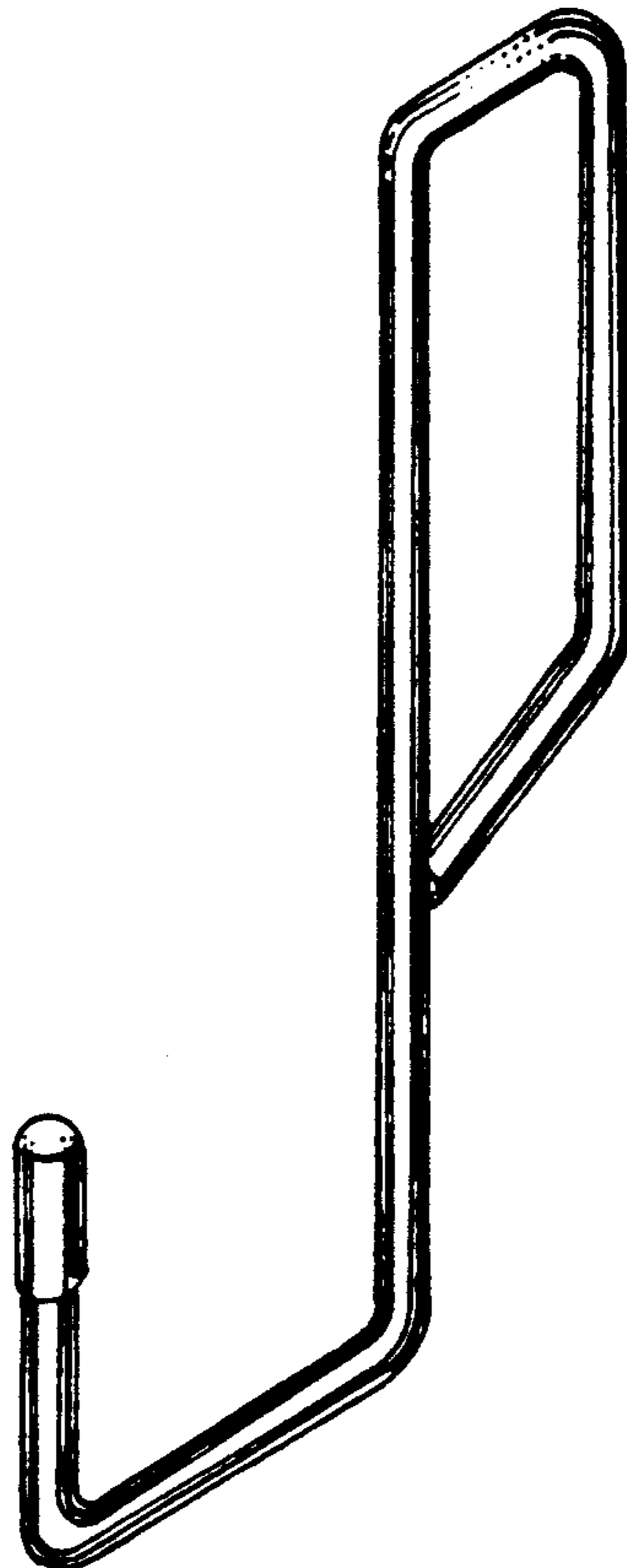

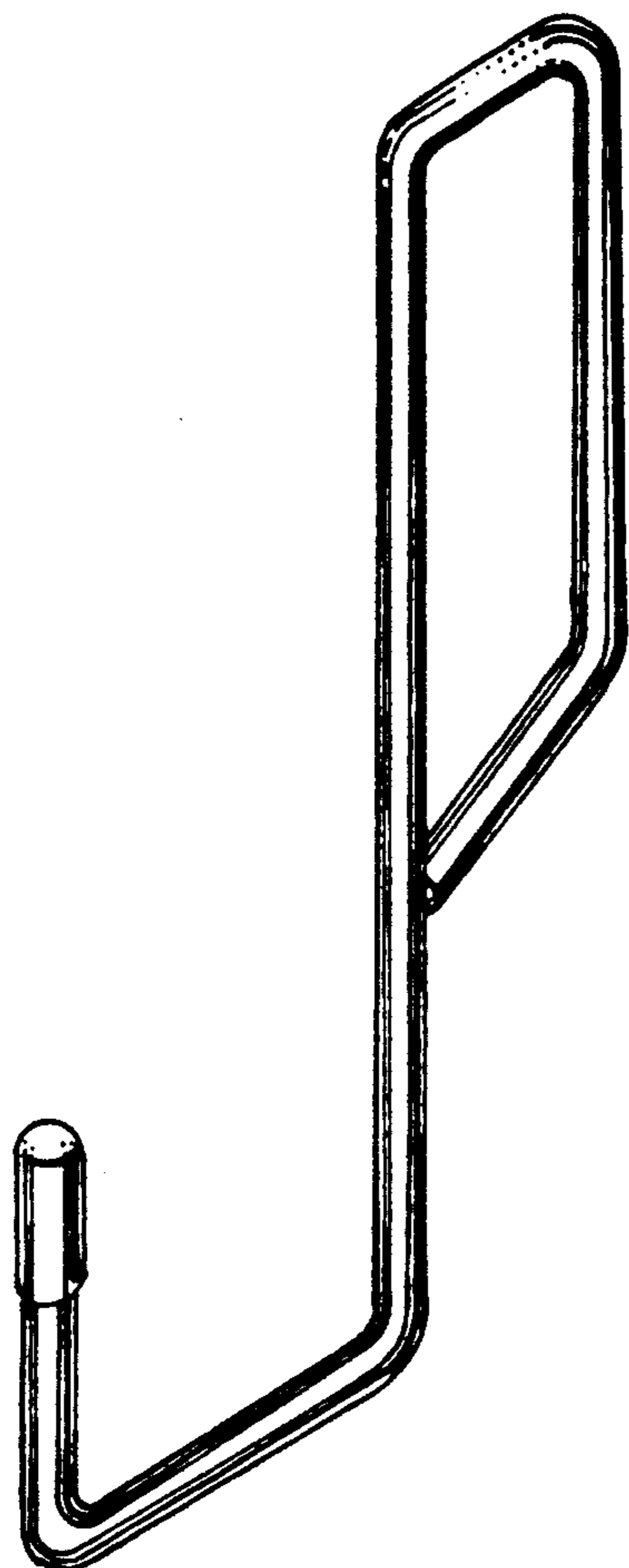
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a garment bag hook, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a garment bag hook according to my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view;

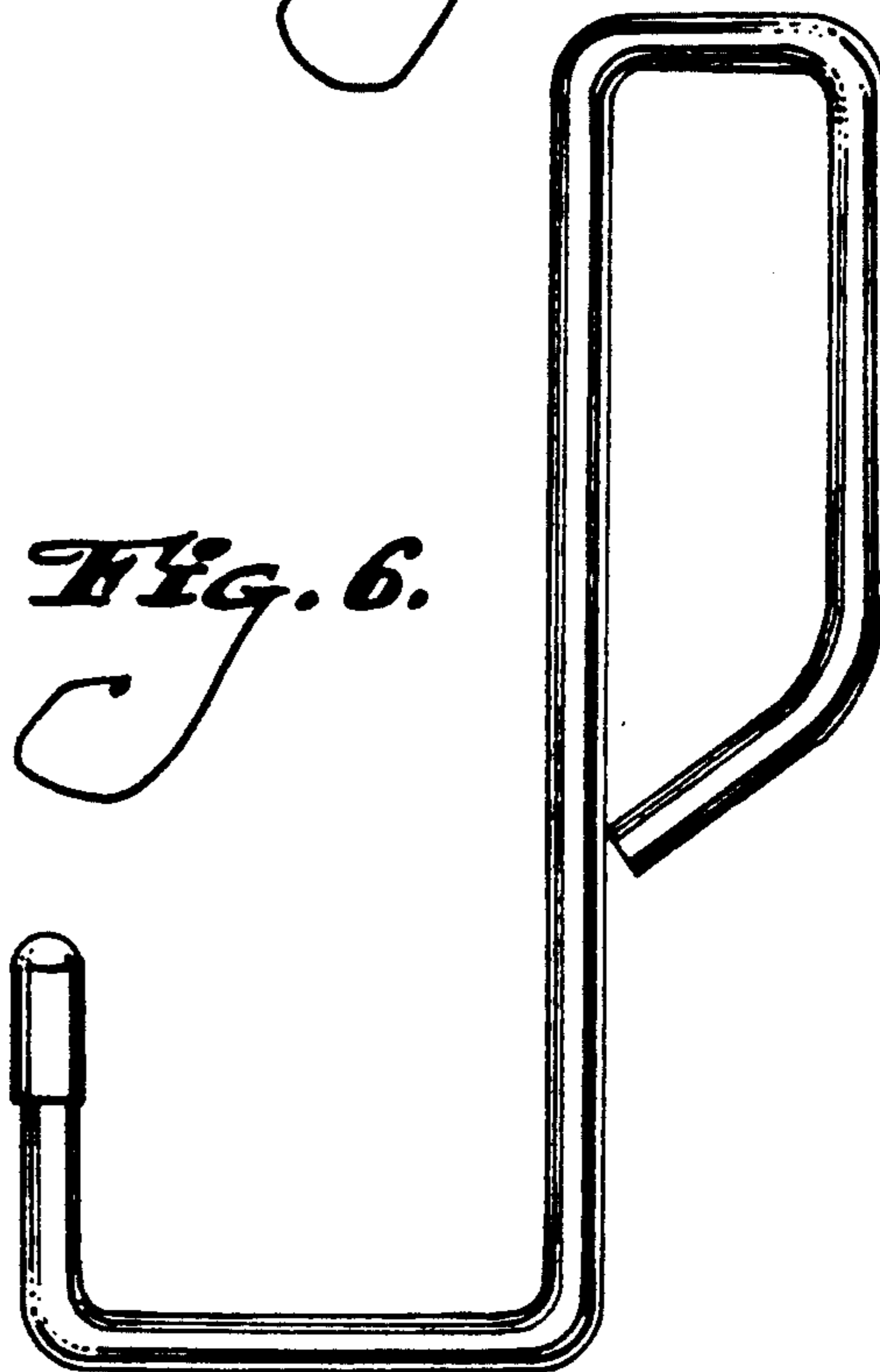
*Fig. 4. Fig. 5.*

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view;  
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view; and,
