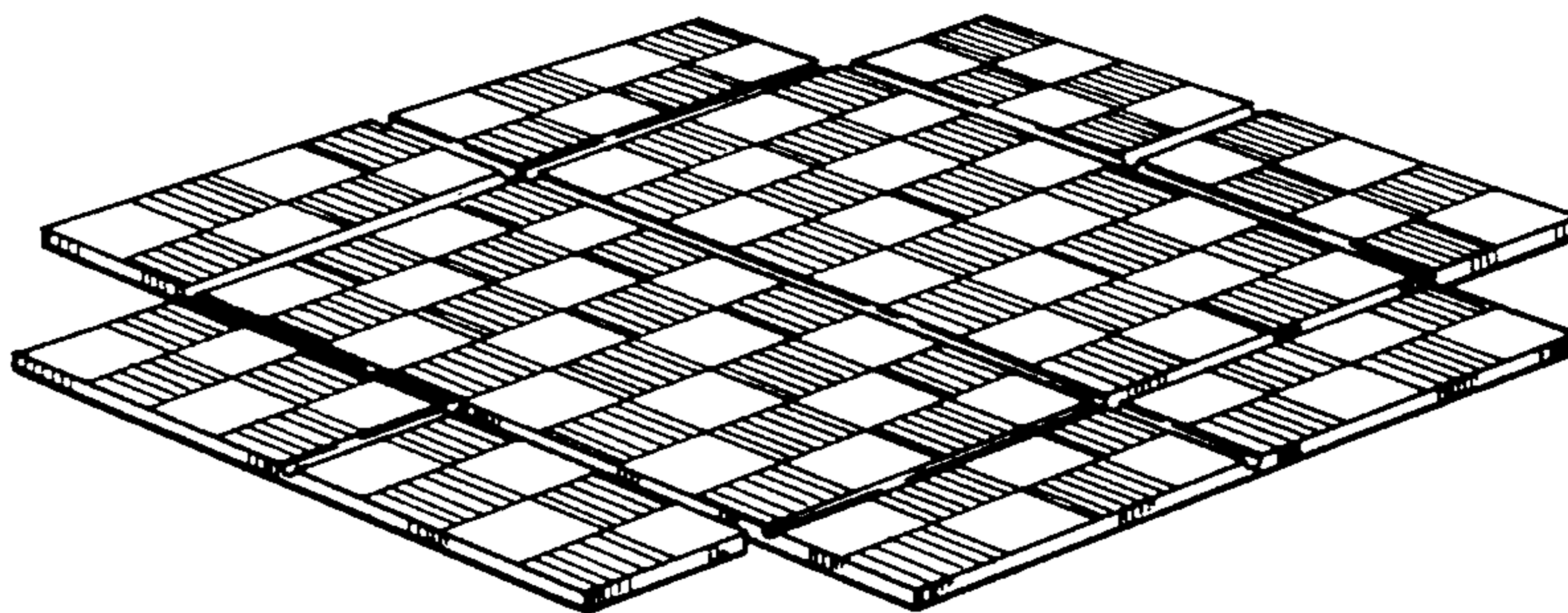
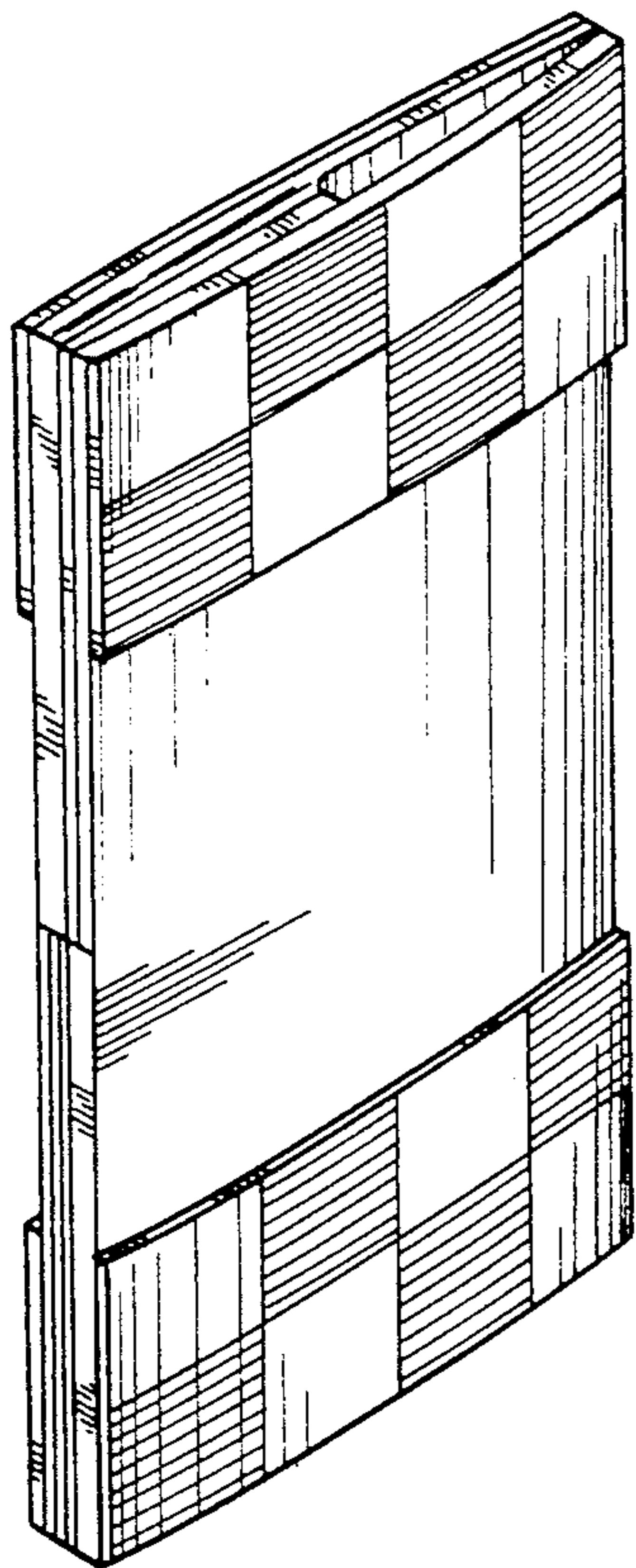

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a game board, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an enlarged perspective view of a game board, showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a one side elevational view thereof, the three other side views being mirror images thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof with the right side of each extension folded under the left side of each respective extension;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof with right side of each extension folded under the left side of each respective extension;
 FIG. 7 is one side elevational view thereof with the right side of each extension folded under the left side of each respective extension, the three other side views being mirror images thereof; and,
 FIG. 8 is an enlarged perspective view thereof, completely folded.



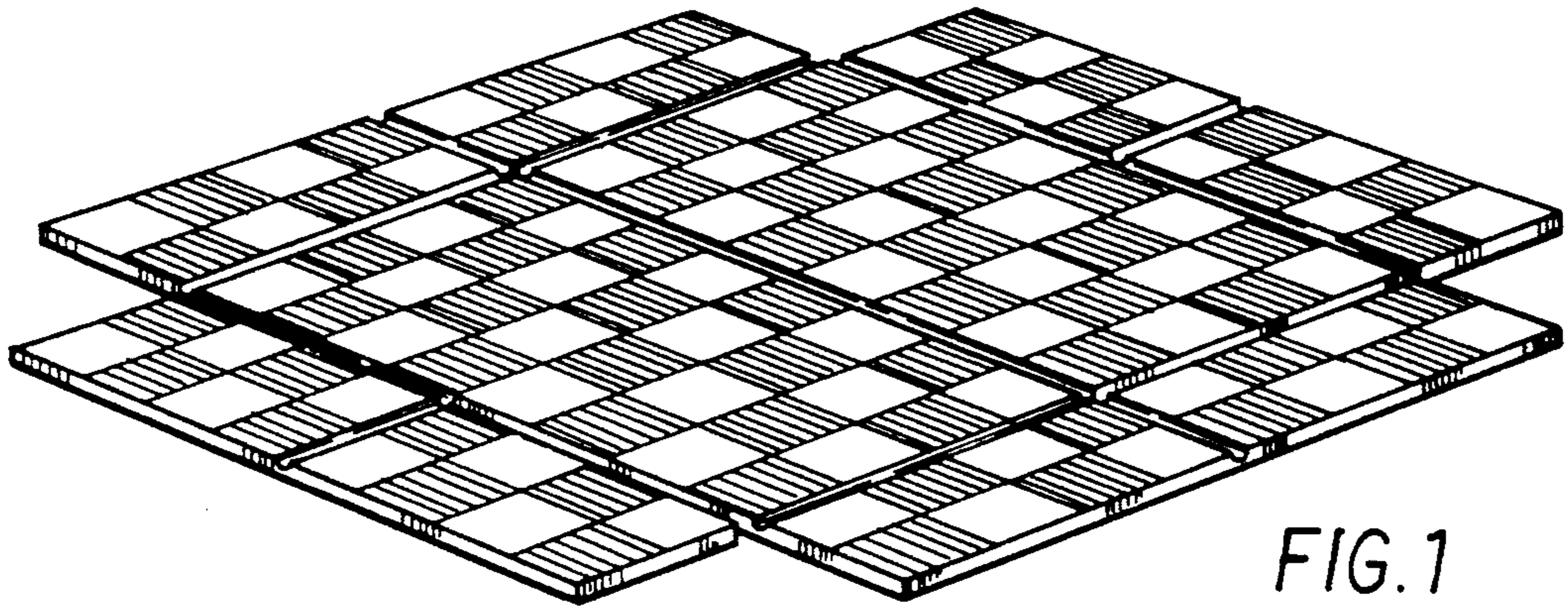

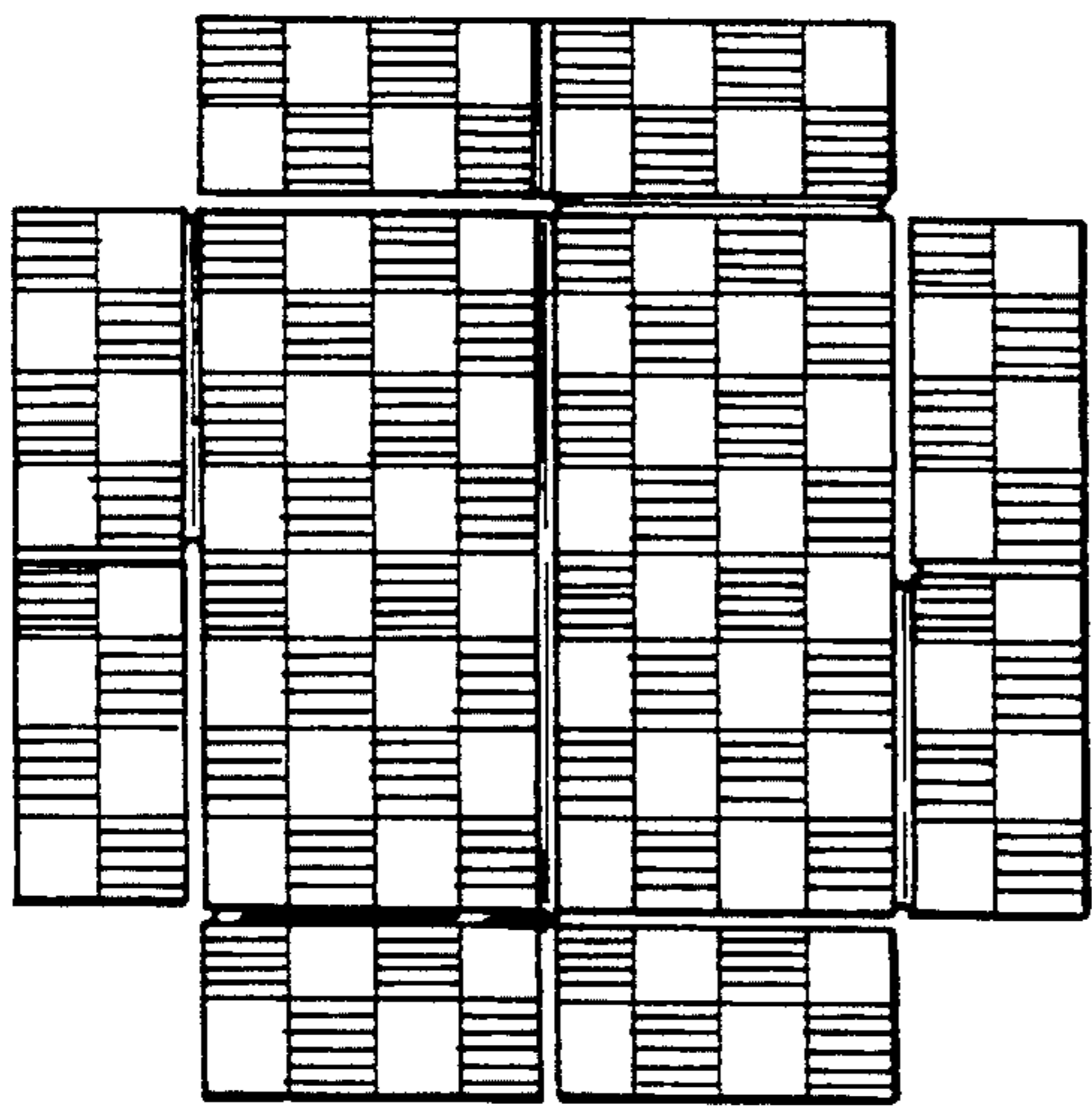

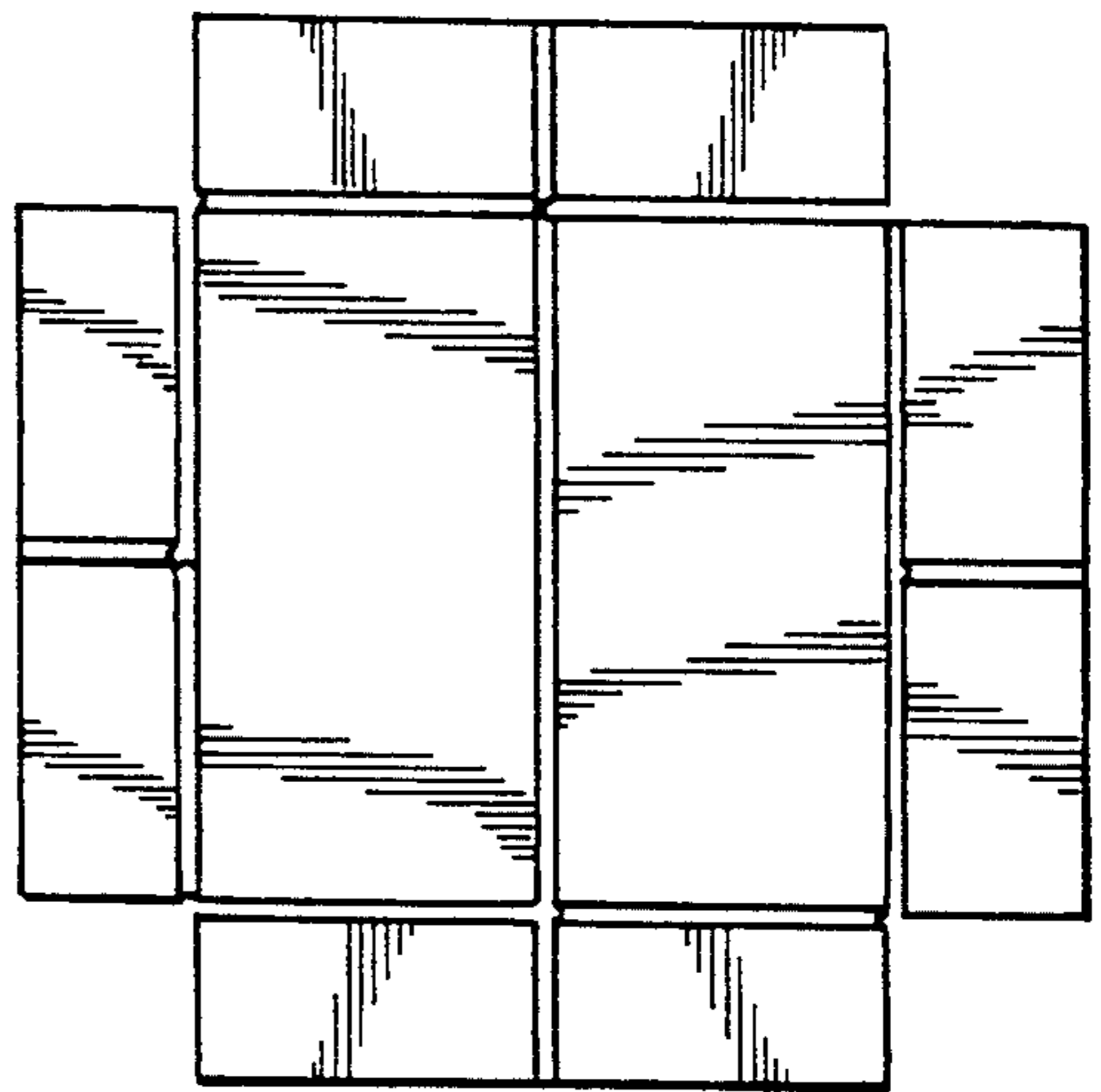

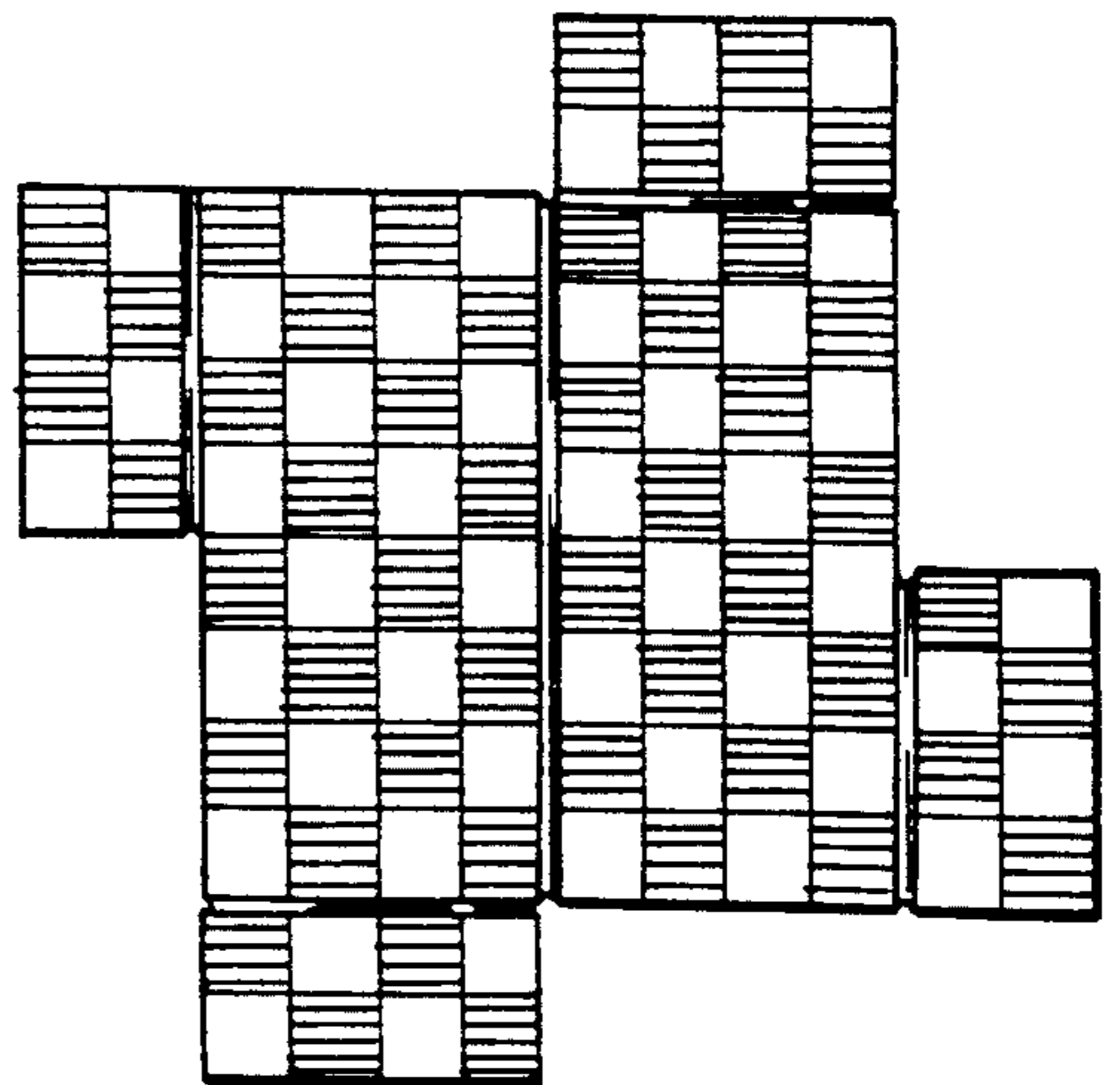

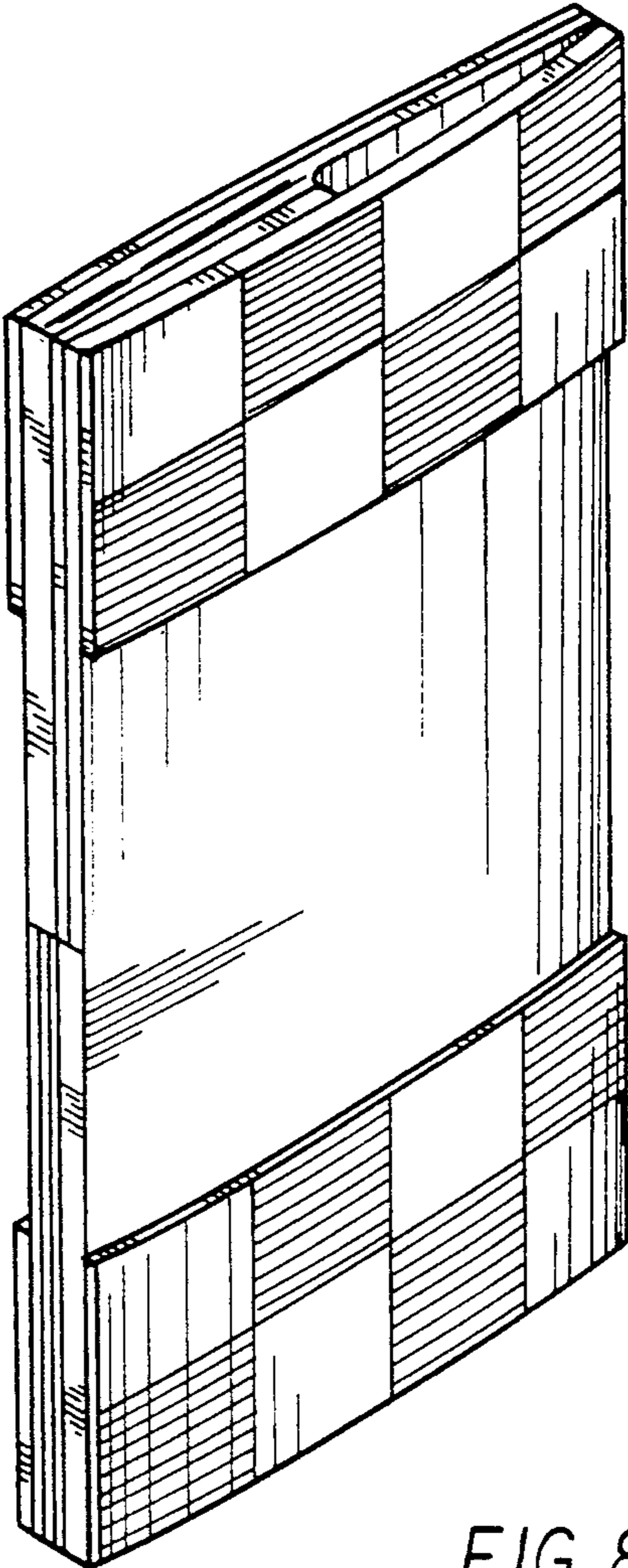

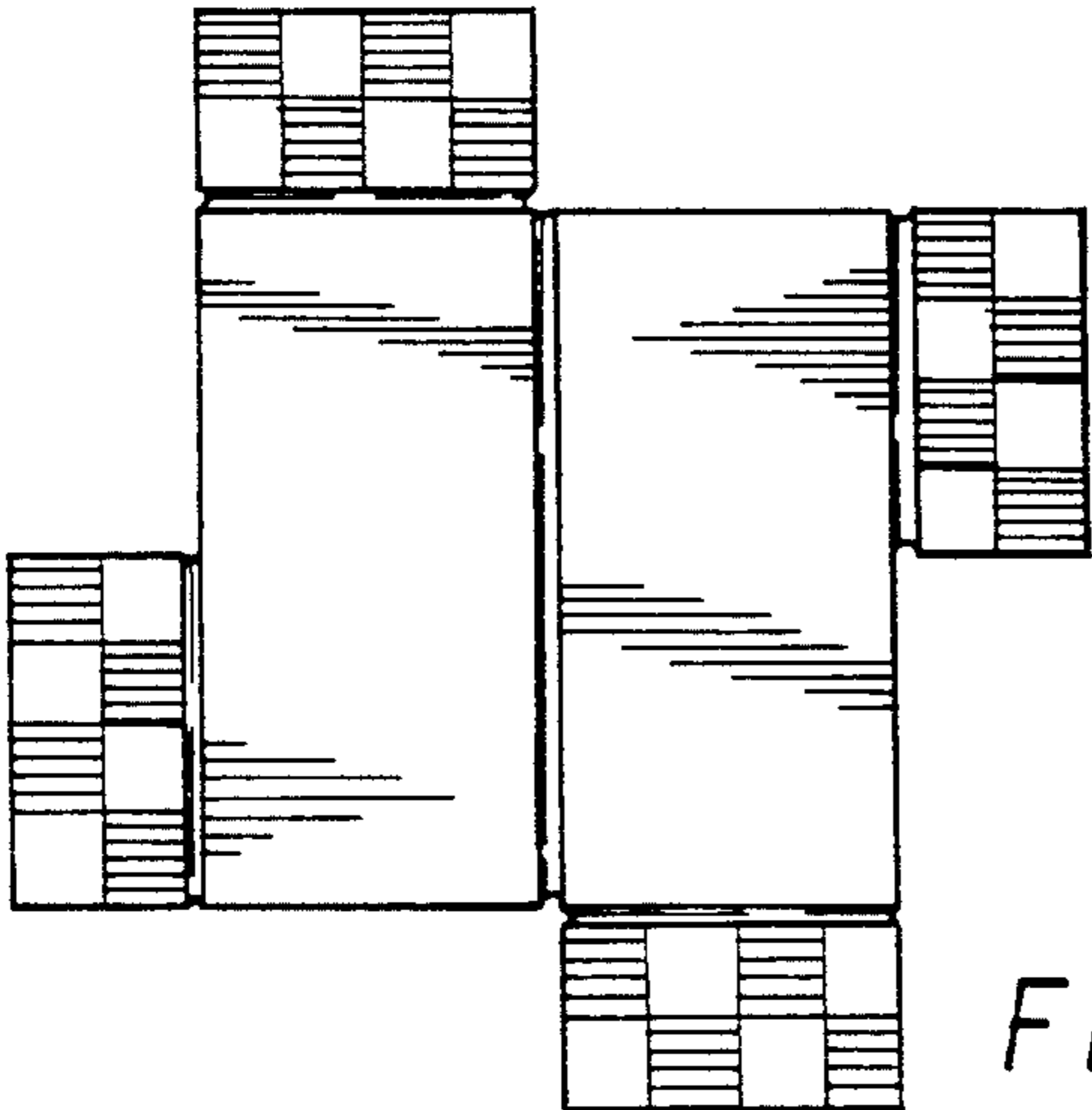
