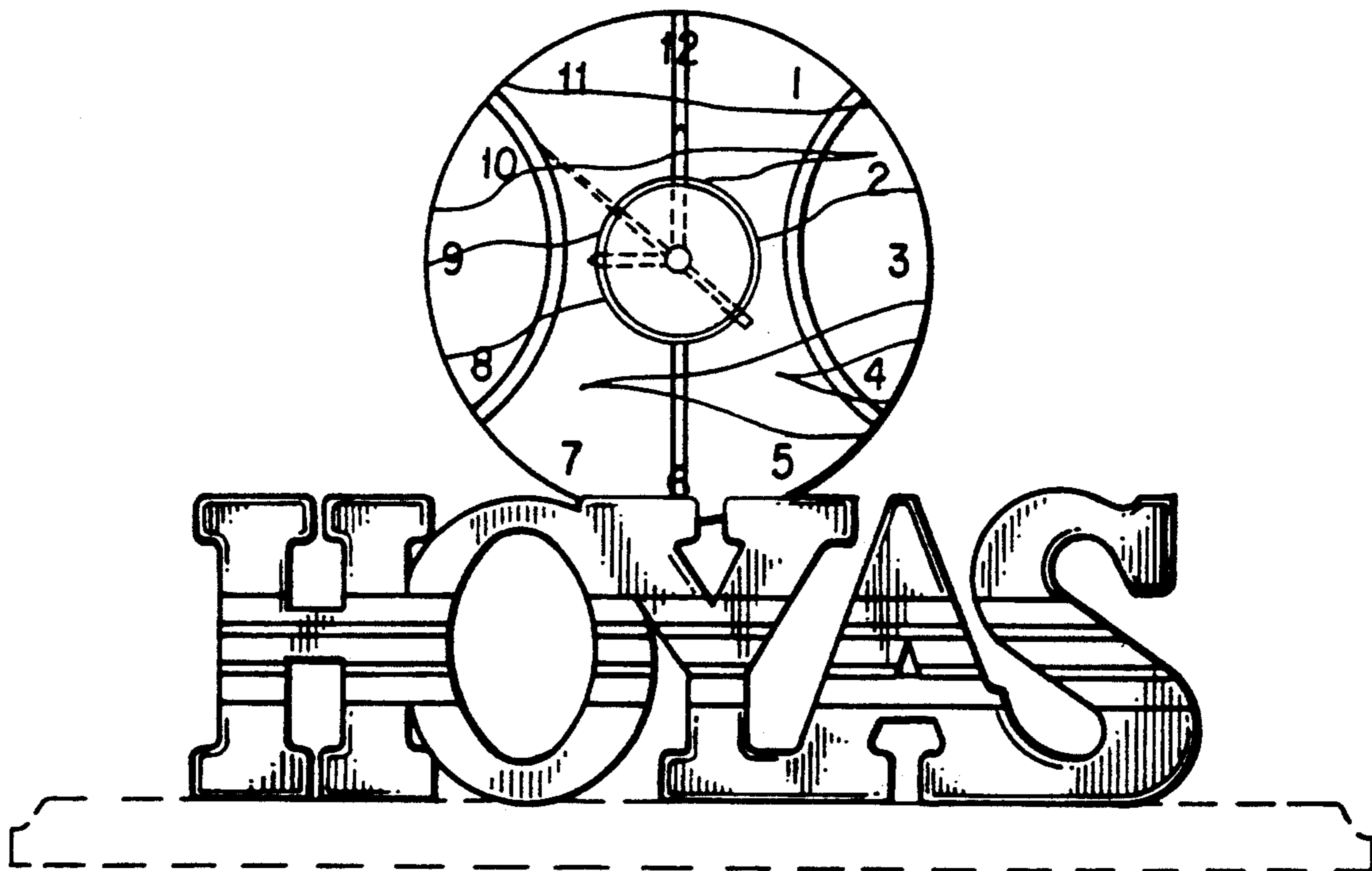

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a team logo clock showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of my new design of FIGS. 1-5;

 The broken line disclosure in FIGS. 1-10 is environmental only and forms no part of the claimed design.



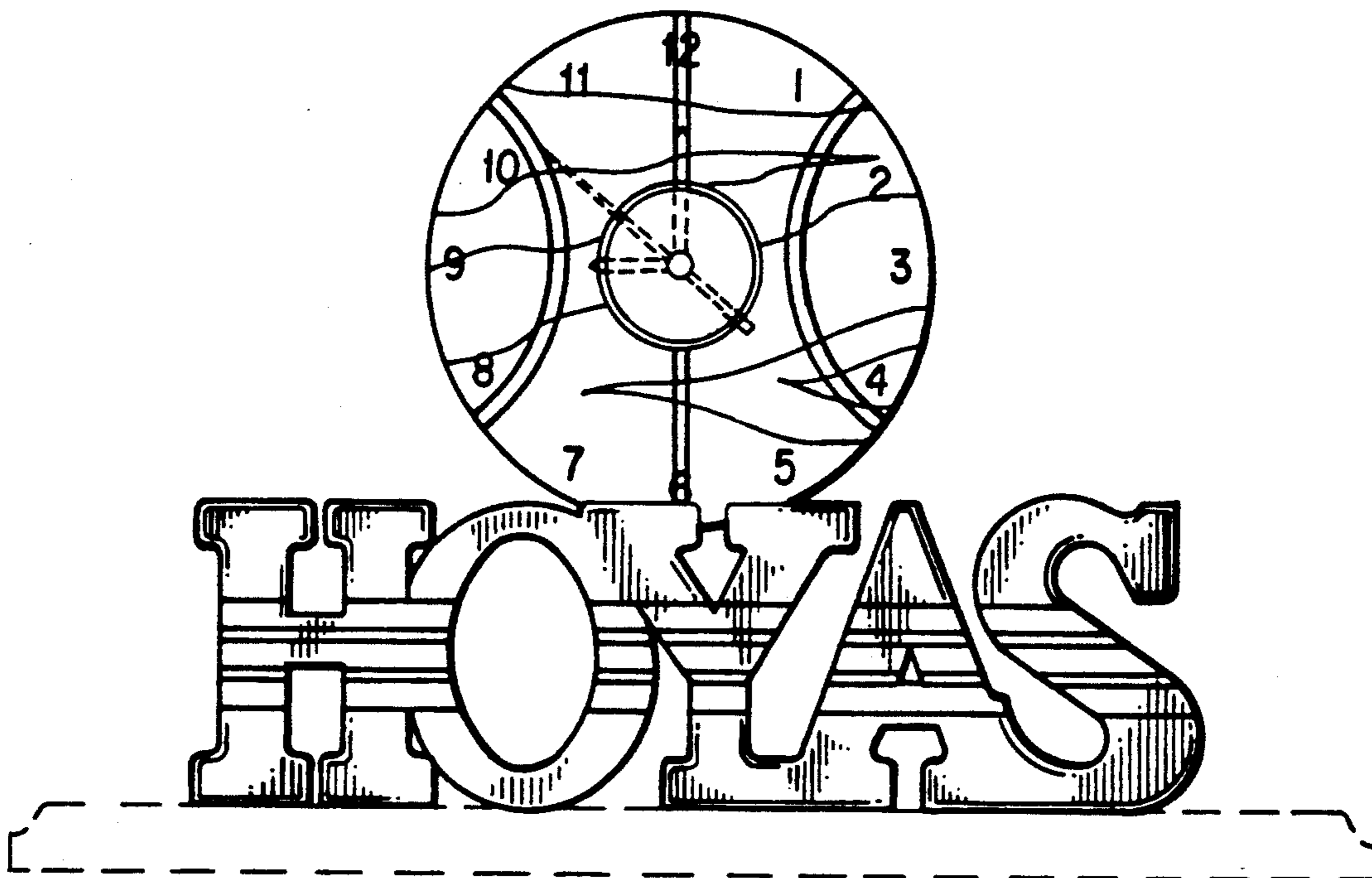

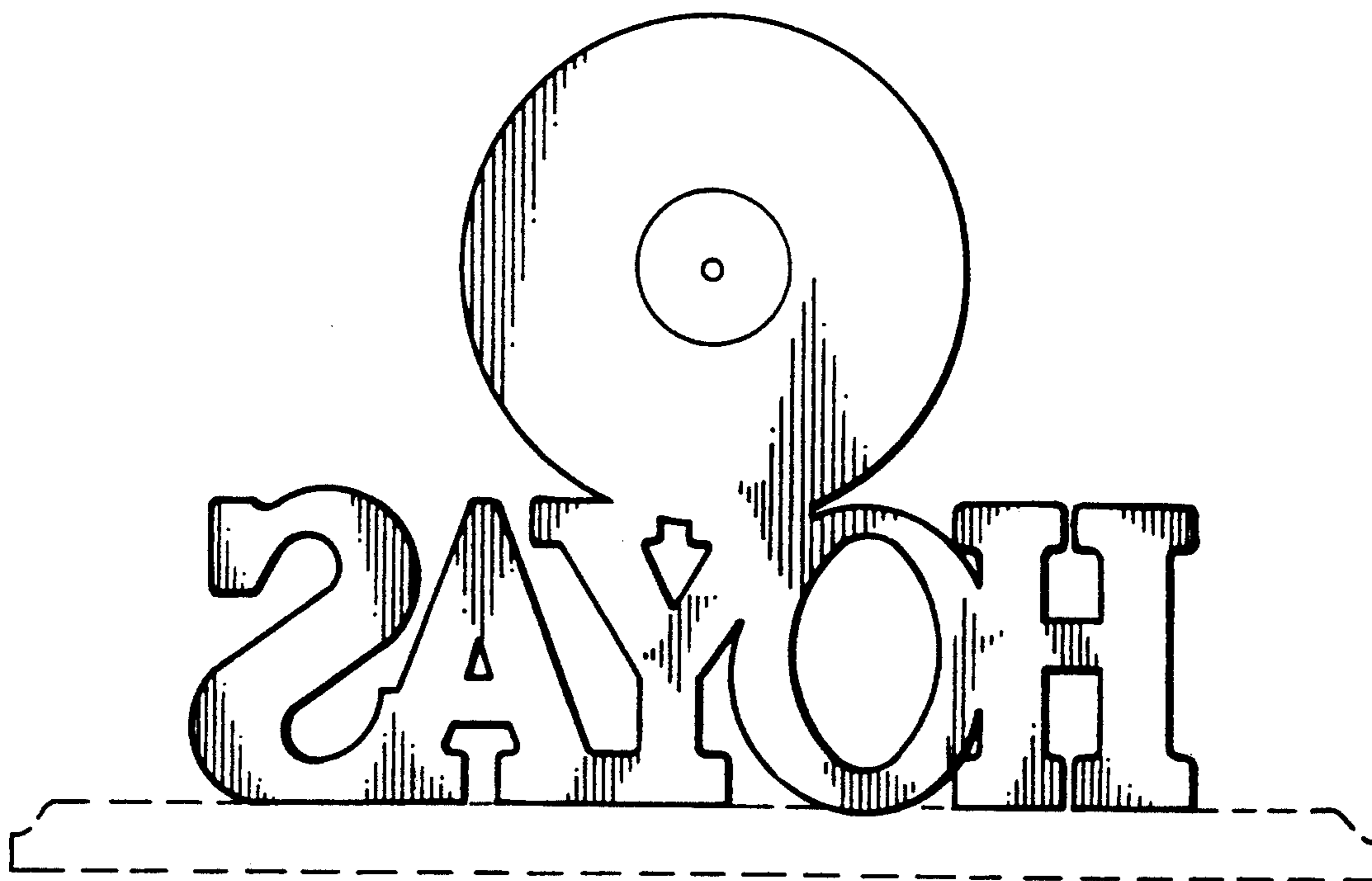

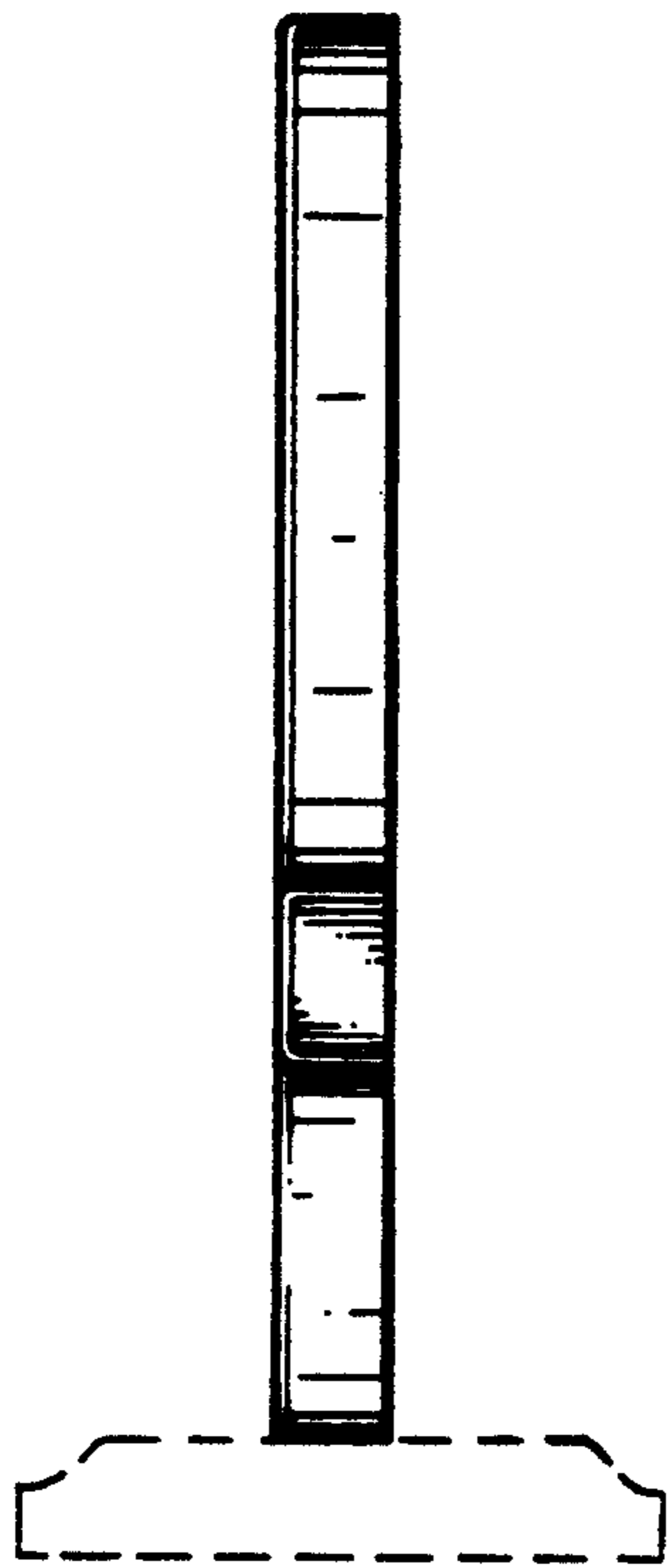

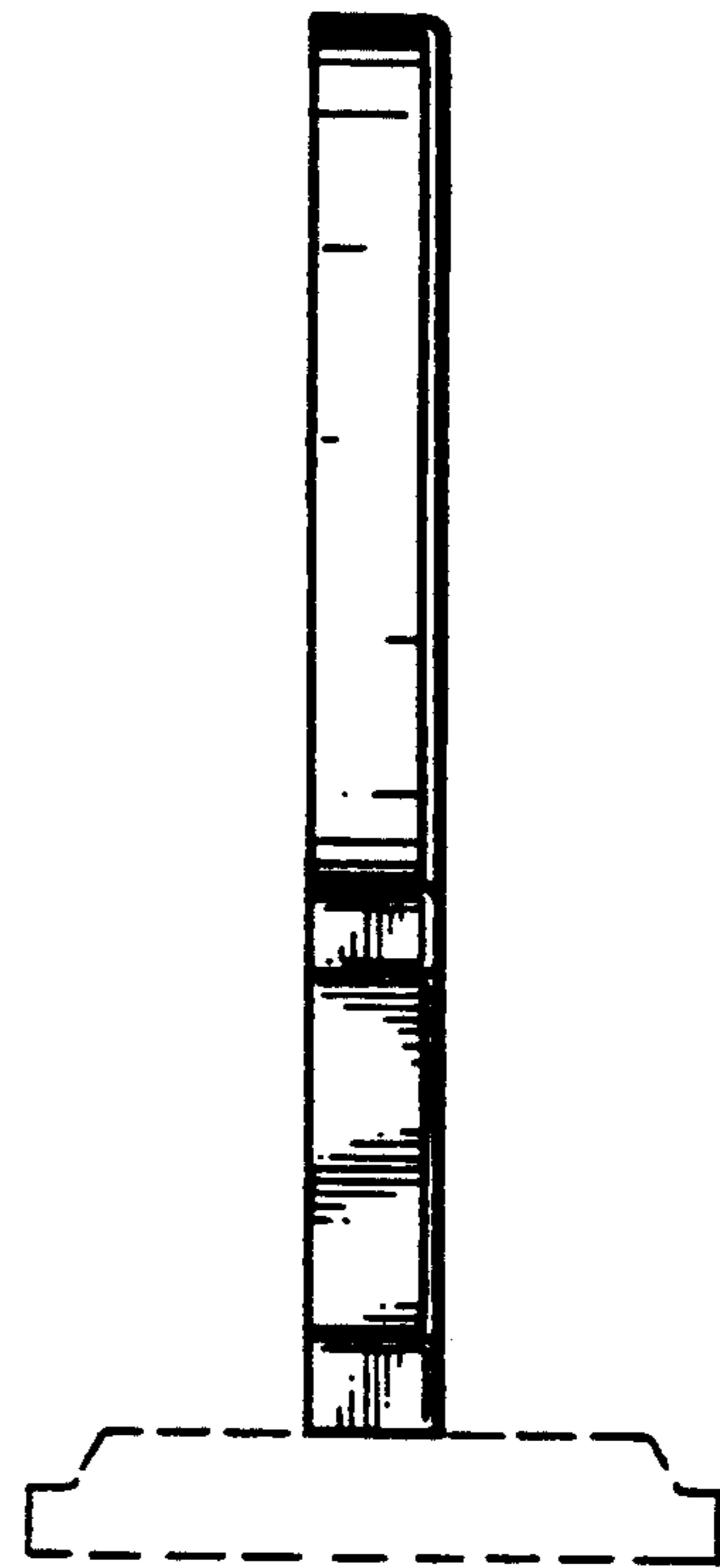

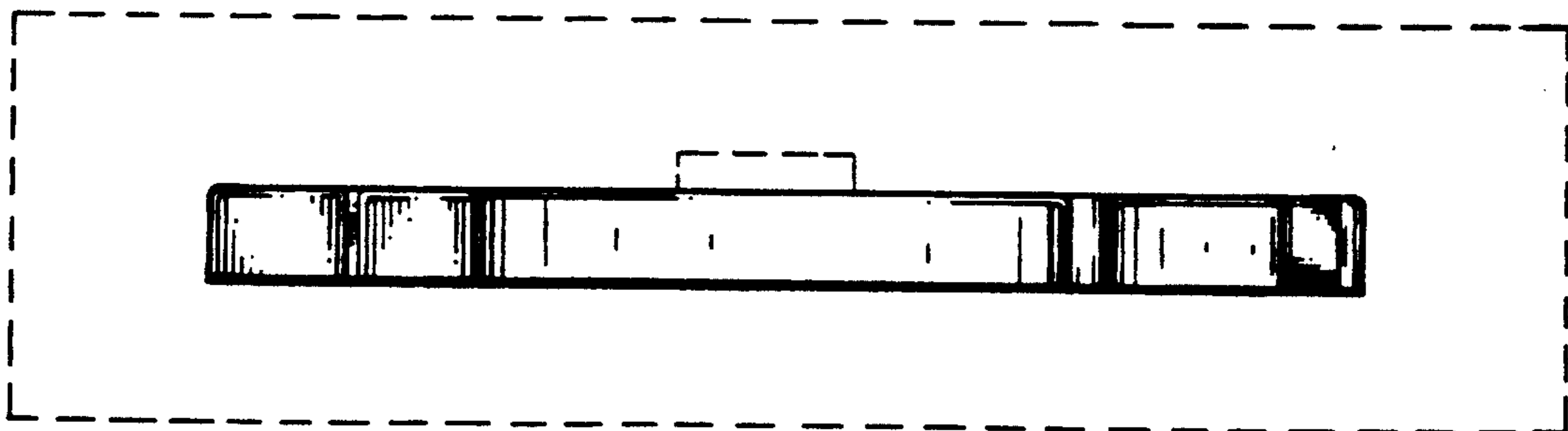

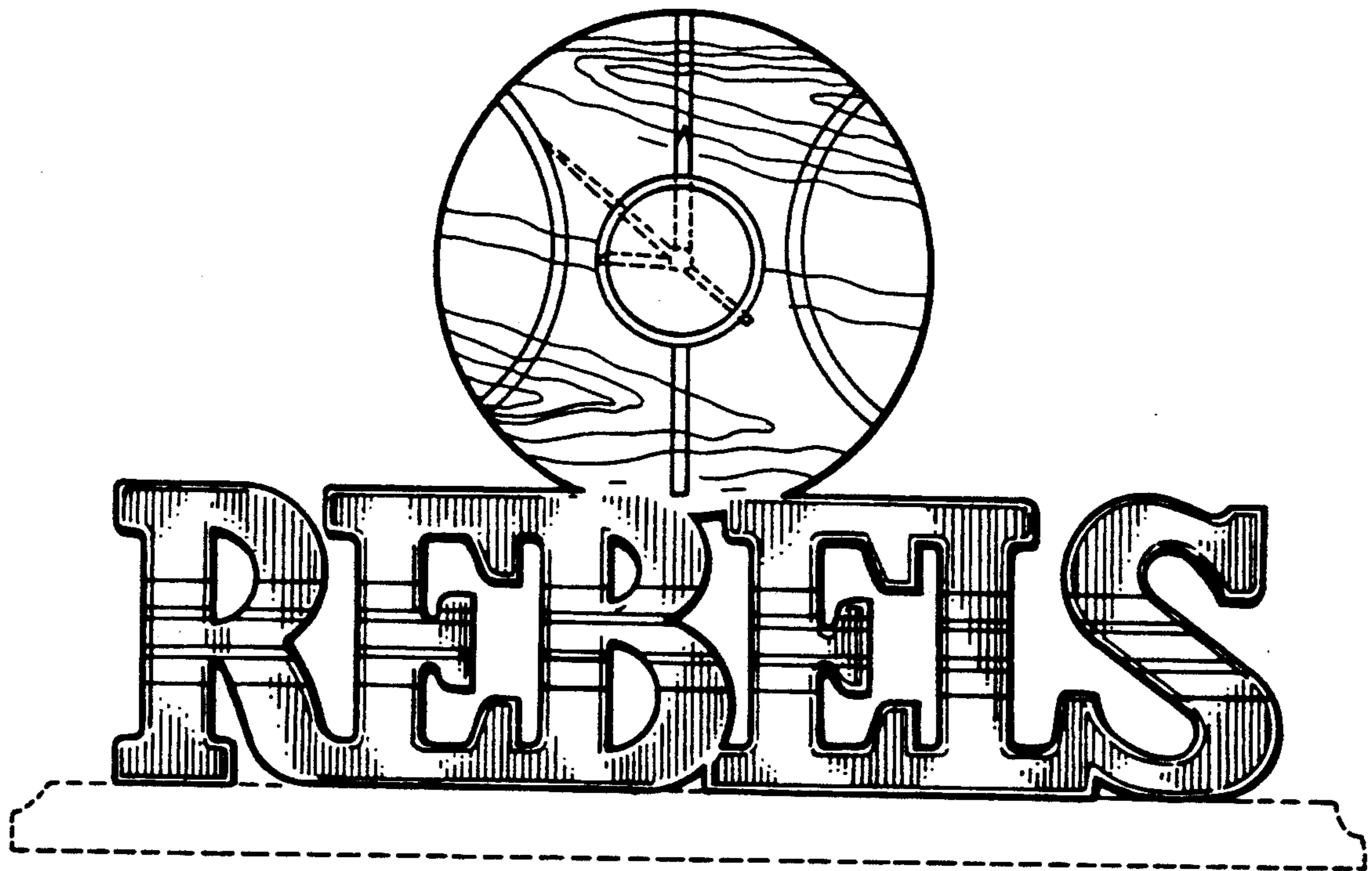

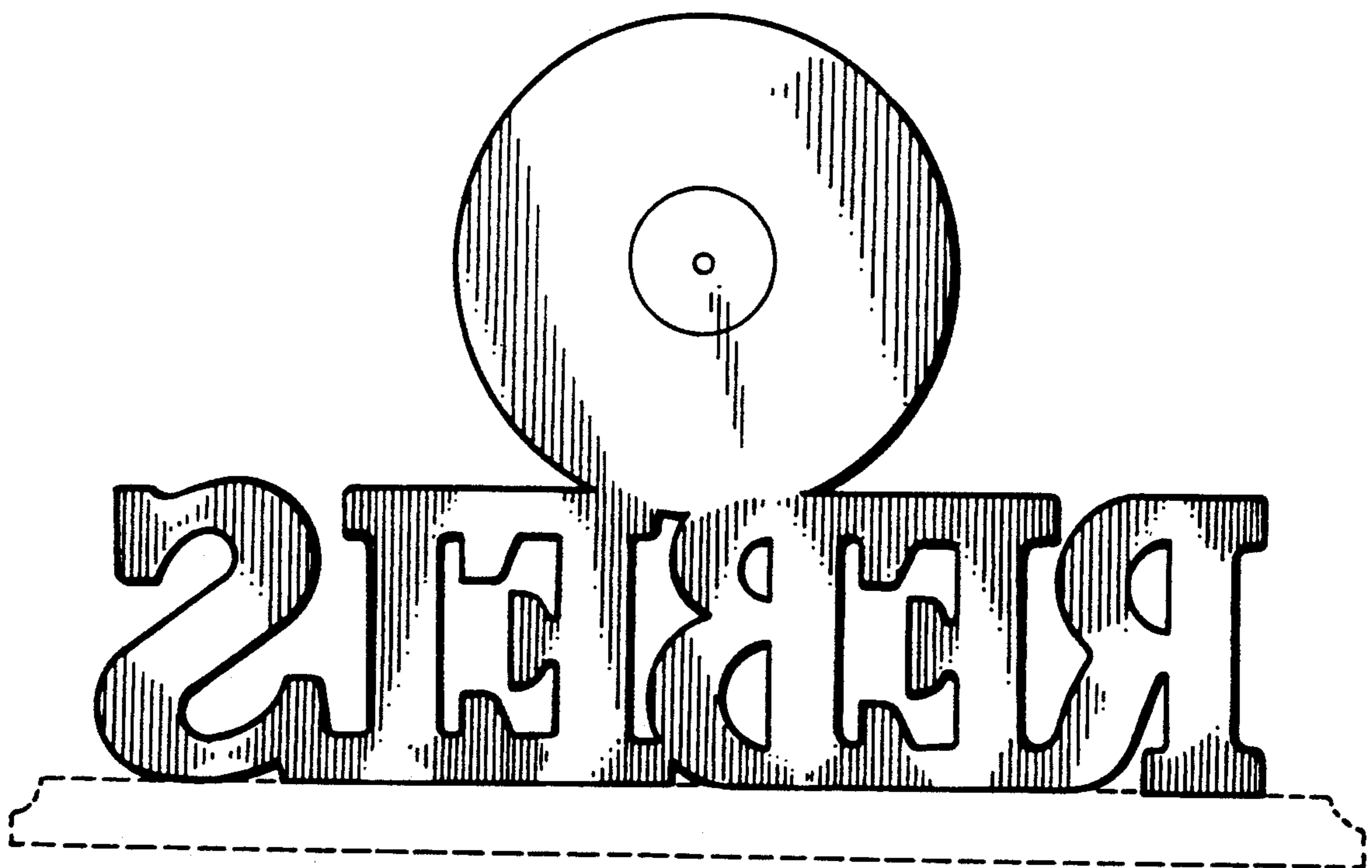

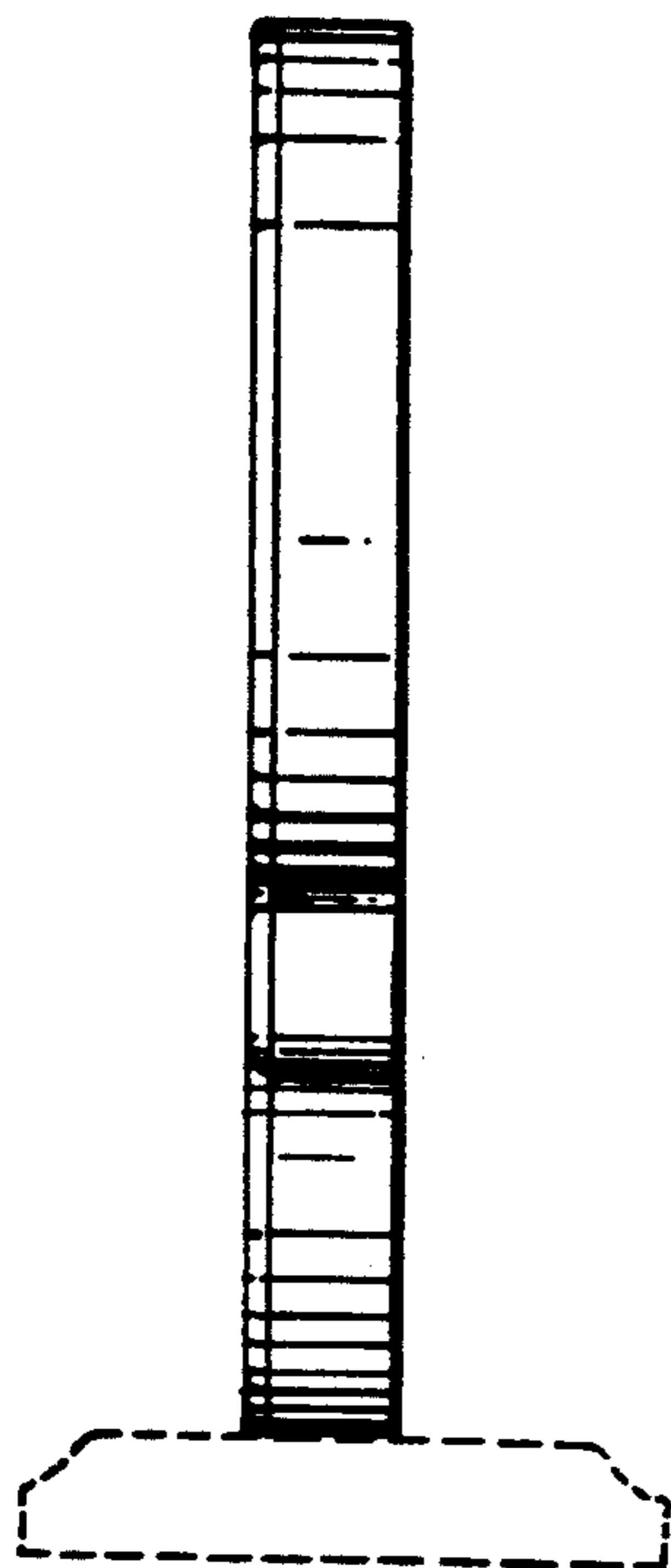

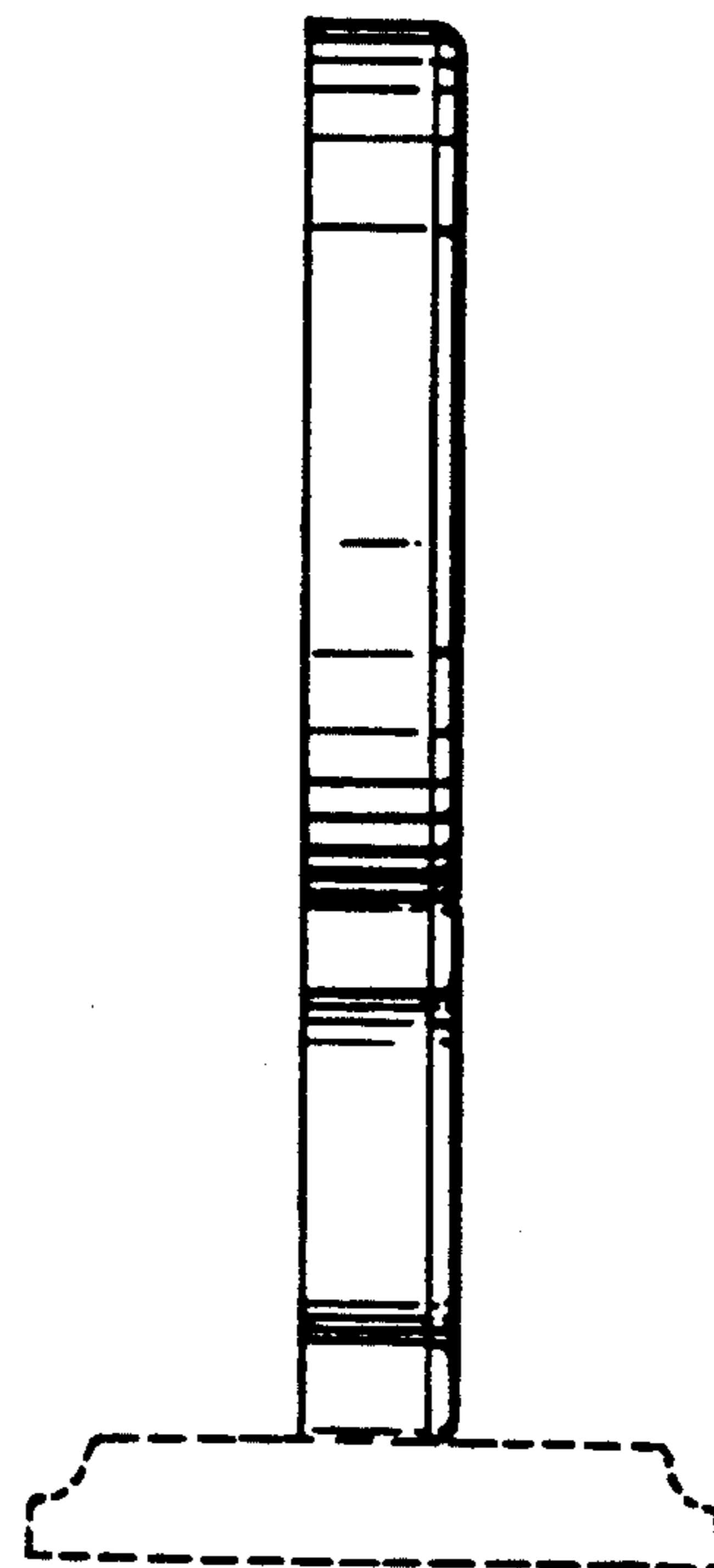

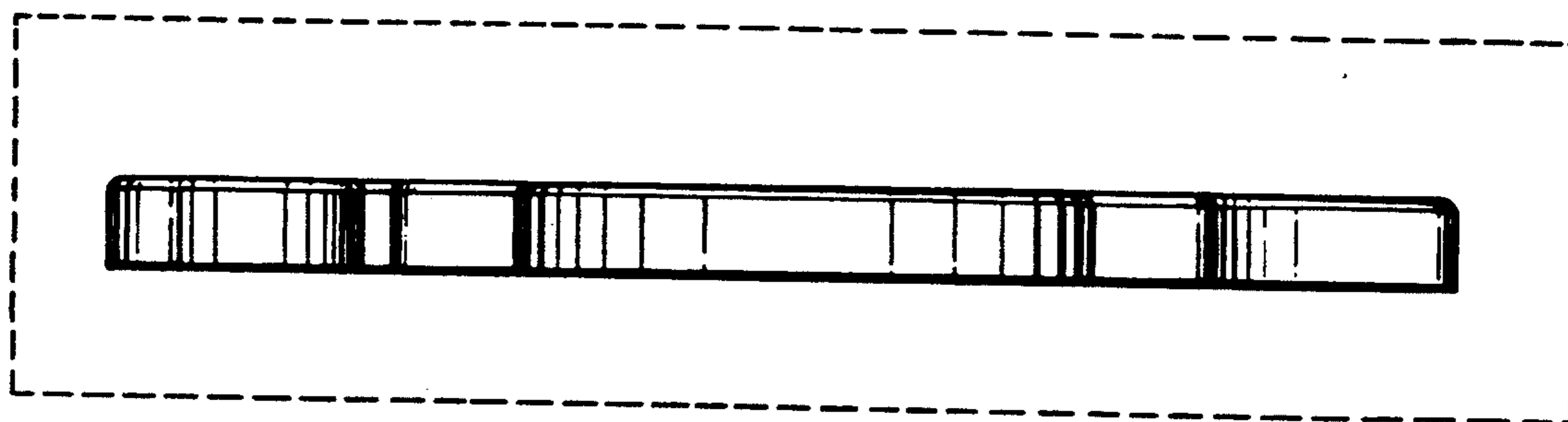
