DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a ball and cup game showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of FIG. 1, the difference residing in the ball's being tethered to the cup;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the cup piece, shown separately for ease of illustration;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of FIG. 3;

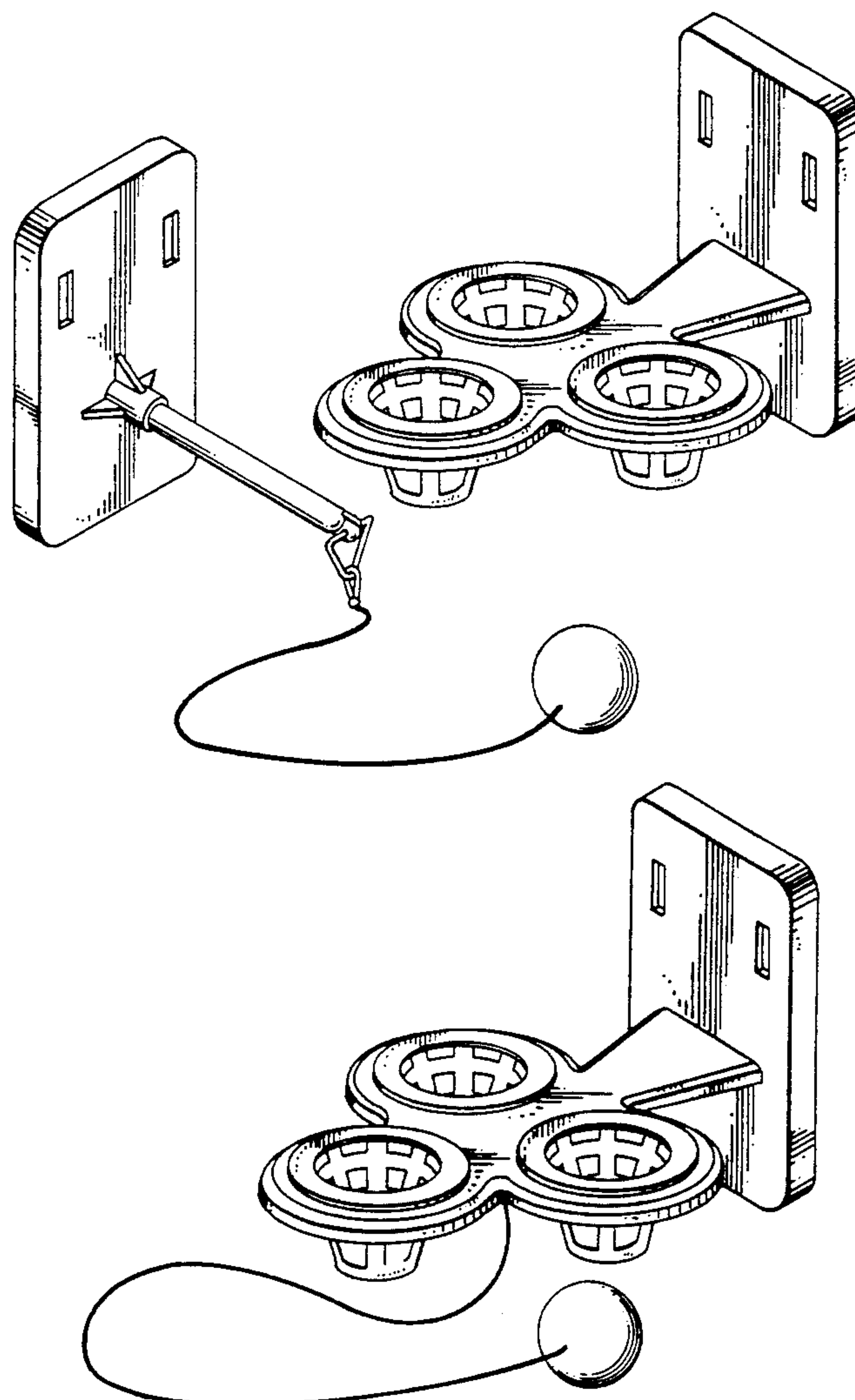
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of FIG. 3;

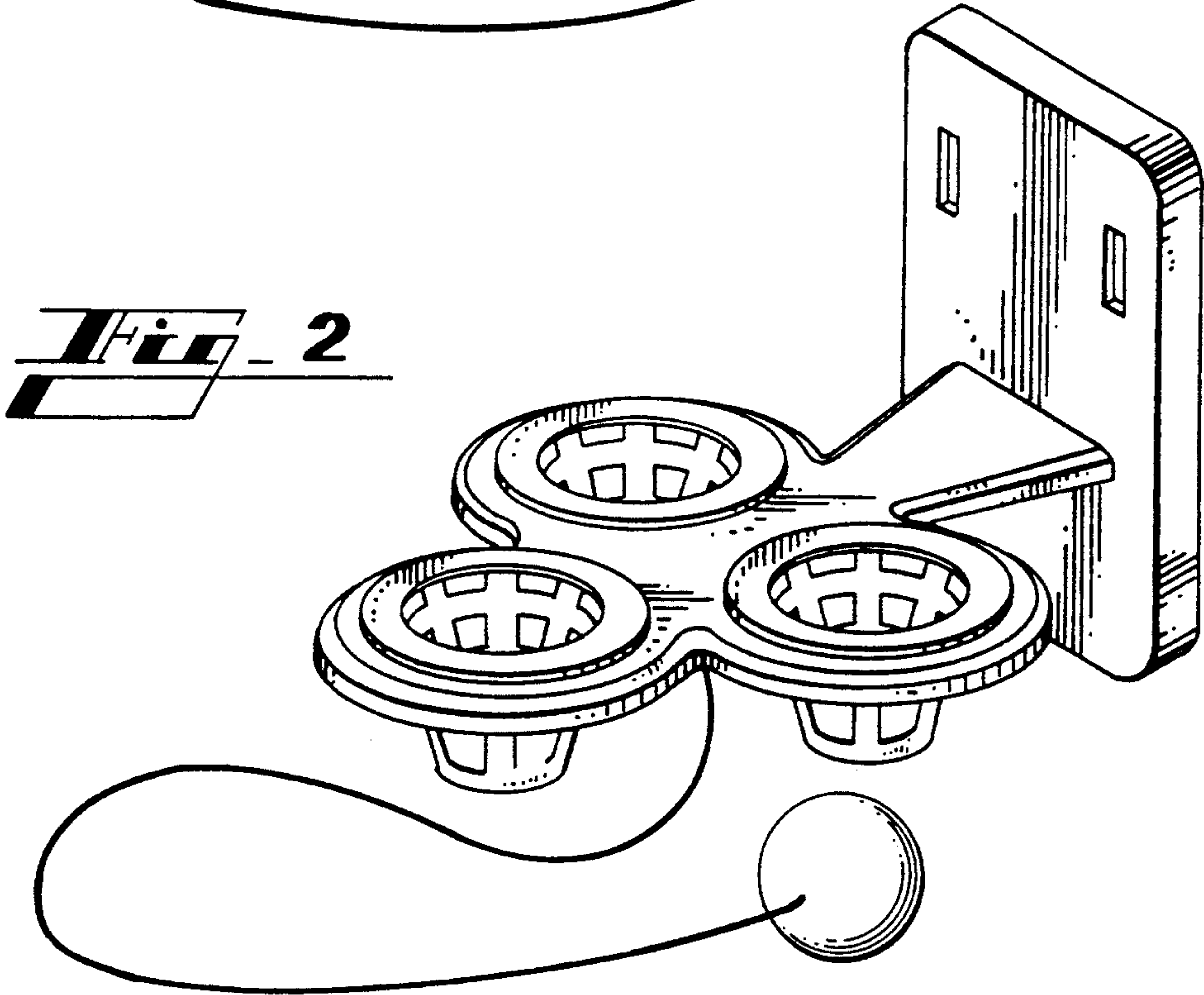
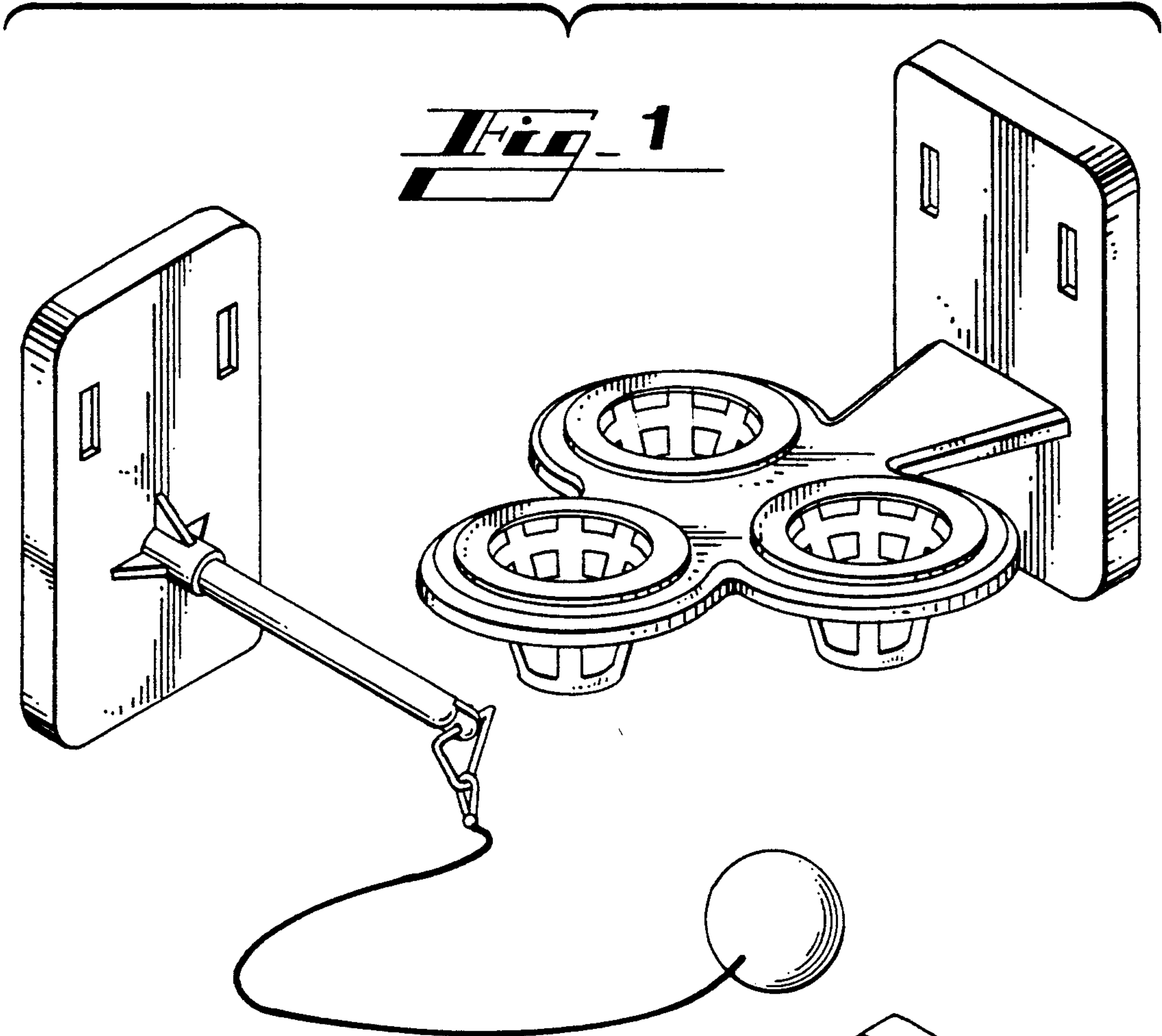
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 3;

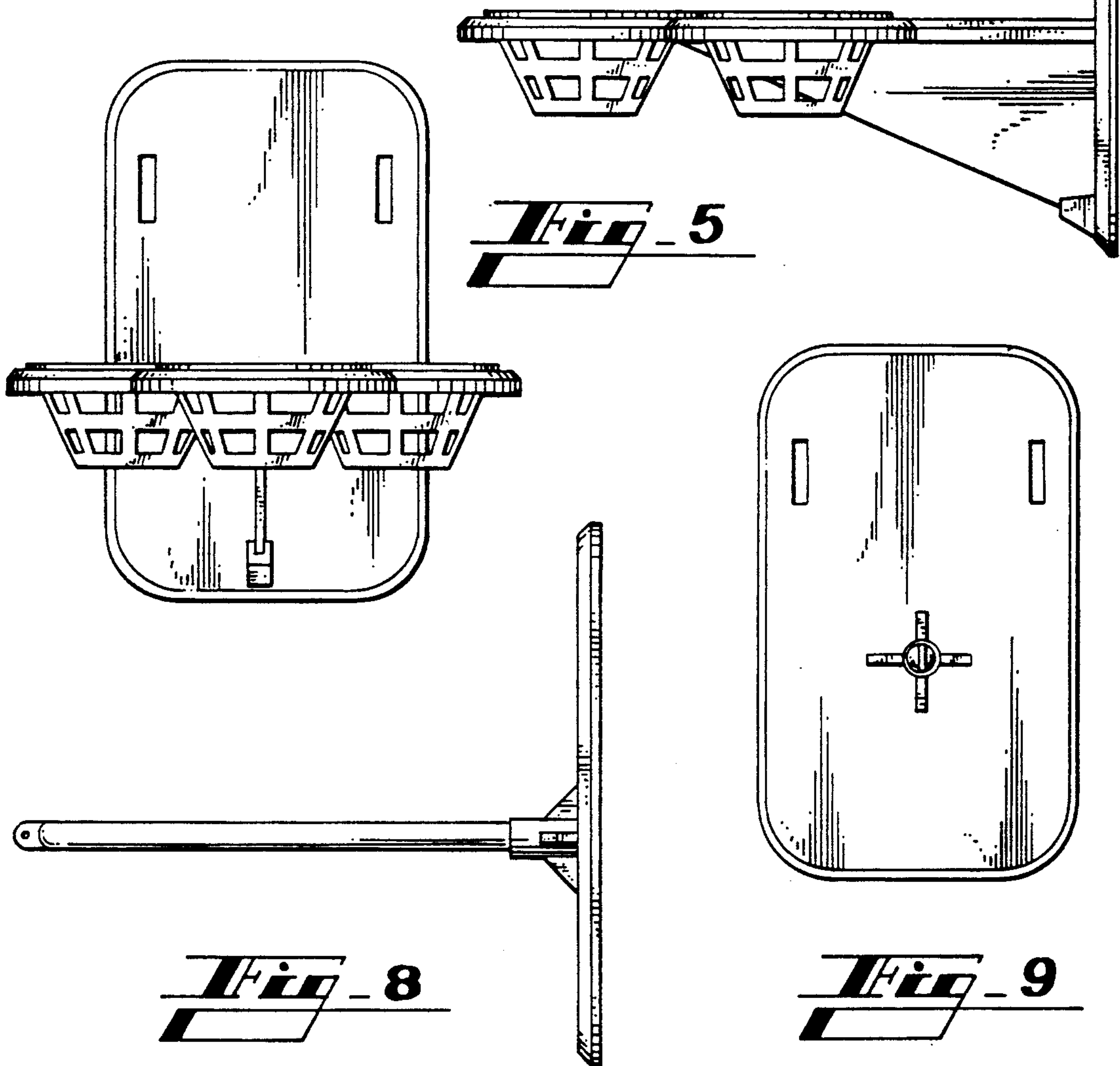
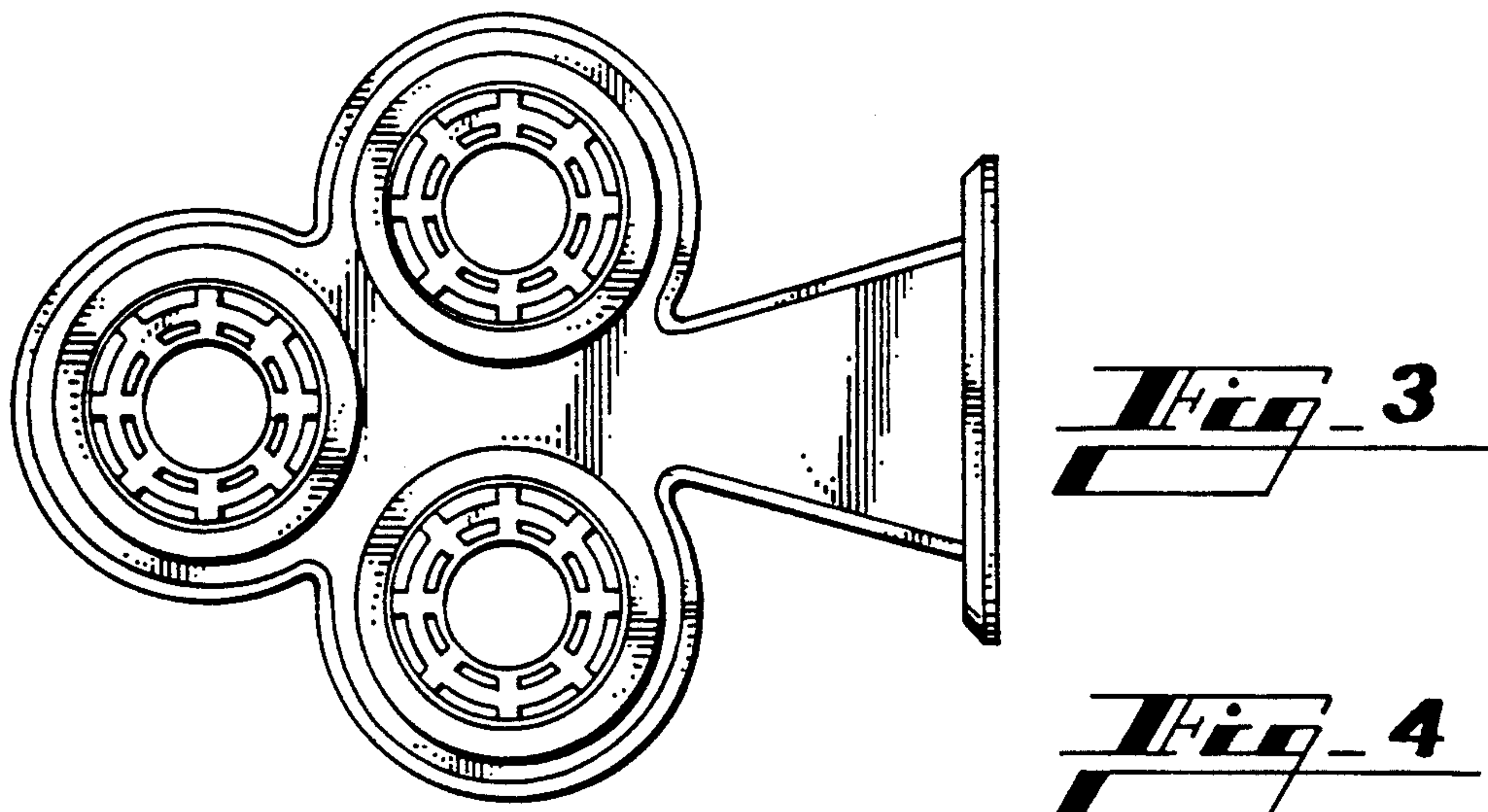
FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the ball carrying piece, shown separately for ease of illustration;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of FIG. 7.







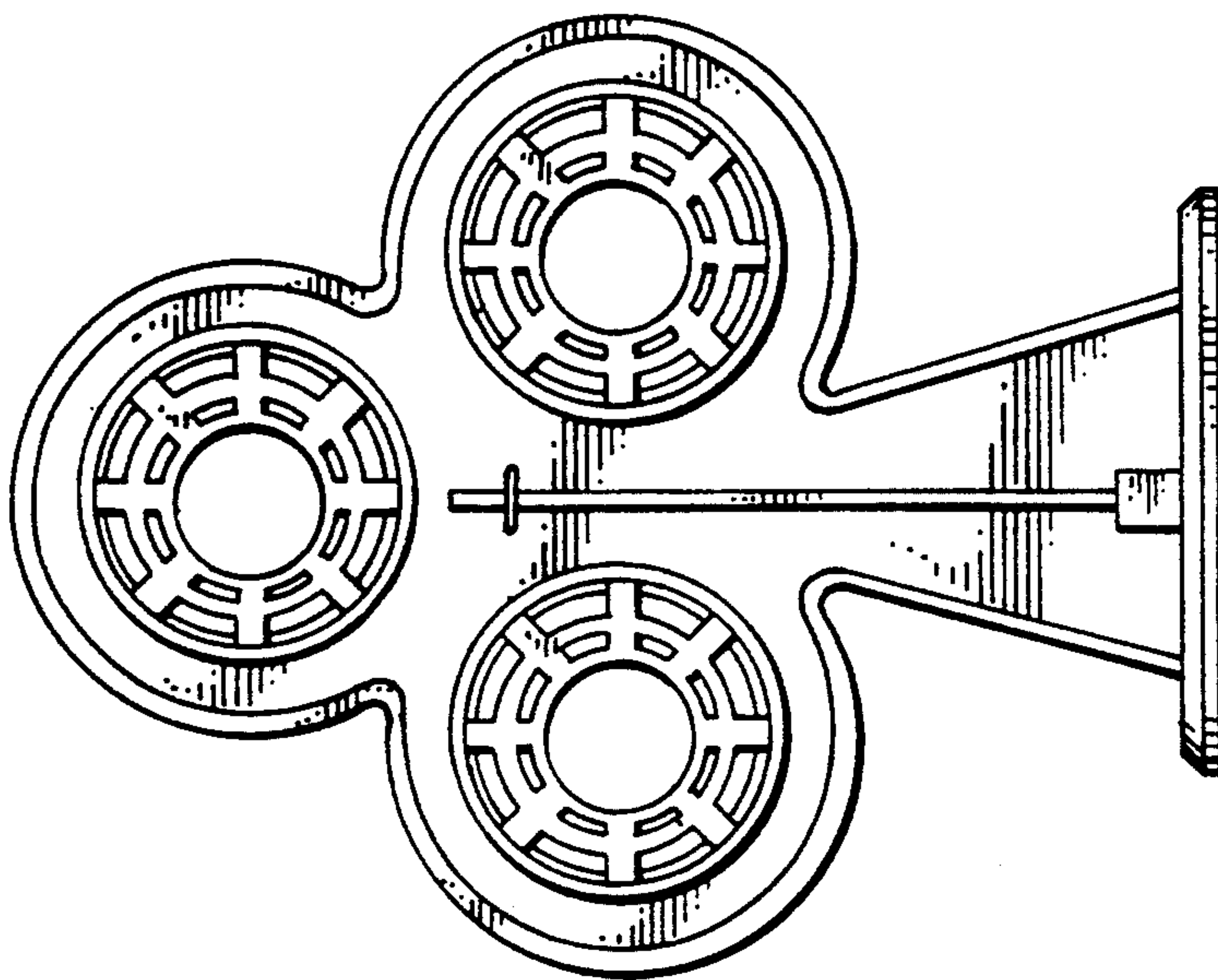
