FIG. 24 is a bottom plan view.

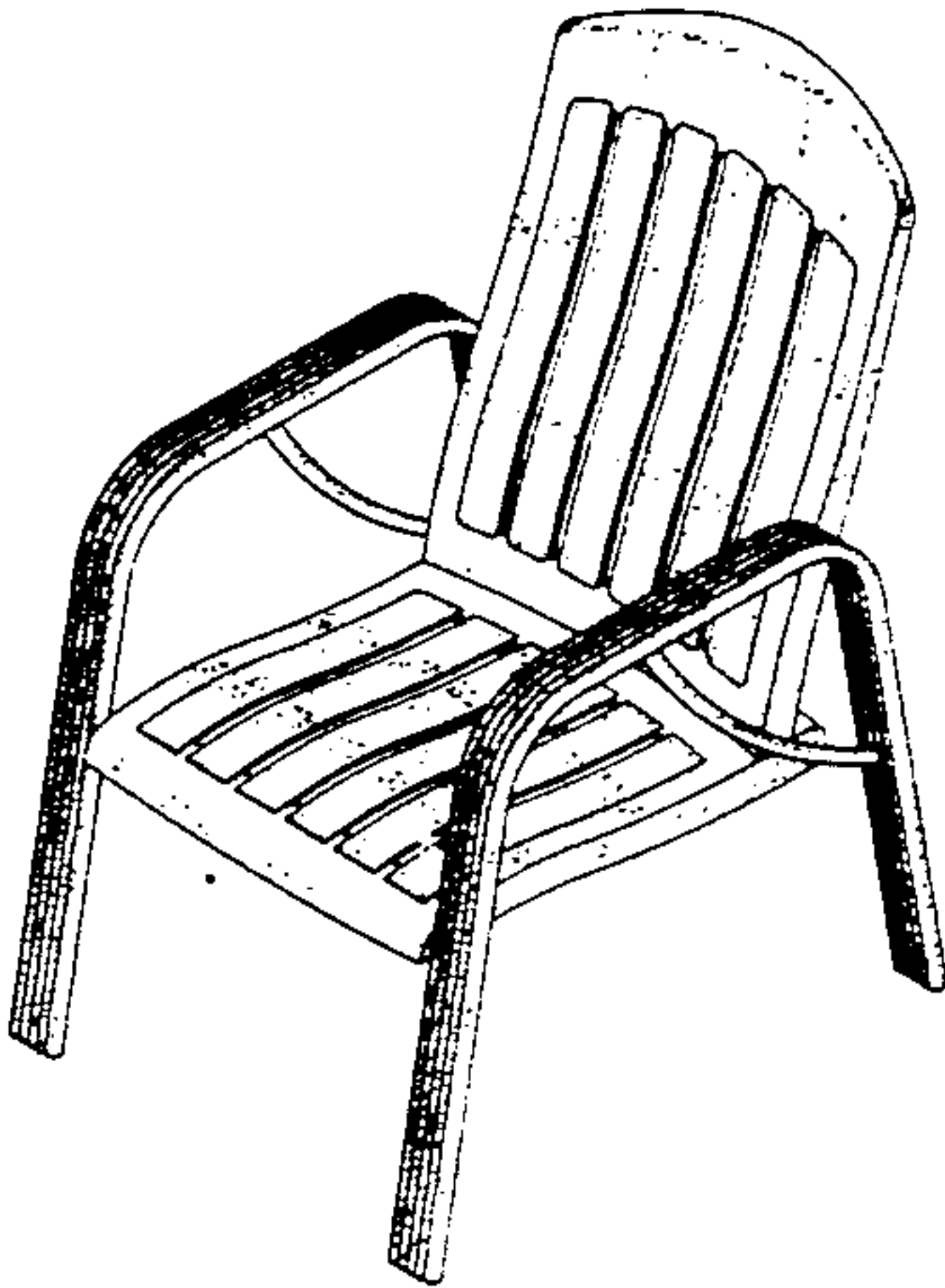

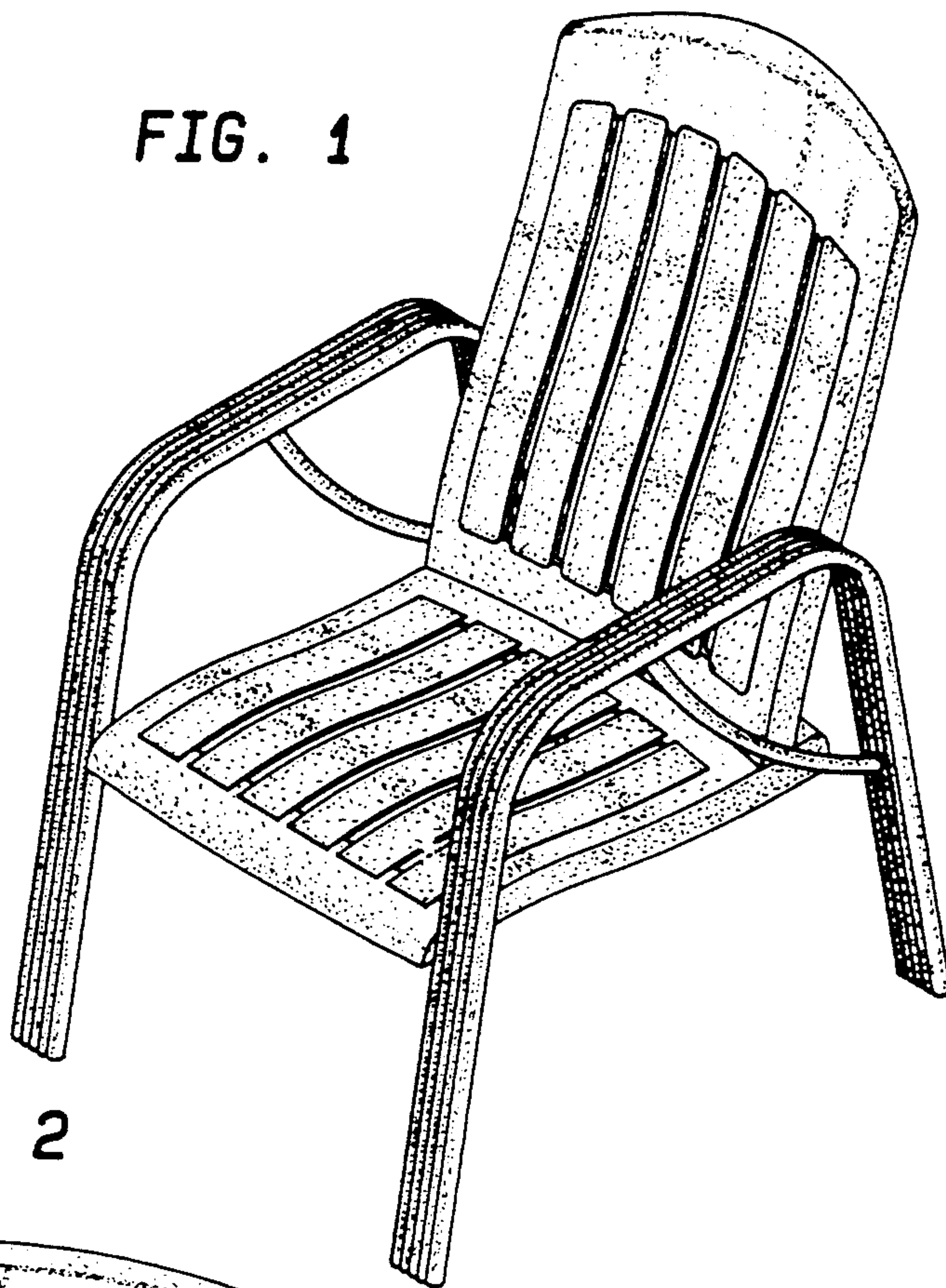

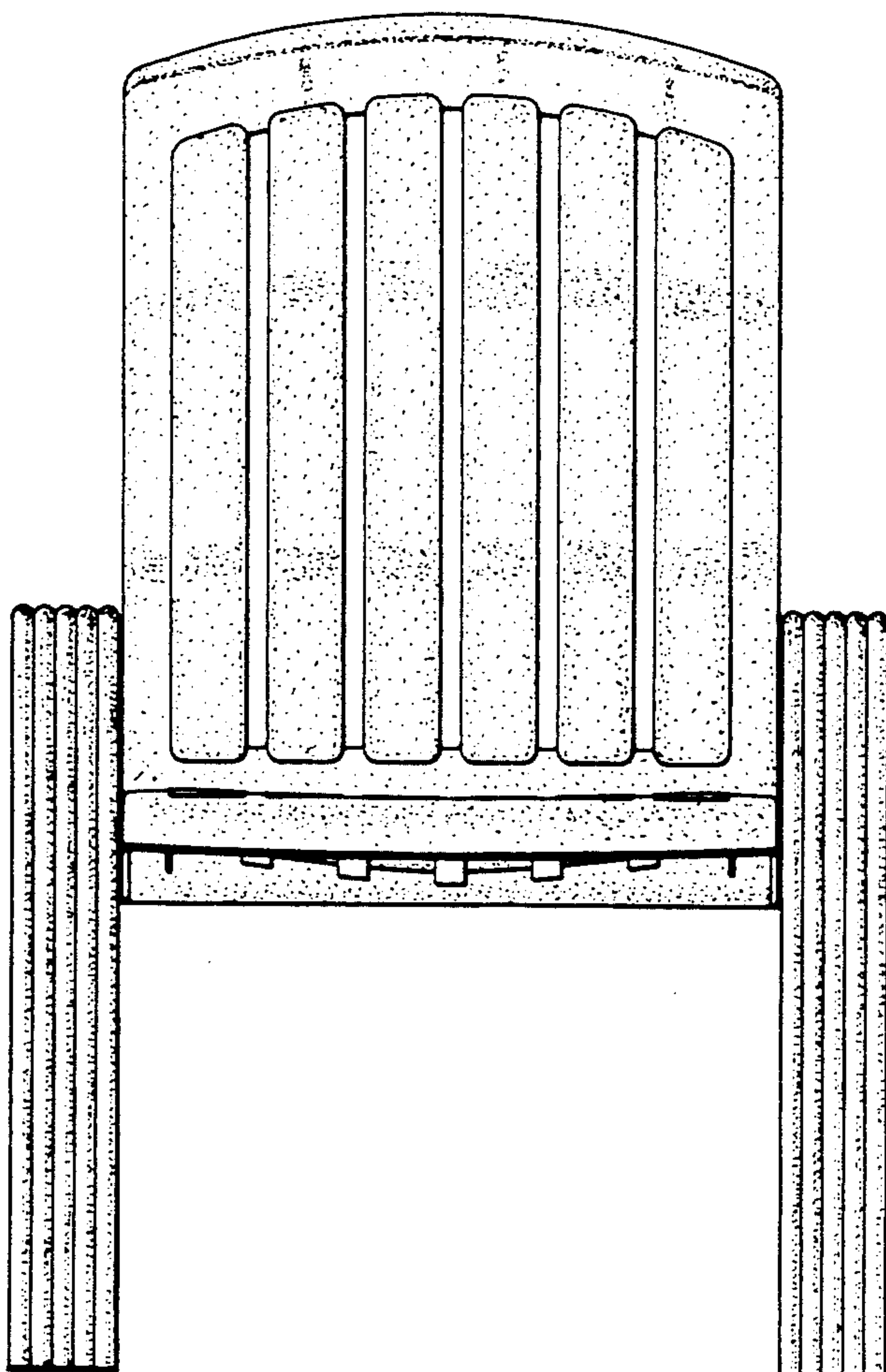

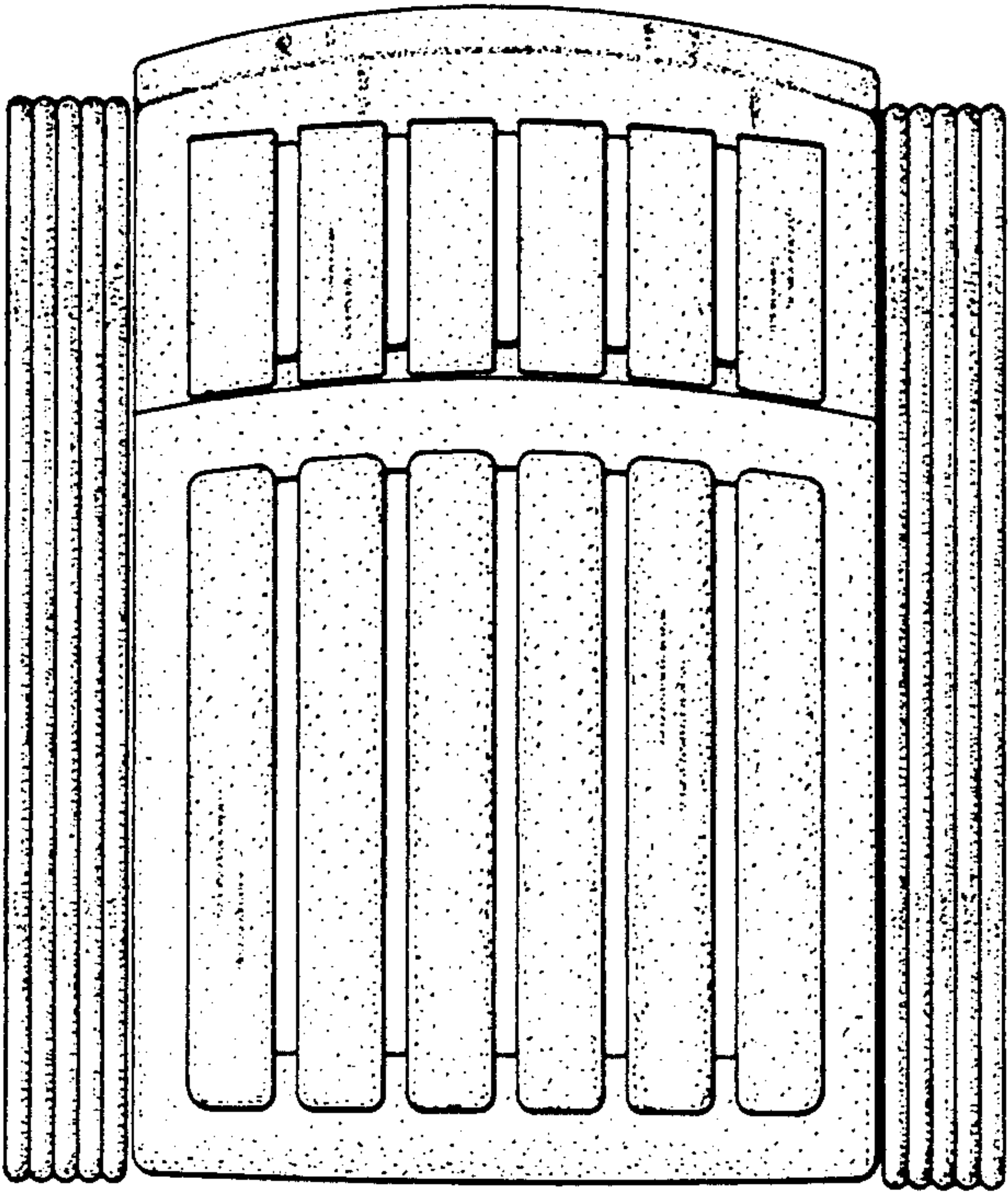

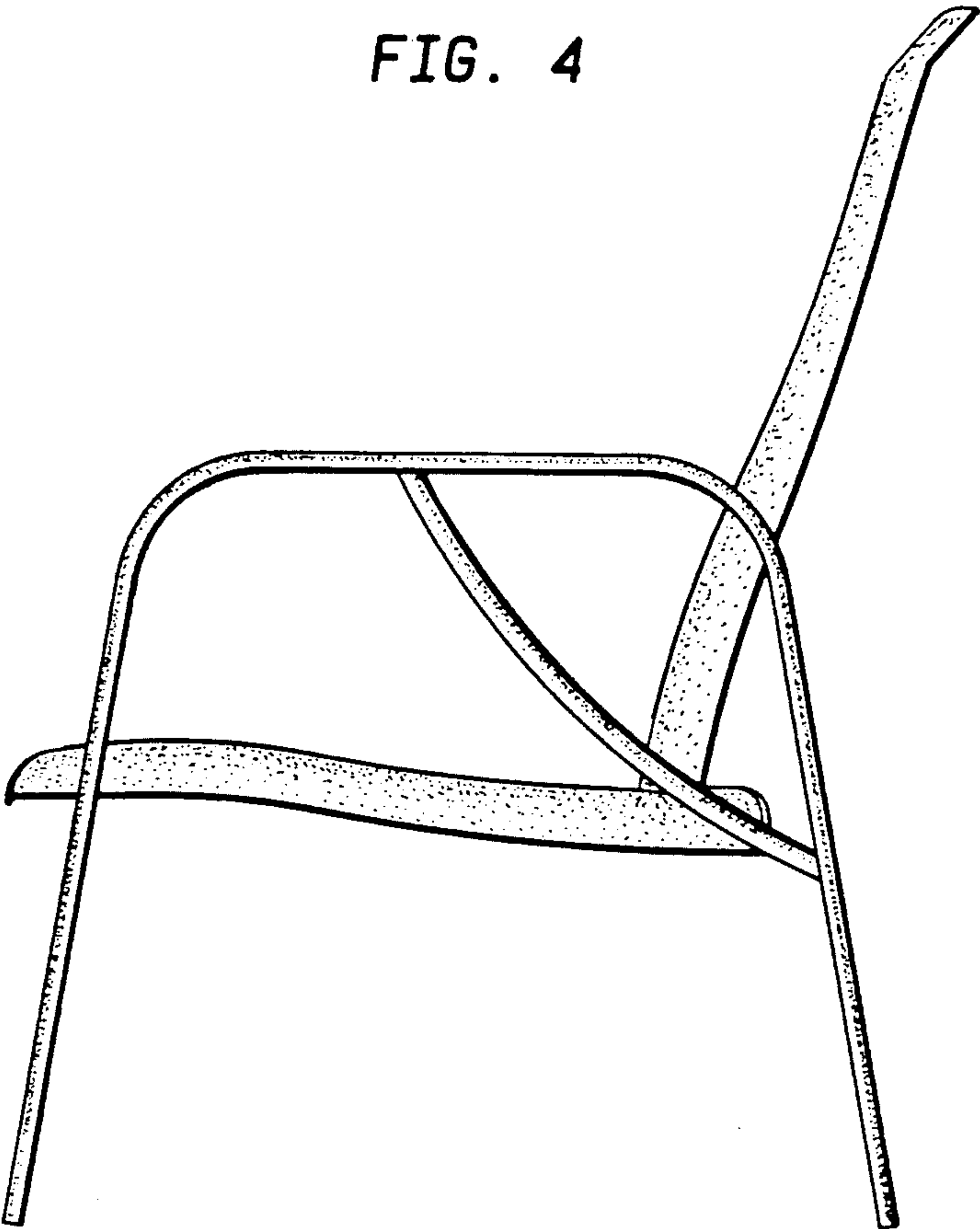

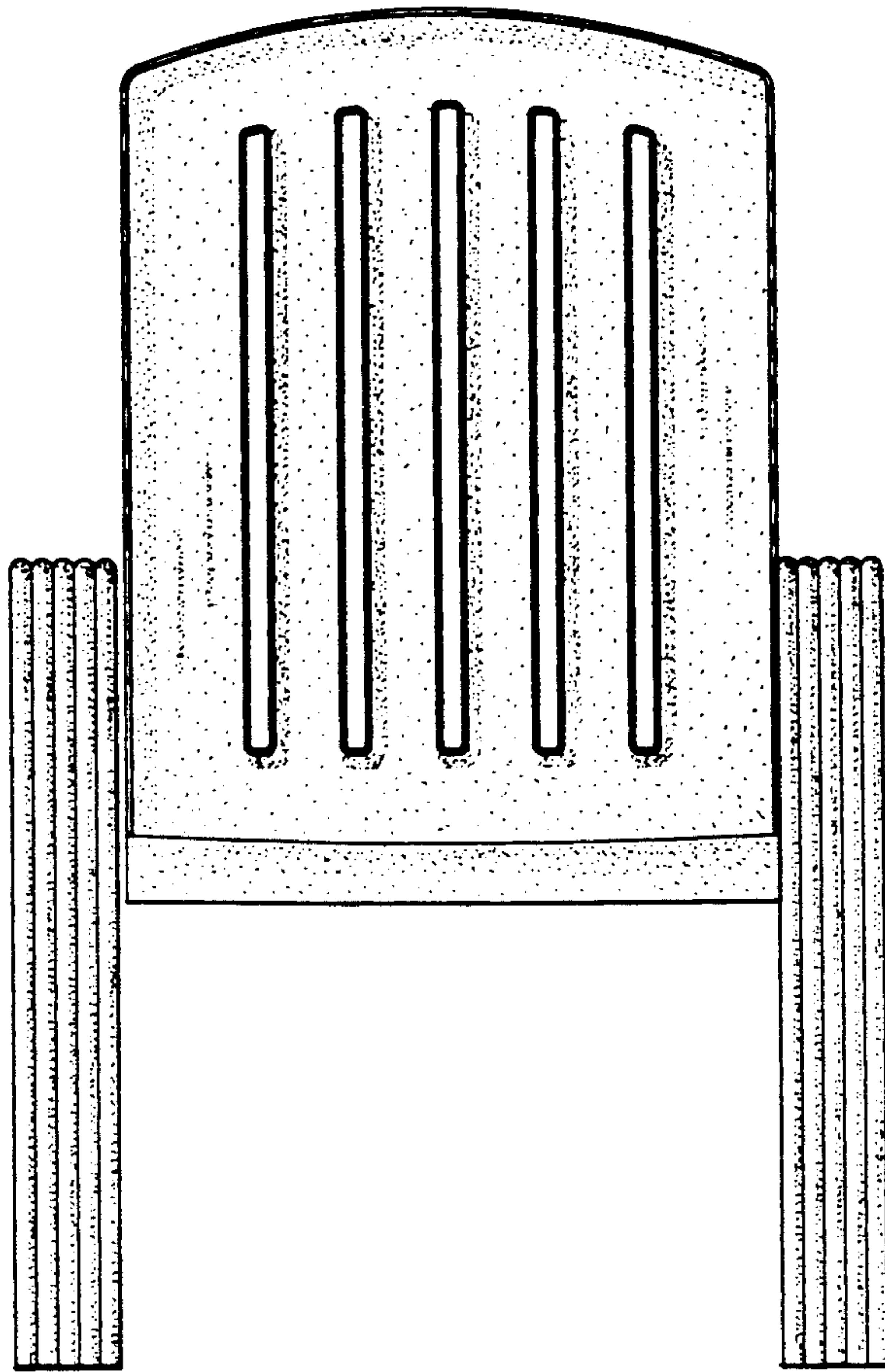

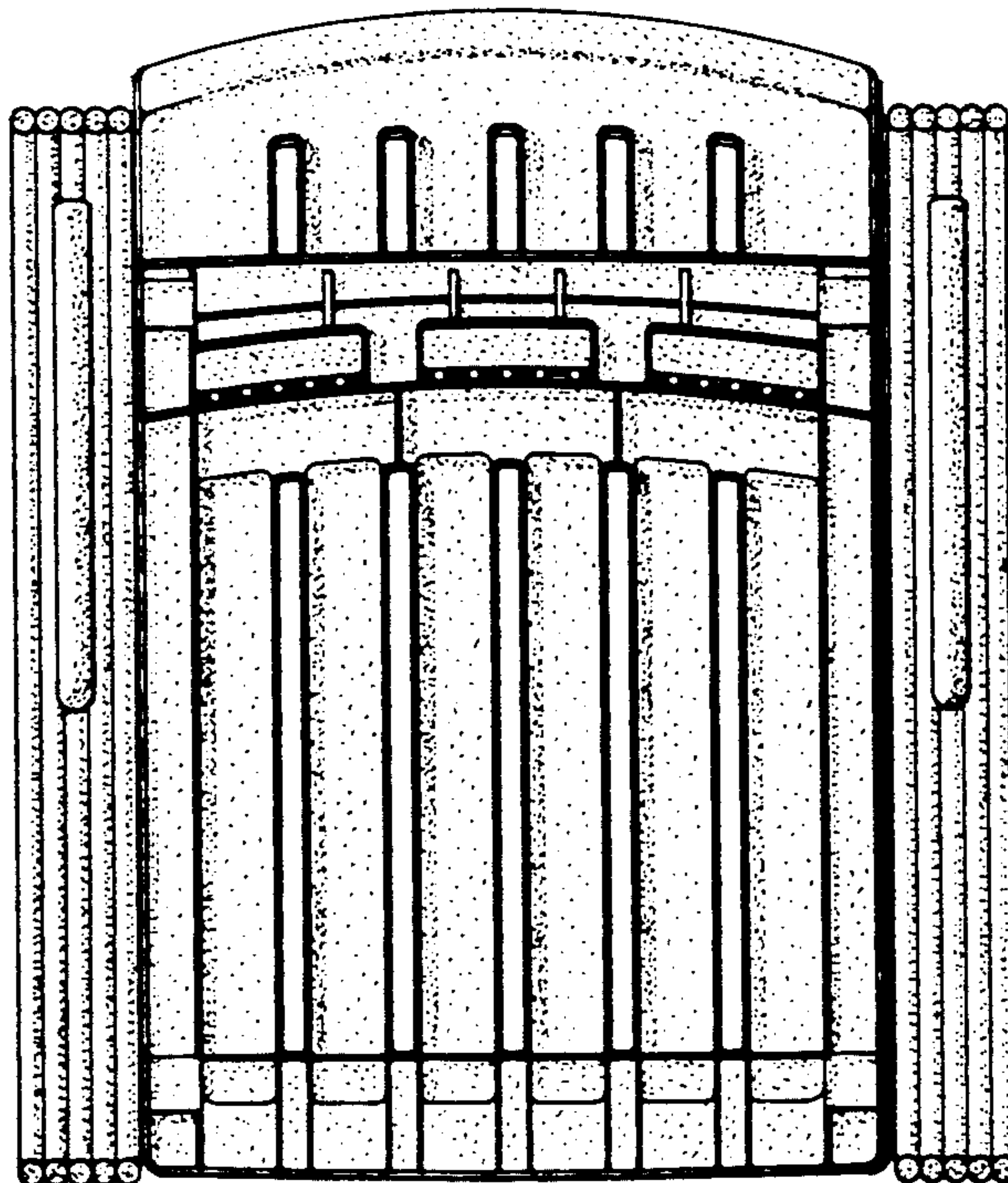

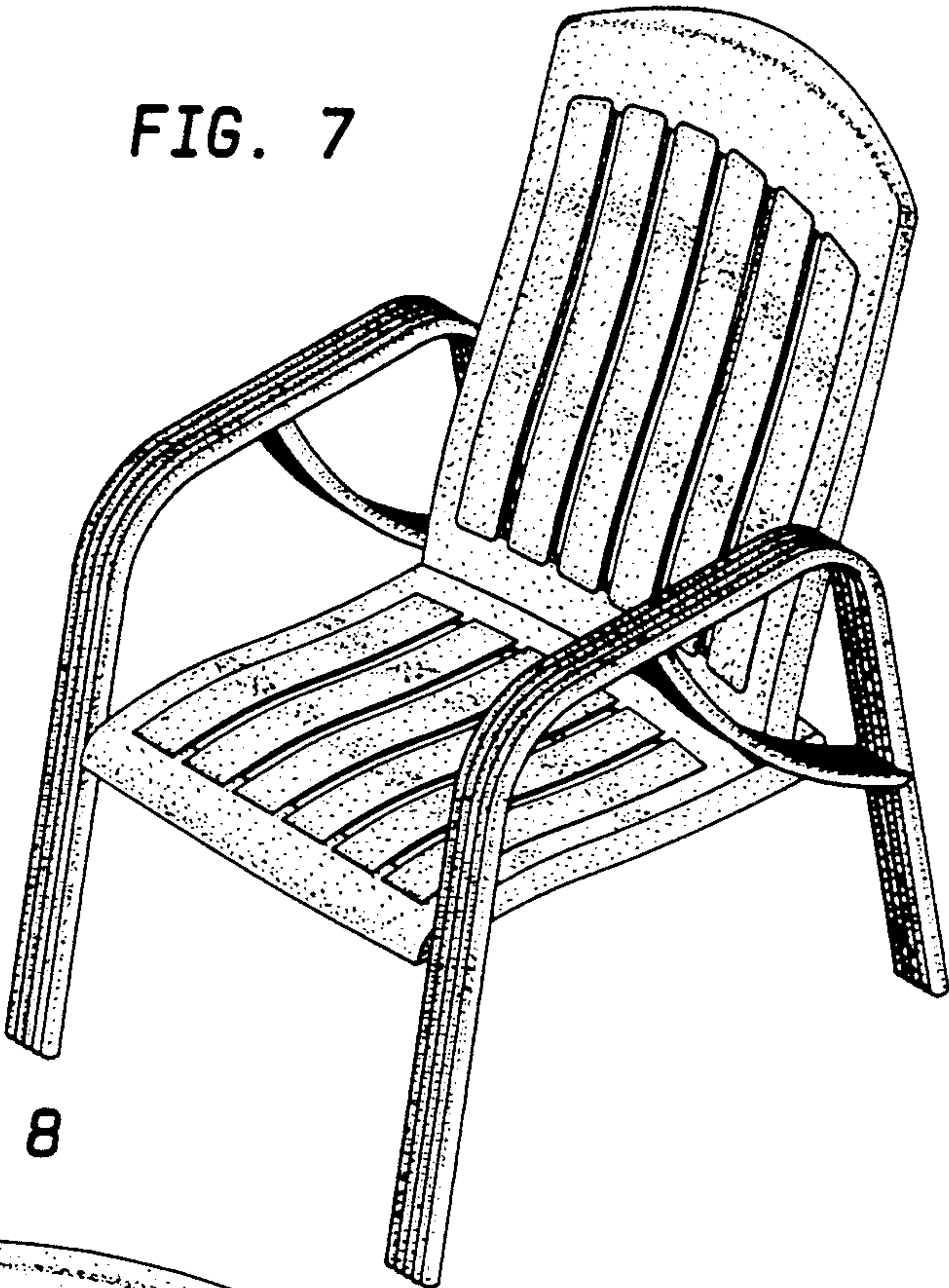

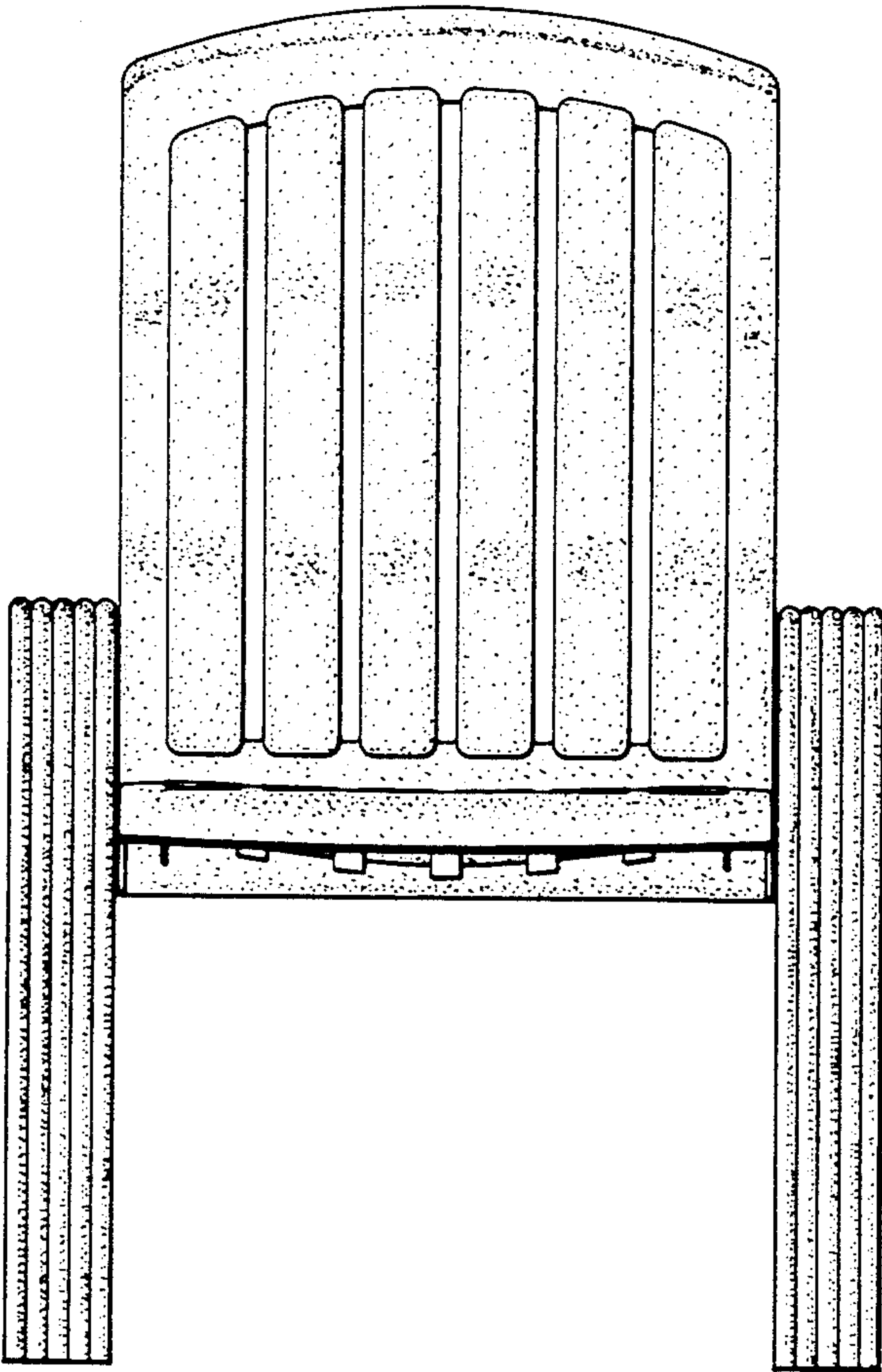

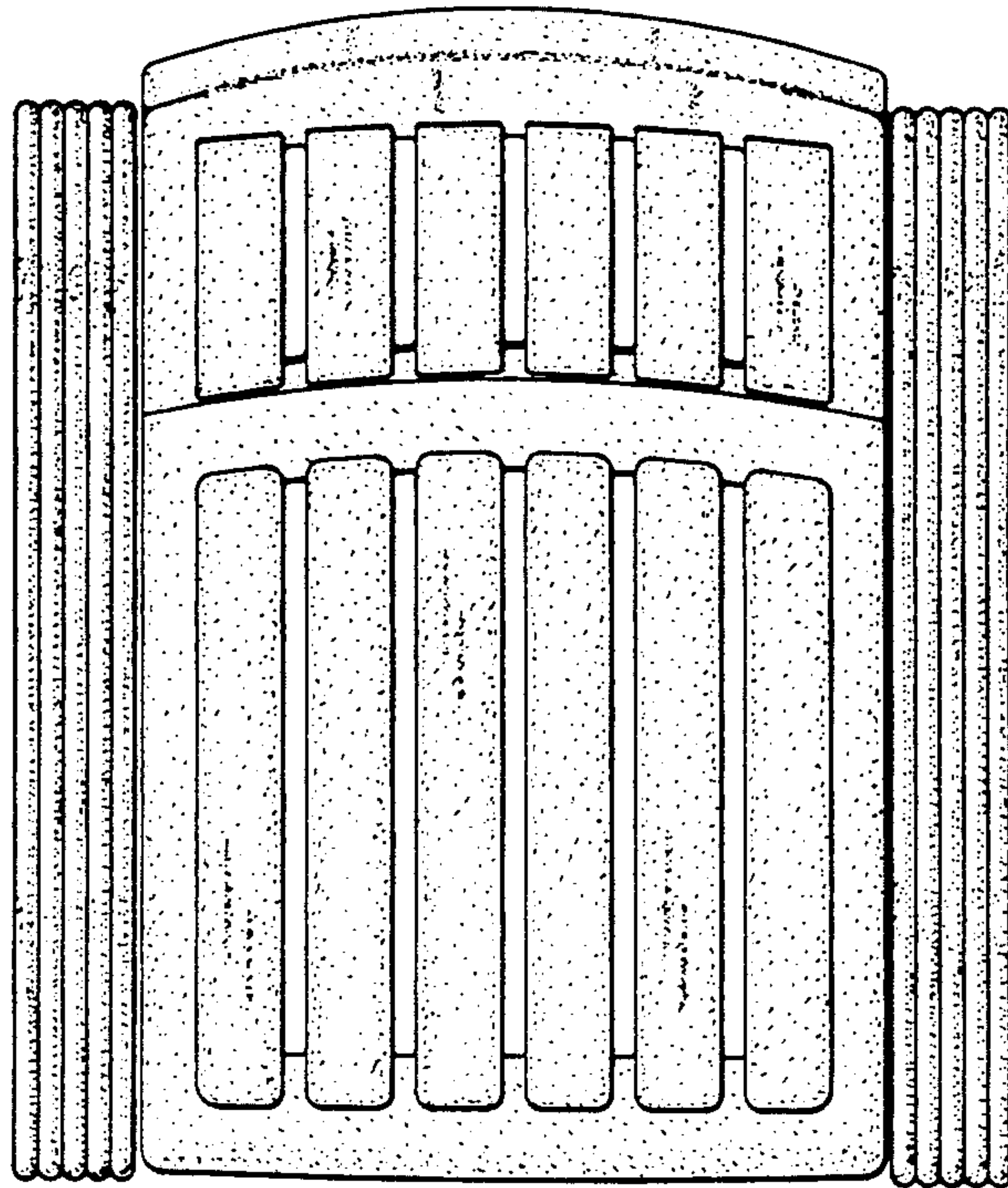

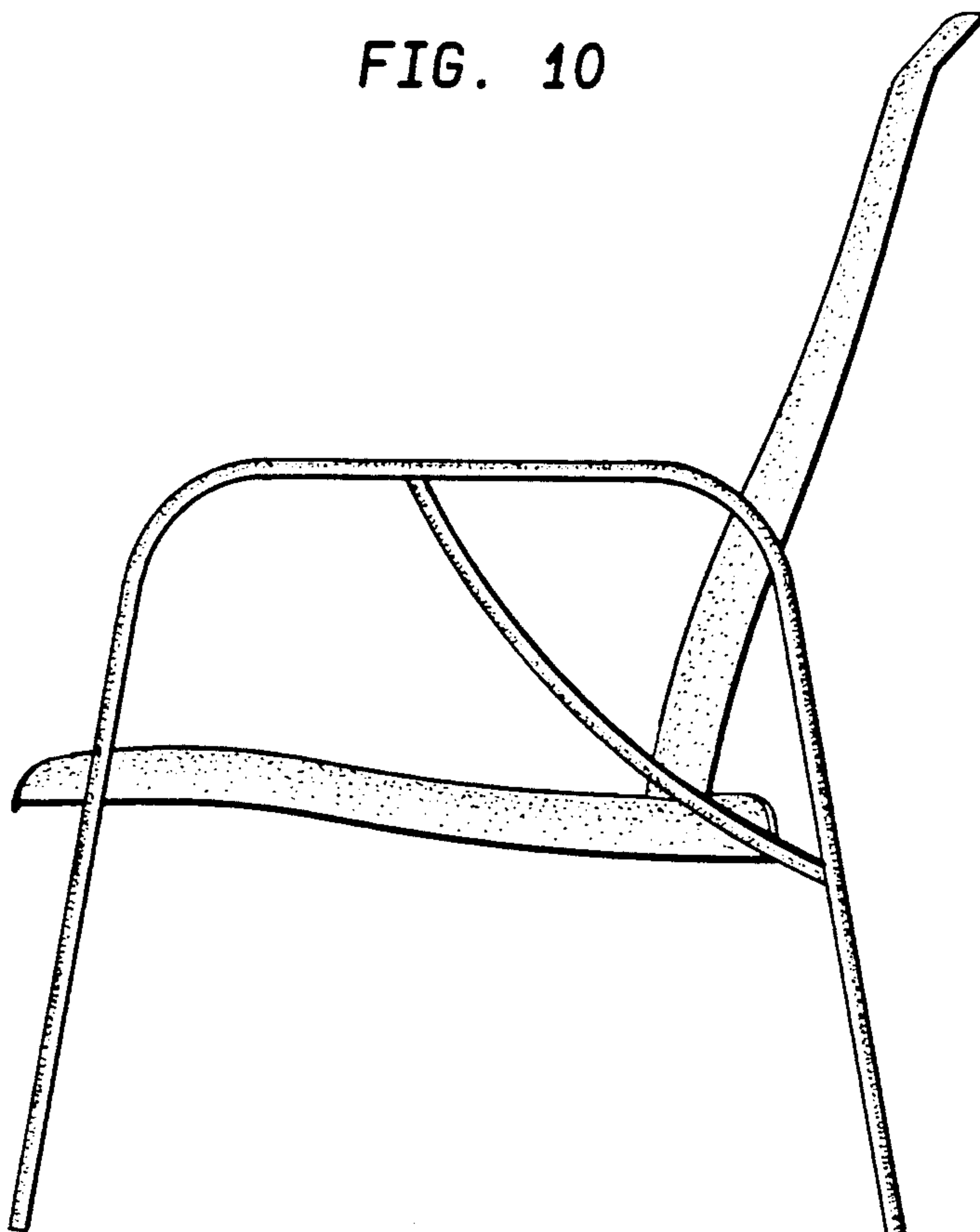

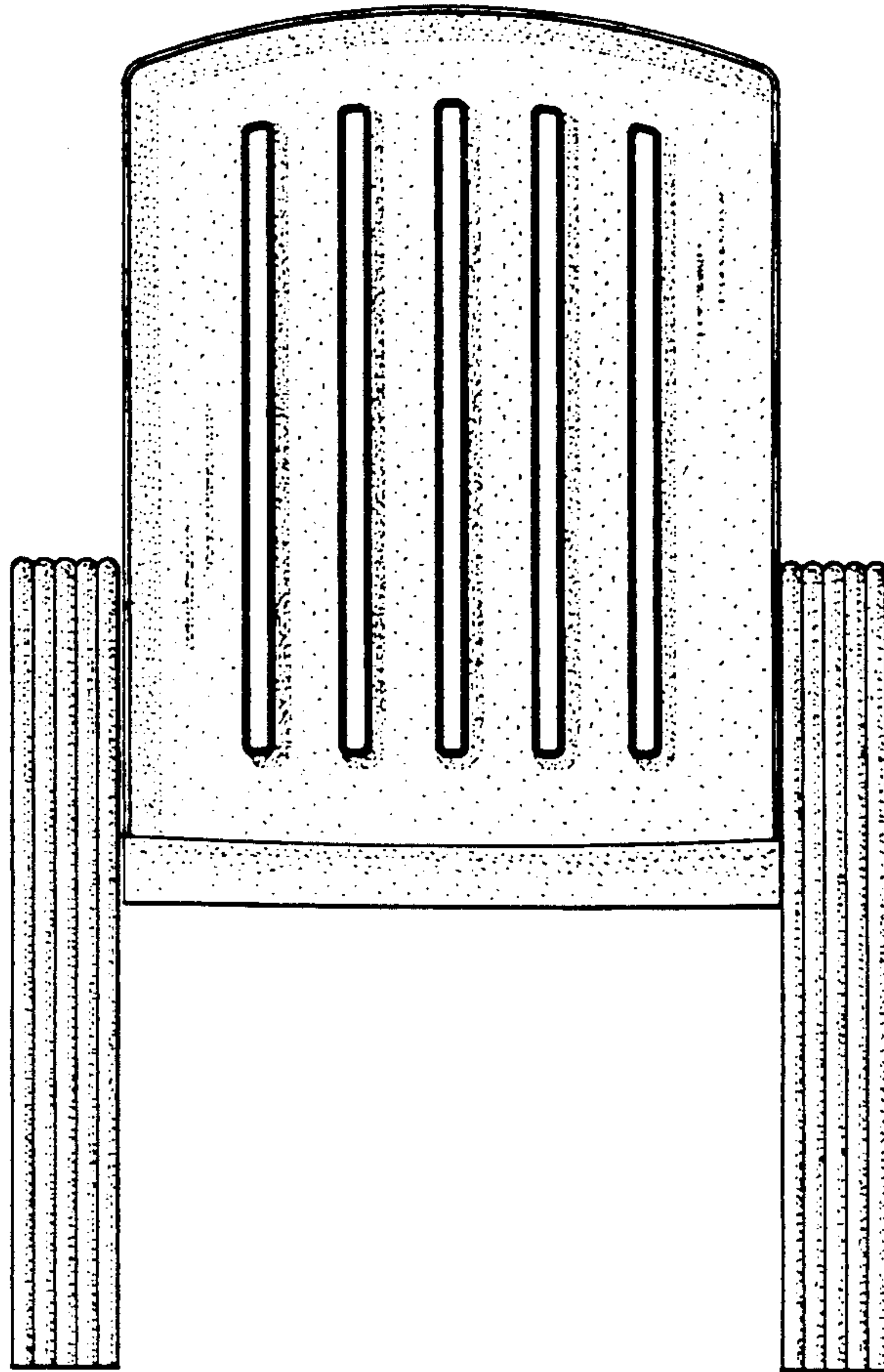

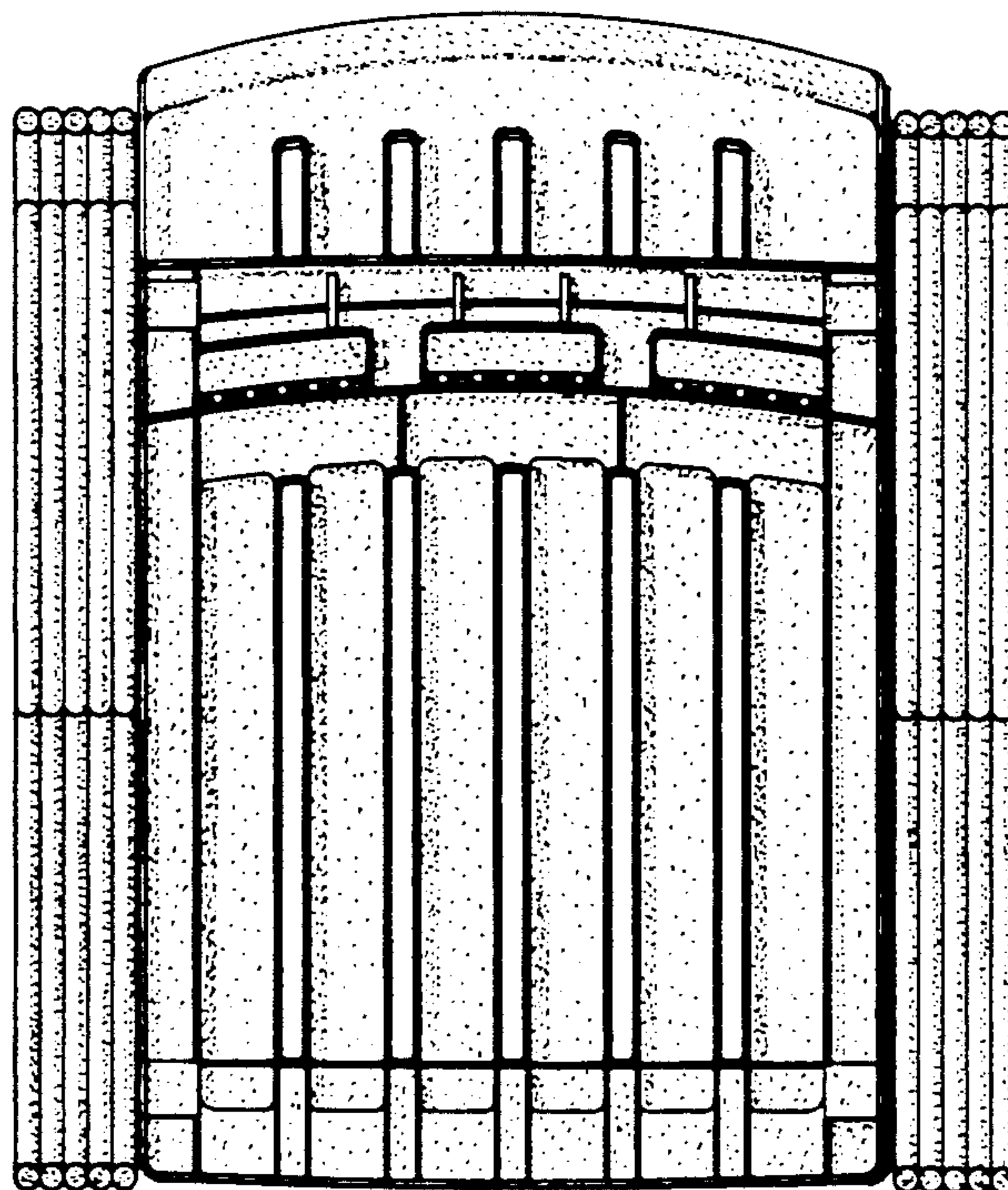

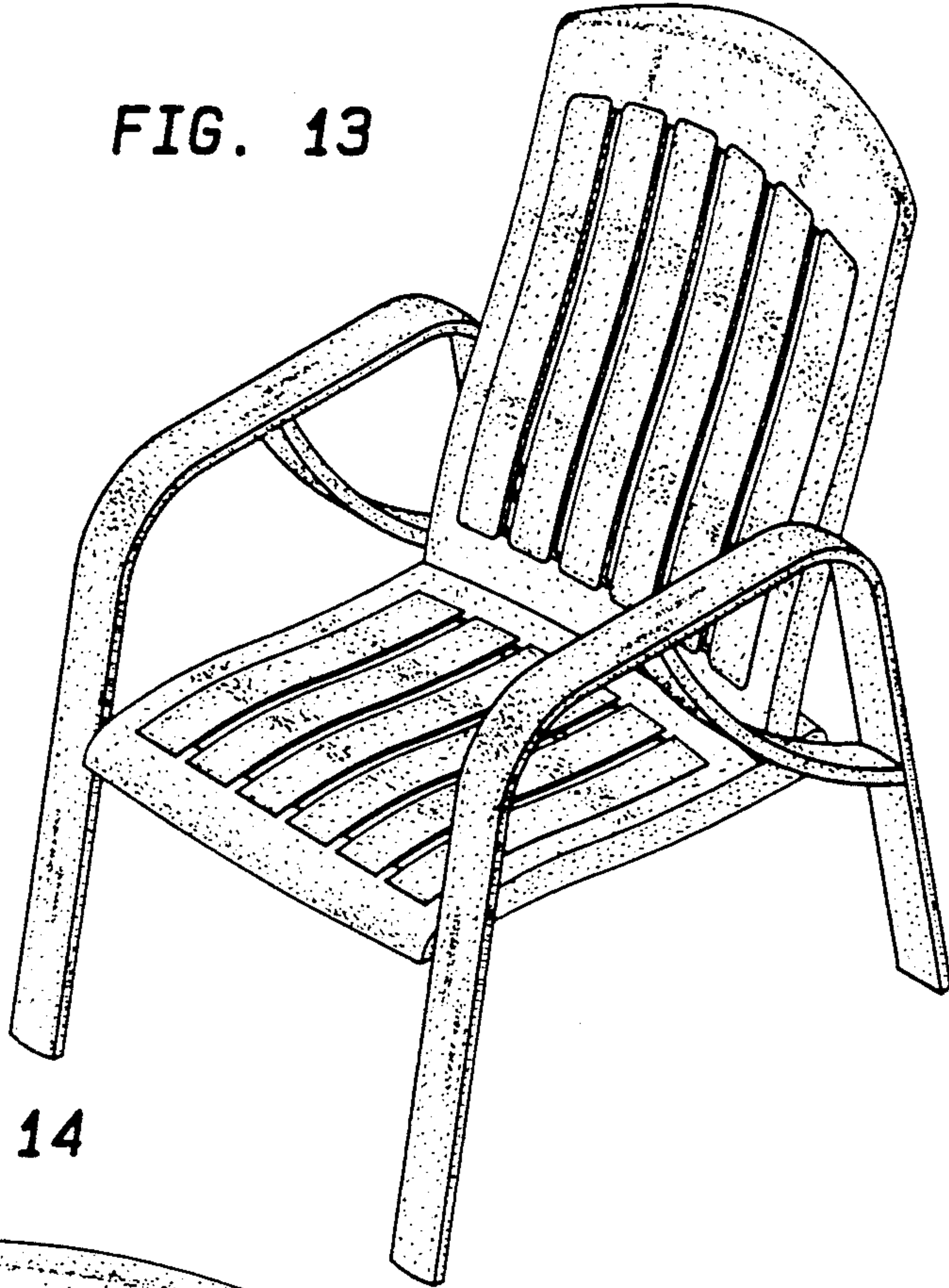

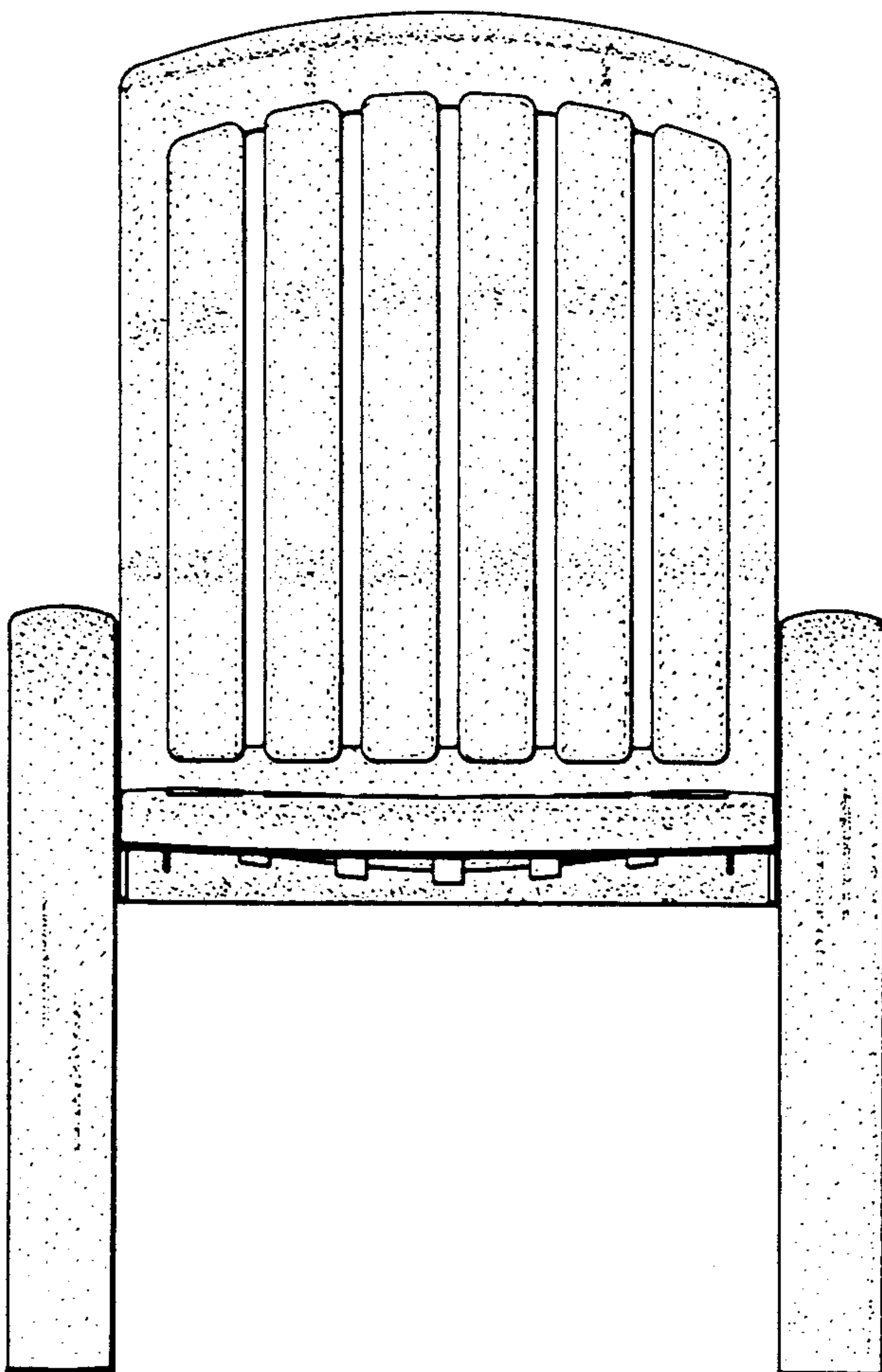

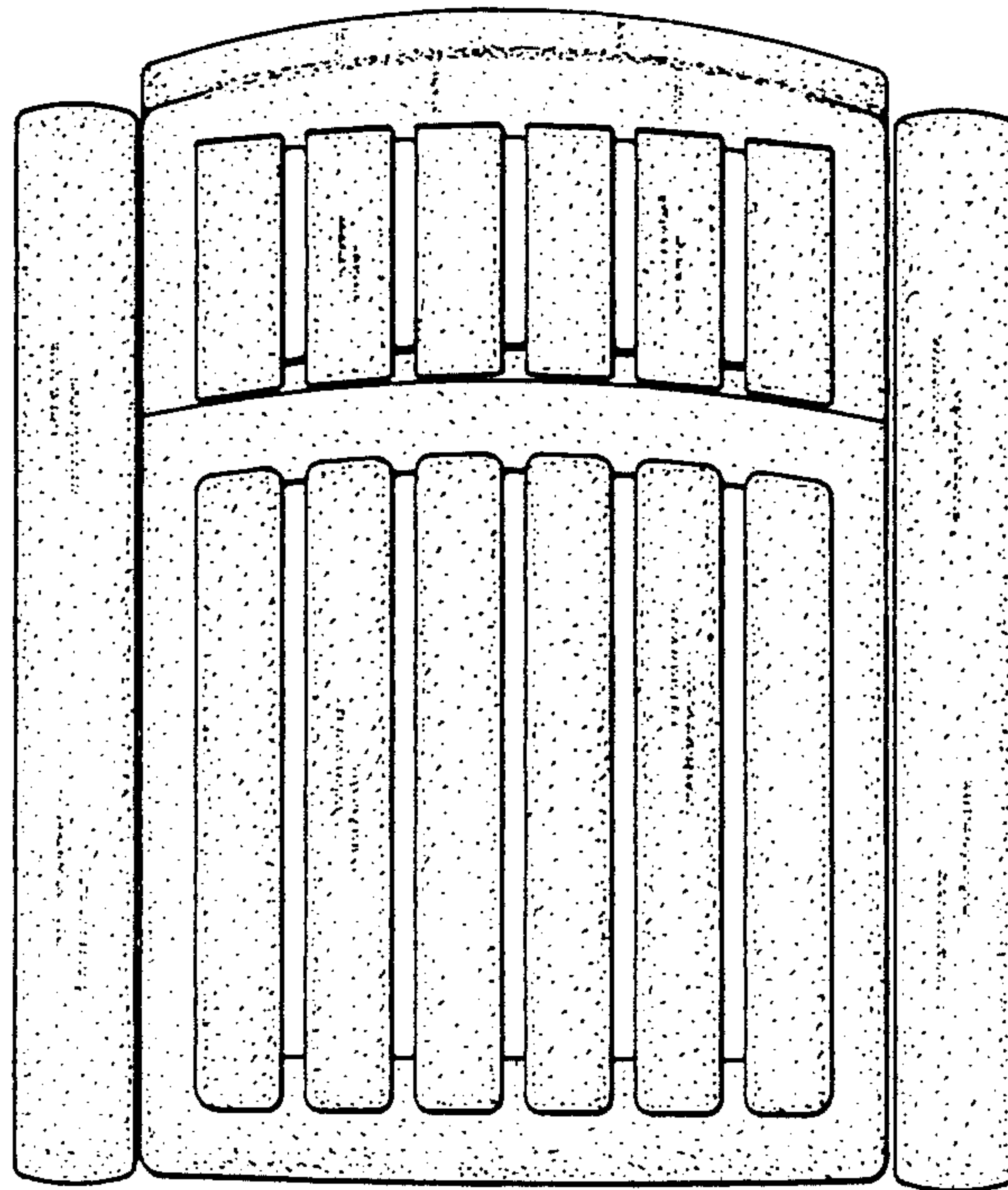

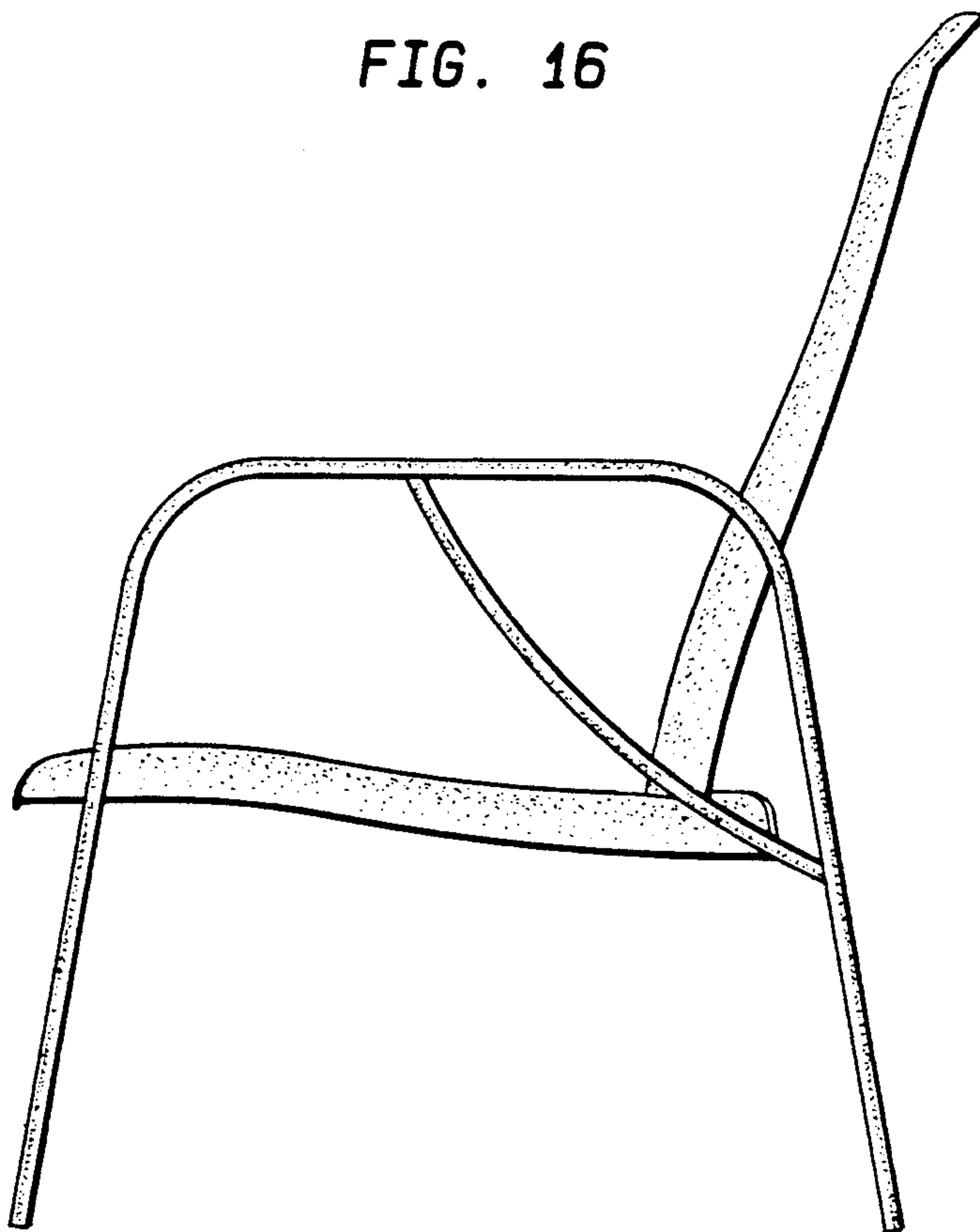

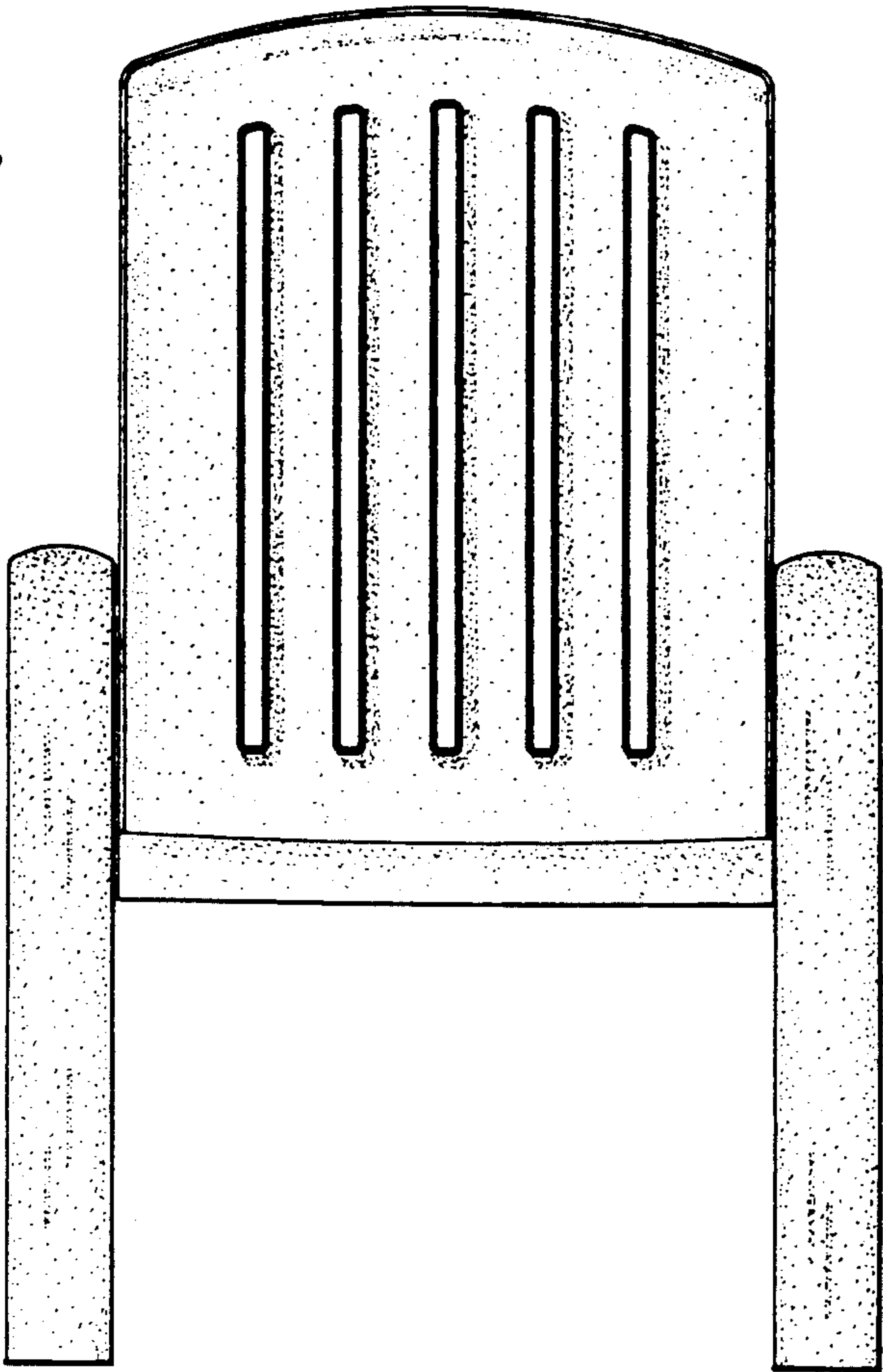

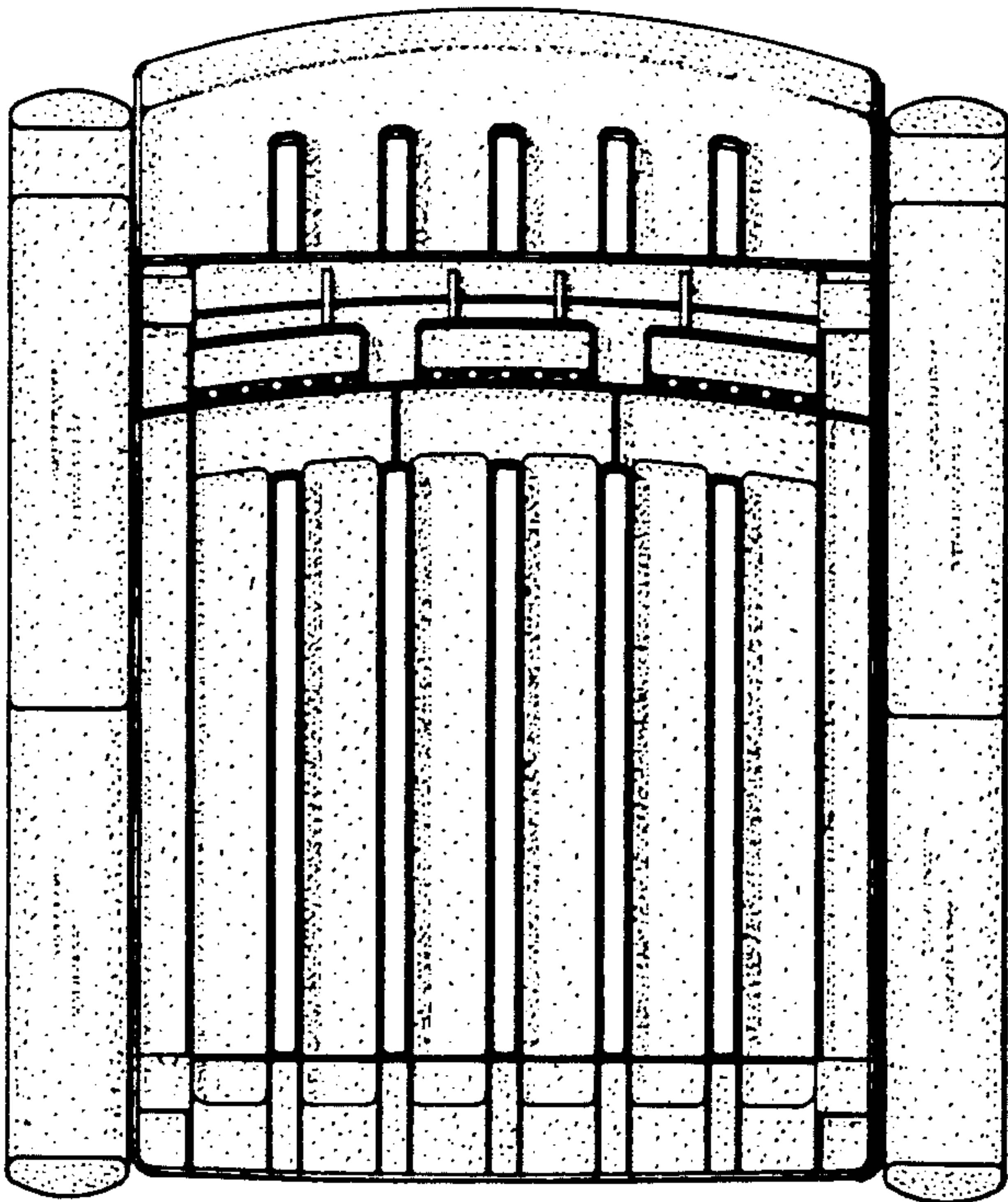

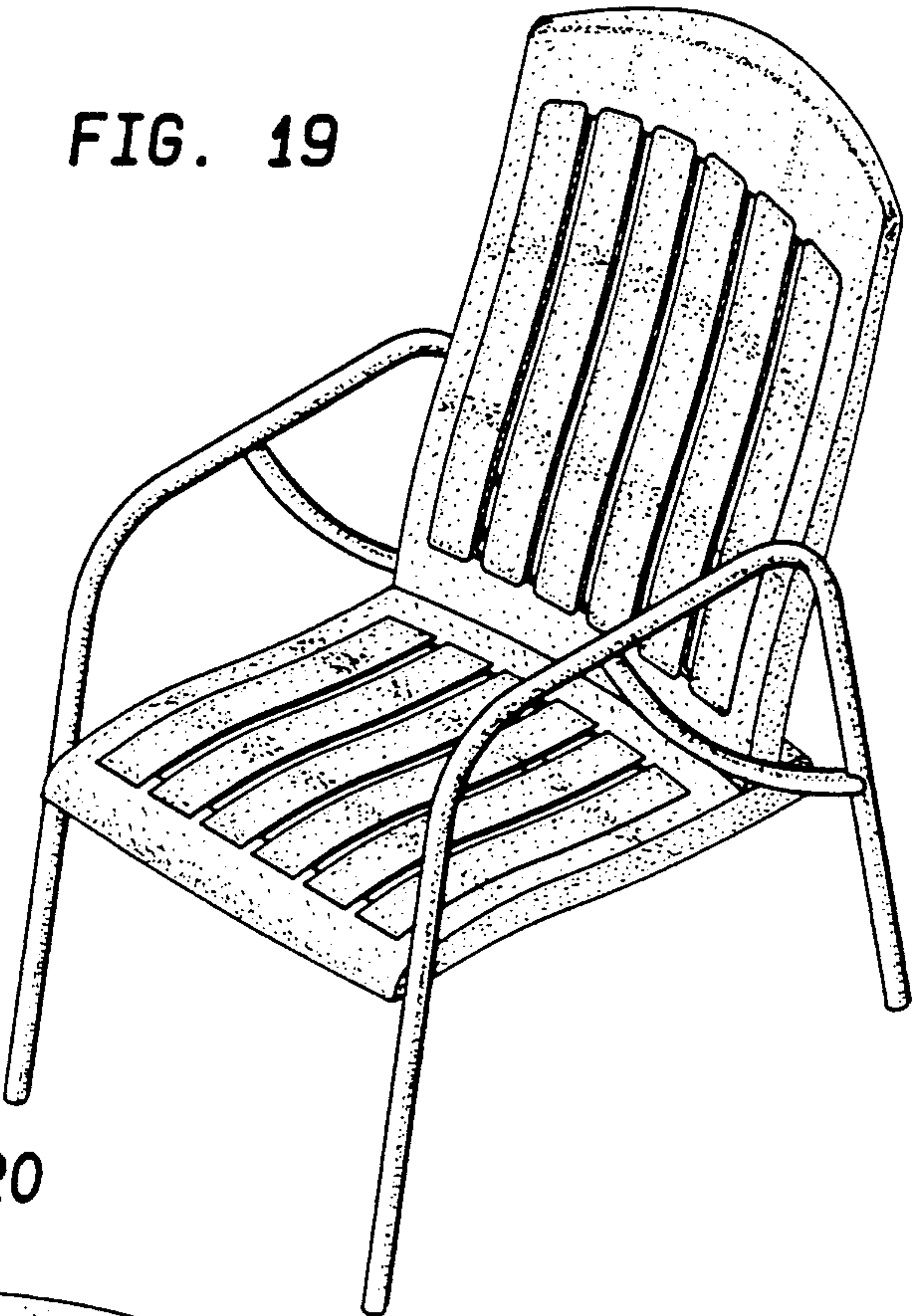

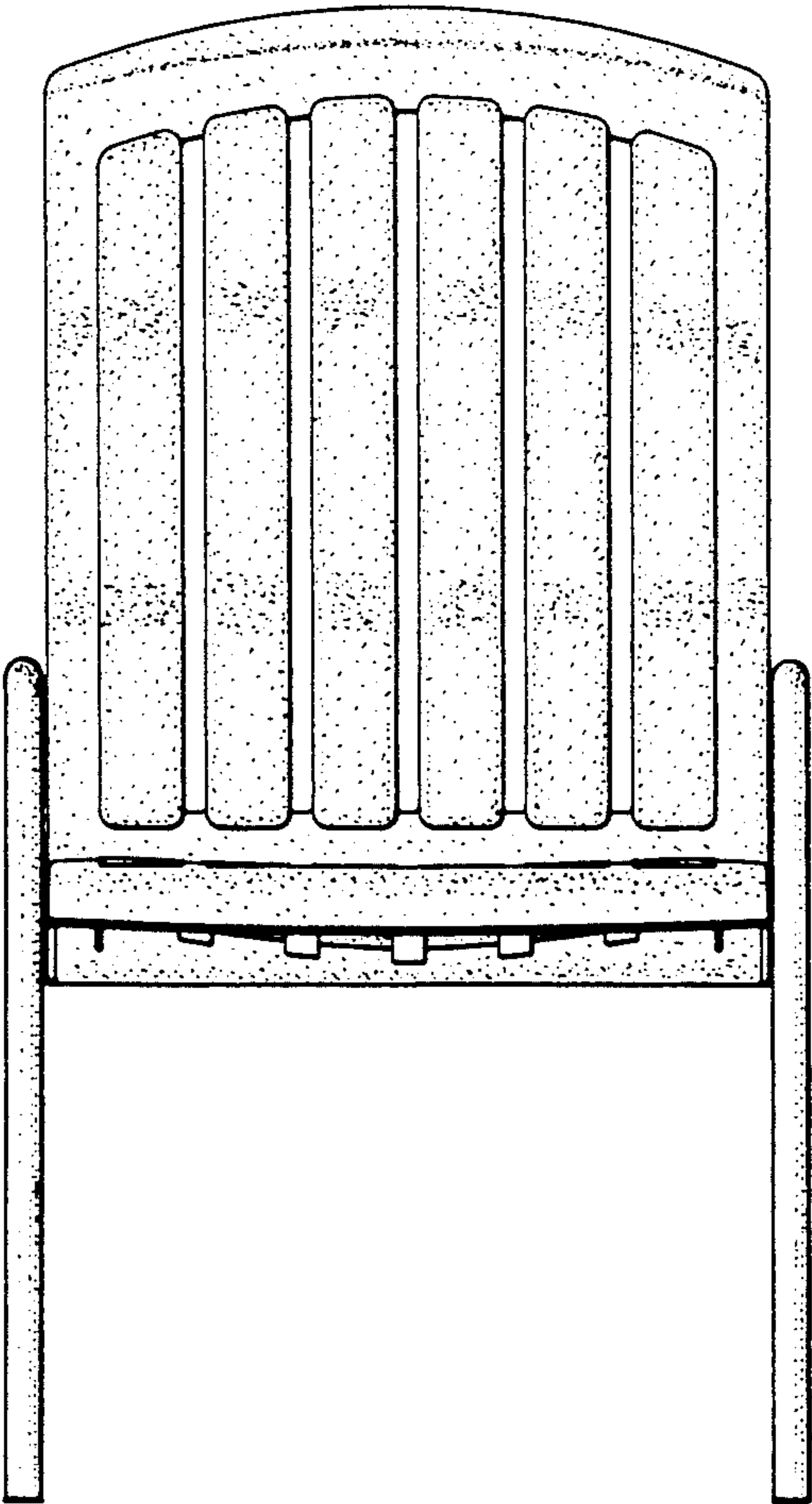

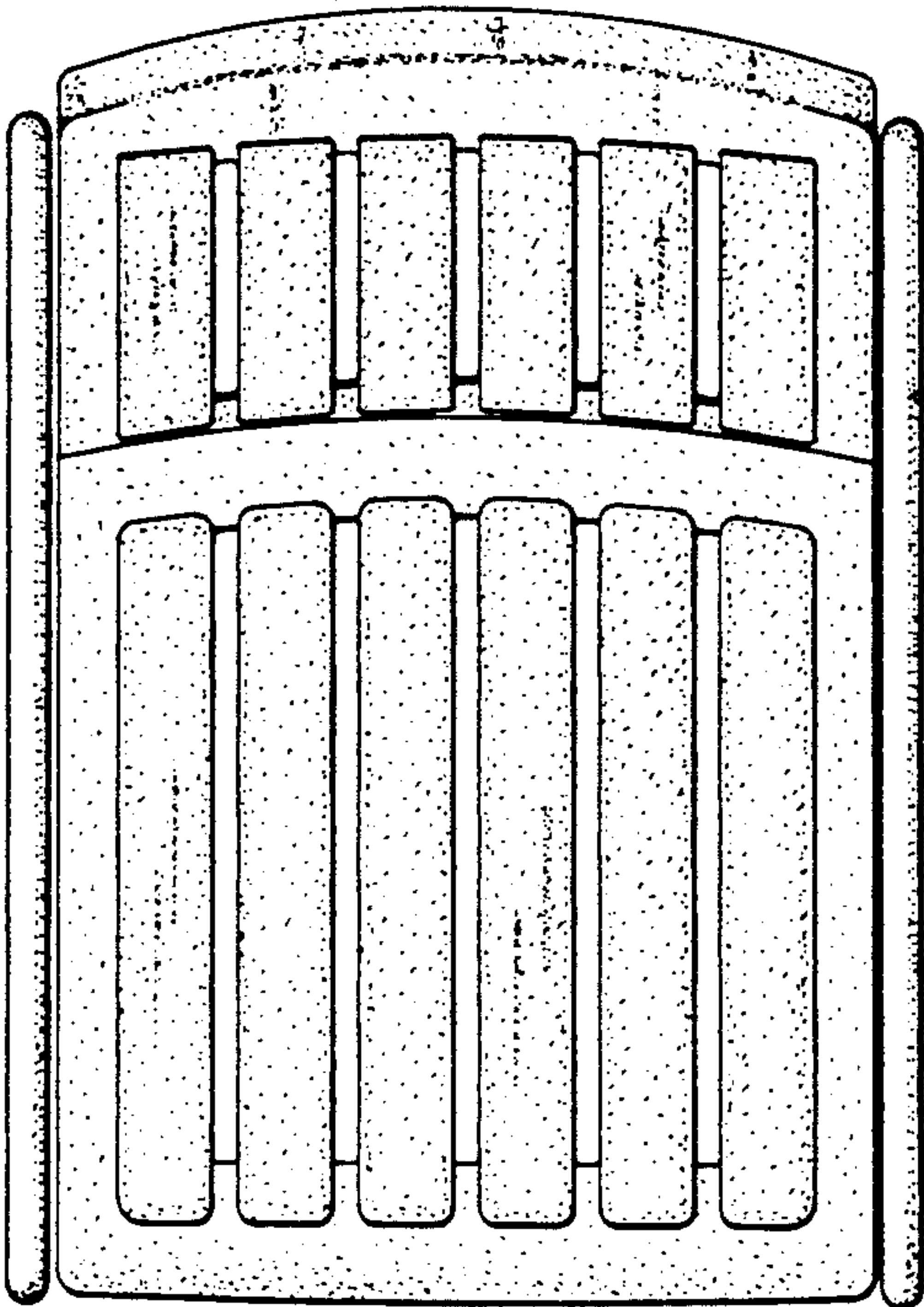

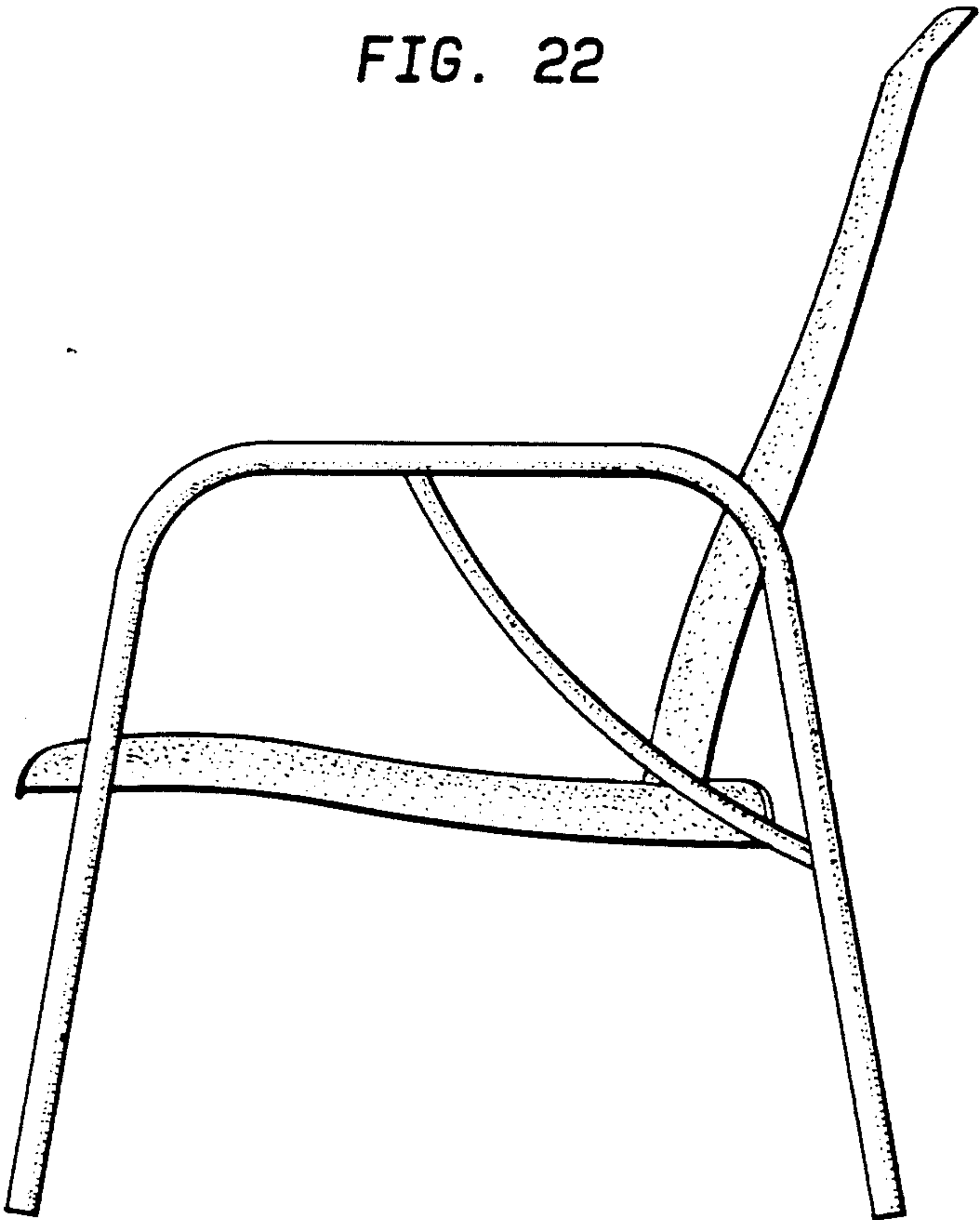

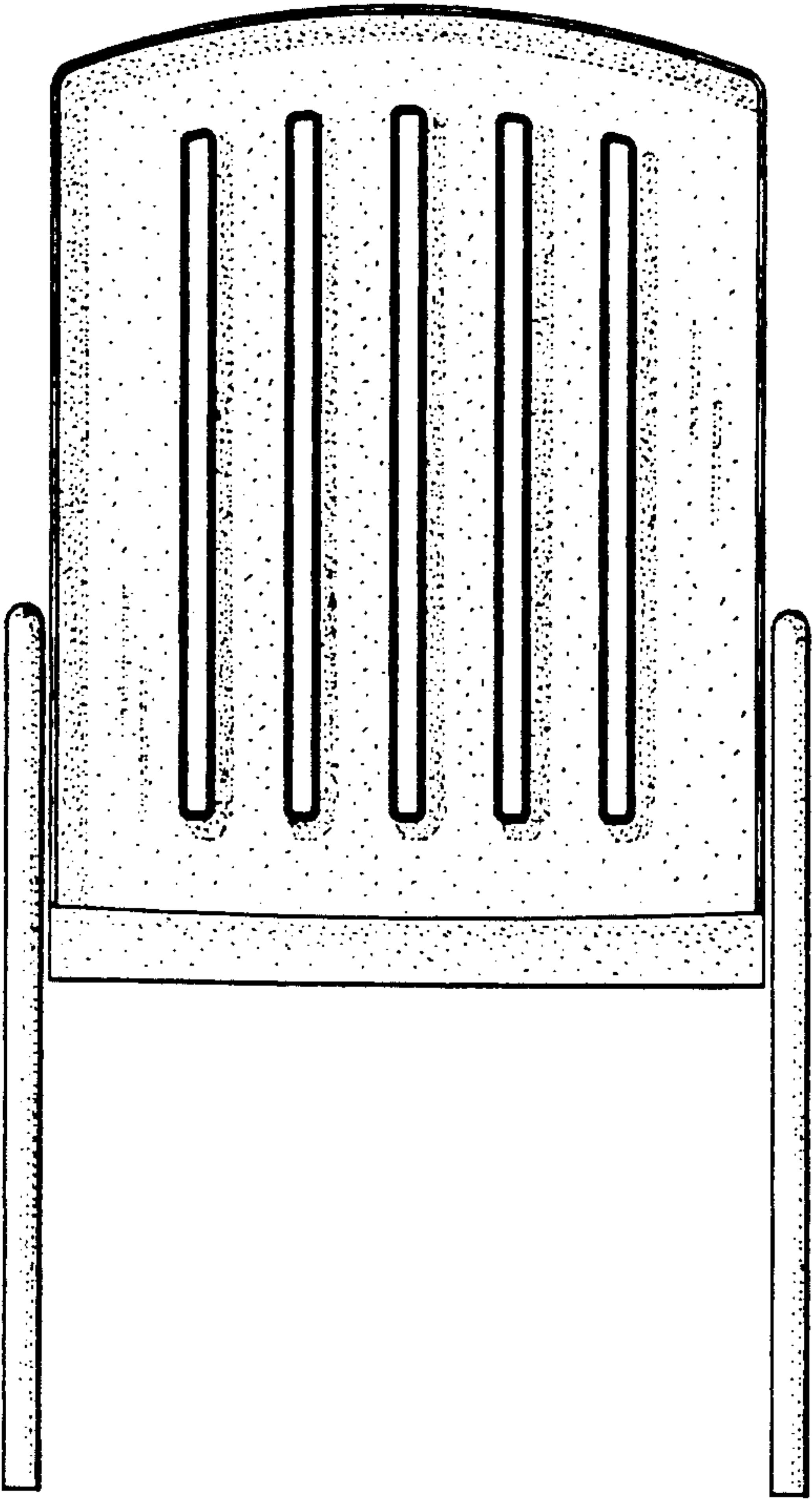
