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[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a perfume bottle, as shown and described.

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.



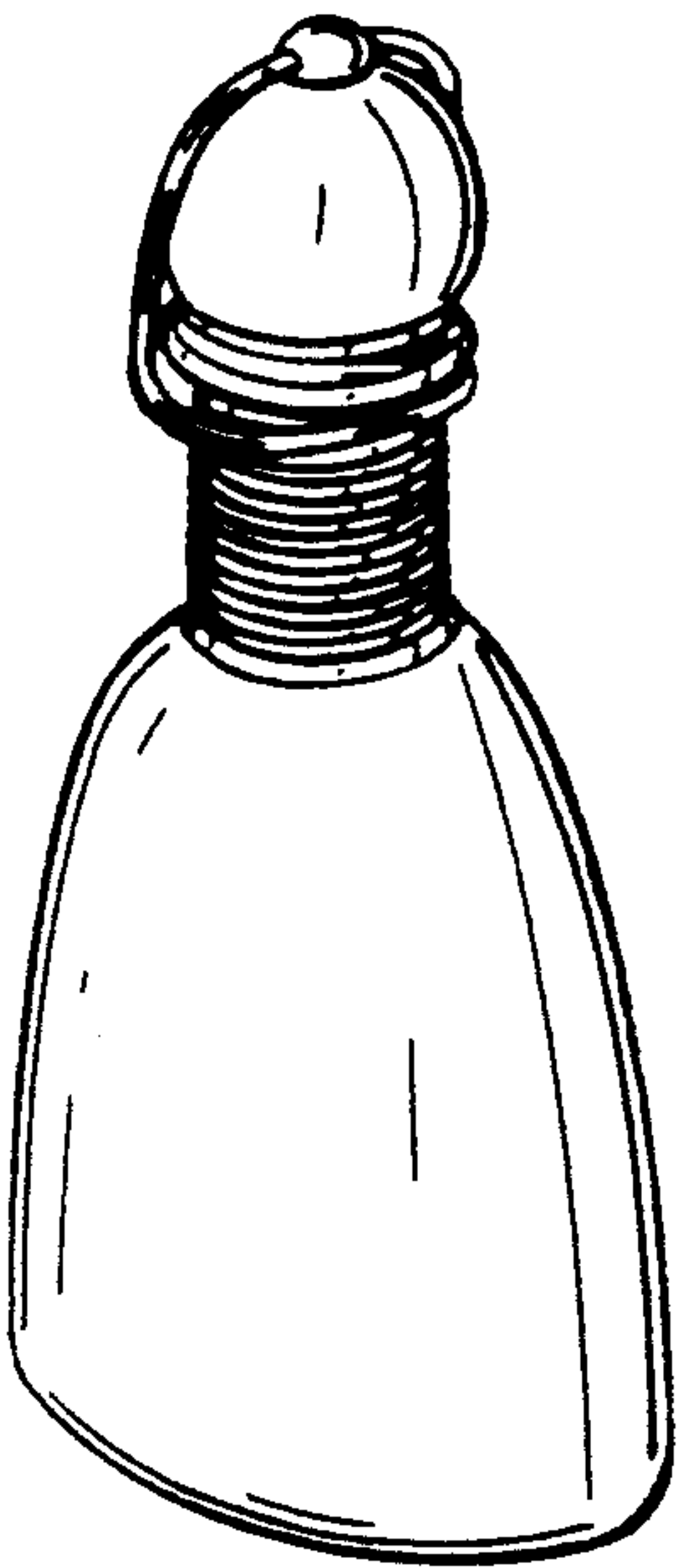

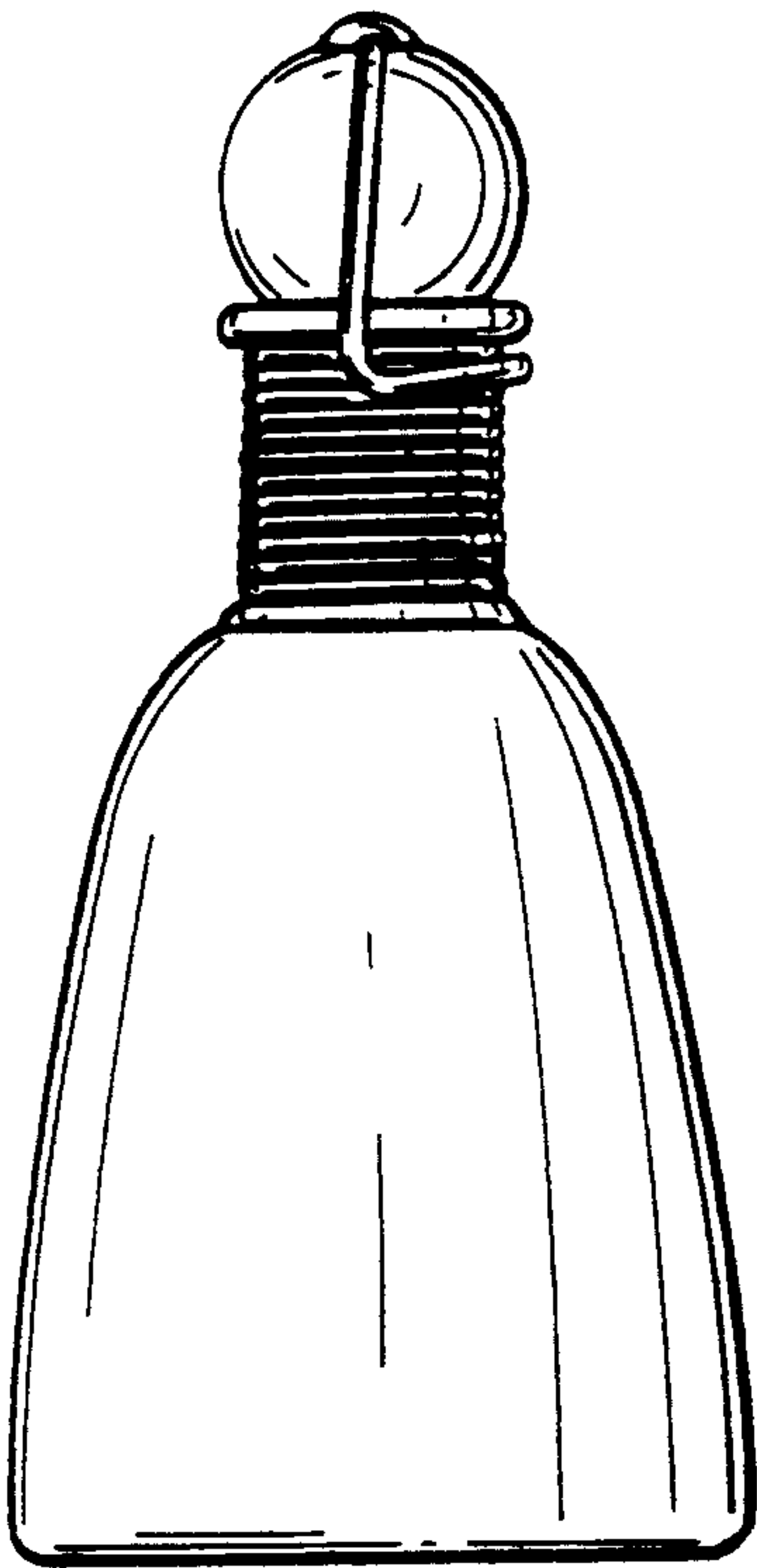

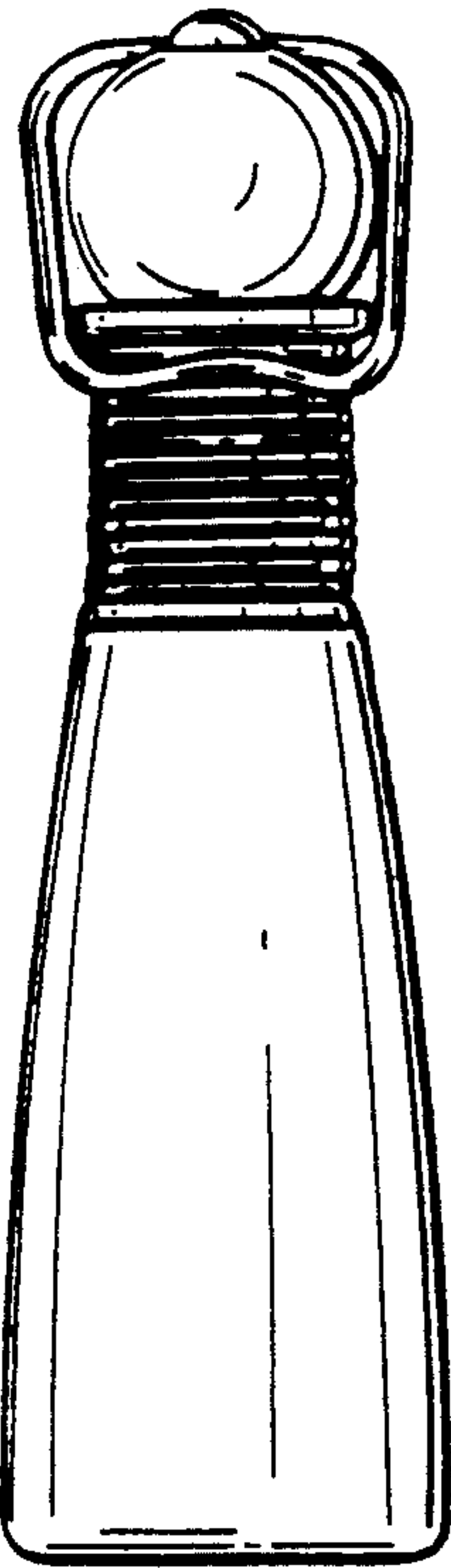

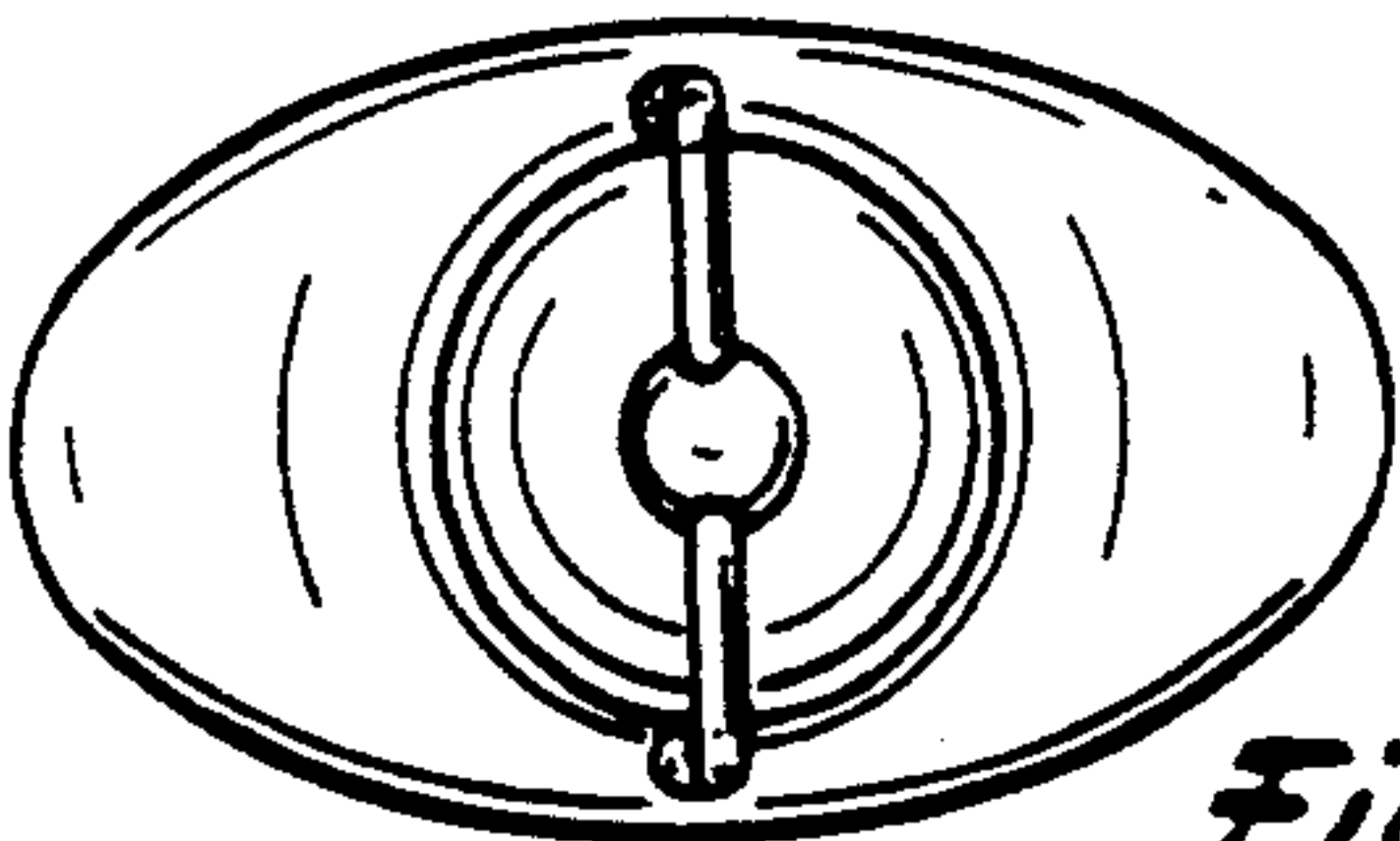

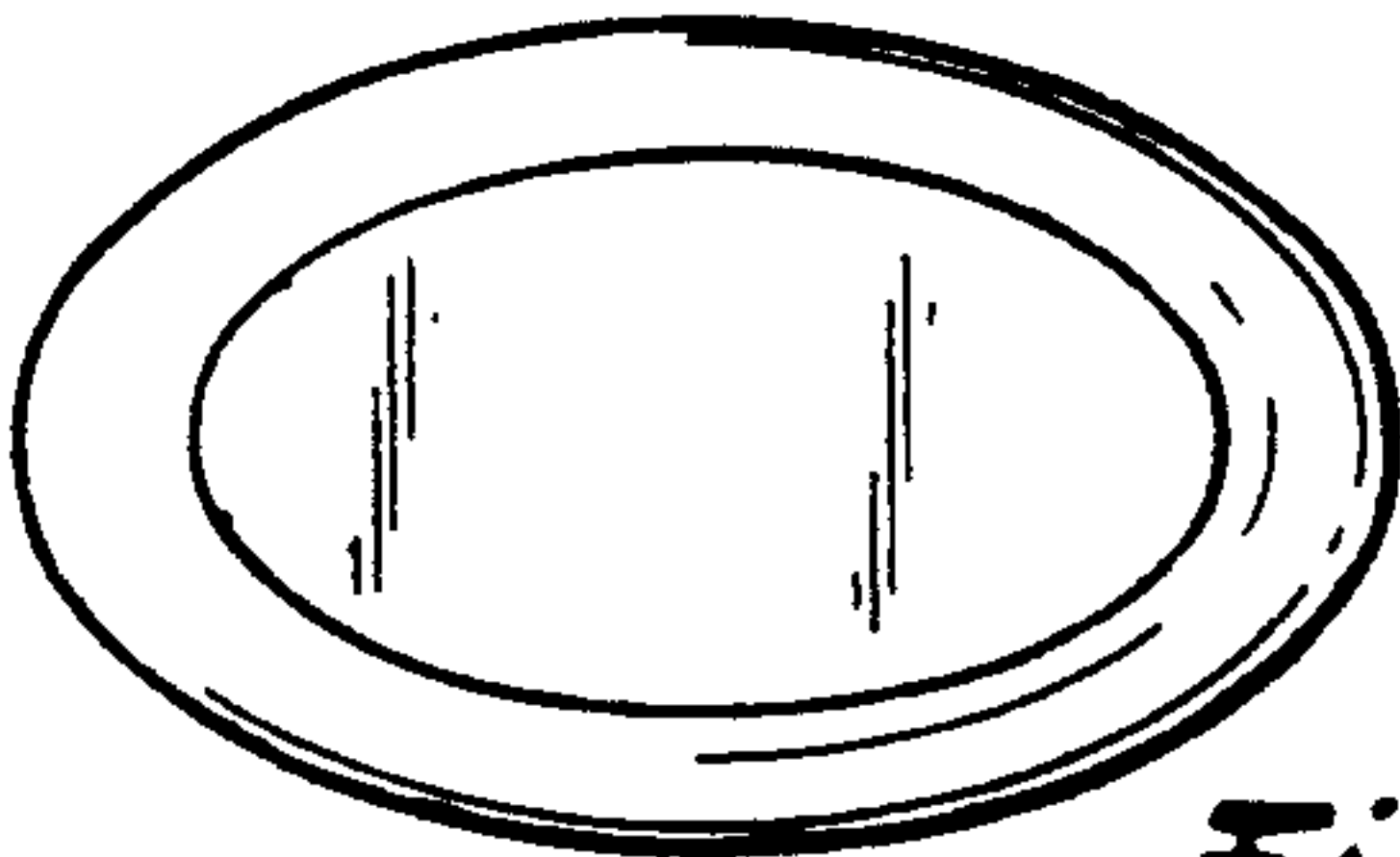
