DESCRIPTION

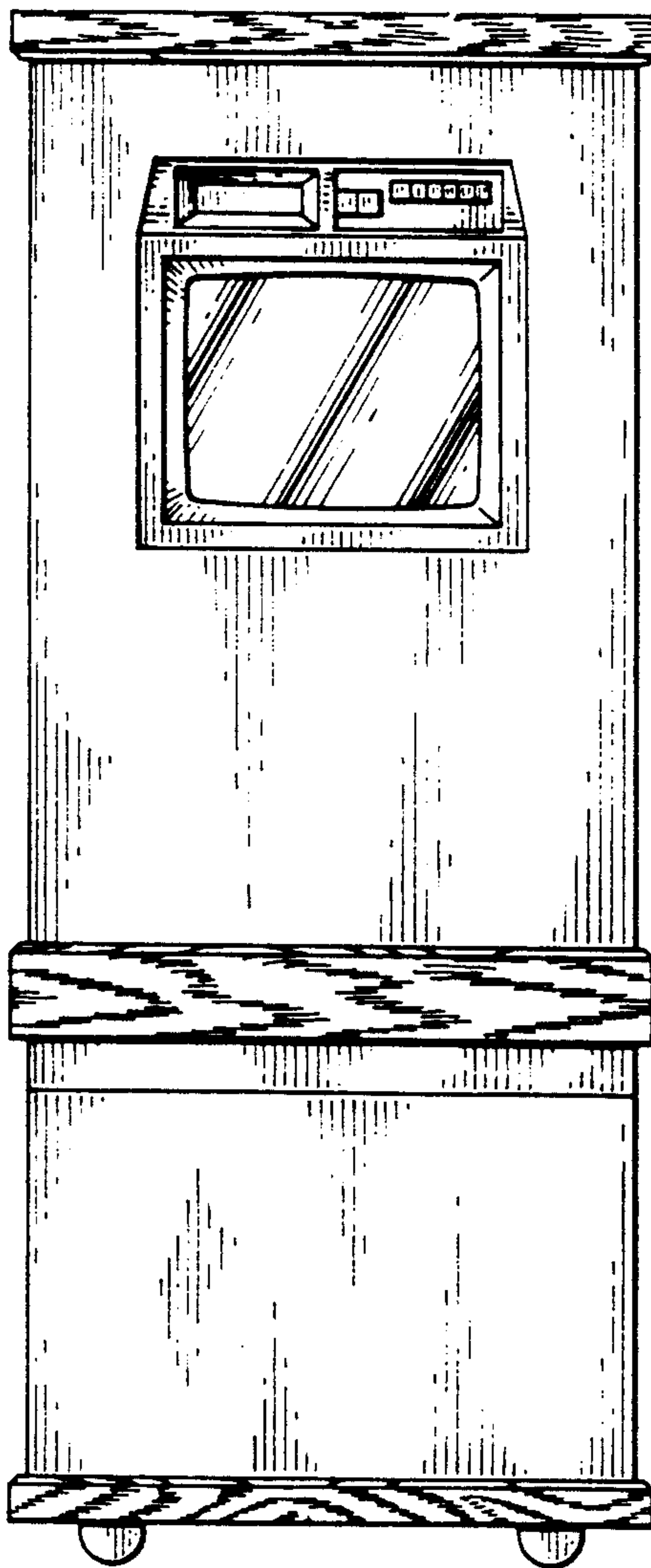
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the video cabinet

image thereof.



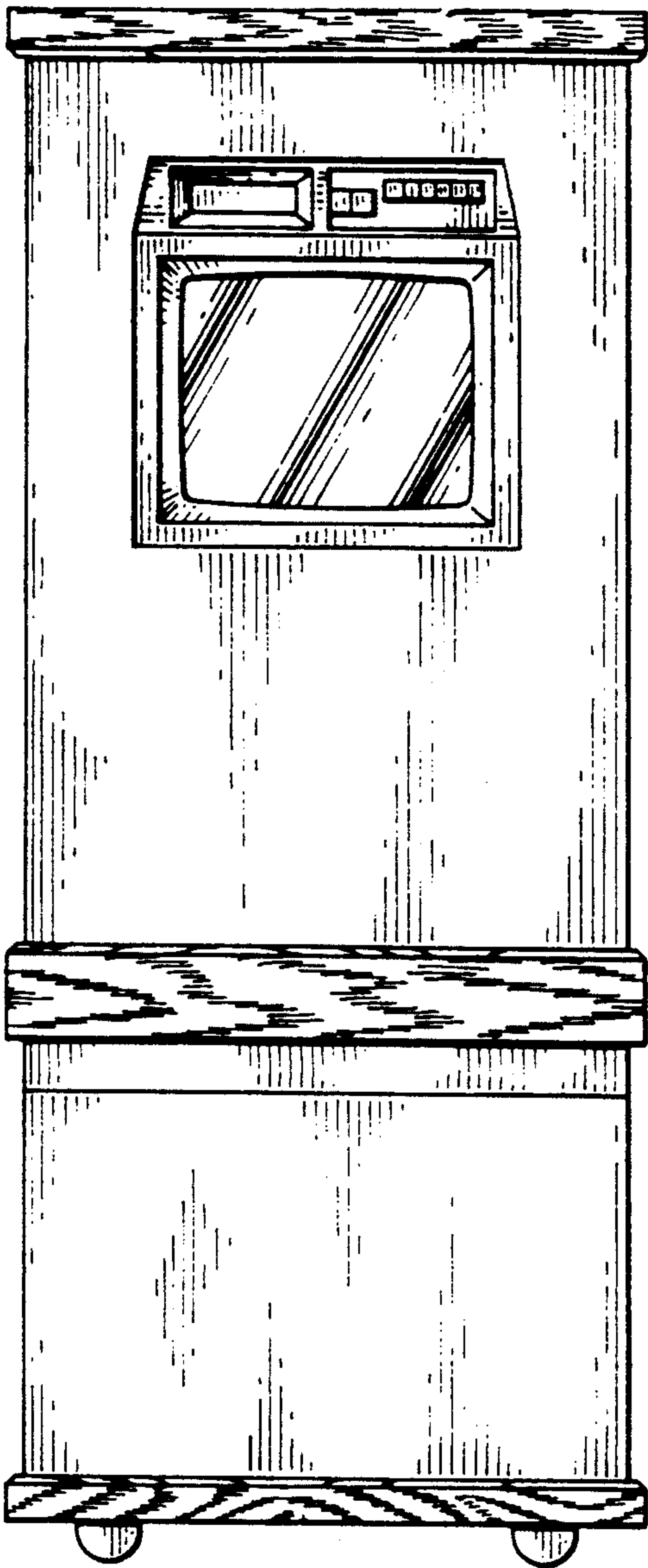
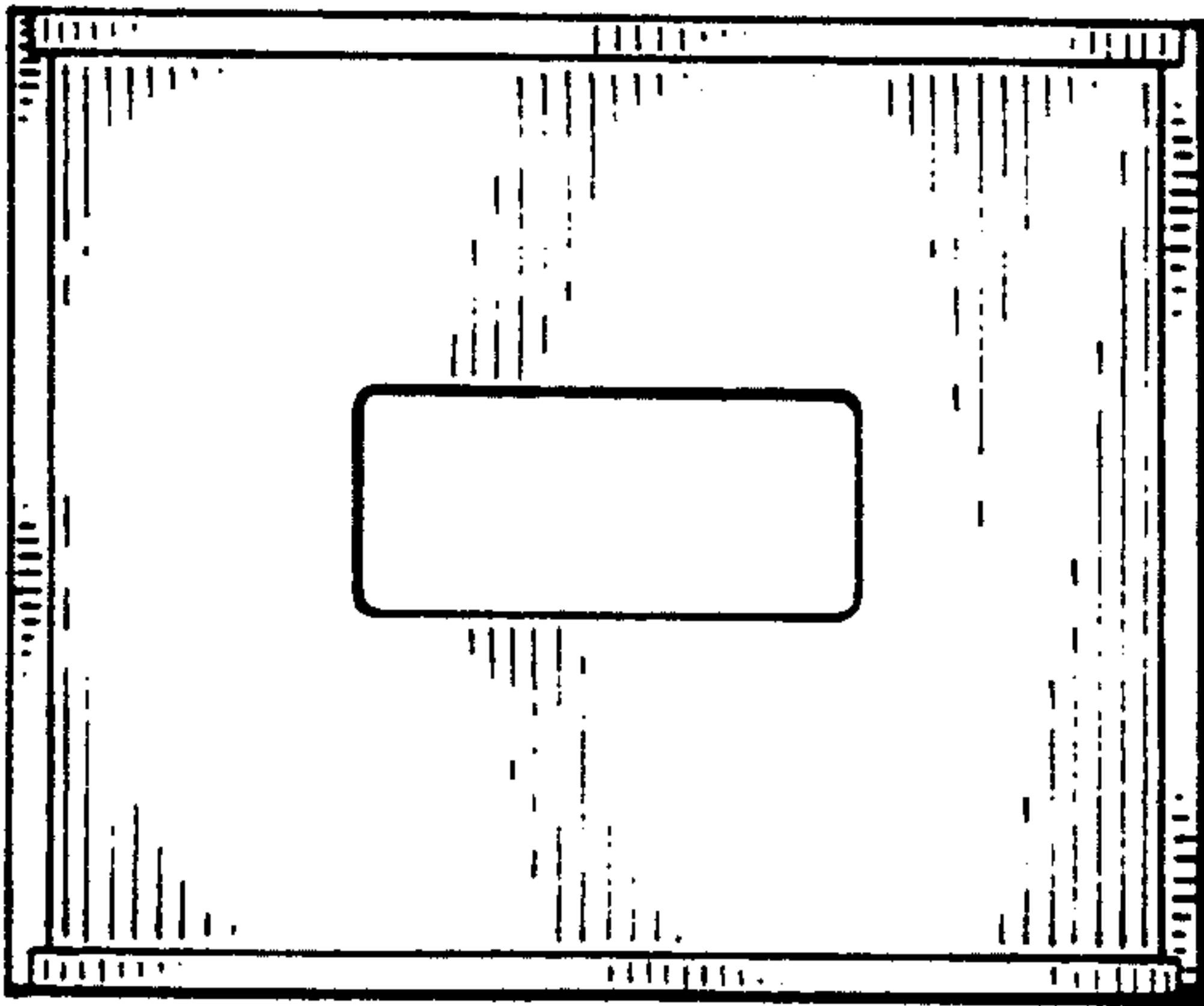

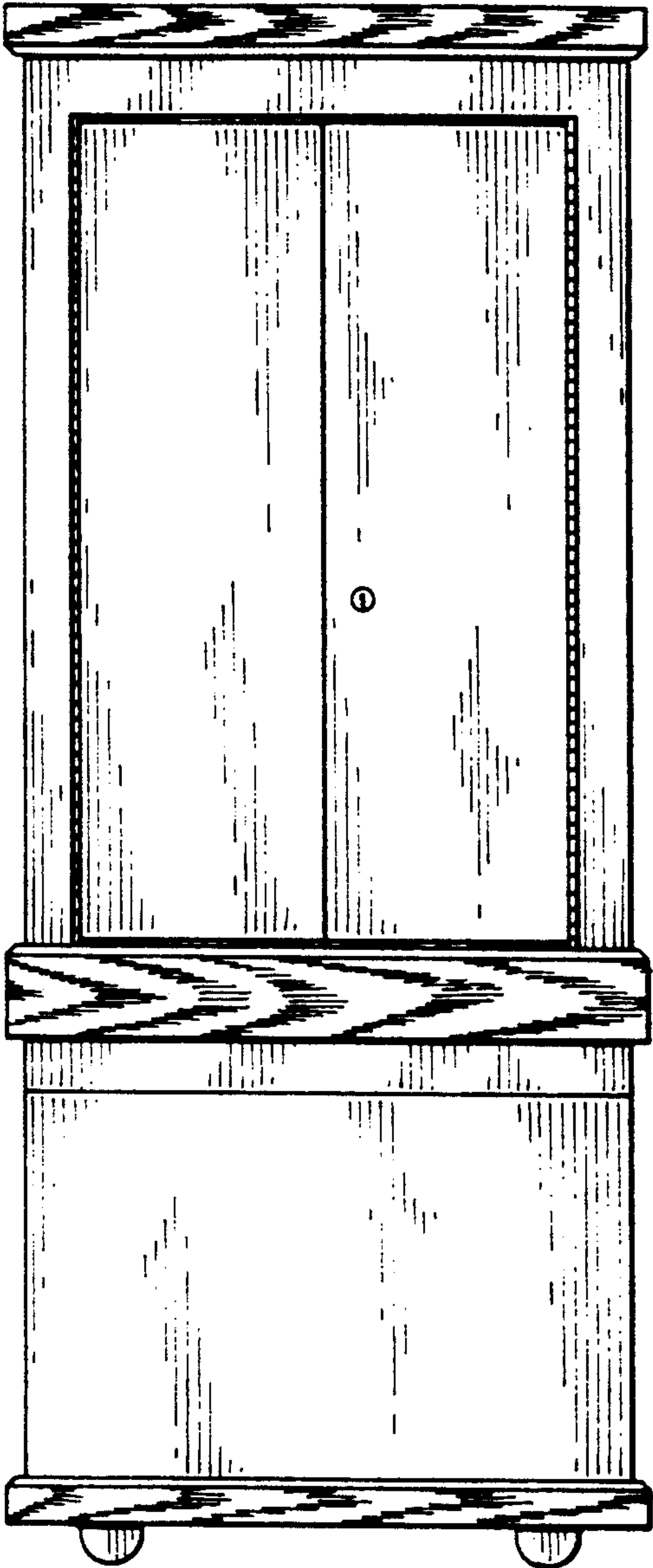
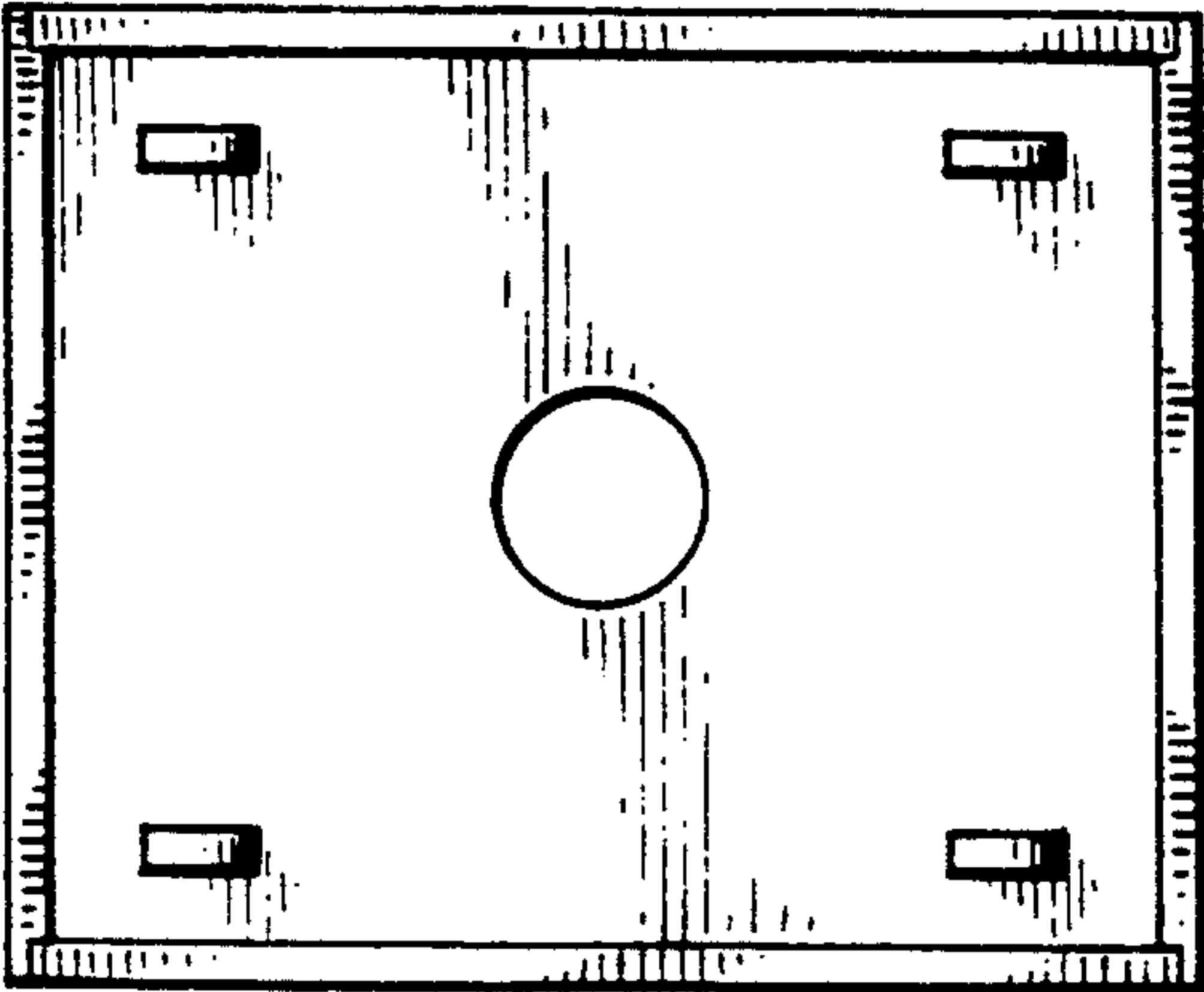

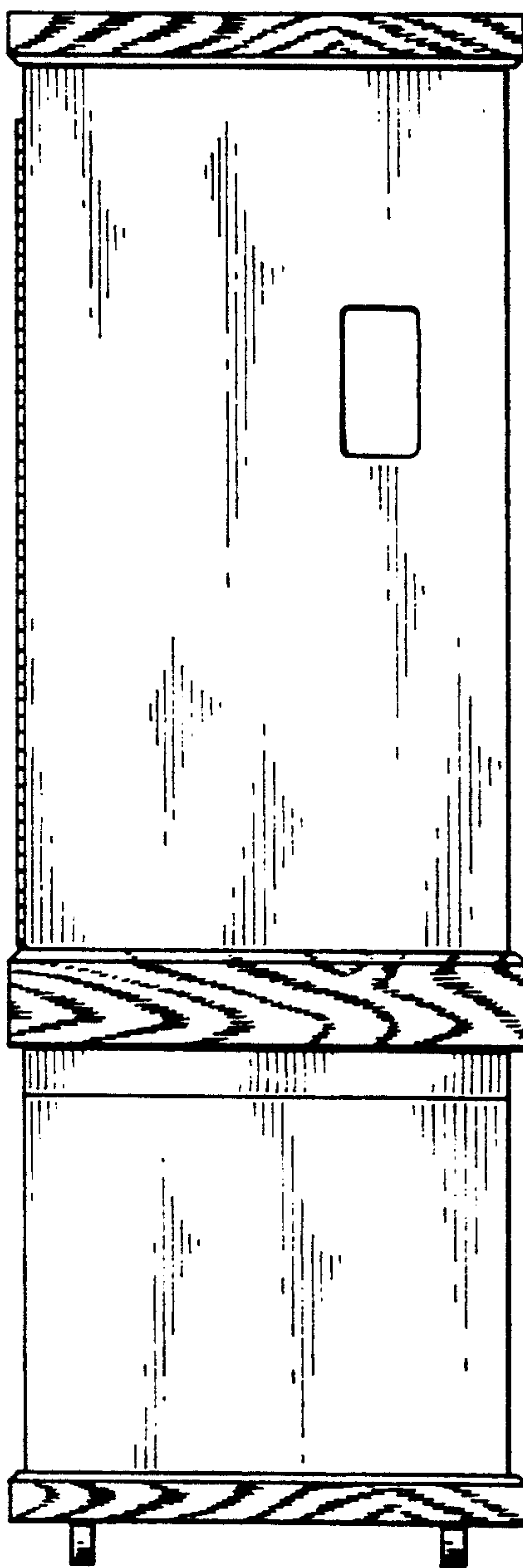
