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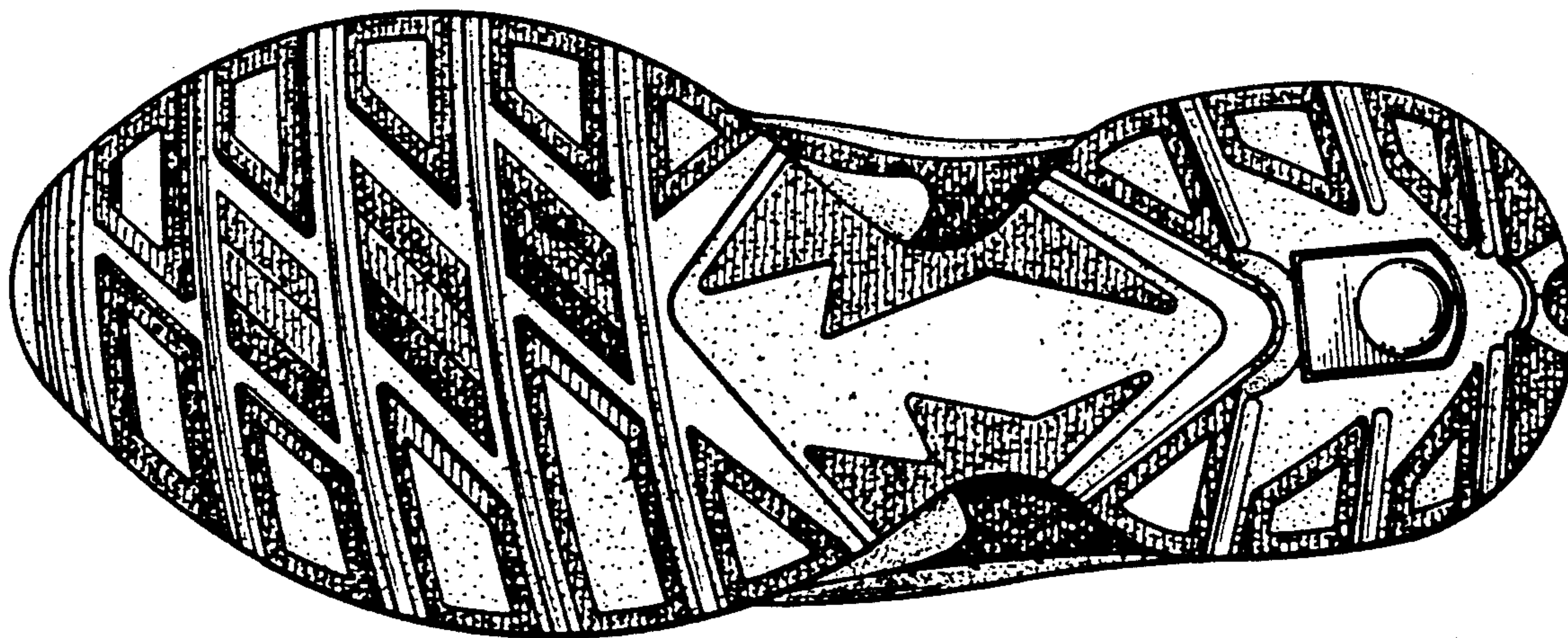
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

The broken line showing of a shoe upper is for environmental purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



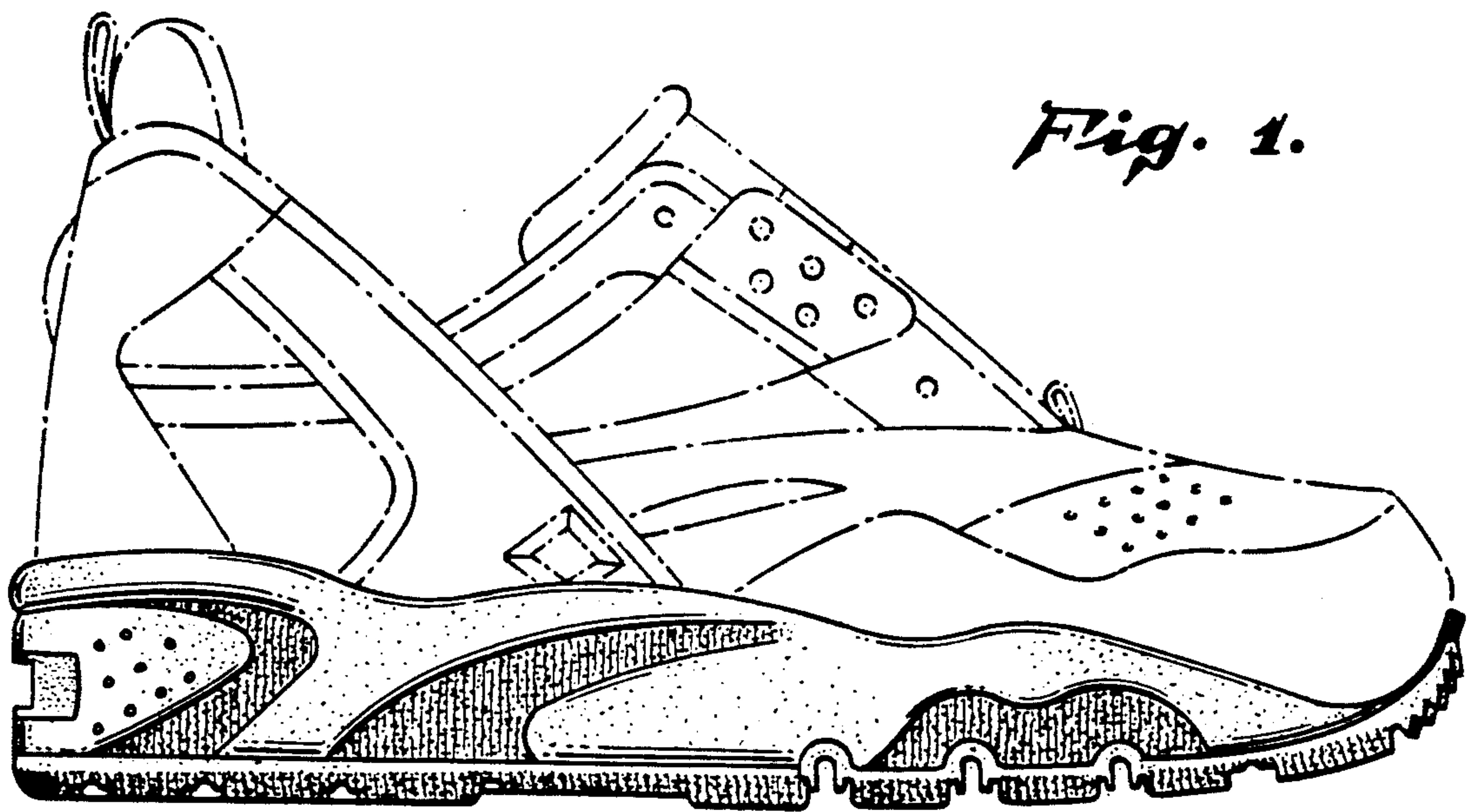

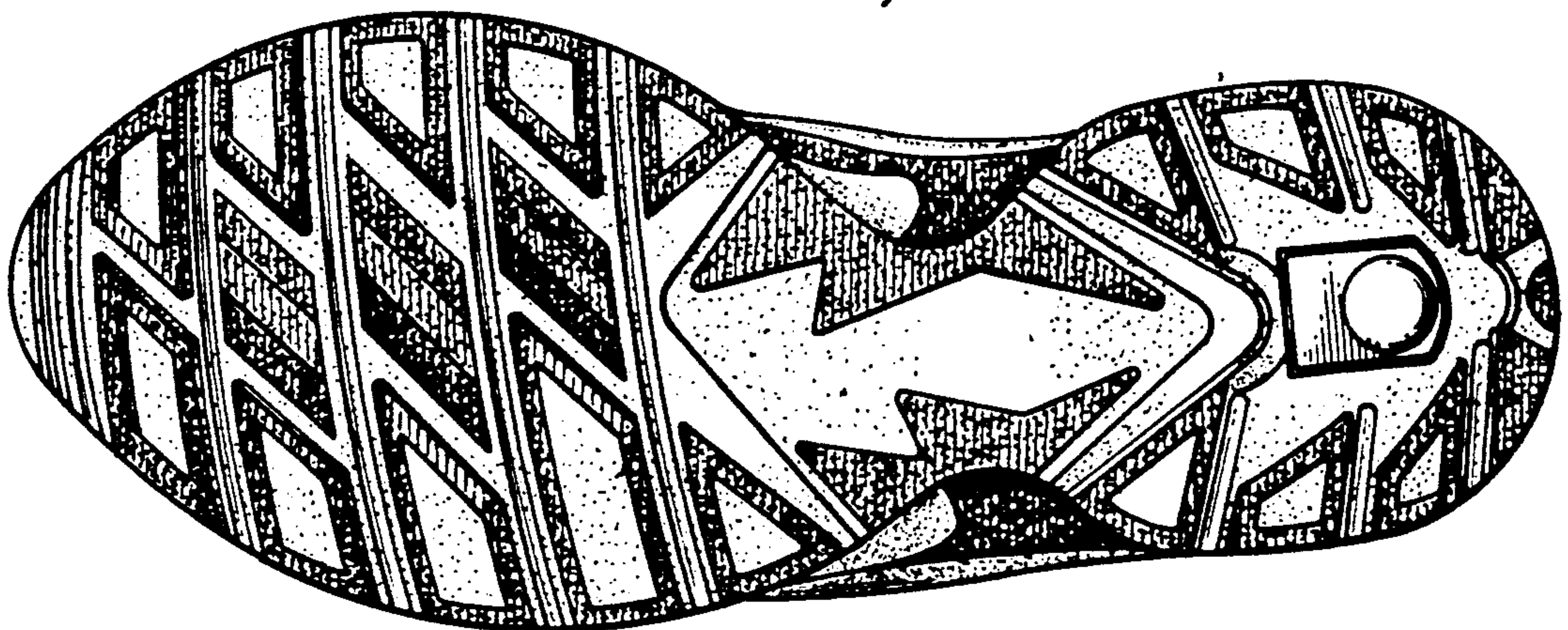

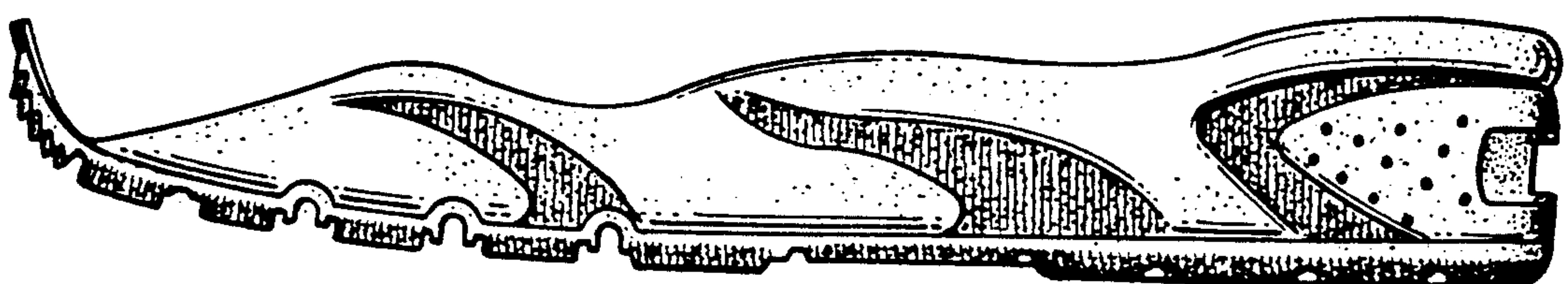

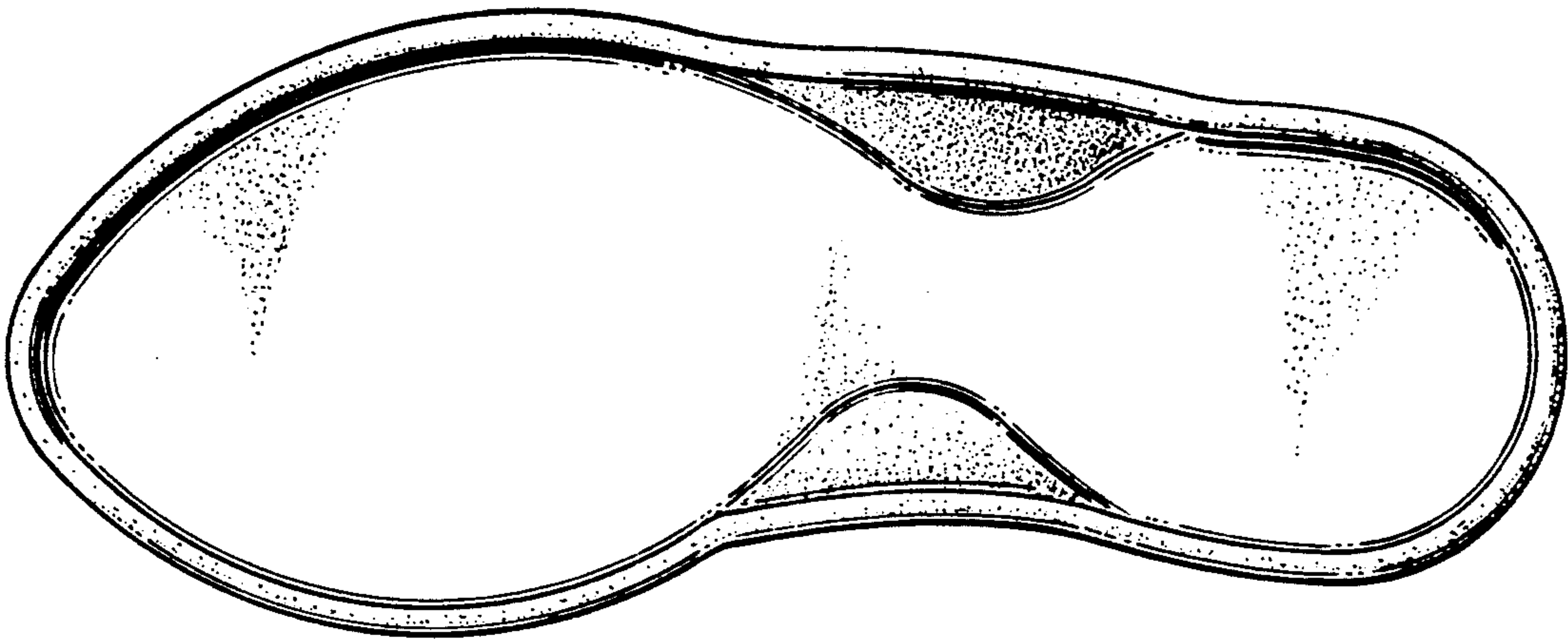

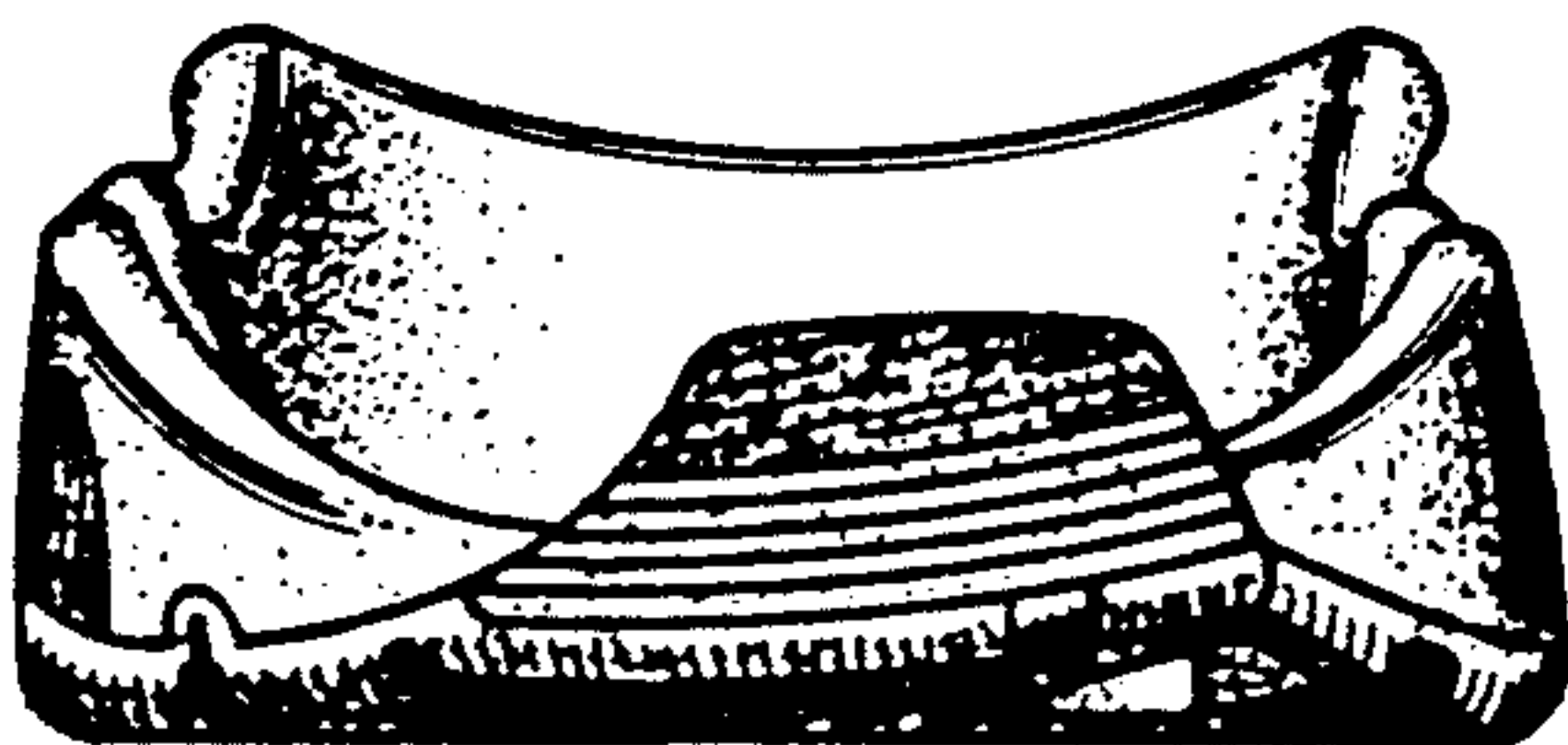
