The ornamental design for a television enclosure, as shown.

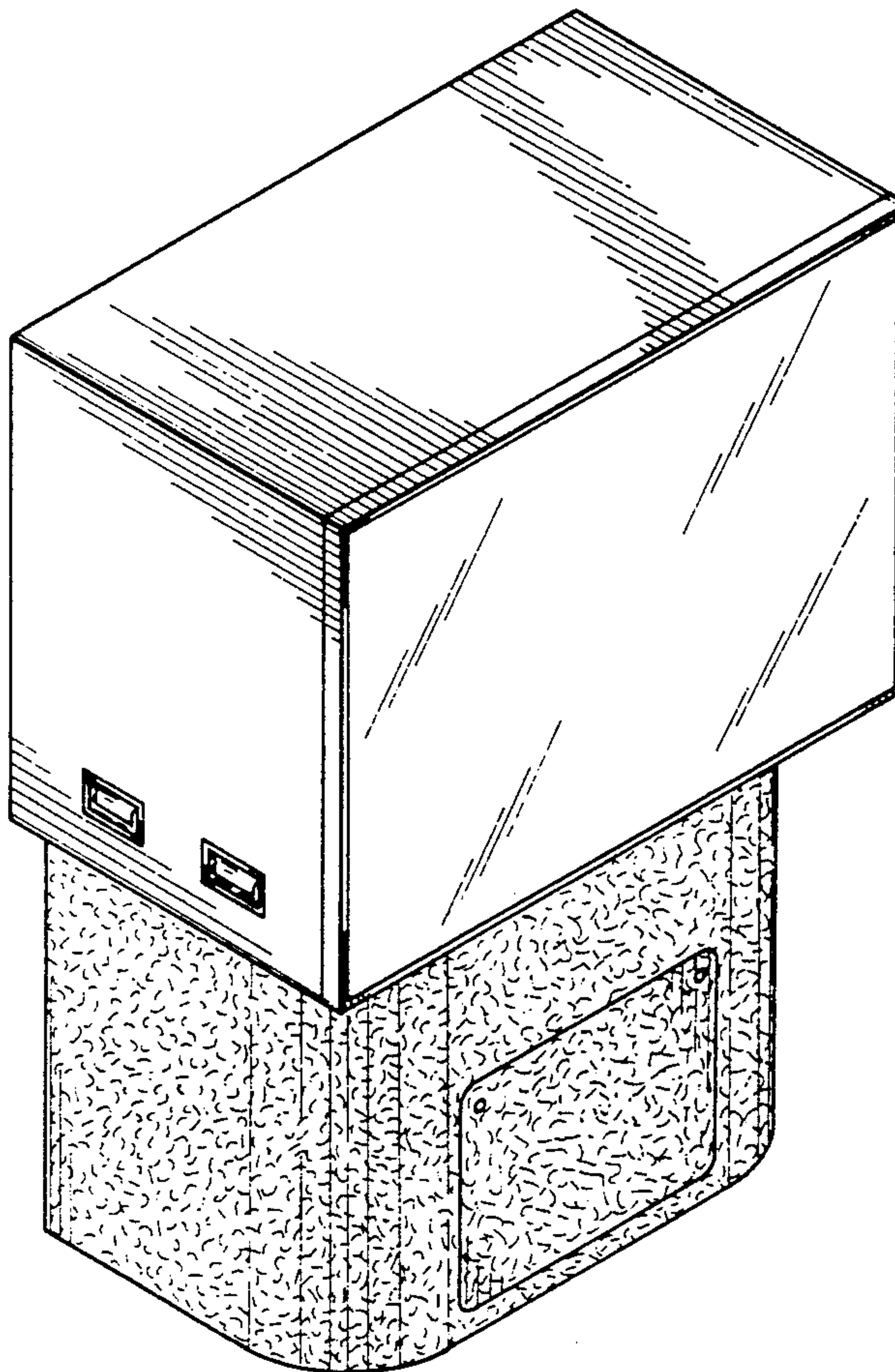
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view;



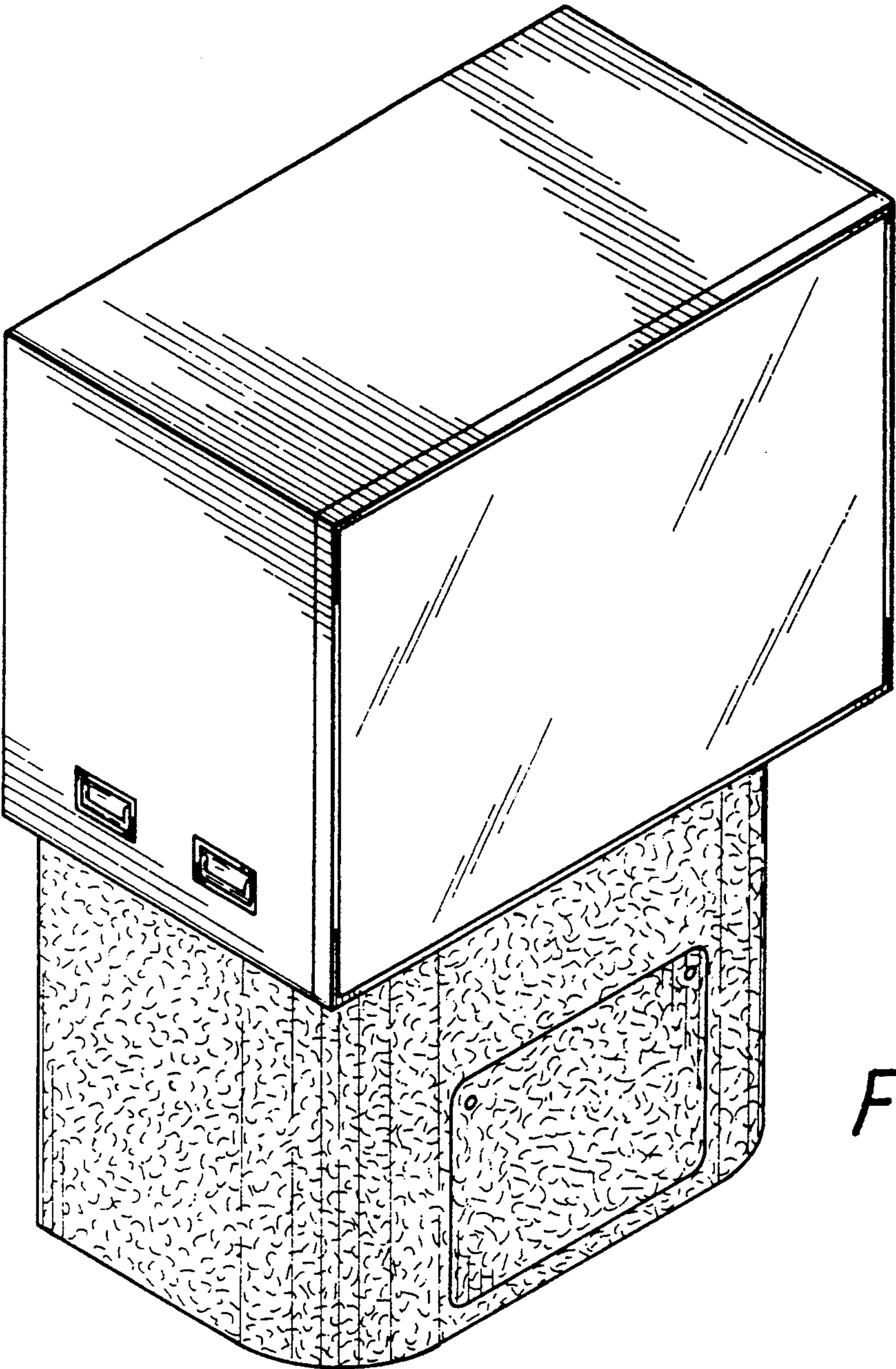
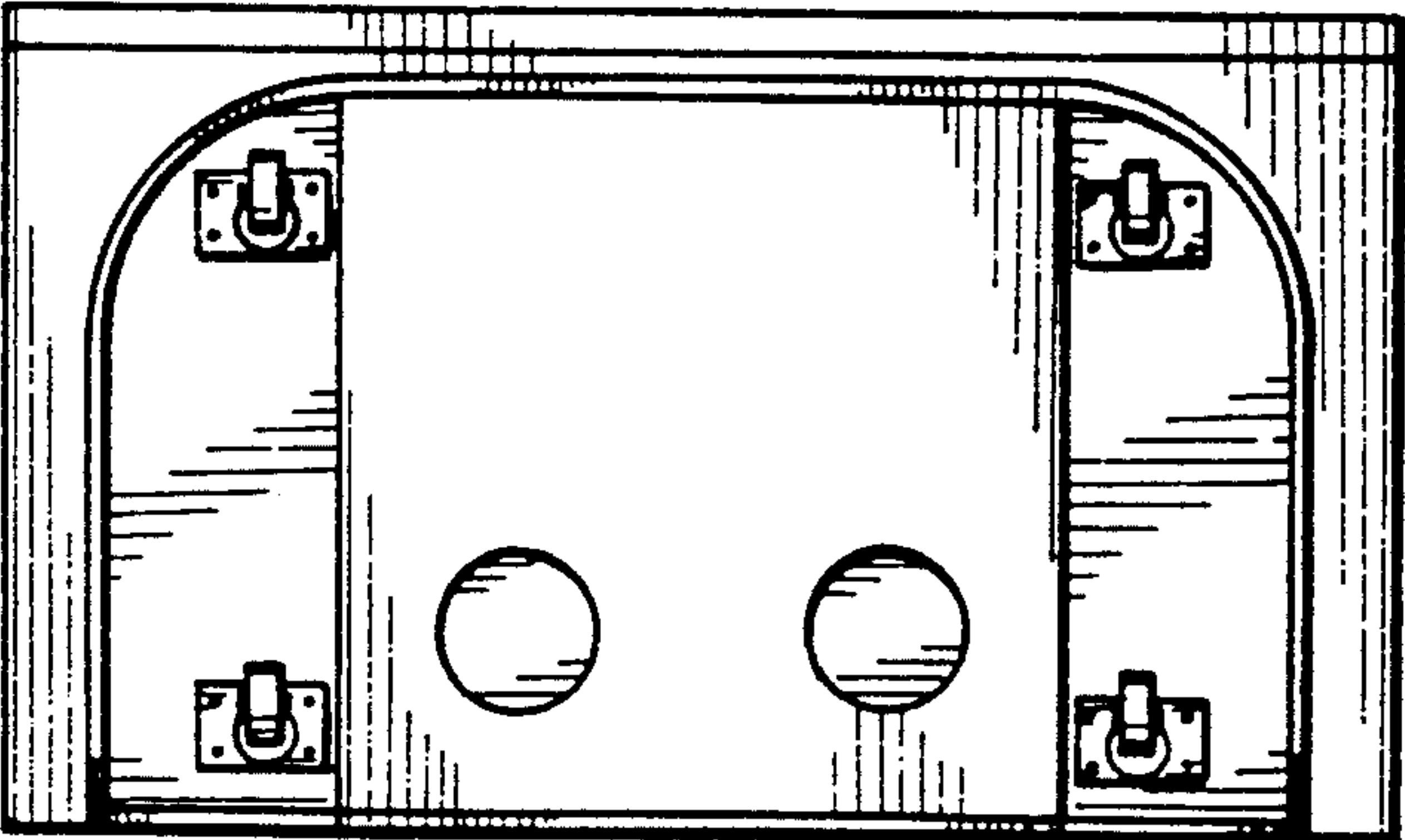

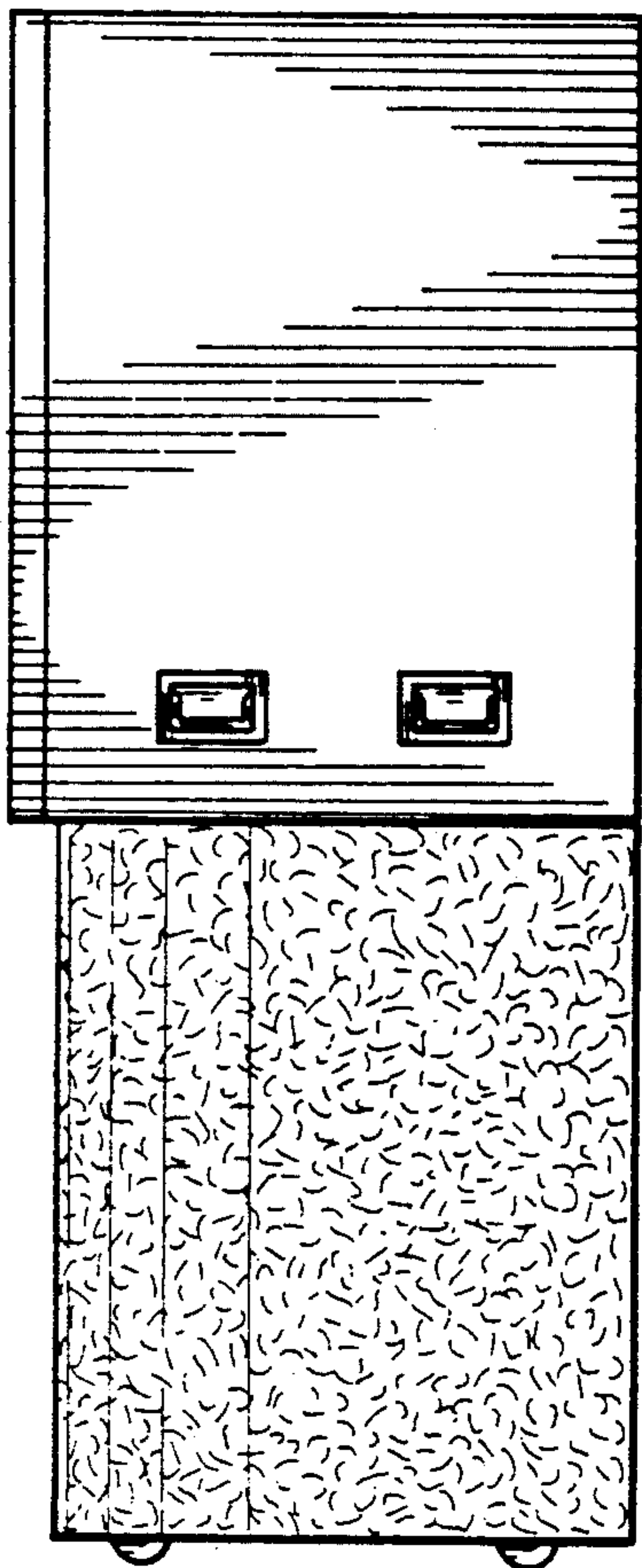

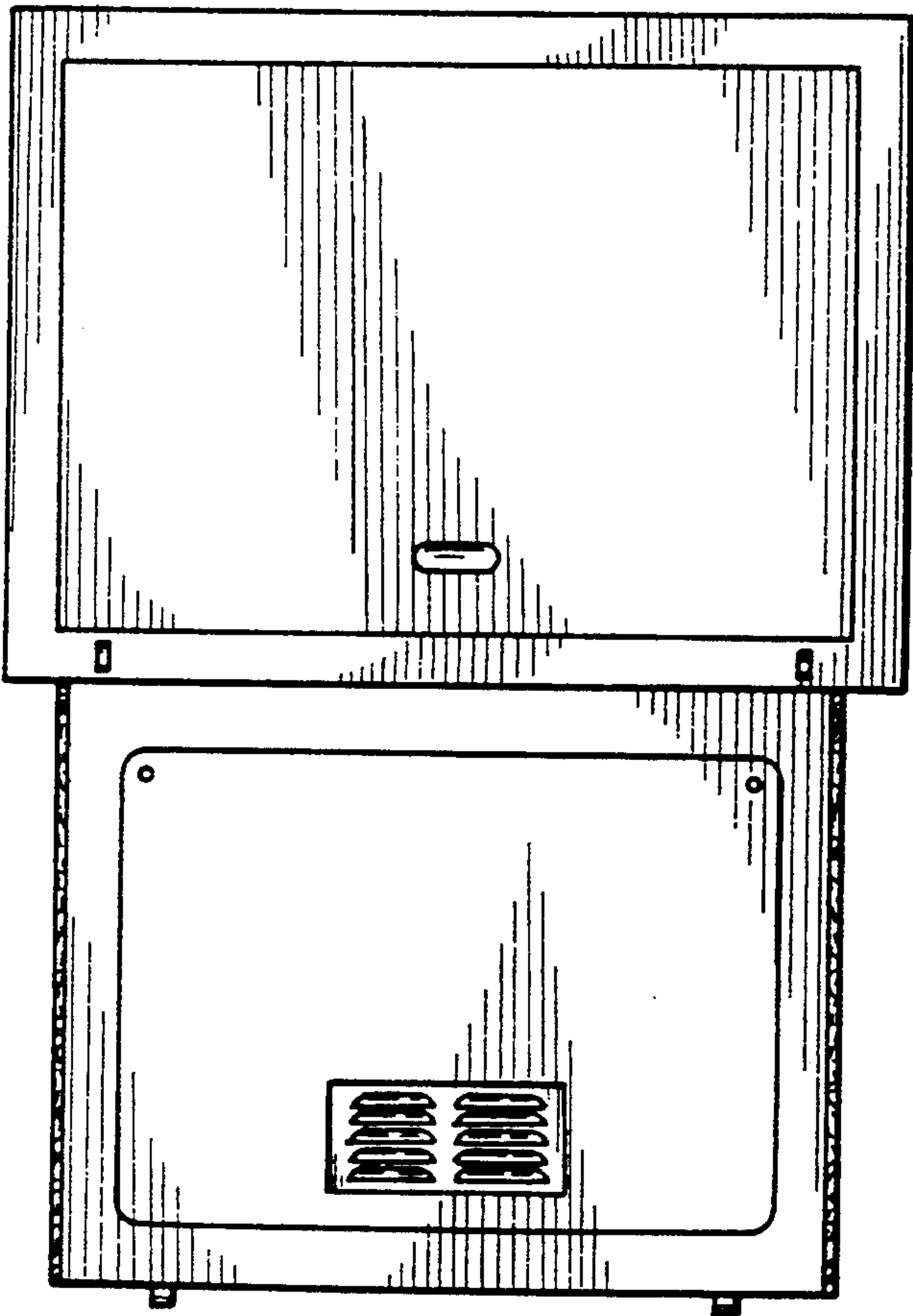
