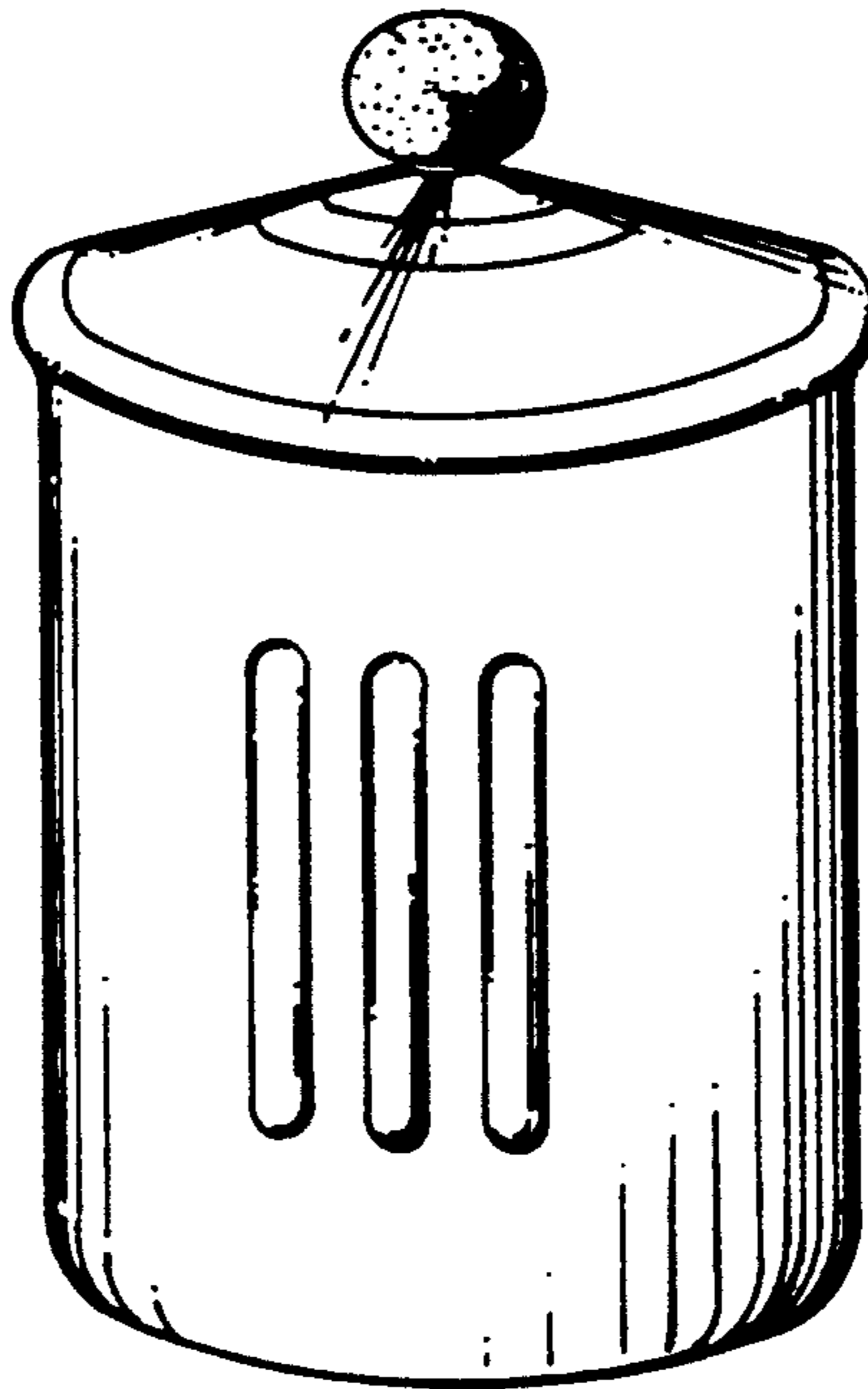

The ornamental design for a preserving jar, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view for a preserving jar showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



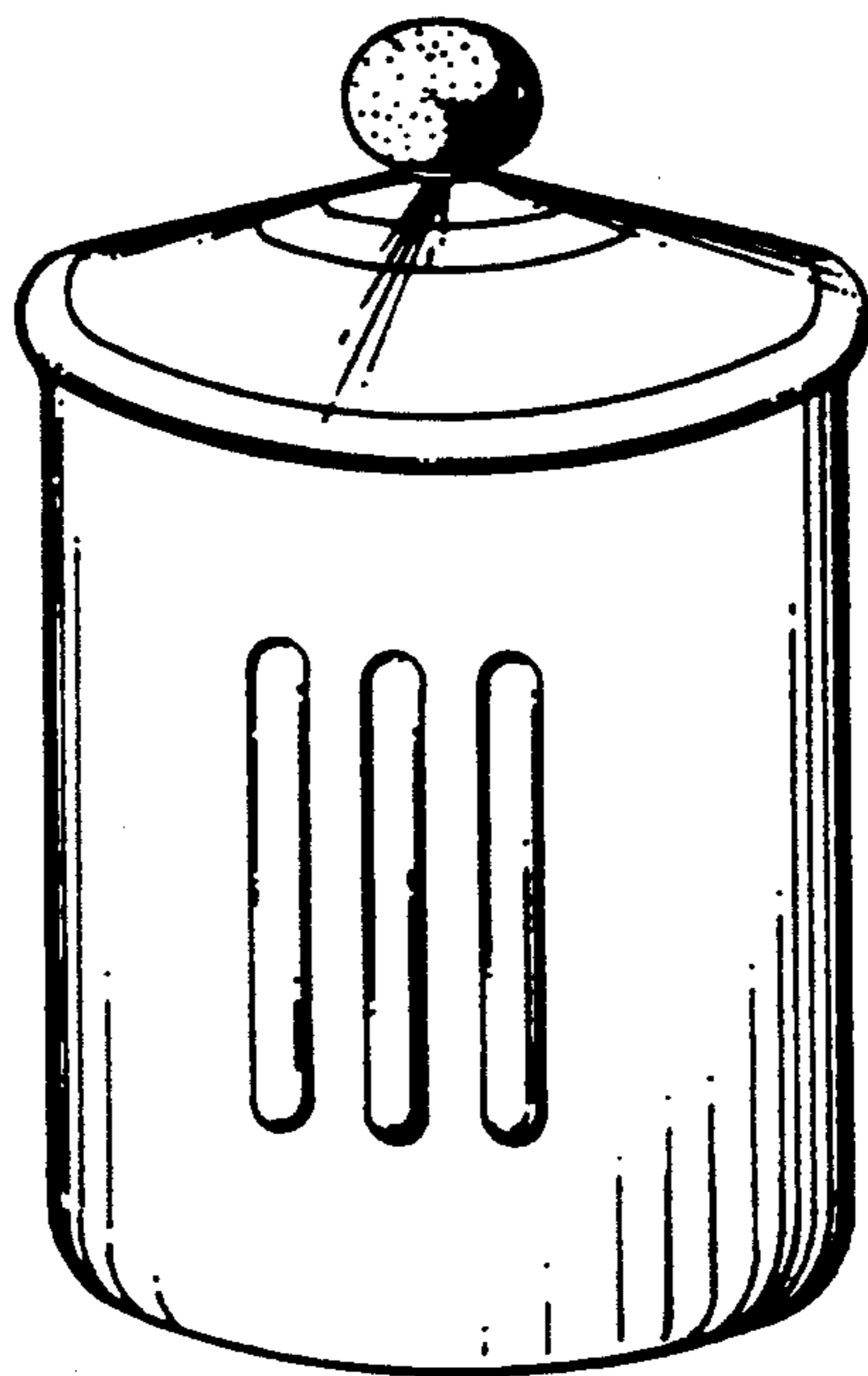

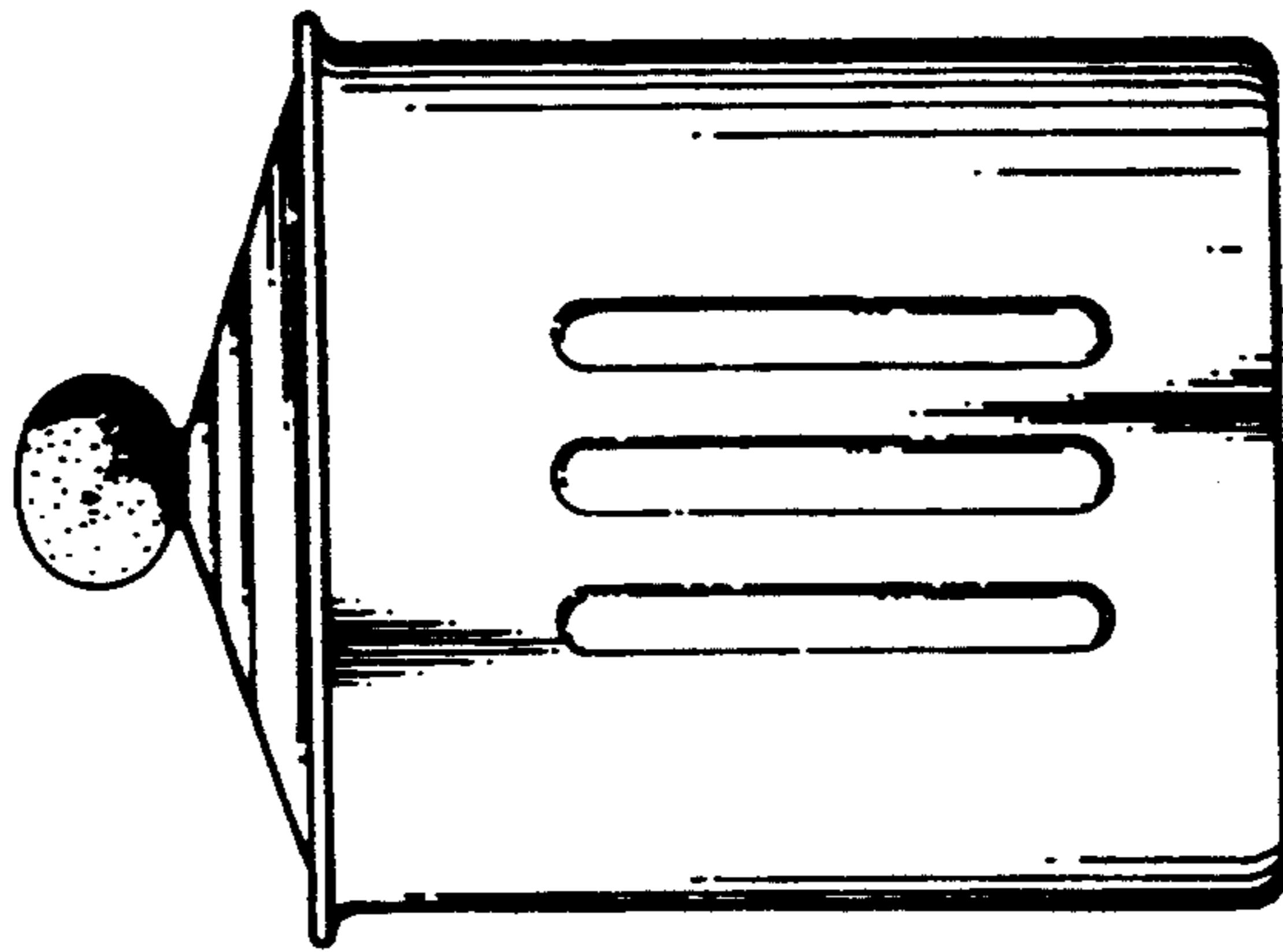

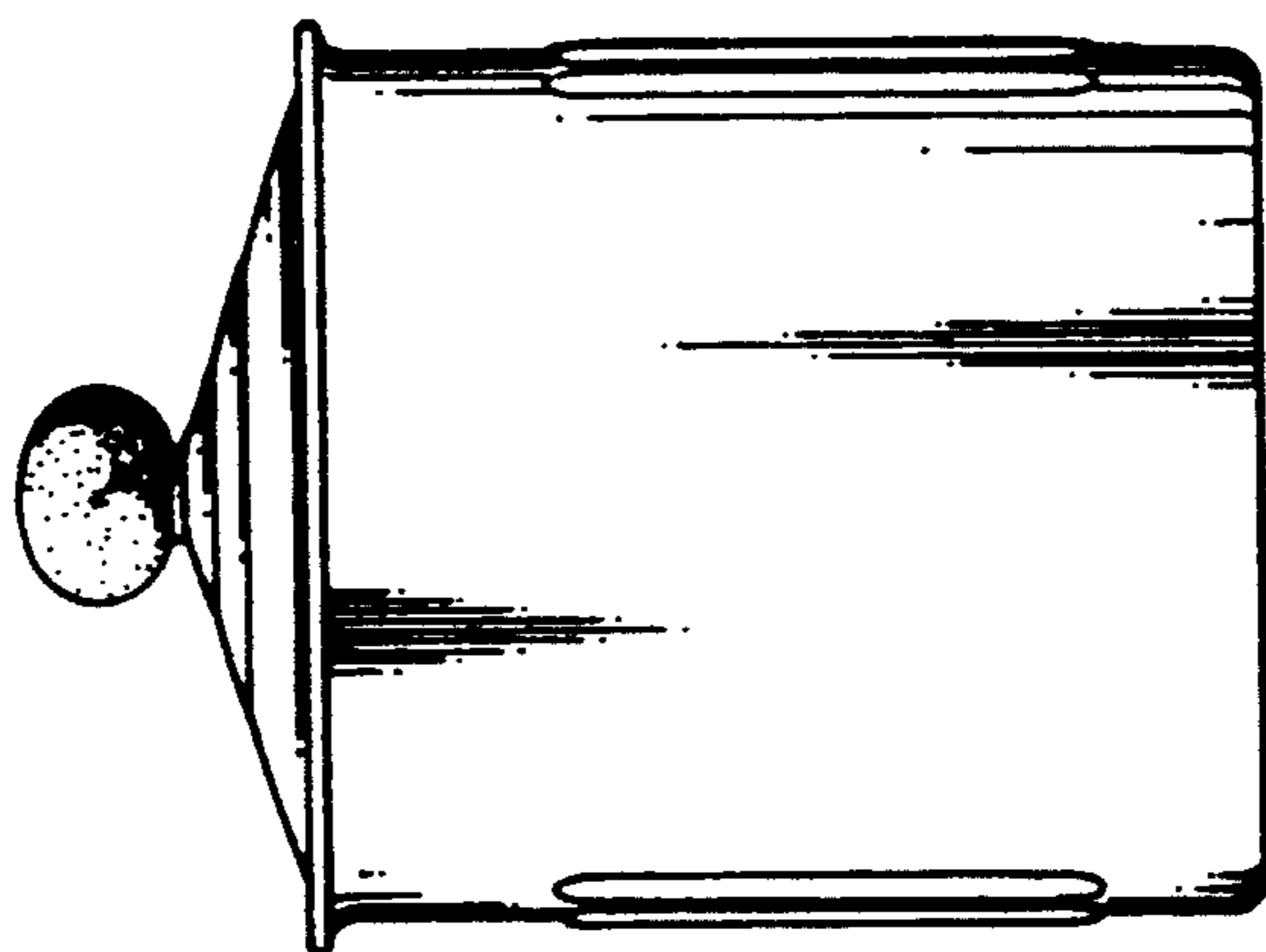

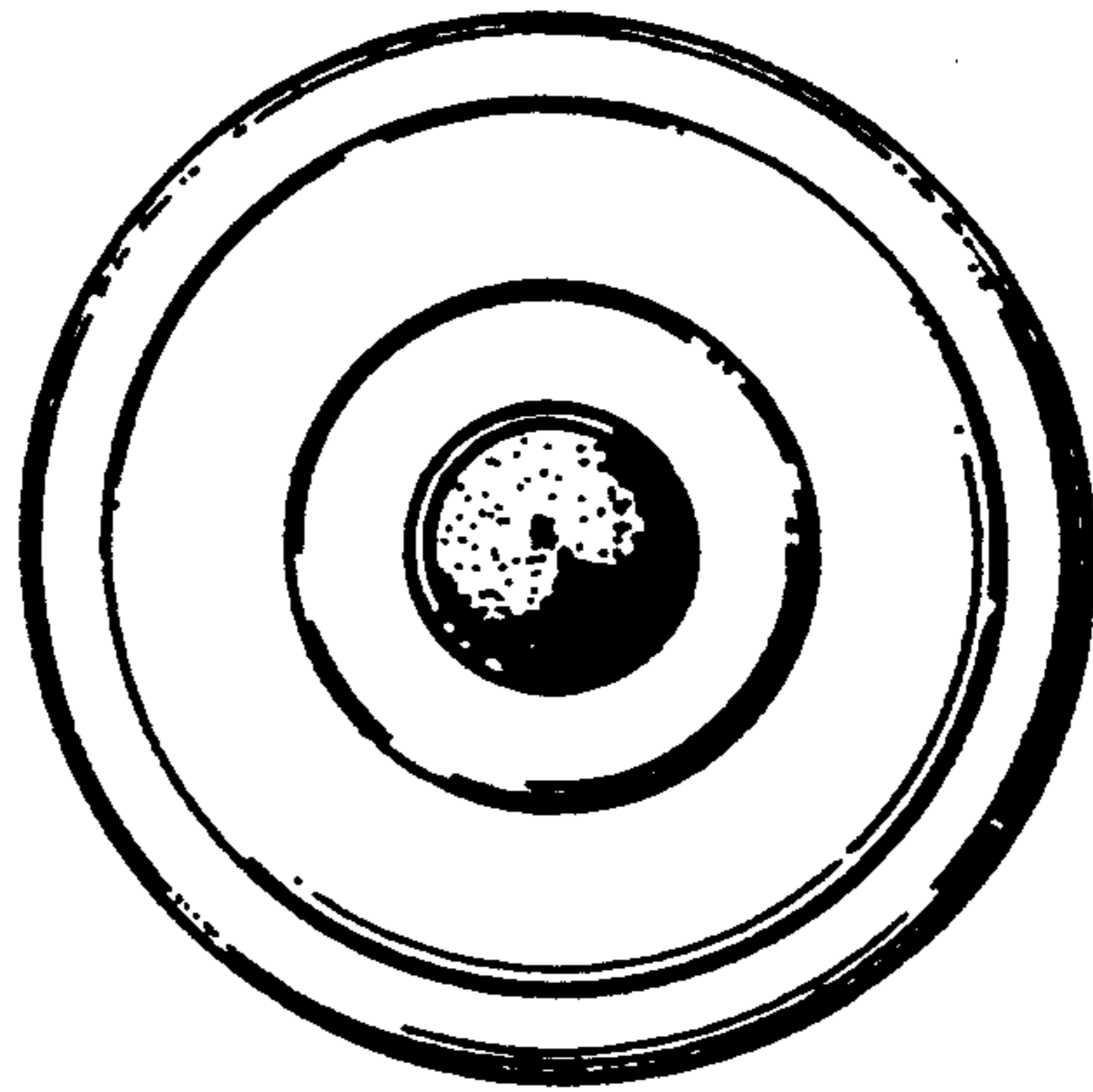

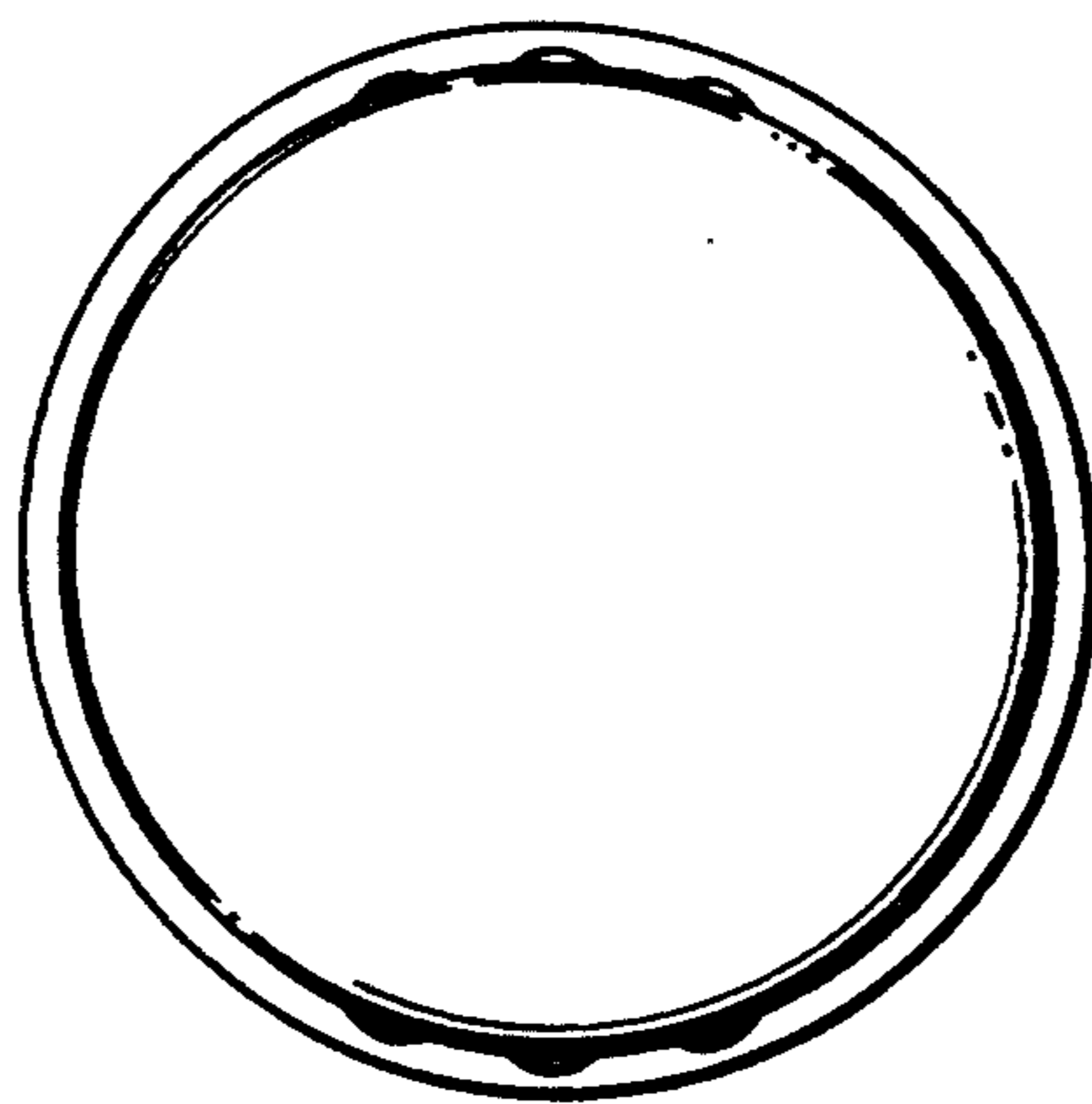
