The ornamental design for a ceiling unit, as shown and described.

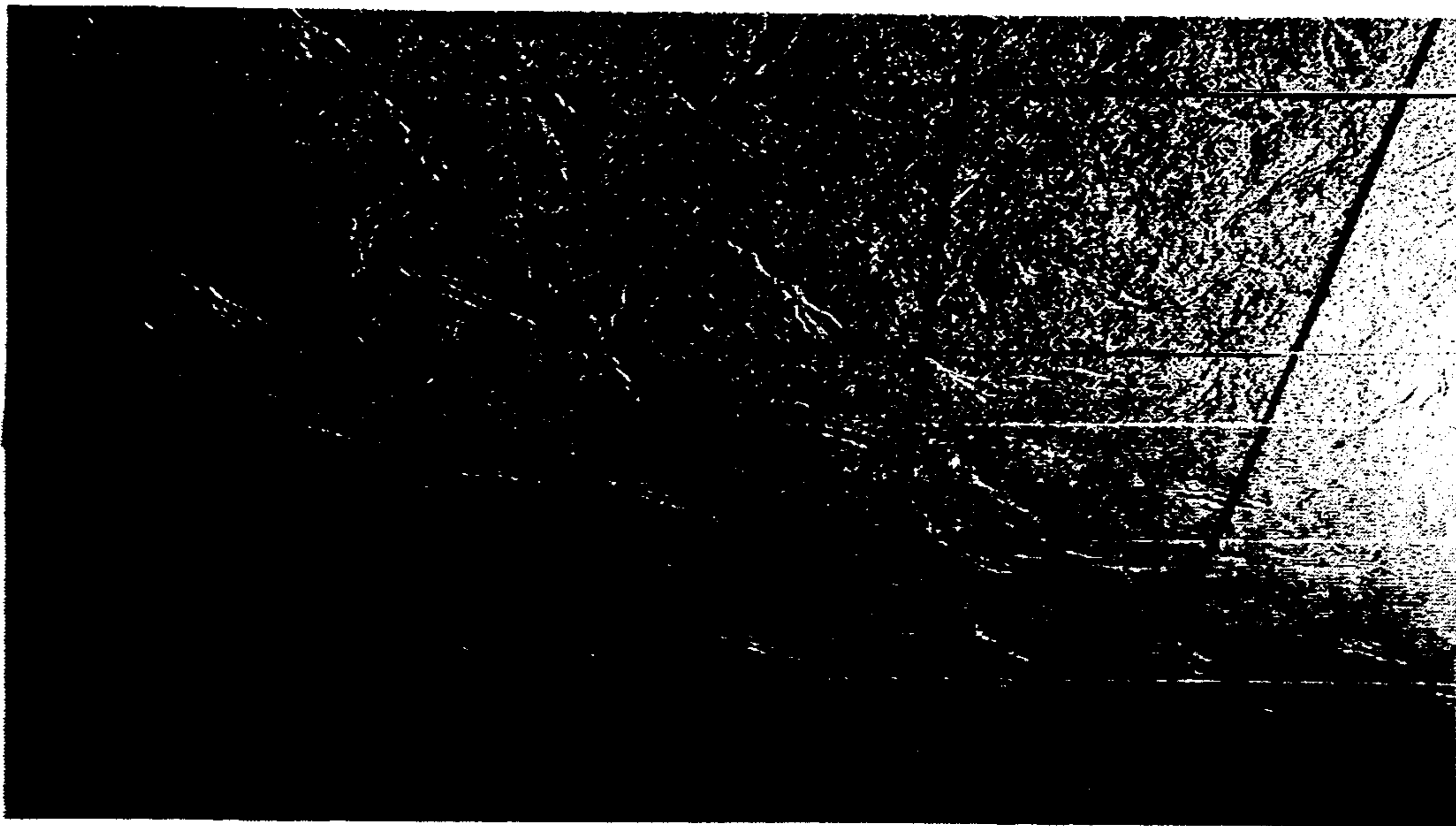
DESCRIPTION

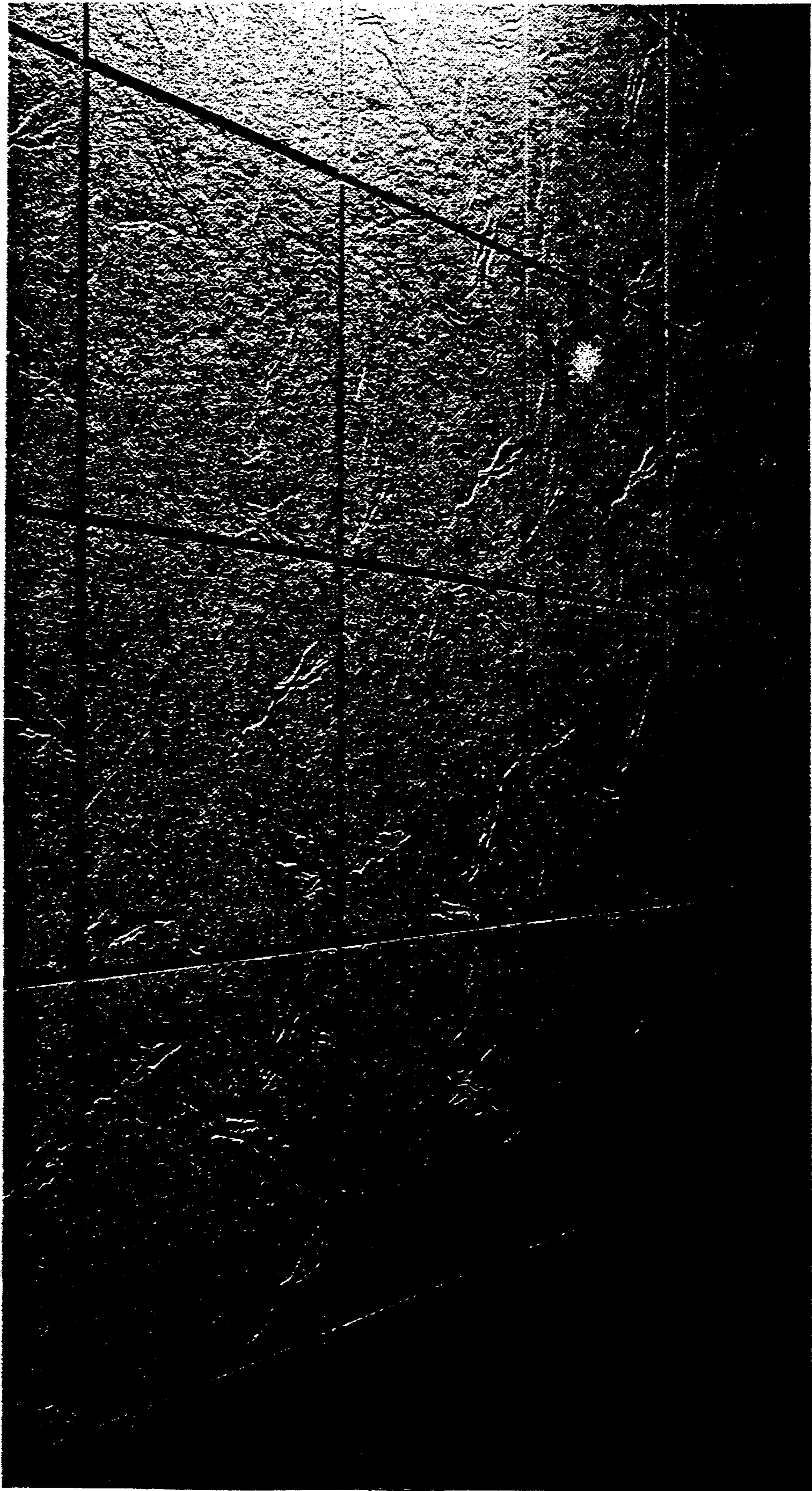

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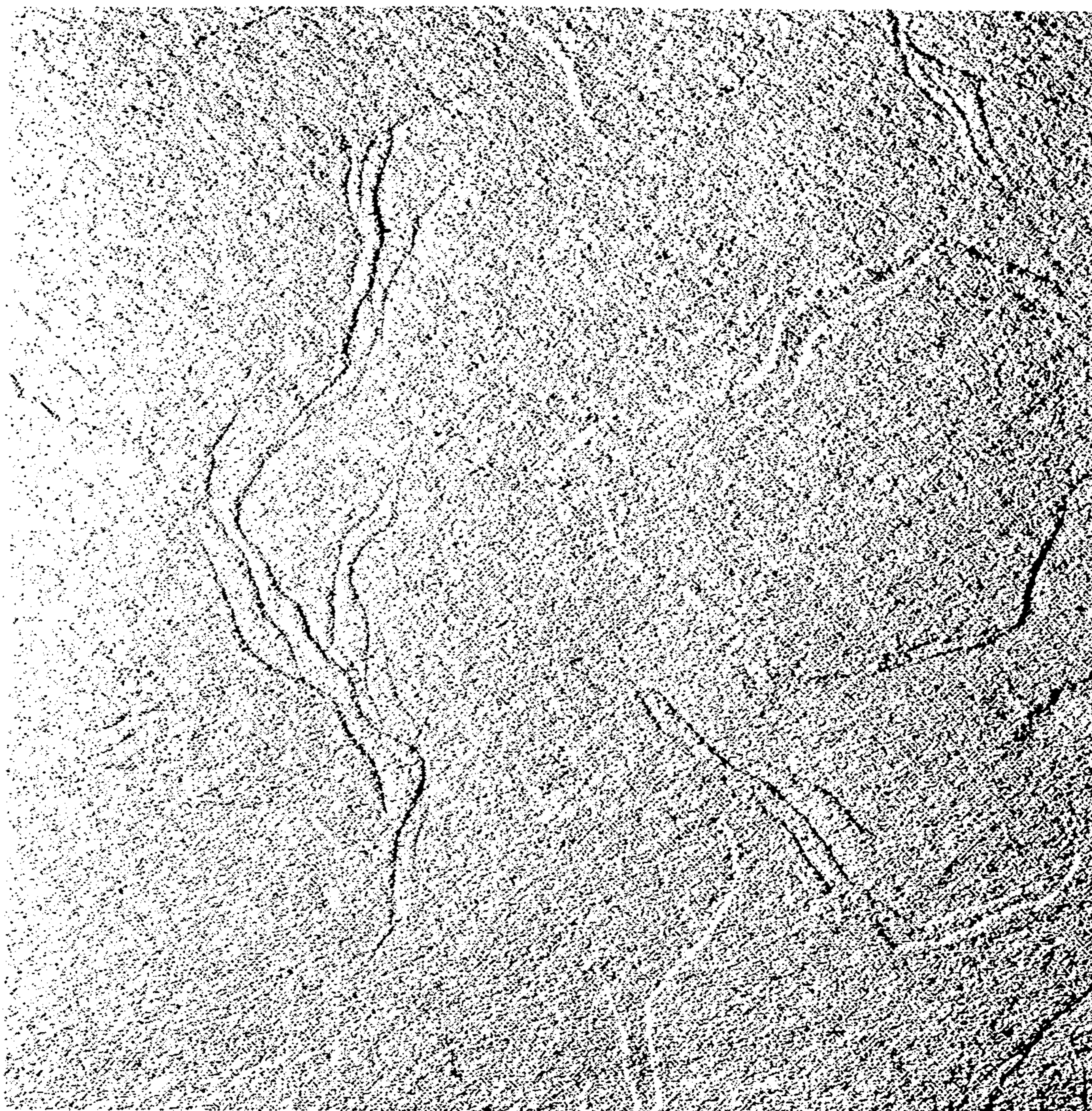
