The ornamental design for a slot-wall shelf for video cassette display, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a slot-wall shelf for video cassette display showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top, front, and left side perspective view;
 FIG. 3 is a front and top perspective view;
 FIG. 4 is a front, top, and right side perspective view;
 FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view;
 FIG. 6 is an inverted rear, bottom, and right side perspective view;
 FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view; and,
 FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view thereof.

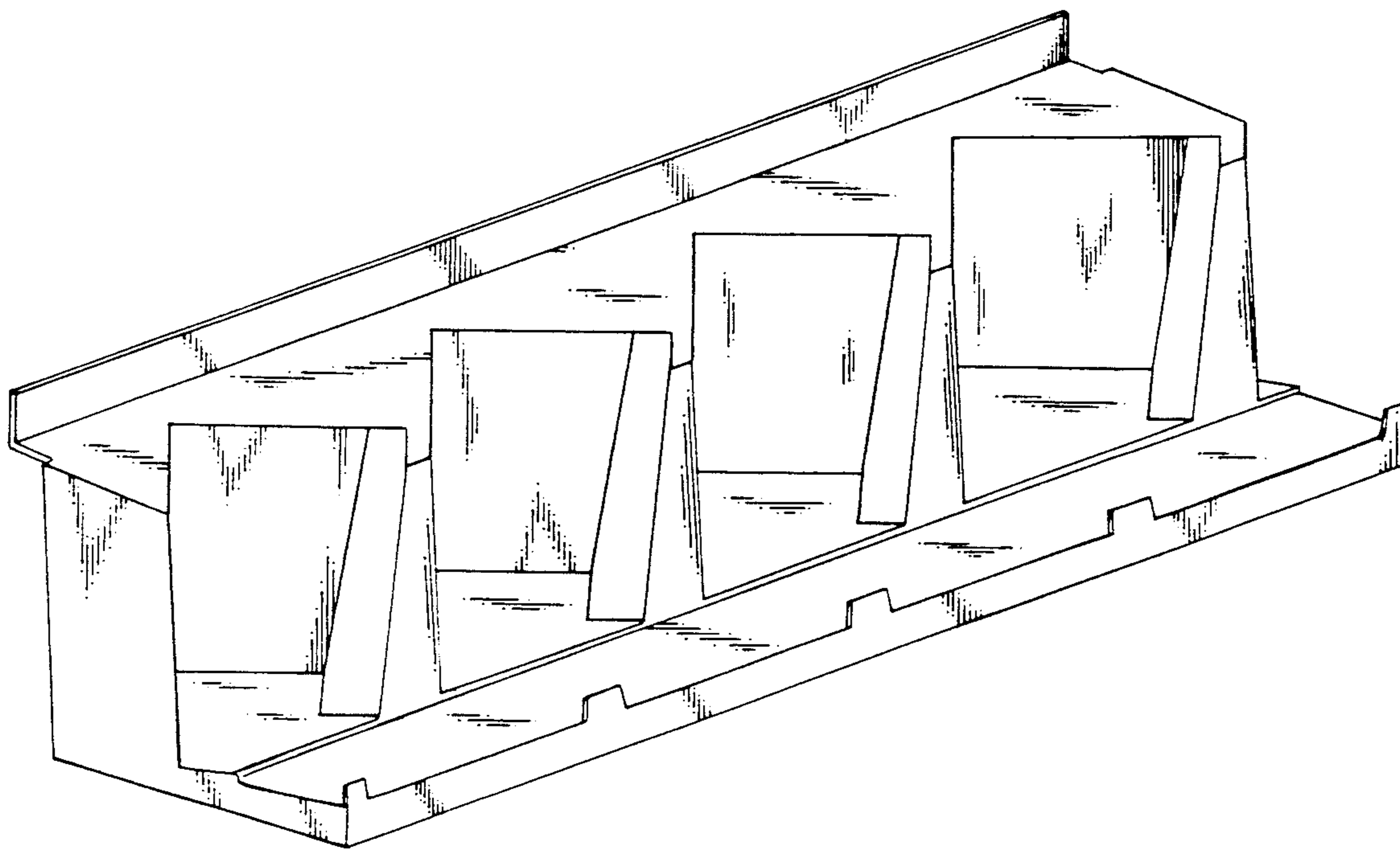
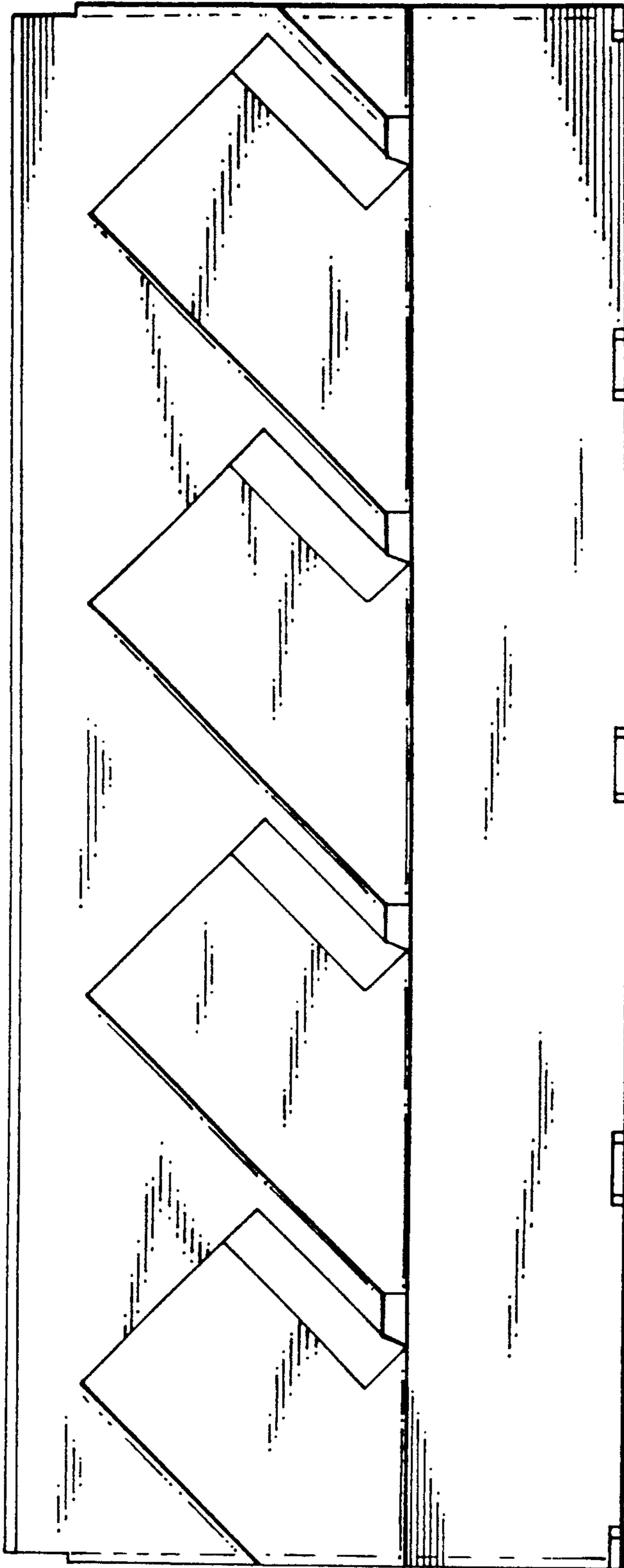

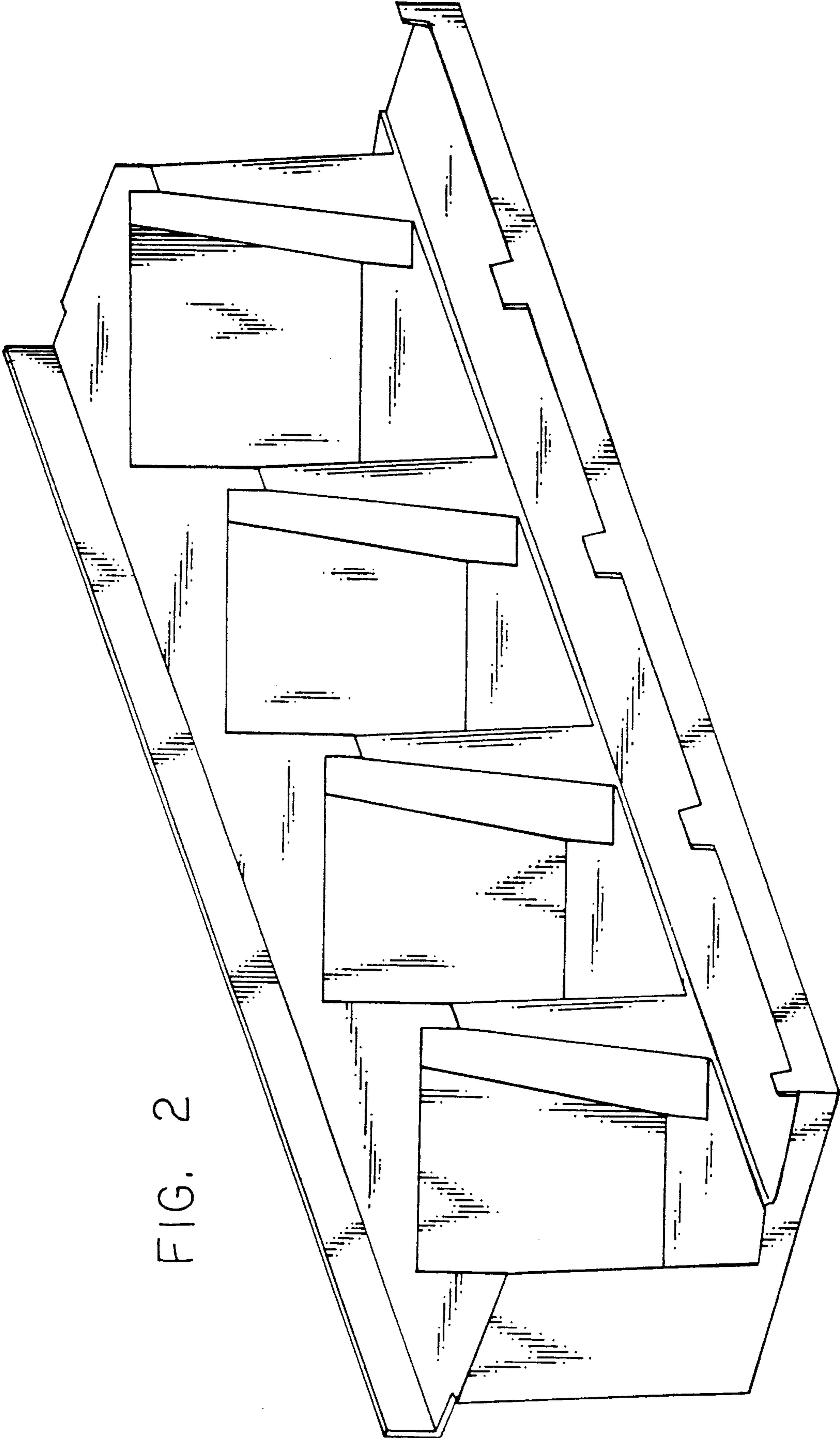

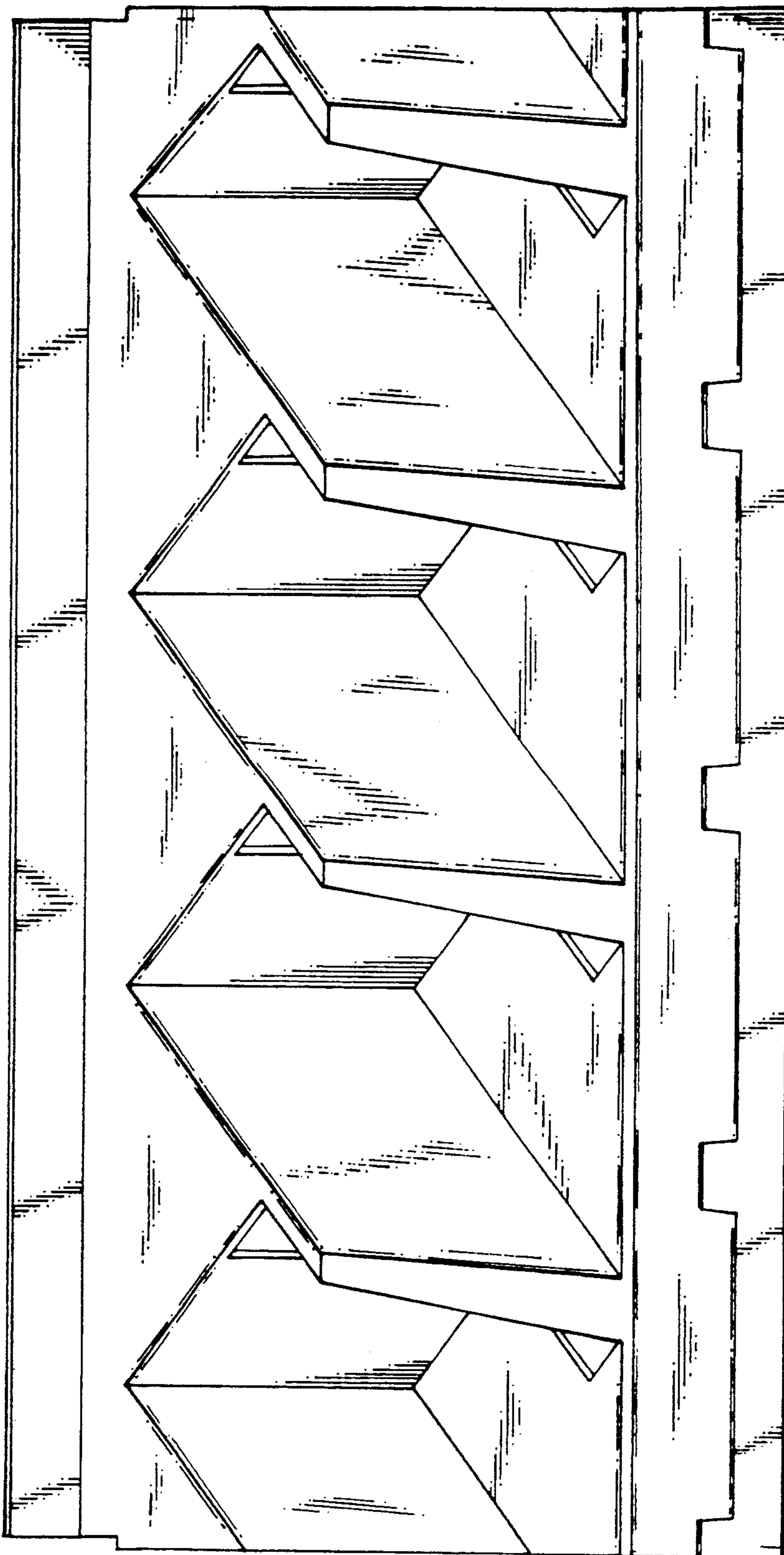
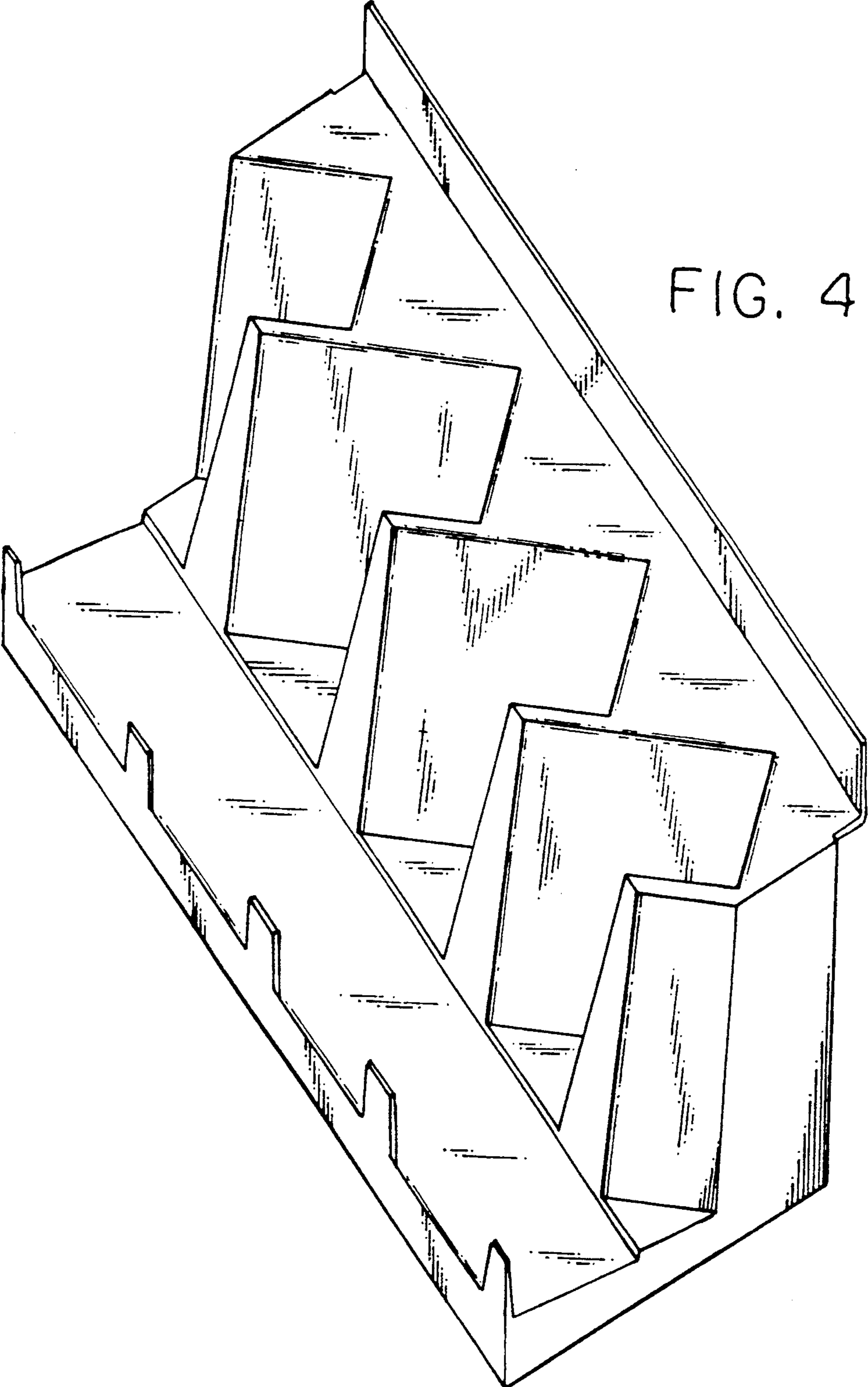

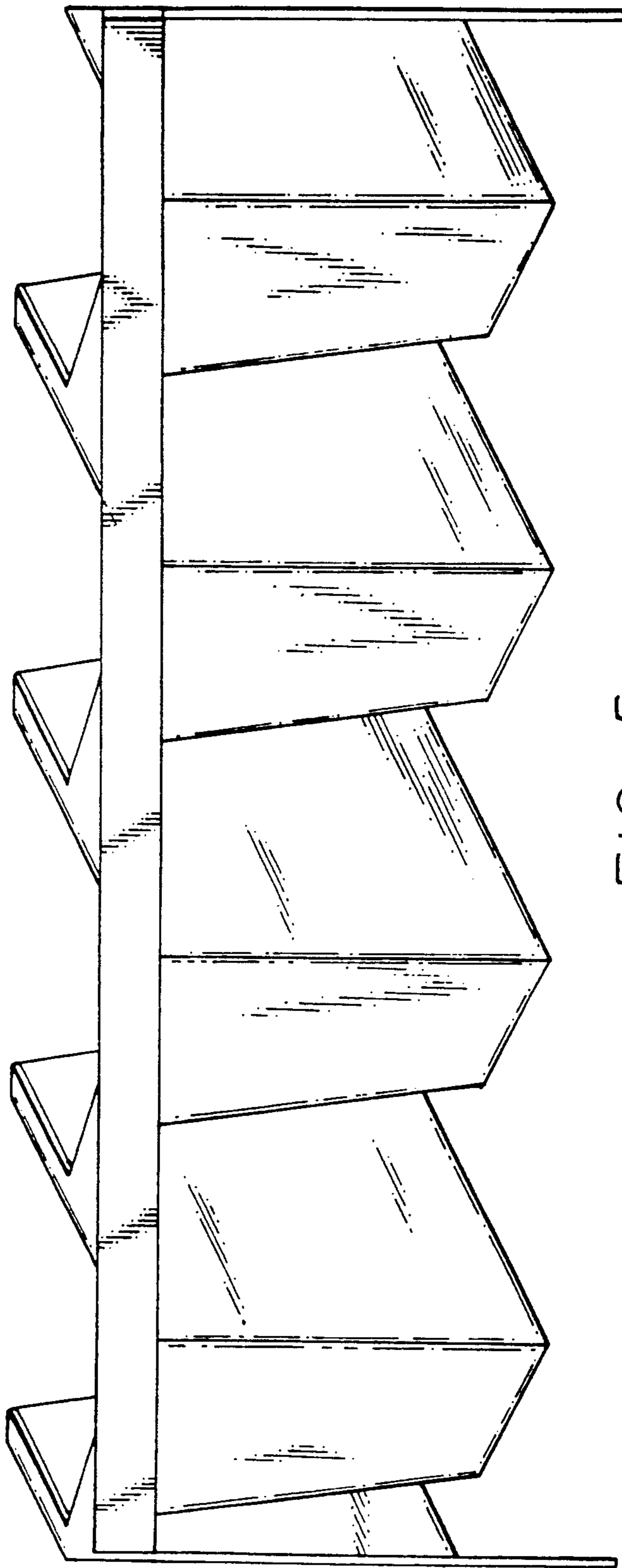

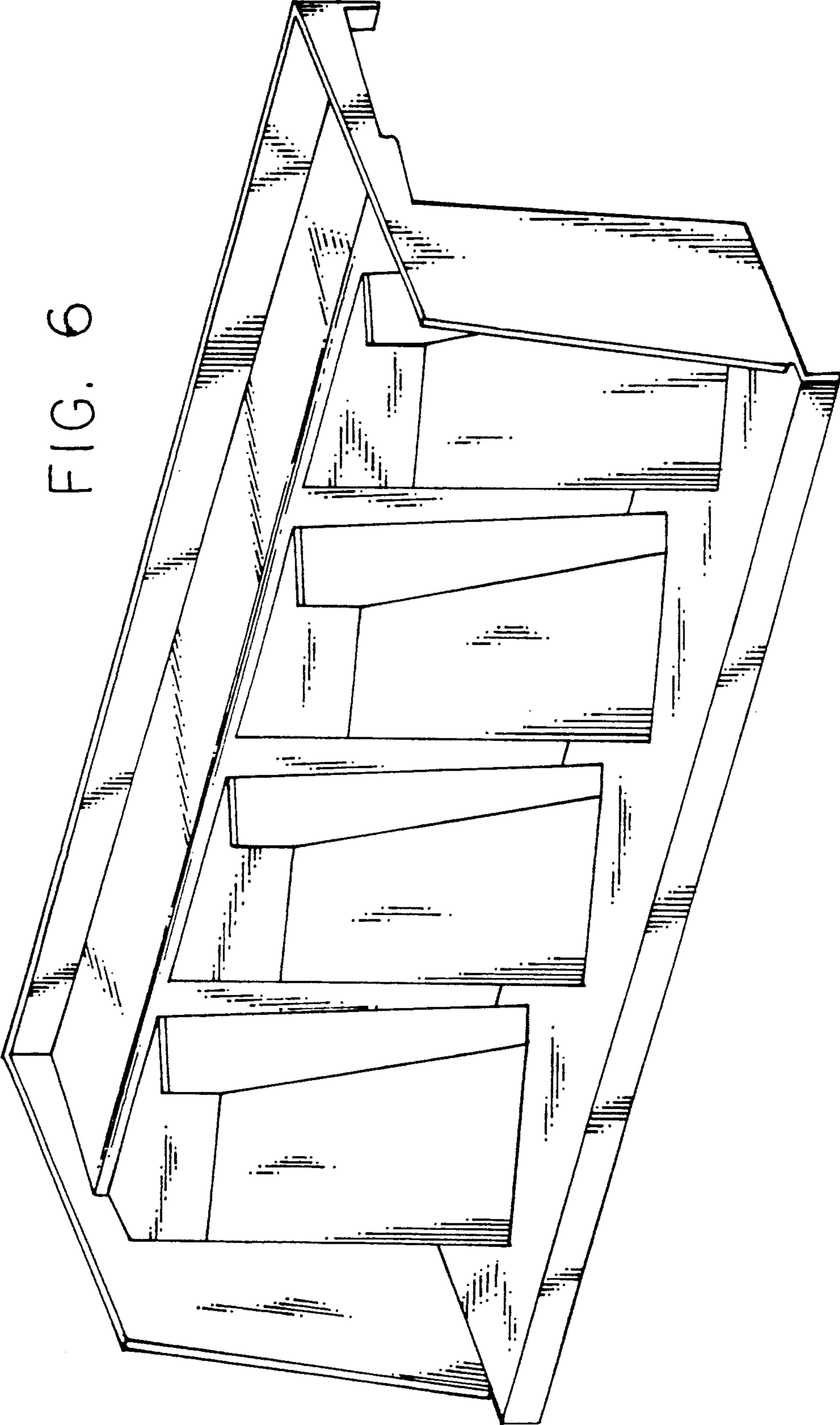

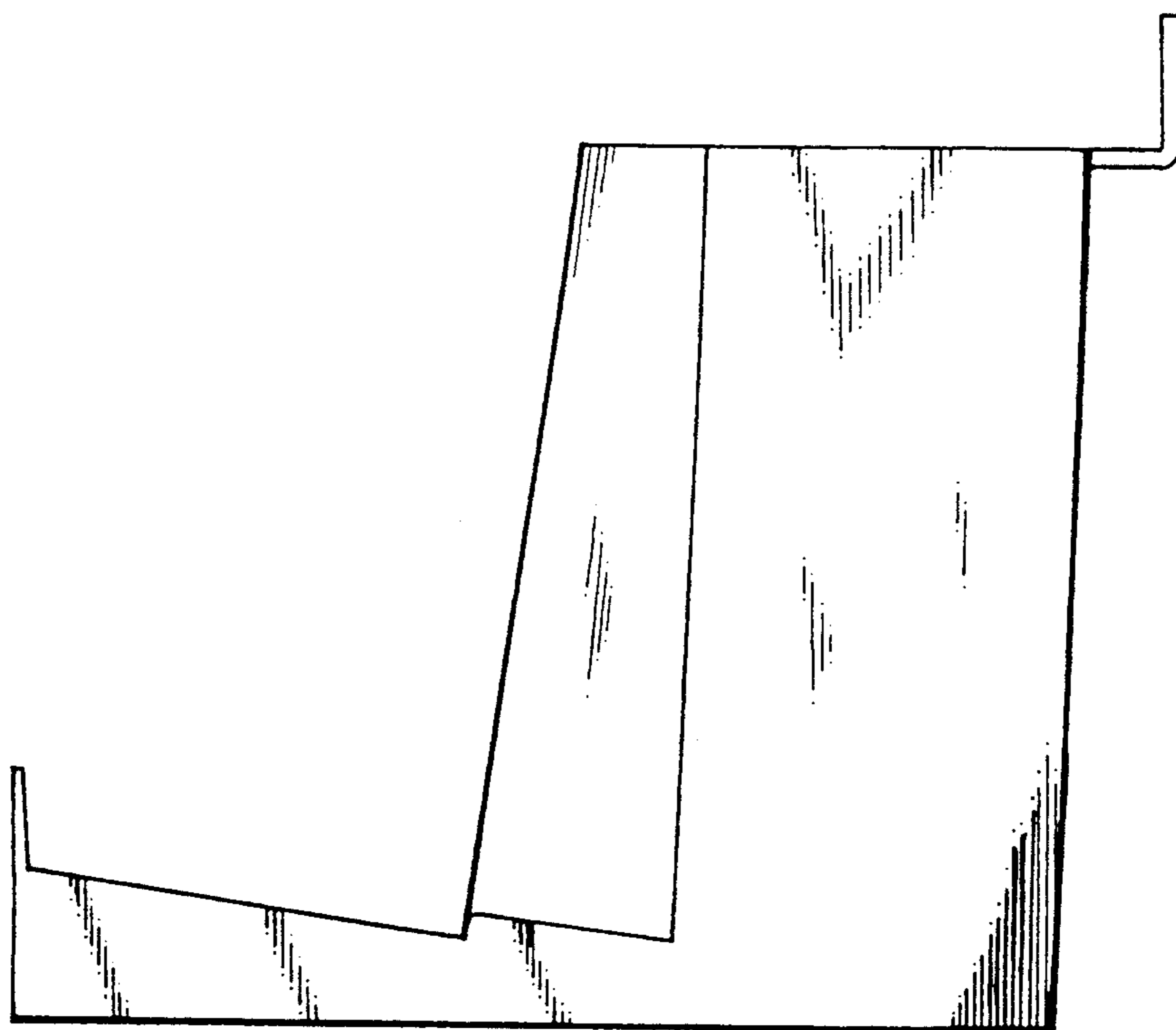
