FIG. 1 is a front view of a modular console command center workstation showing our new design;

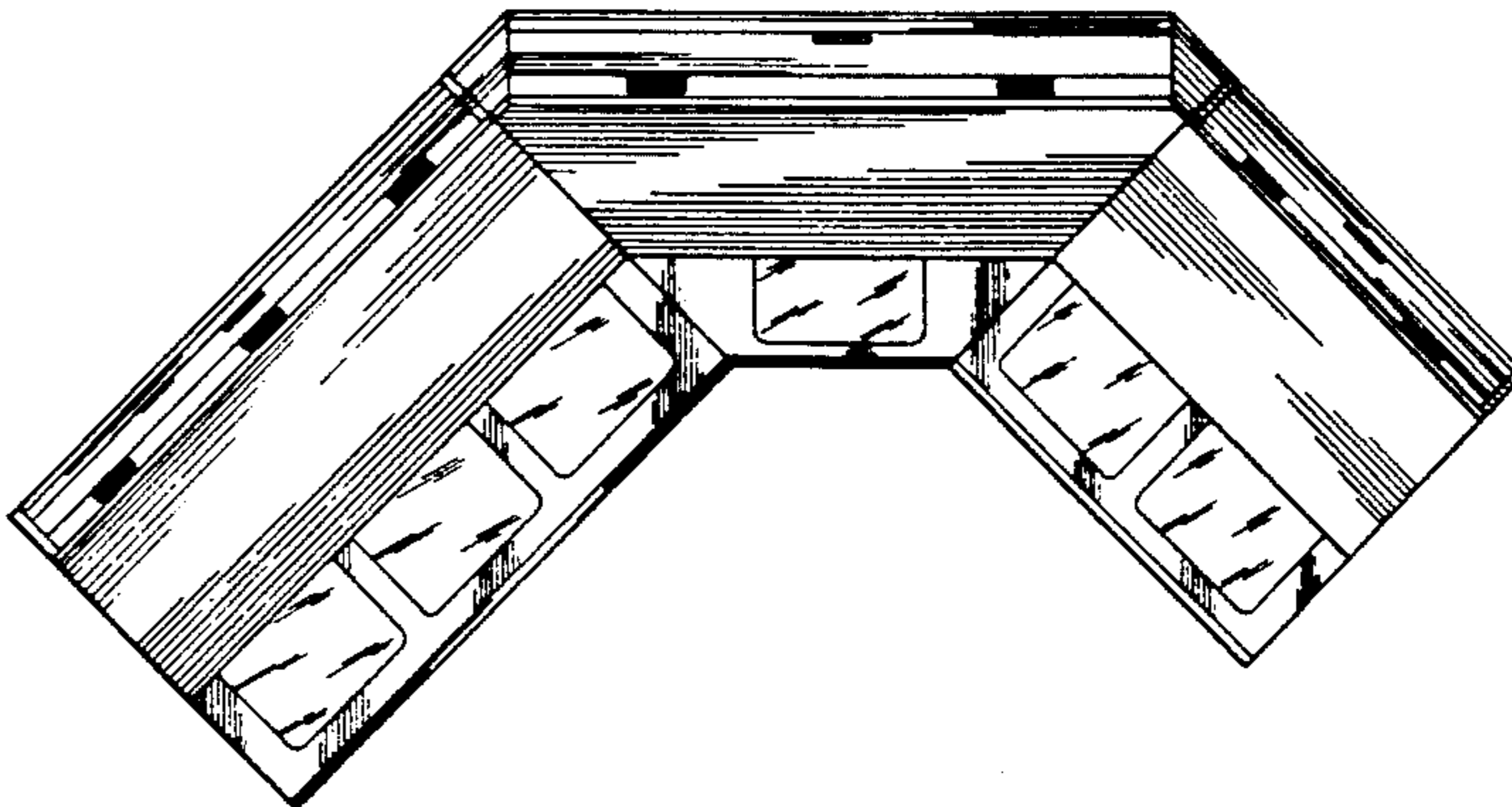
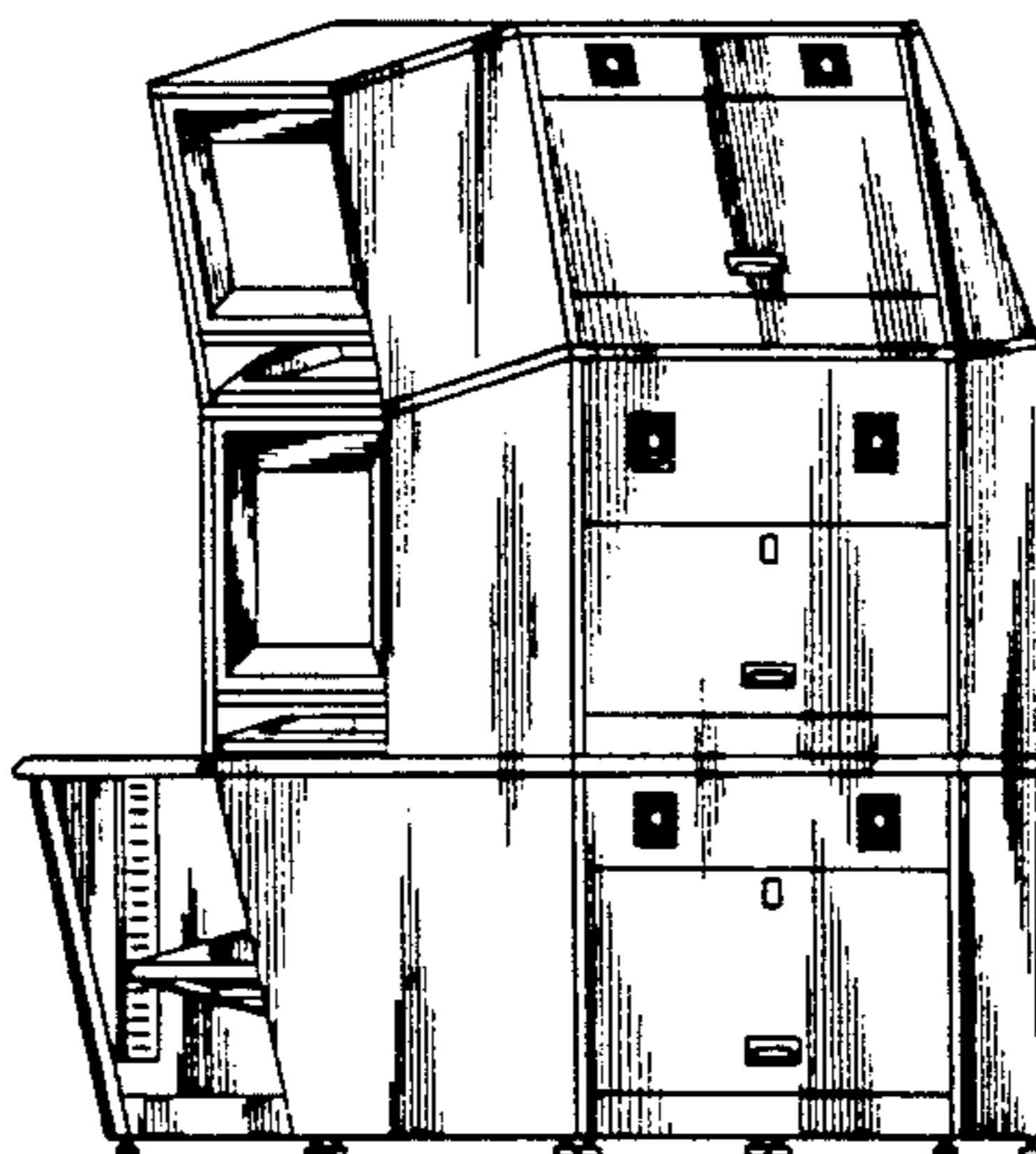
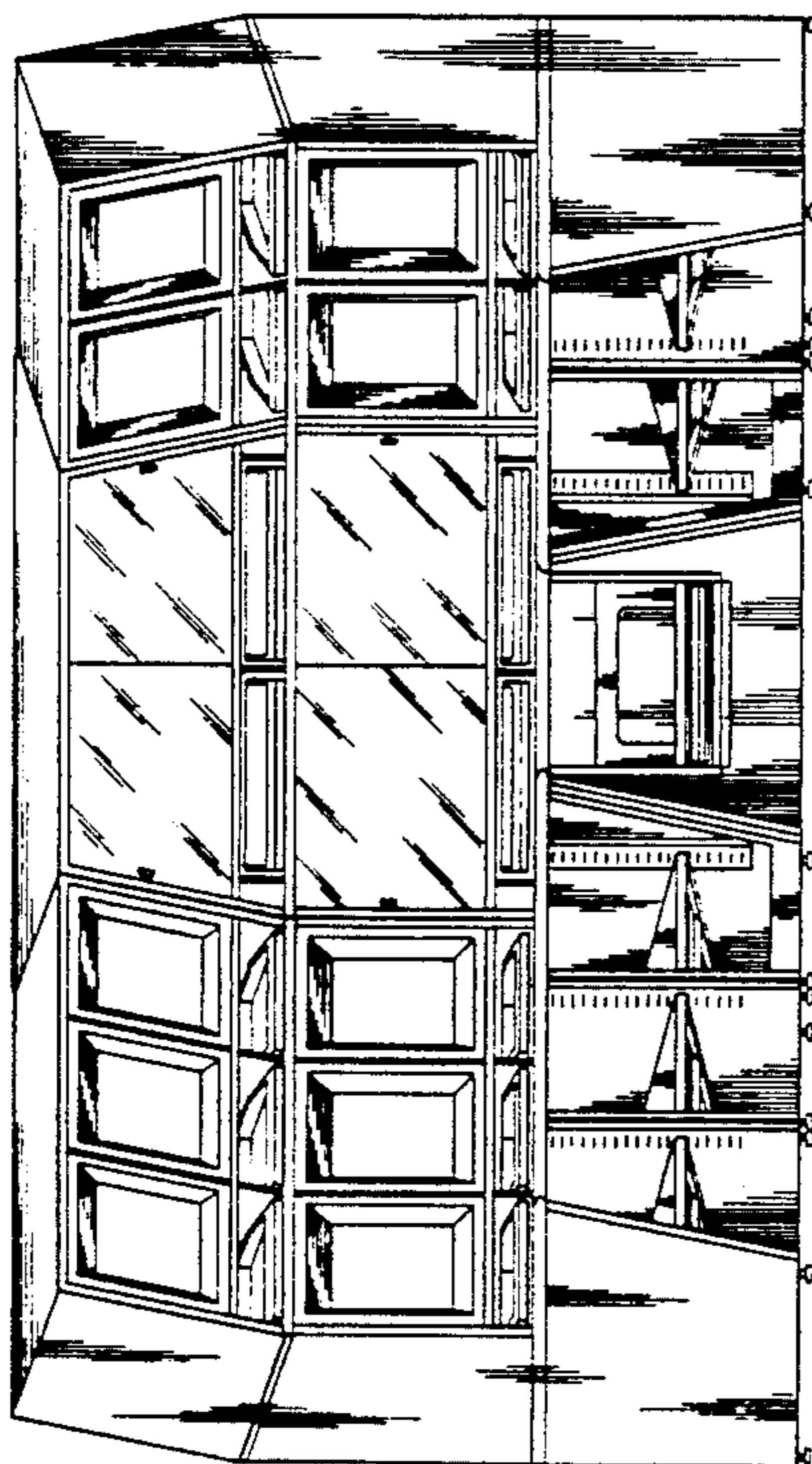
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



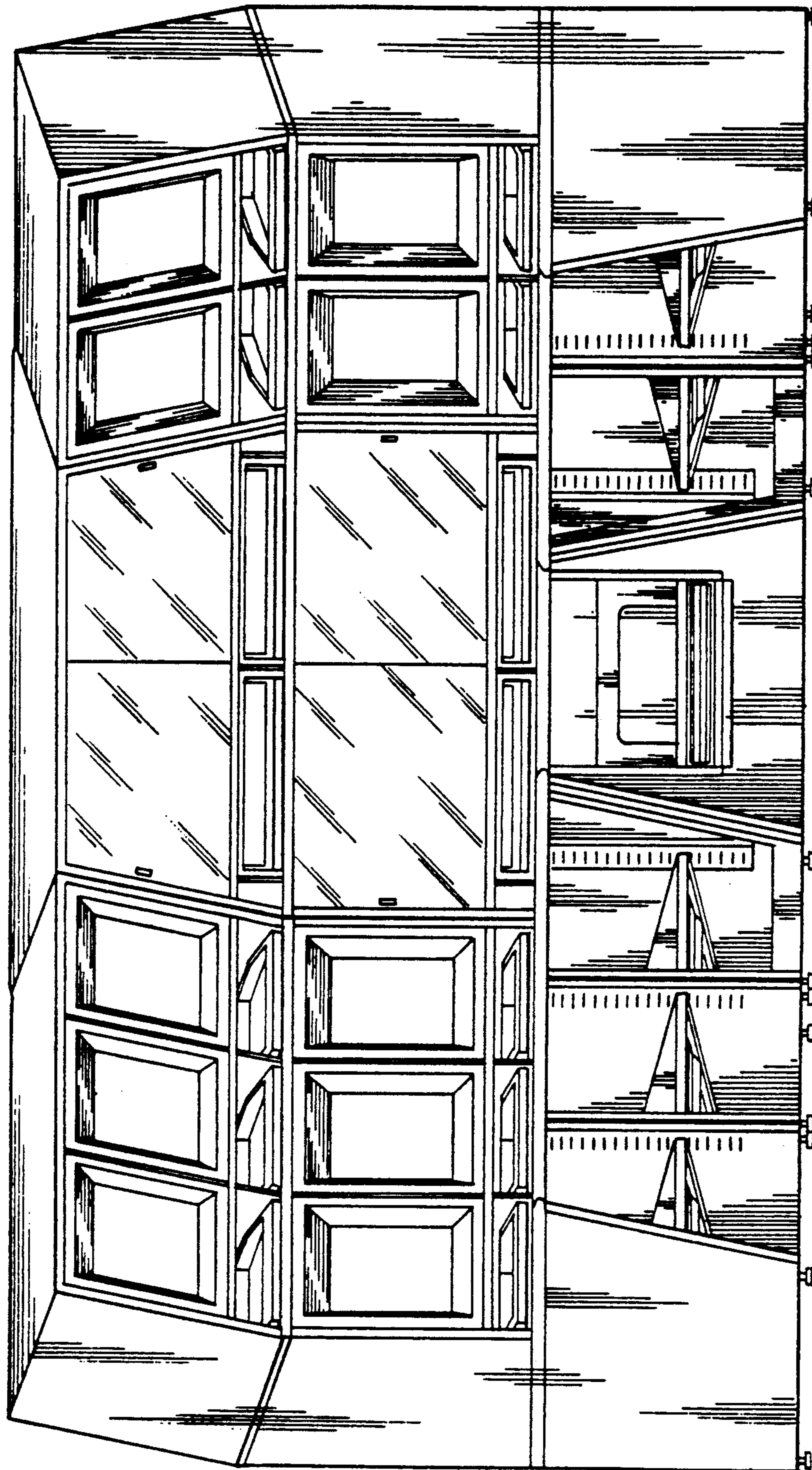

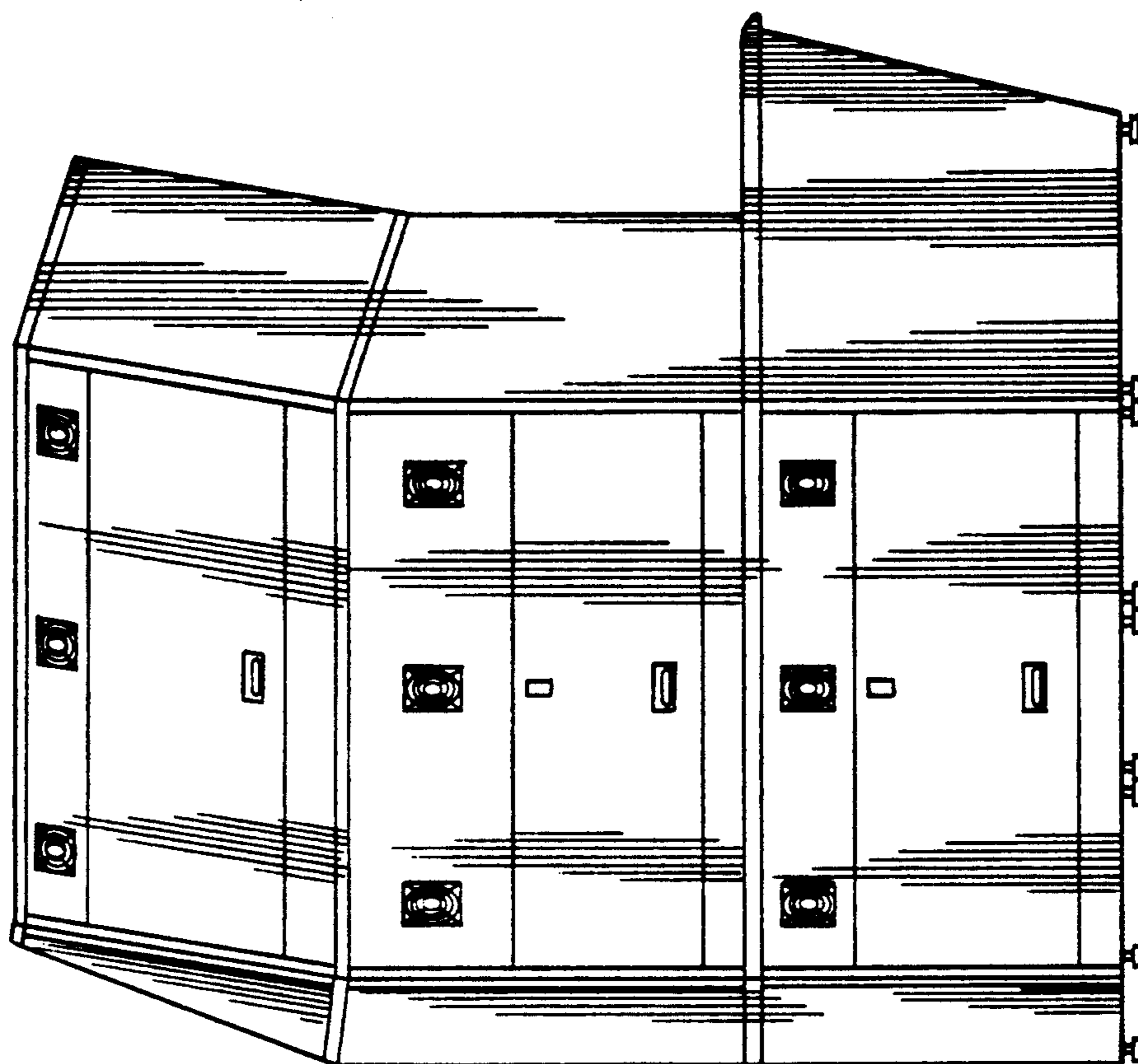
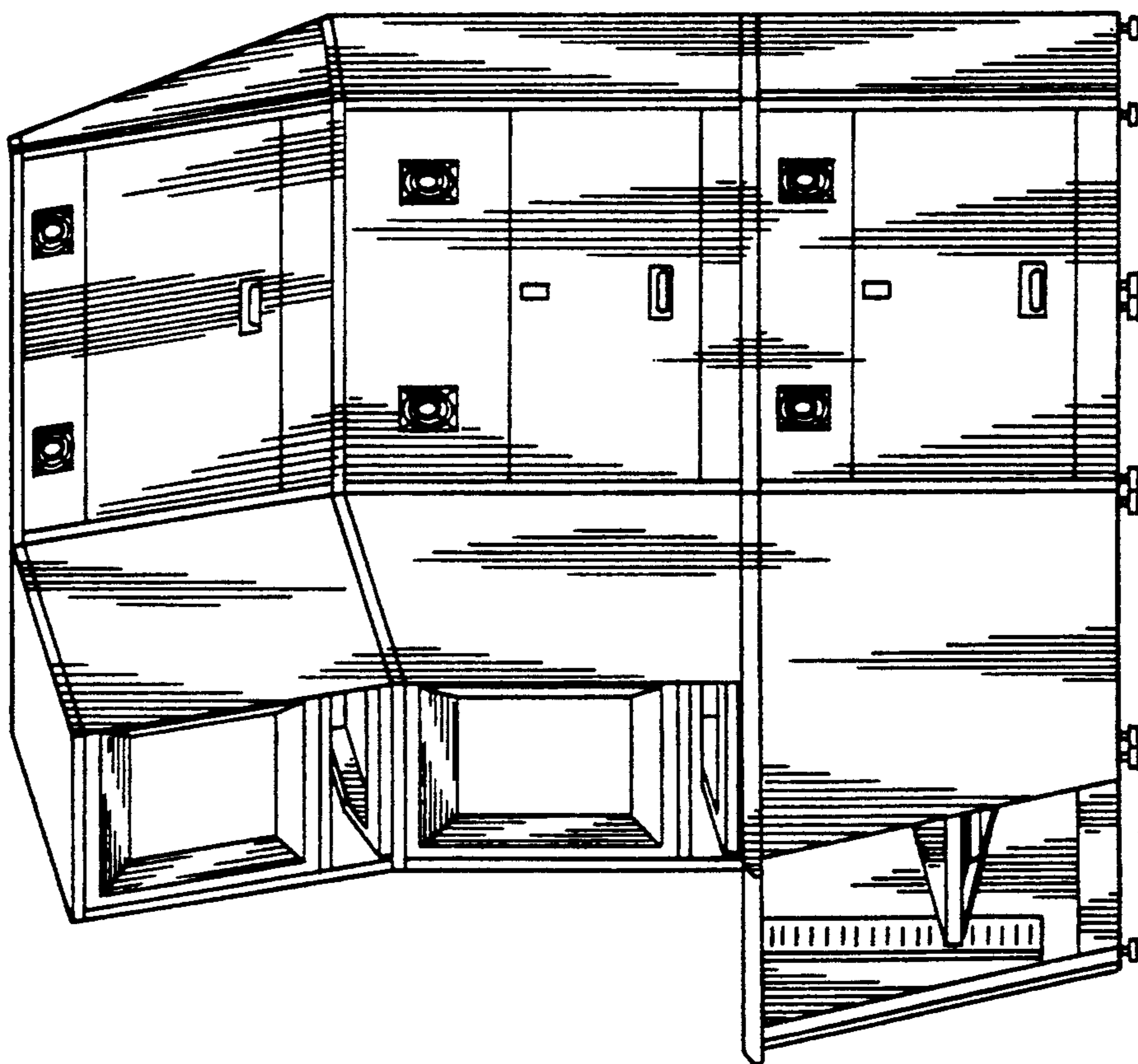

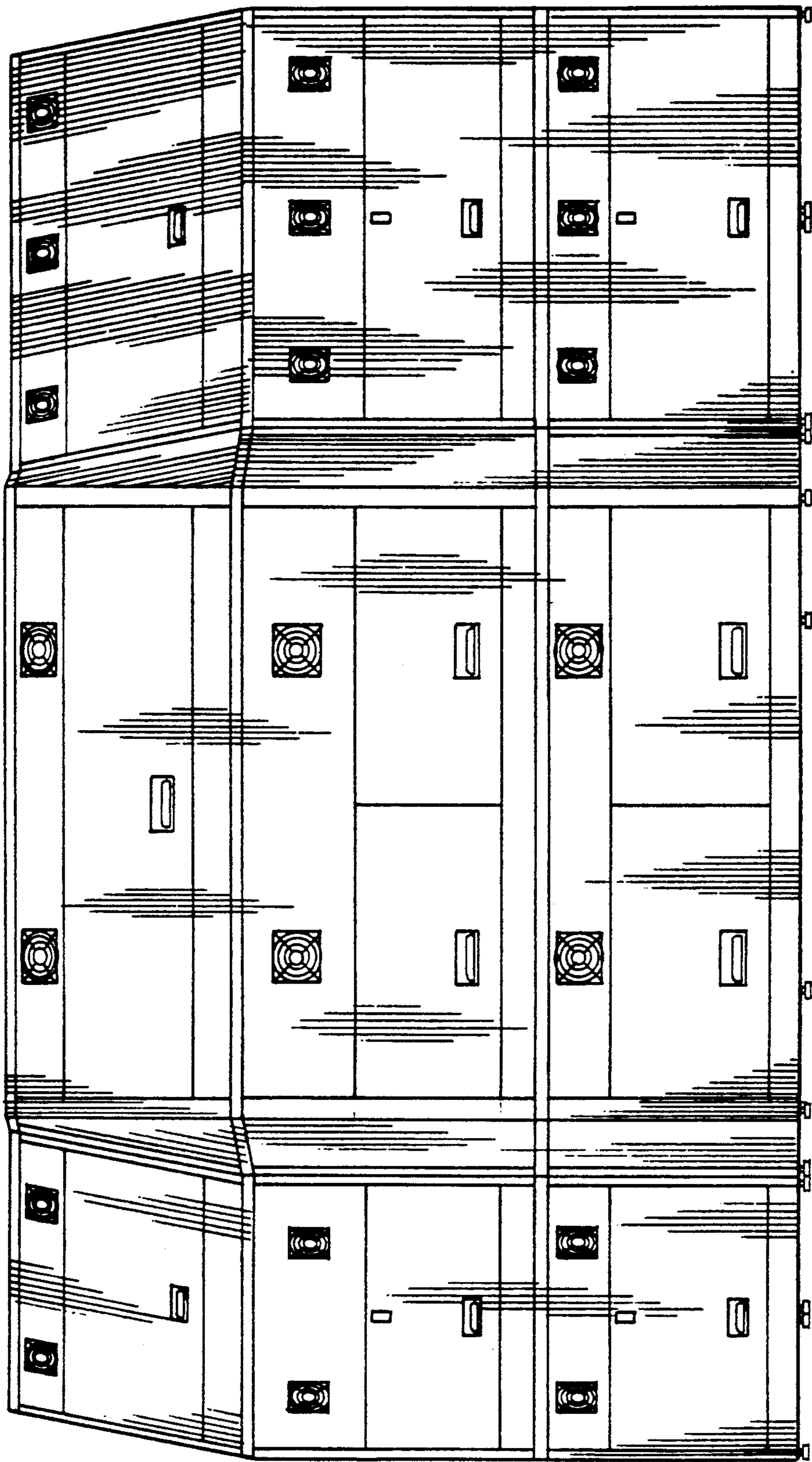

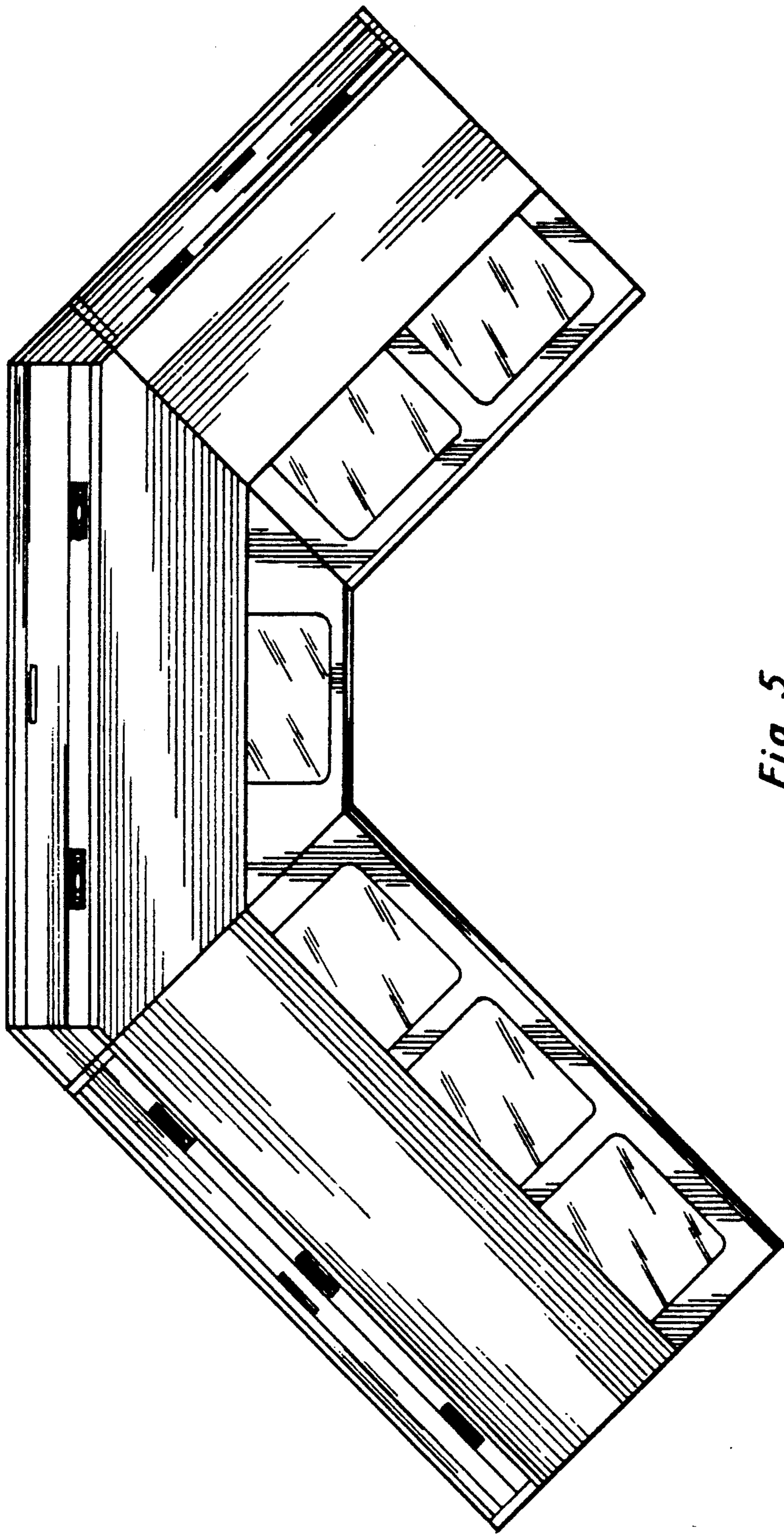

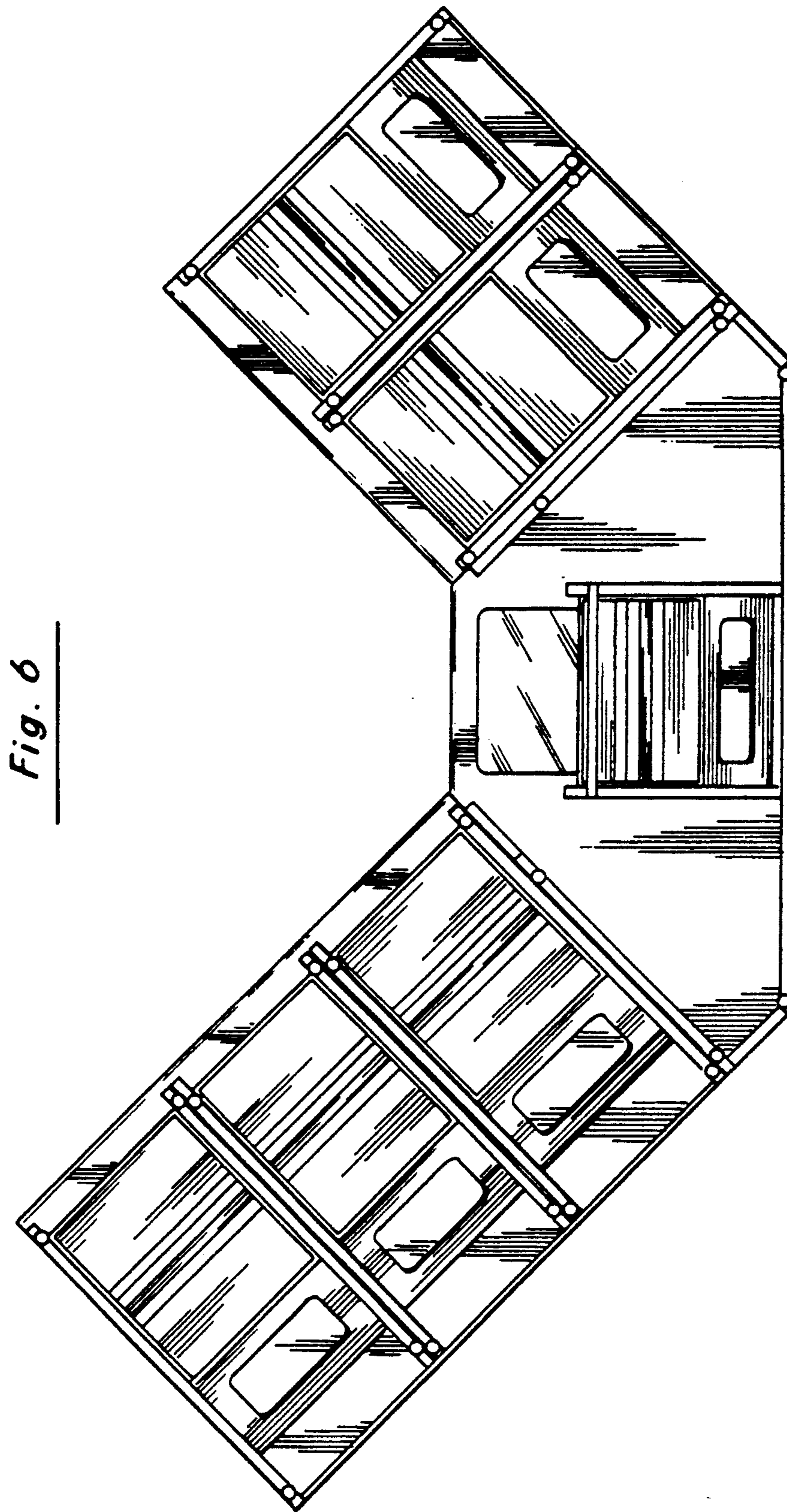
