FIG. 1 is a perspective view looking down at the top of a mounting for a telescope mirror showing my new design;

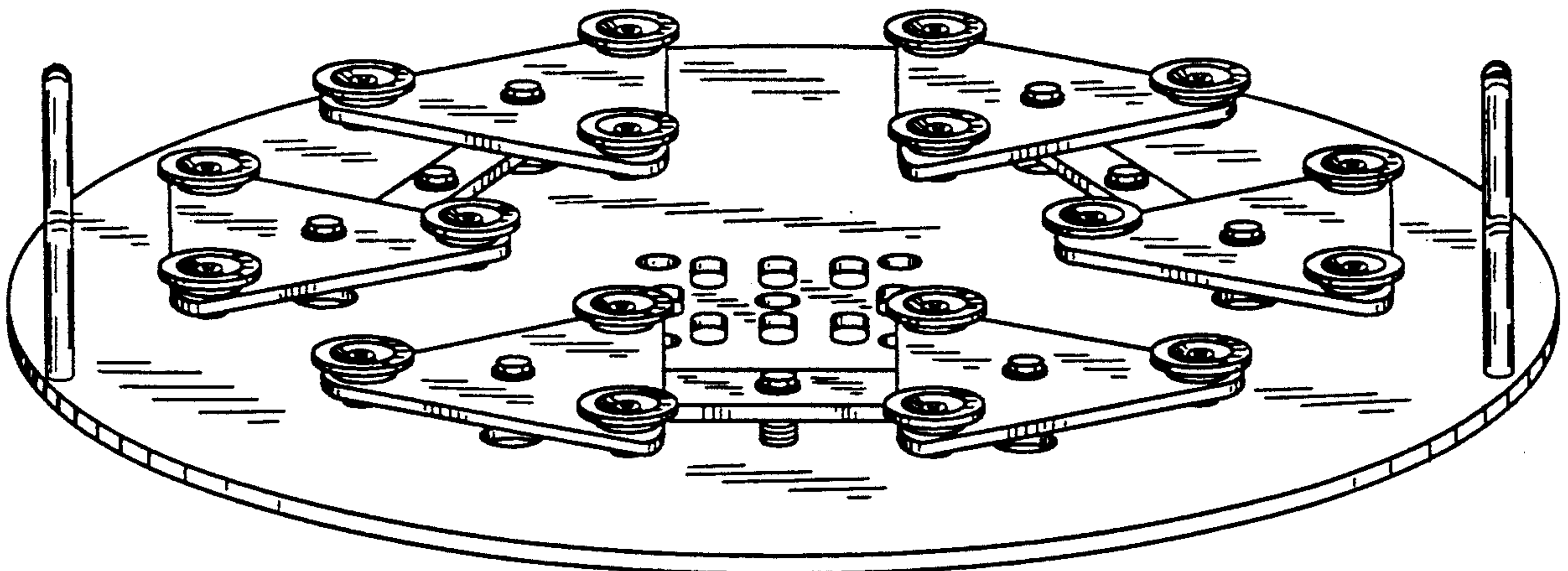
FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the mounting looking upwardly at the bottom of the mounting;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the mounting.



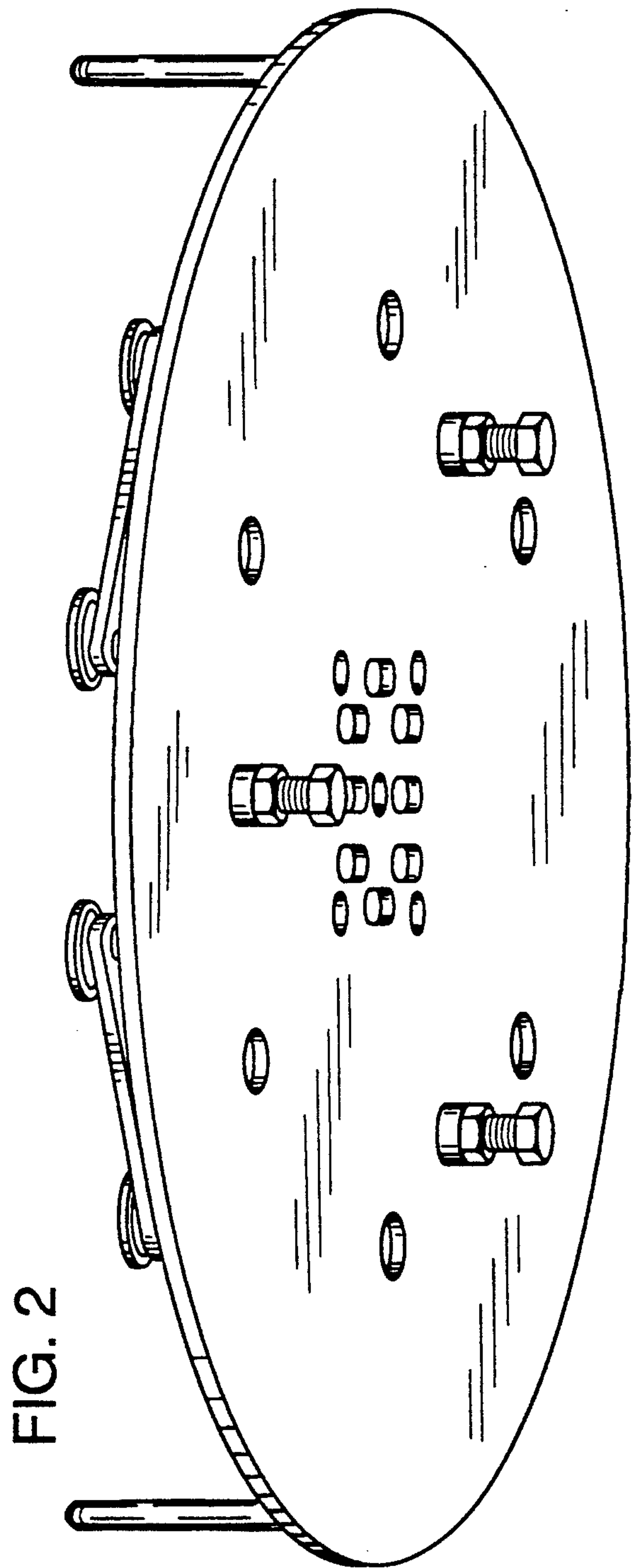
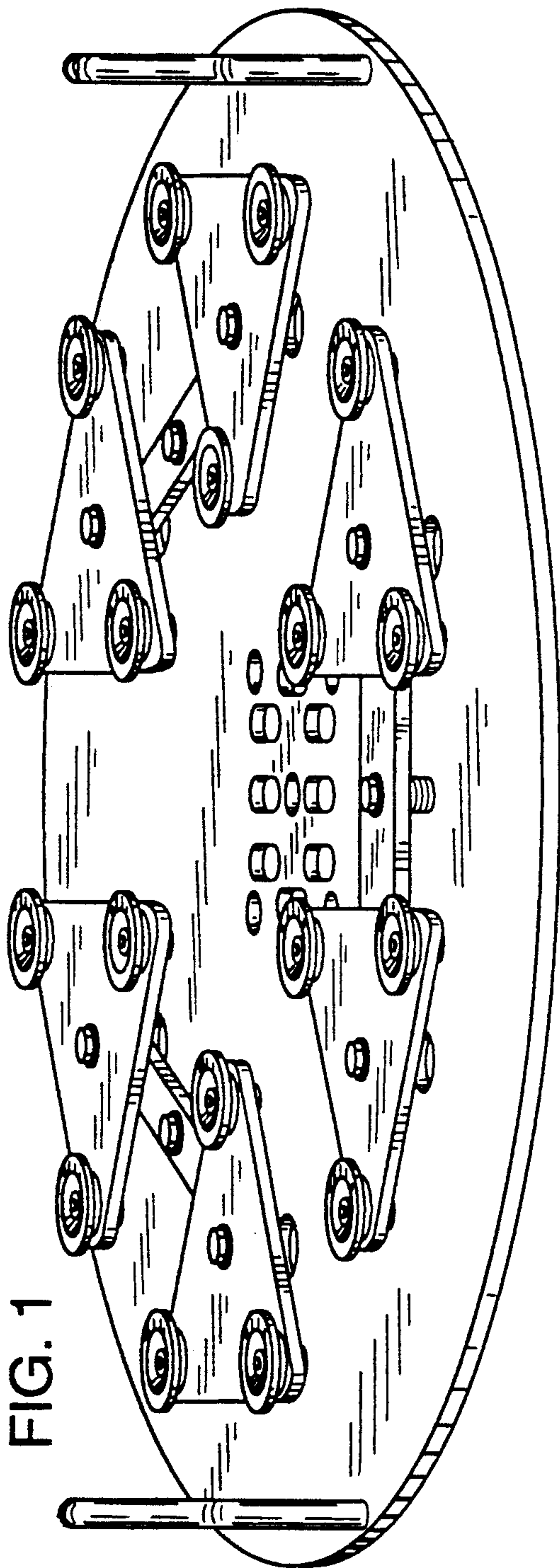

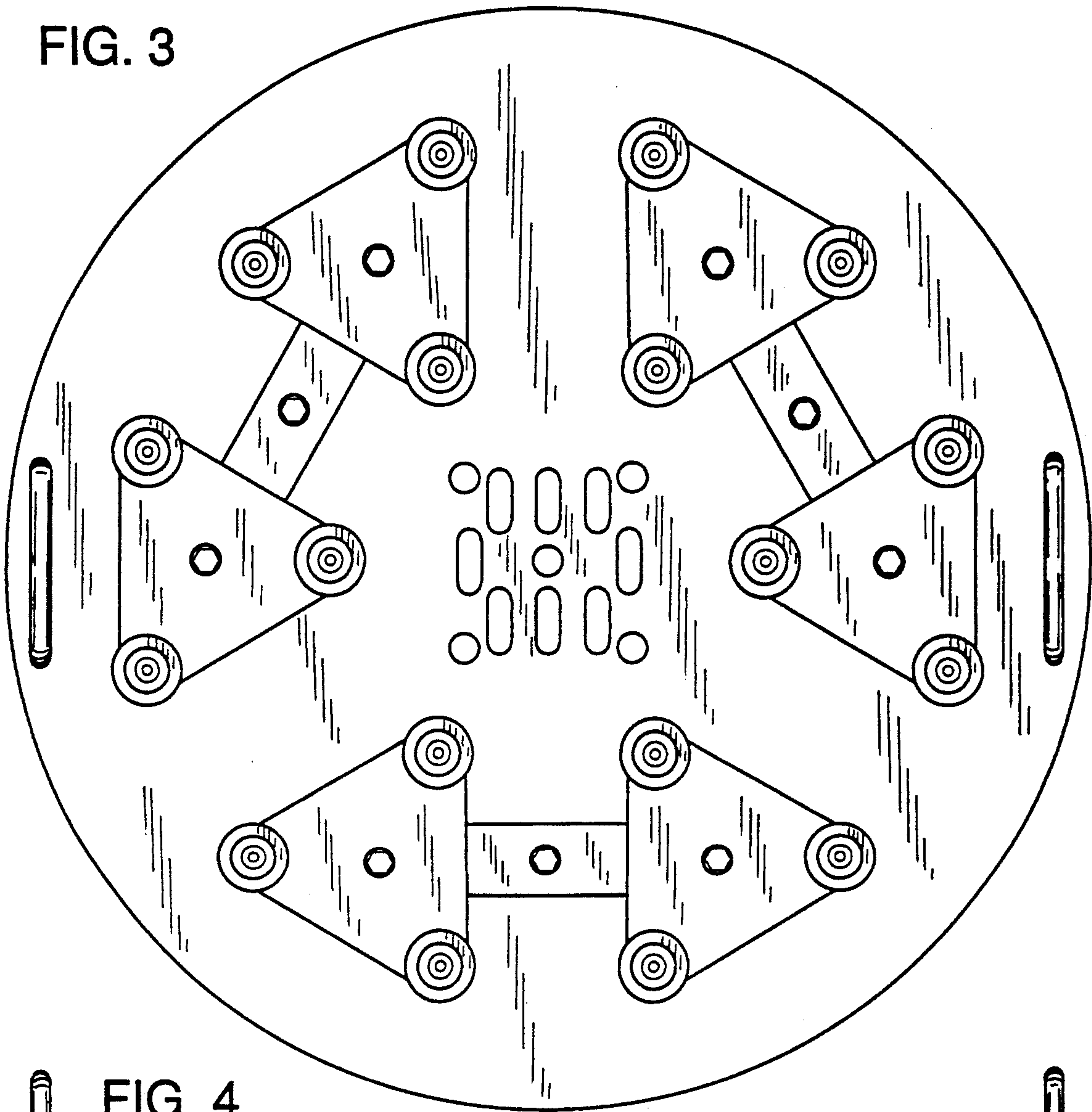

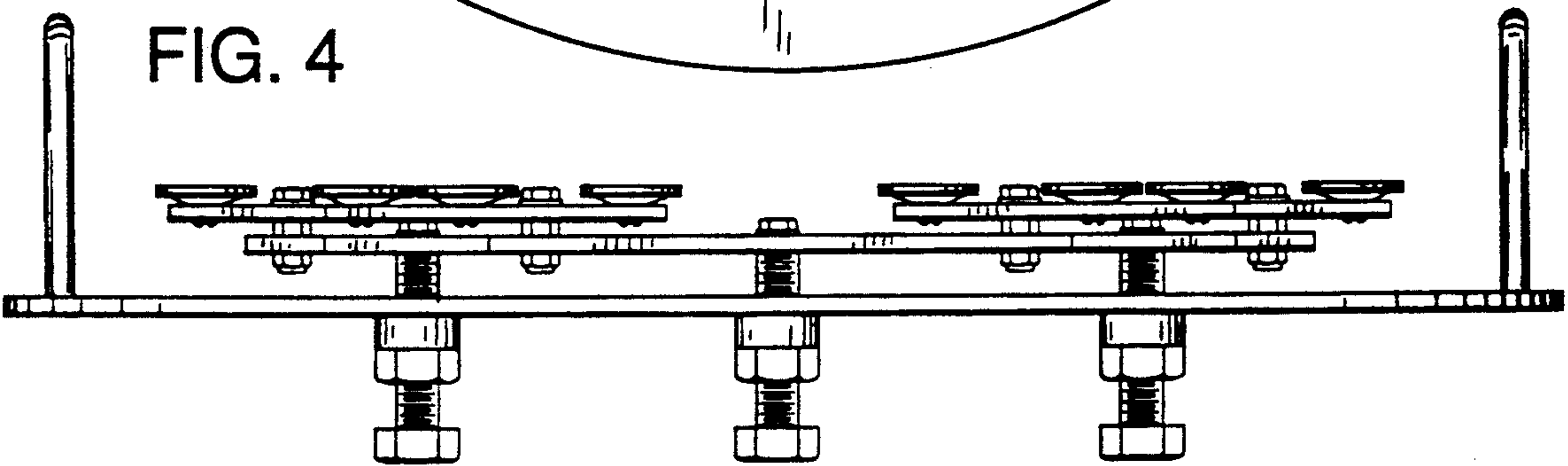

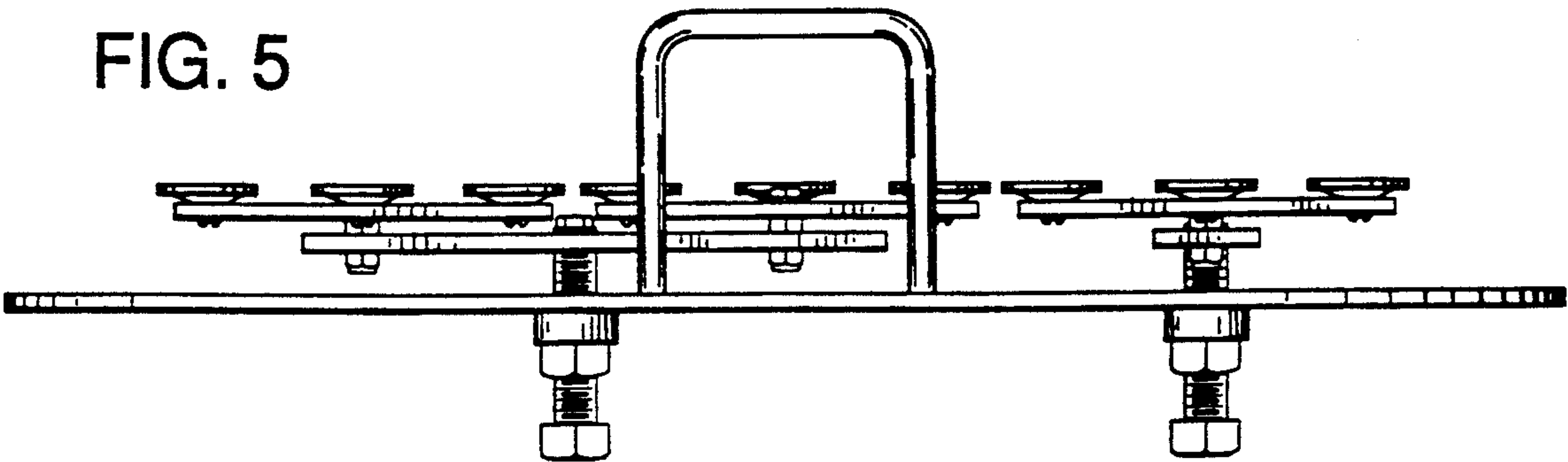
