DESCRIPTION

FIG. 6 is an end elevational view thereof, the end opposite being a mirror image of the end shown in FIG. 6.

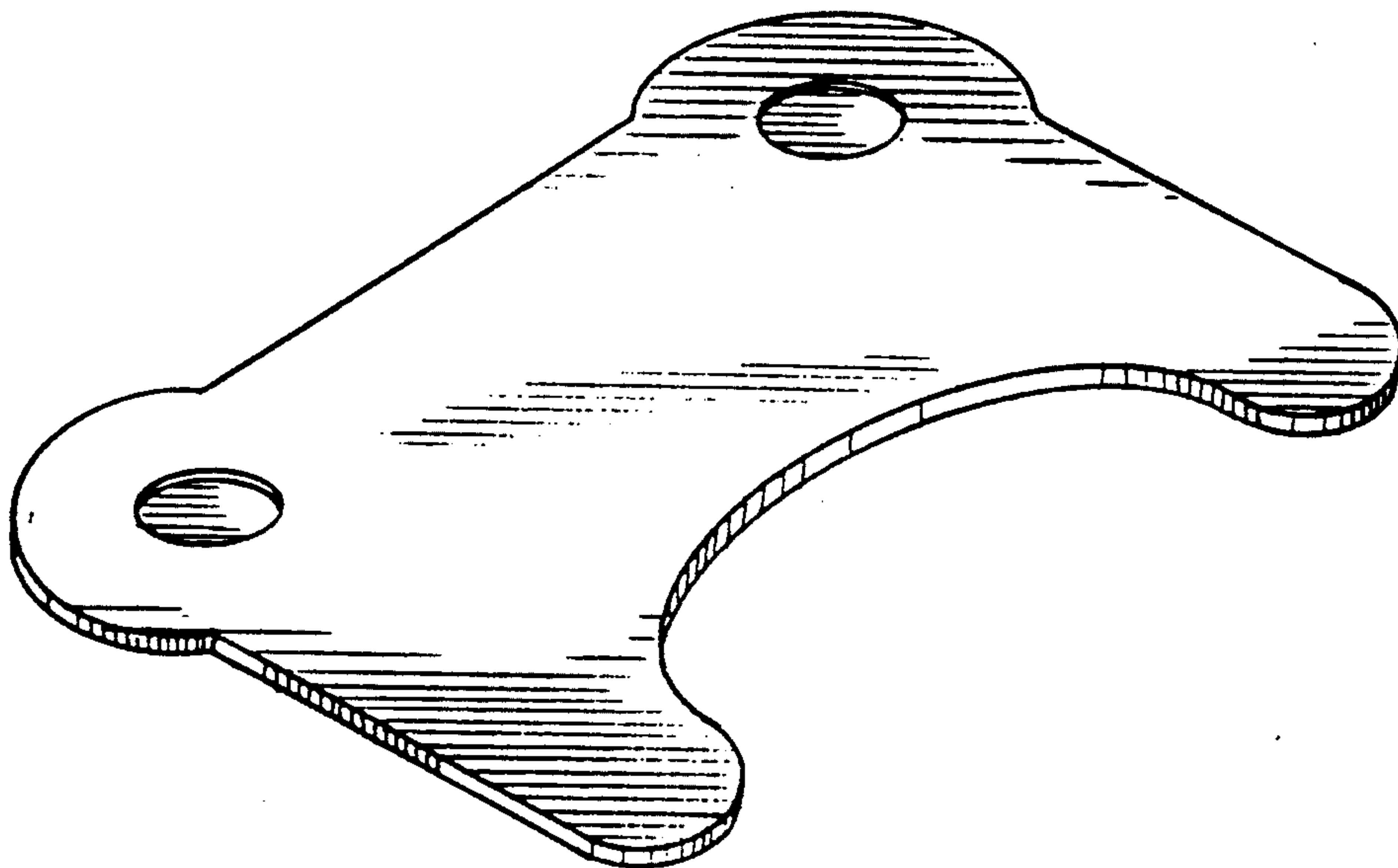

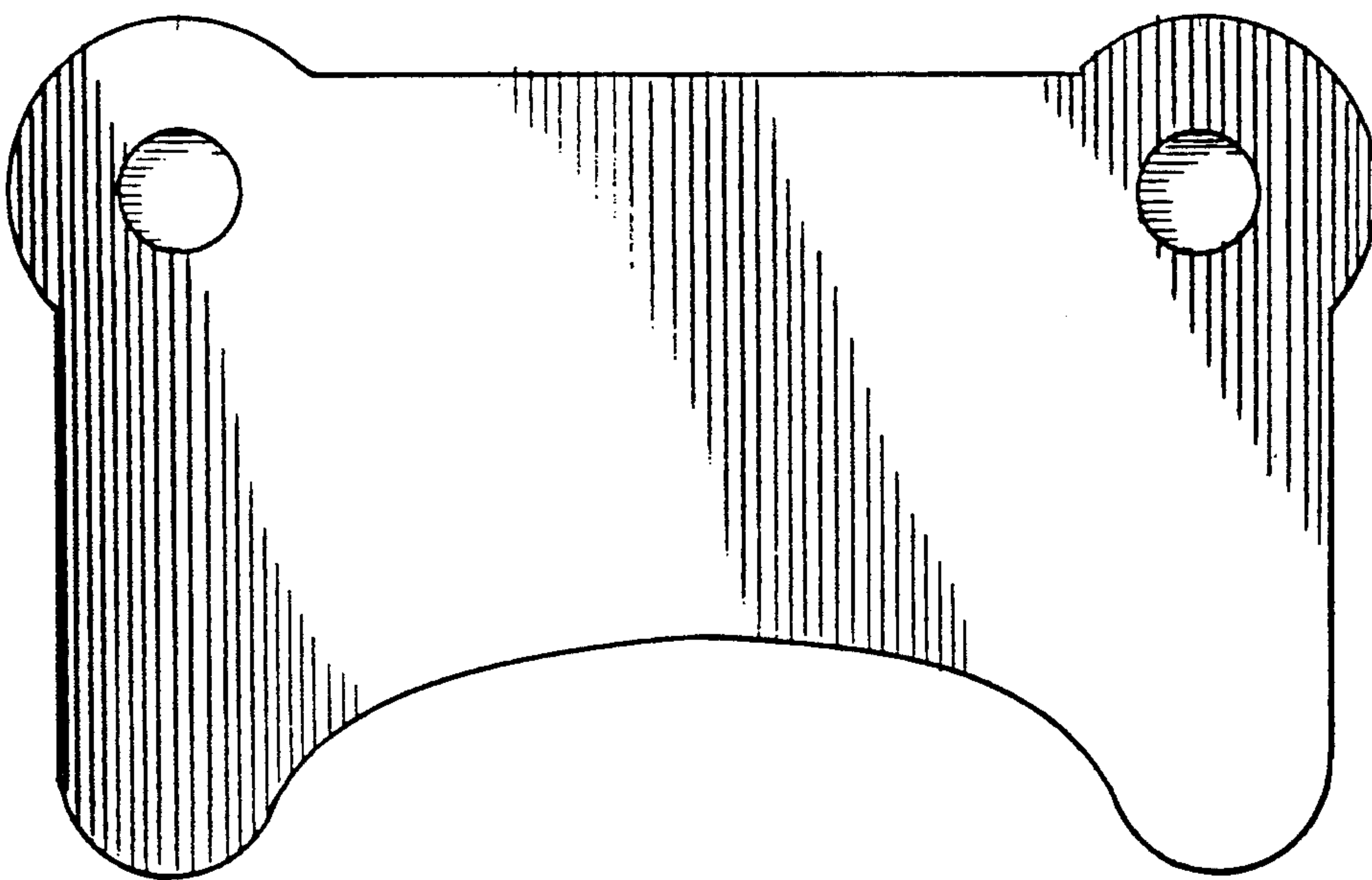
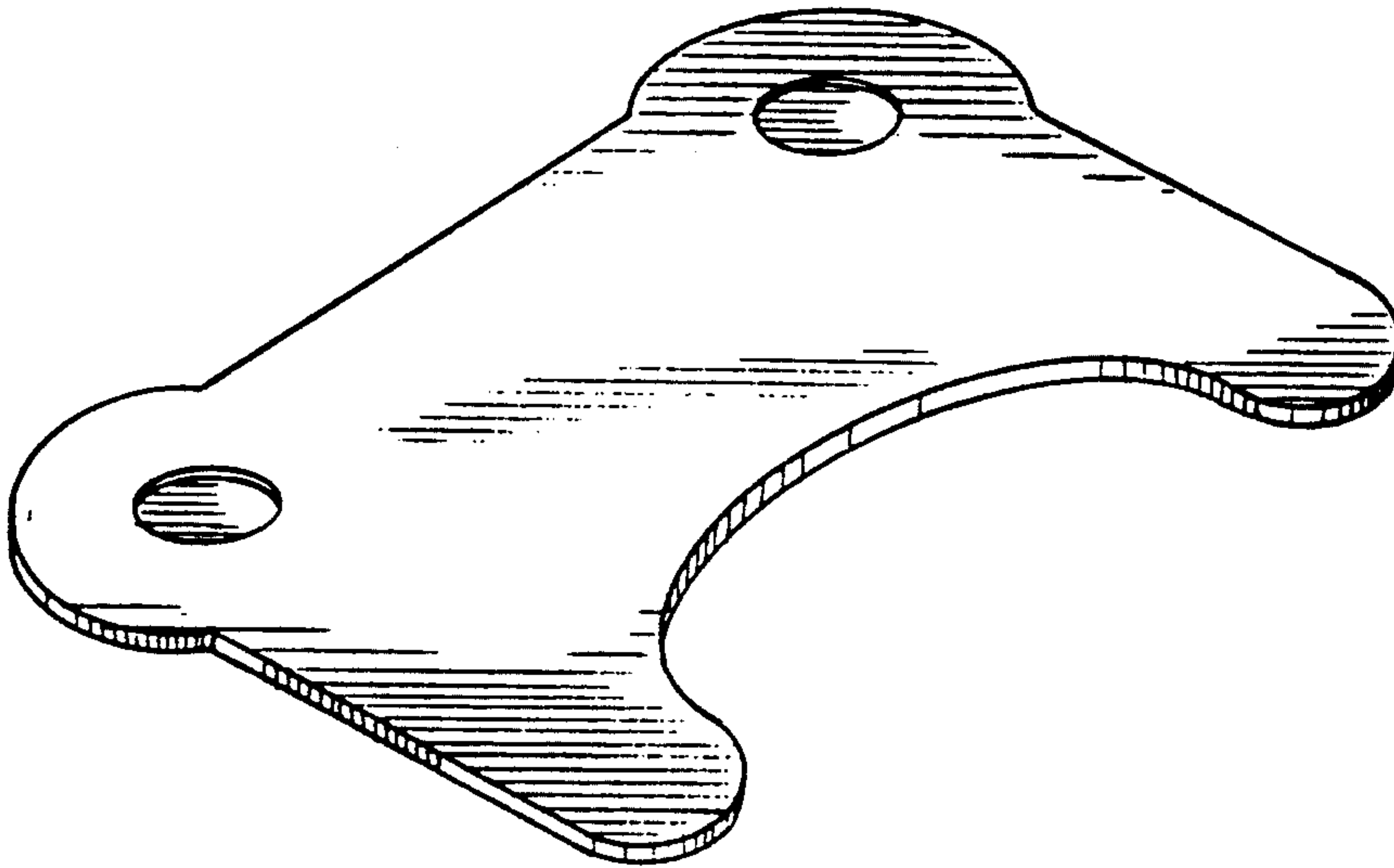

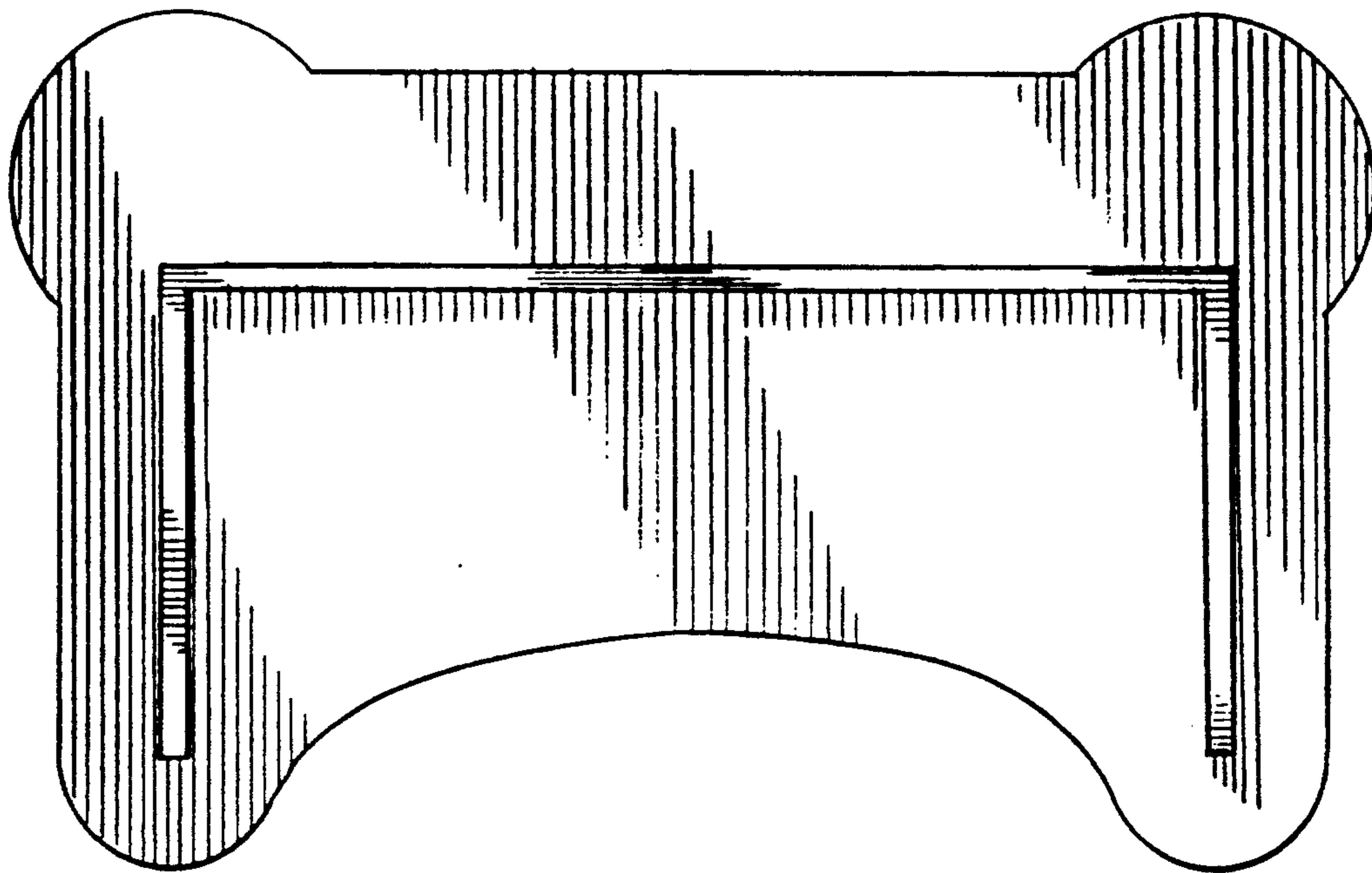
