The broken lines shown on the bib in FIGS. 1, 2, and 7 are understood to represent conventional stitching.

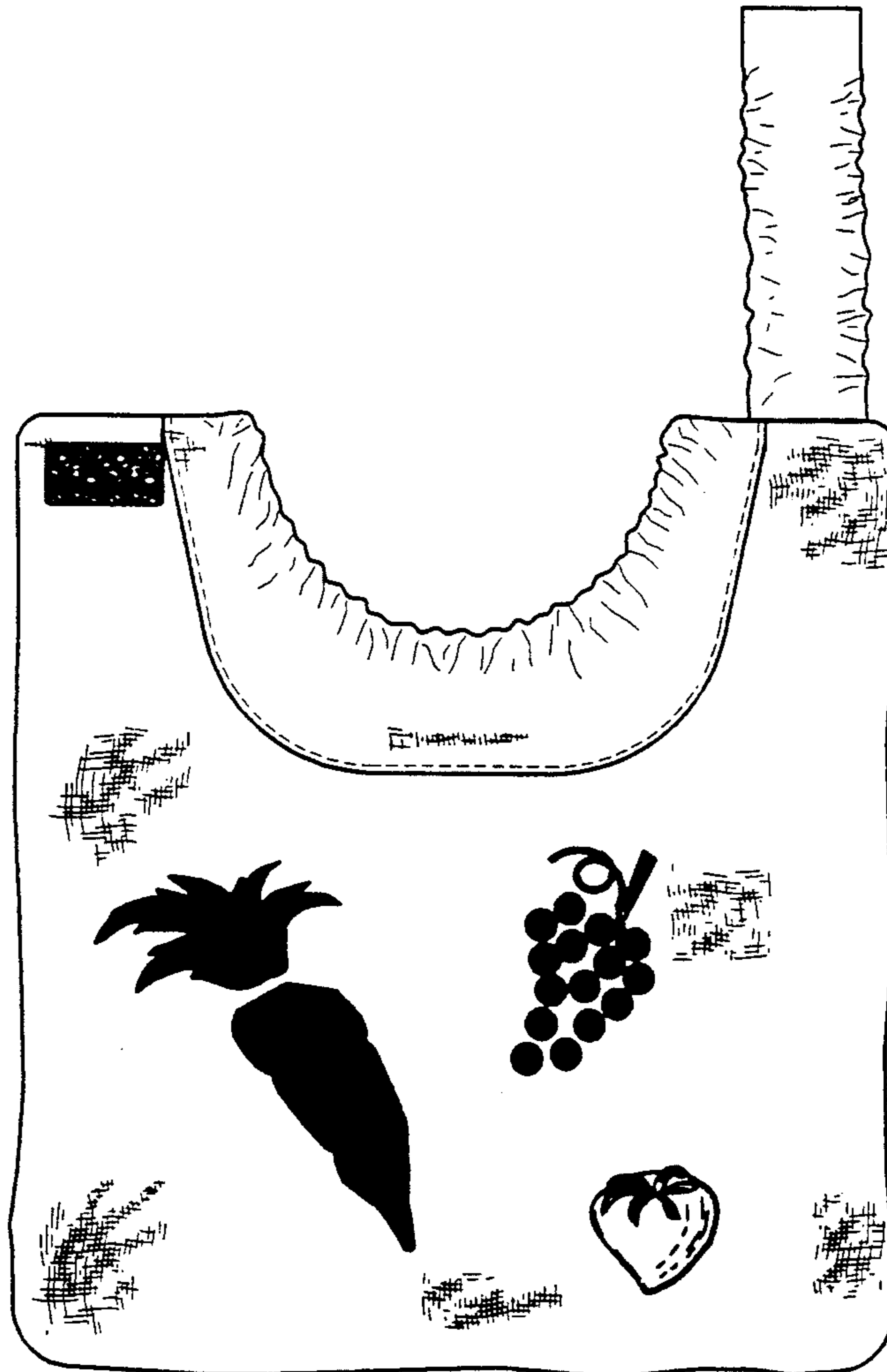

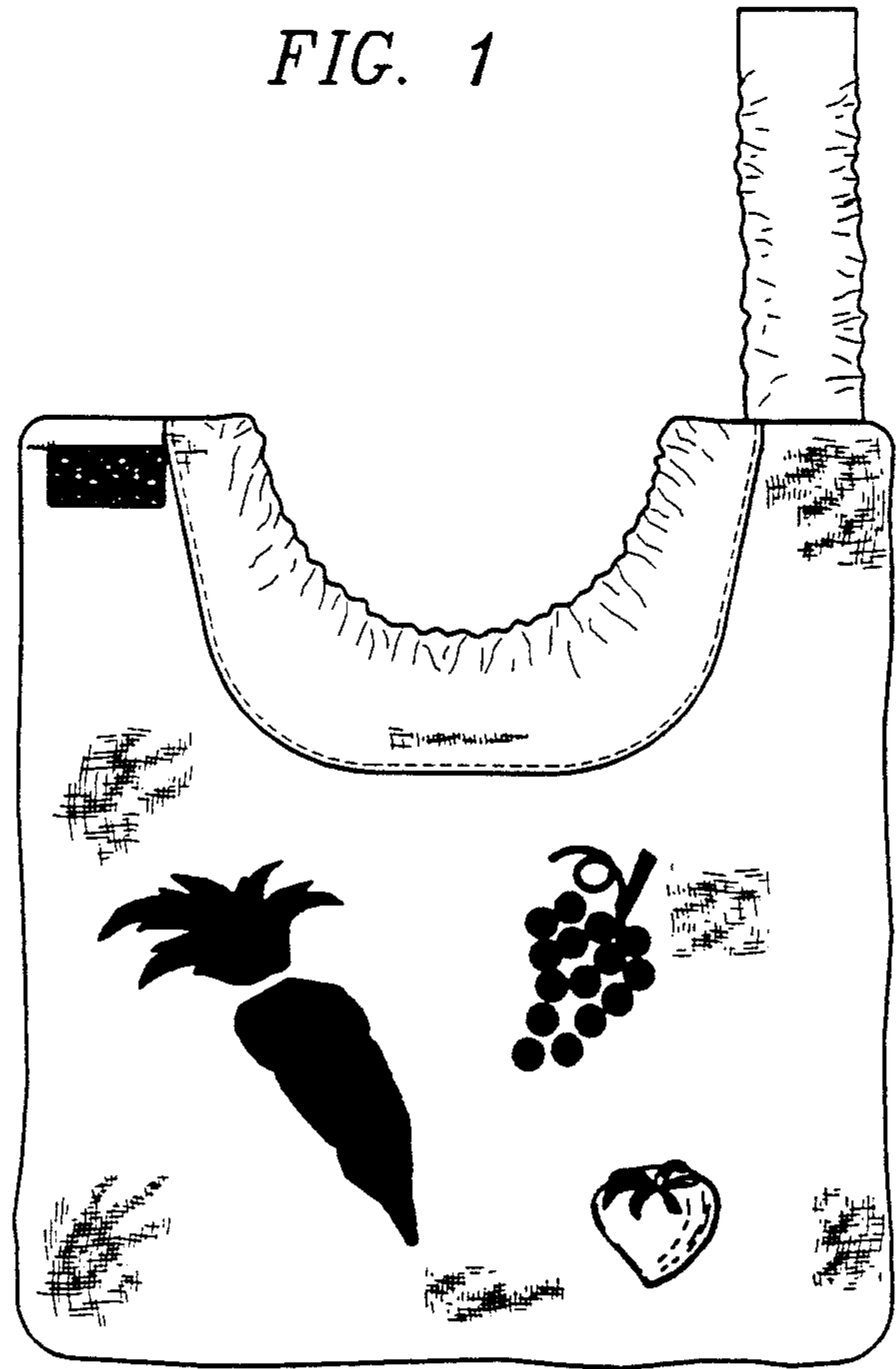

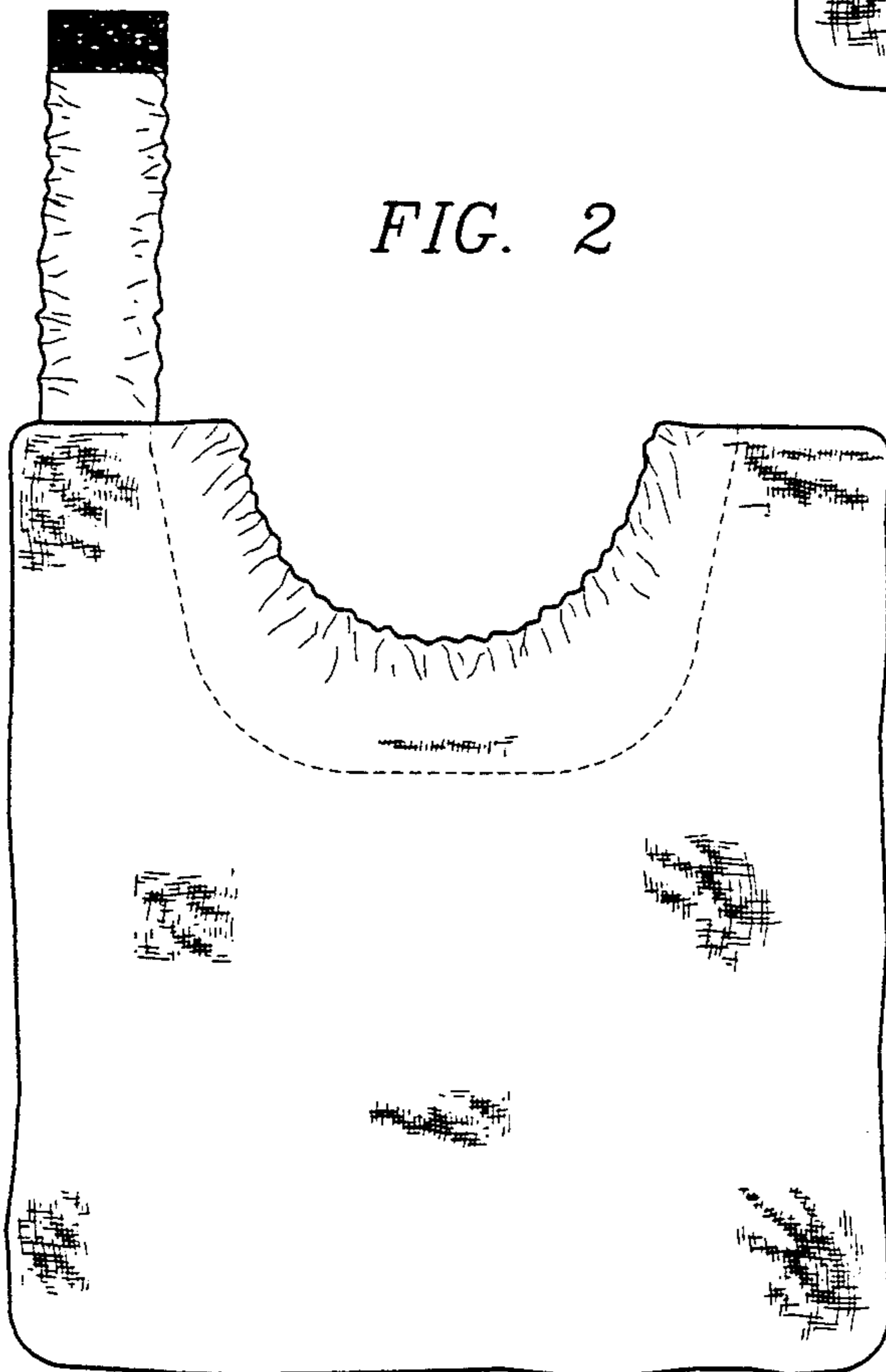

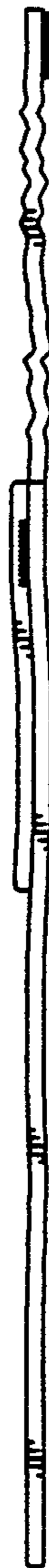

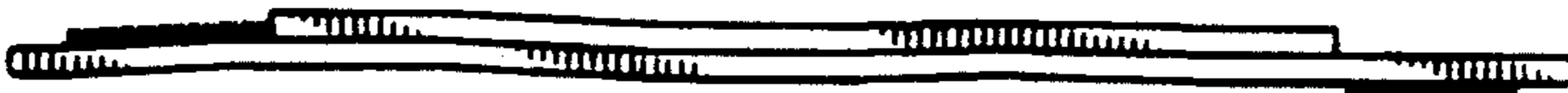
