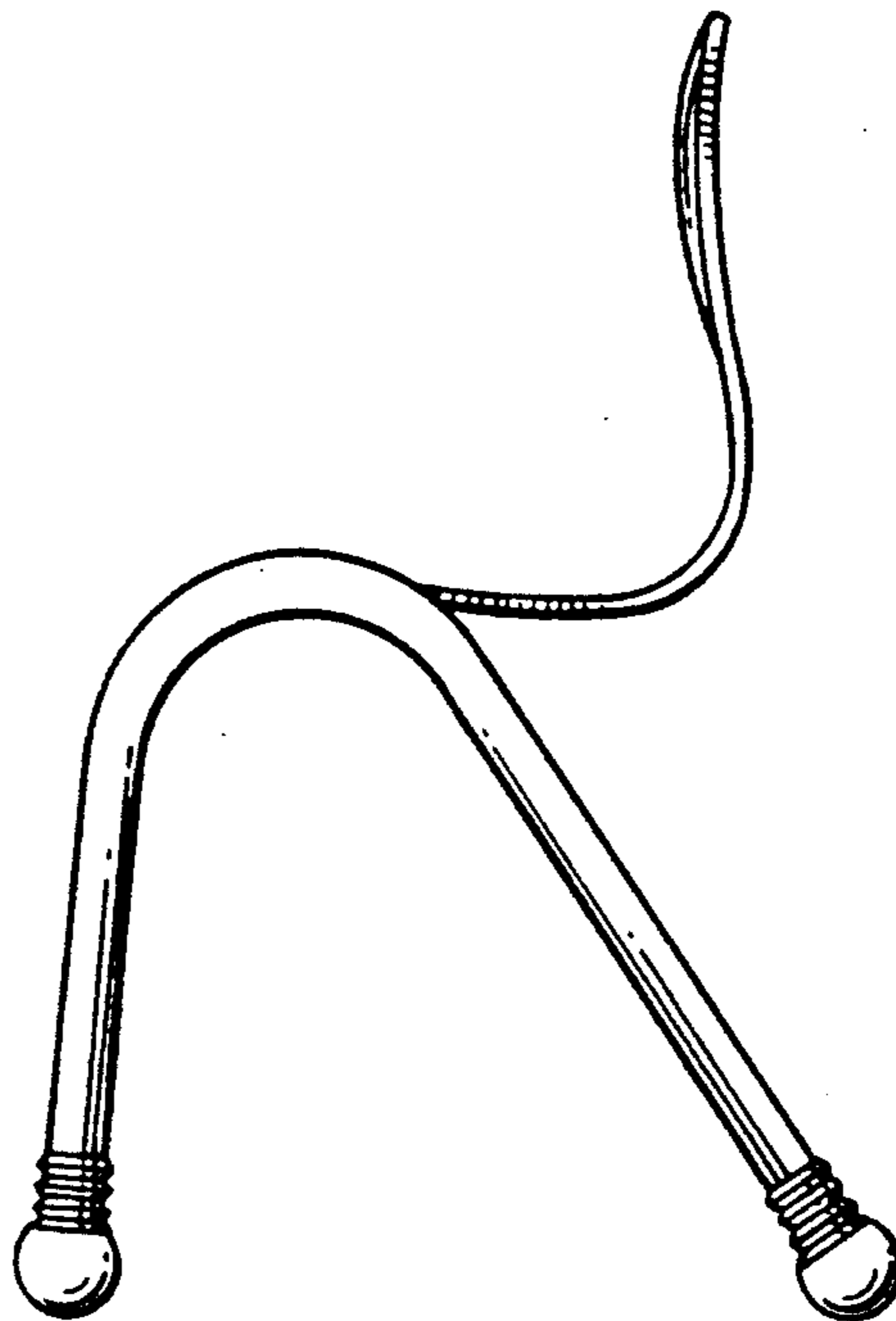
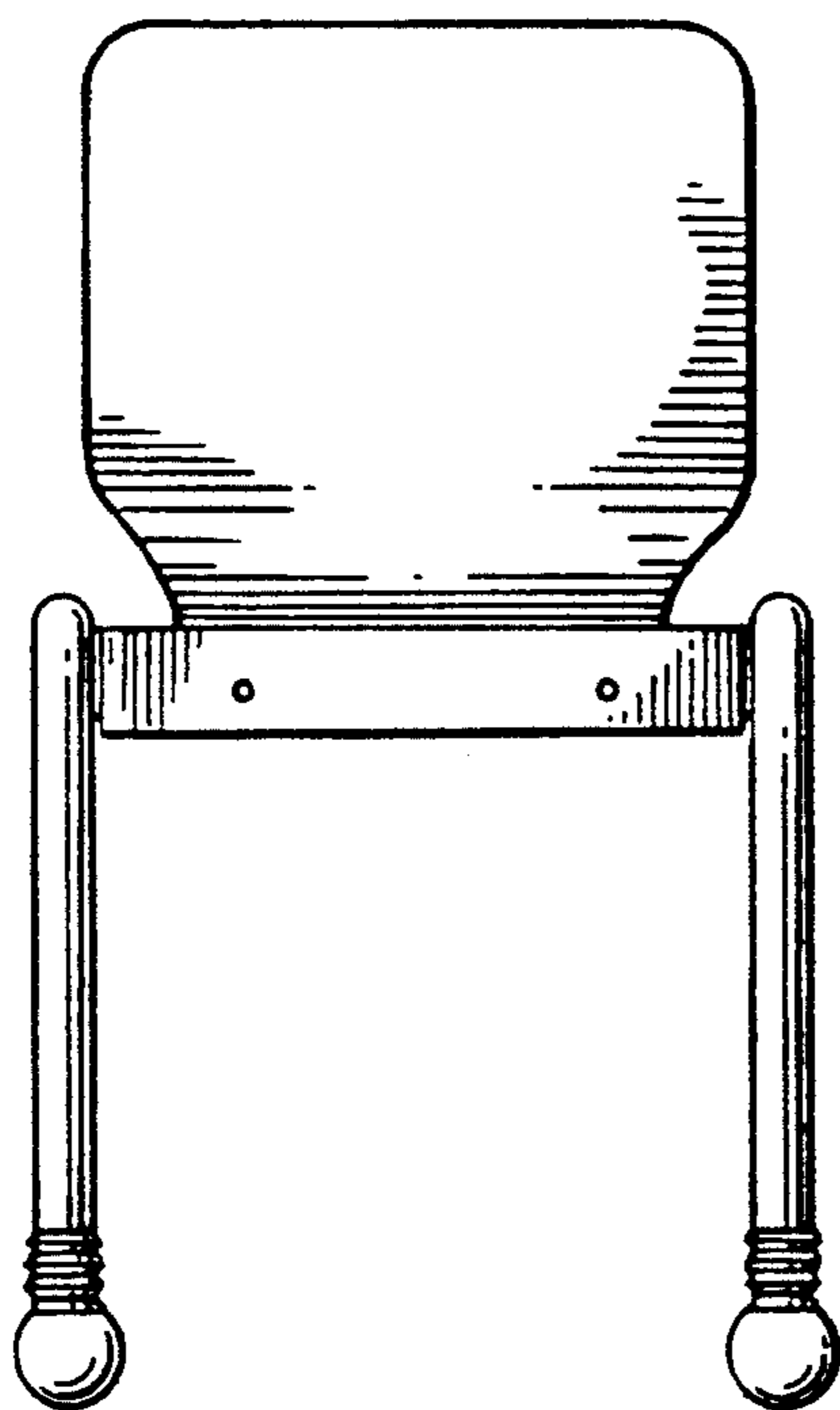

FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the chair.



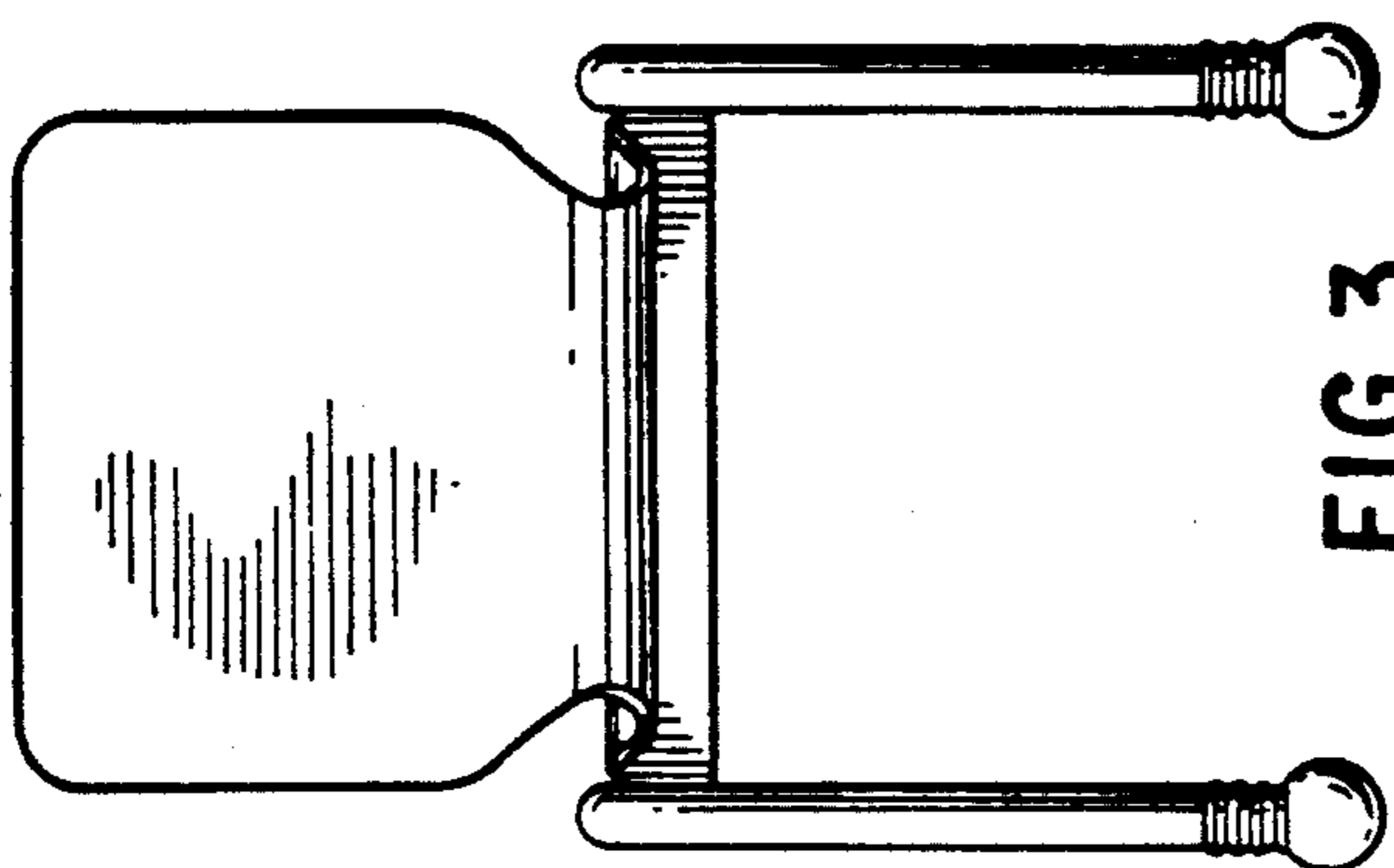

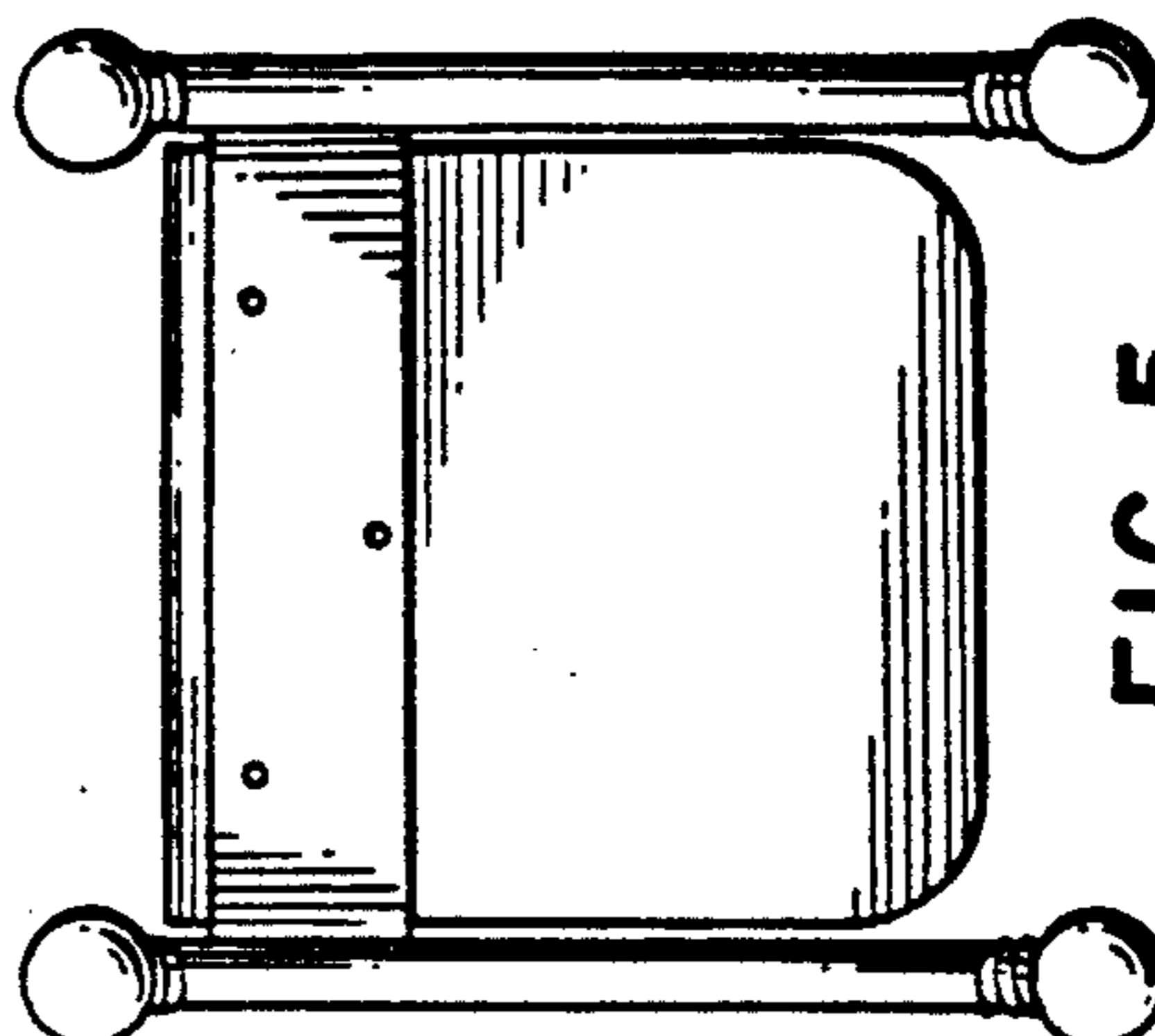

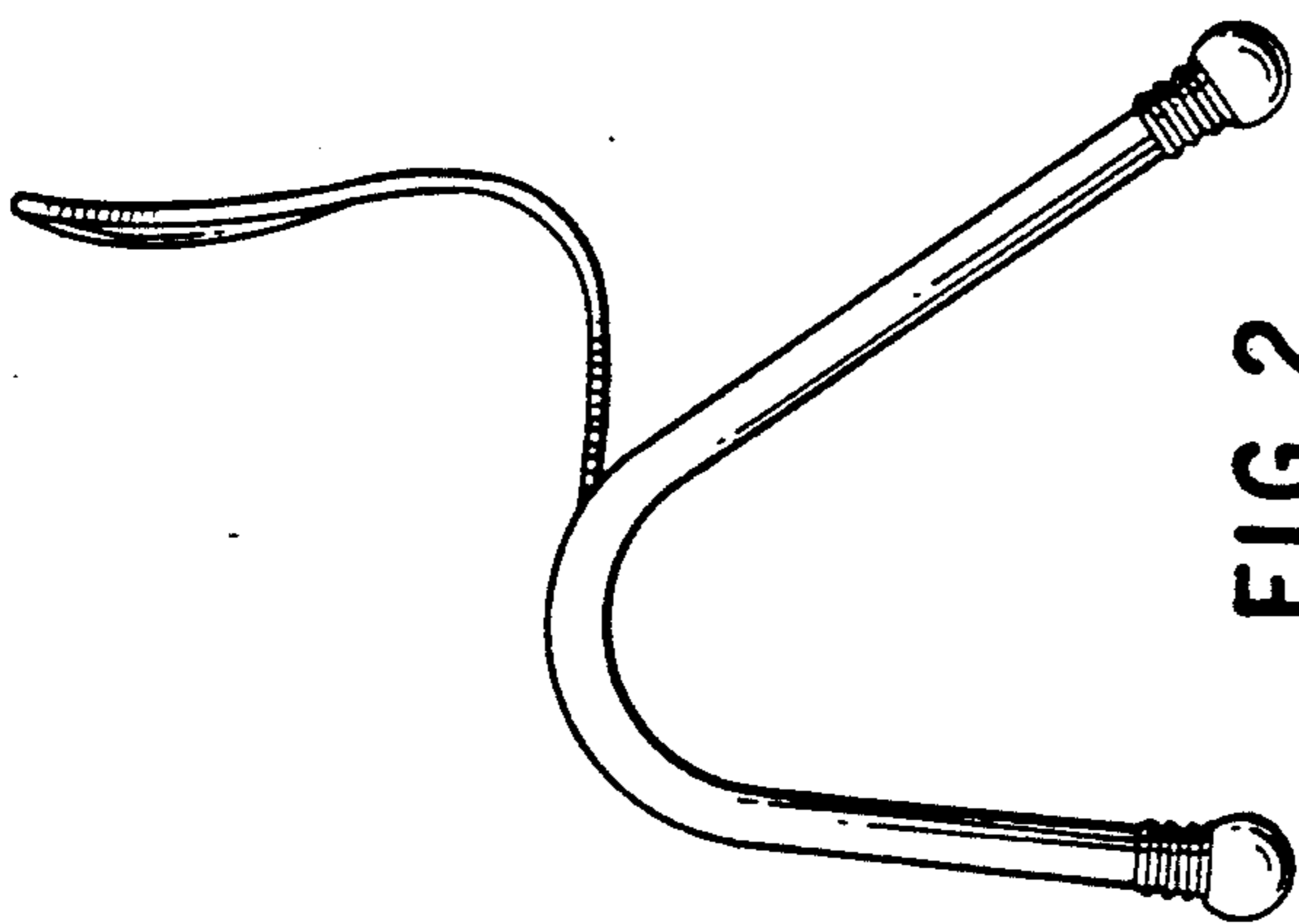

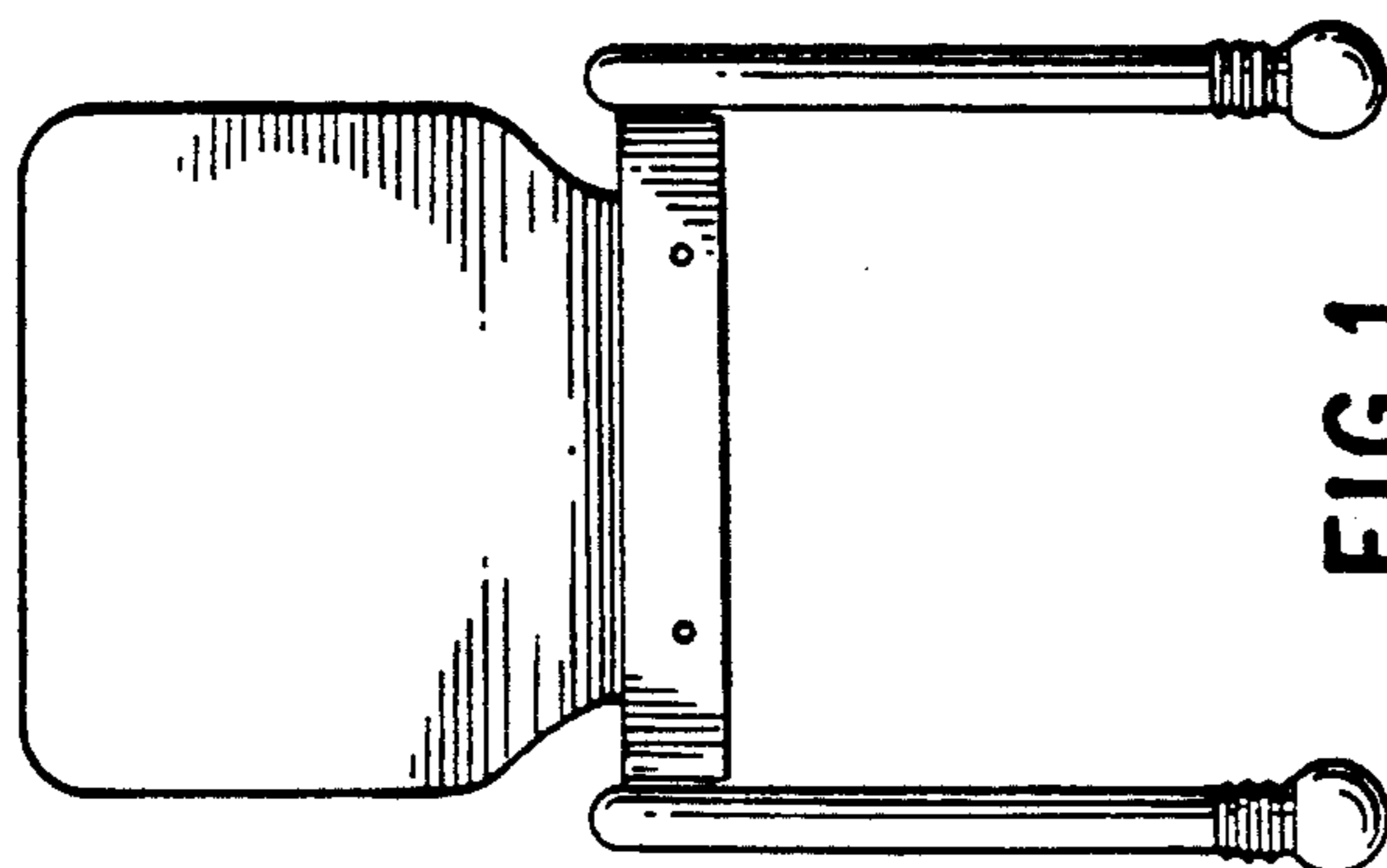

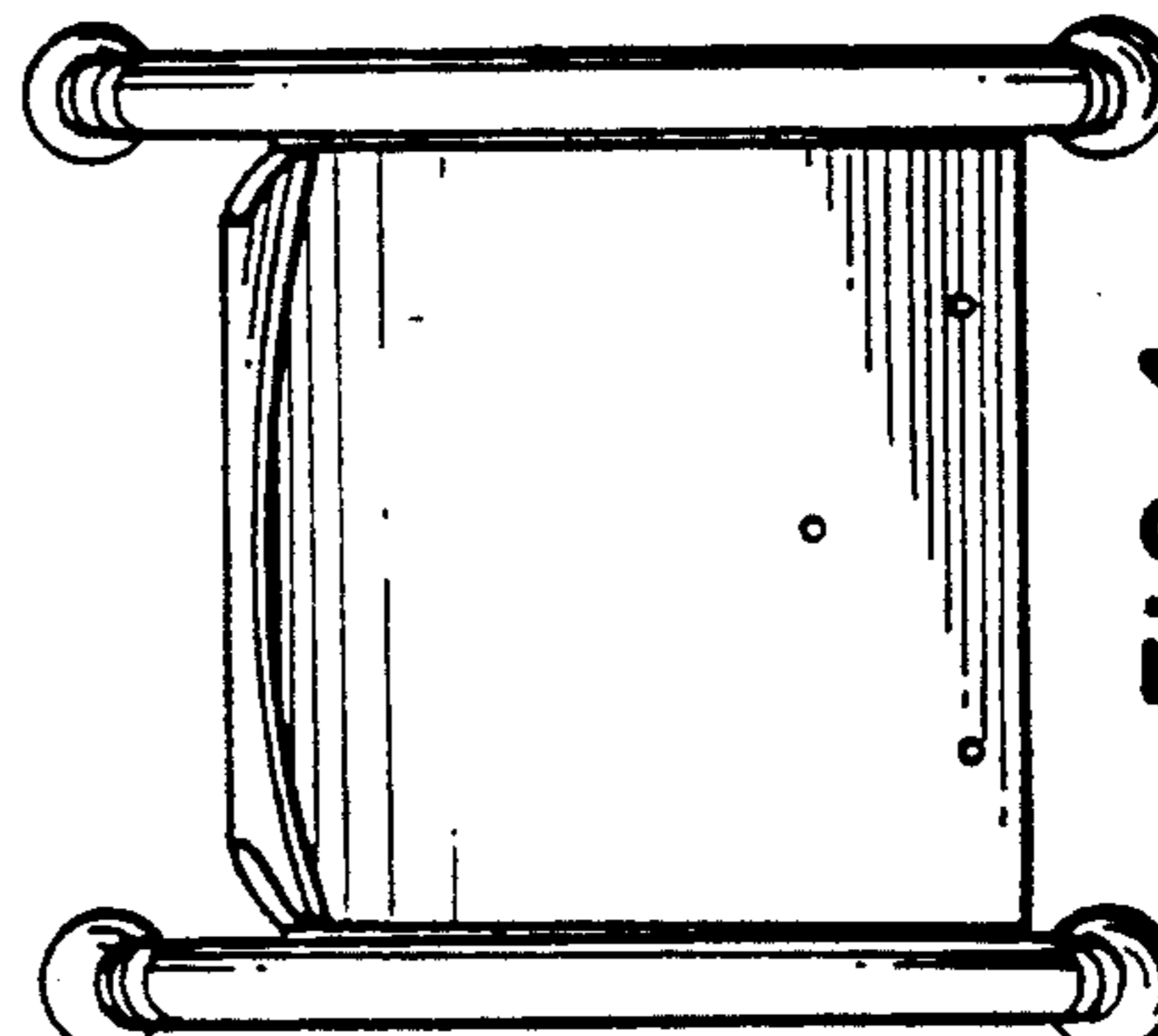
