The ornamental design for a suspended luminaire, as shown and described.

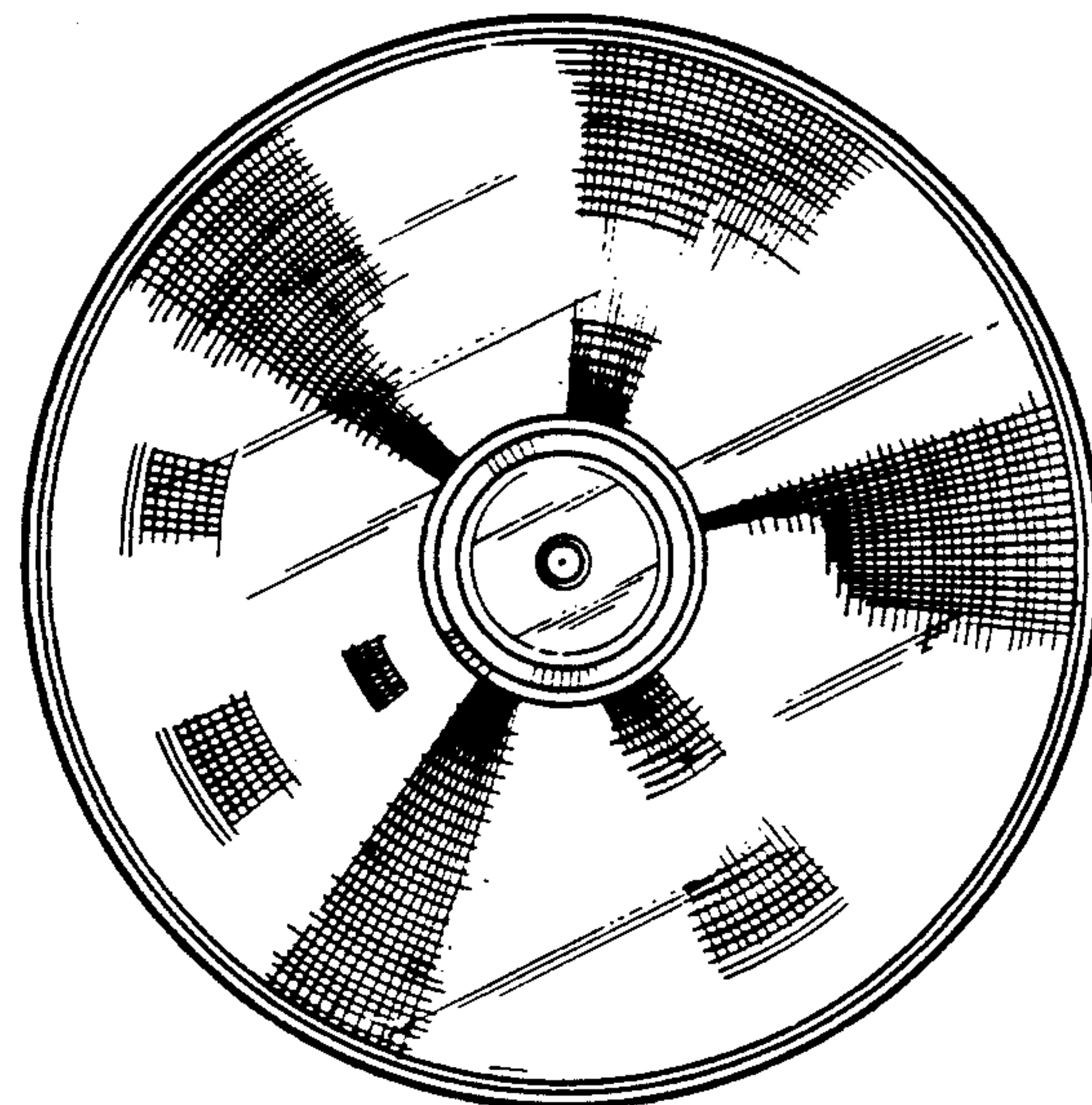
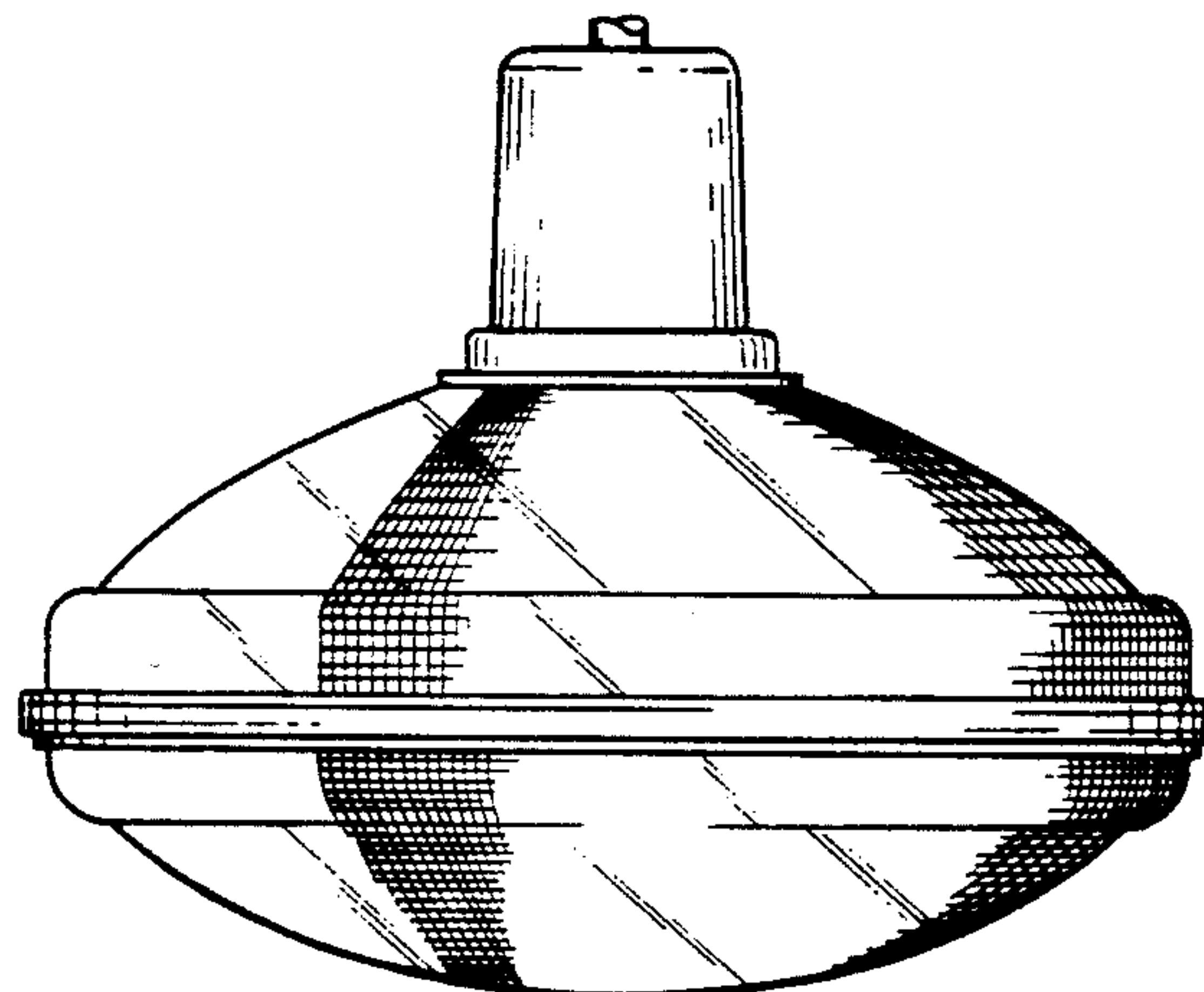
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



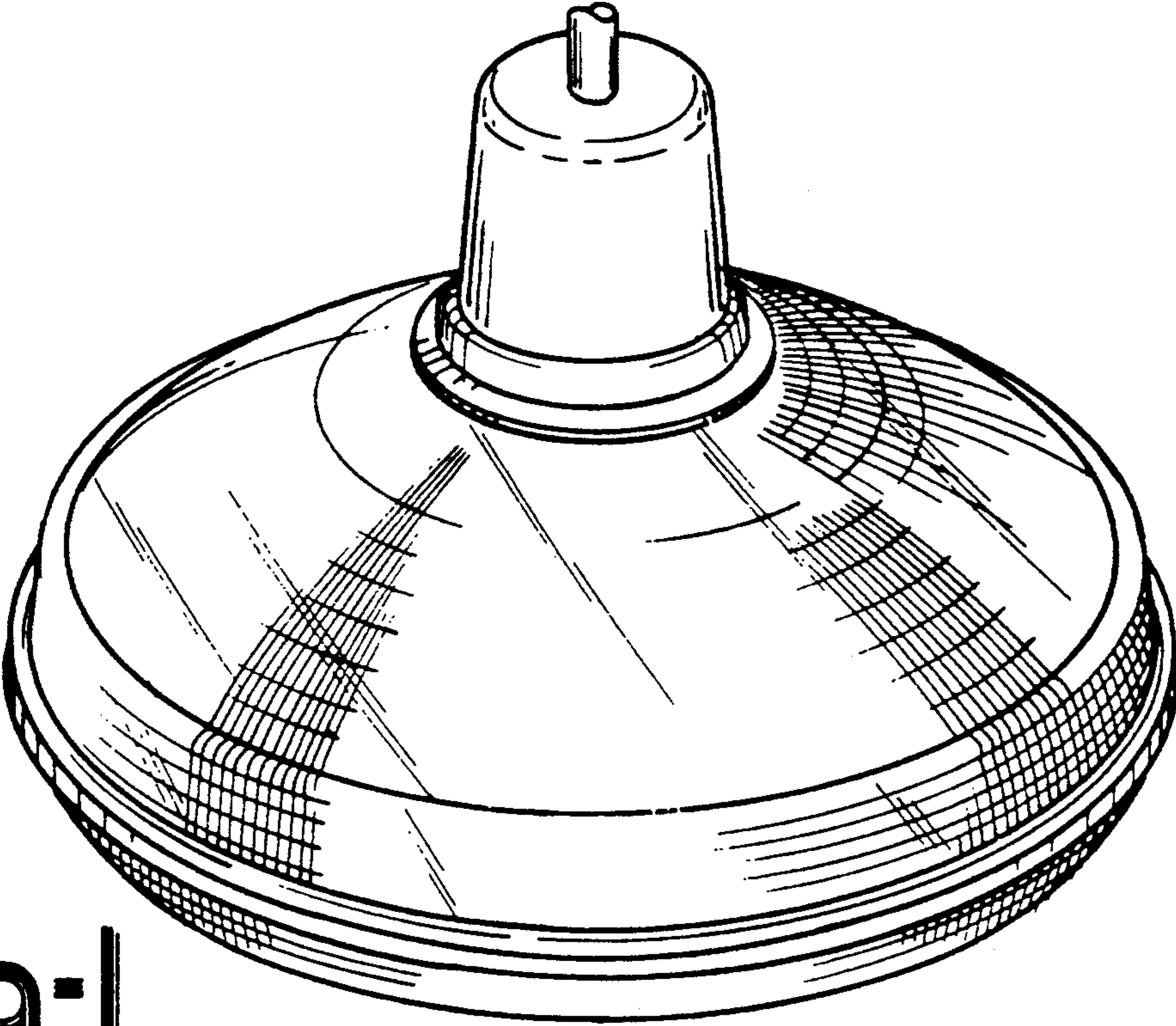

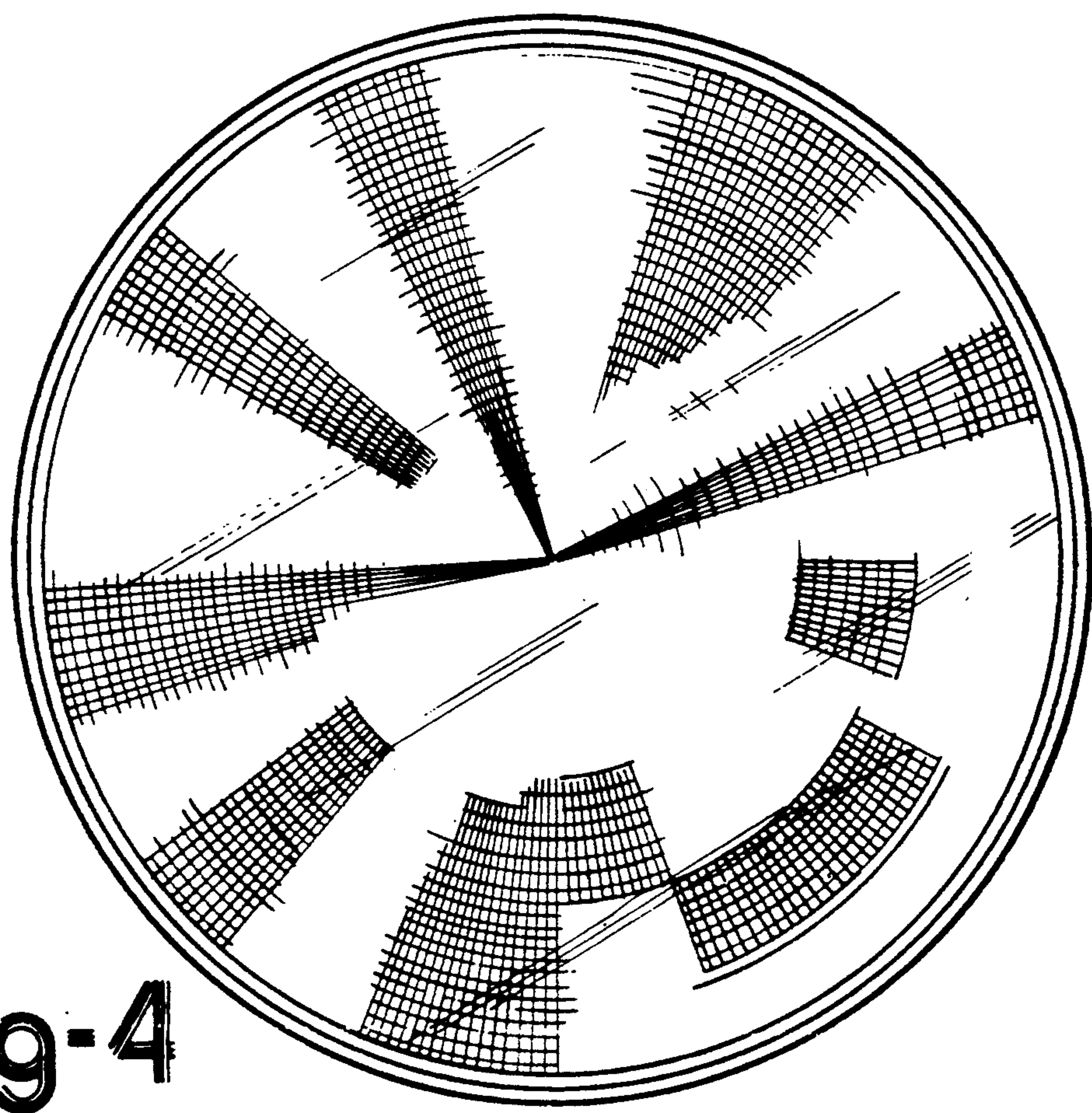

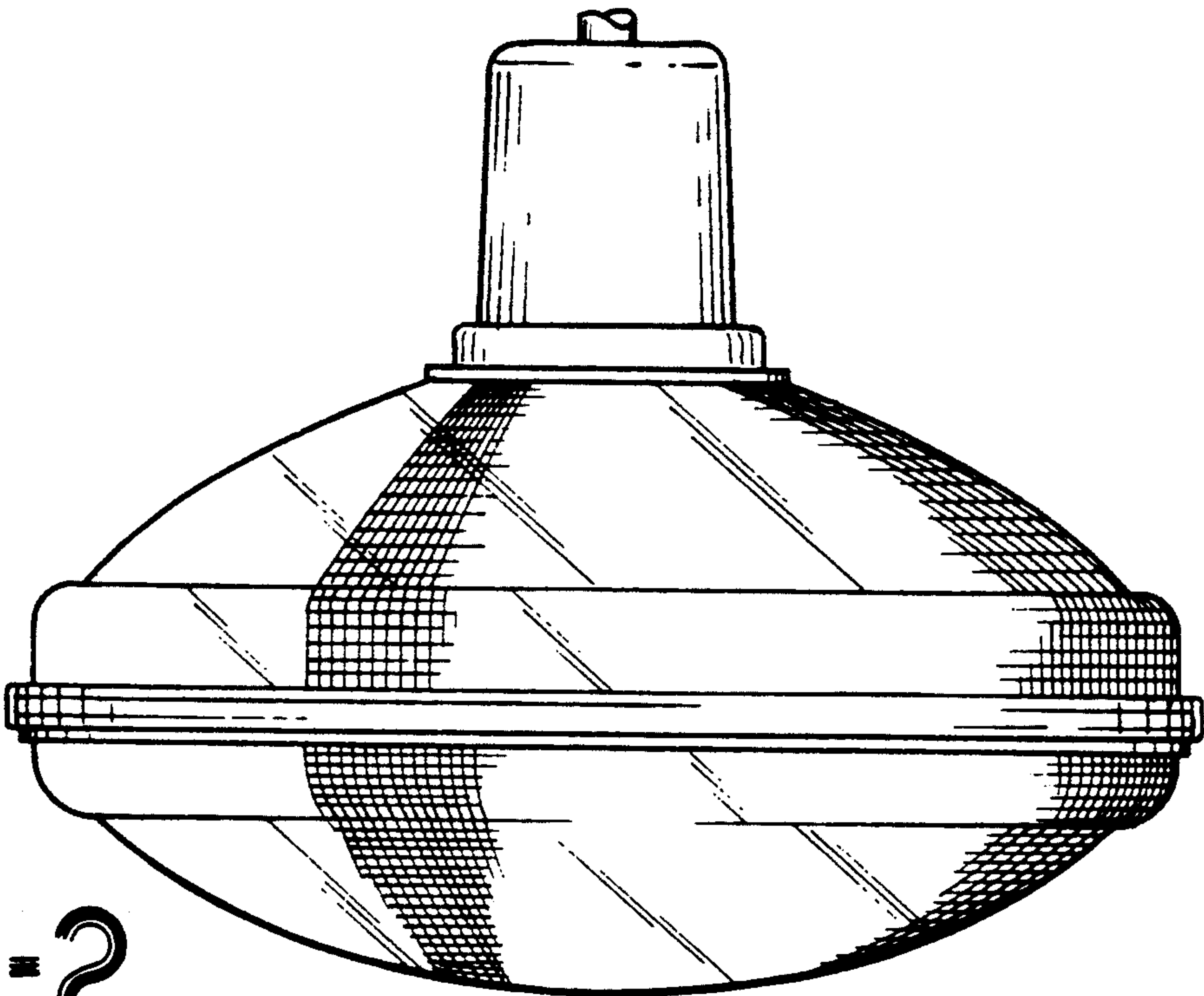

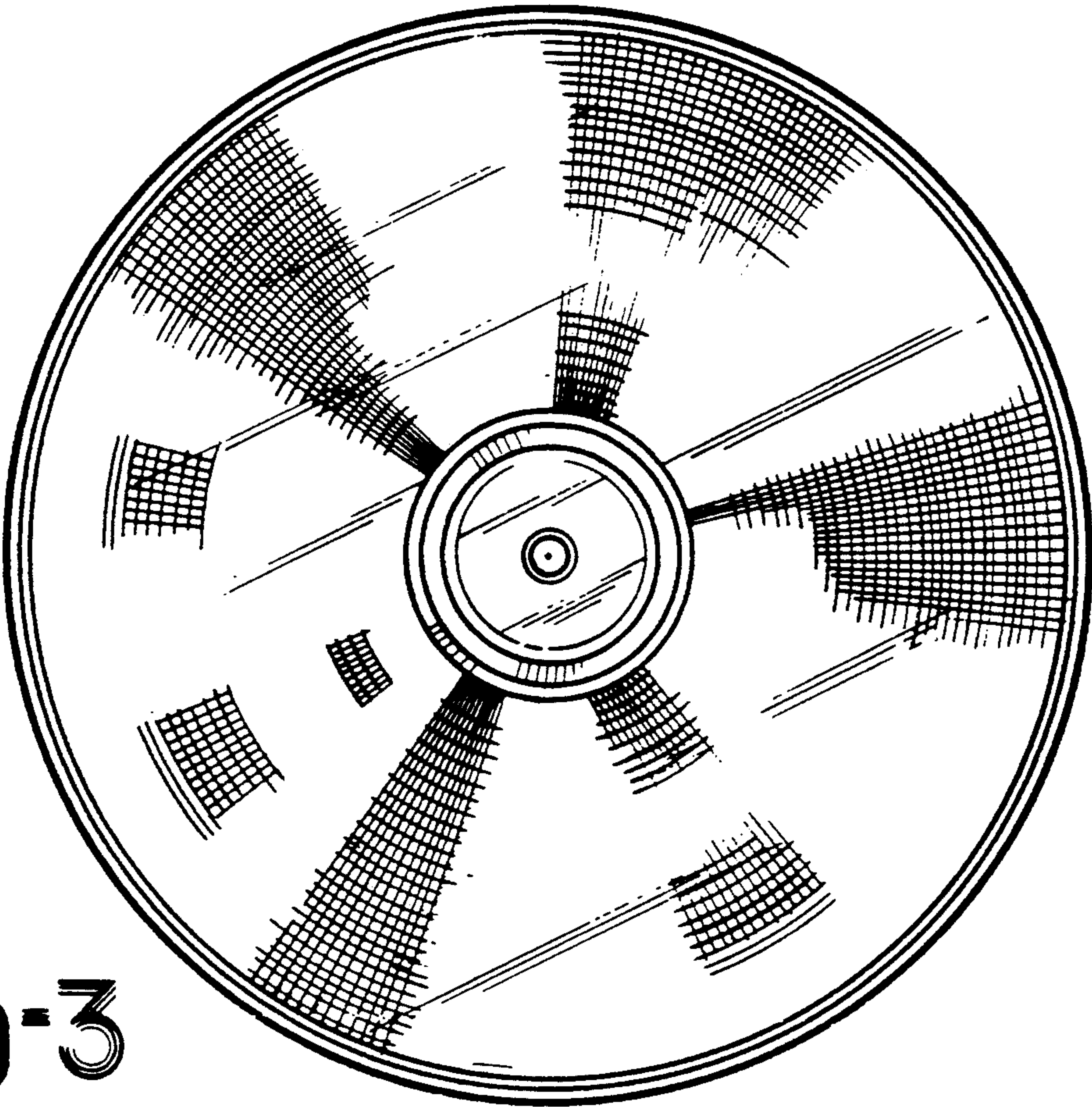
