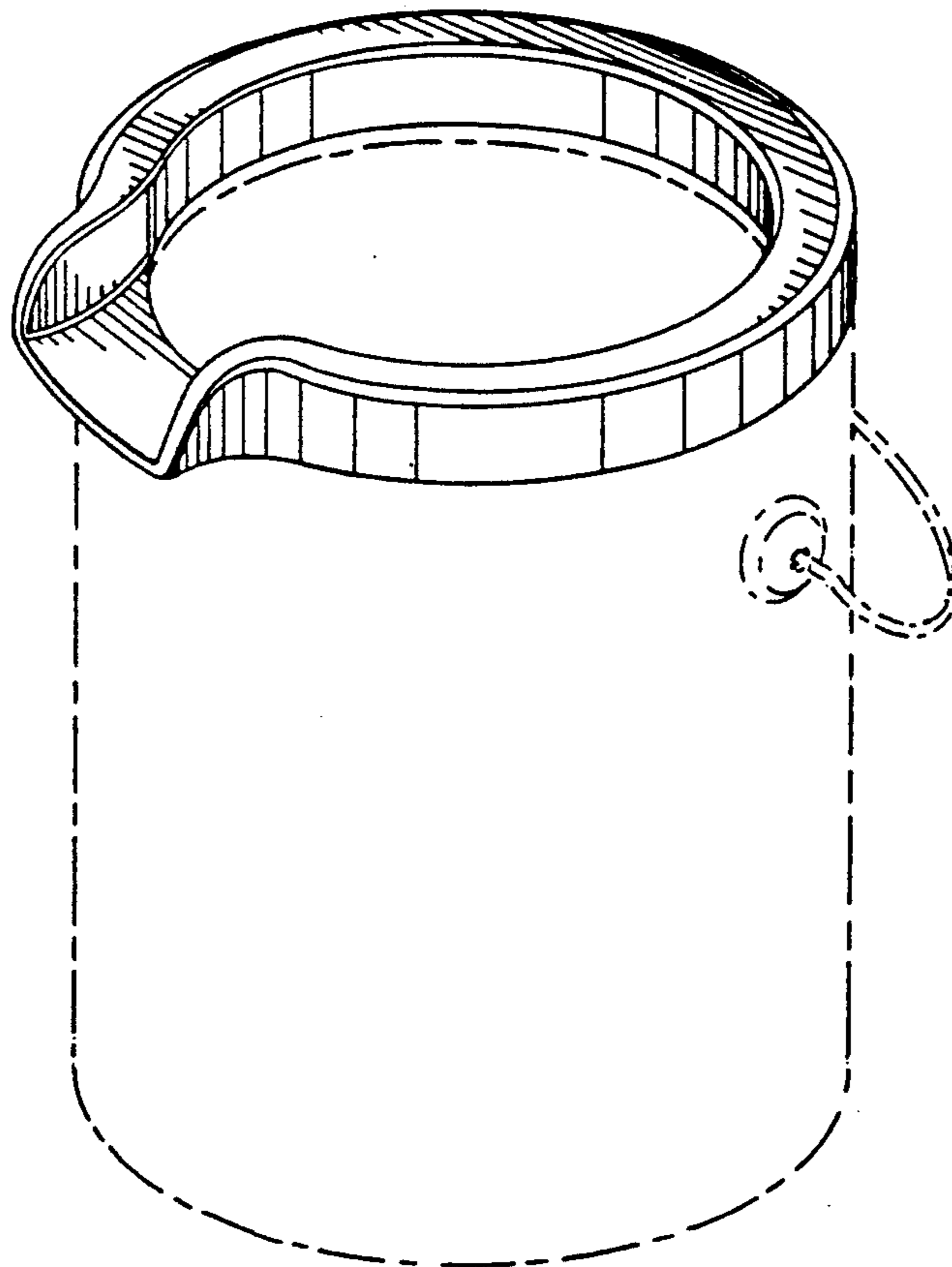

The broken-line showing of the paint can in FIG. 1 is for information only and forms no part of the instant design.



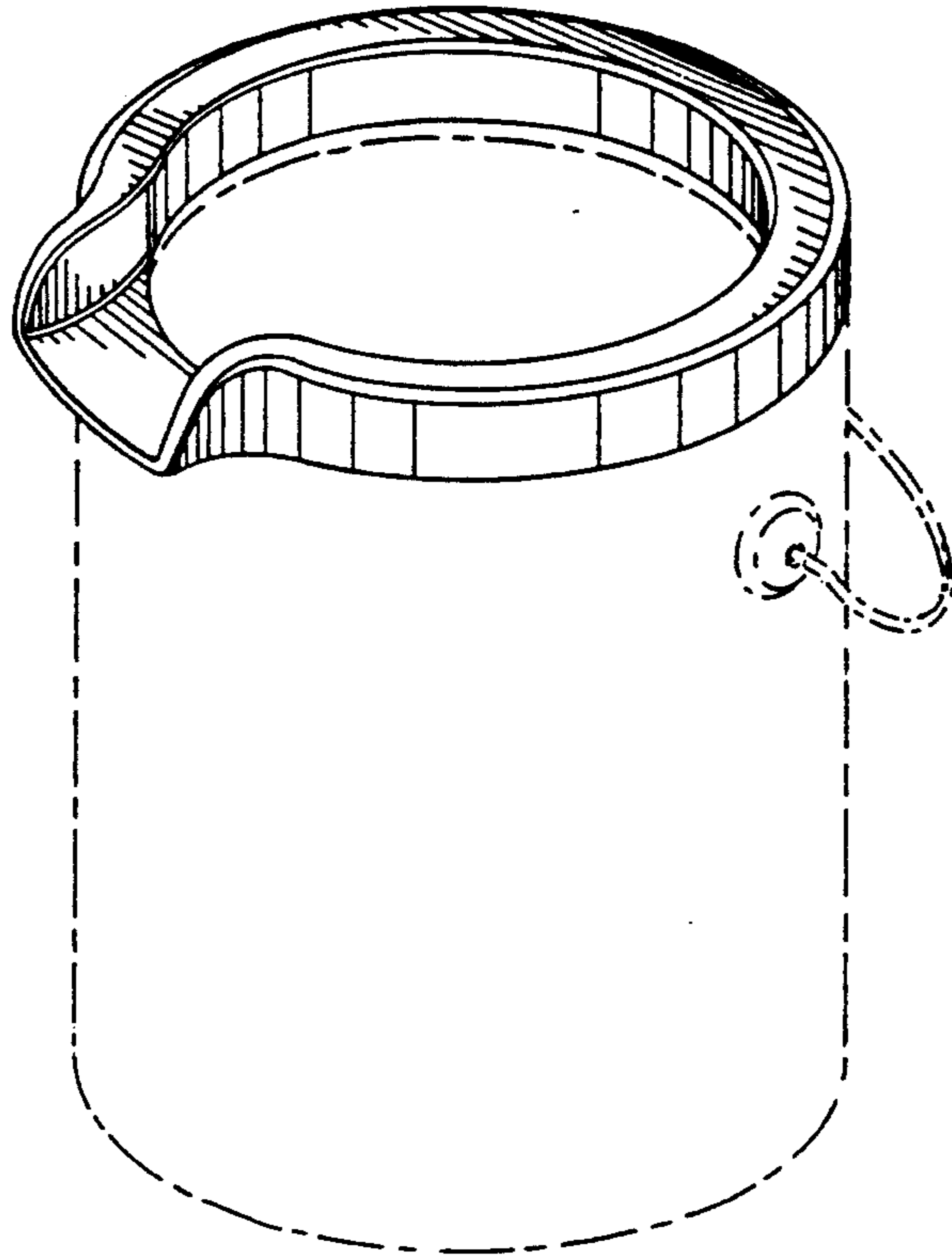

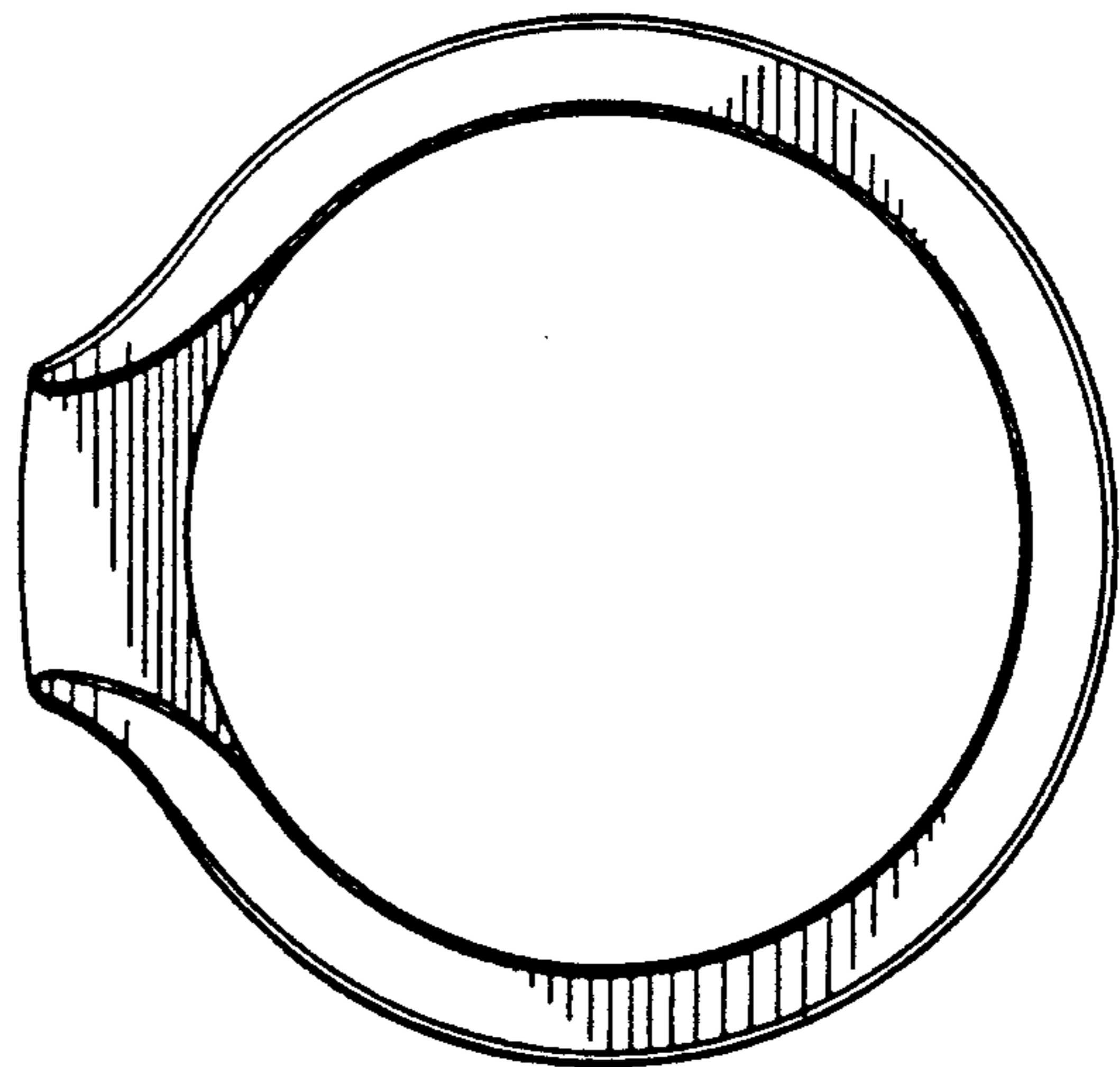

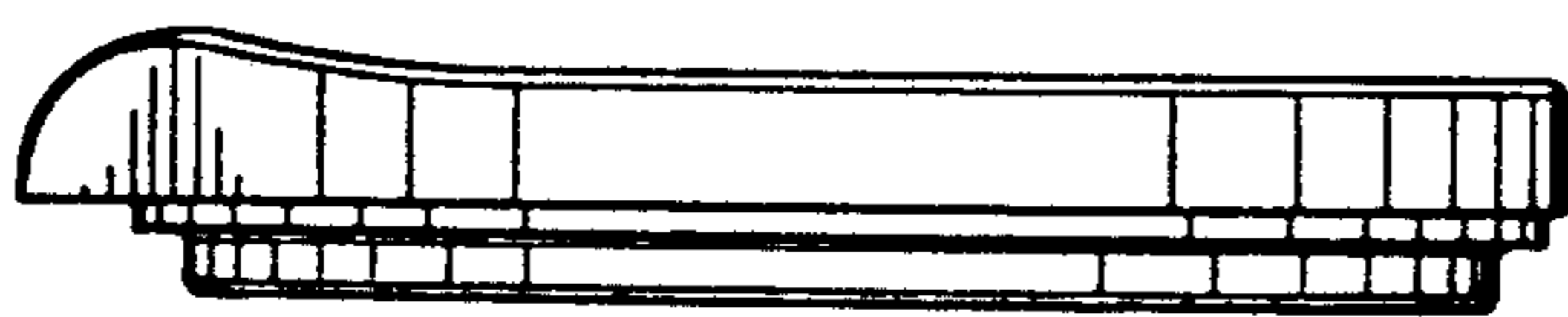

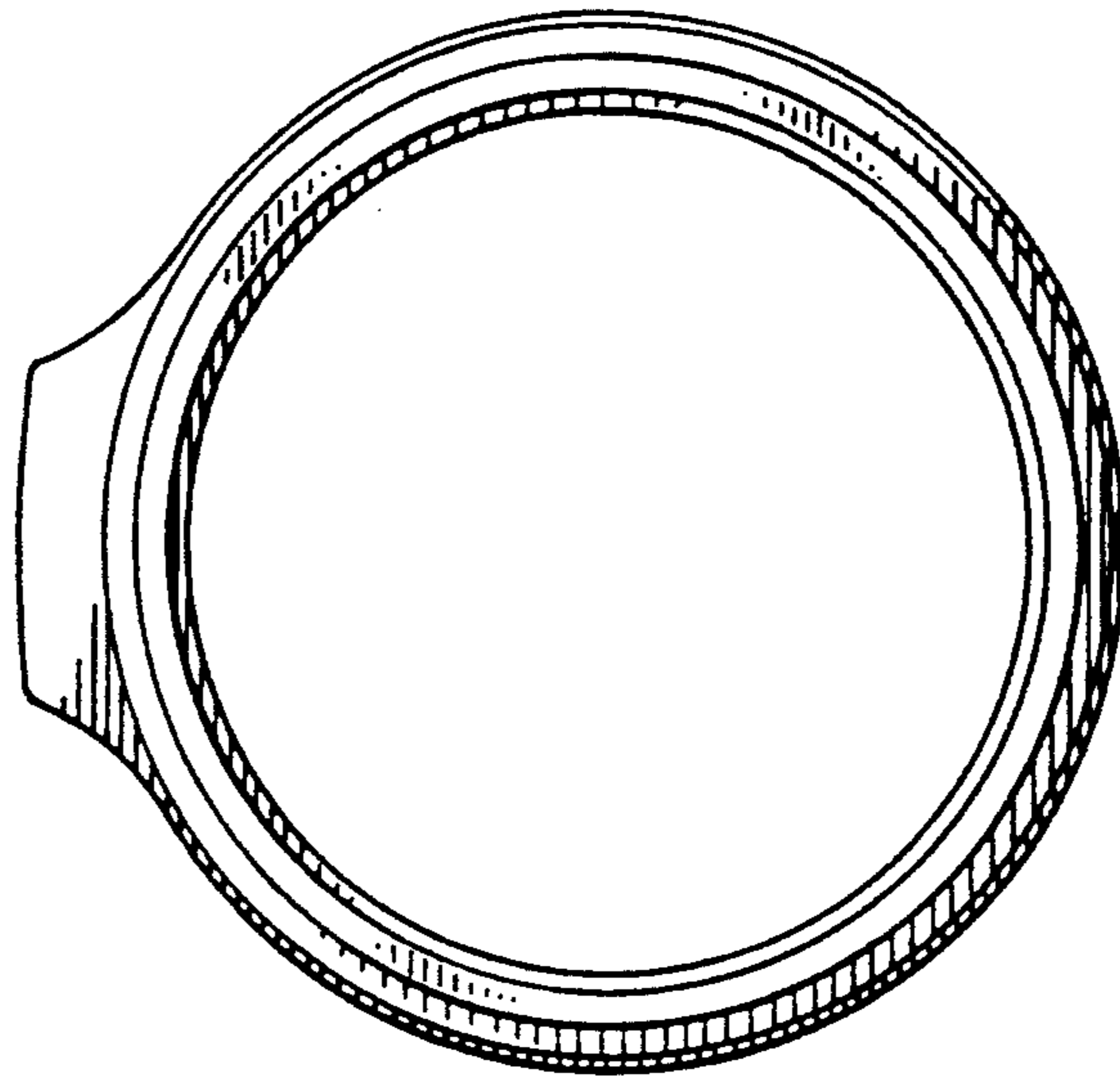

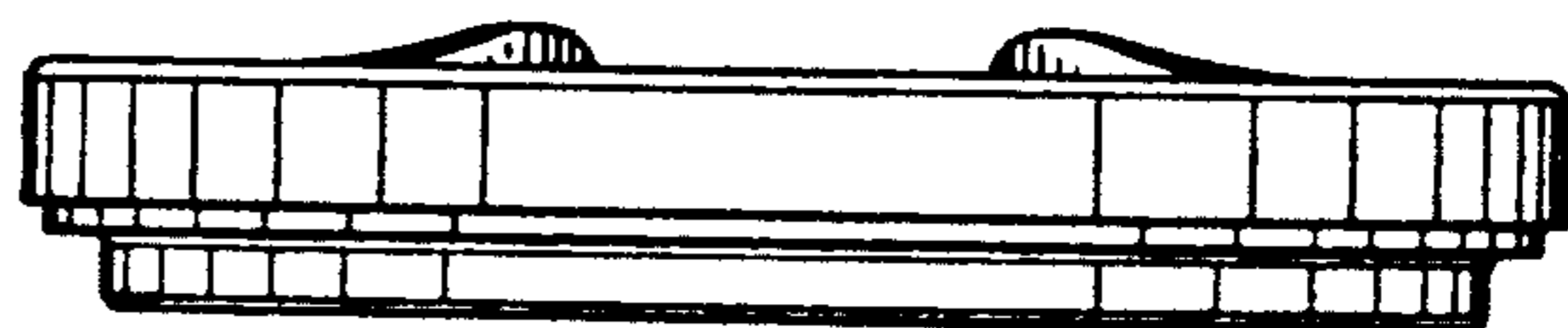

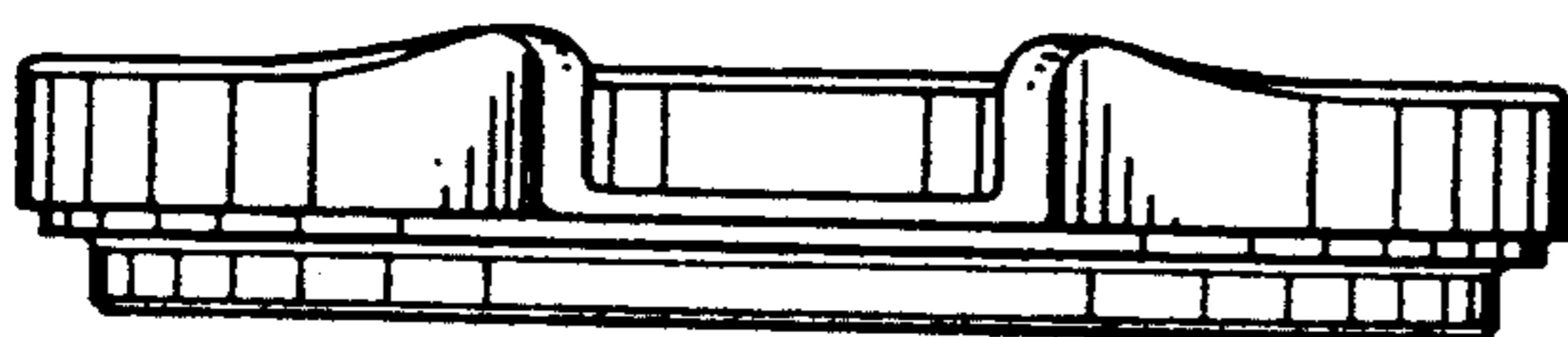
