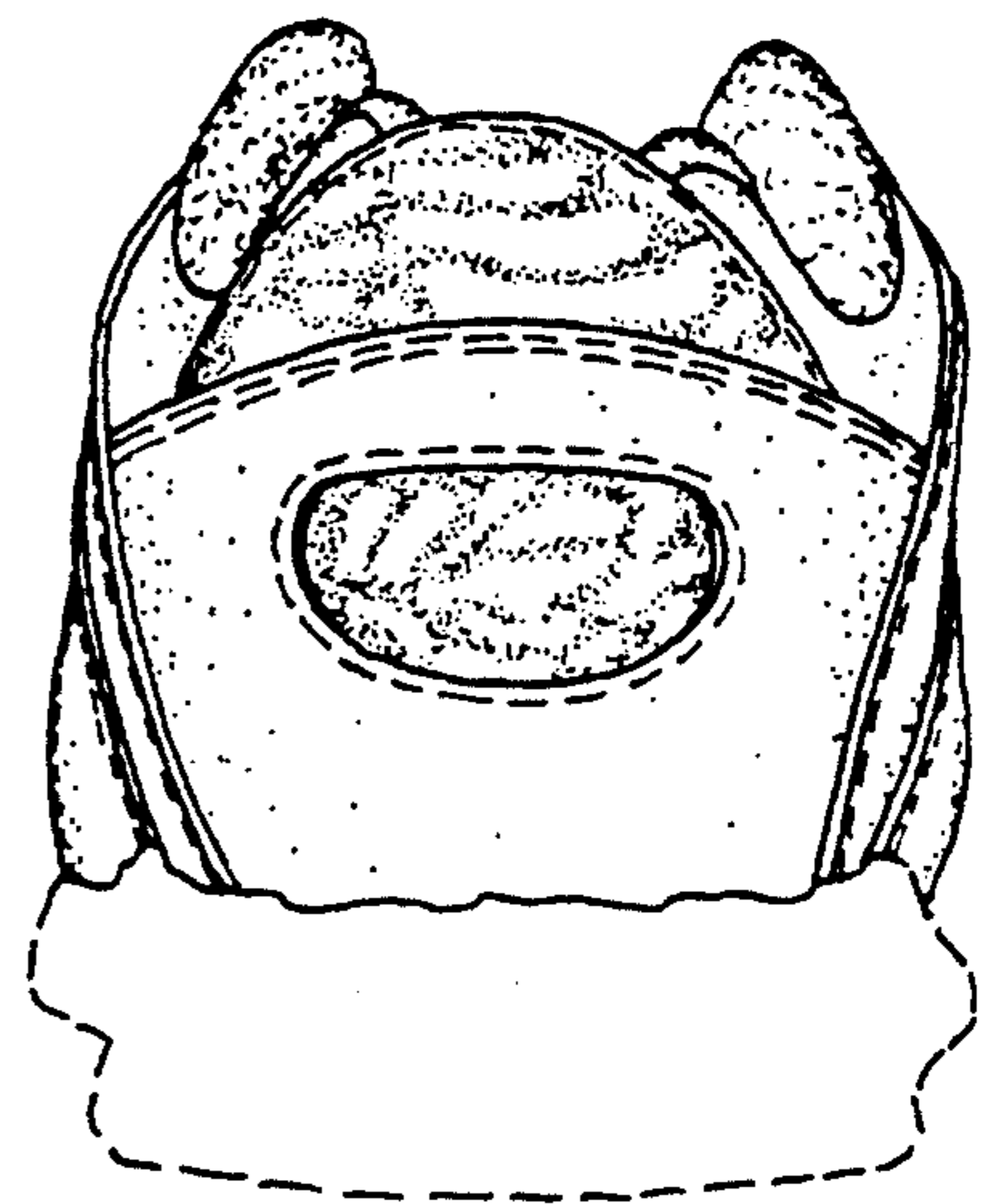
