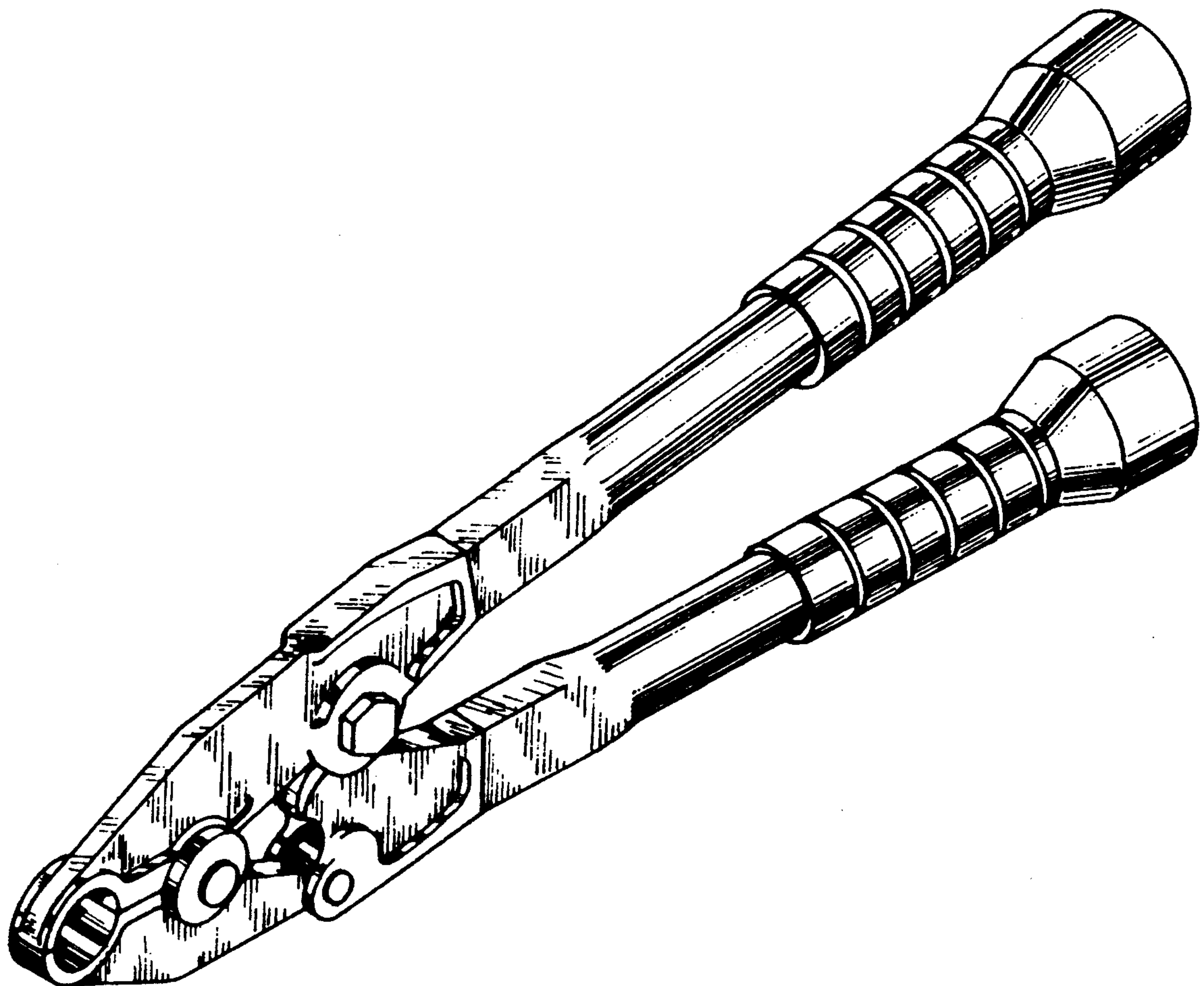

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a crimping tool, showing my new design, shown in a closed position; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof, shown in an open position; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof, shown in a closed position; FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof.



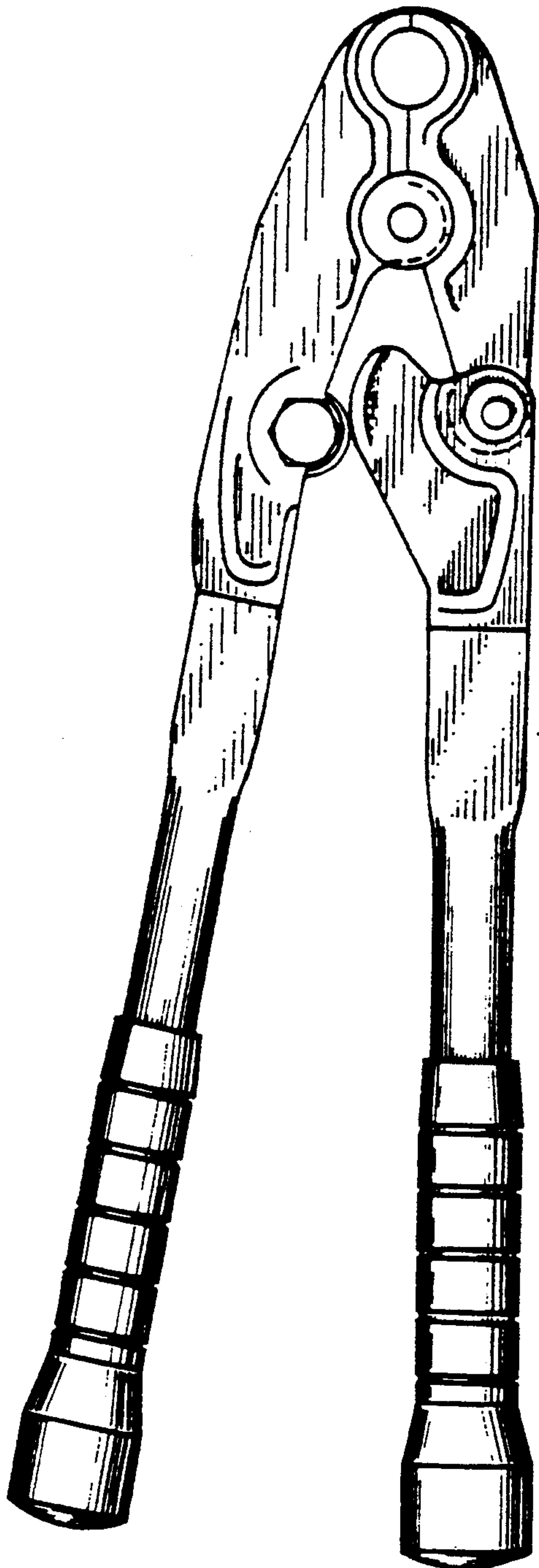

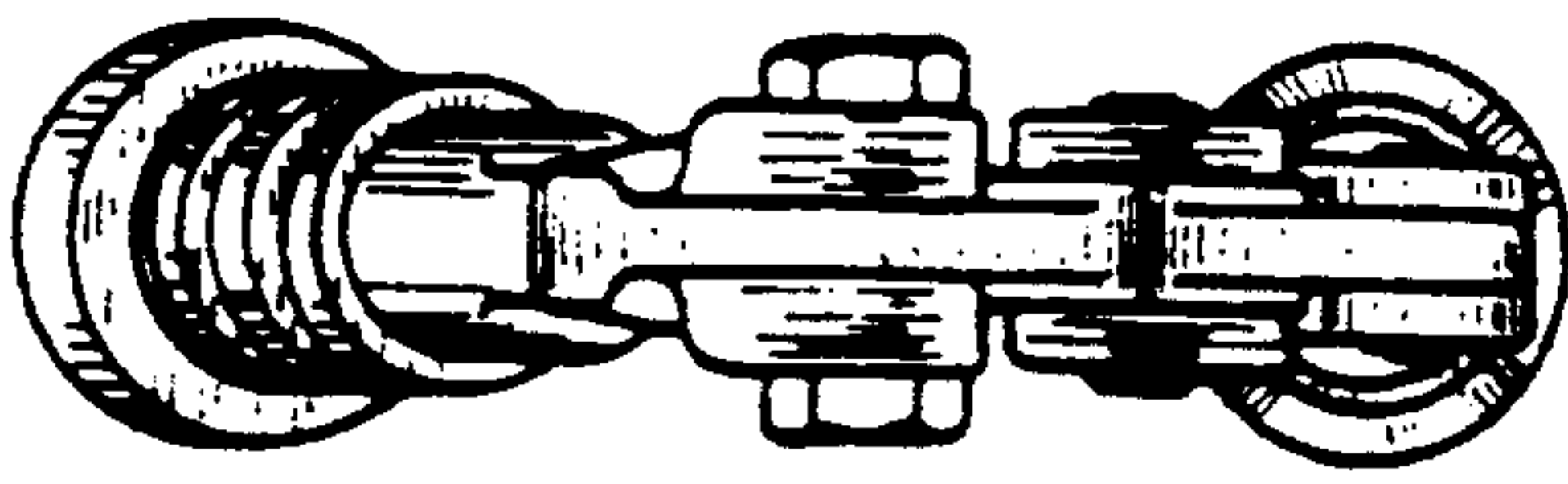
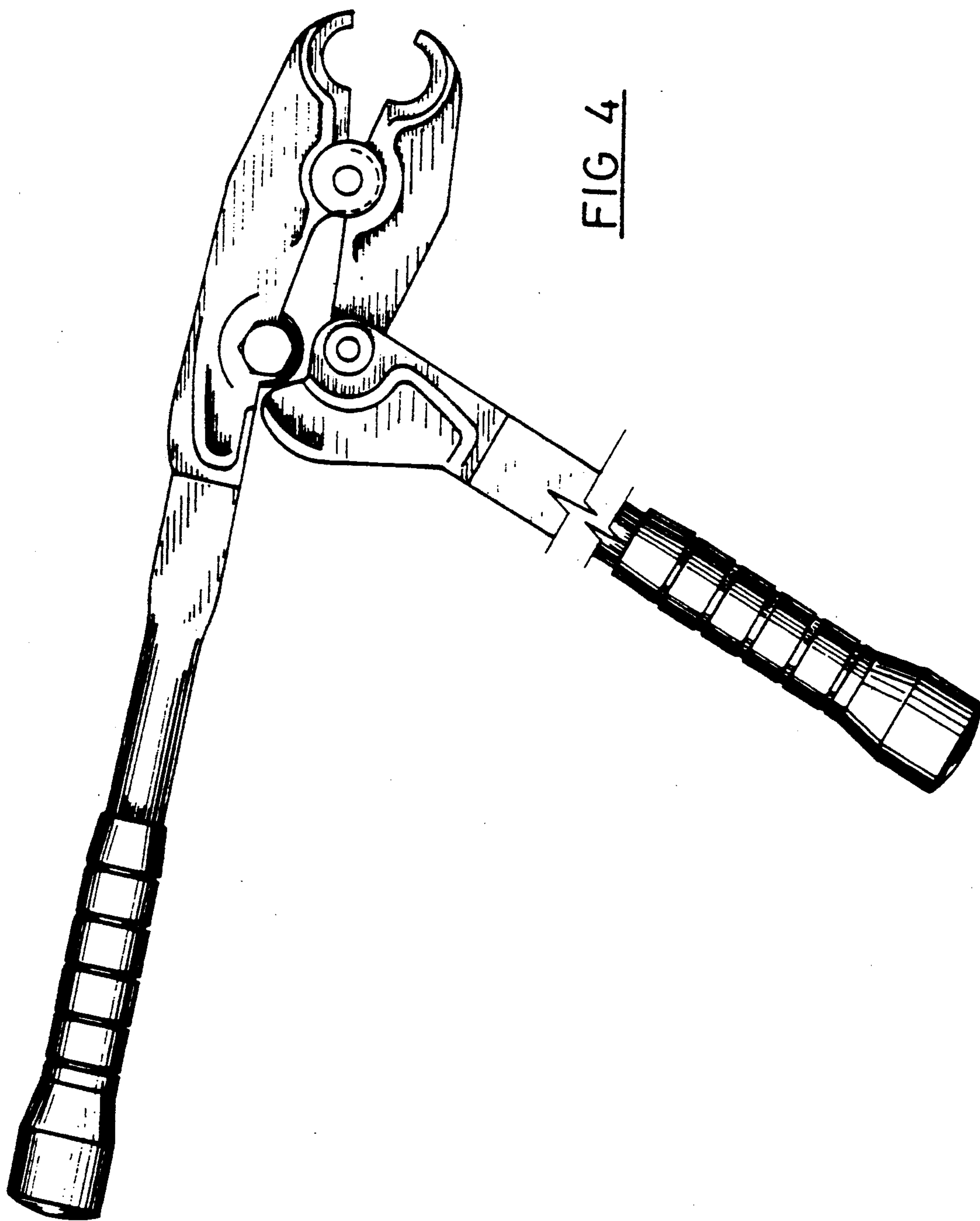

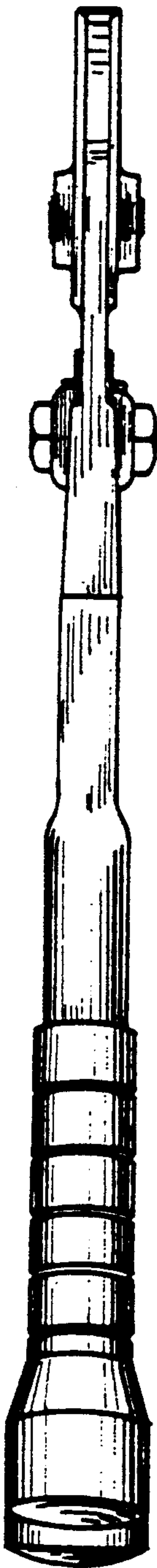

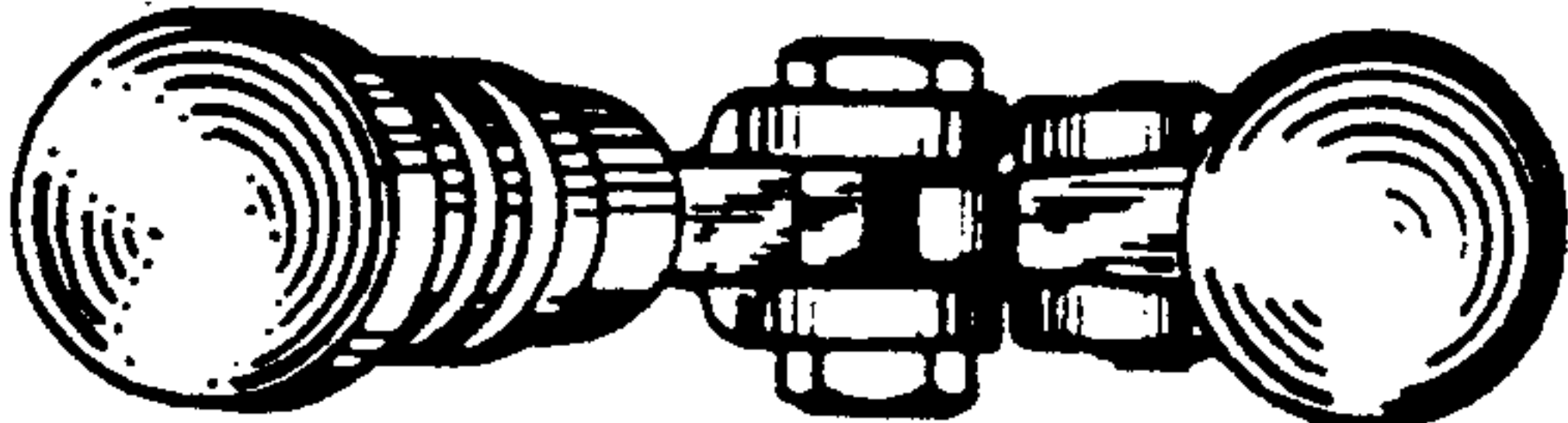

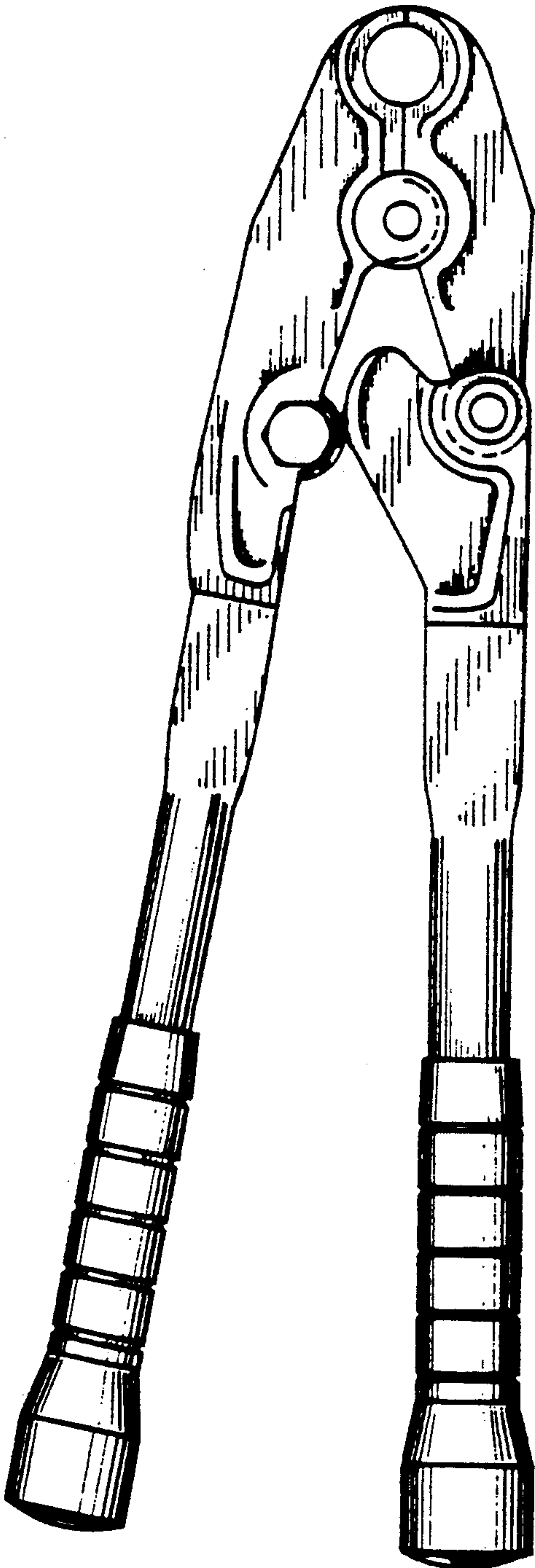

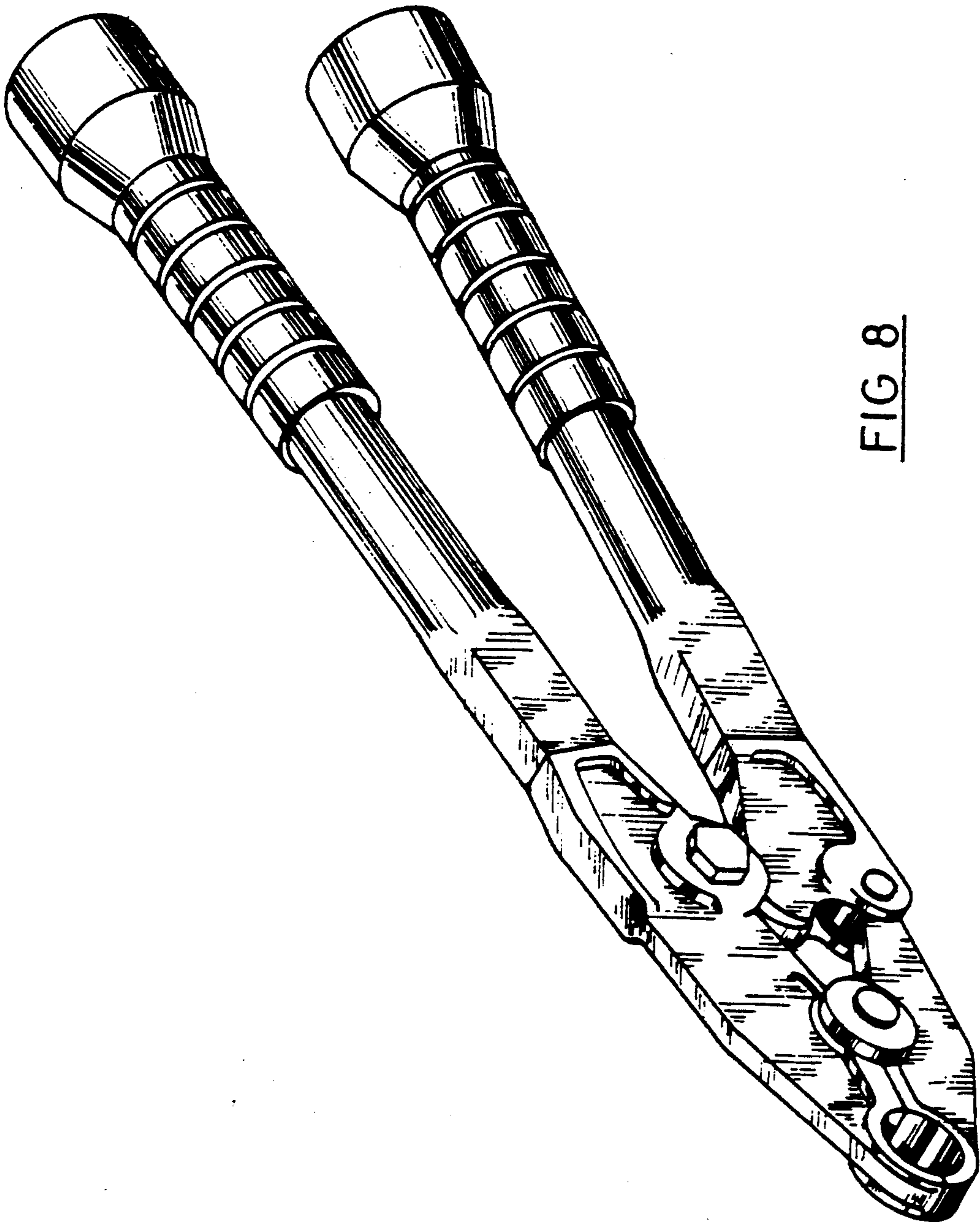
