FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof;

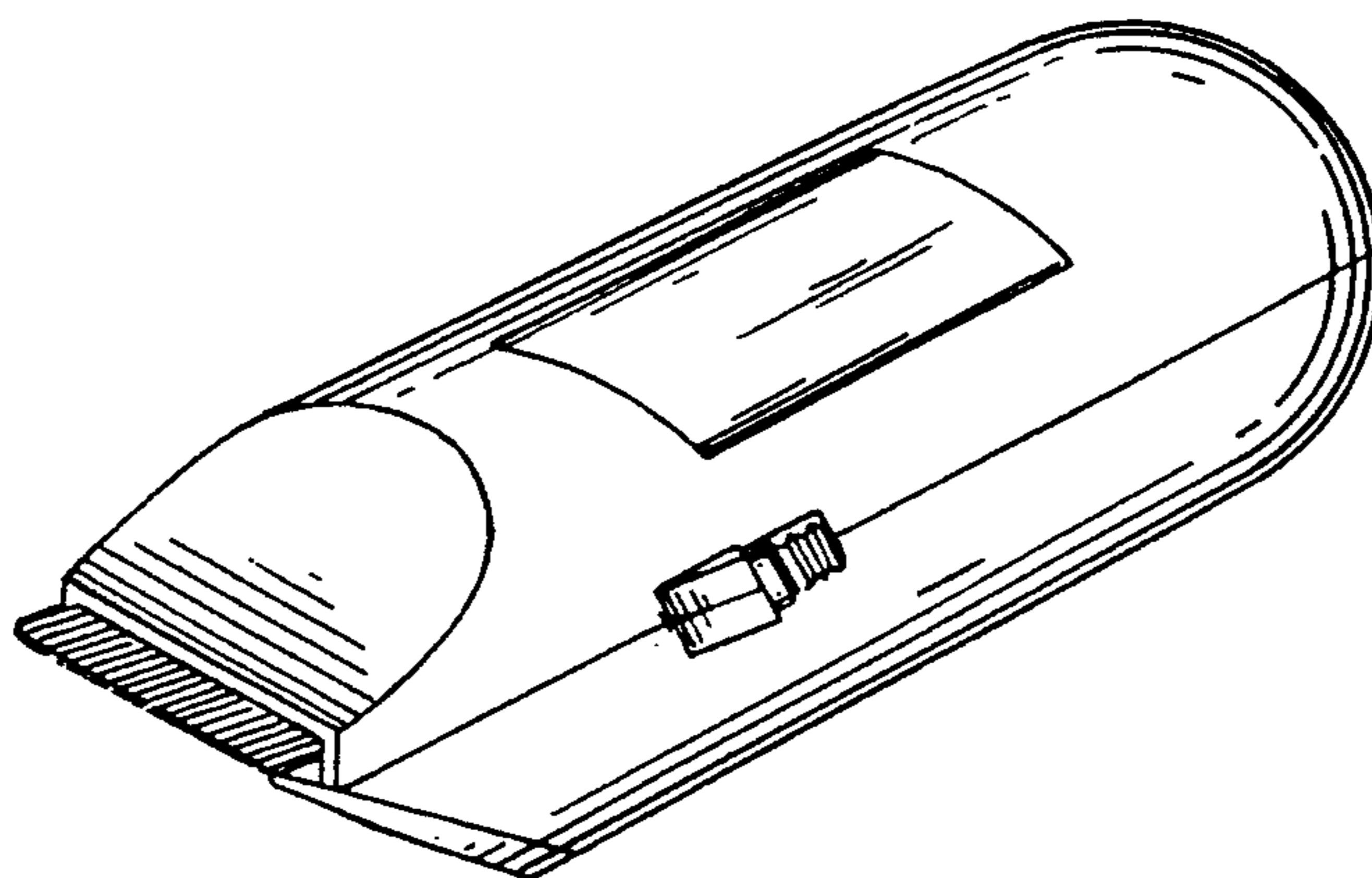
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;

The broken line showing of the electrical cord is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



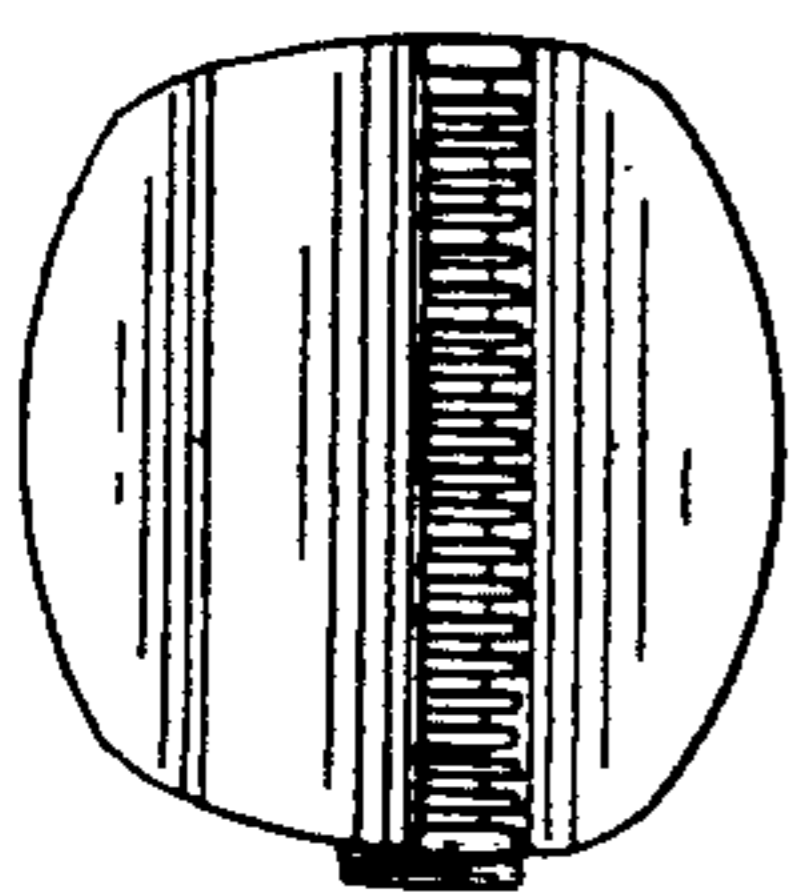

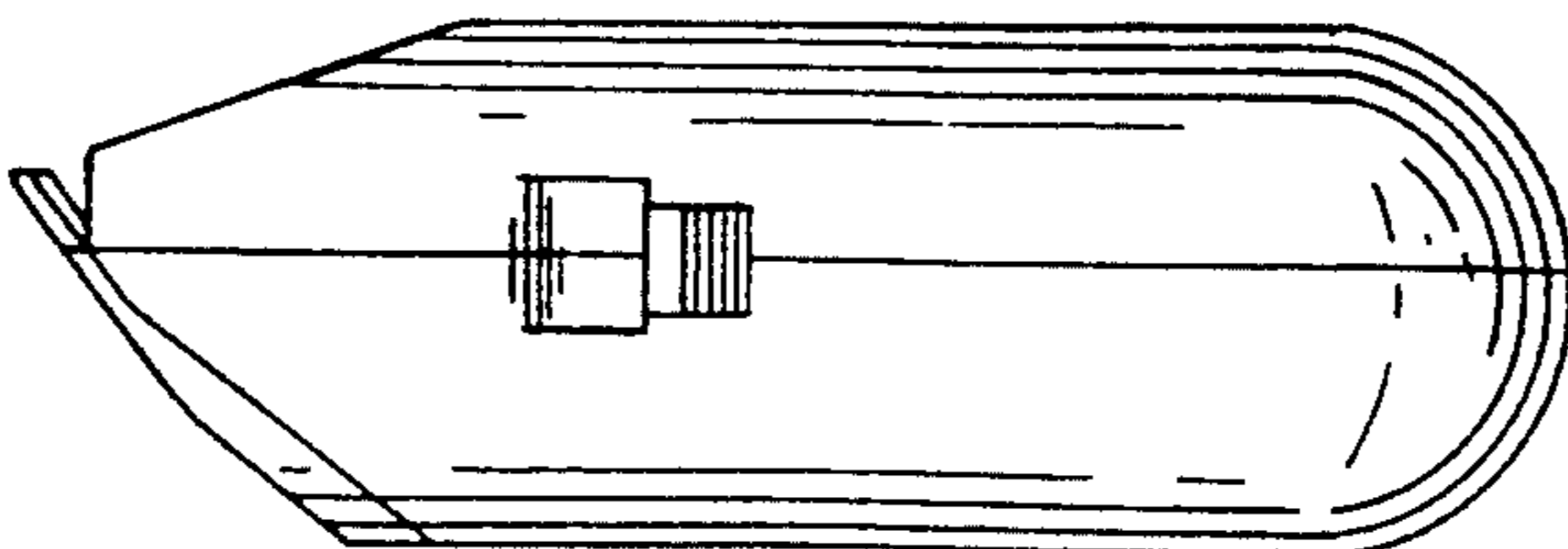

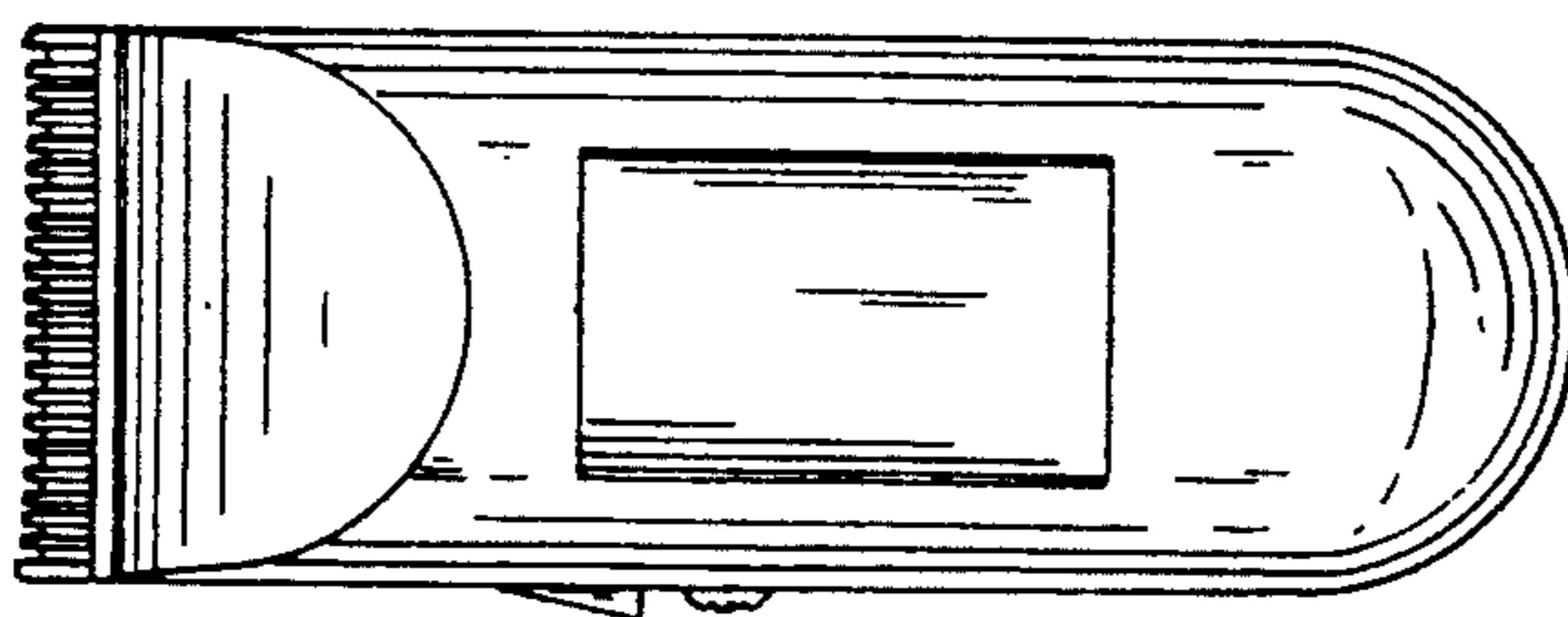

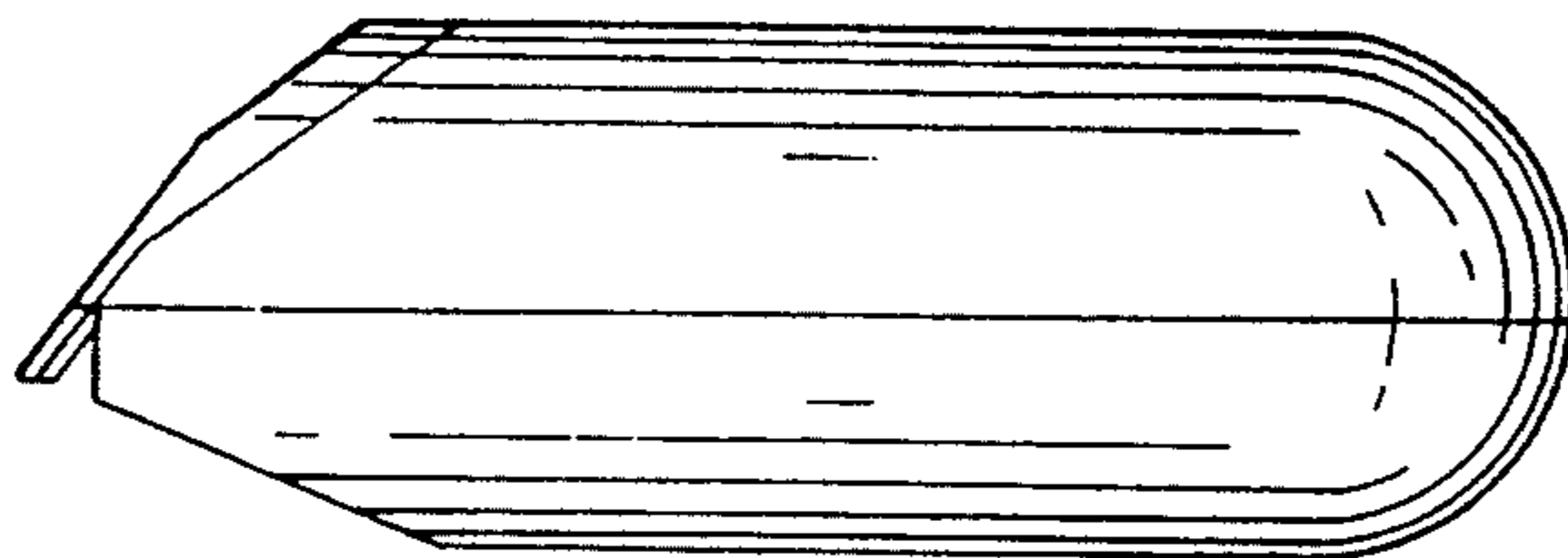

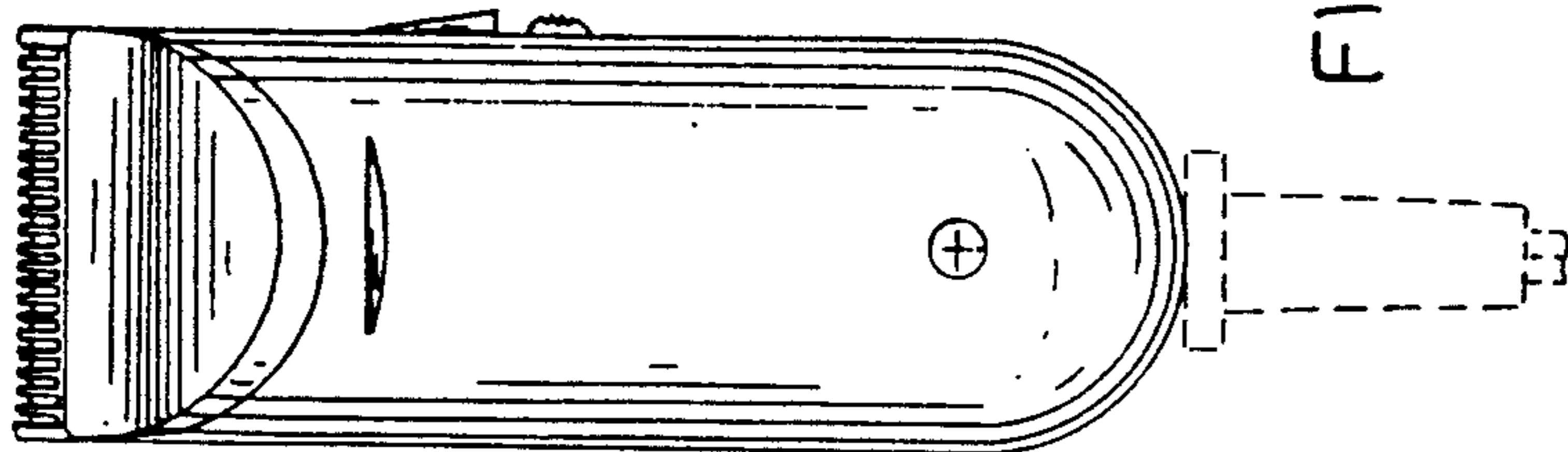

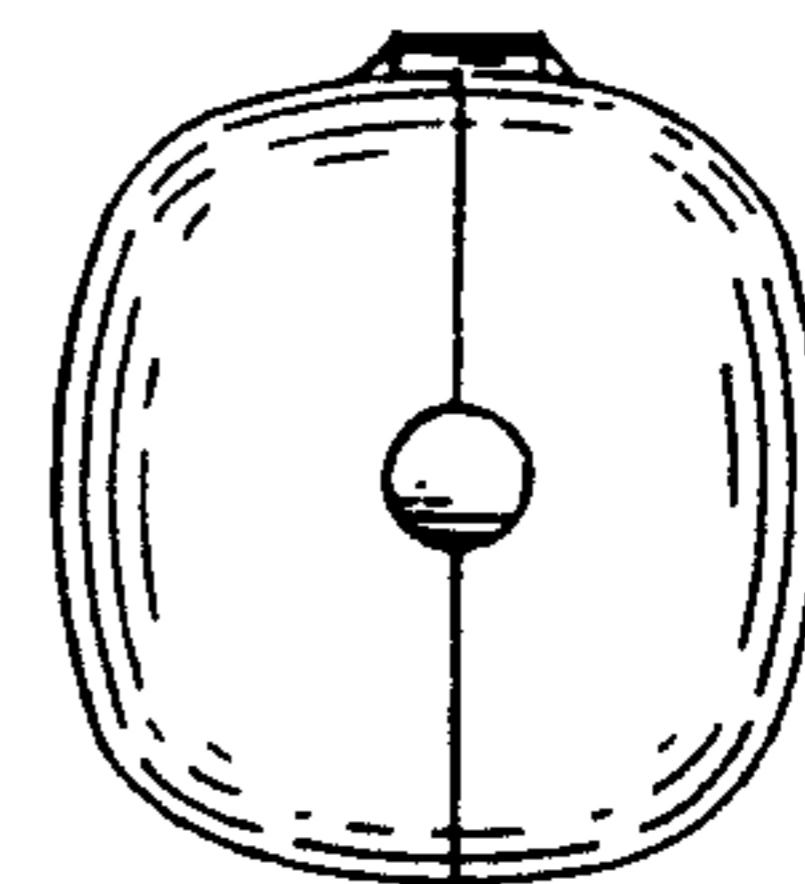

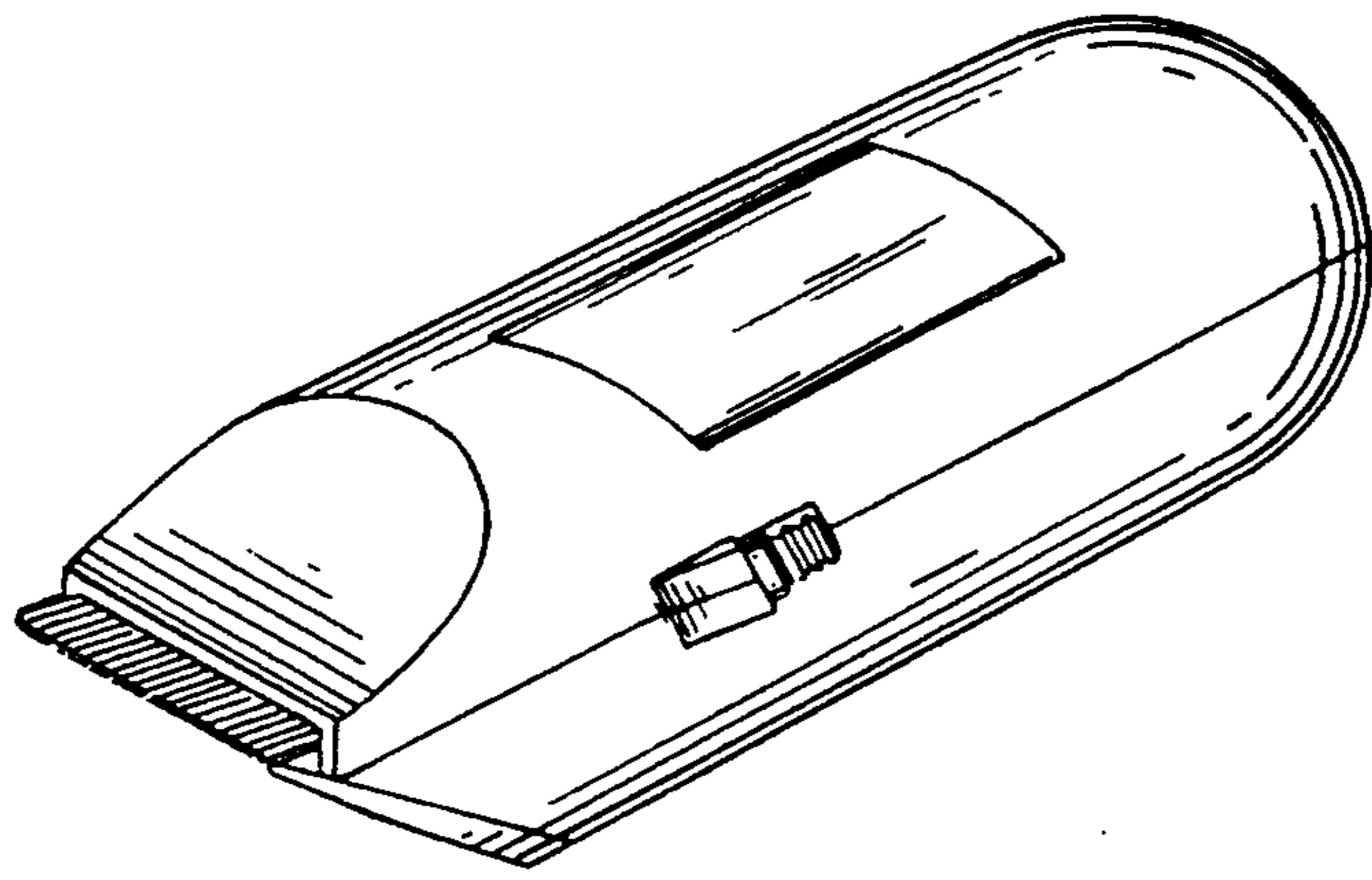
