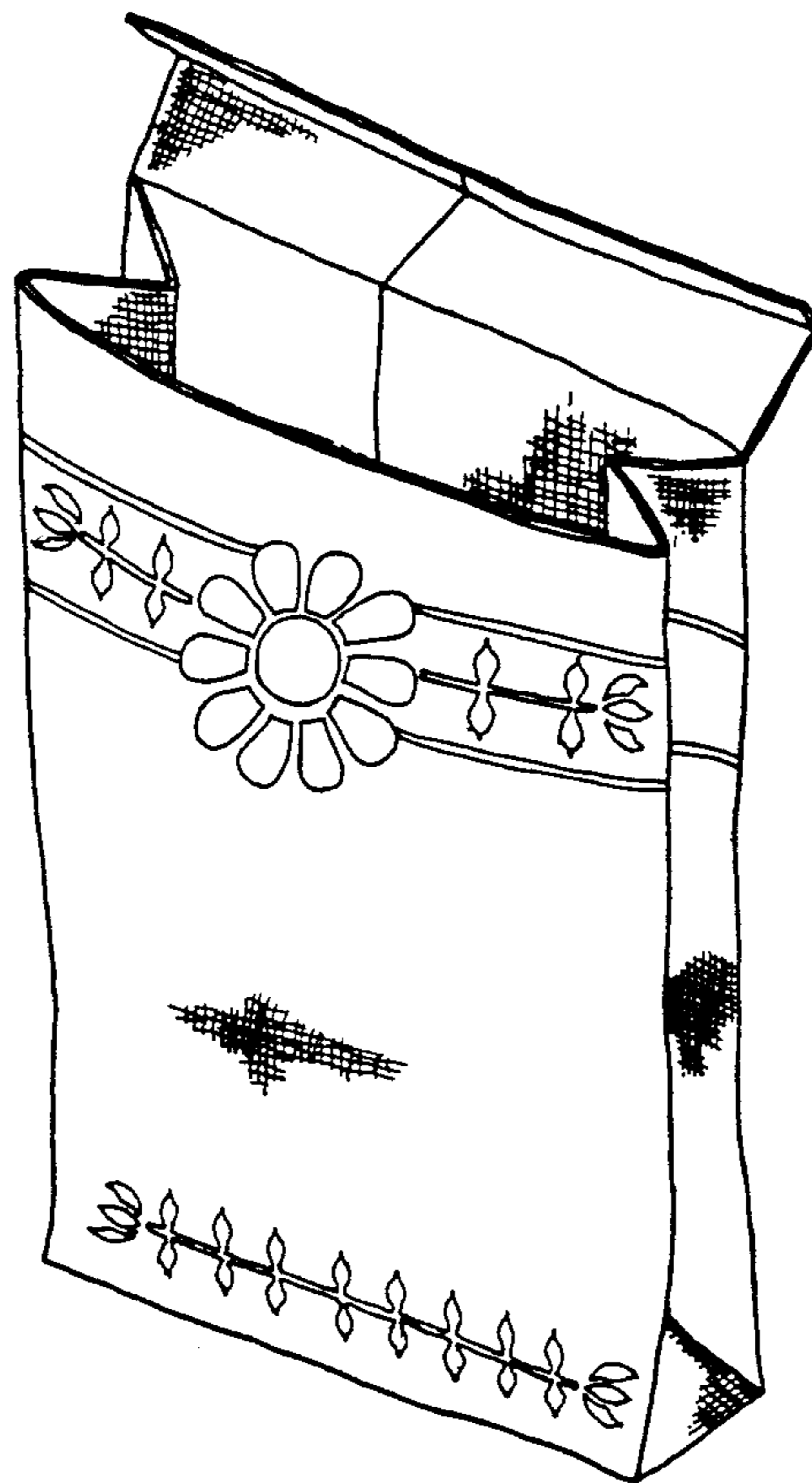

The ornamental design for a bag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bag showing my design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 3;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view shown; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



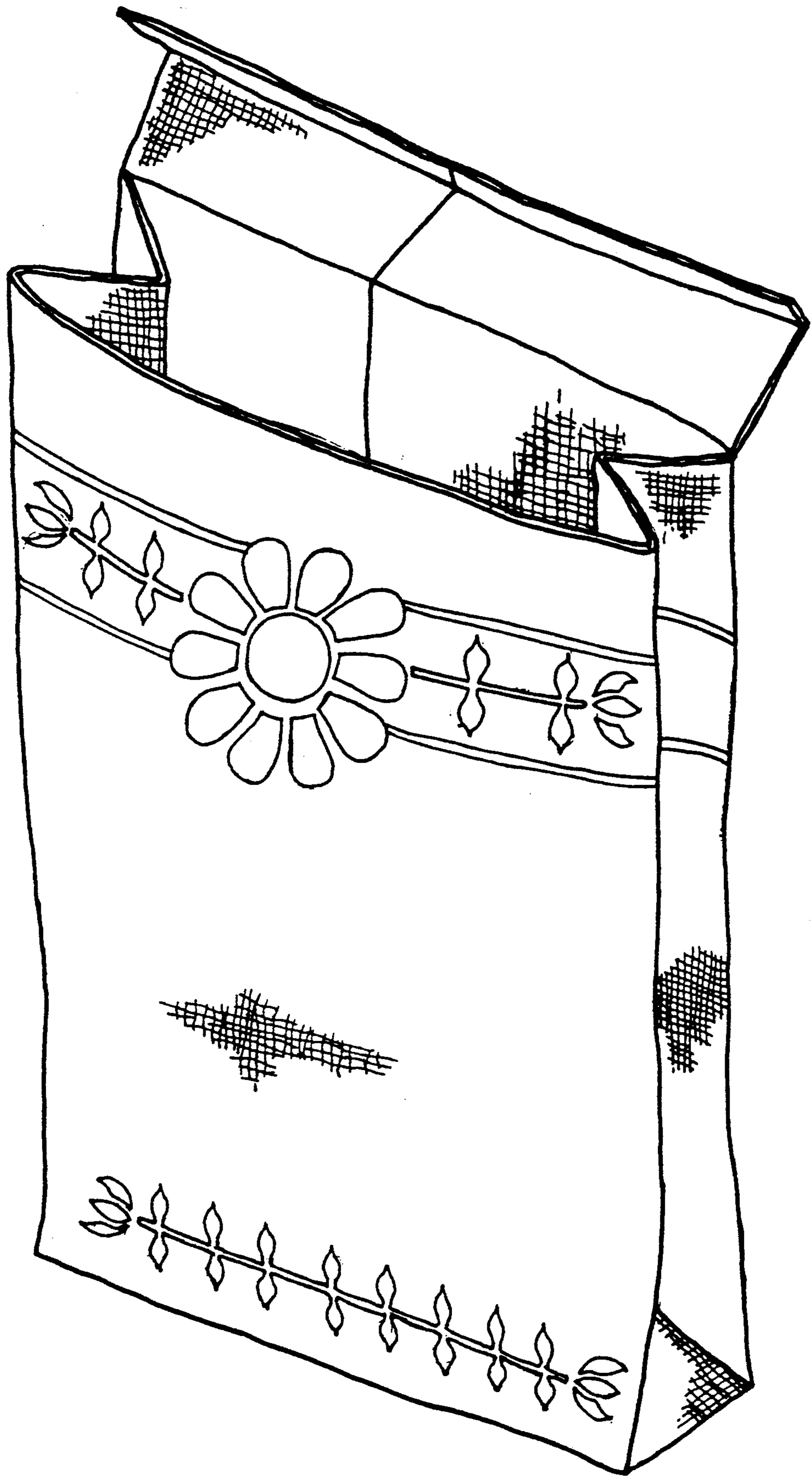

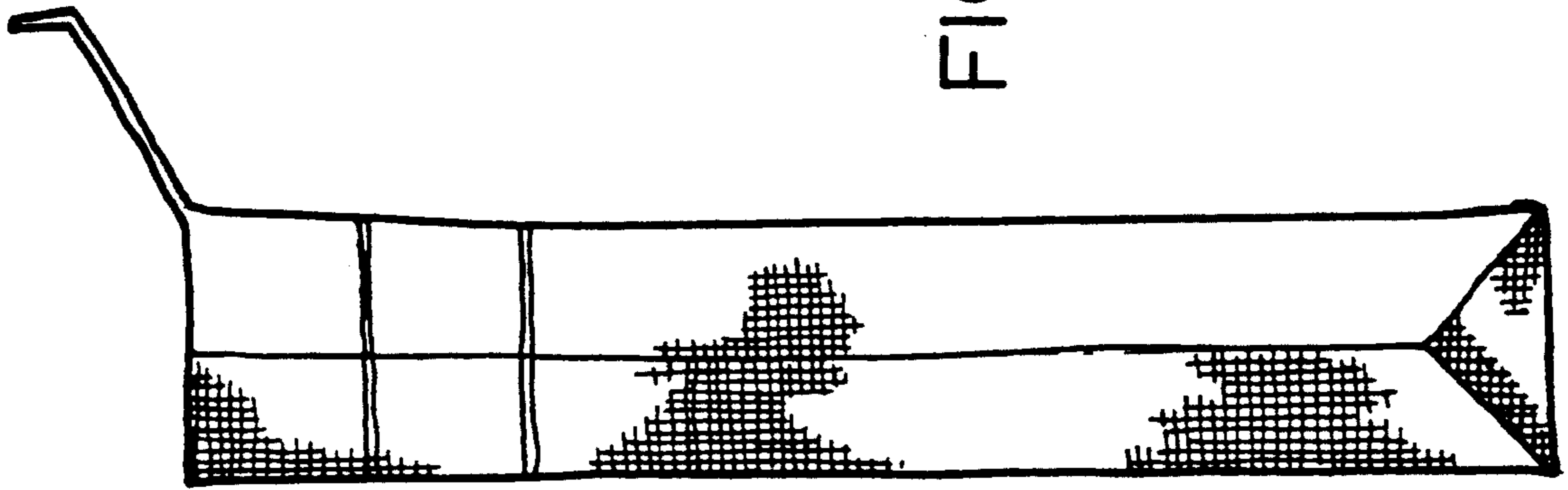

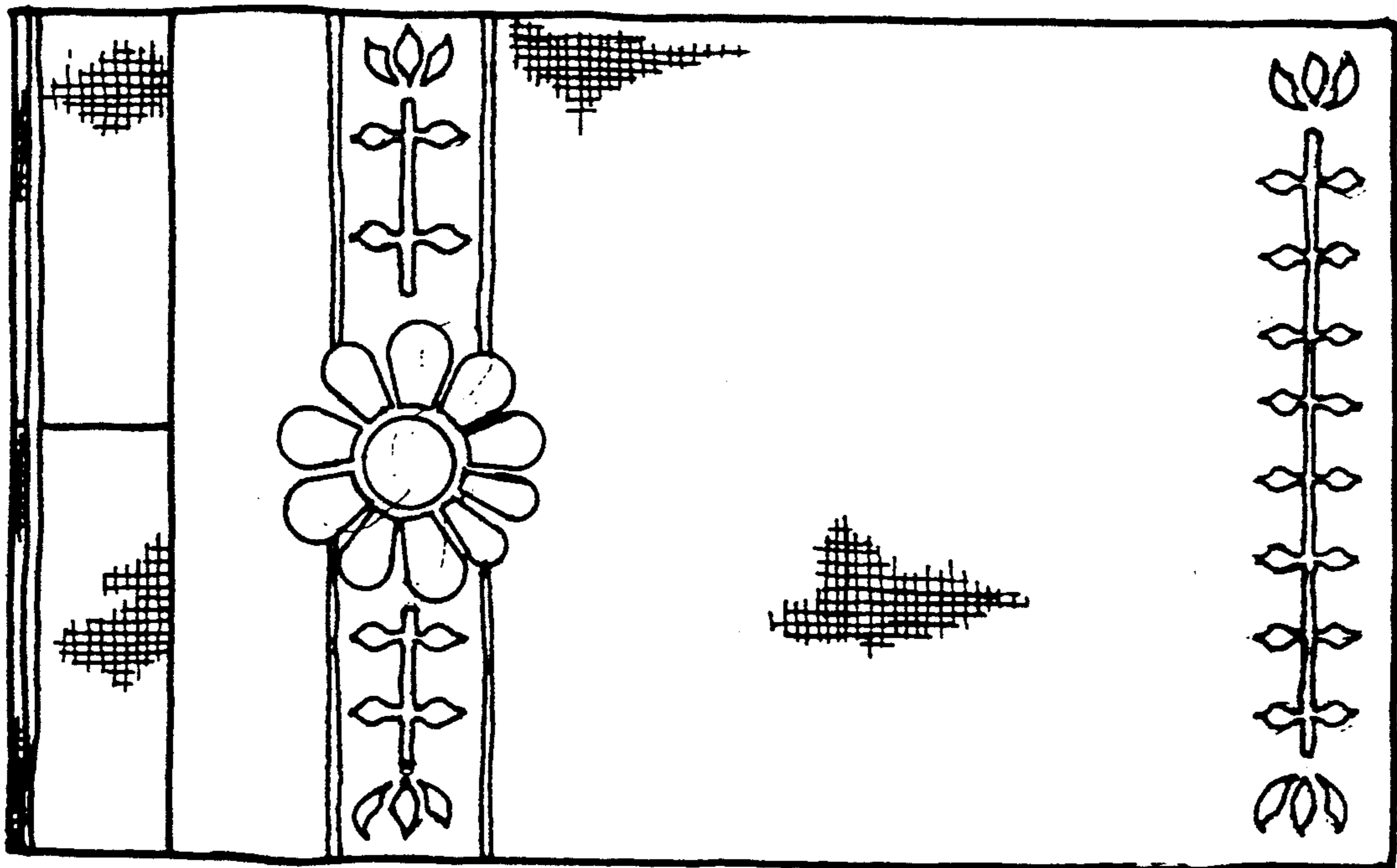

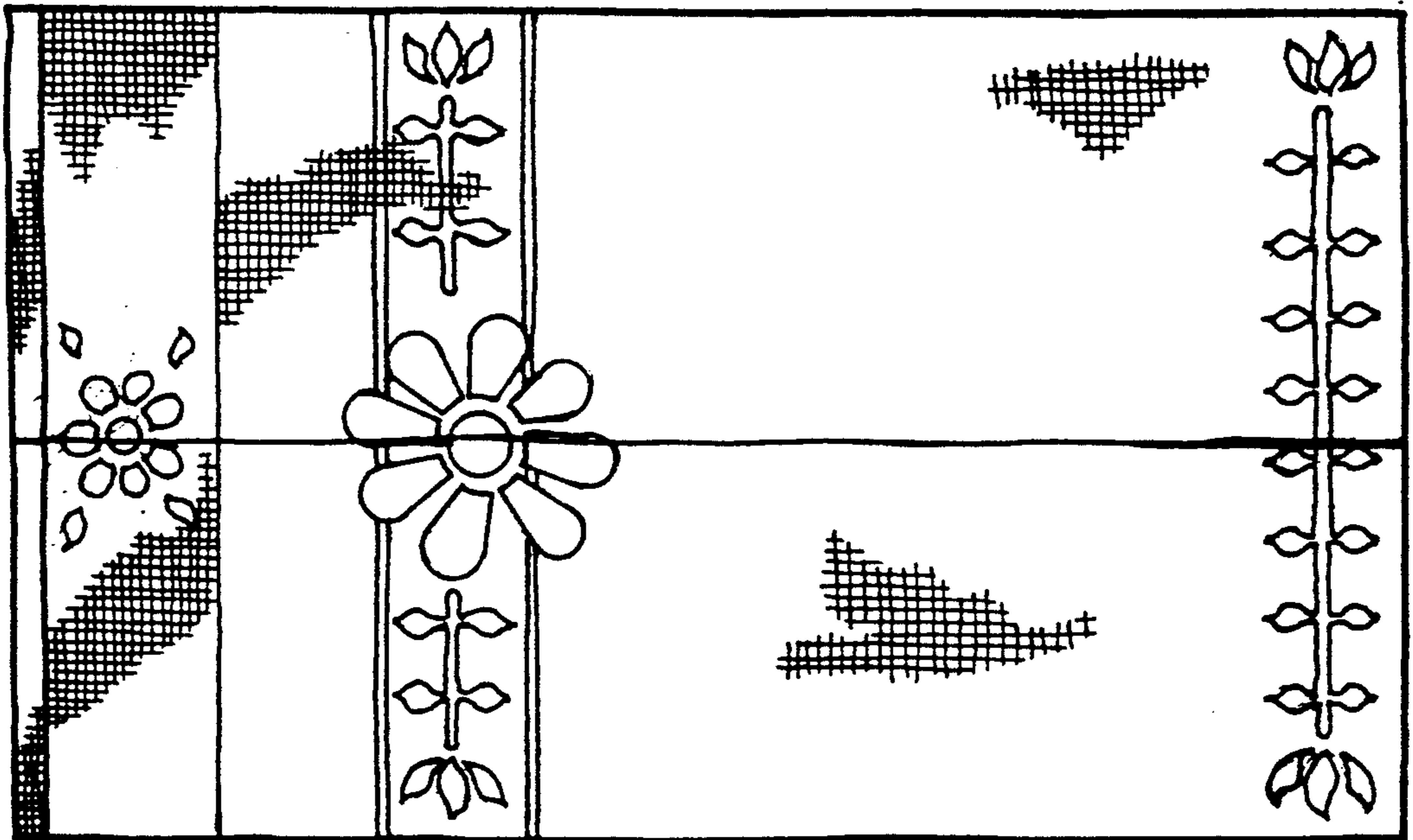

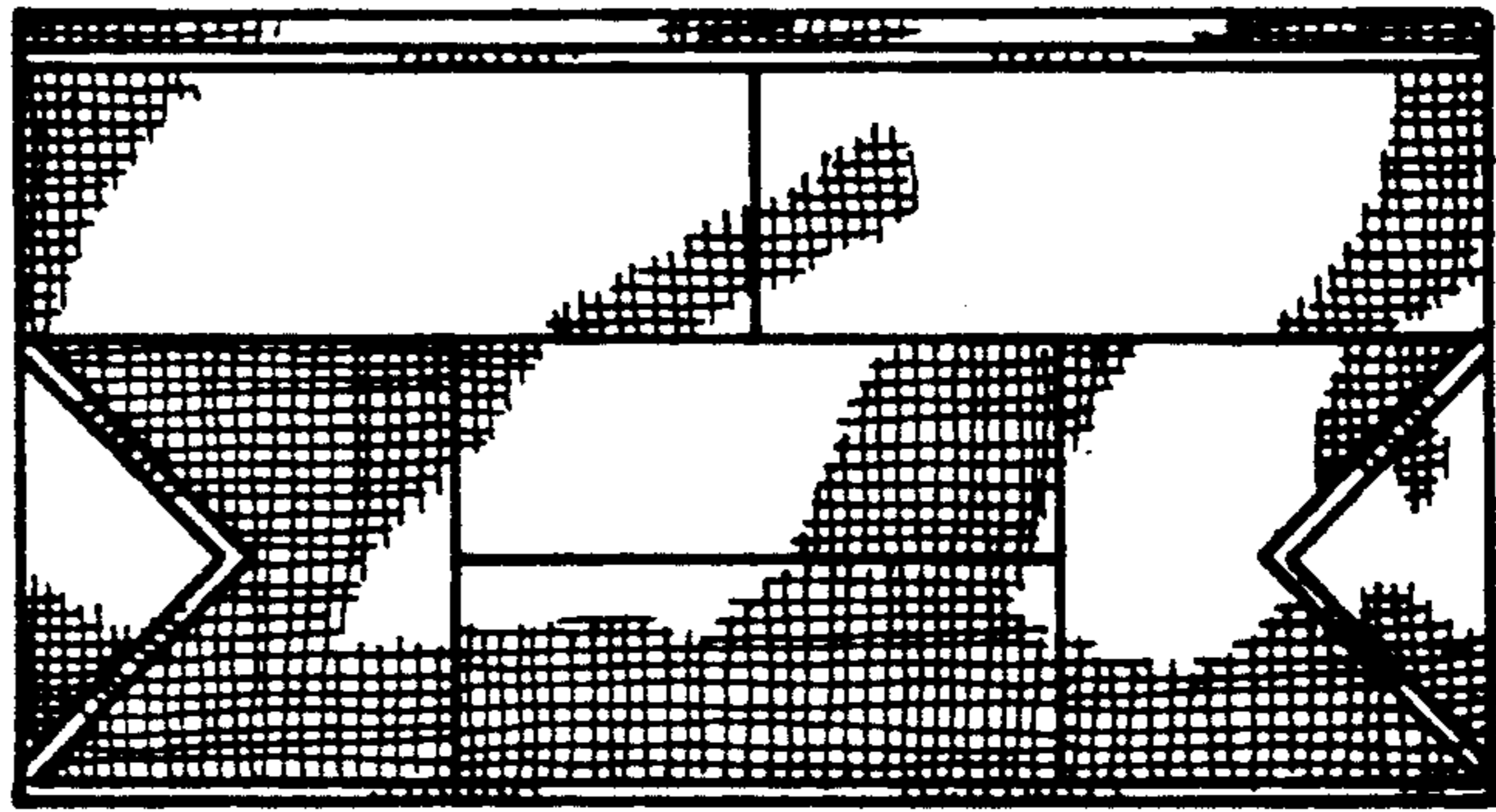
