FIG. 6 is a view from the right side of FIG. 5 thereof.

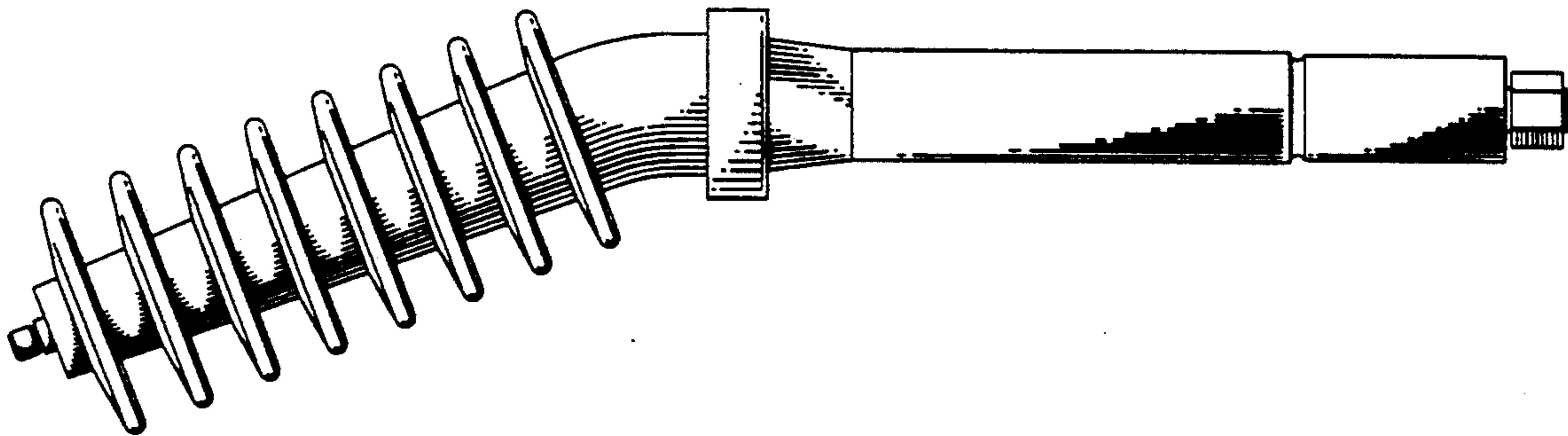

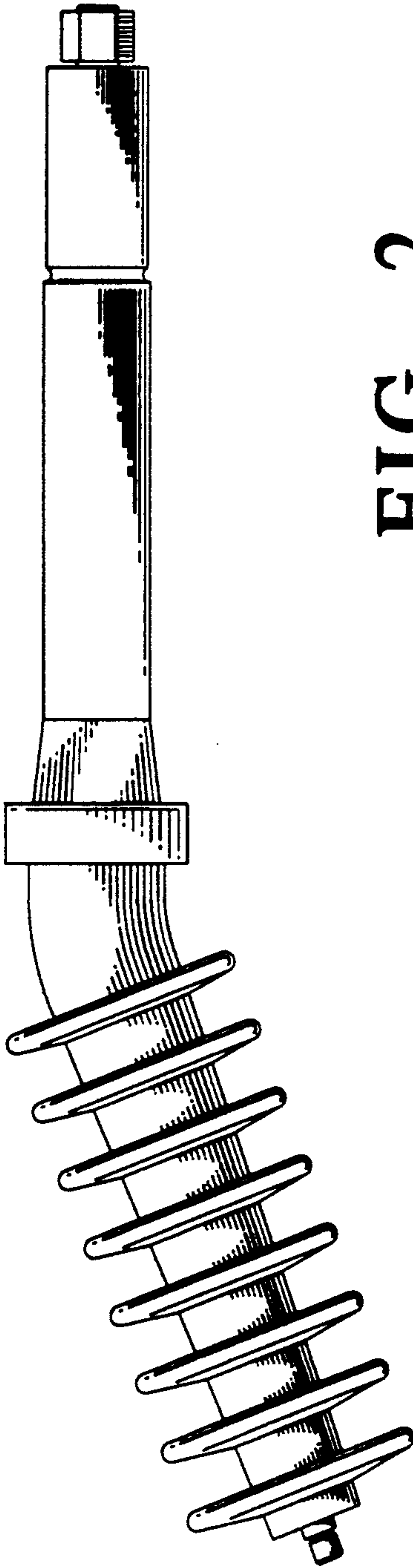

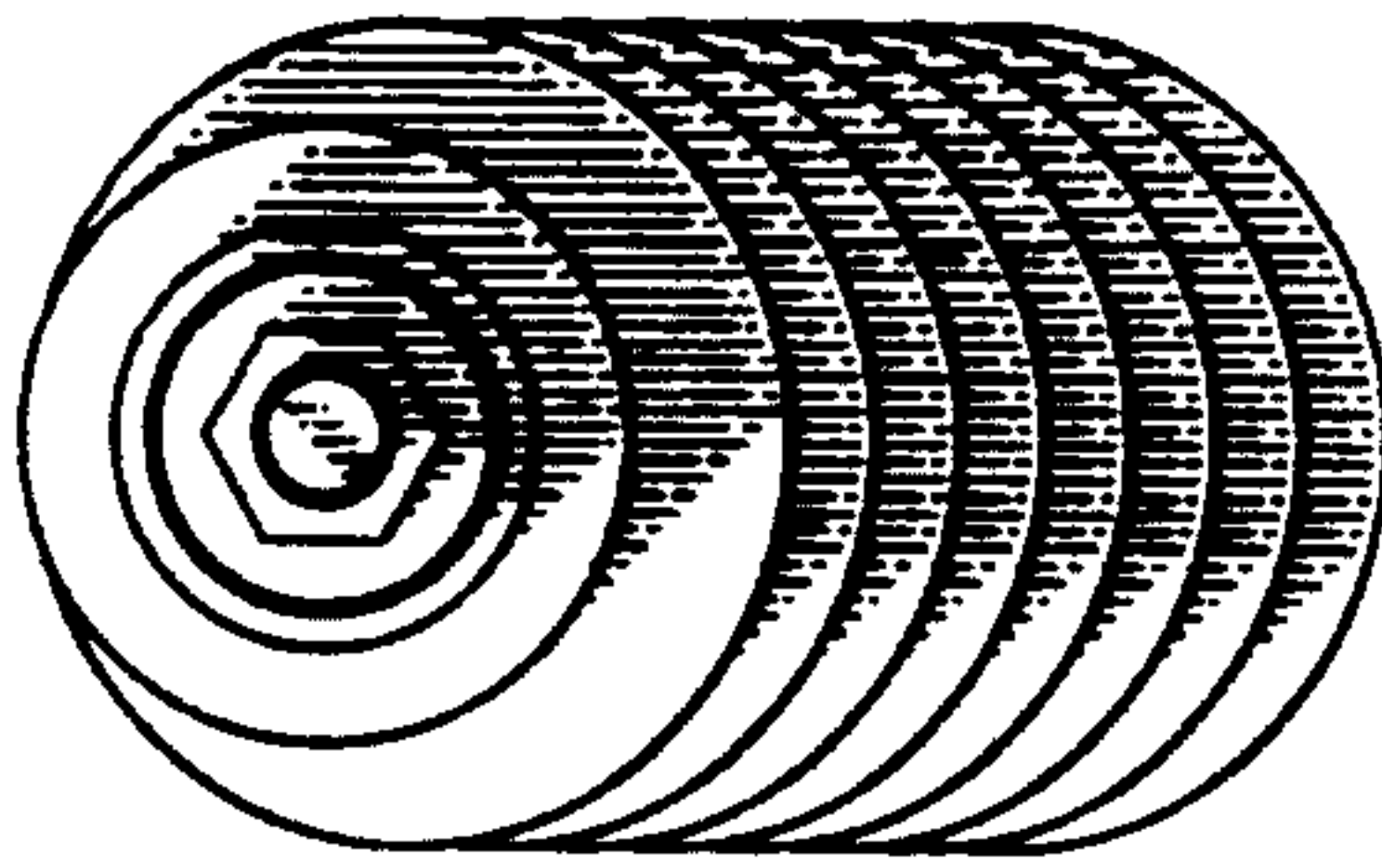
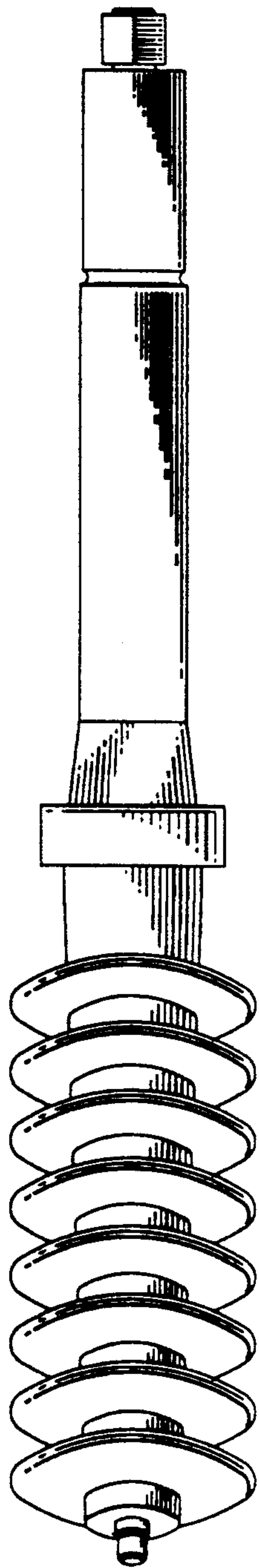

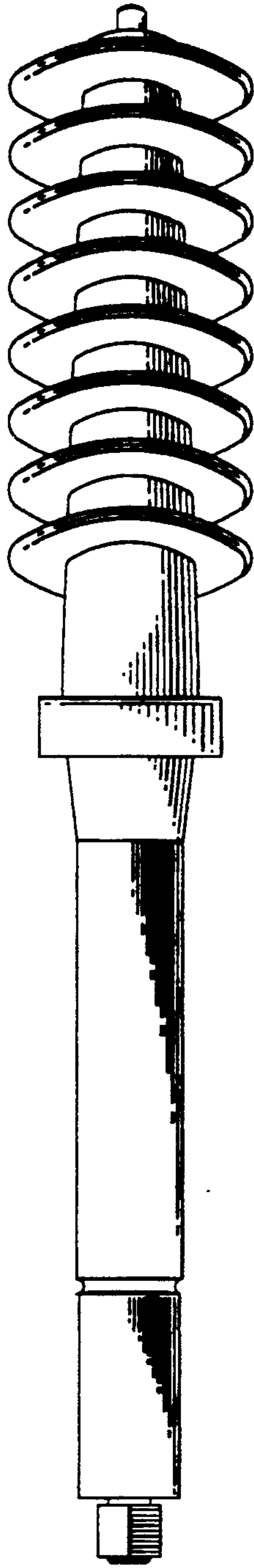

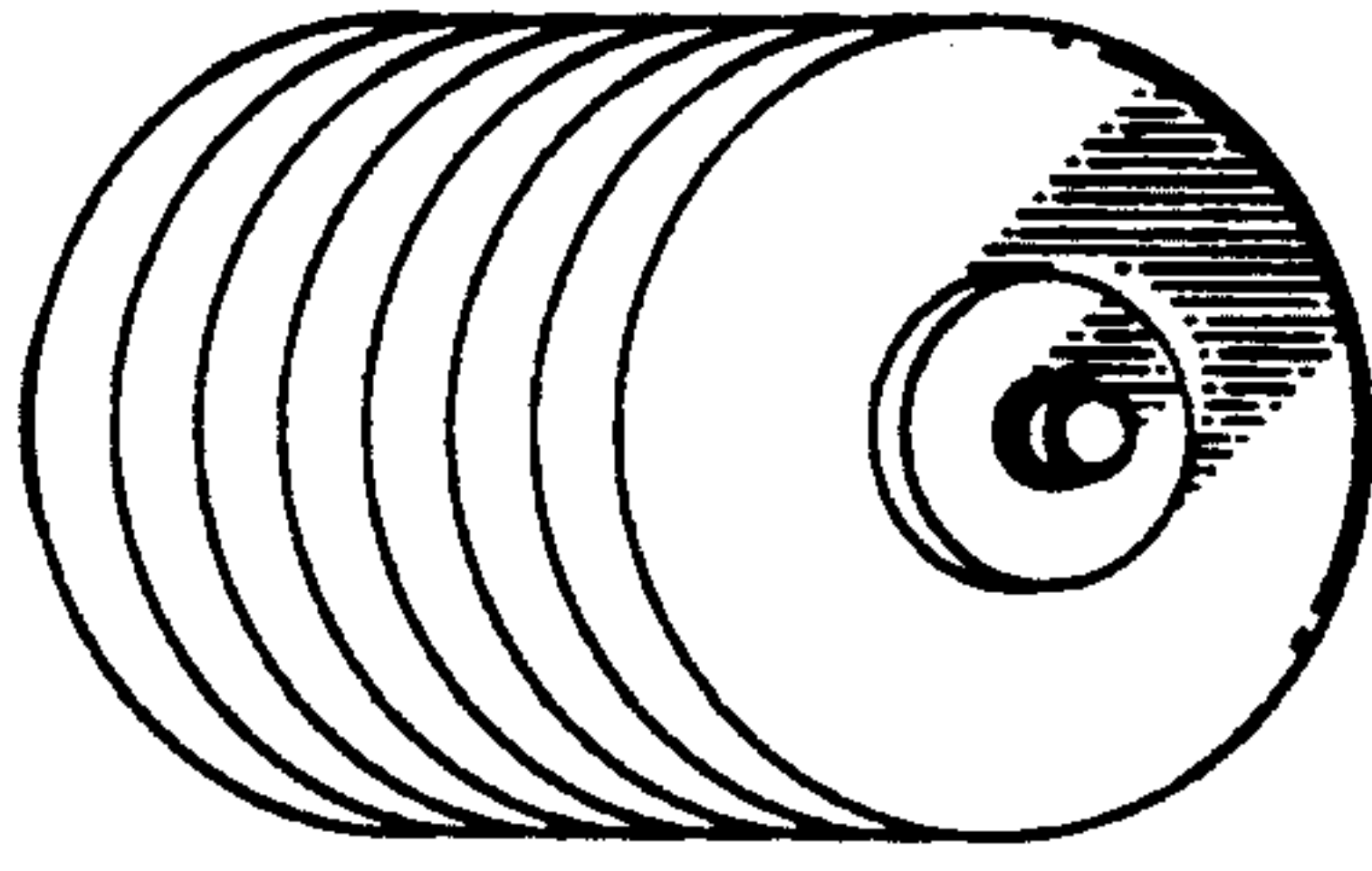
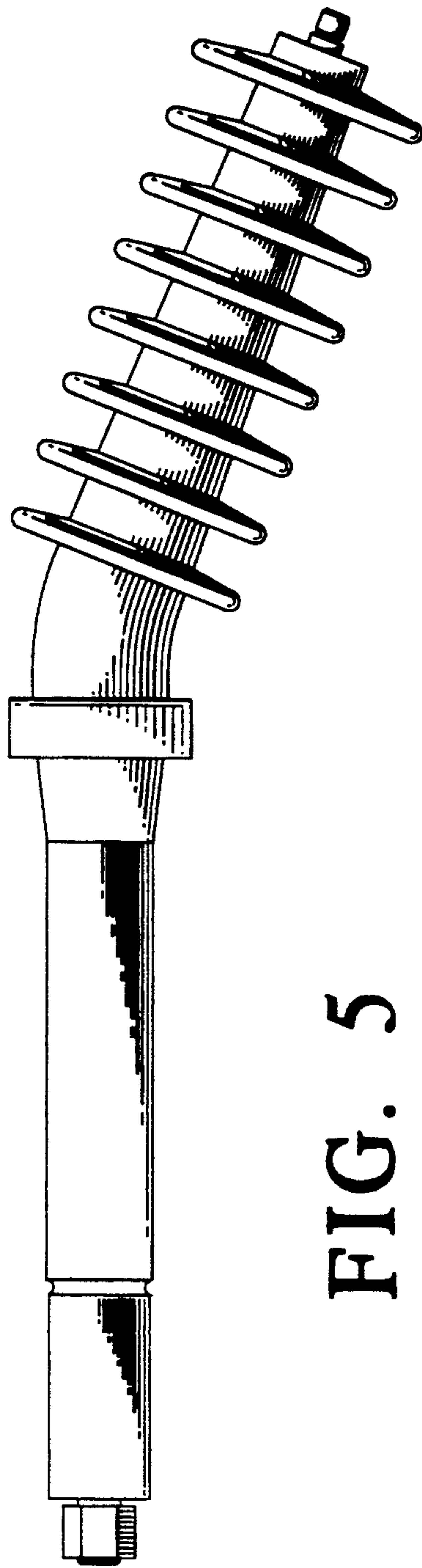
