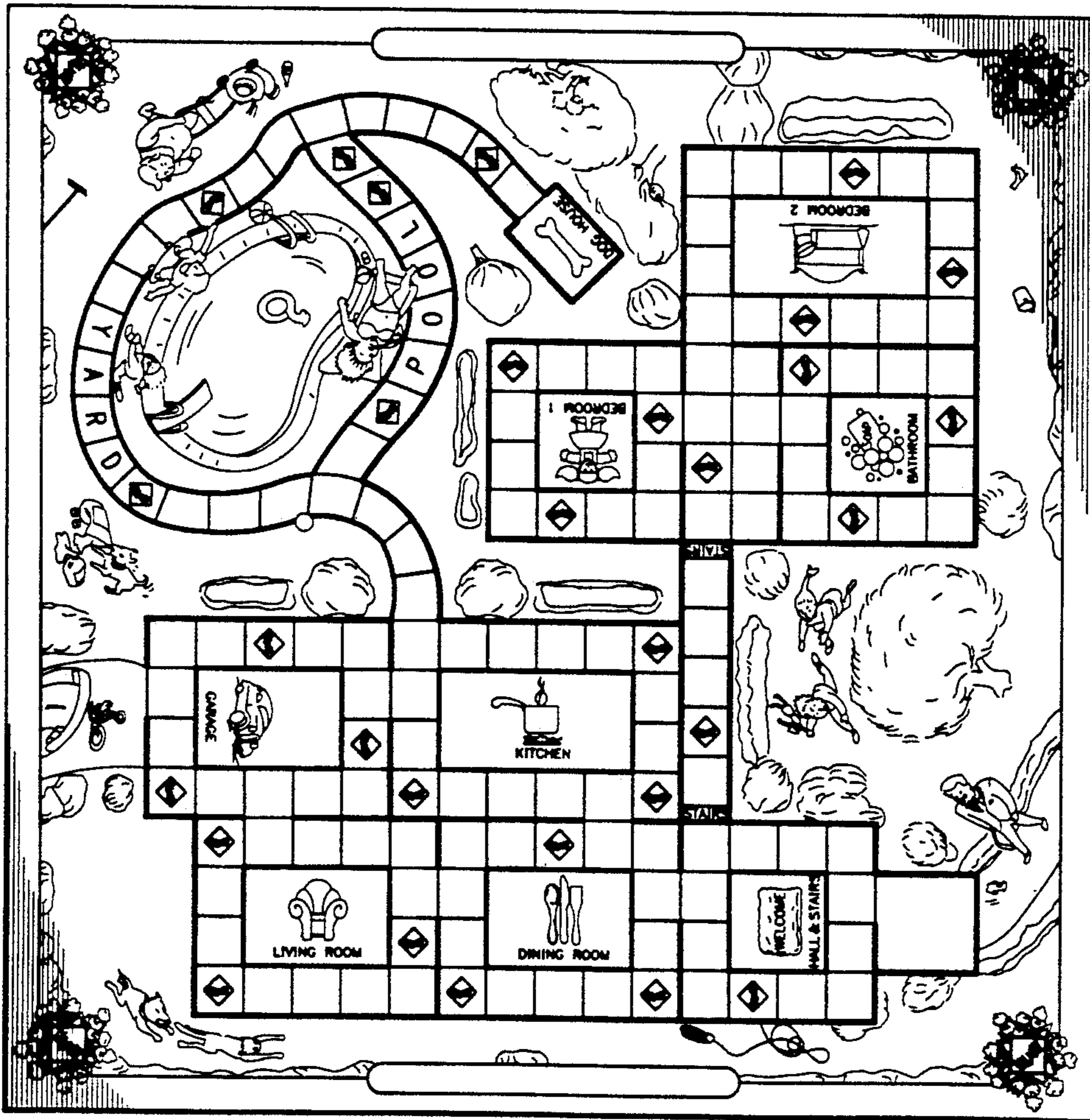

FIG. 2 is a side view of the game board, the four sides and the bottom are plain and unadorned.



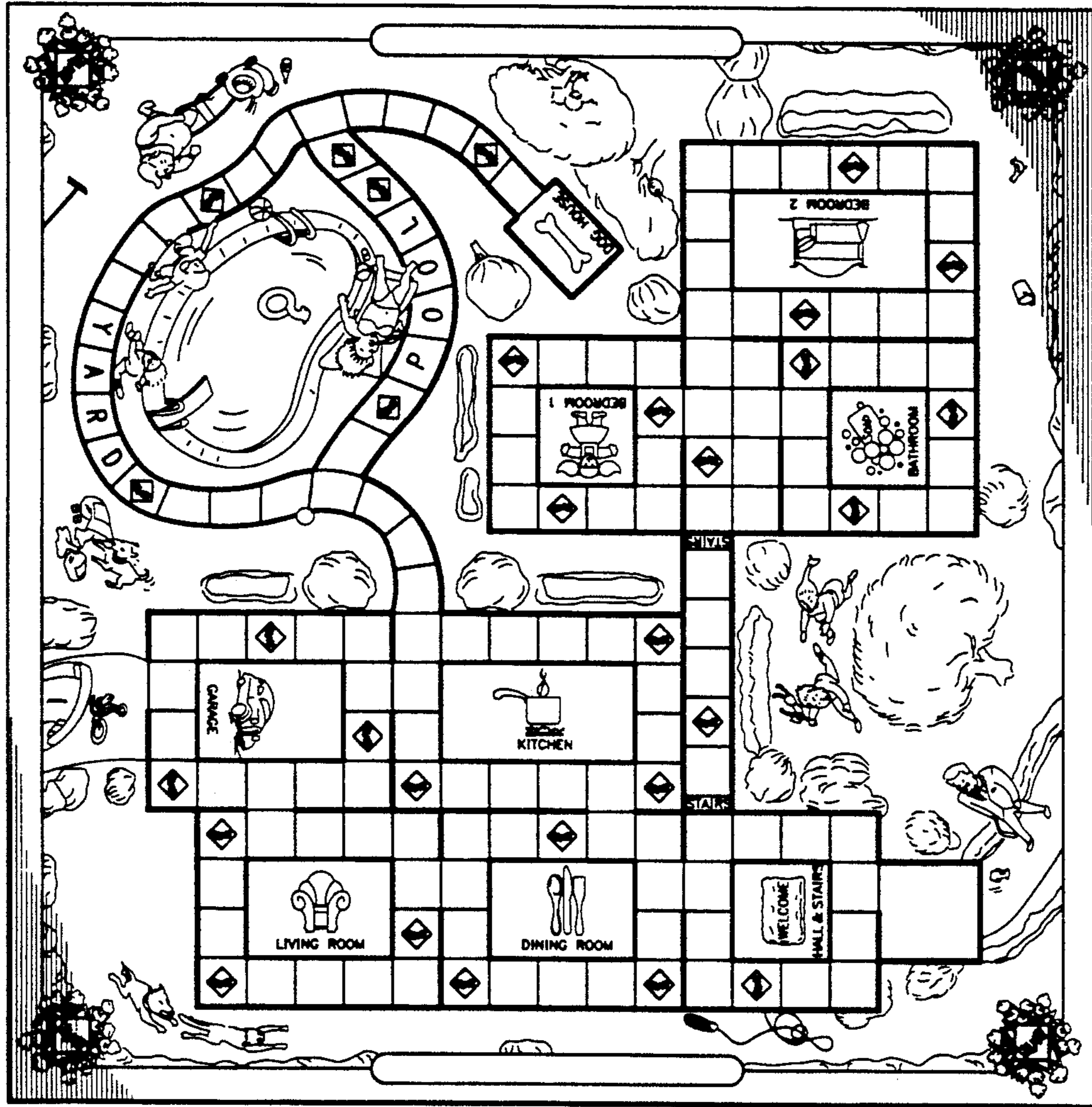
