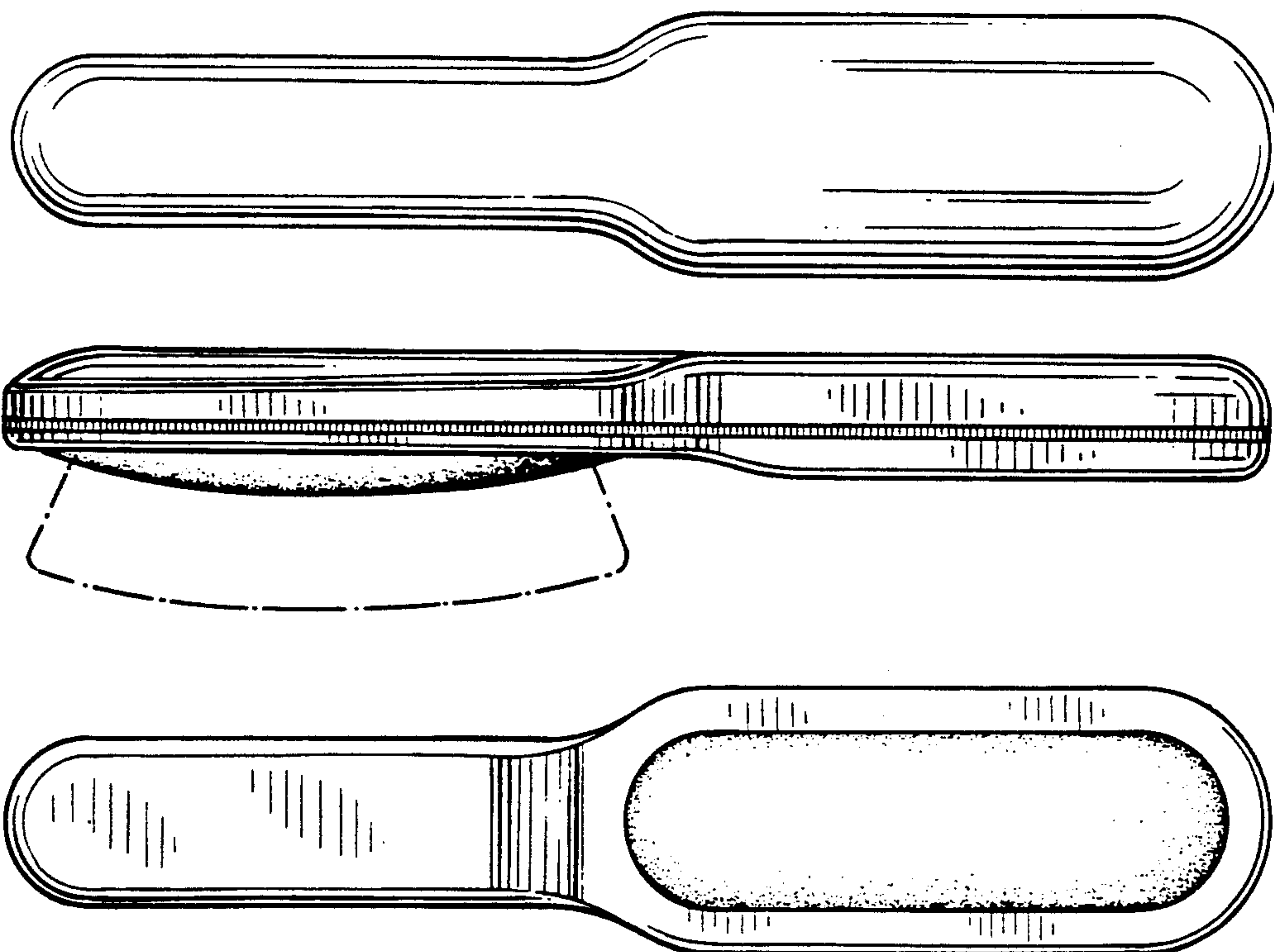

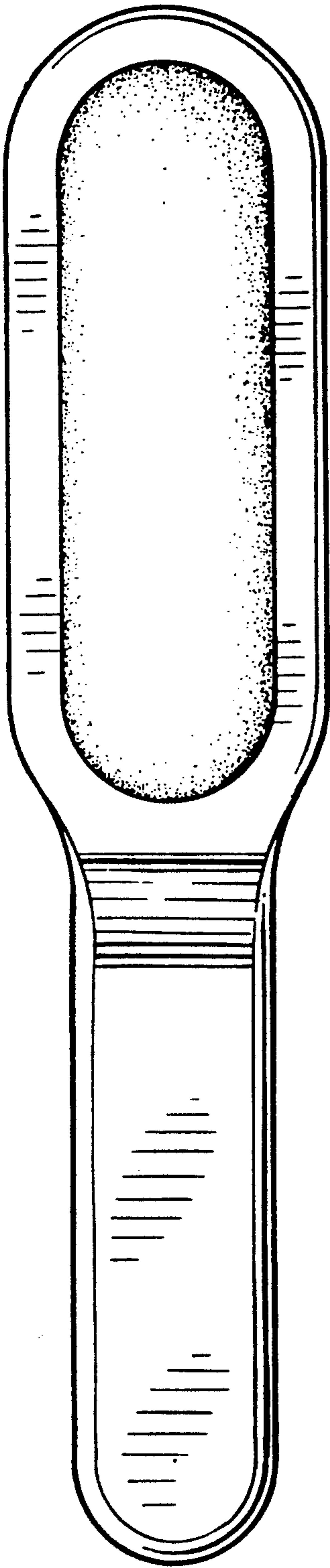
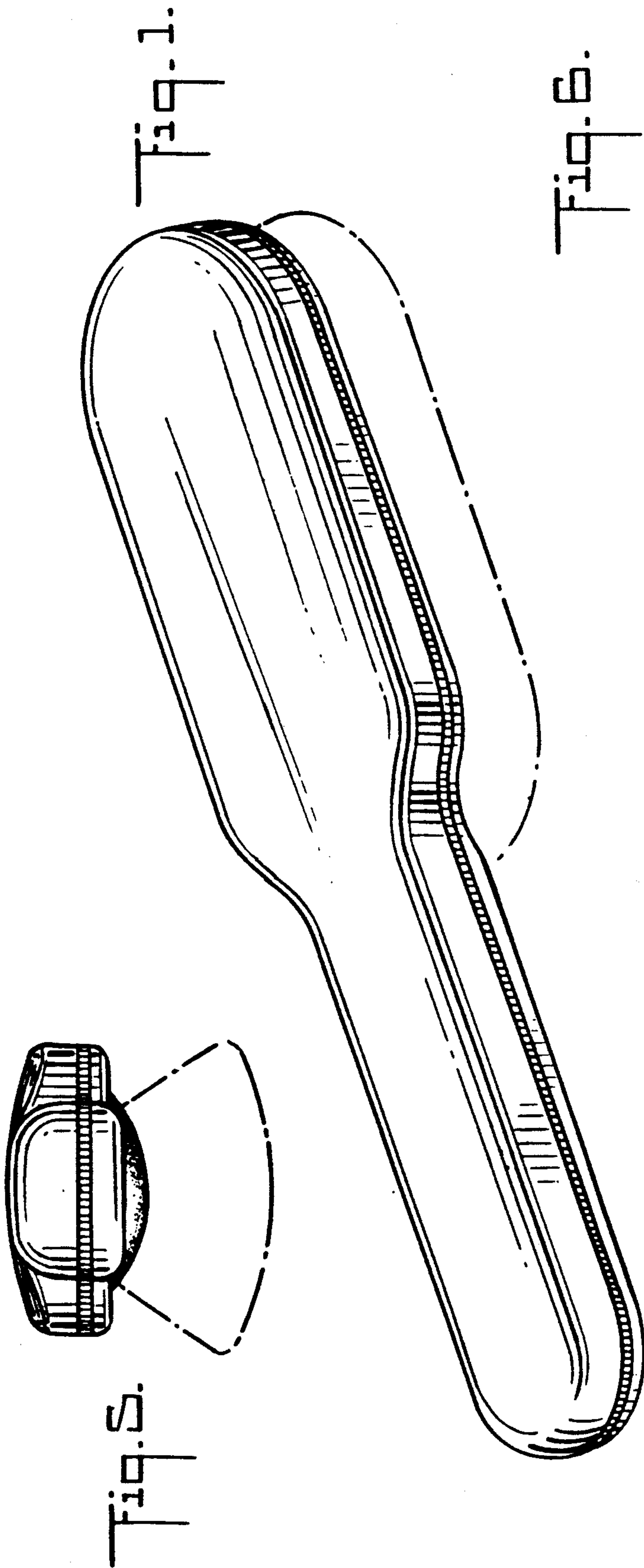
The ornamental design for a hairbrush back and handle unit, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top and right side perspective view of a hairbrush back and handle unit showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is an end elevational view as seen from the left of FIG. 3; FIG. 5 is an elevational view of the opposite end thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of the design shown in FIGS. 1-6; FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image; FIG. 9 is a top plan view of a third embodiment of the design shown in FIGS. 1-6; FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image; FIG. 11 is a perspective view as seen from the bottom and right end of FIG. 8; FIG. 12 is an end elevational view as seen from the left of FIG. 8; FIG. 13 is a perspective view as seen from the bottom and right end of FIG. 10; and, FIG. 14 is an end elevational view as seen from the left of FIG. 10.

The broken line showing of bristles is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.





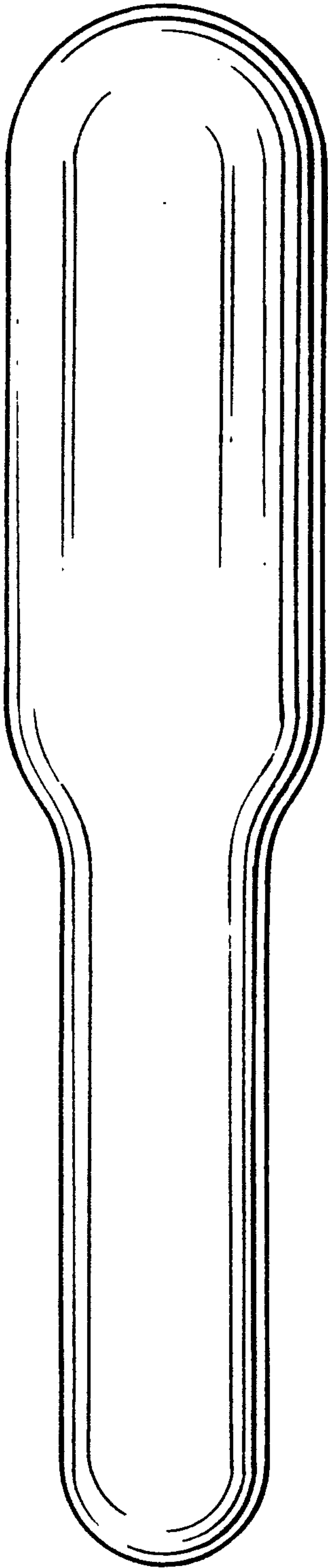

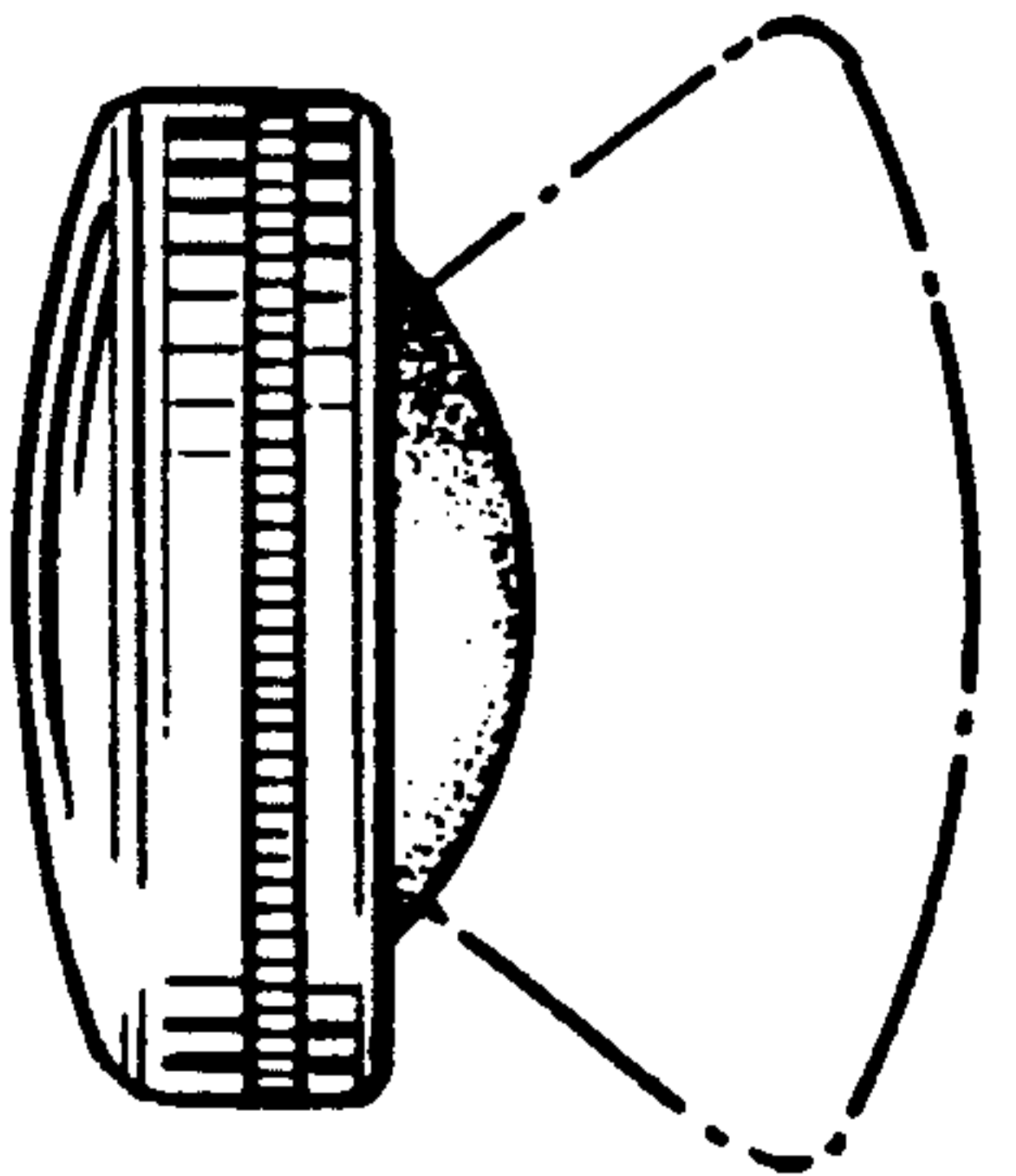
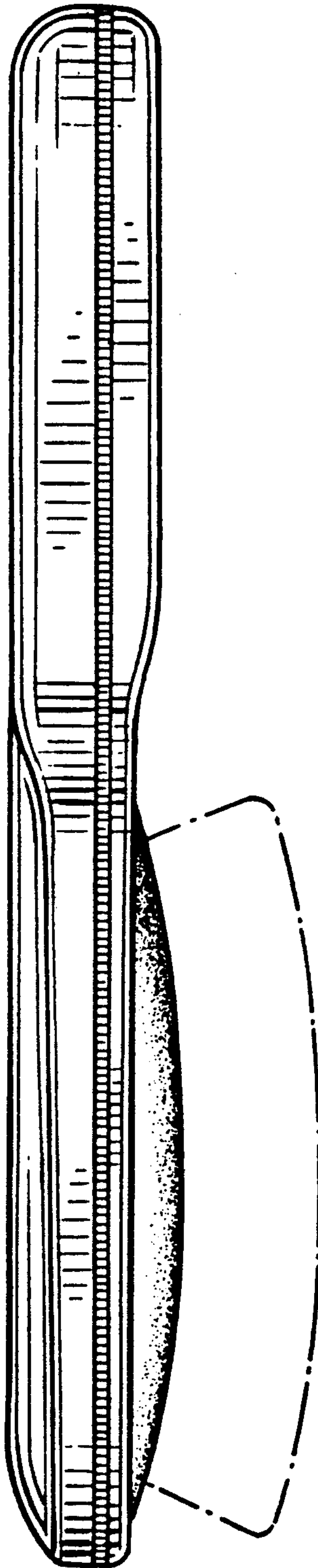

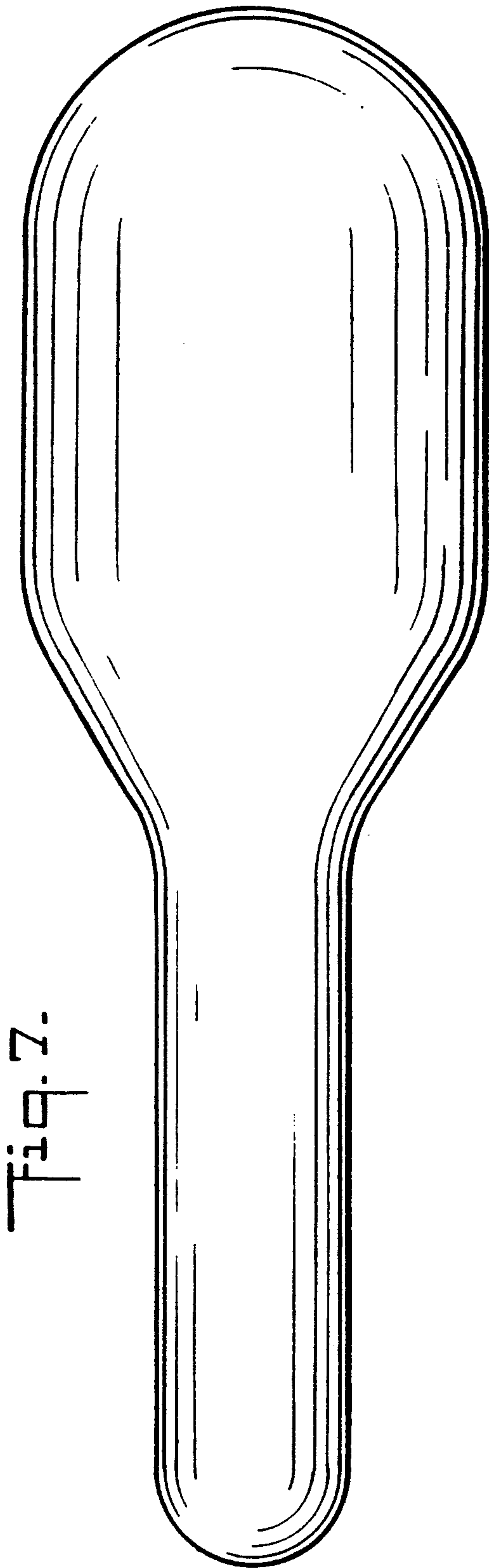

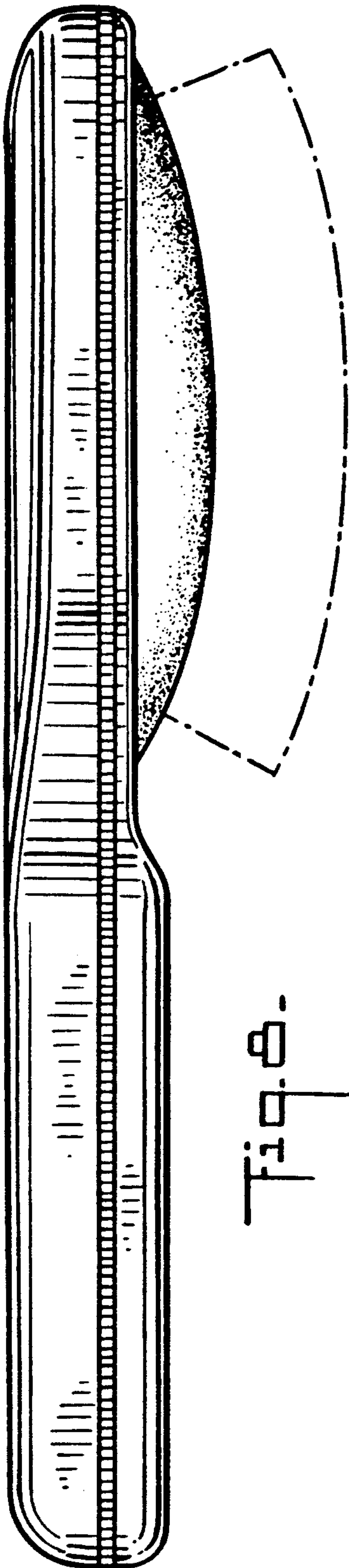

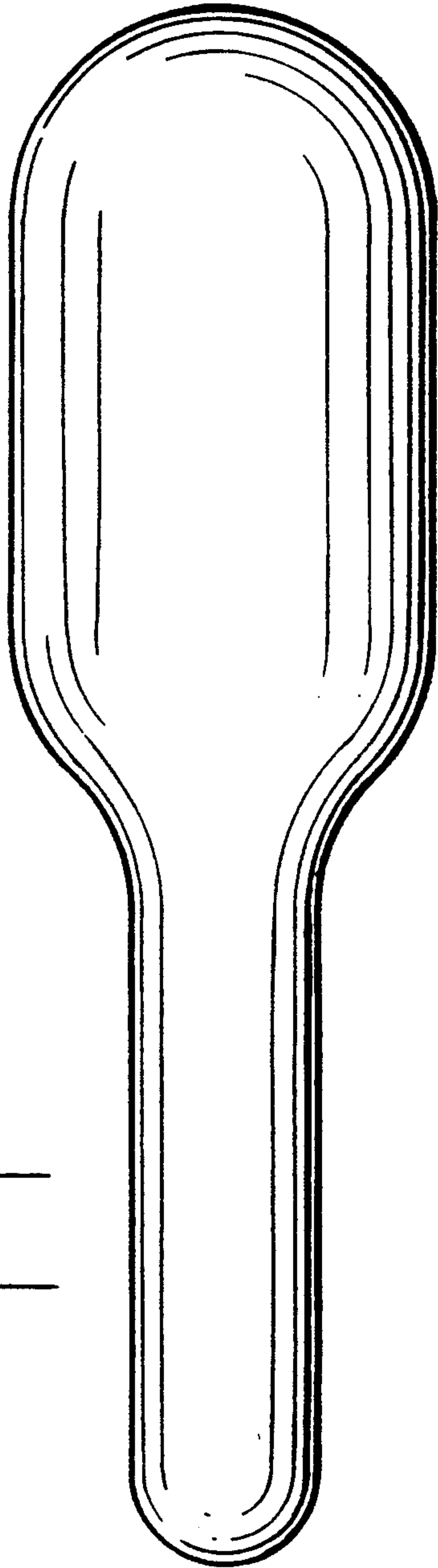

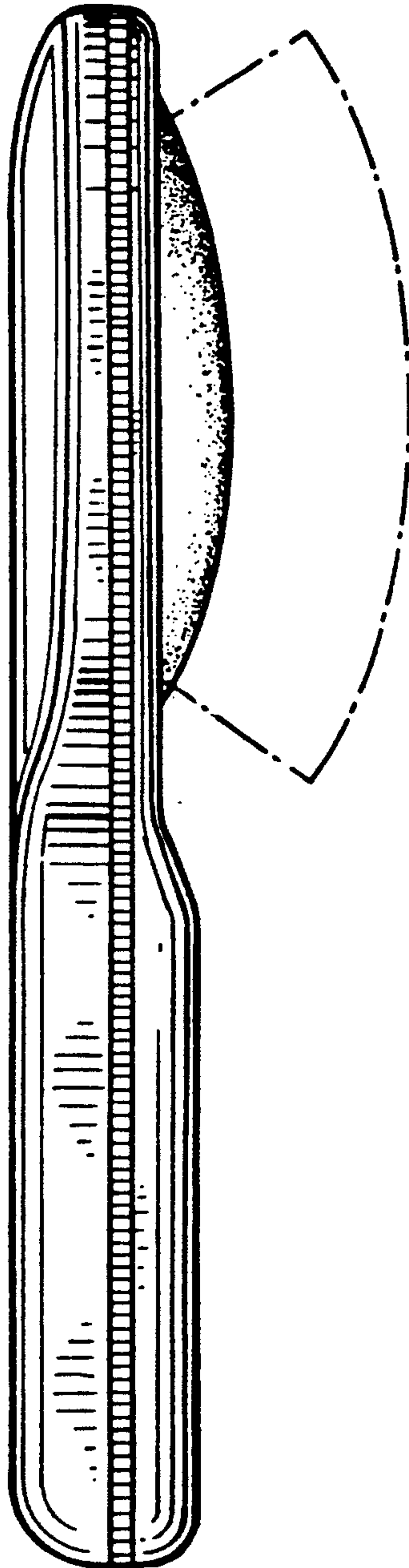

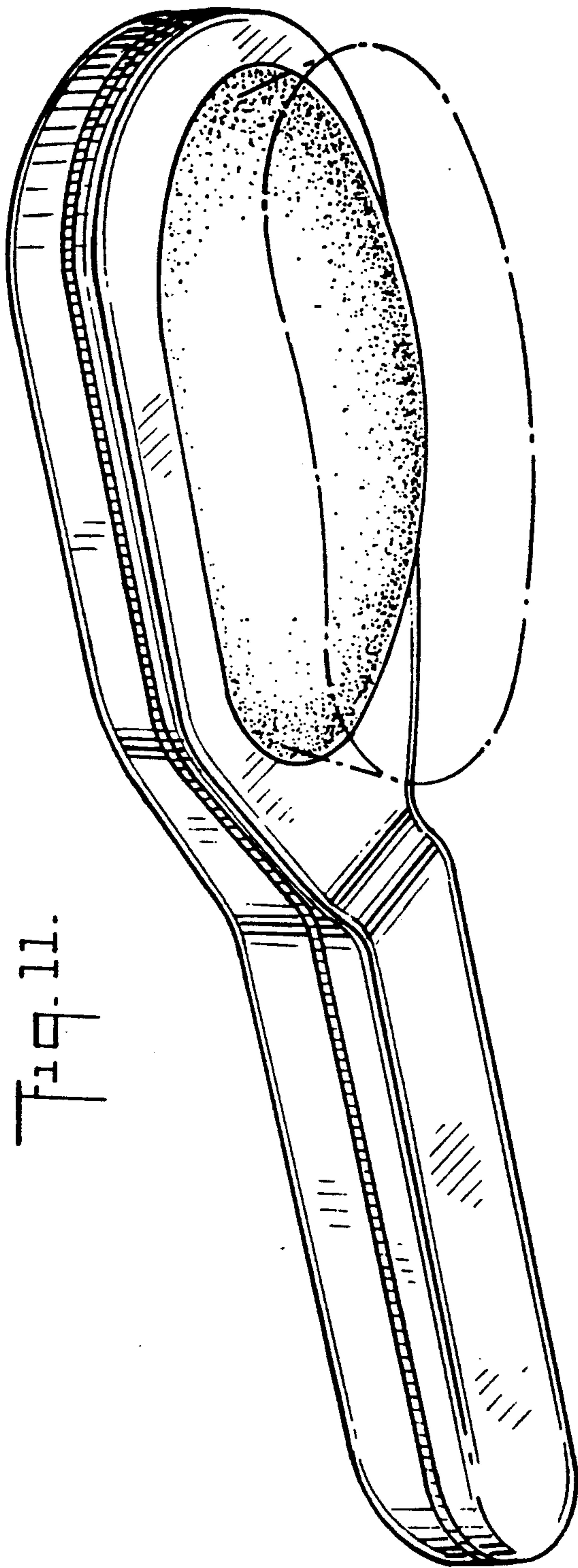
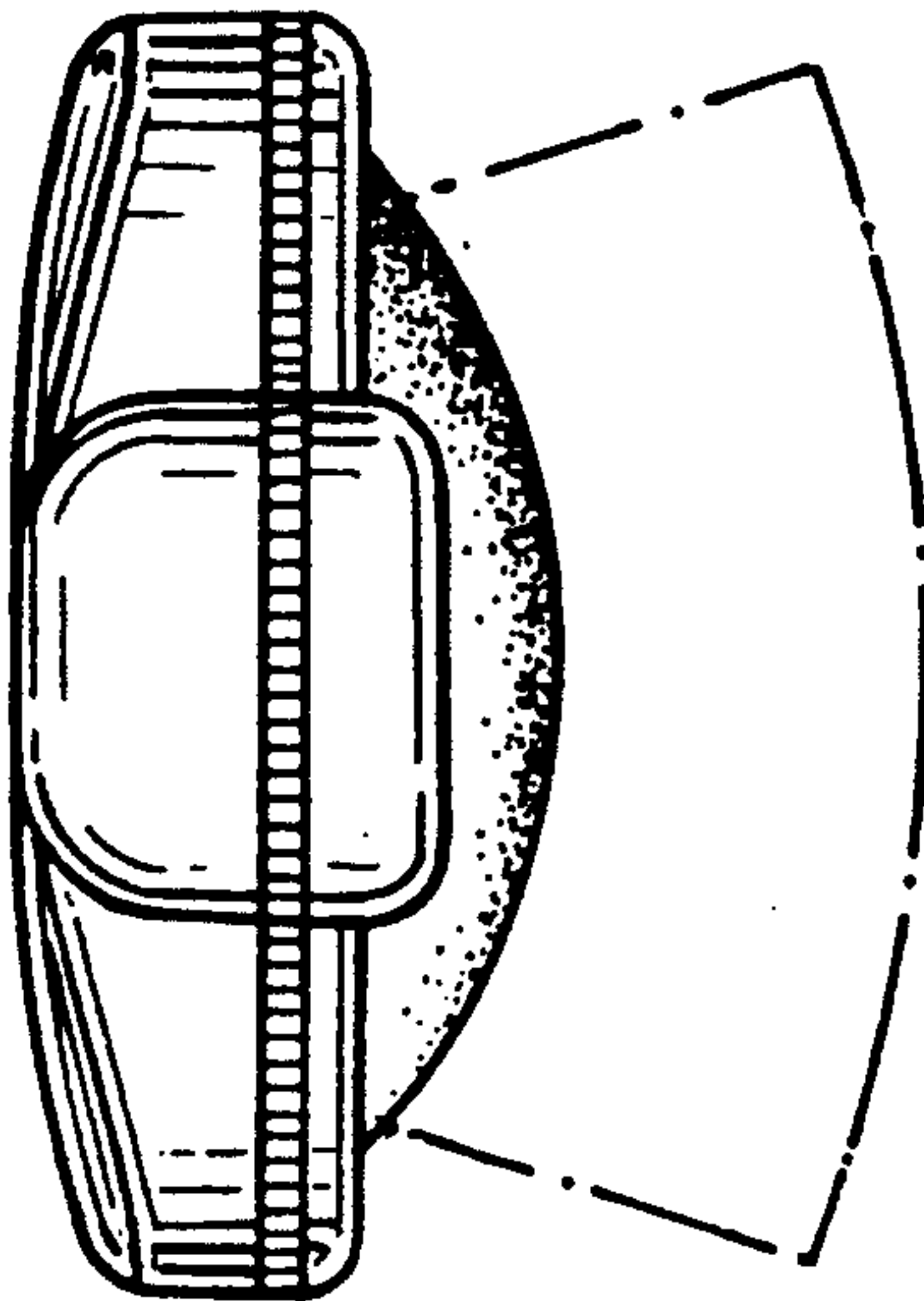

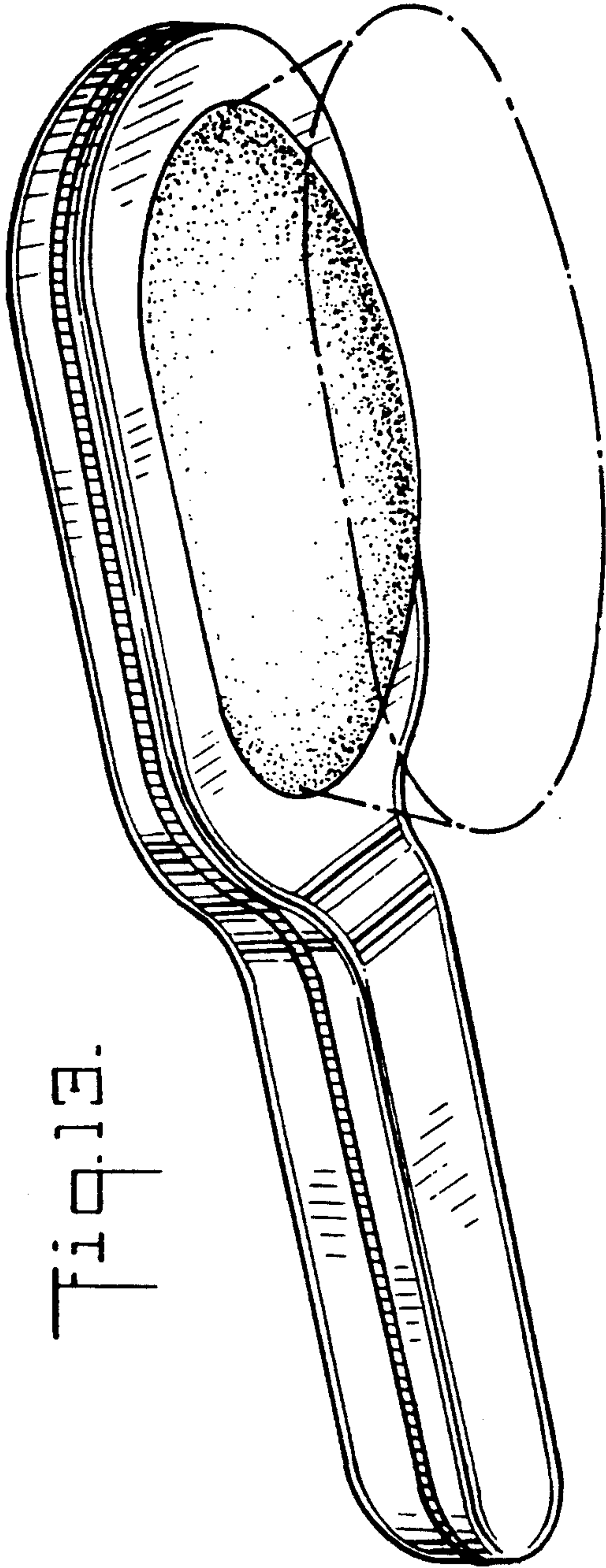

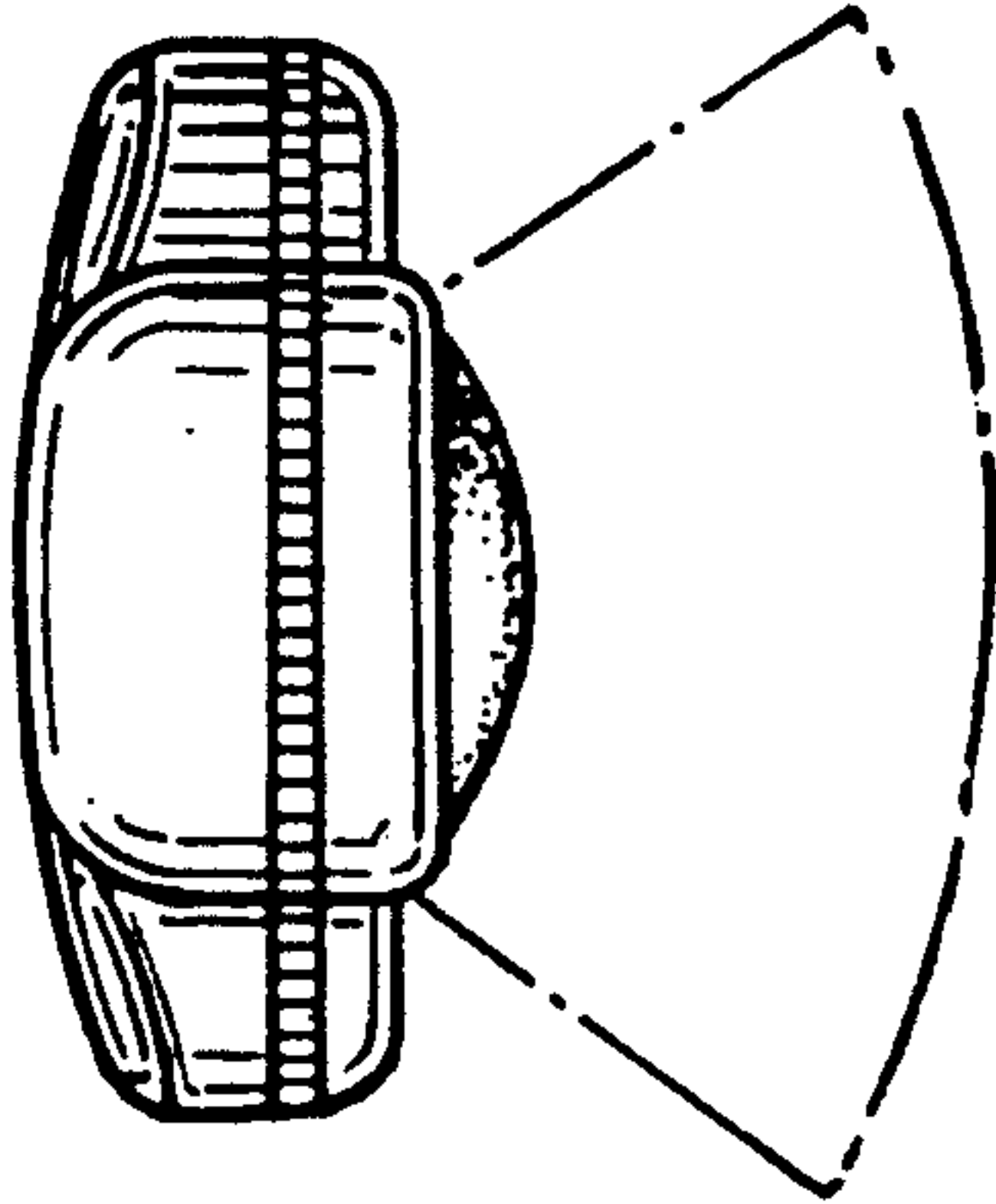
