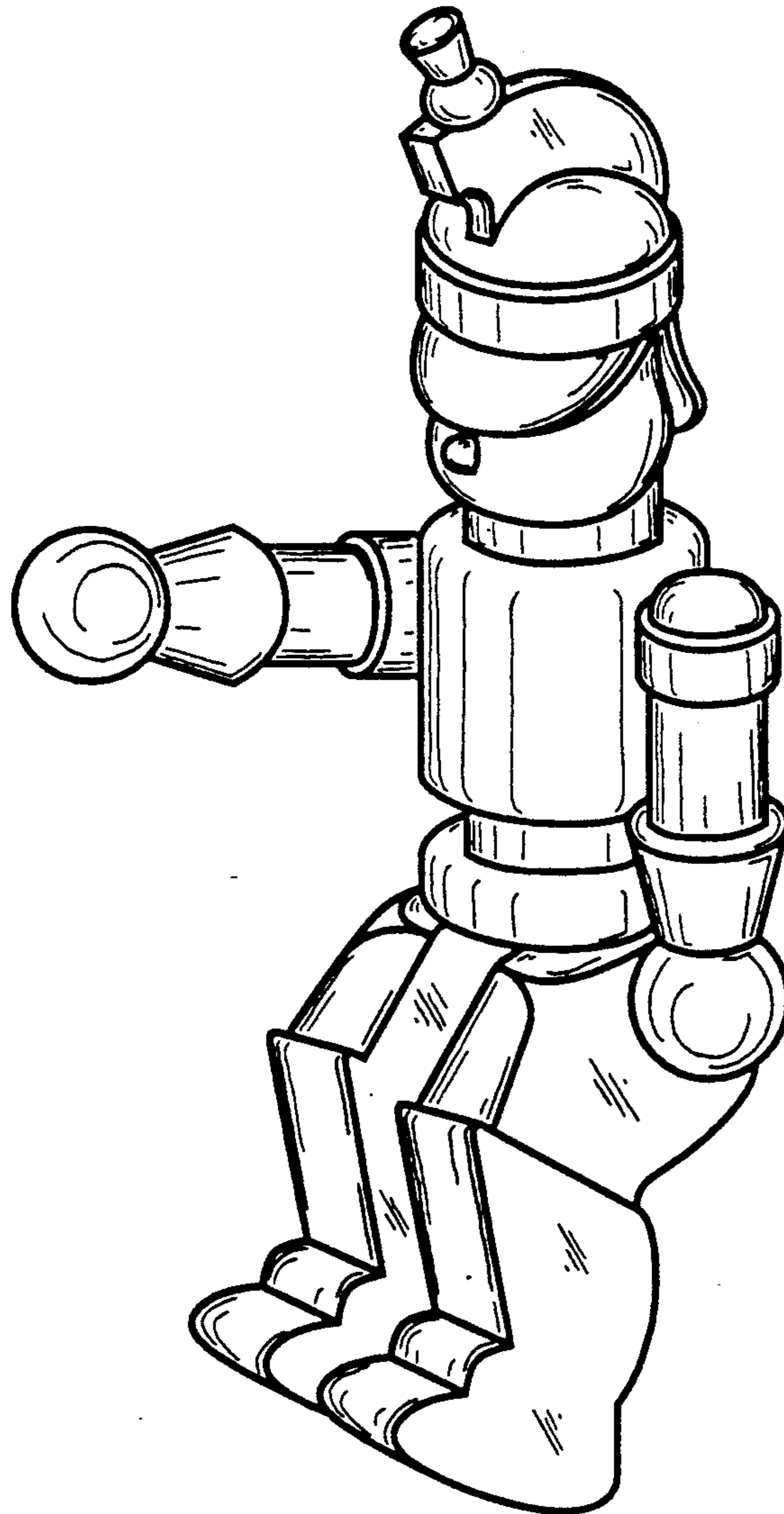

The ornamental design for a toy soldier, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toy soldier embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, it being understood that the right side elevational view appears as a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



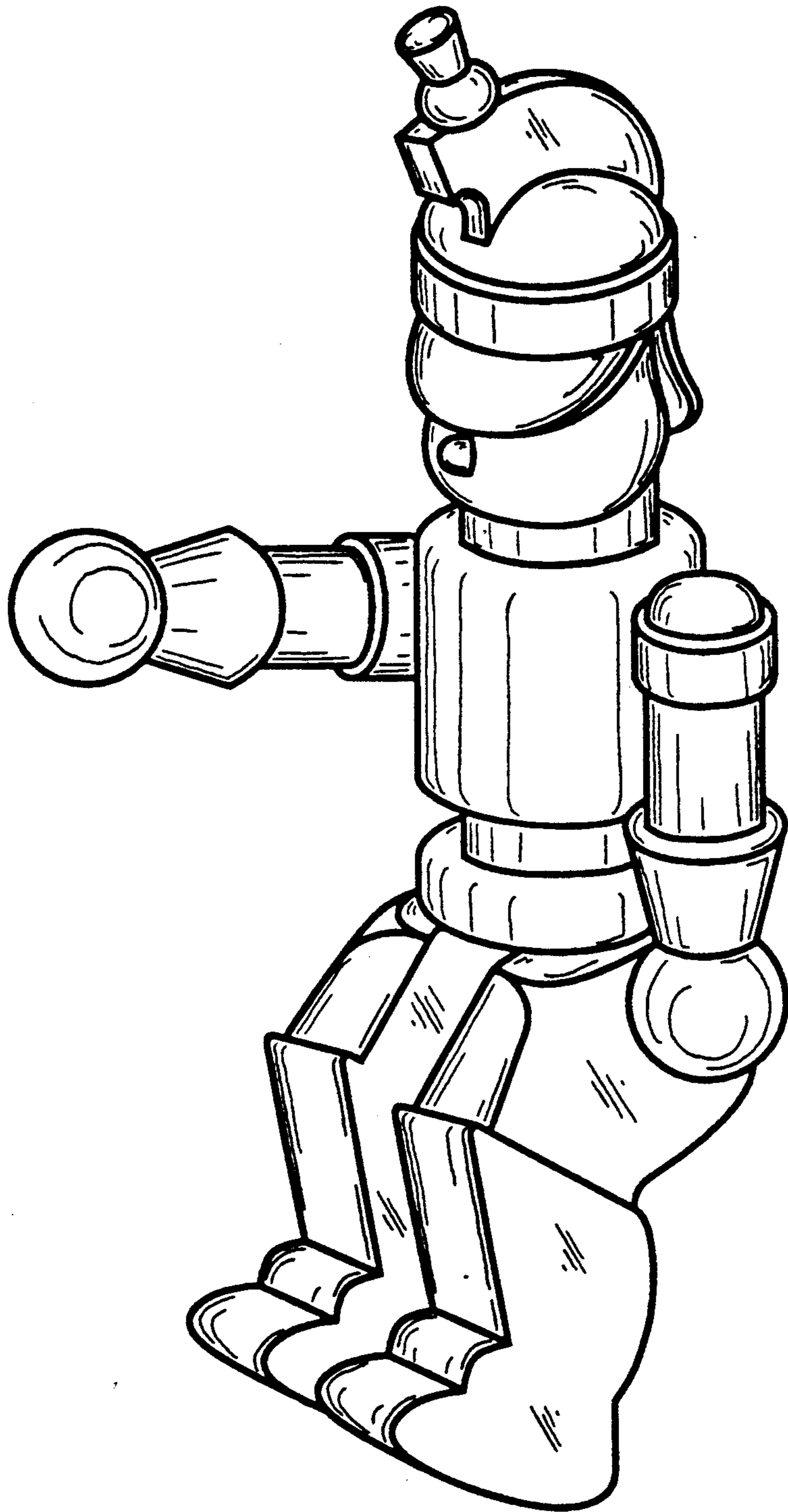

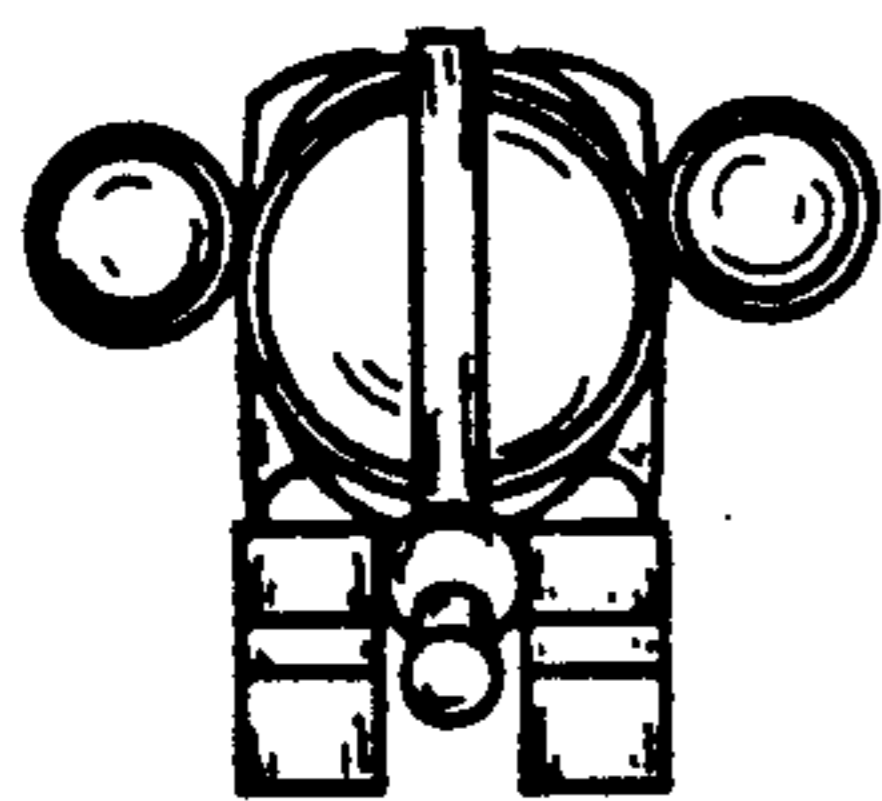

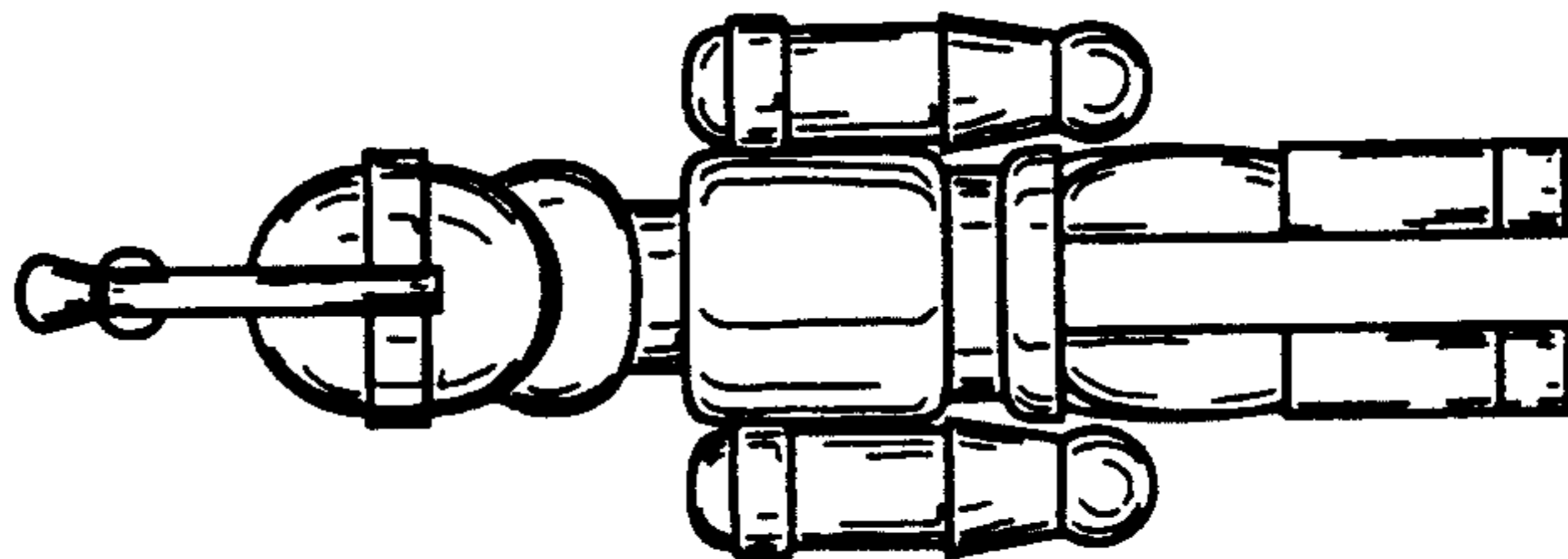

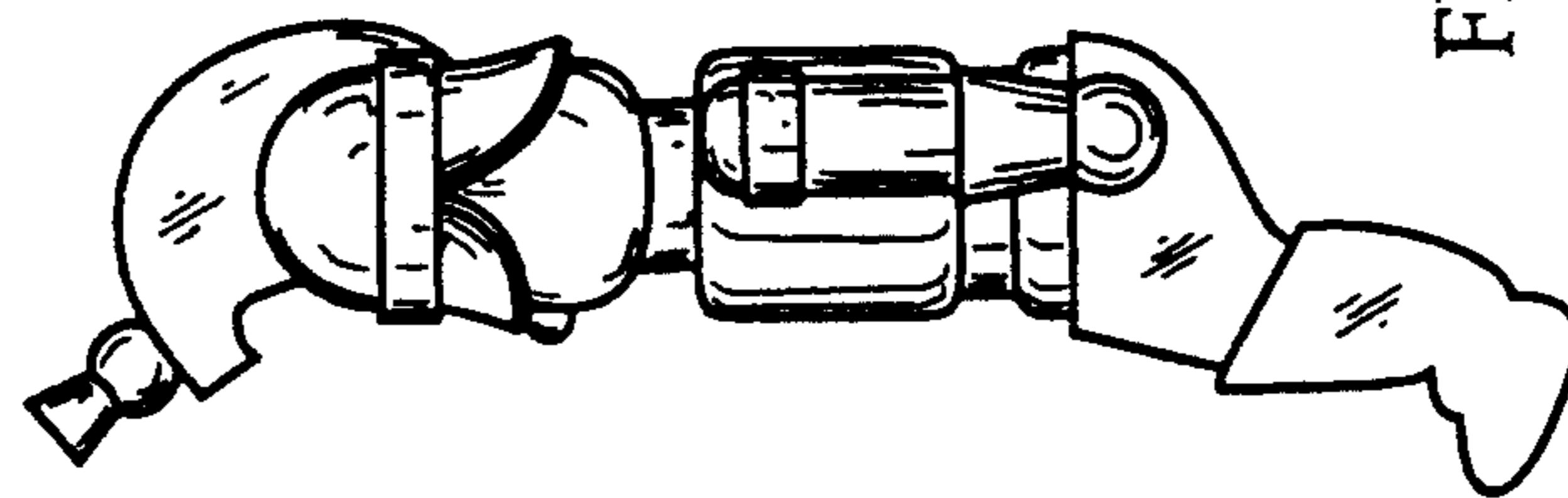

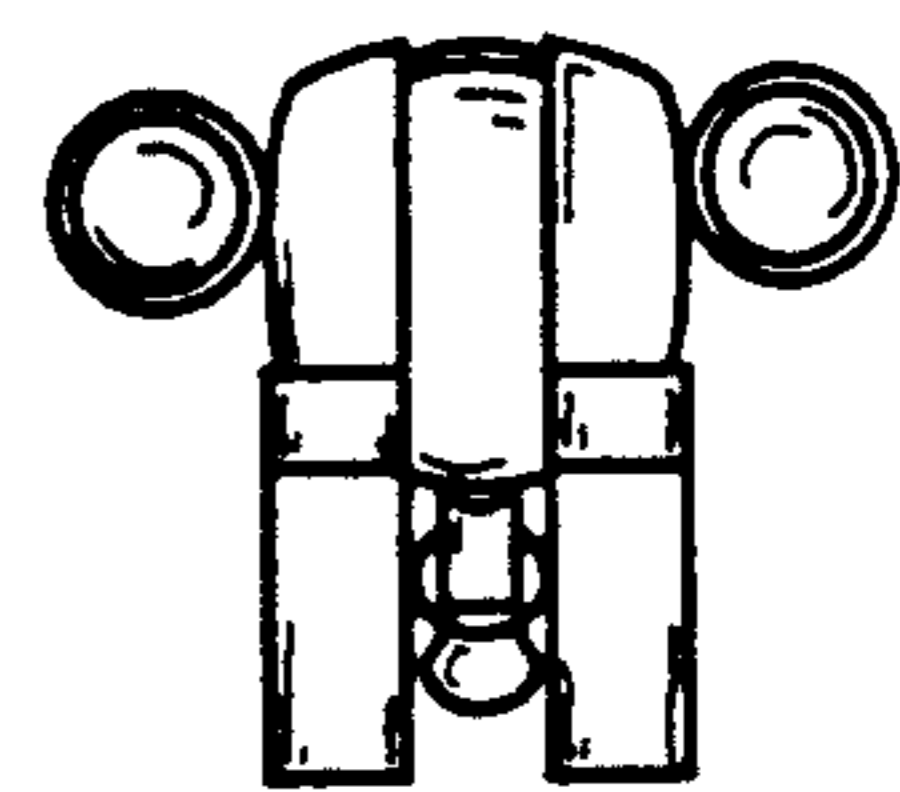

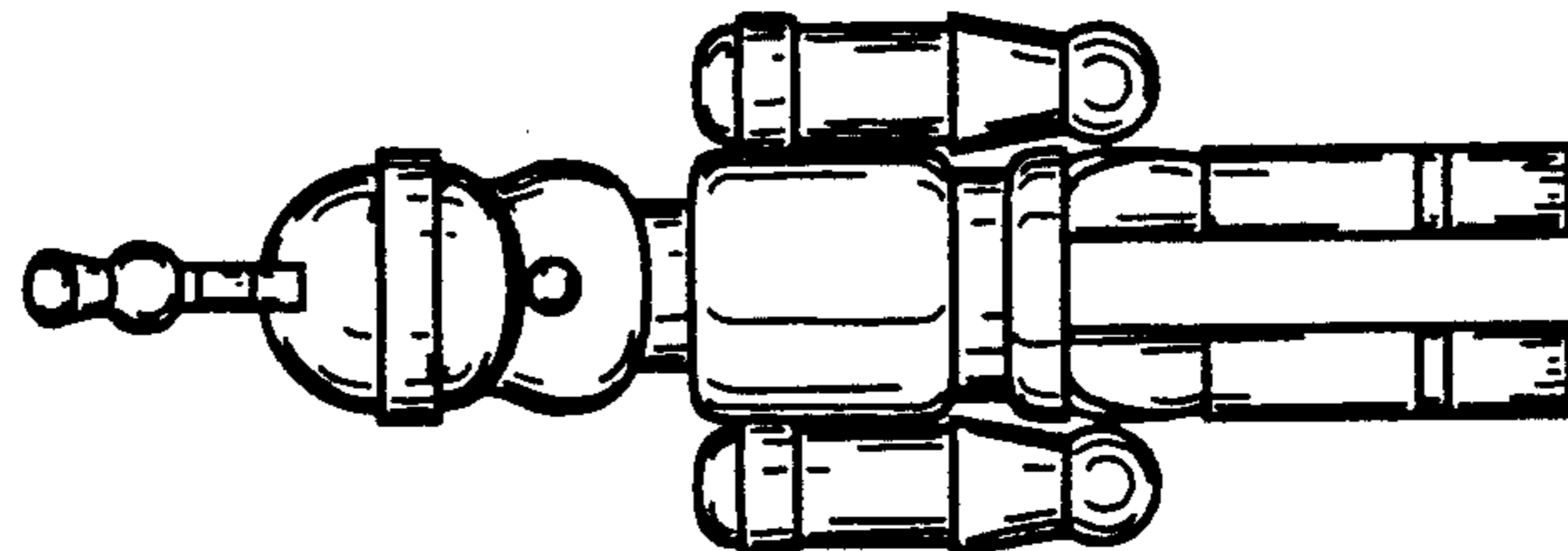
