[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a fishing pole holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a fishing pole holder, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is an end elevational view as seen from the right of FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof as seen from the left of FIG. 2;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment;
FIG. 8 is a side elevational view of the design shown in FIG. 7;
FIG. 9 is an end elevational view as taken from the right hand side of FIG. 8;
FIG. 10 is an end elevational view as taken from the left hand end of FIG. 8;
FIG. 11 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 13 is a perspective view of a third embodiment;
FIG. 14 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 15 is an end elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 14;
FIG. 16 is an end elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 14;
FIG. 17 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 18 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The broken line showing of a reel and part of a rod in FIGS. 1, 7 and 13 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
