FIG. 6 is a closer view of the seat portion of the chair in FIG. 5;

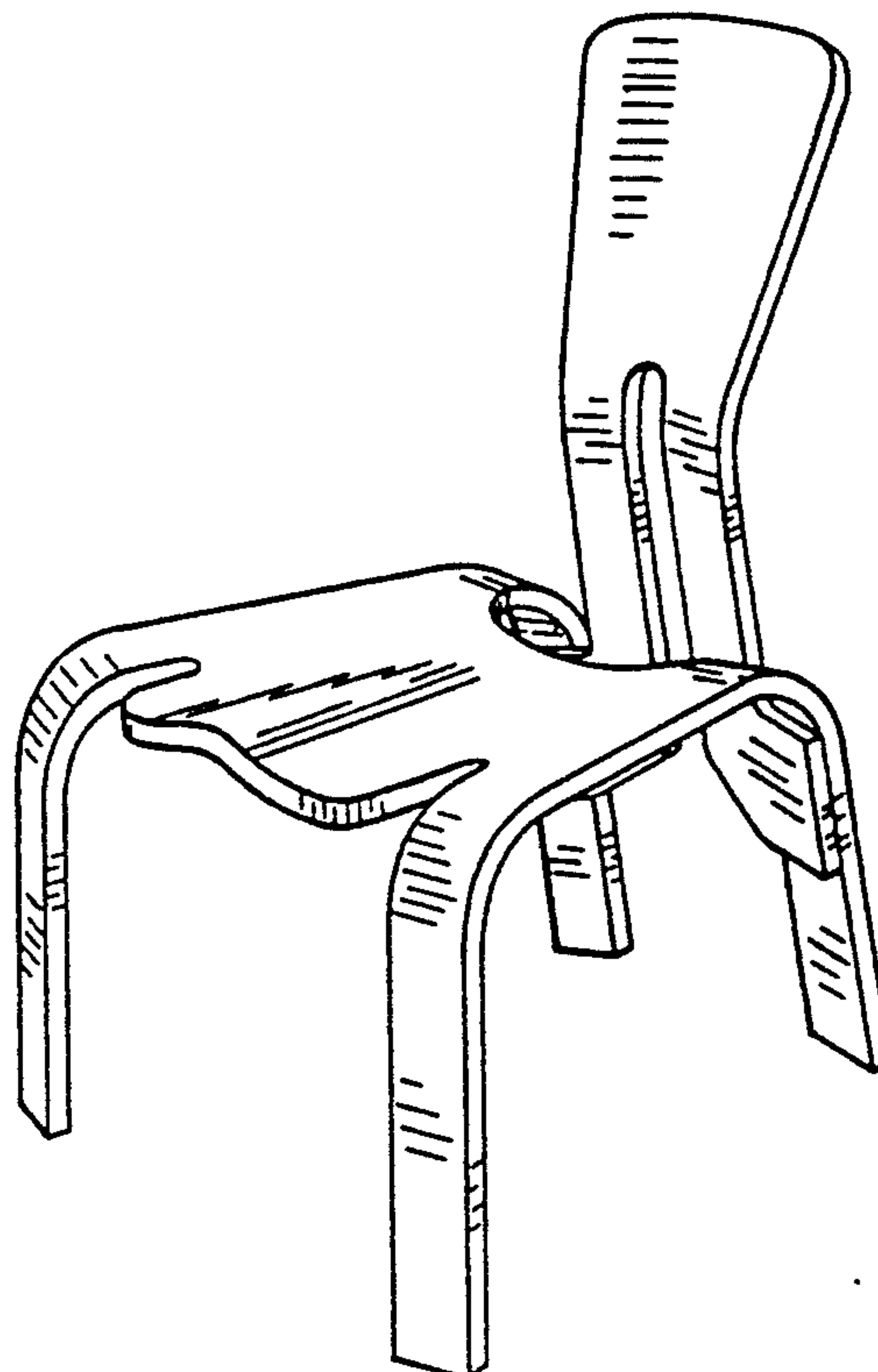
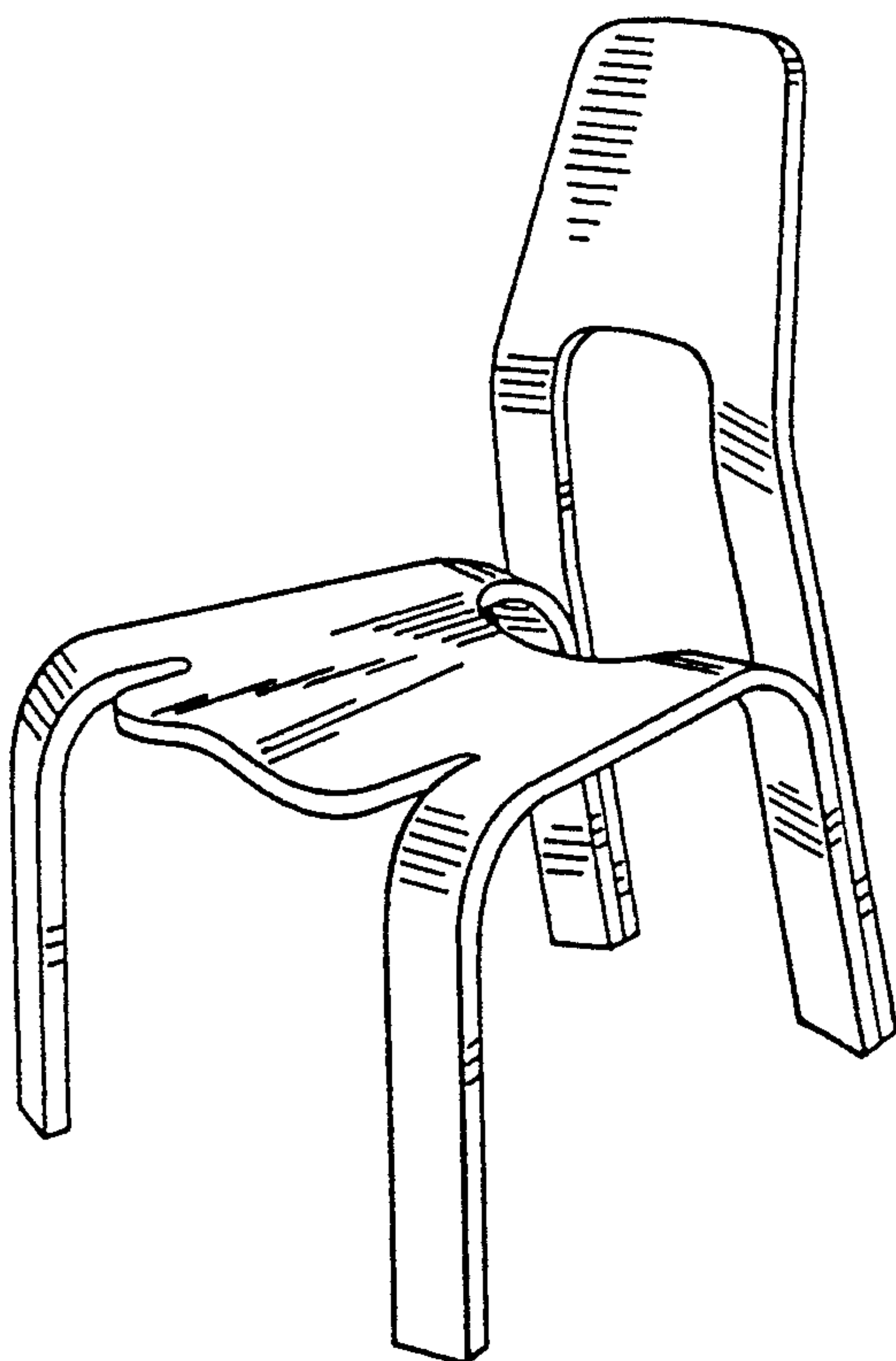
FIG. 7 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a perspective view thereof.



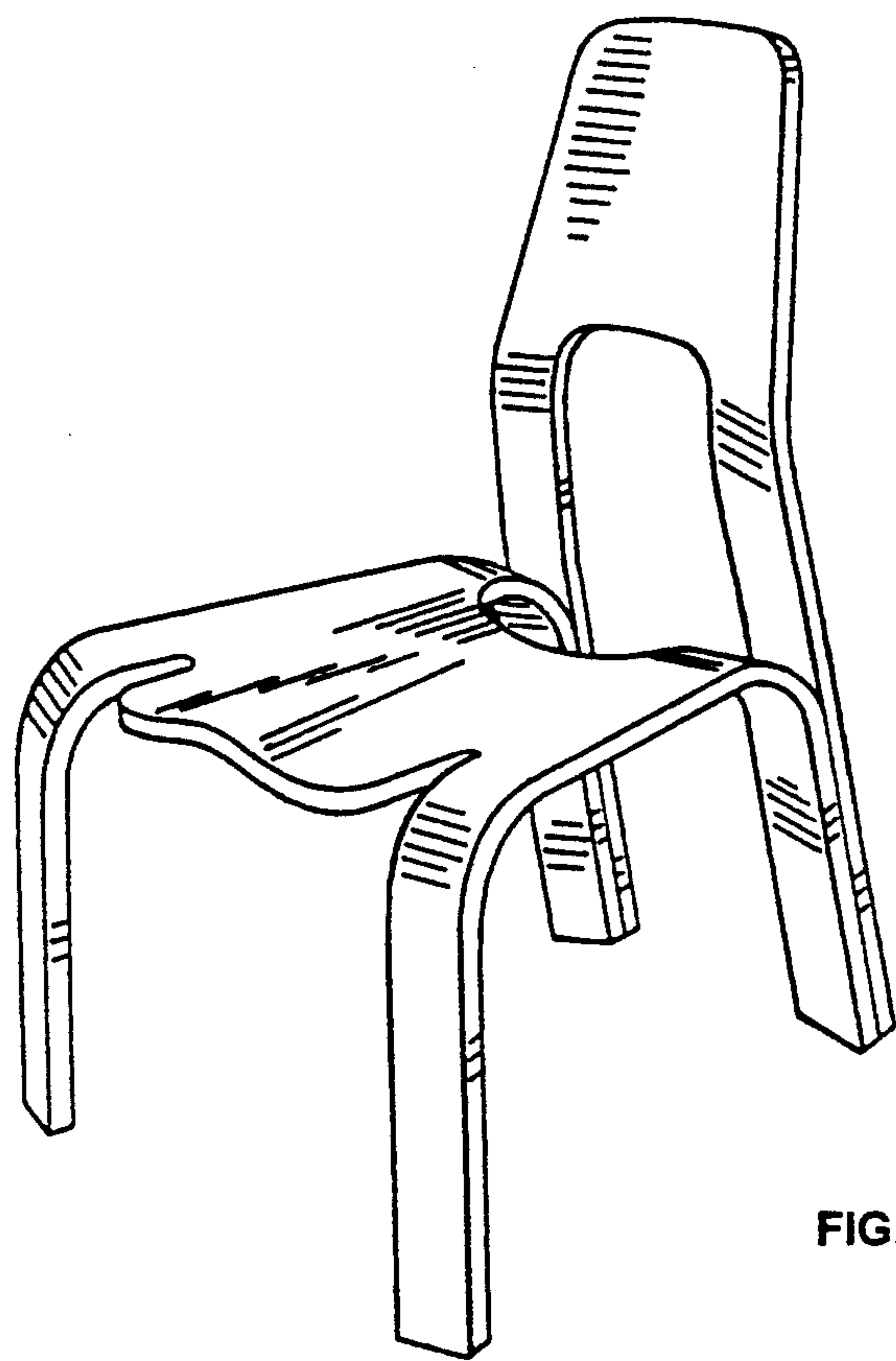

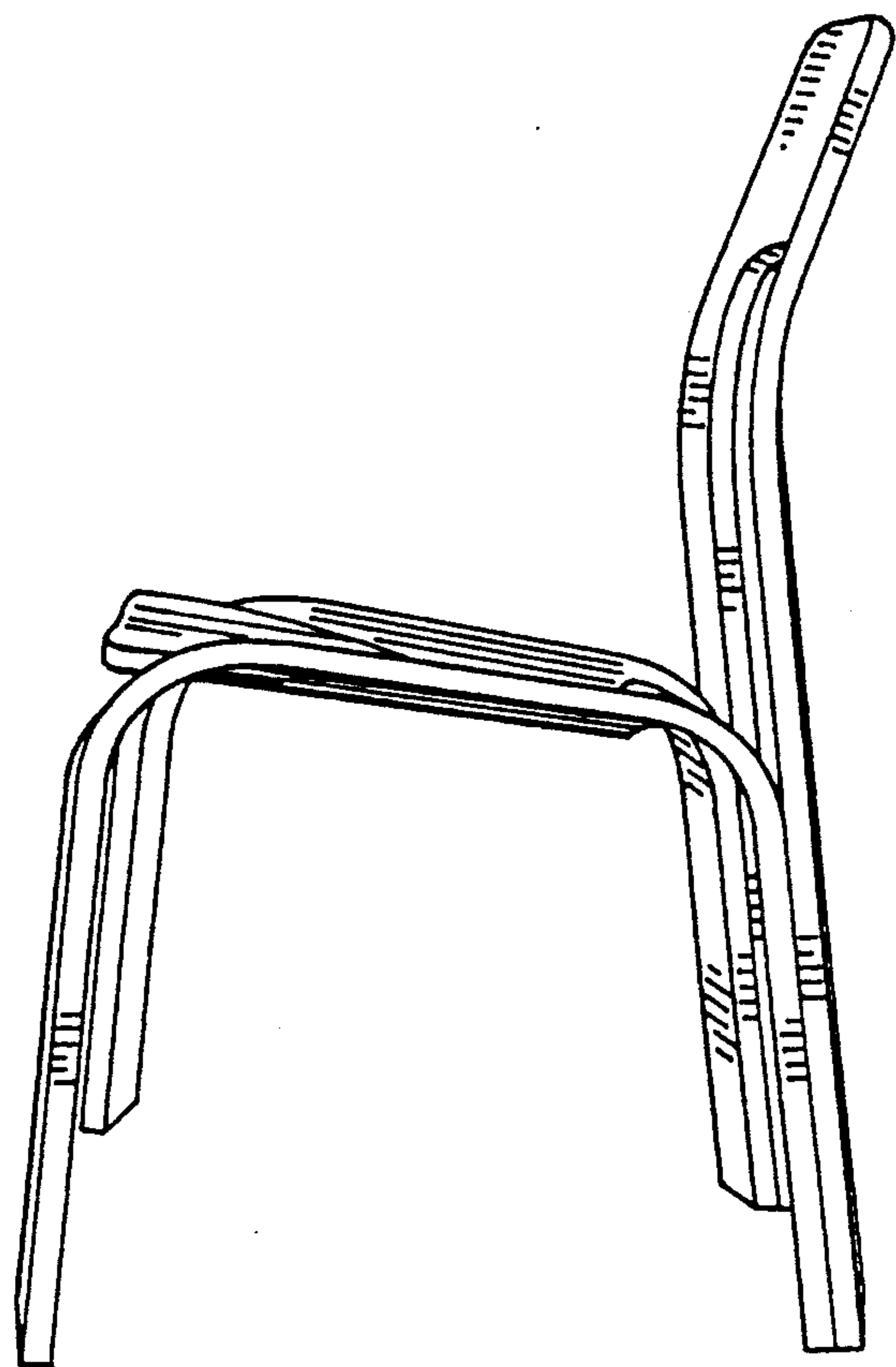

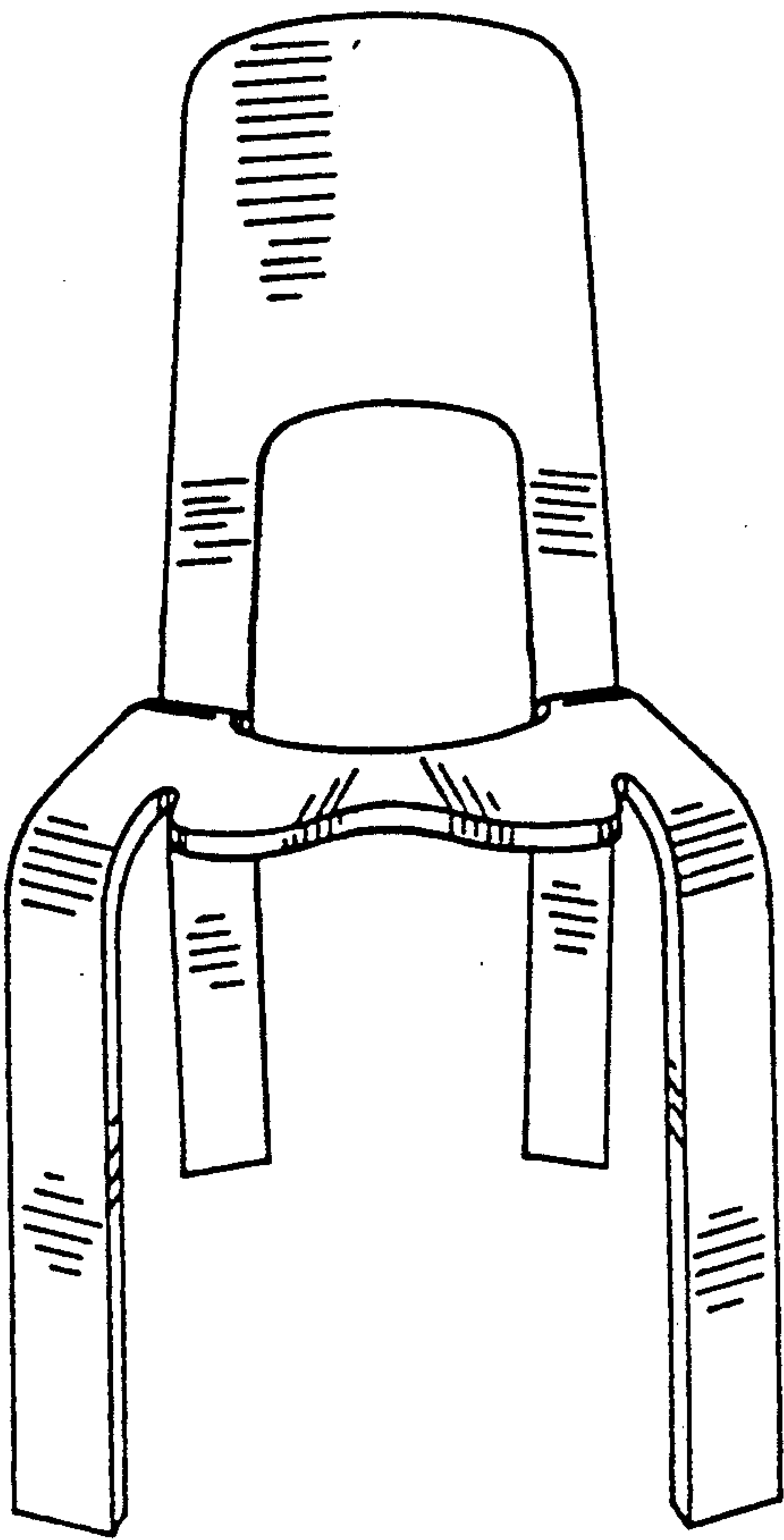

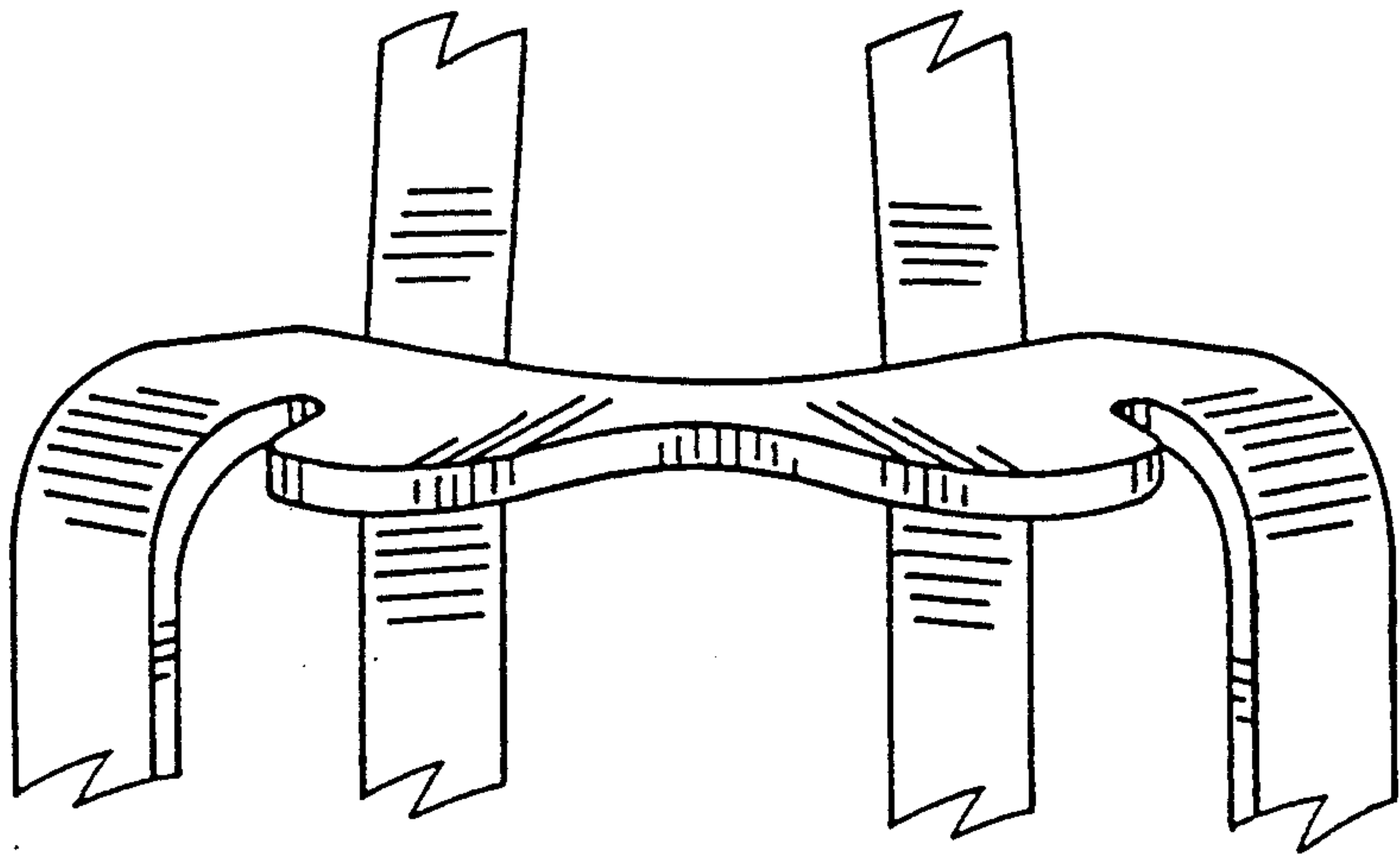

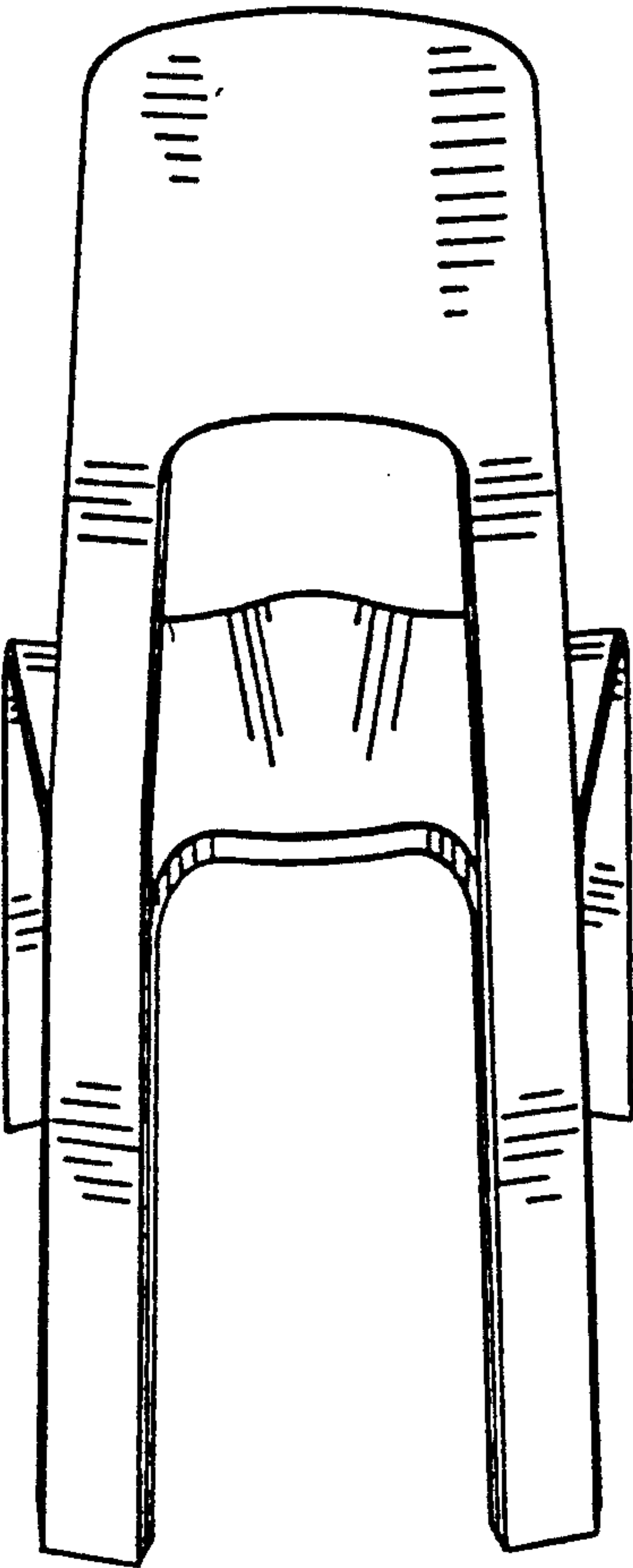

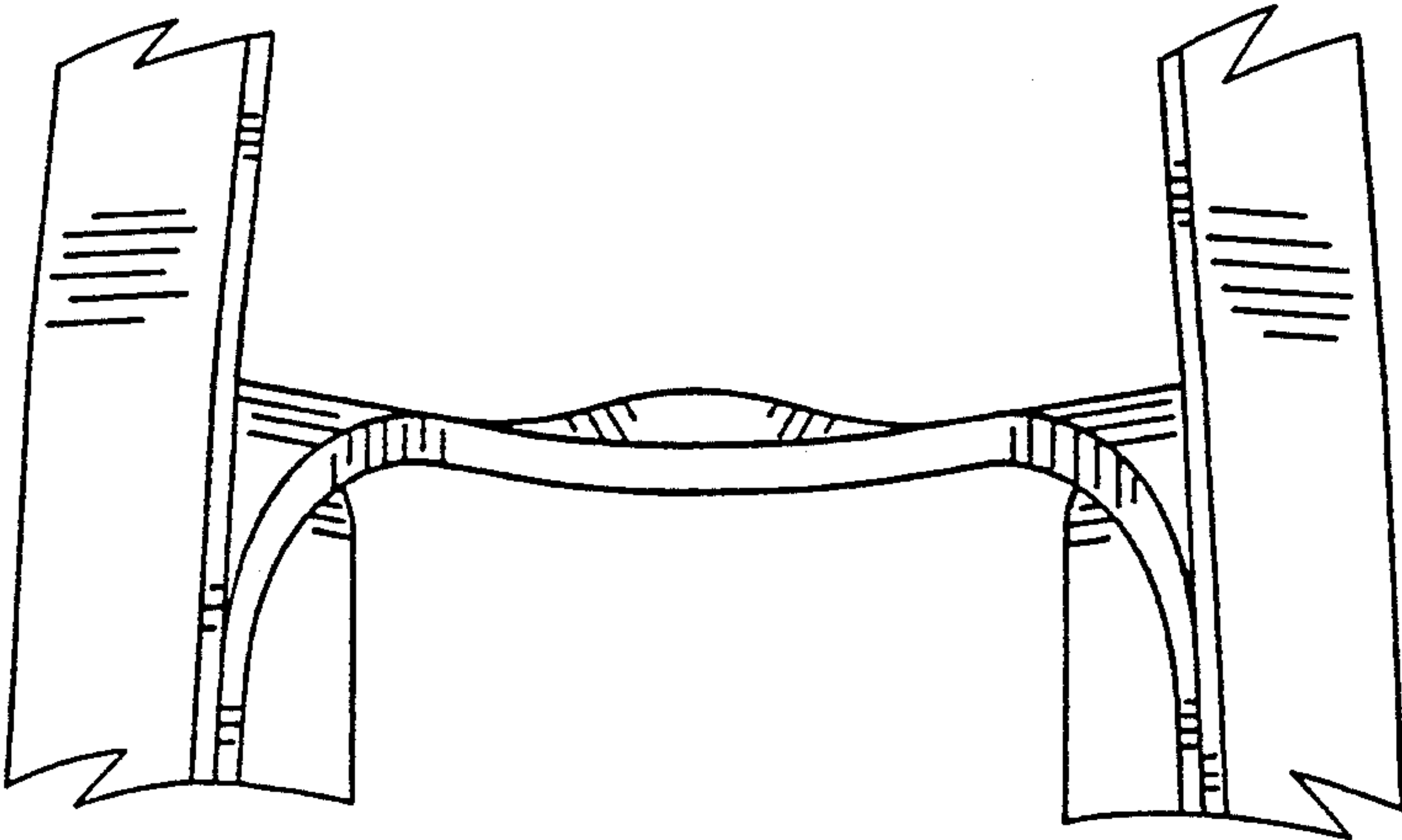

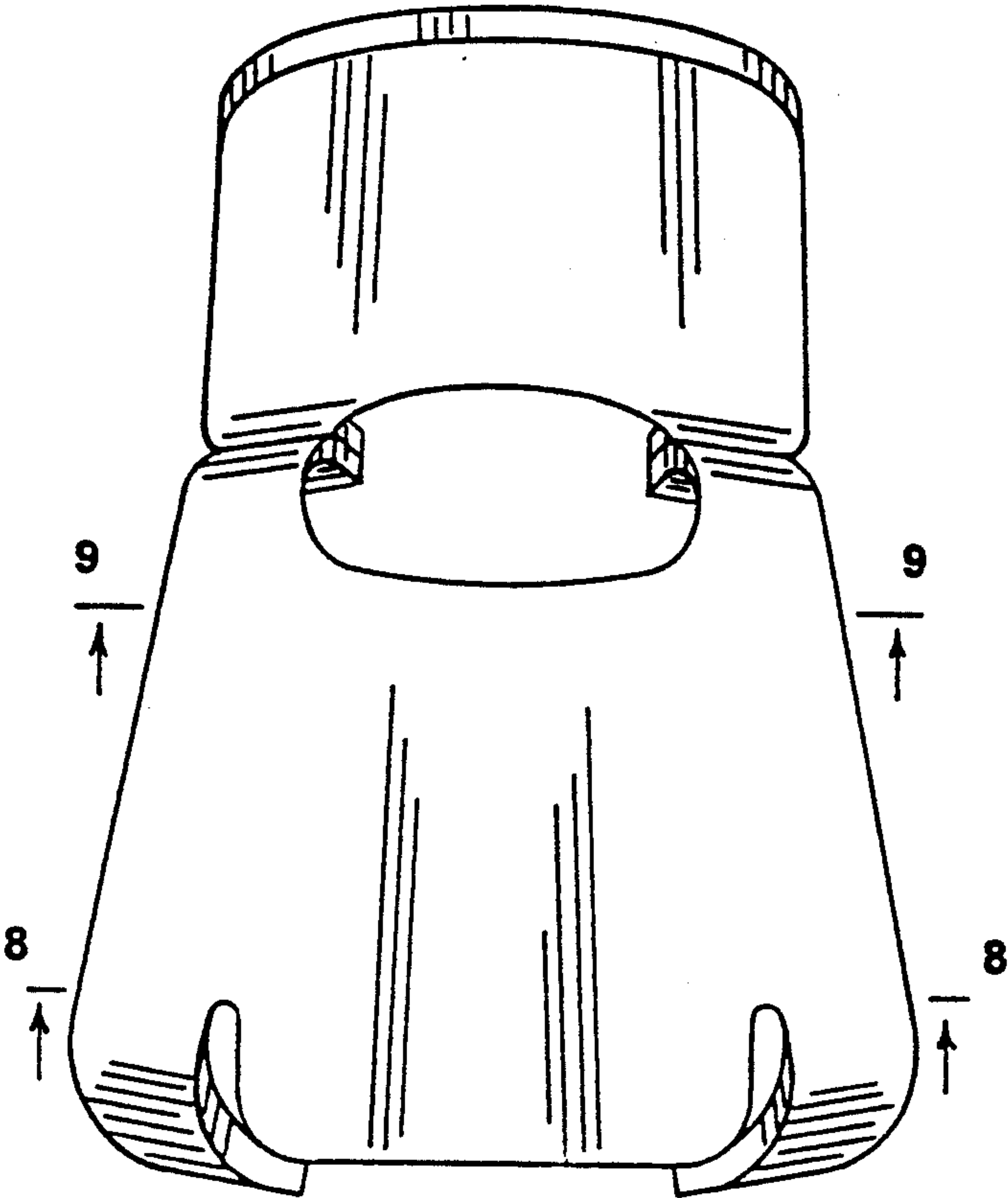

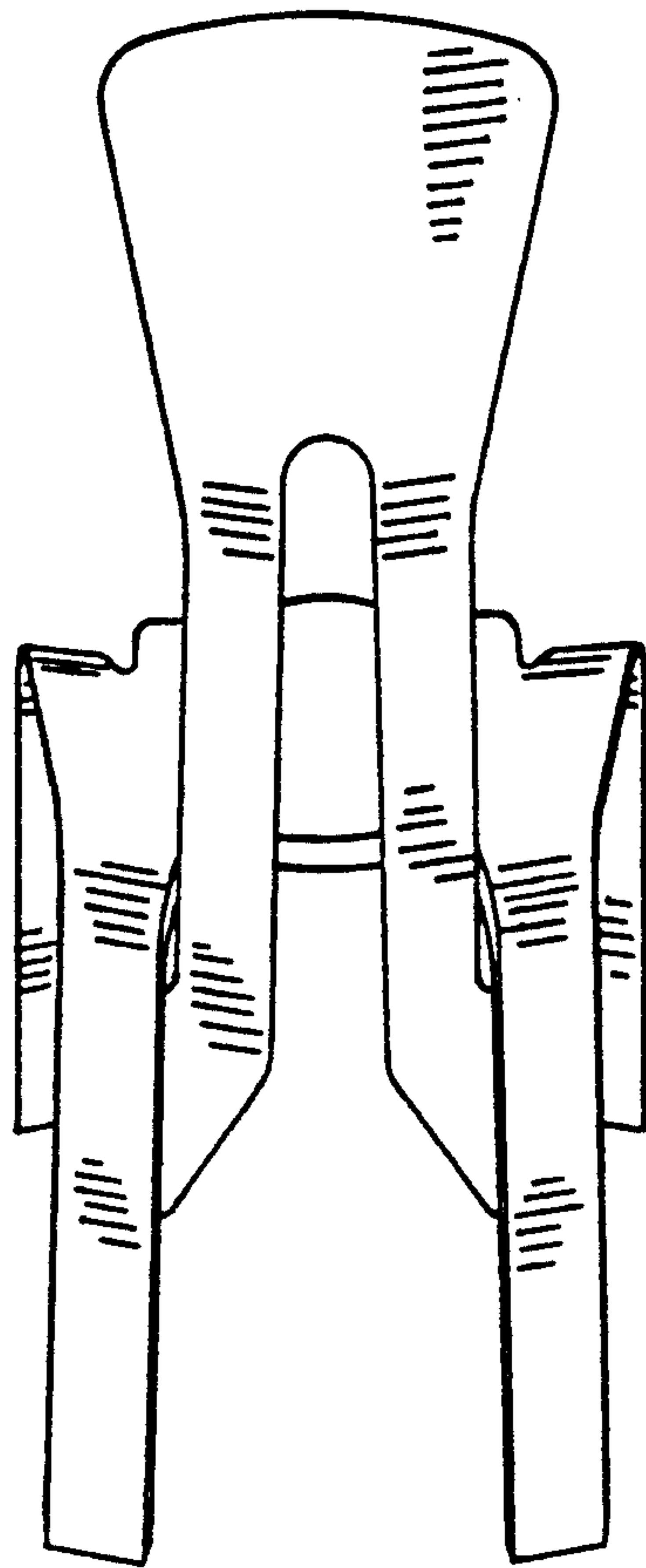

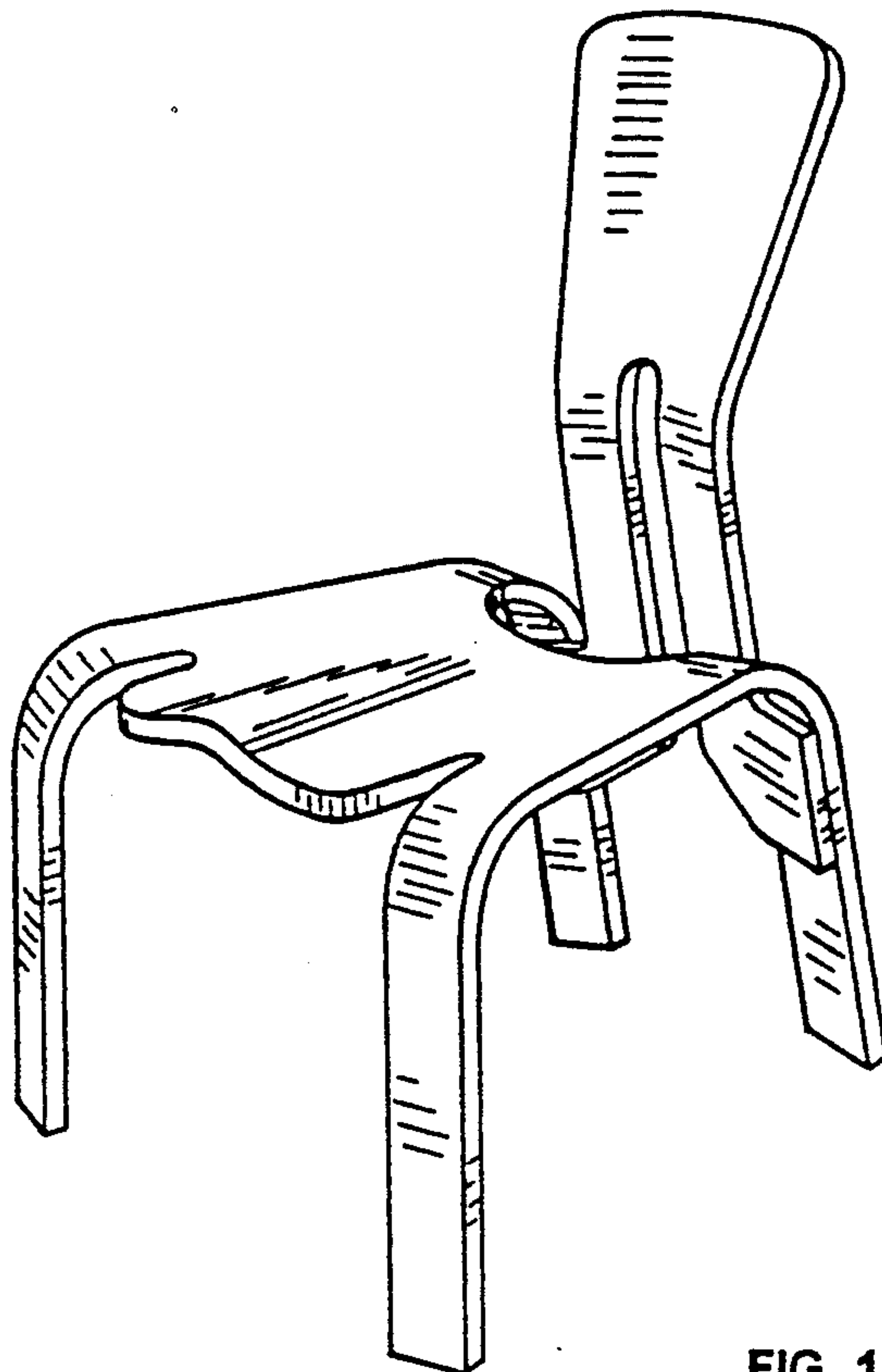
