FIG. 2 is an enlarged scale front elevational view thereof;

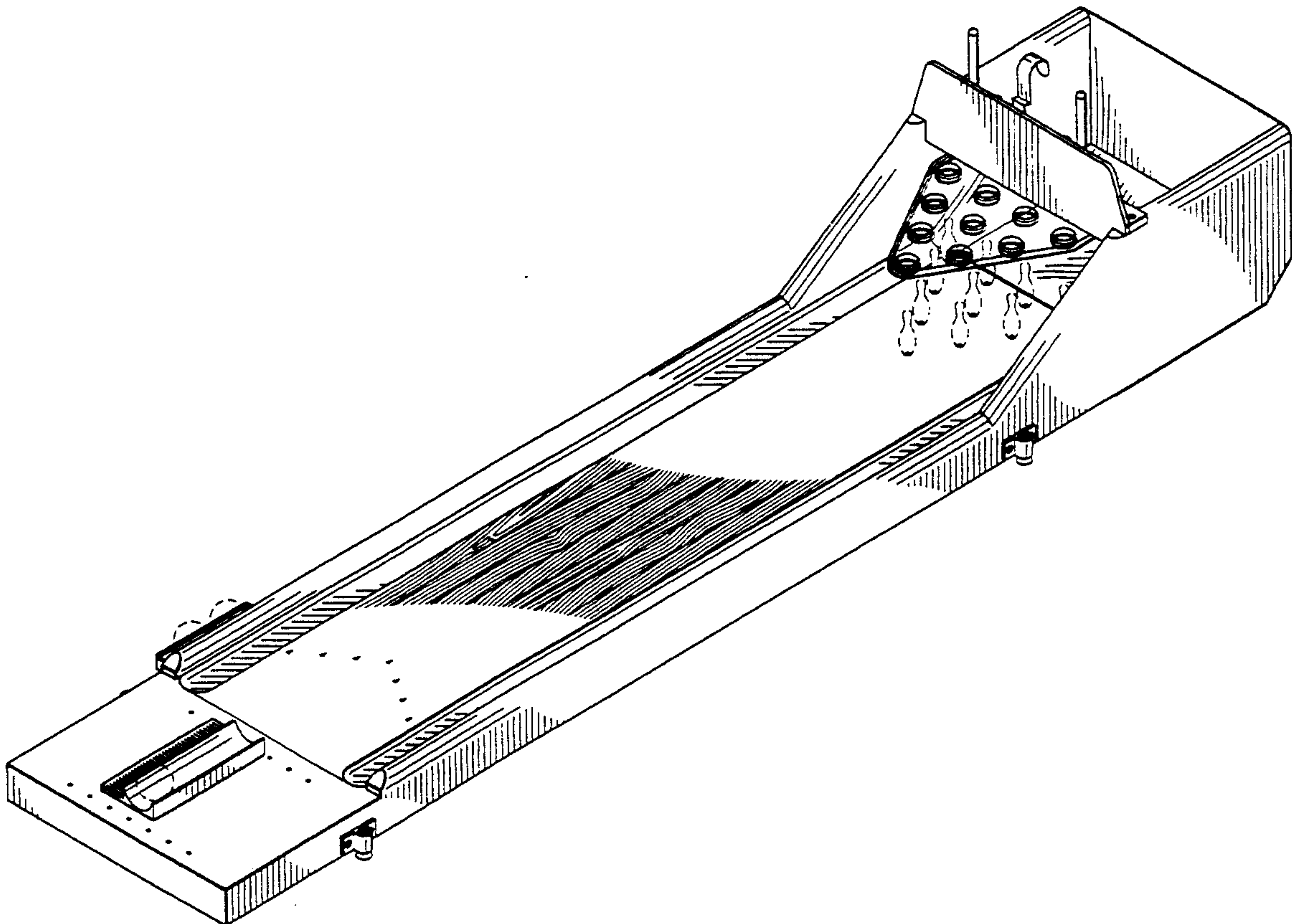
FIG. 3 is an enlarged scale rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



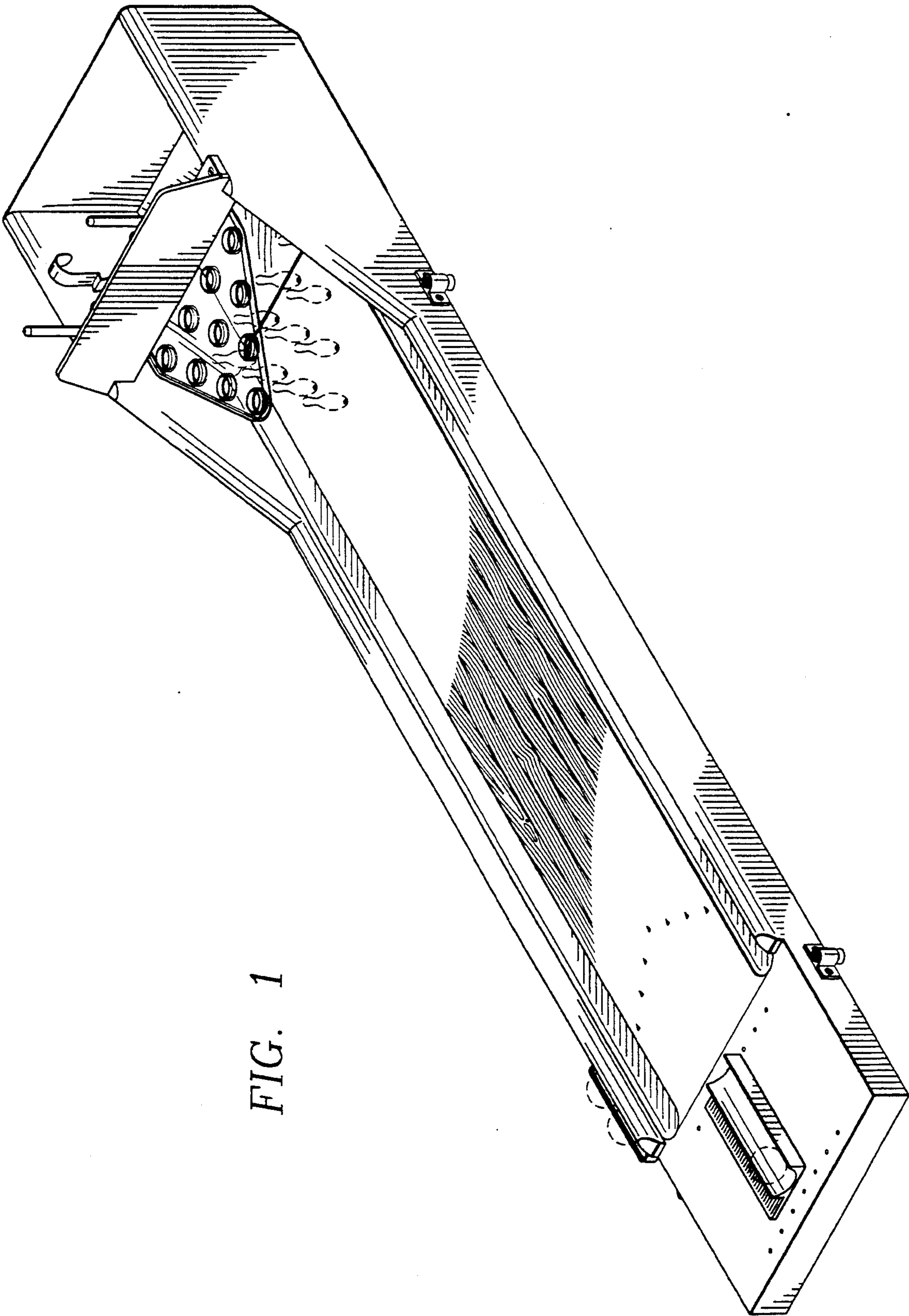

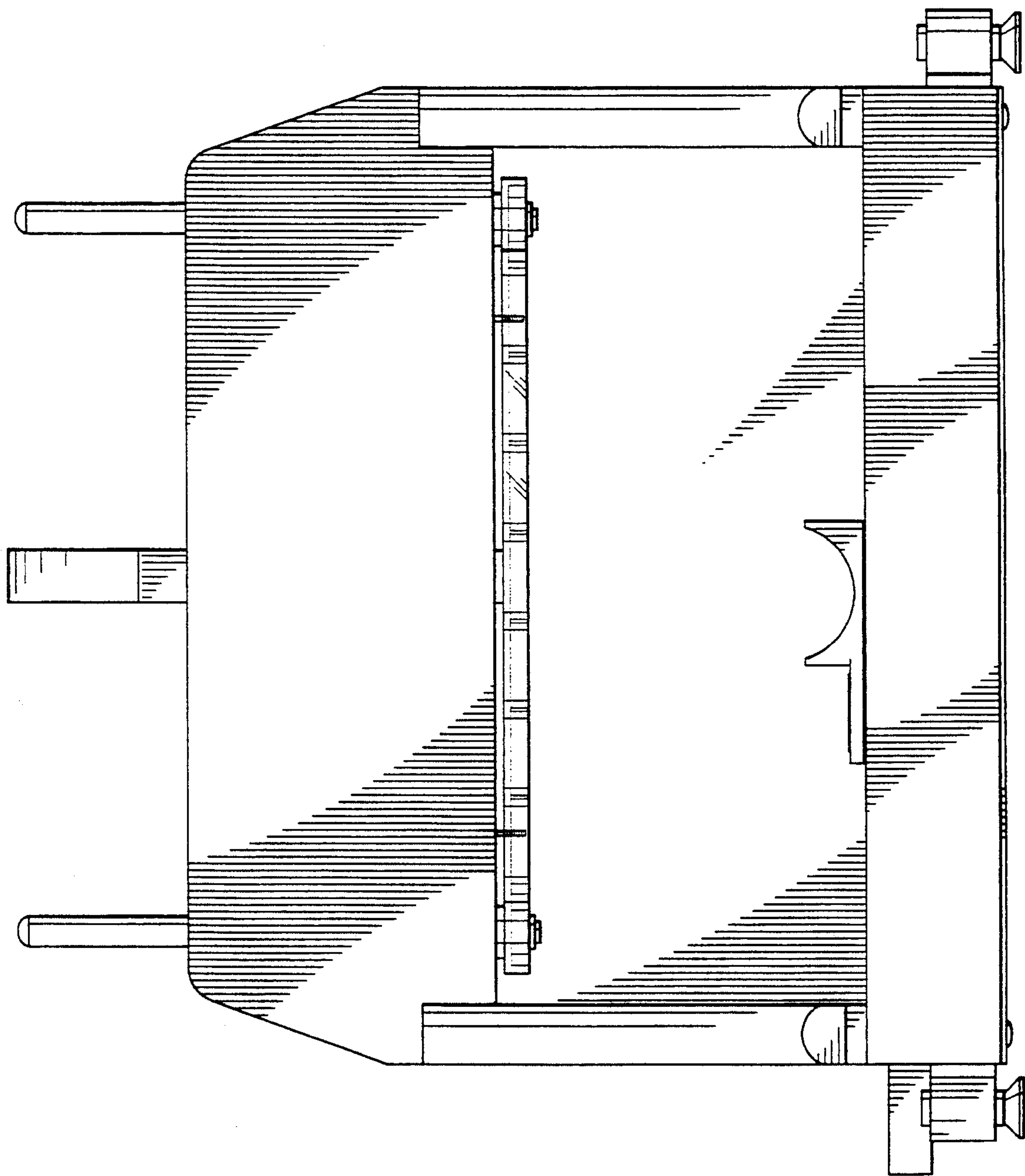

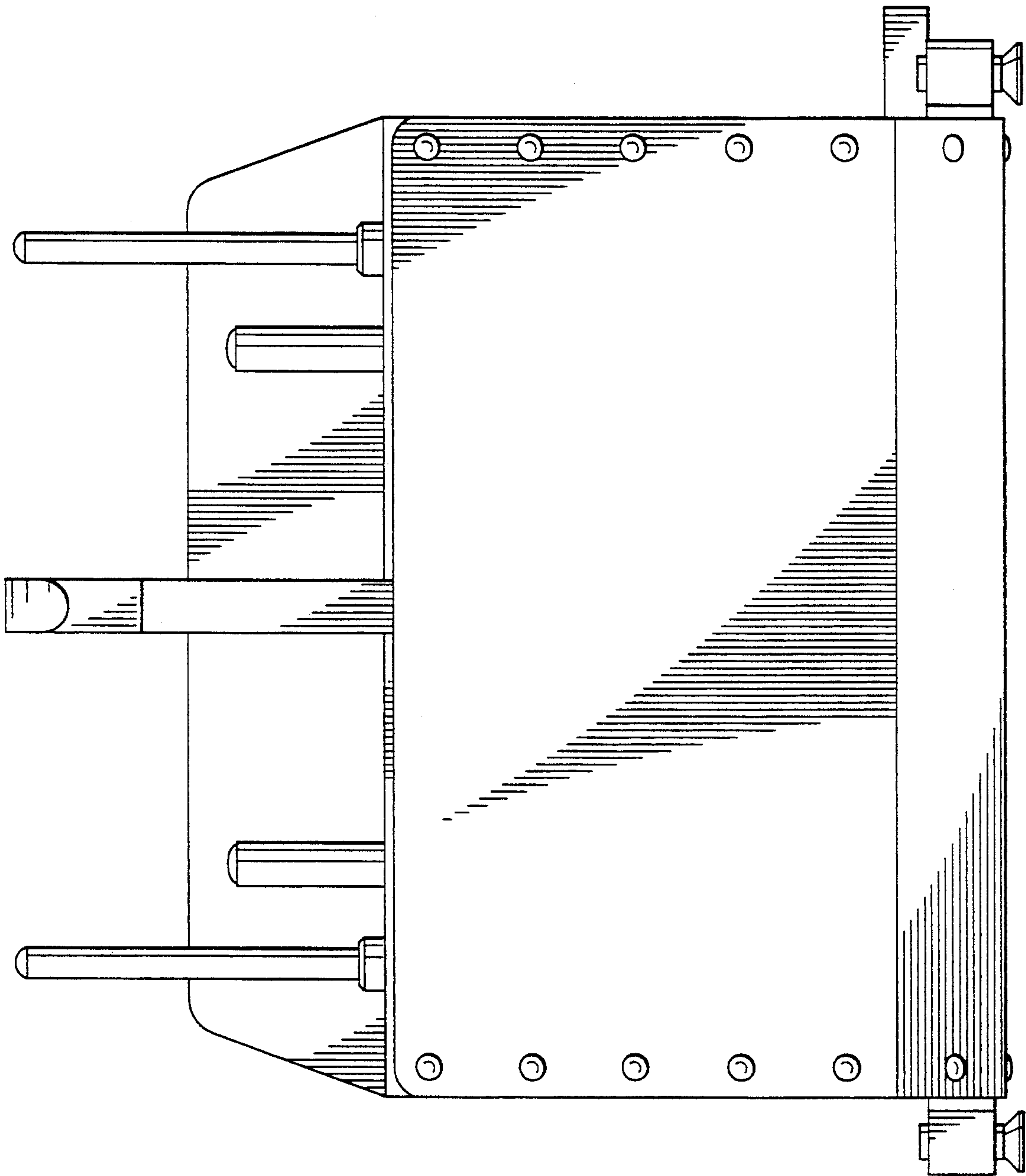

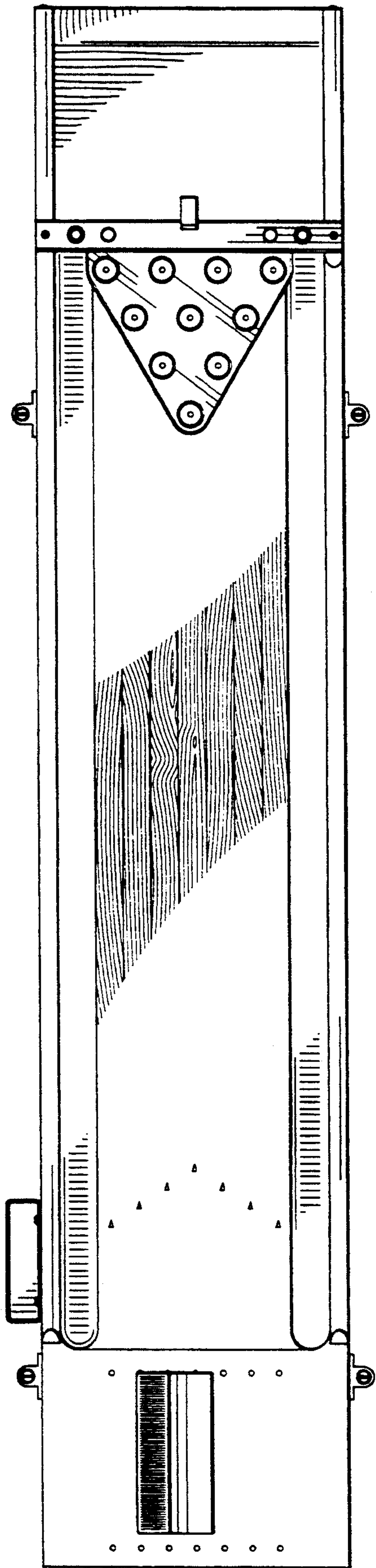

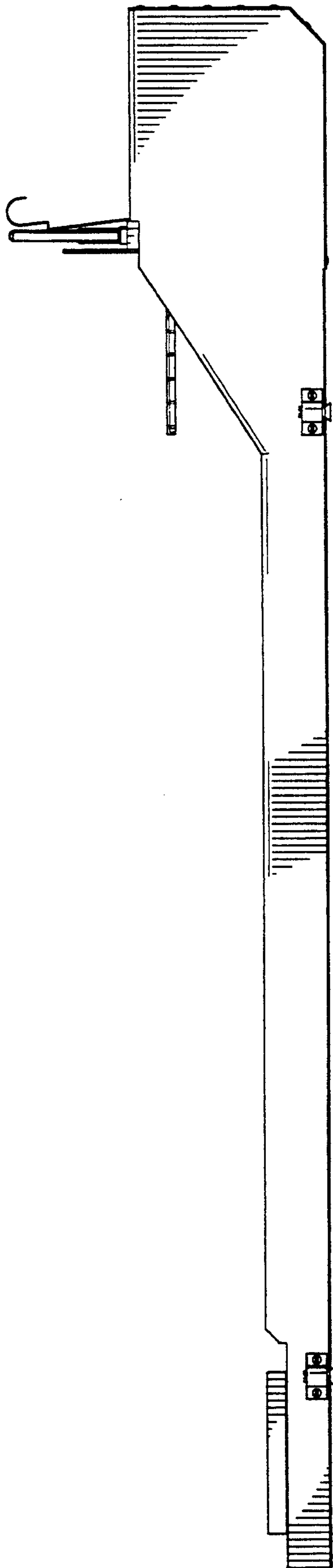

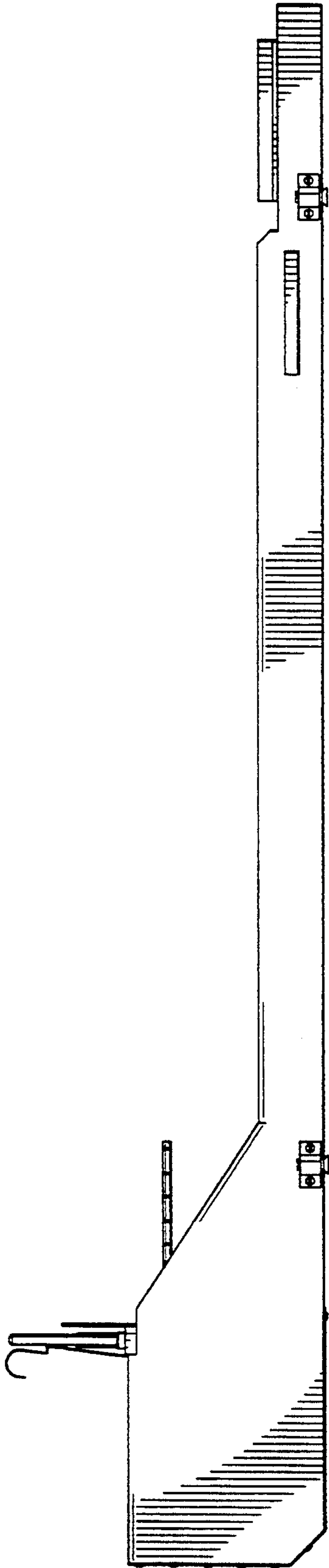

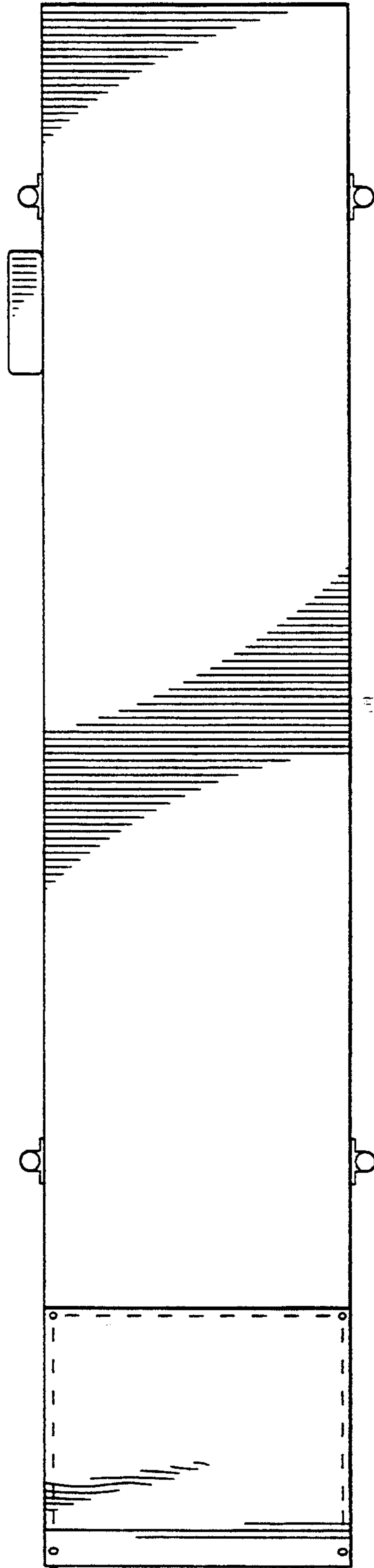
