FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

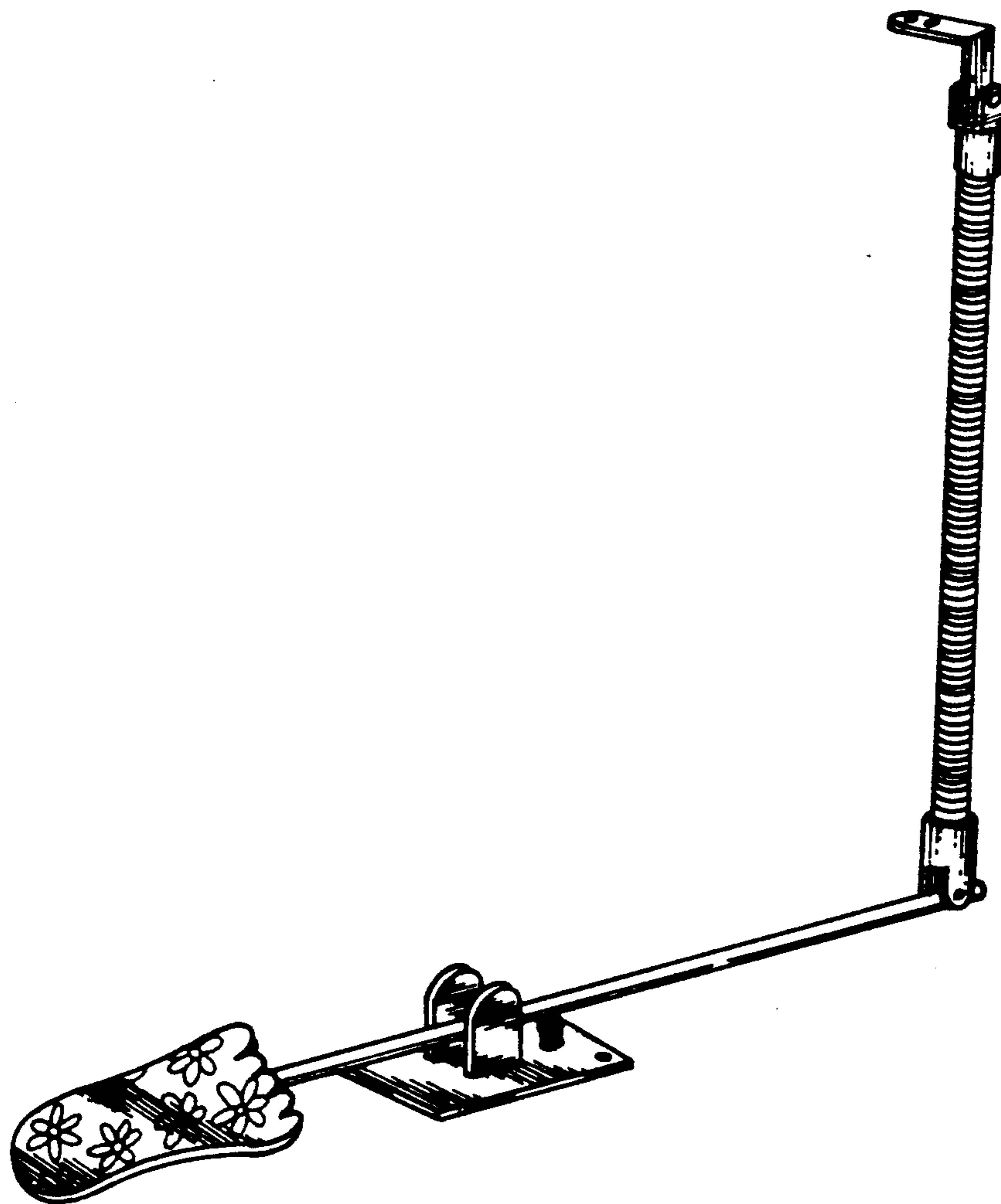
FIG. 5 is a perspective view of a second embodiment thereof;

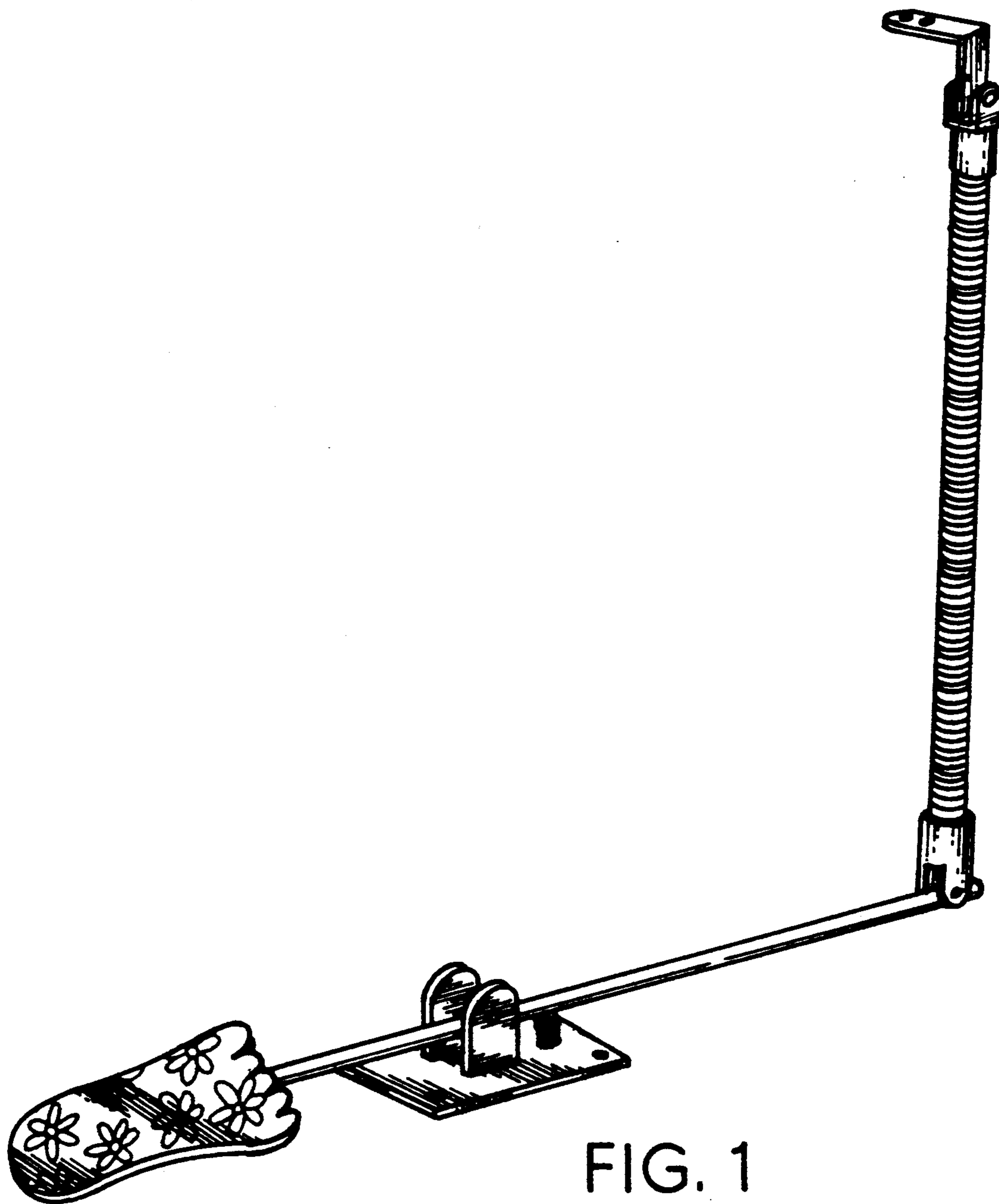

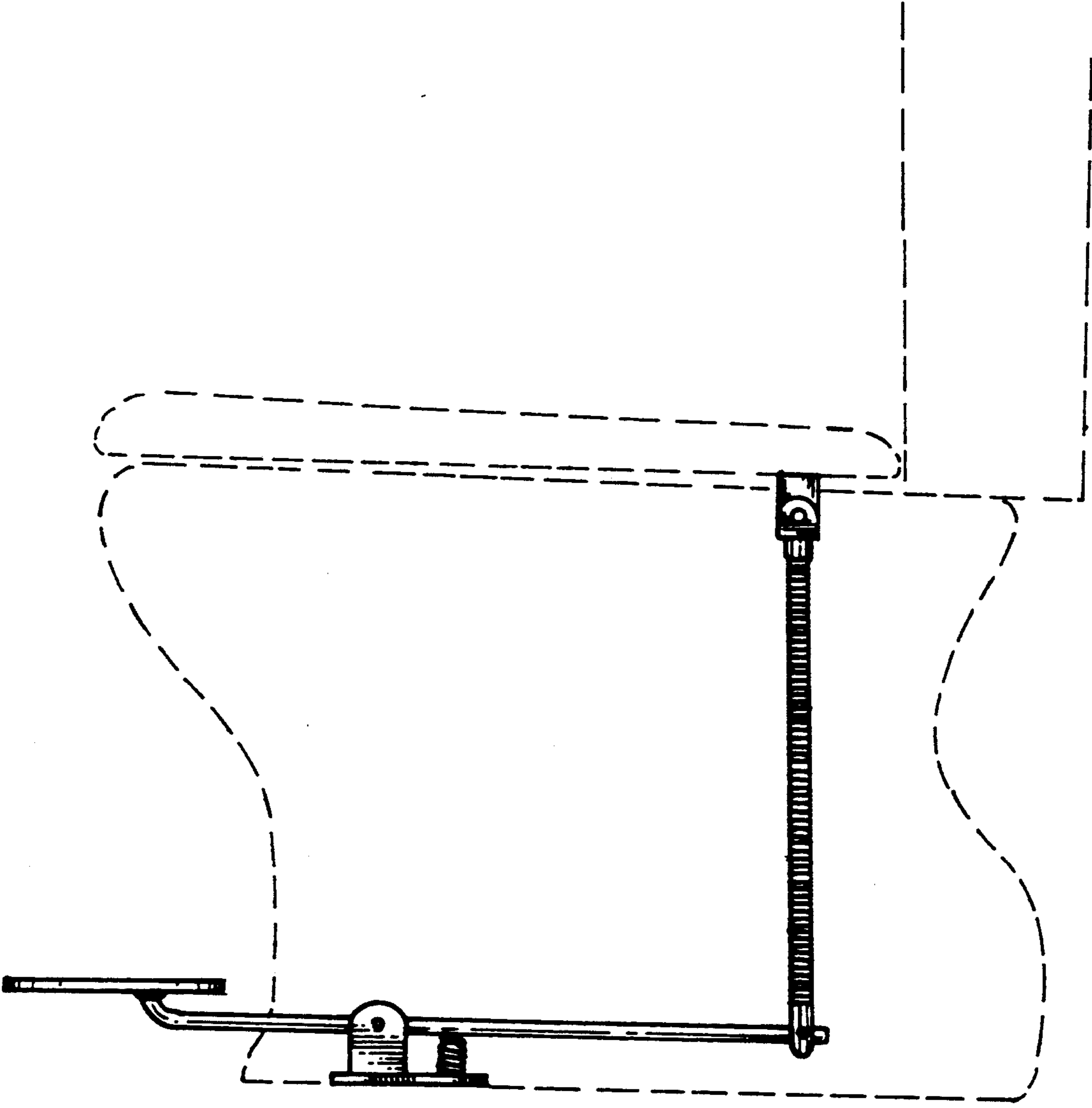

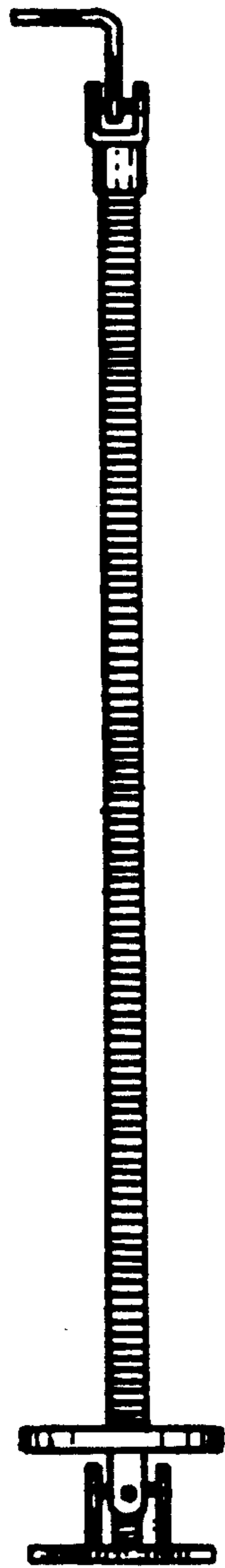

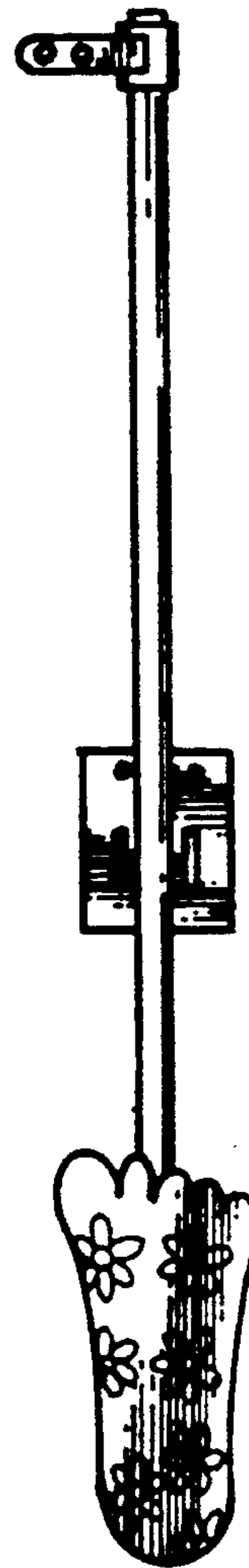

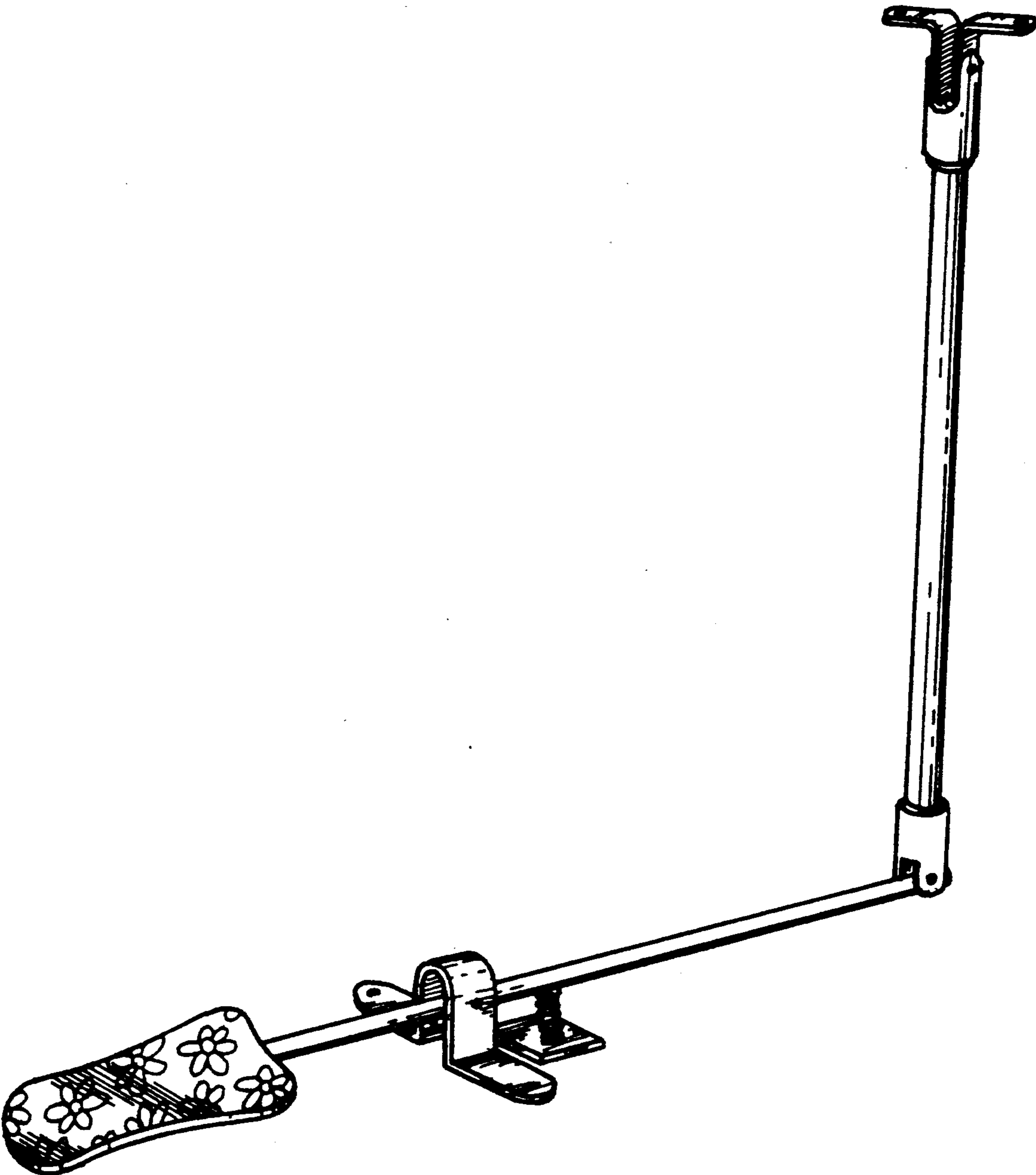

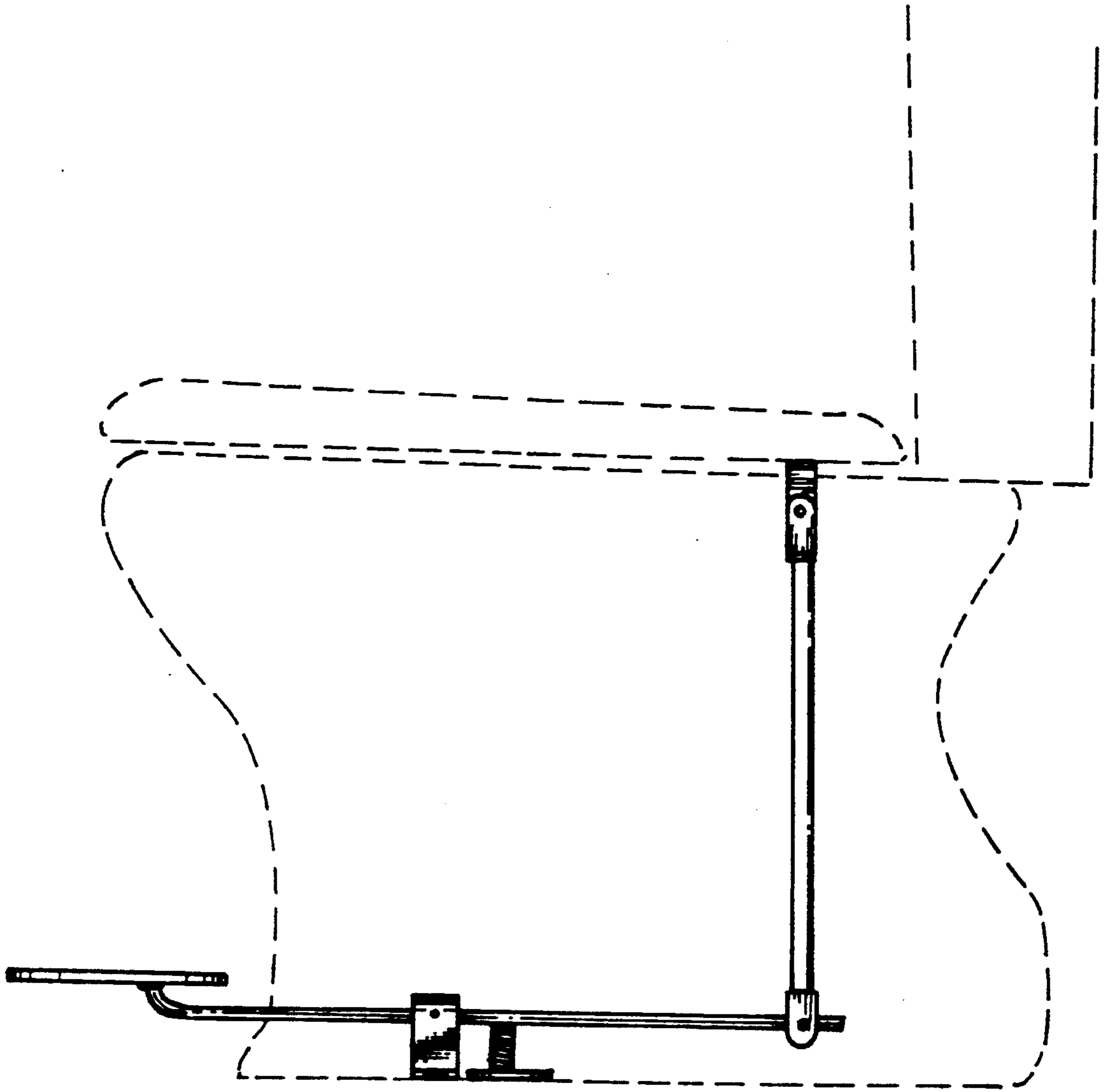

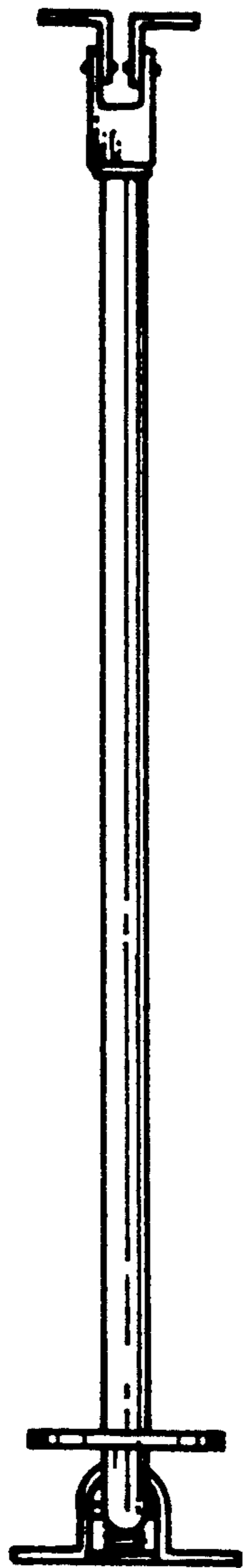
