FIG. 12 is a front elevation view of FIG. 8;

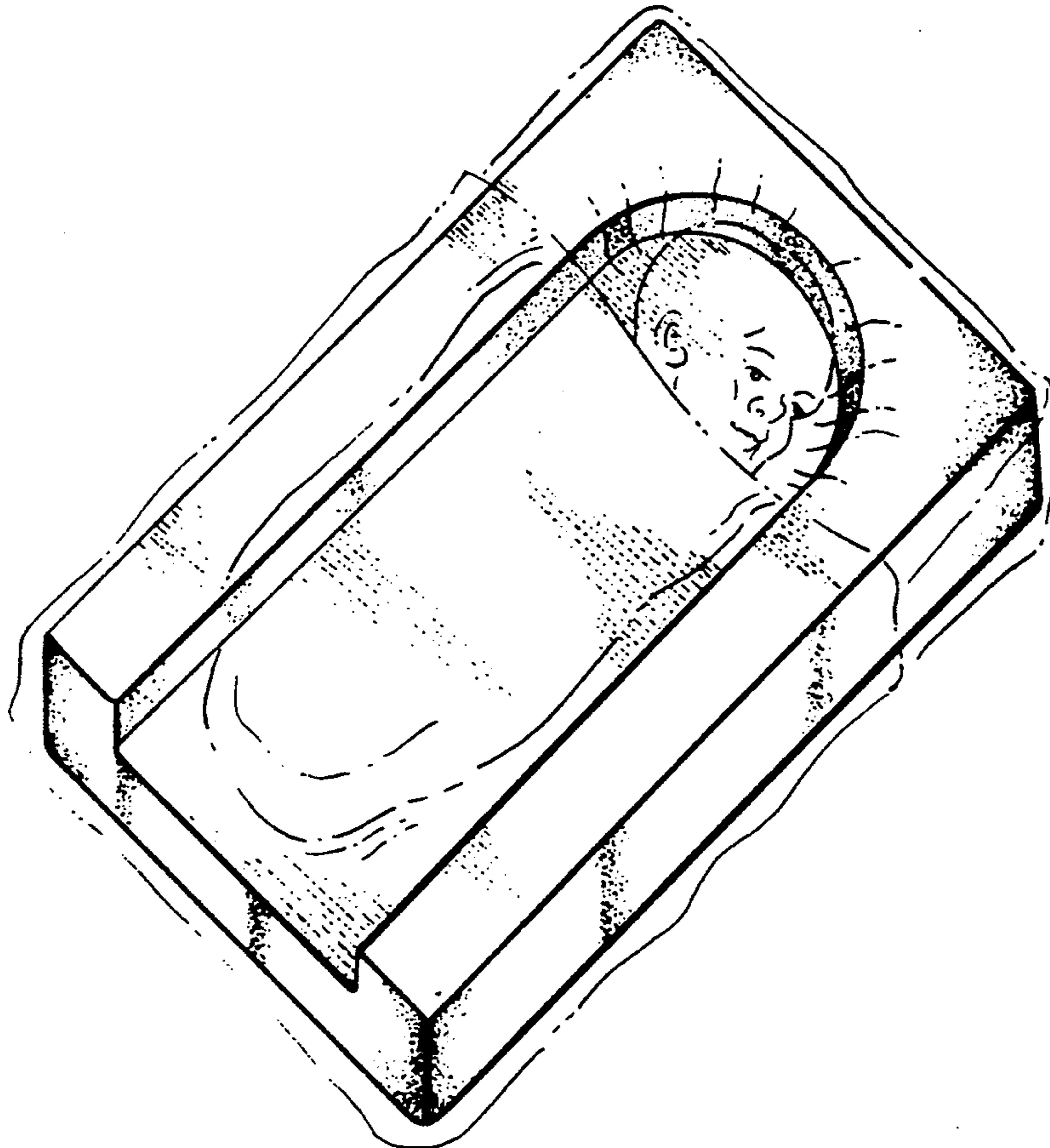
The ornamental design for a combined infant cushion and cover, as shown and described.

The cross-hatch shading in FIGS. 1, and 8-14 represents fabric, and is understood to extend throughout the cover.



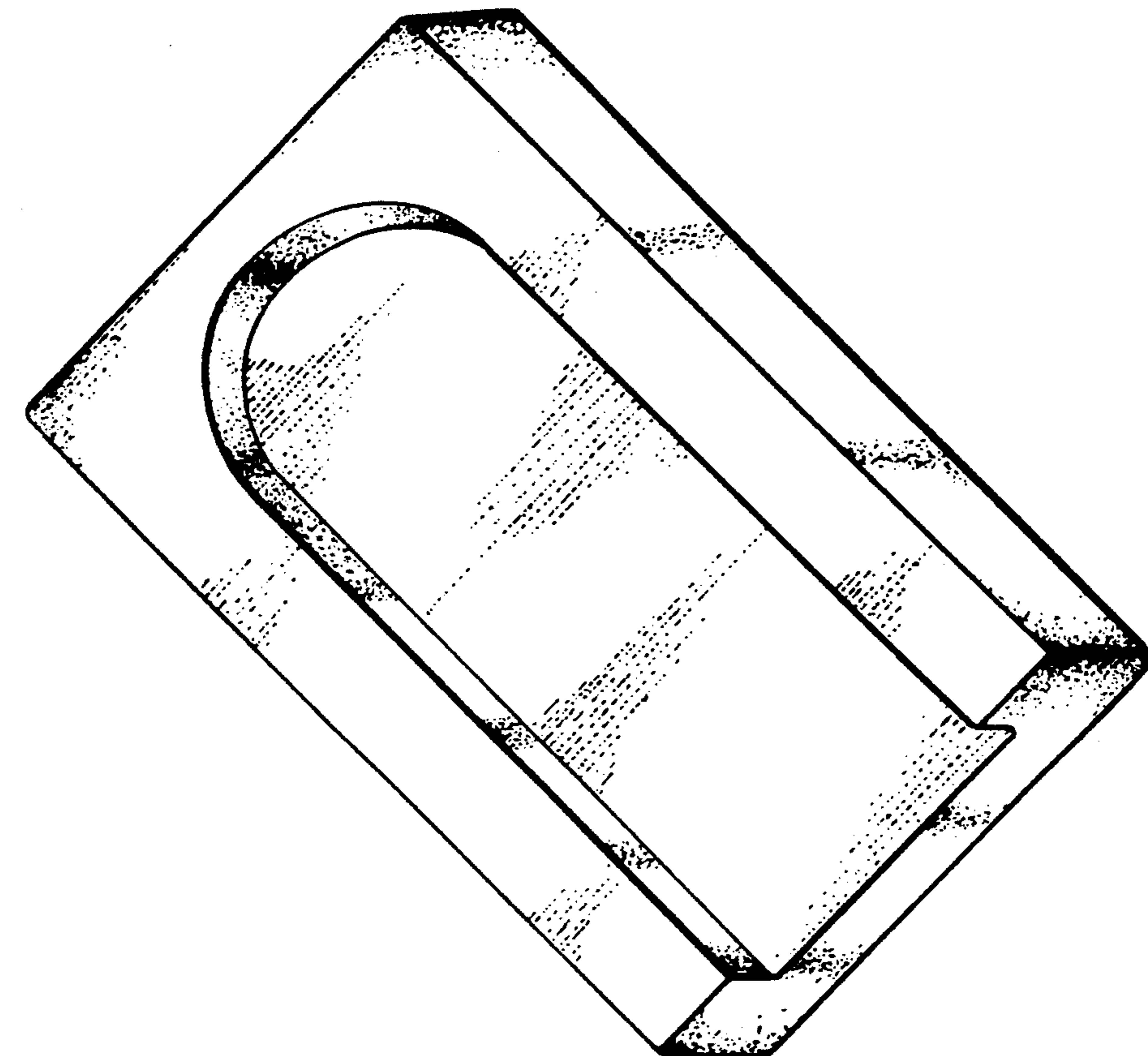

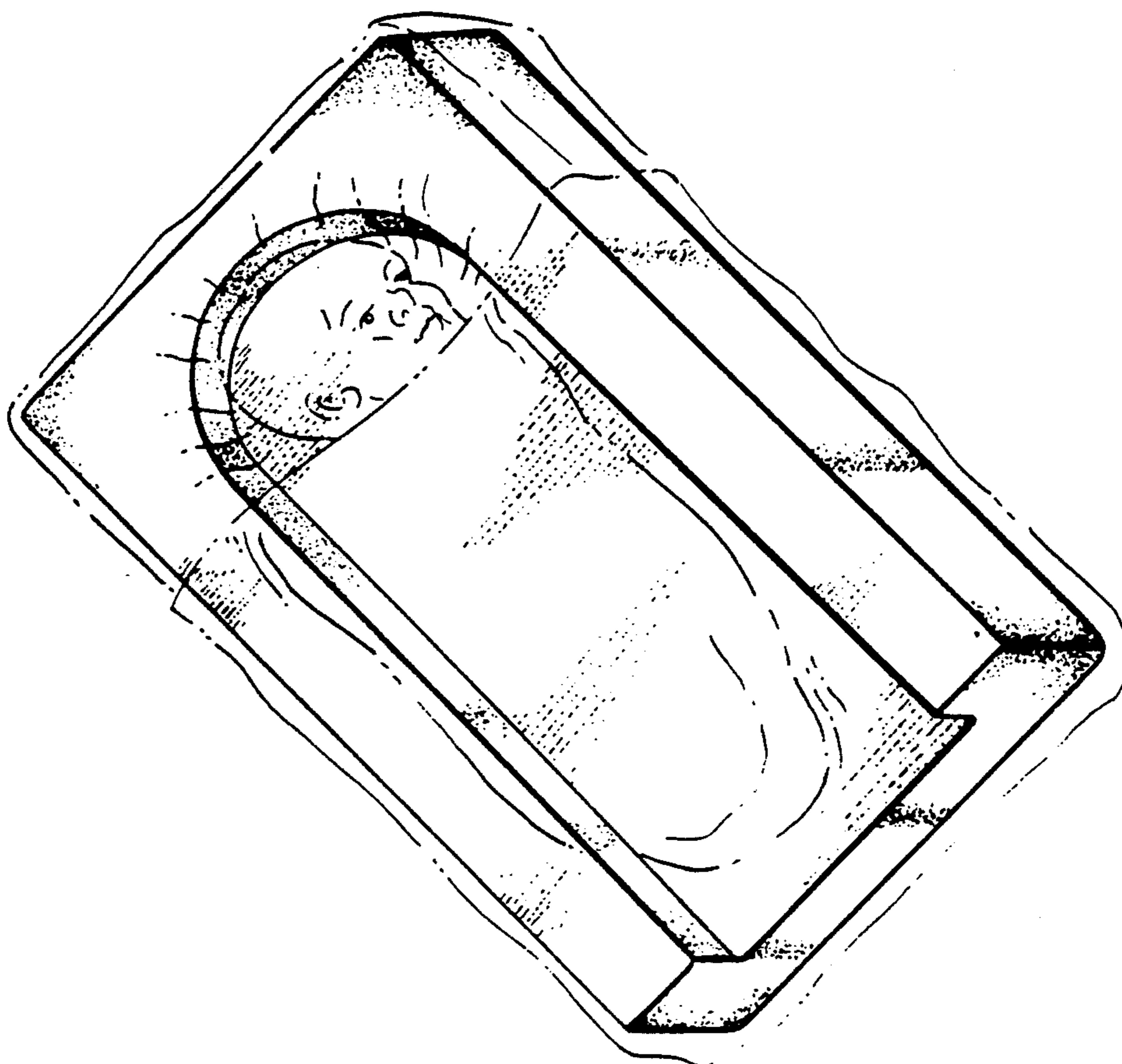

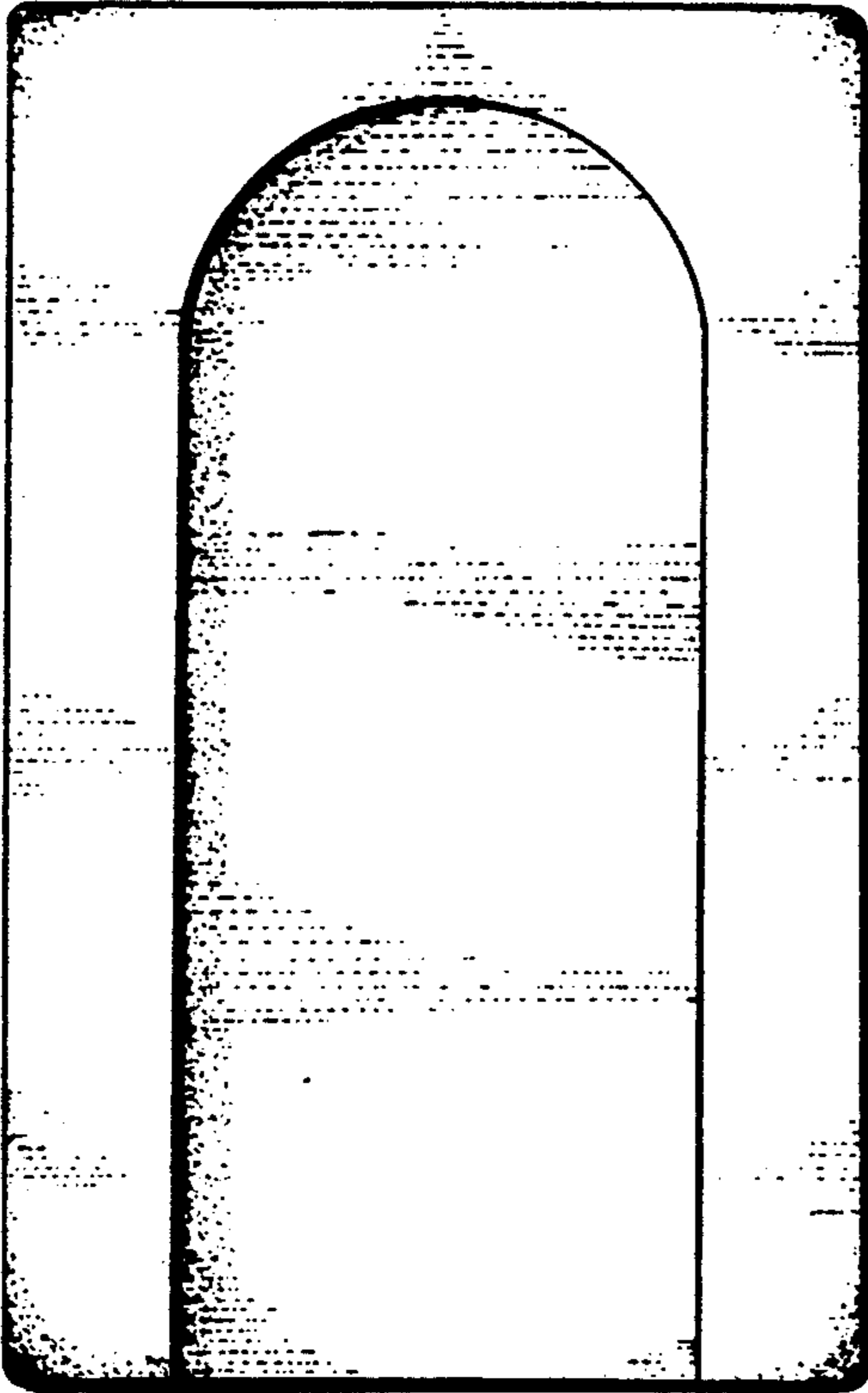

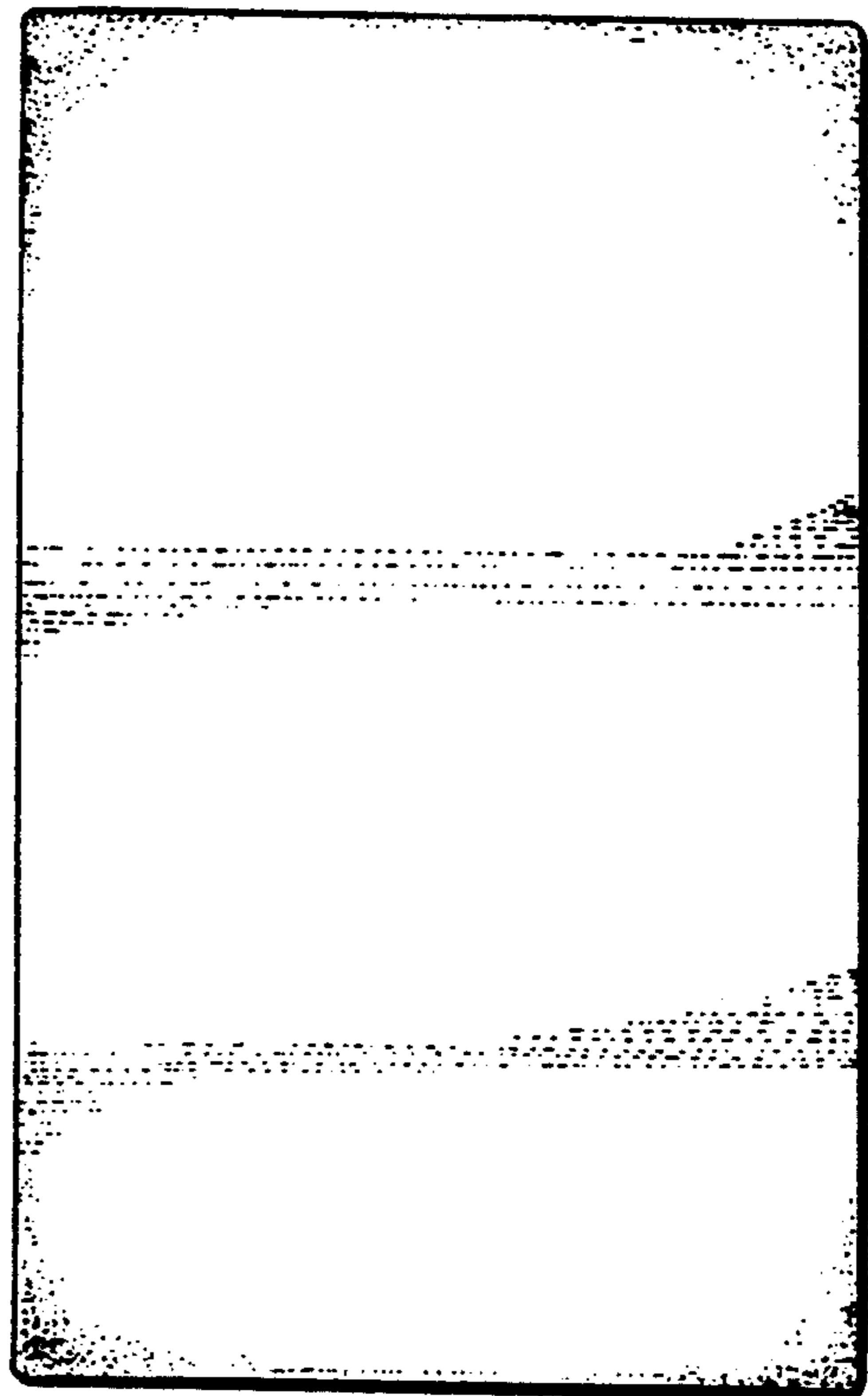

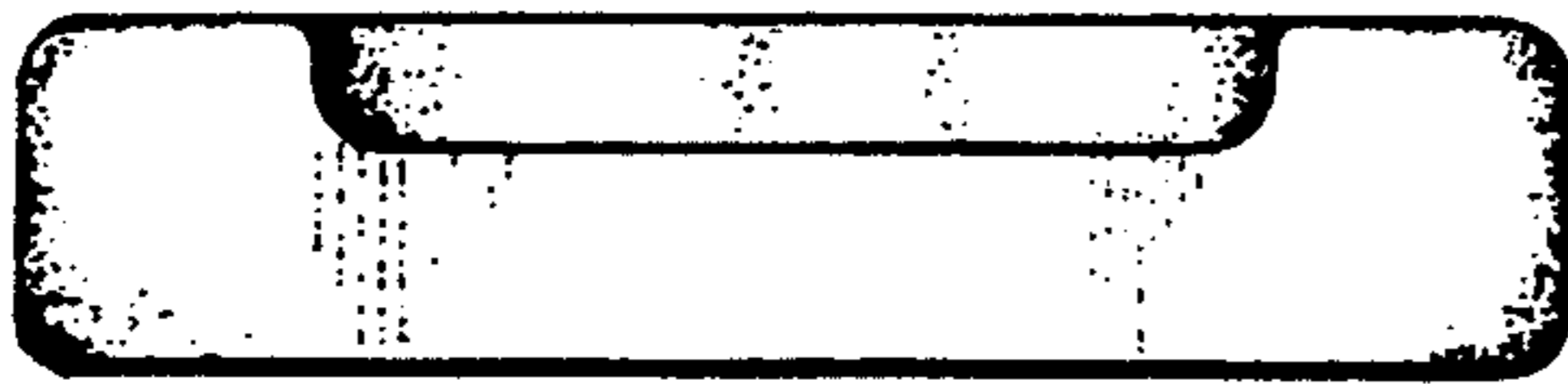

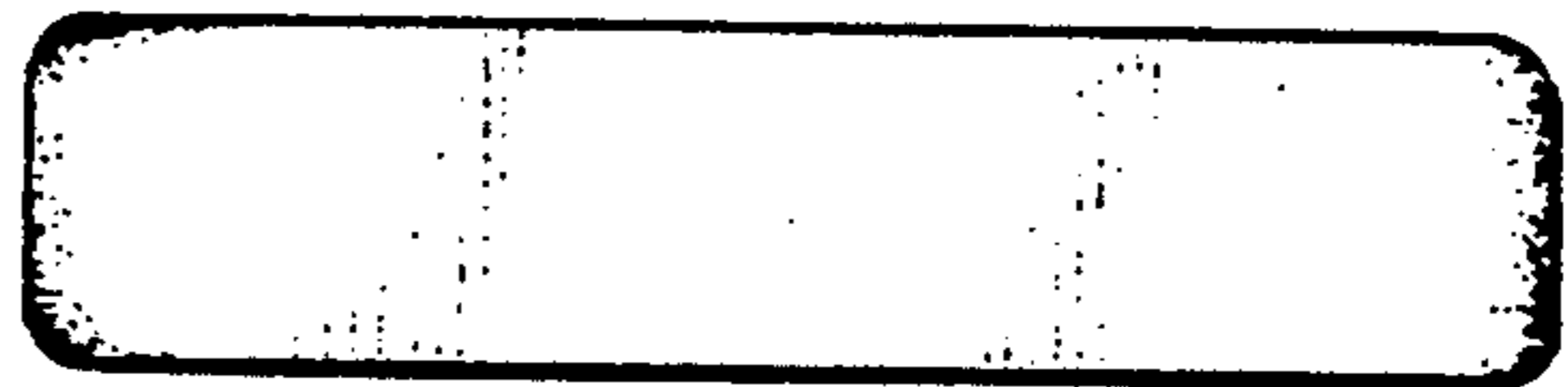

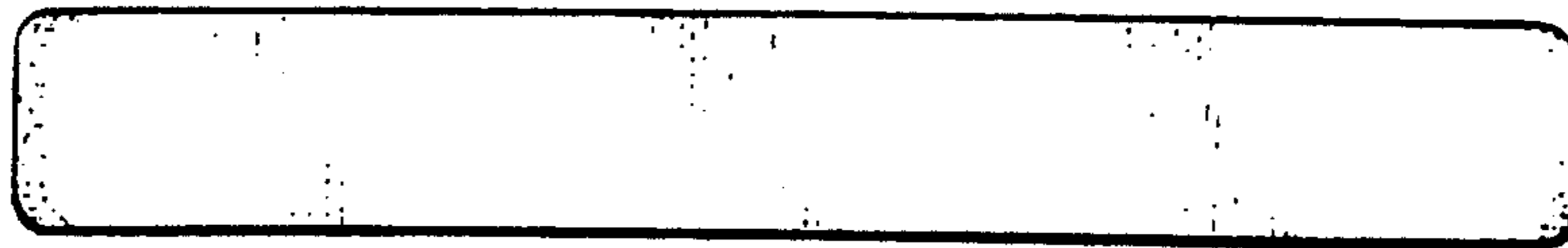
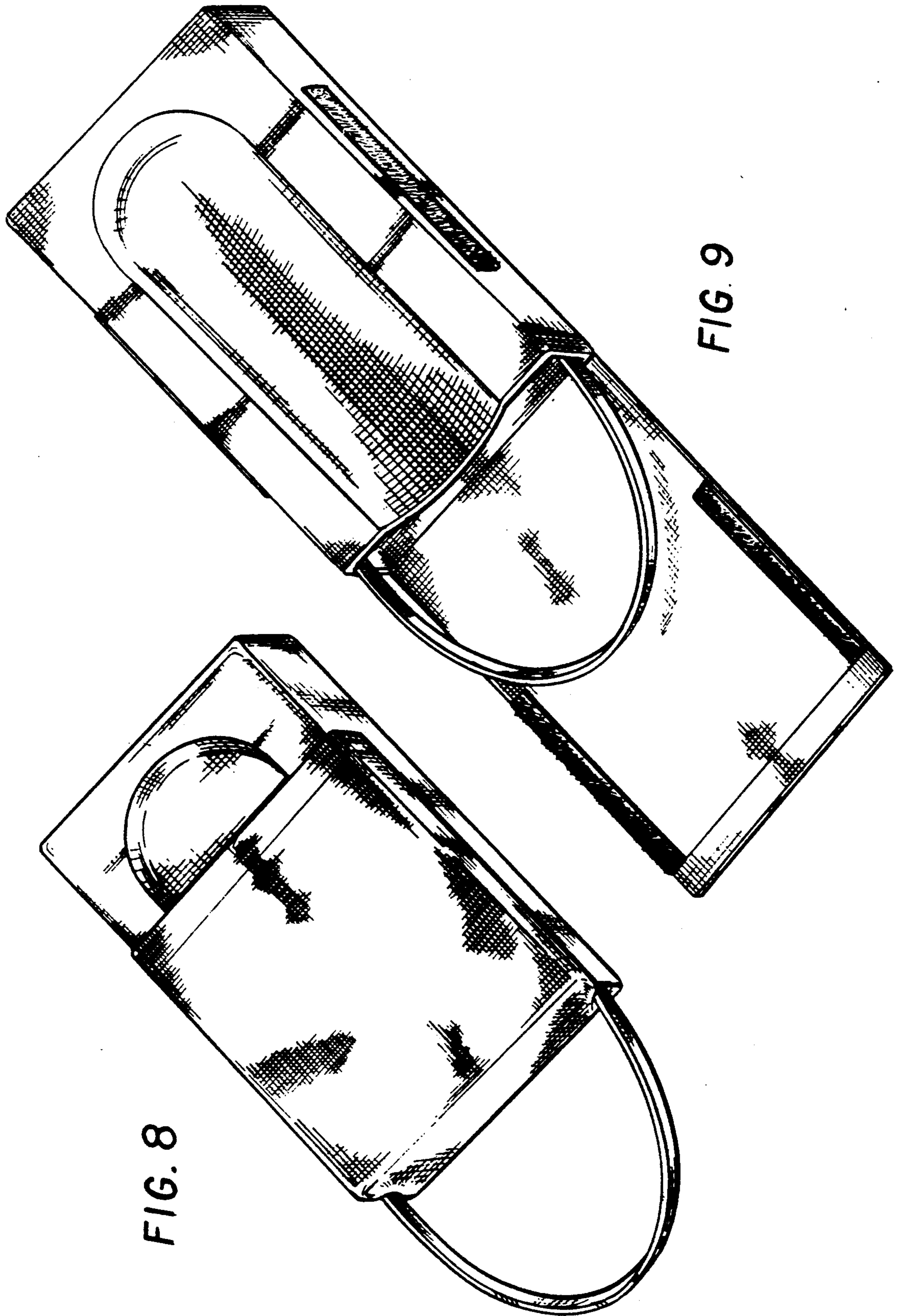

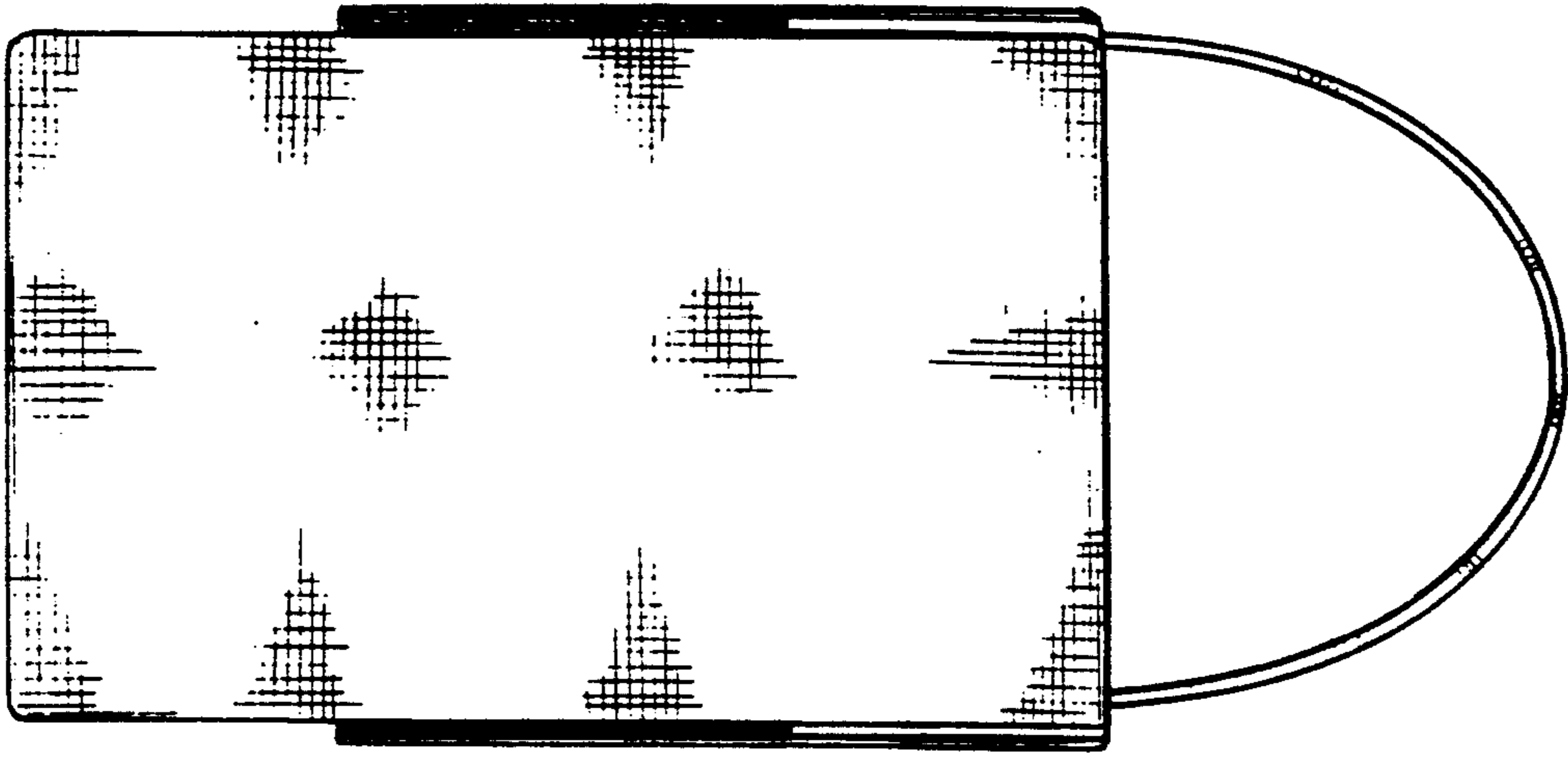

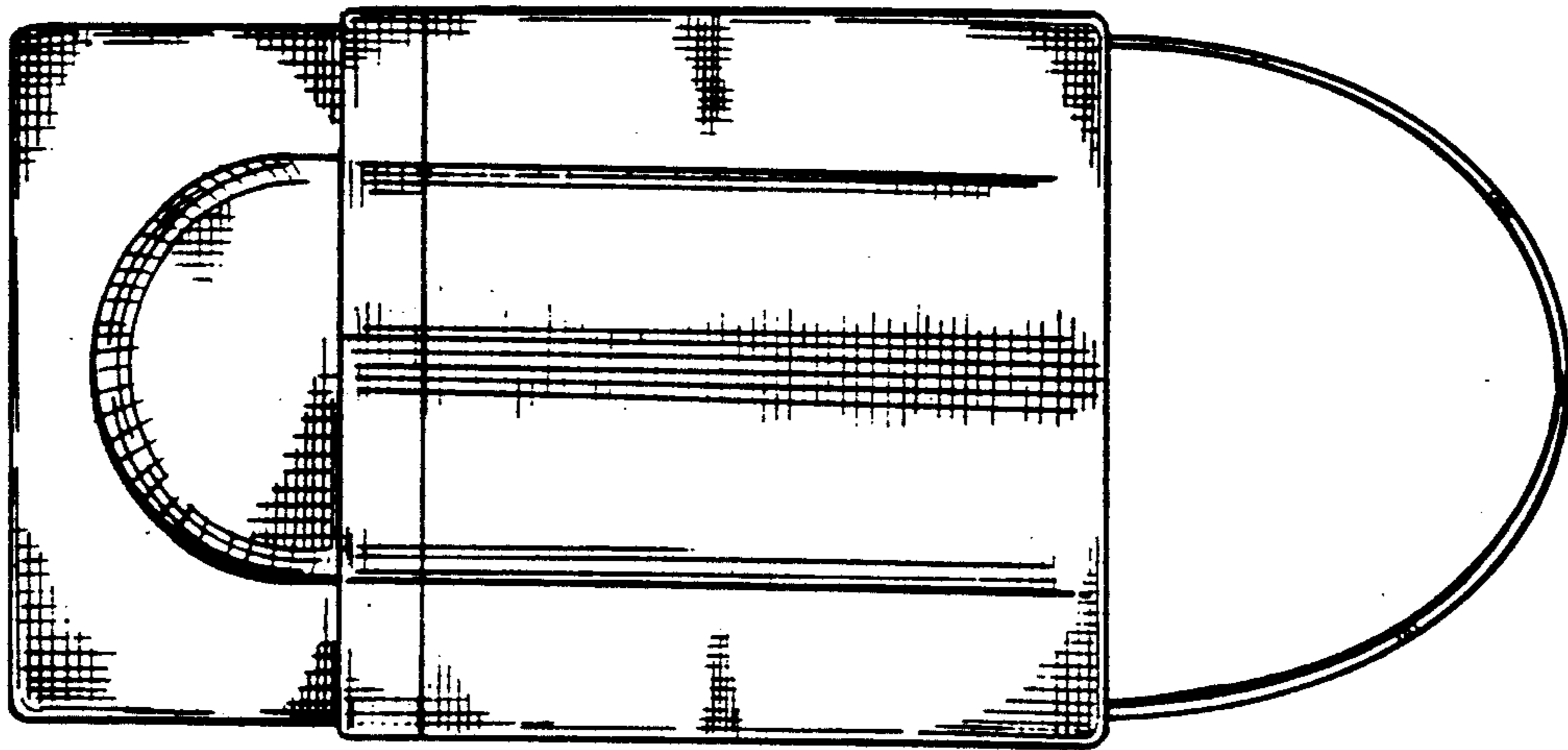

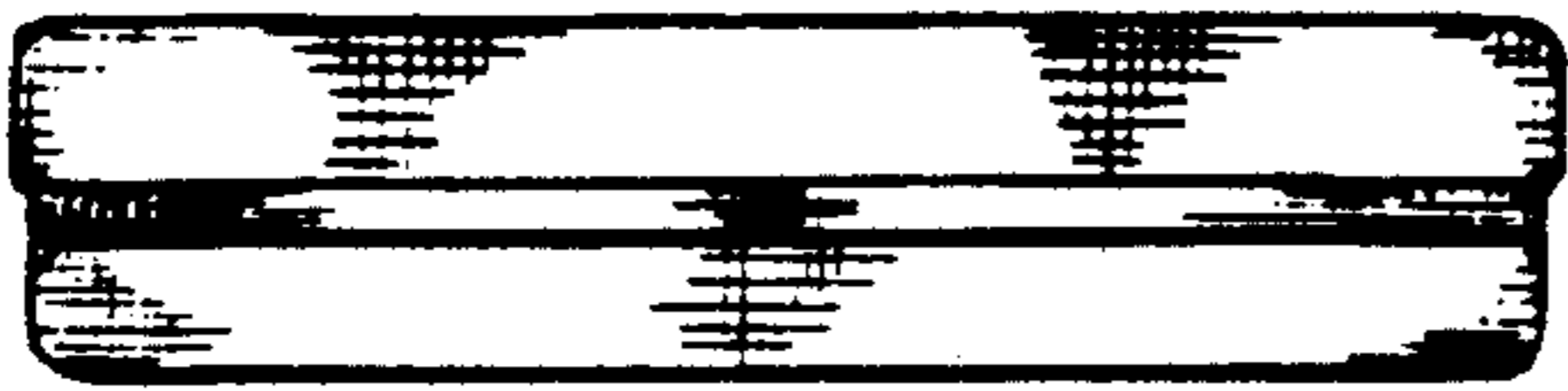
