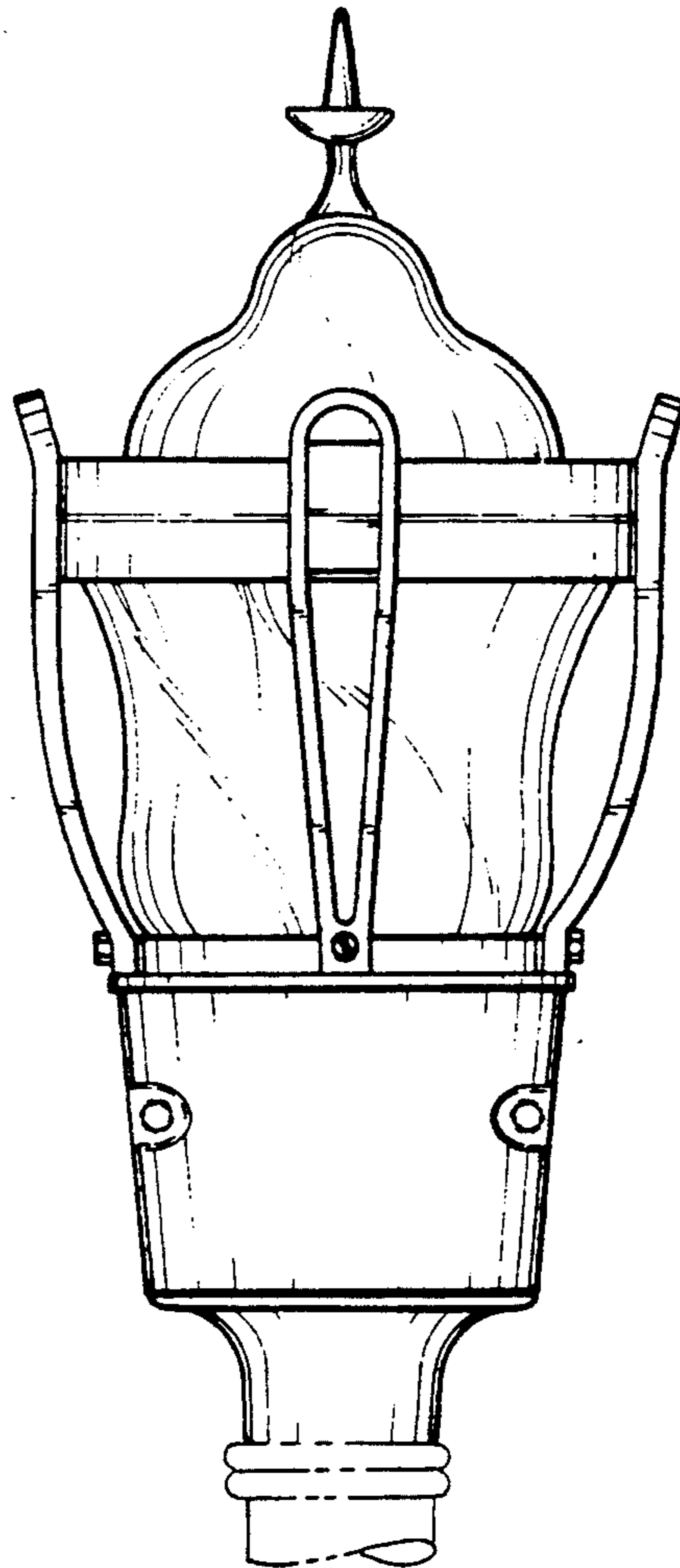
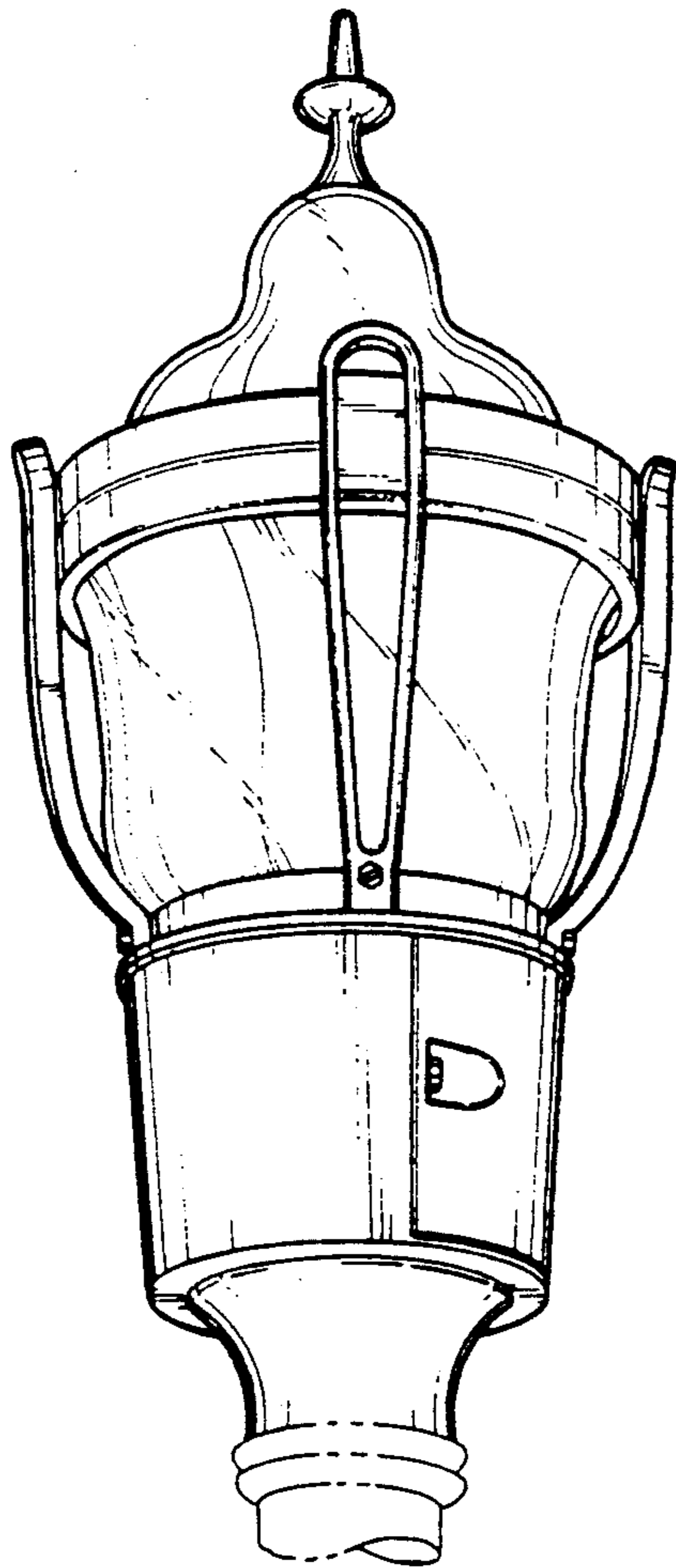

The ornamental design for a pole mounted street luminaire, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view; FIG. 5 is a top plan view; and, FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view. 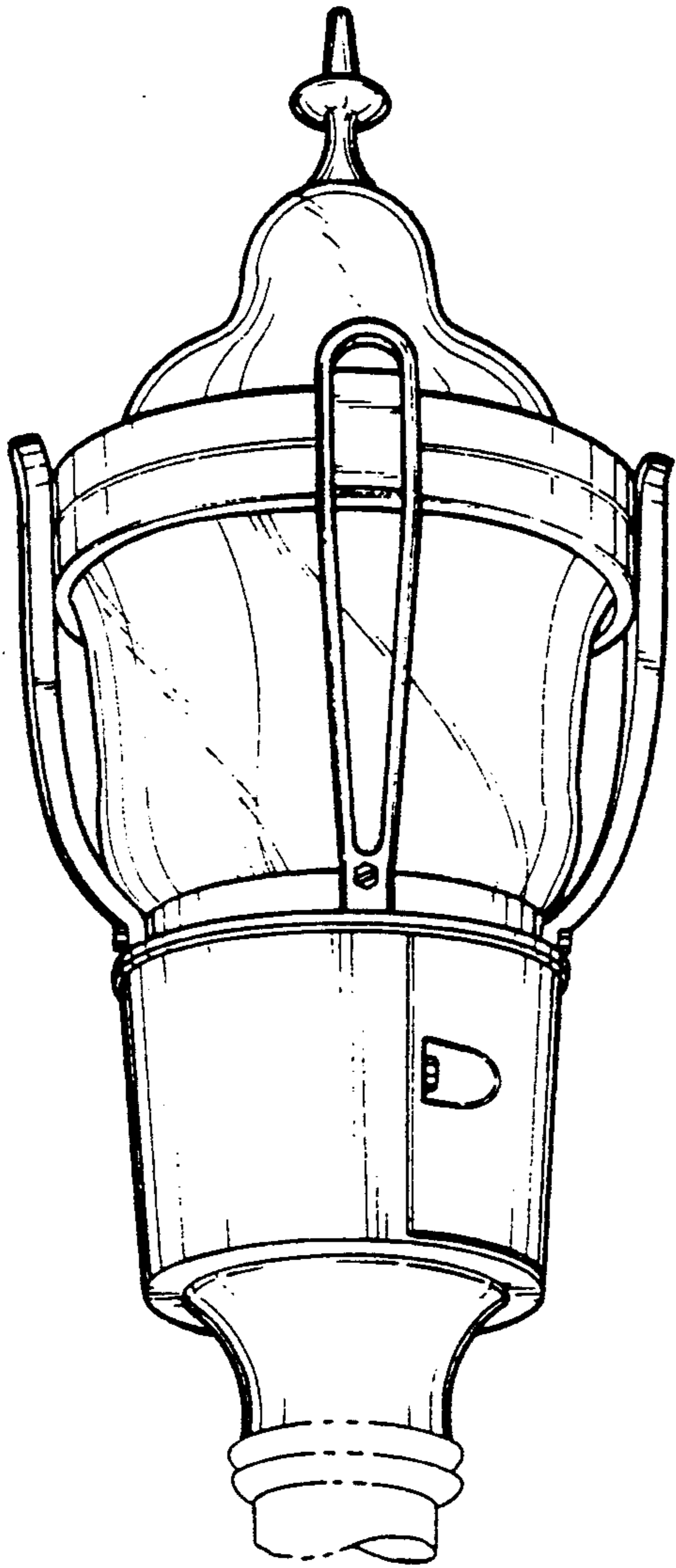

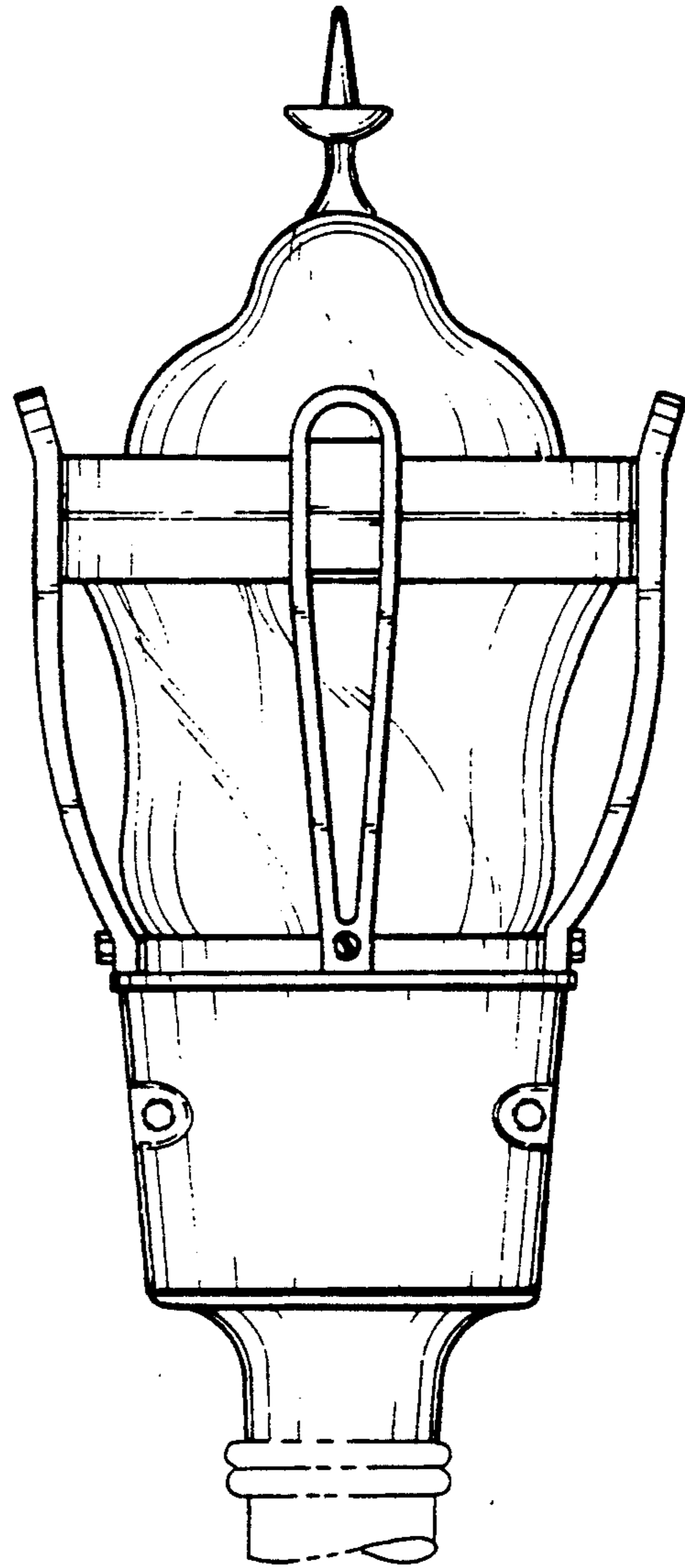

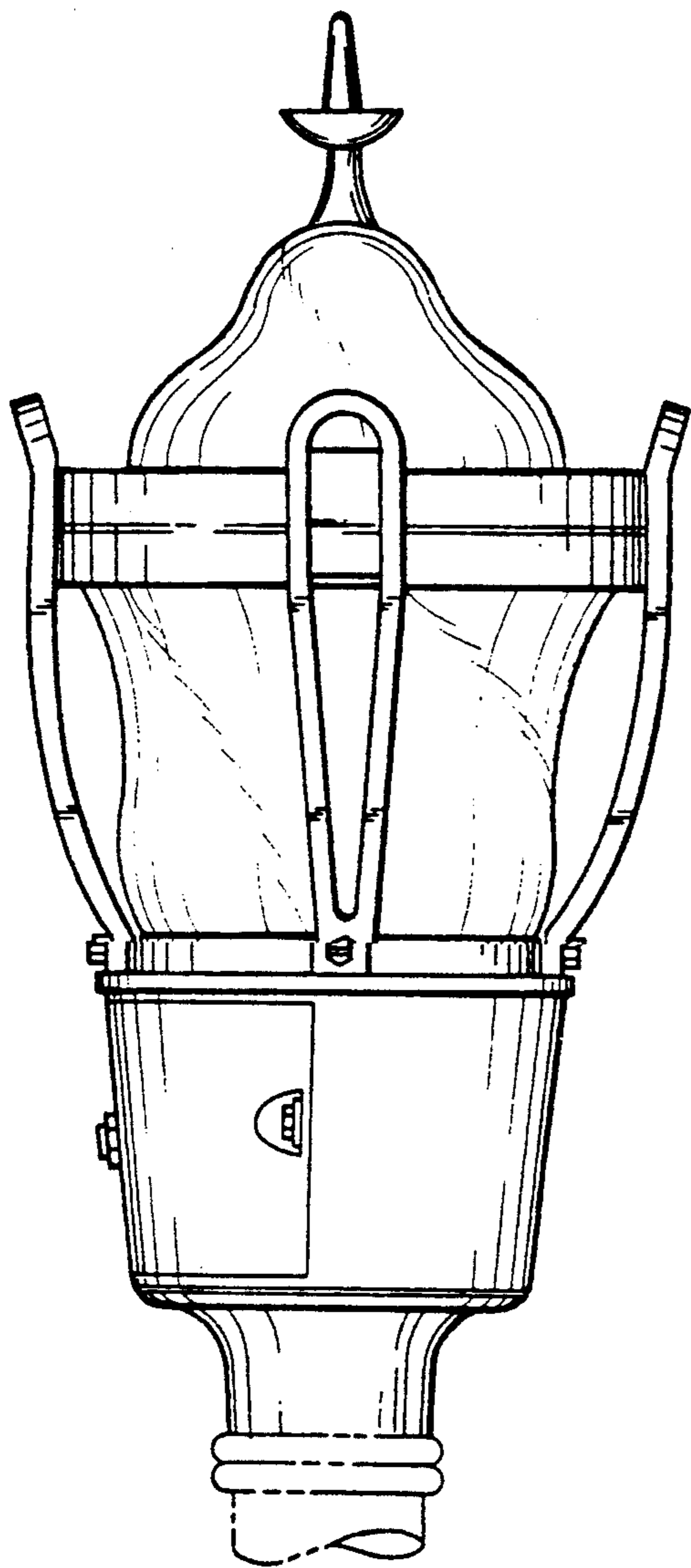

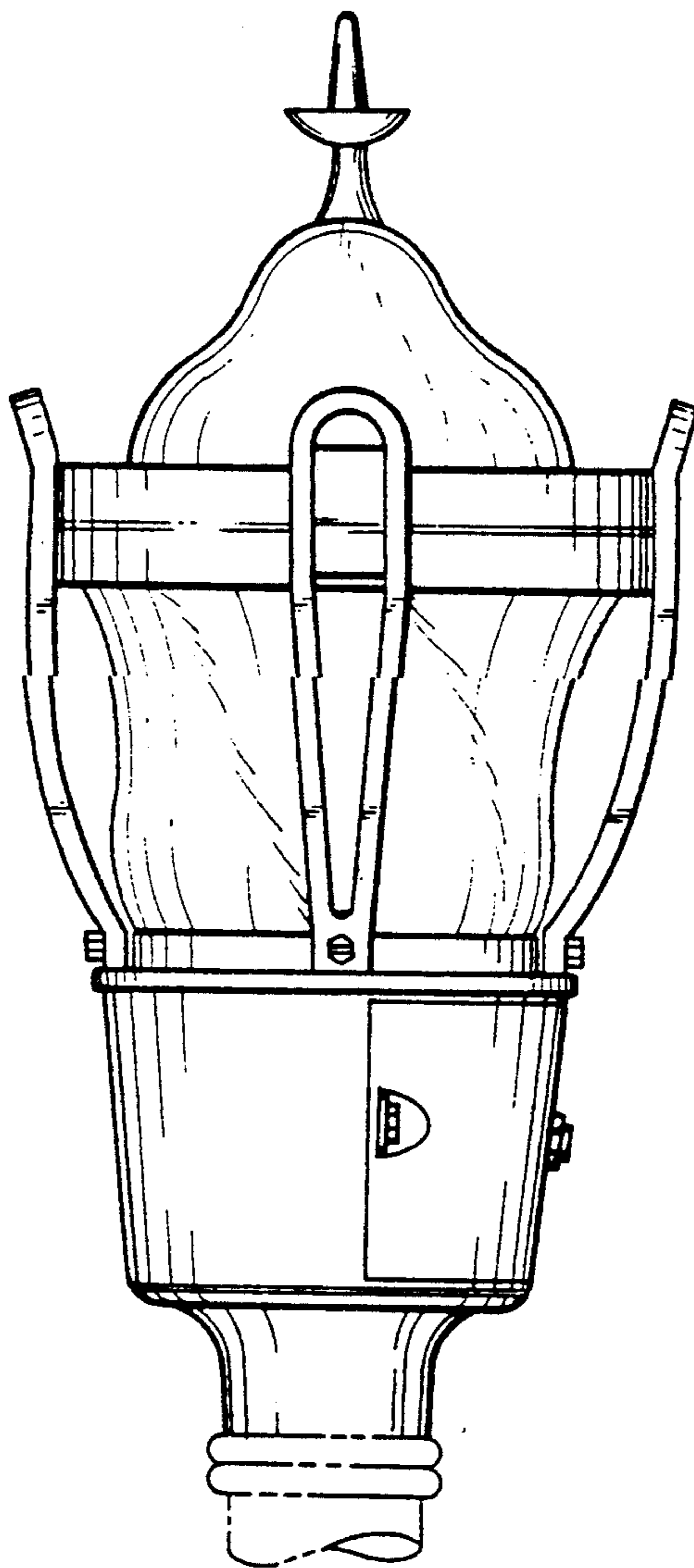

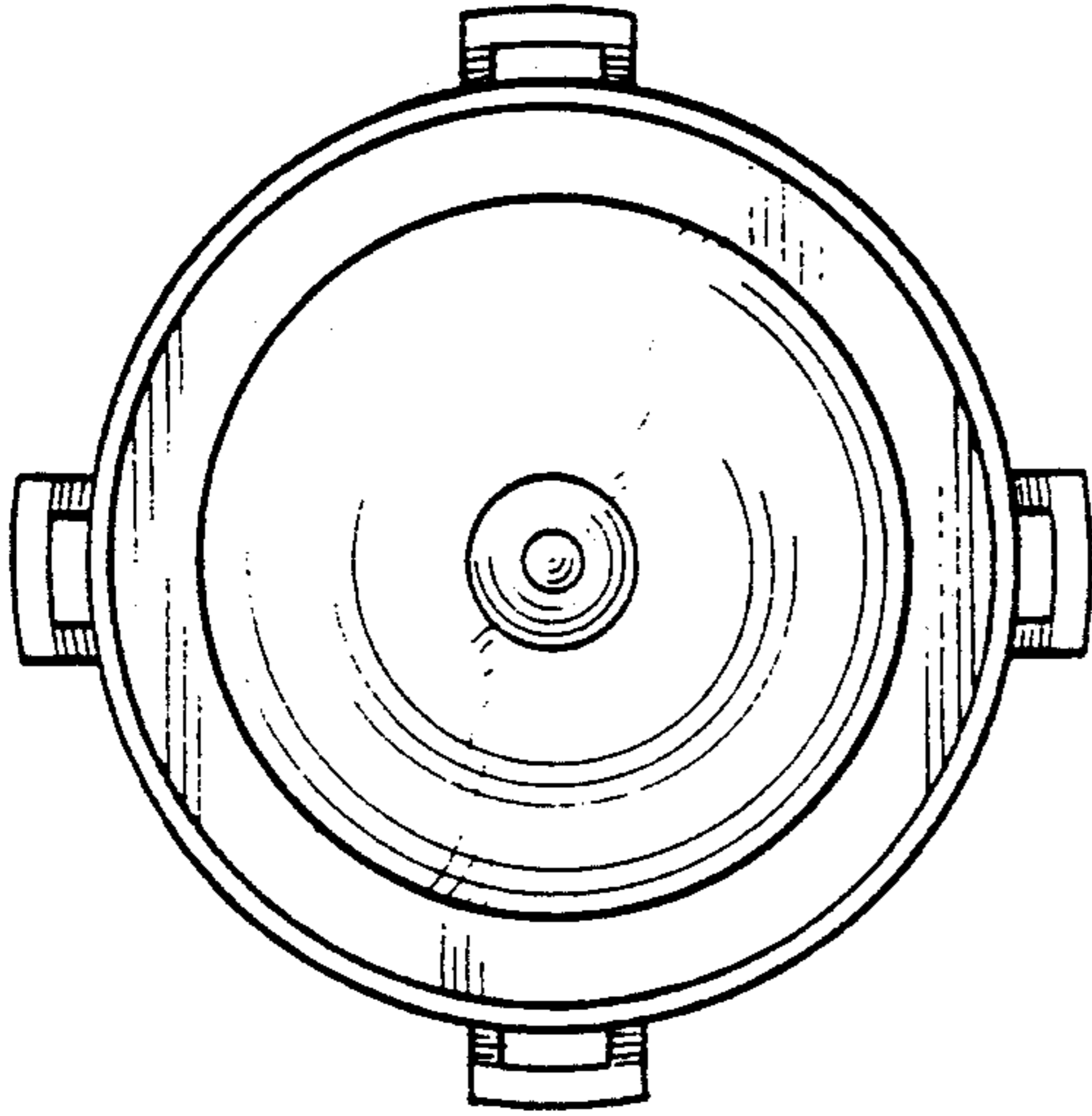

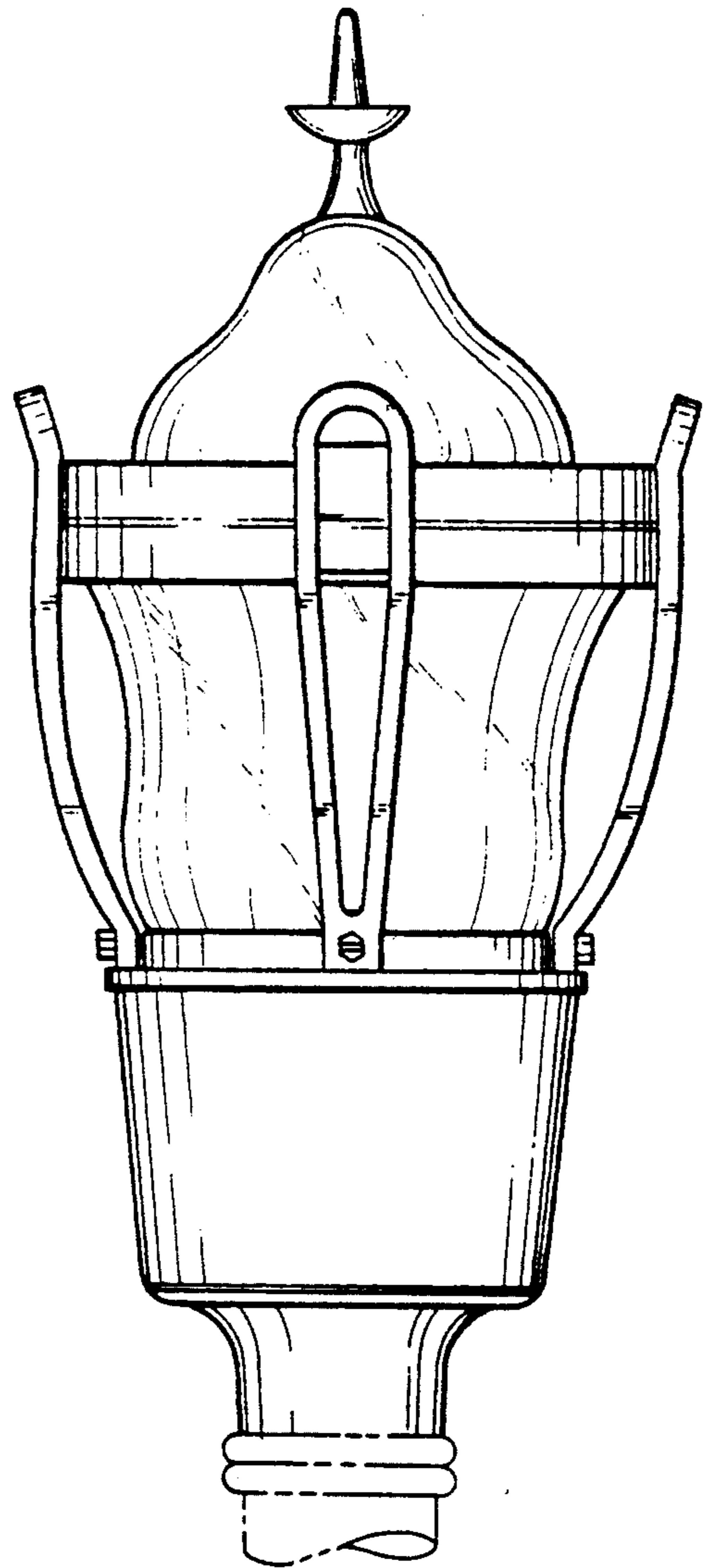
