FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a shoe sole showing my new design;

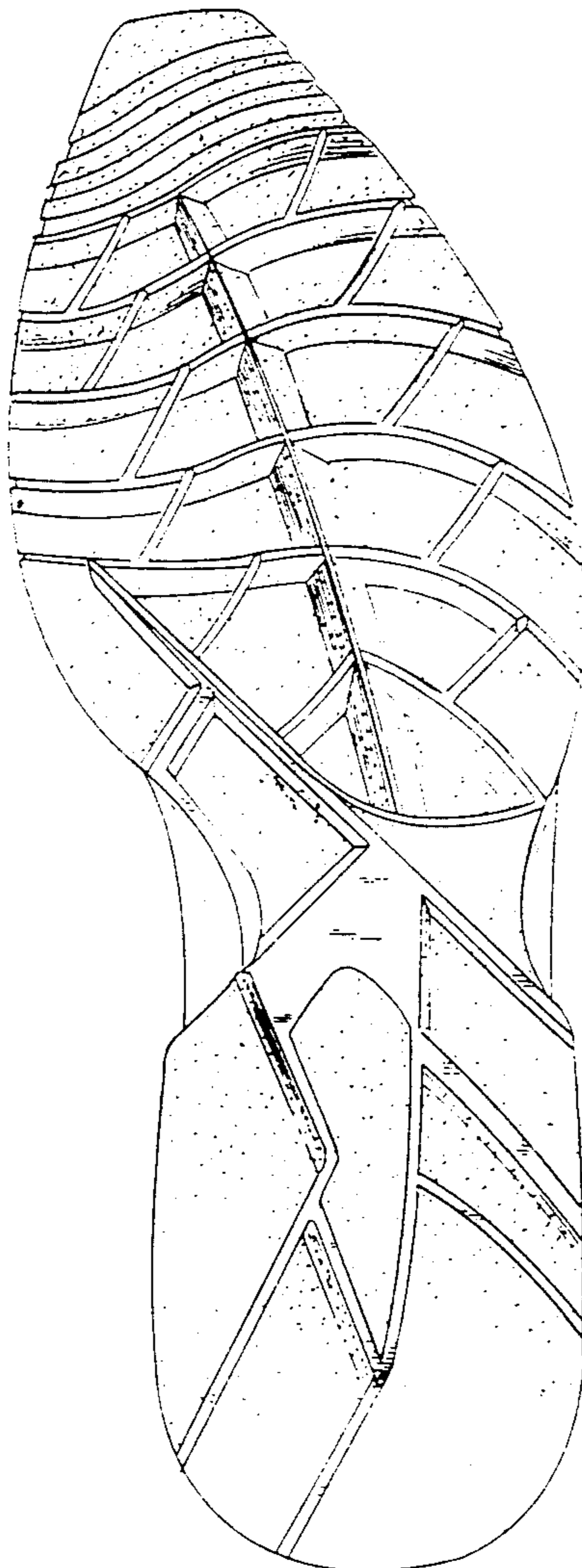
FIG. 2 is a left side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view thereof.



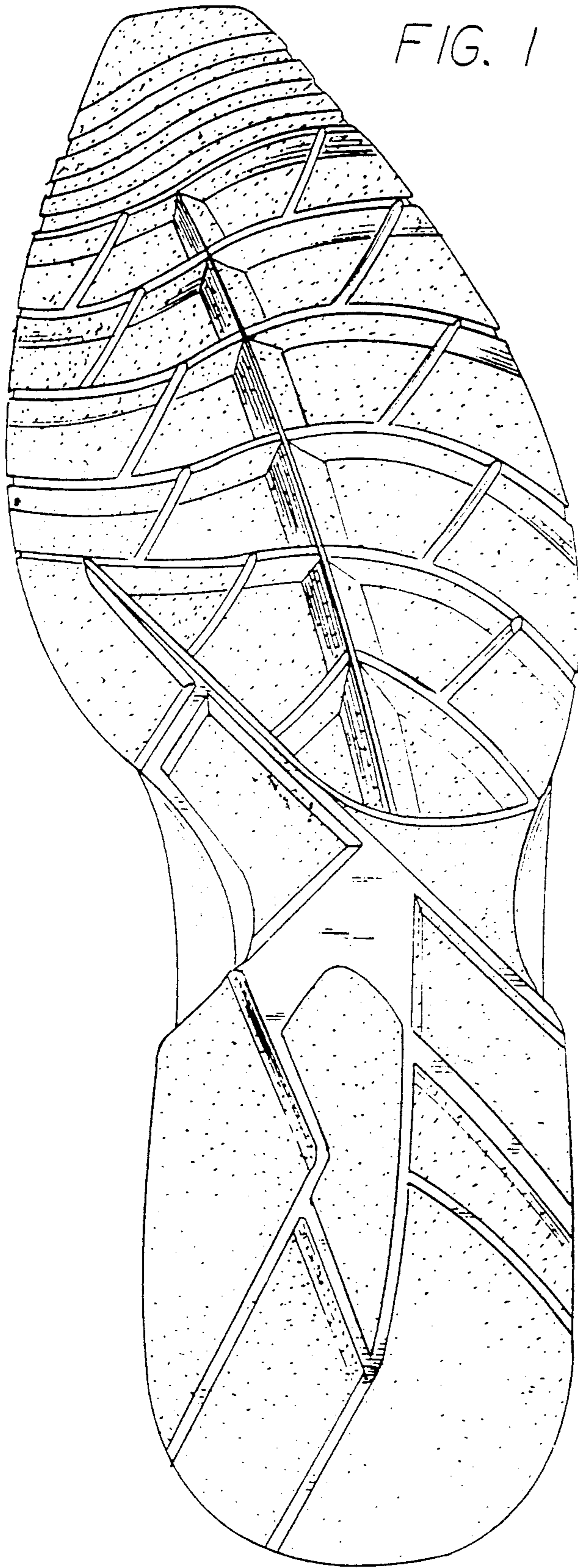


FIG. 1 FIG. 2

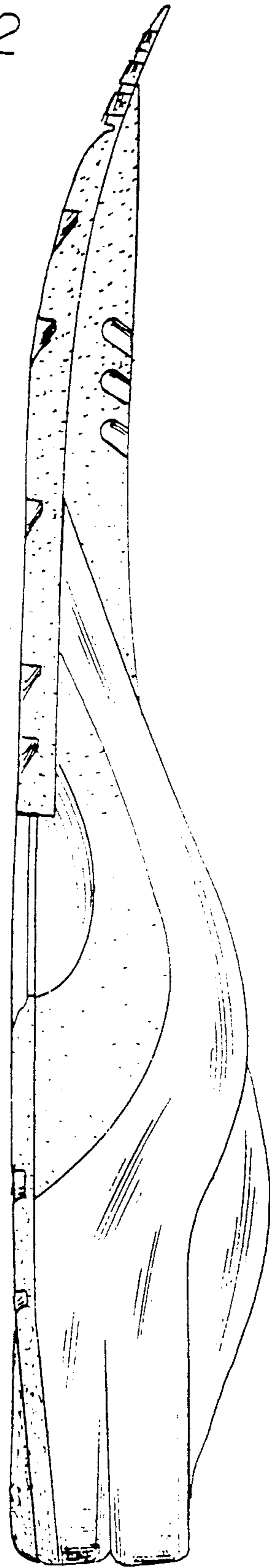

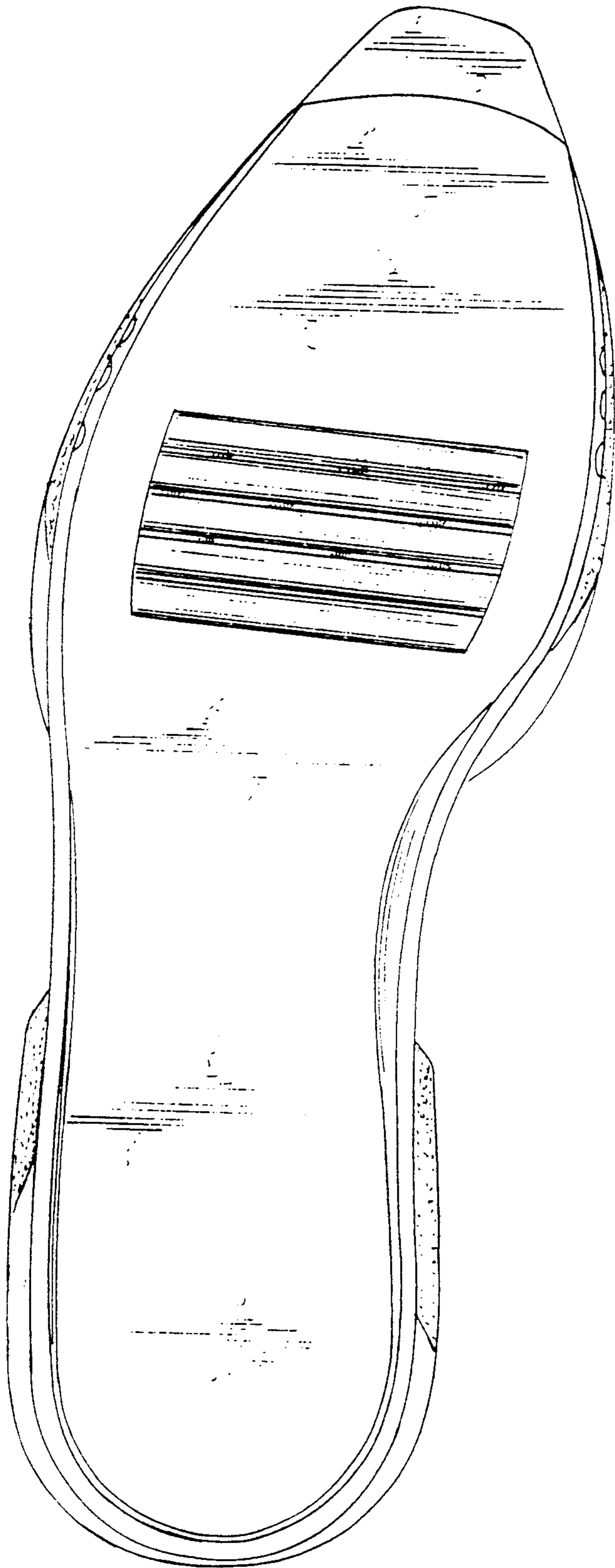
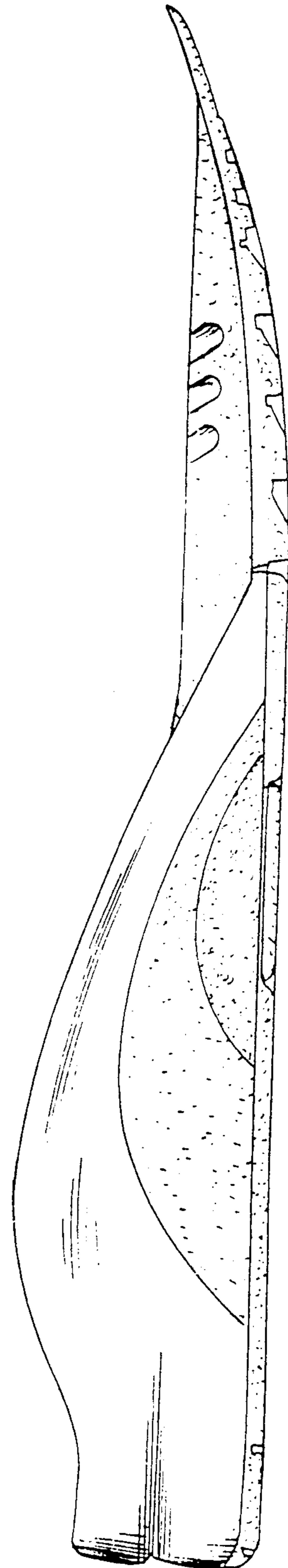

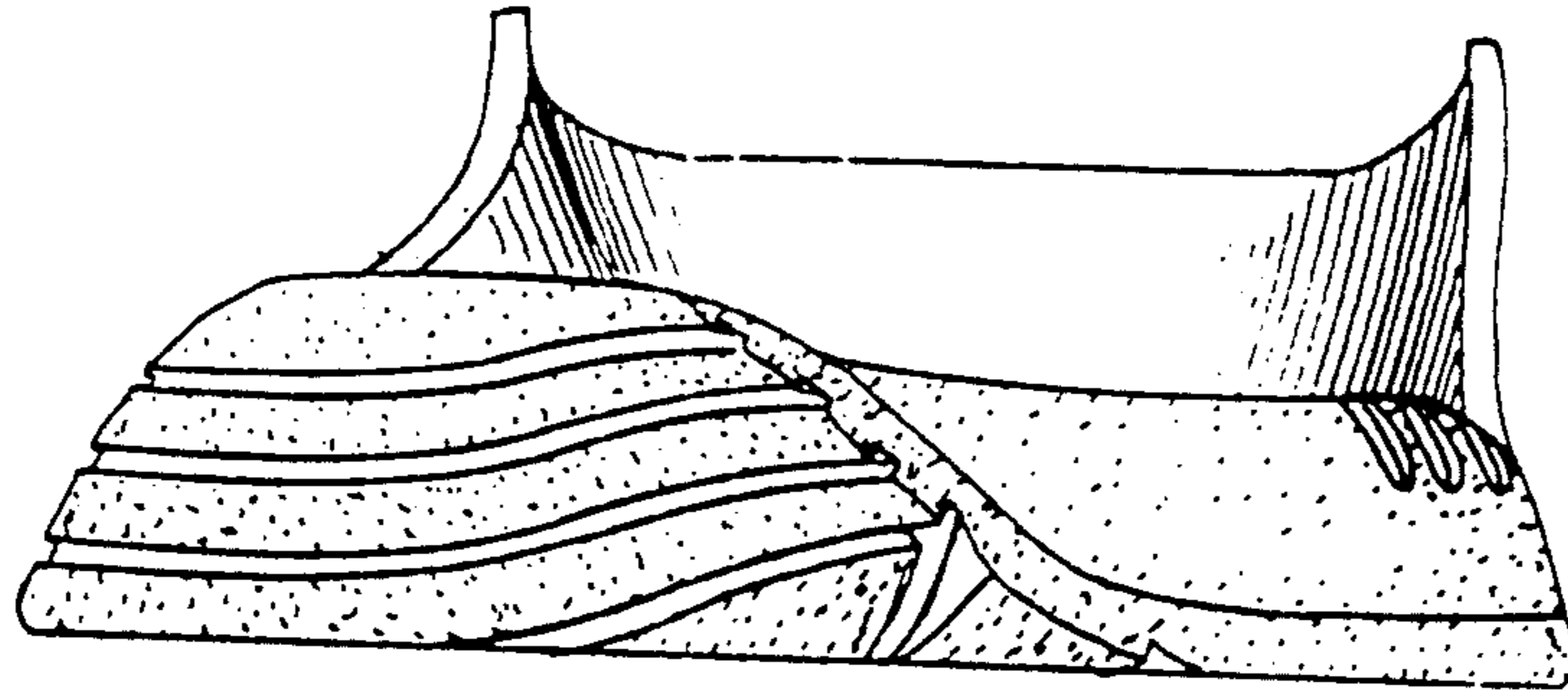

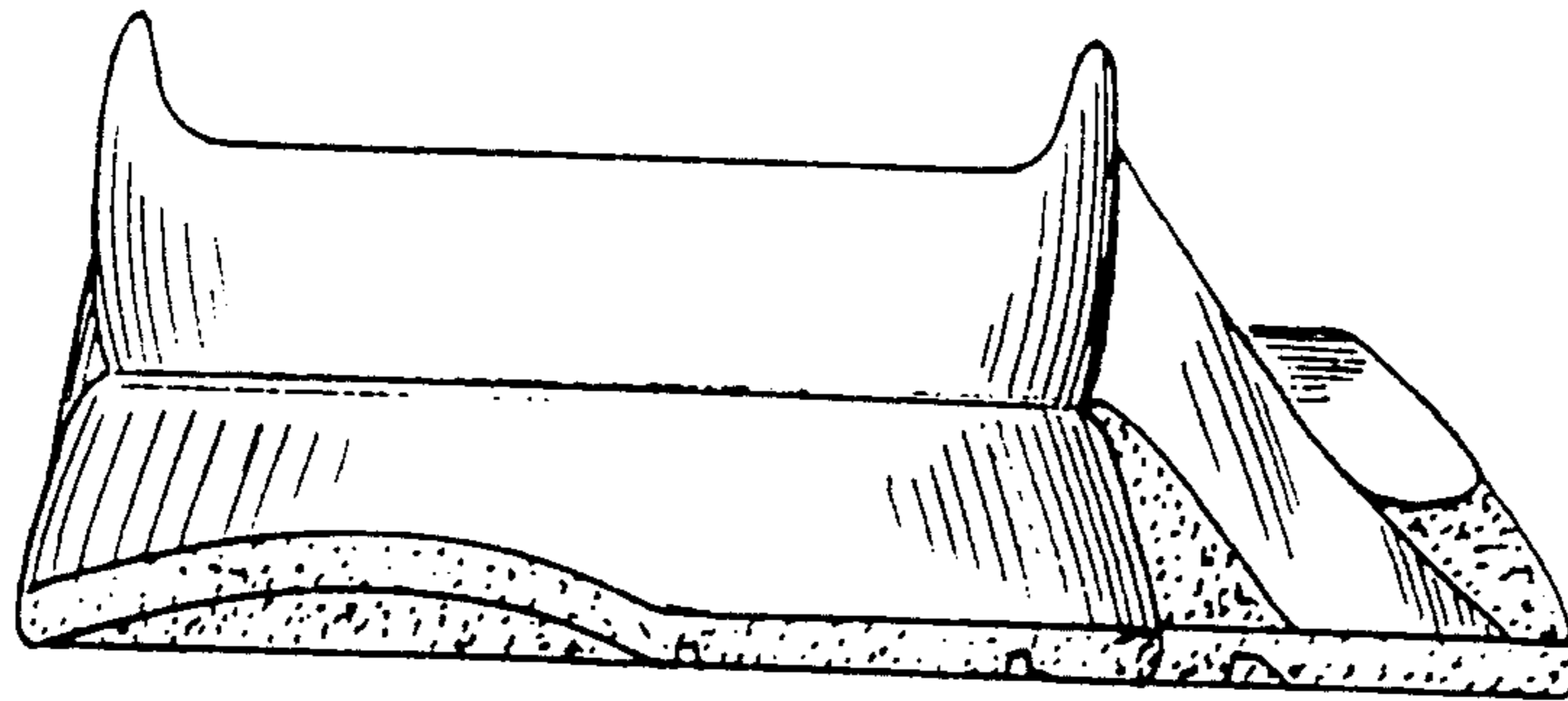
