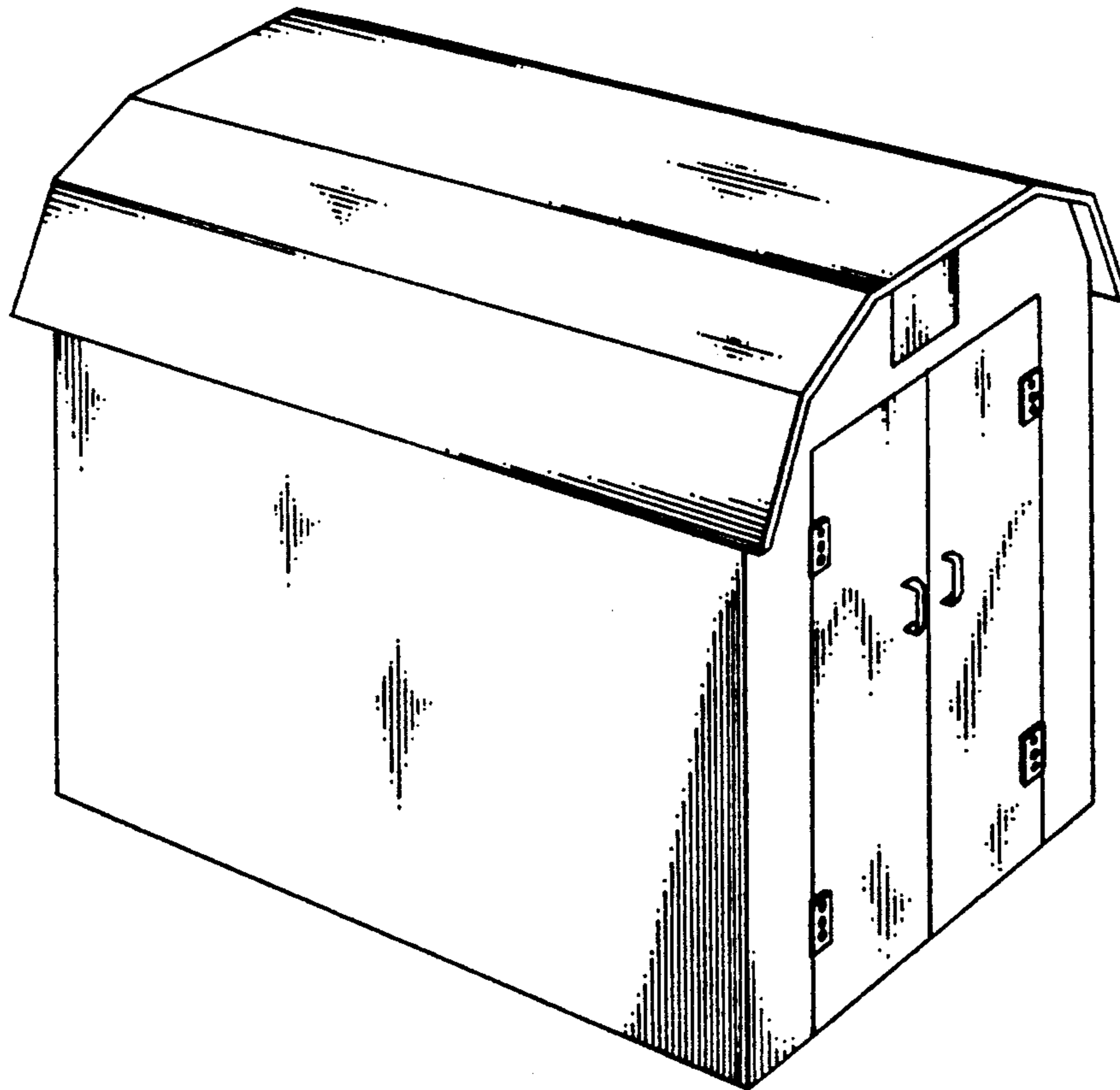

FIG. 7 is a front view with the doors open showing the interior of the invention.



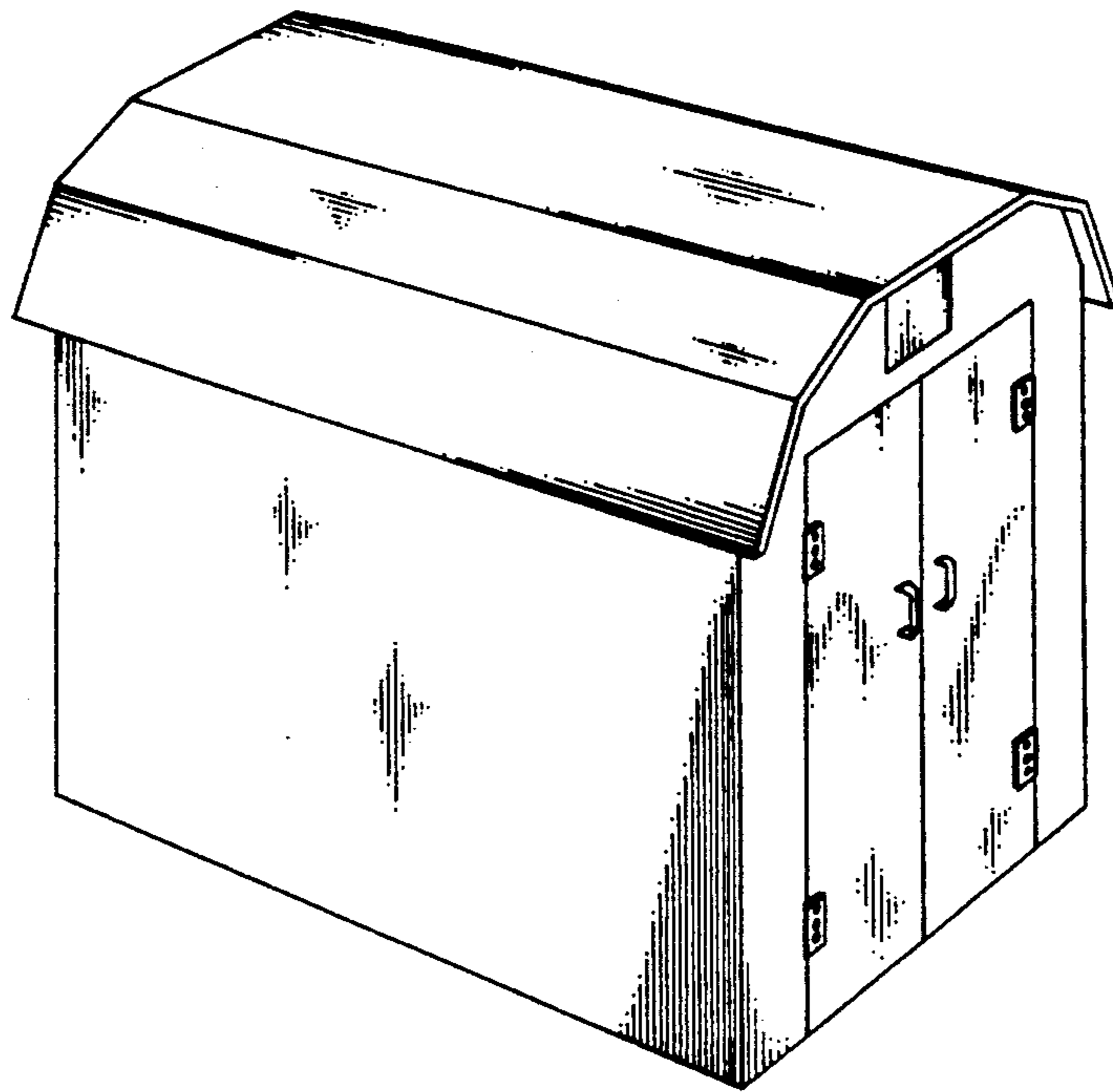

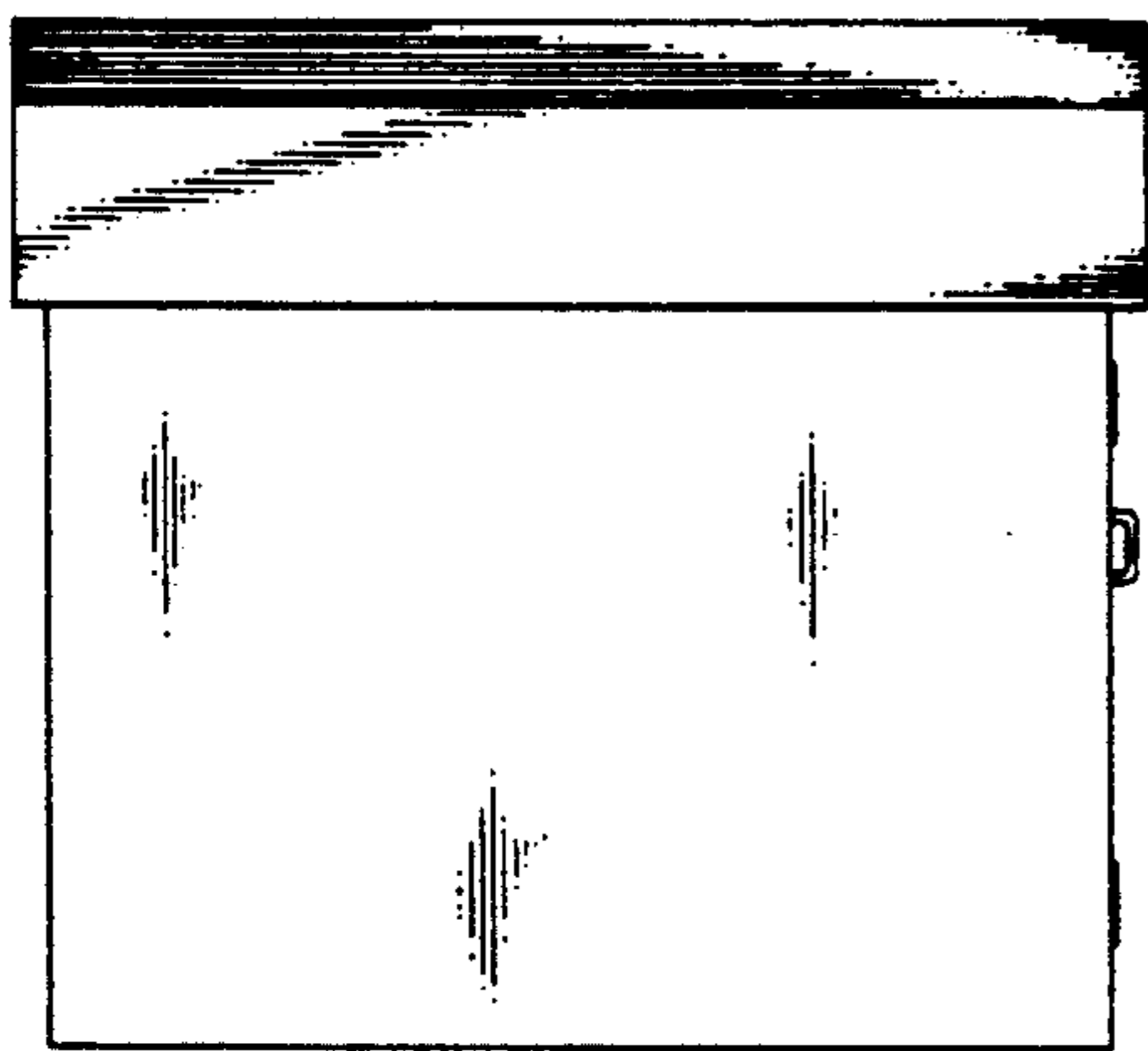

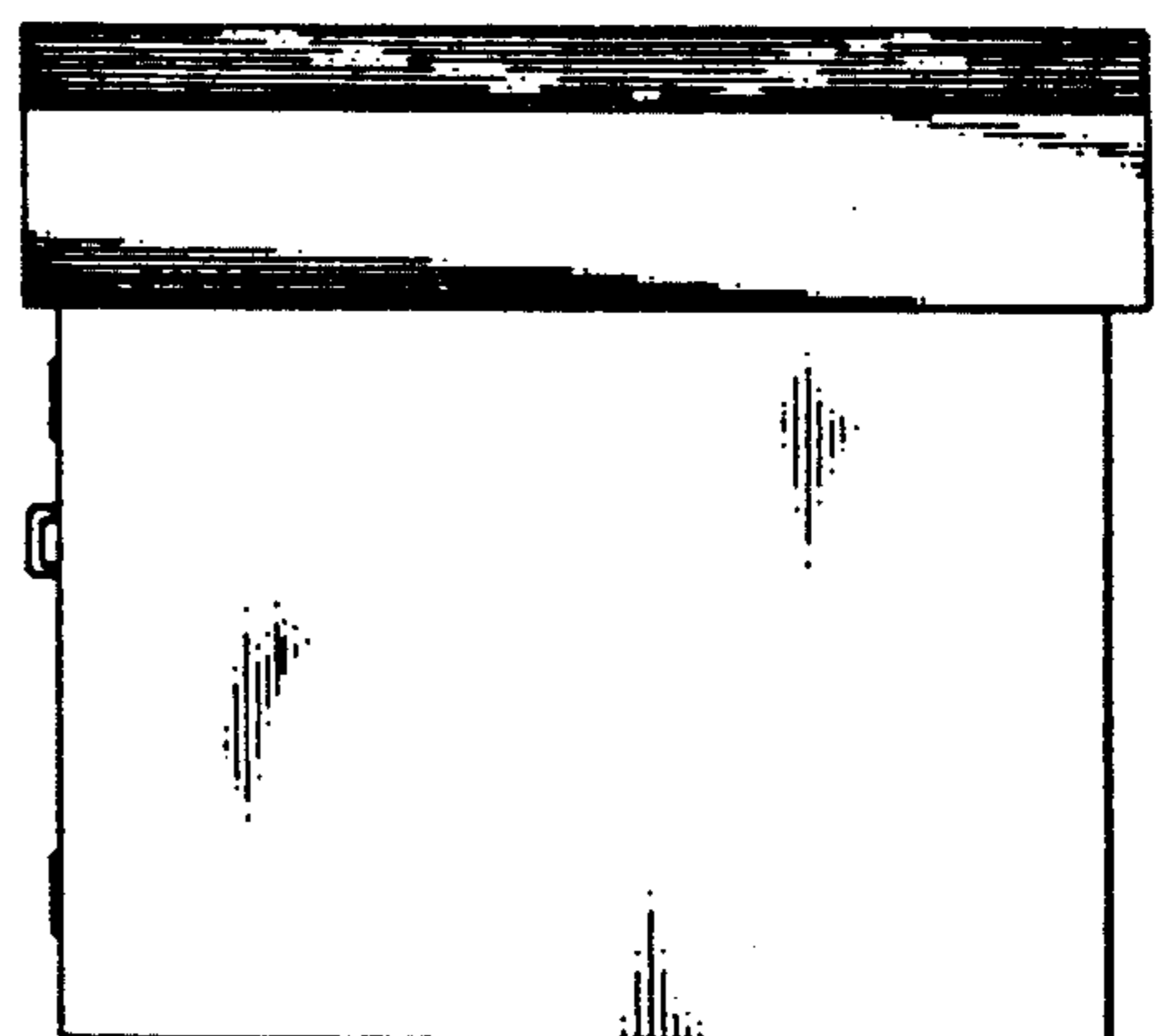

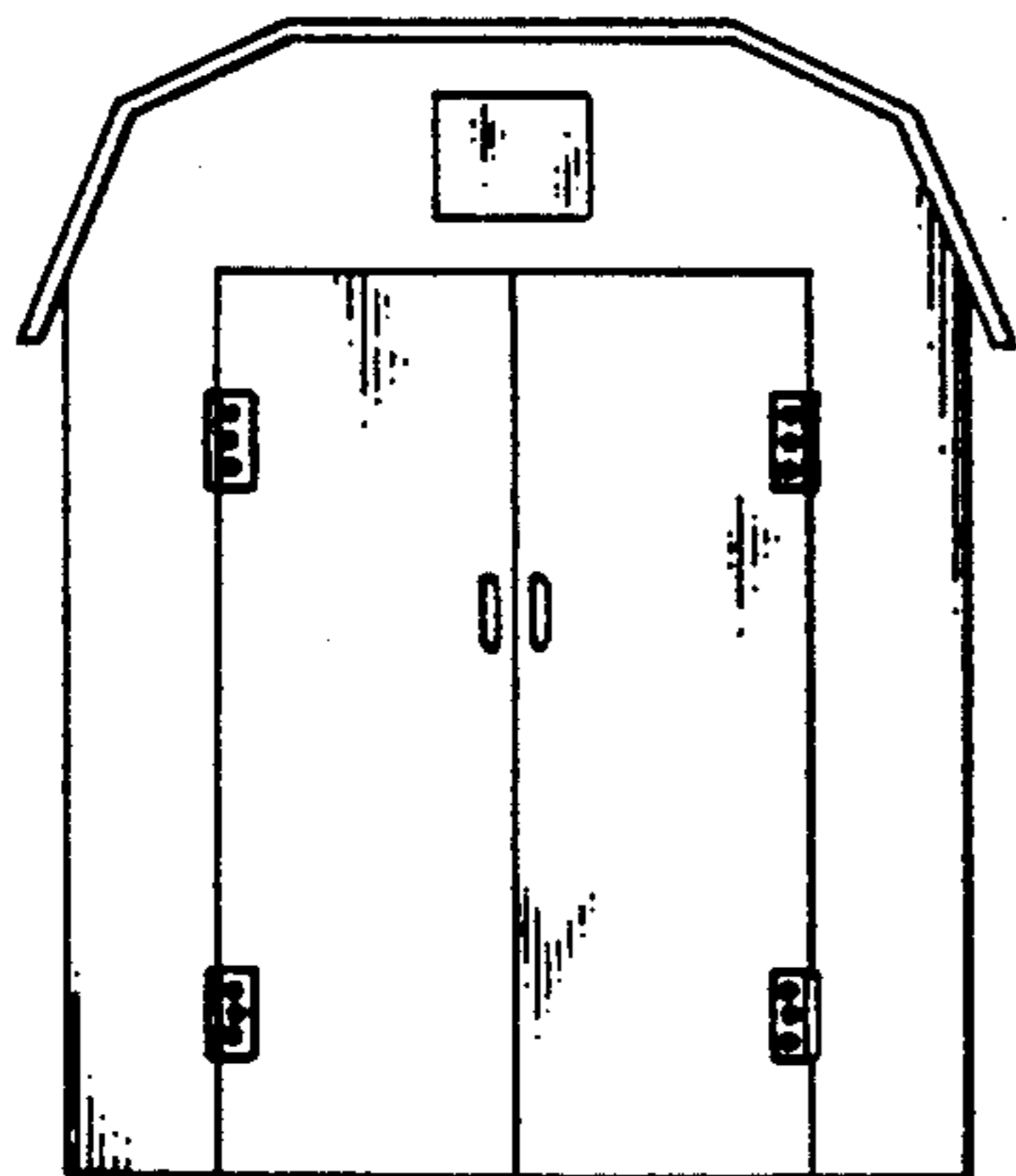

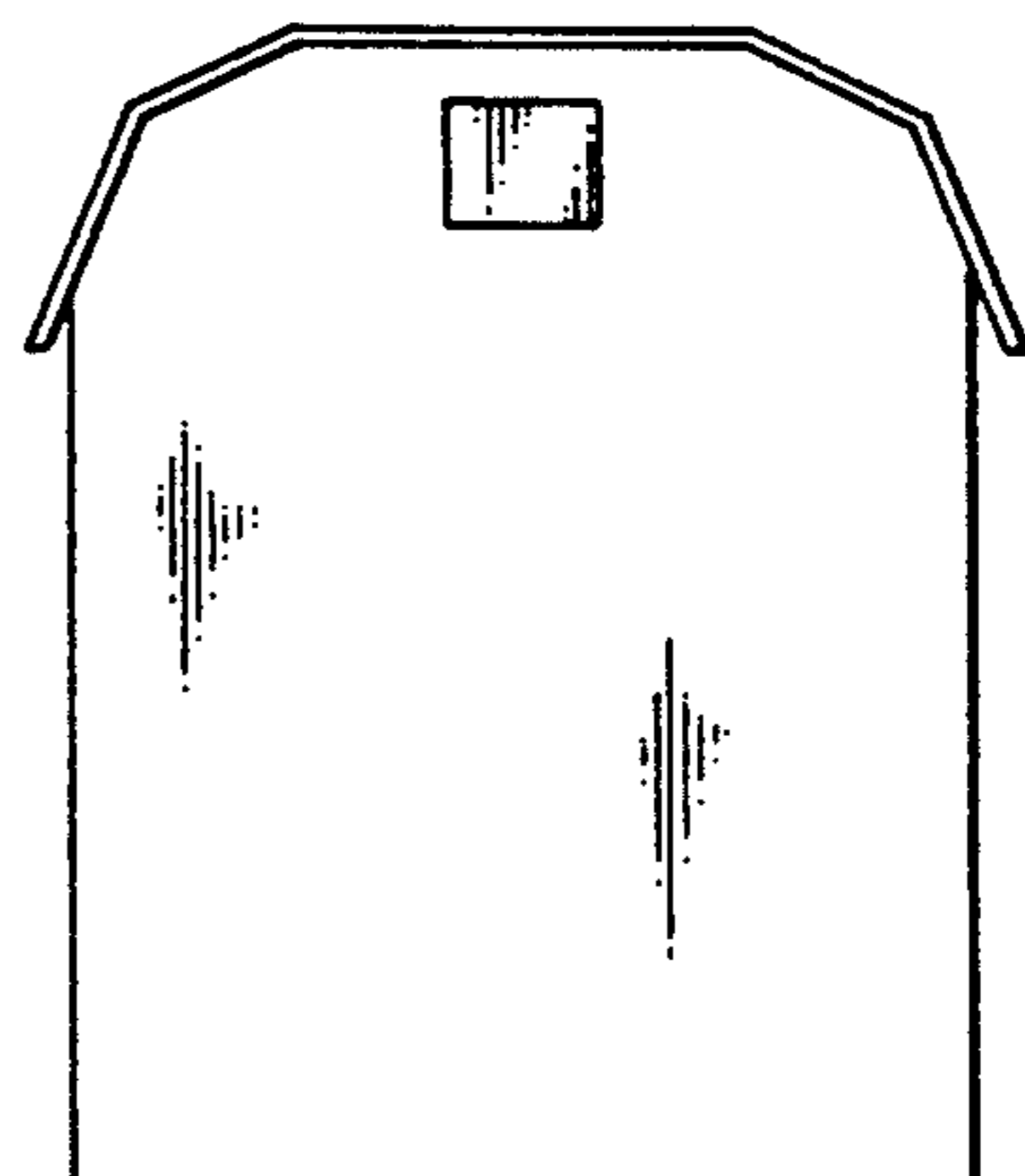

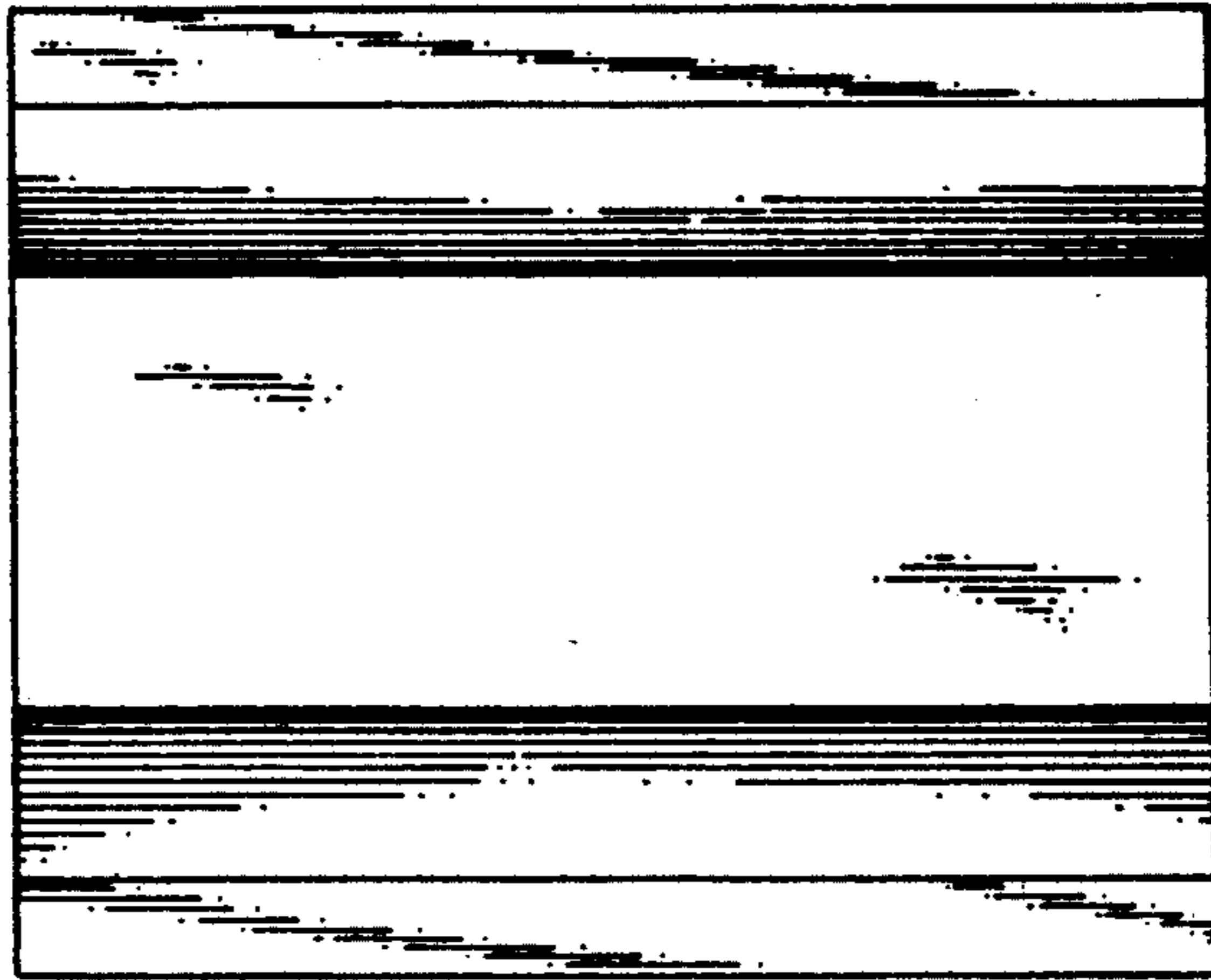

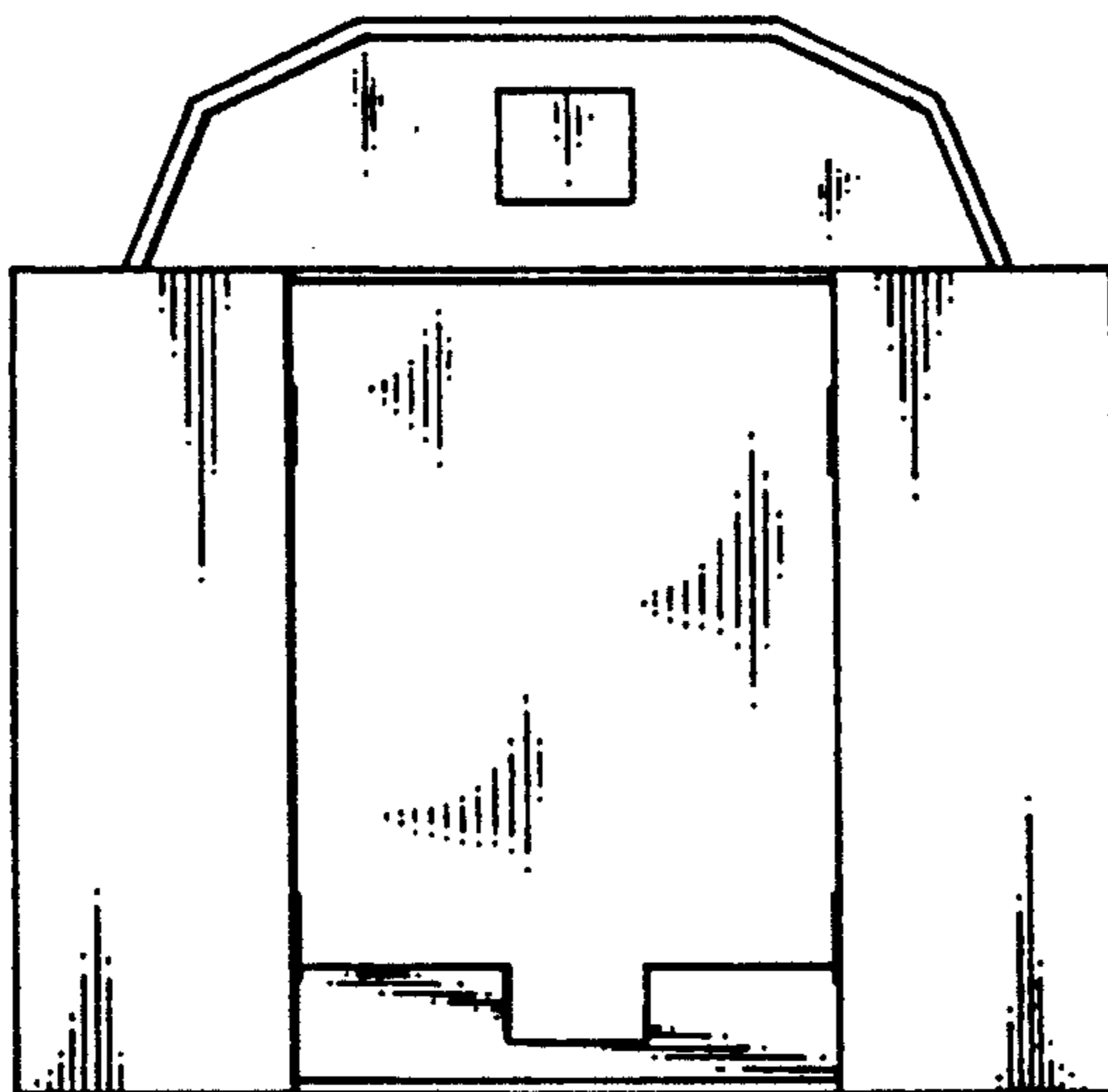
