[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a motorcycle tire, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a motorcycle tire showing my new design, it being understood that the tread pattern is repeated uniformly throughout the circumference of the tire;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being identical thereto;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged fragmentary front elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 5—5 in FIG. 4.

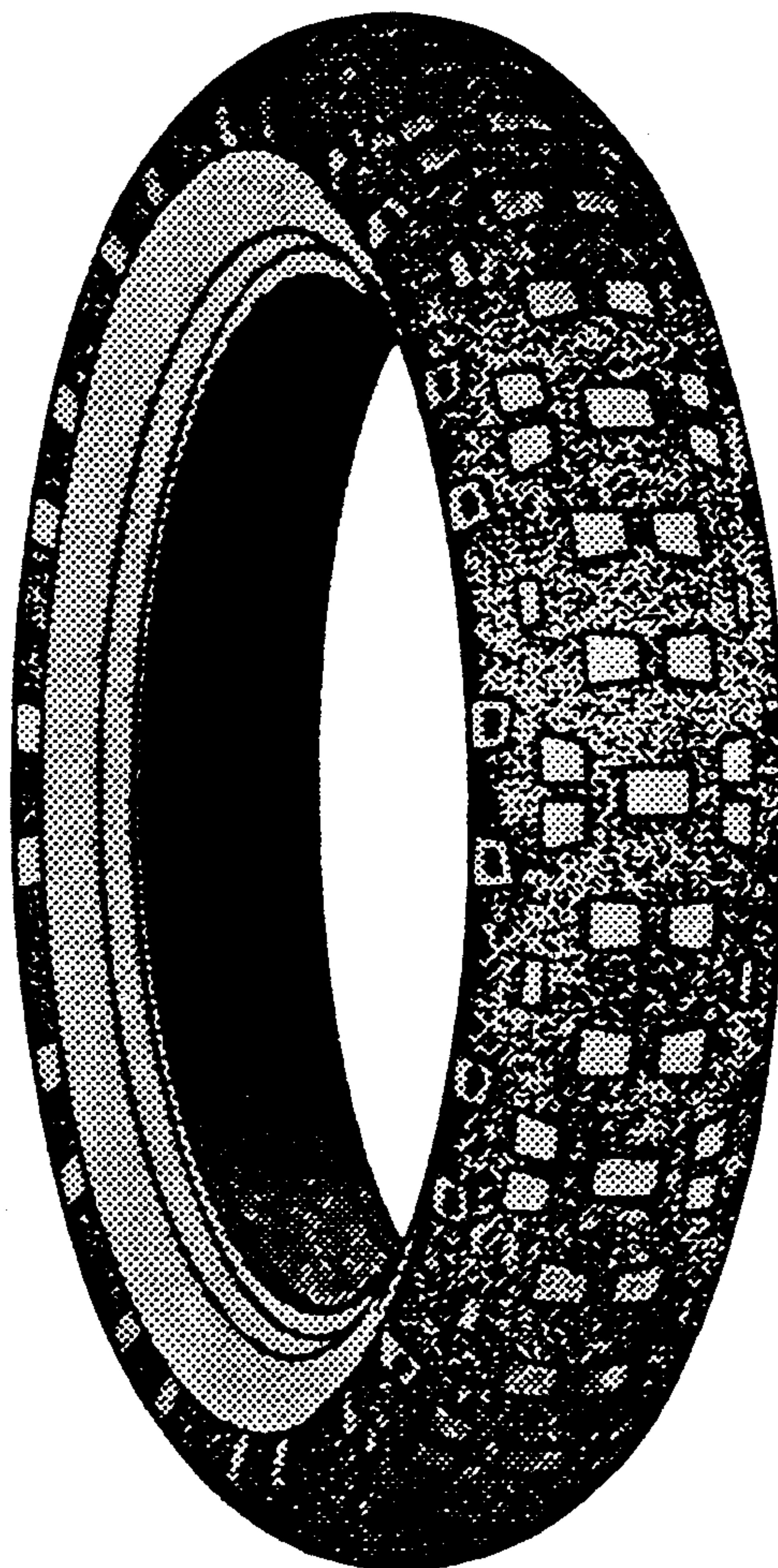

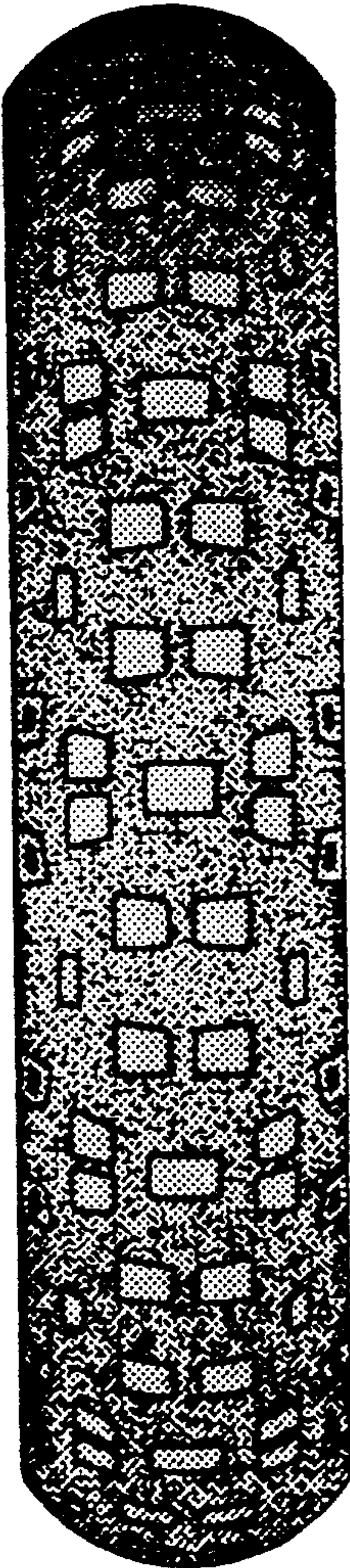

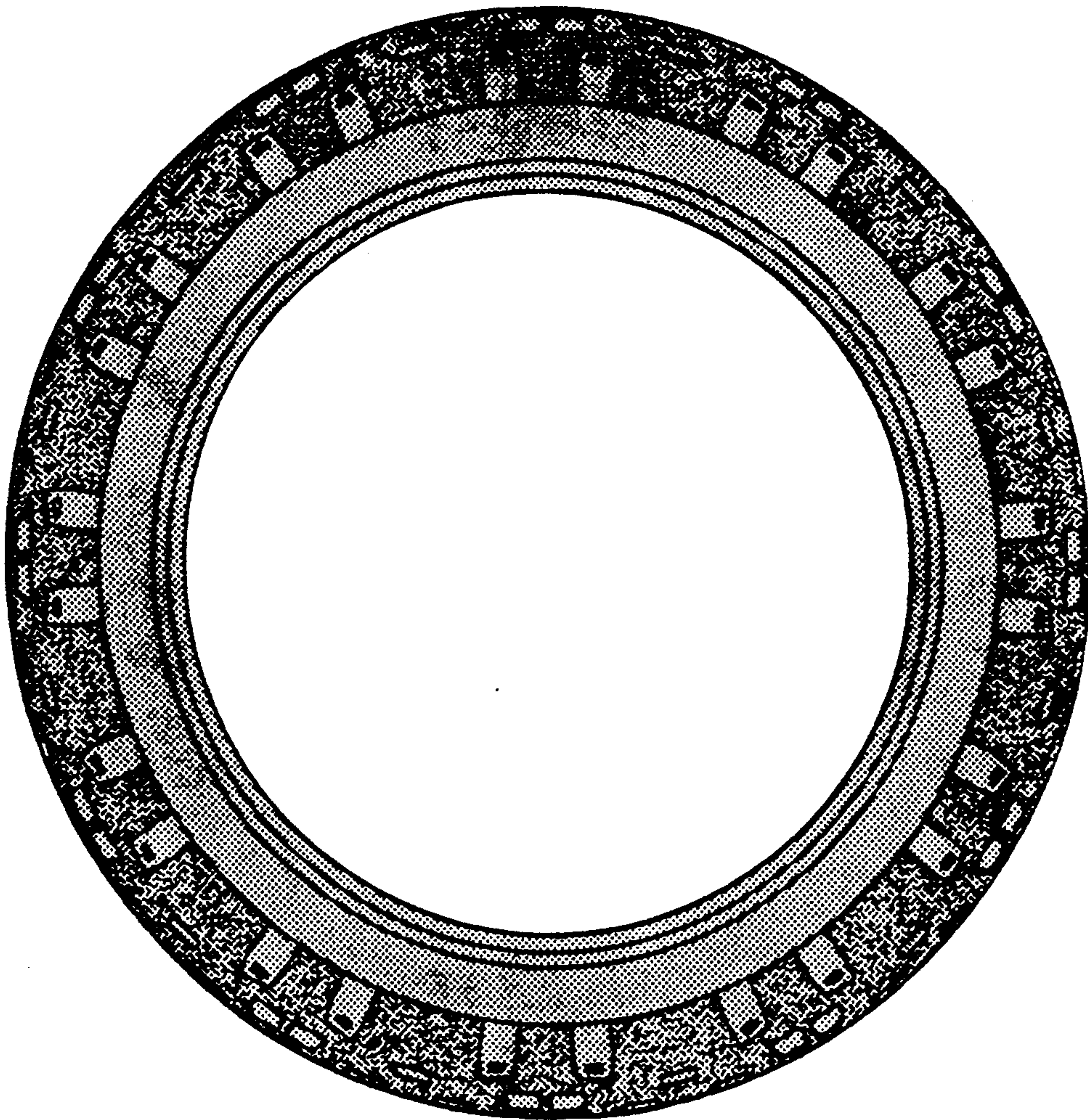

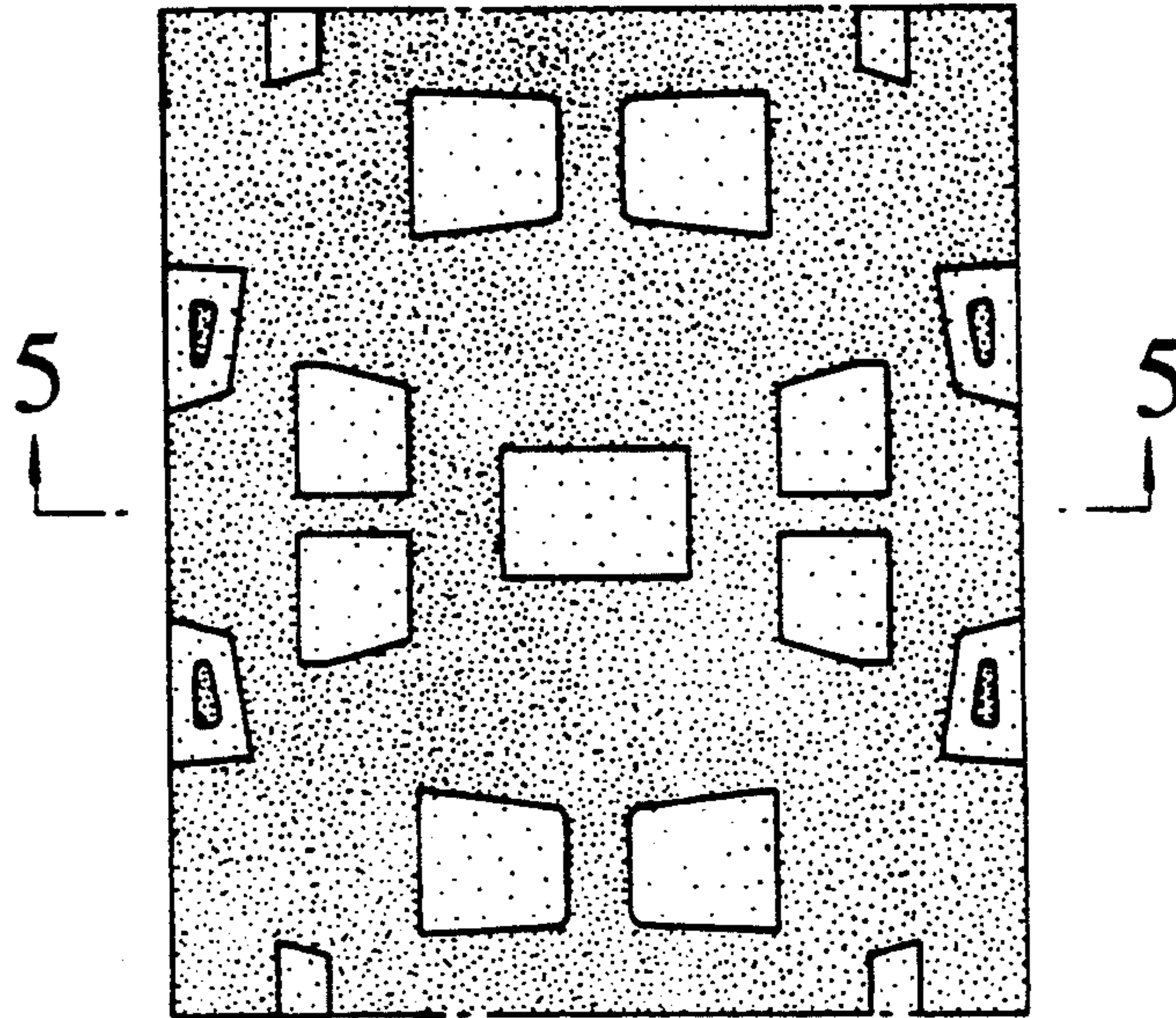
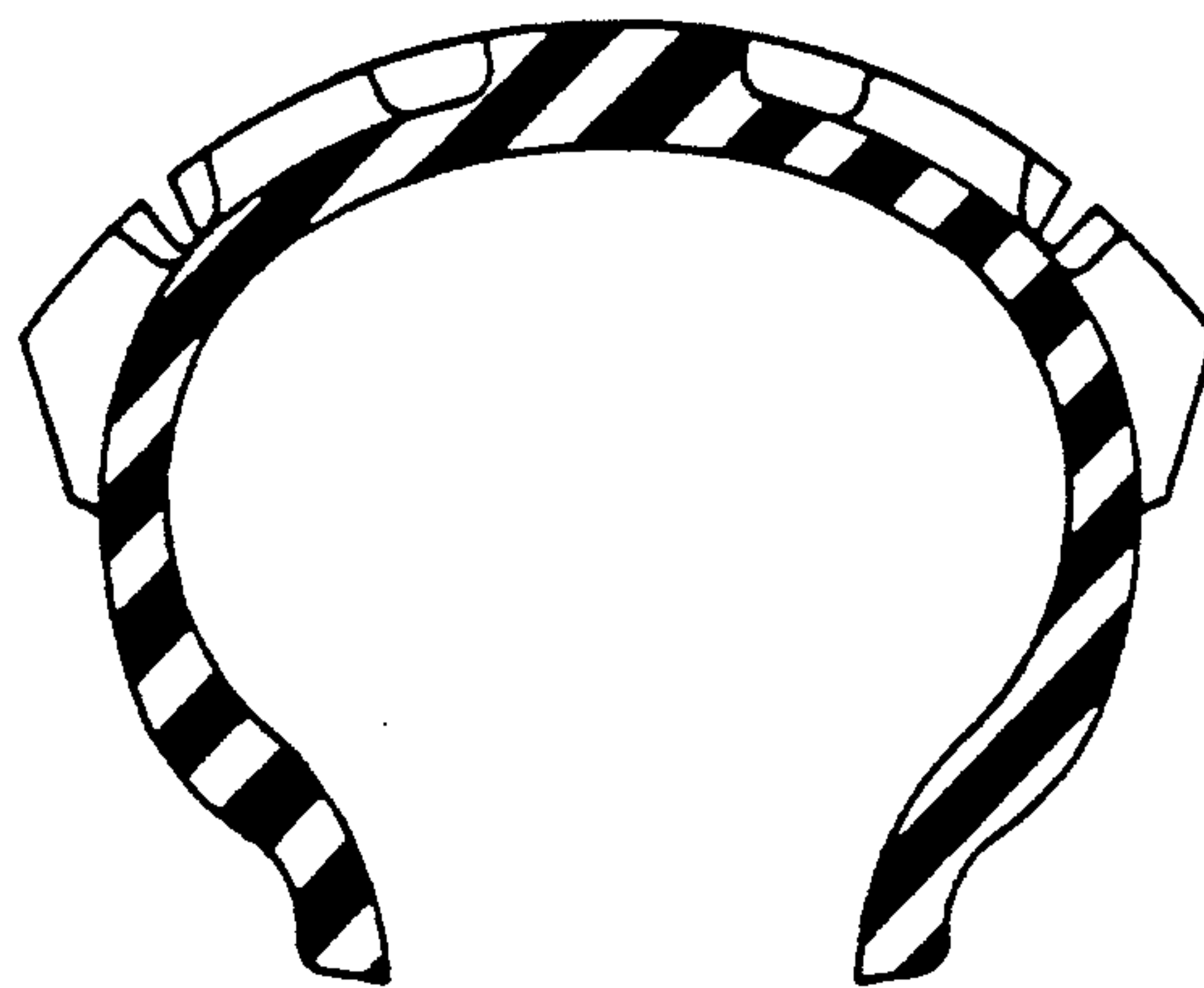
