The ornamental design for a charging base for a cordless telephone, as shown and described.


## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and upper left perspective view of a charging base for a cordless telephone showing our new design. The broken line showing is included for the purpose of illustrating environmental elements only and forms no part of the claimed design;


FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view of the charging base for a cordless telephone shown an enlarged scale. The broken line showing is included for the purpose of illustrating environmental elements only and forms no part of the claimed design;






