[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an upper surface of a plate, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

The figure is a top plan view of an upper surface of a plate showing my new design.

The plate design, apart from what is shown in the drawing, is conventional. The lining on the drawing is not shading, but is a part of the design.
