FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of one side of a shoe fastening system showing our new design;


FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the other side of the shoe fastening system shown in FIG. 1;


FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the shoe fastening system shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the shoe fastening system shown in FIG. 1; and,


FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the shoe fastening system shown in FIG. 1.






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
