[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a transponder tag housing for attachment to the ear of an animal, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an enlarged elevation view, showing one side of the transponder tag housing for attachment to the ear of an animal;

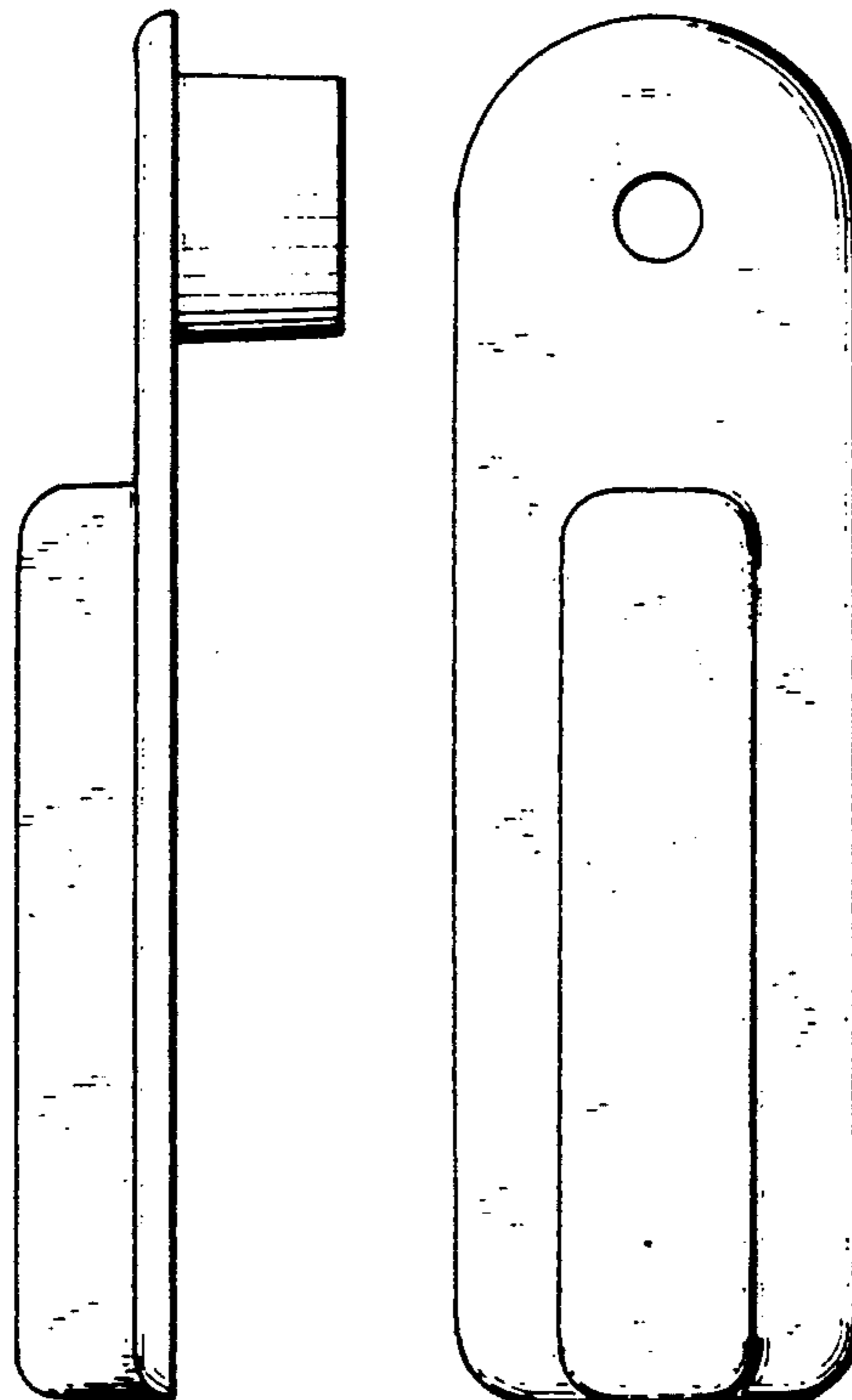
FIG. 2 is an elevation view, showing the front of the transponder tag housing for attachment to the ear of an animal;

FIG. 3 is a elevation view showing the back;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the transponder tag housing for the attachment to the ear of an animal;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the transponder tag housing for attachment to the ear of an animal with an unsealed internal cavity; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the transponder tag housing for attachment to the ear of an animal with the sealed internal cavity.



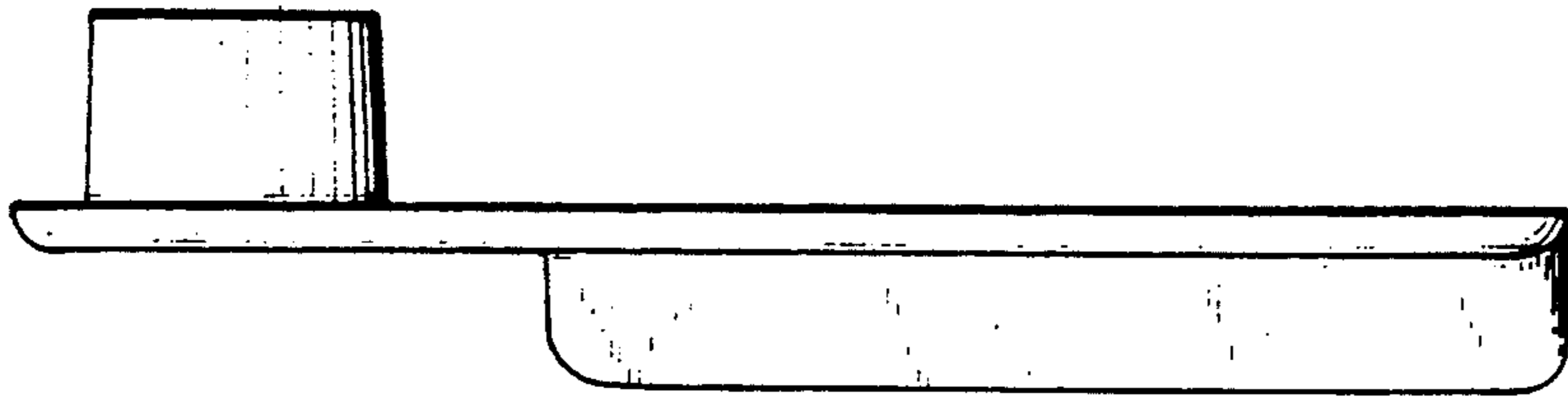

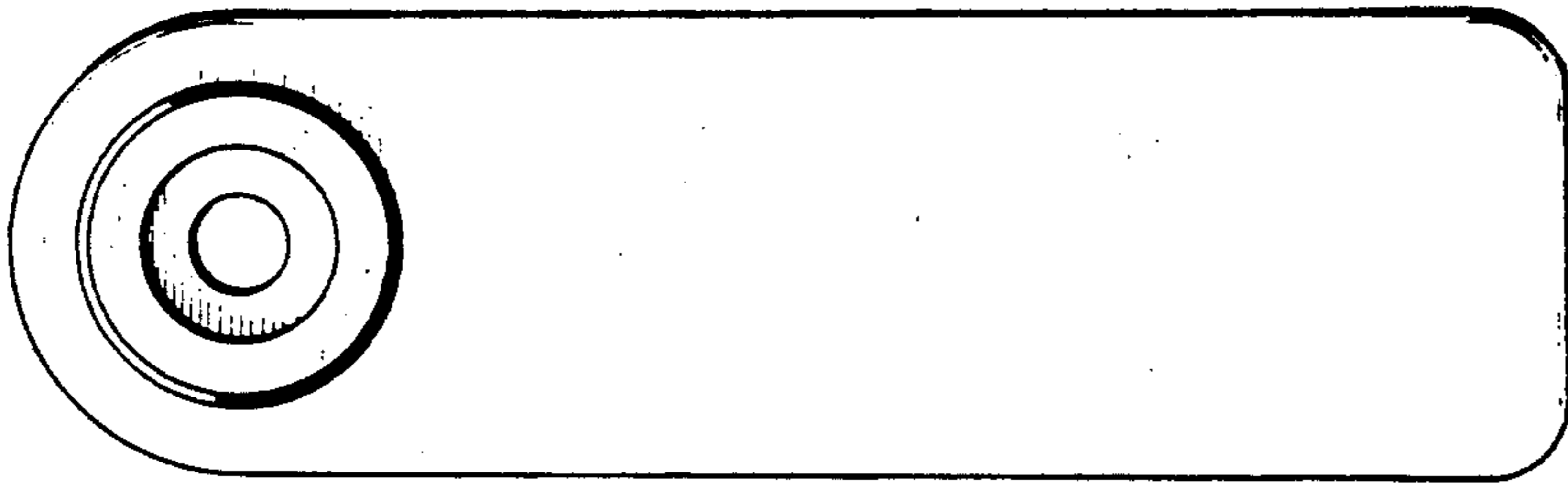

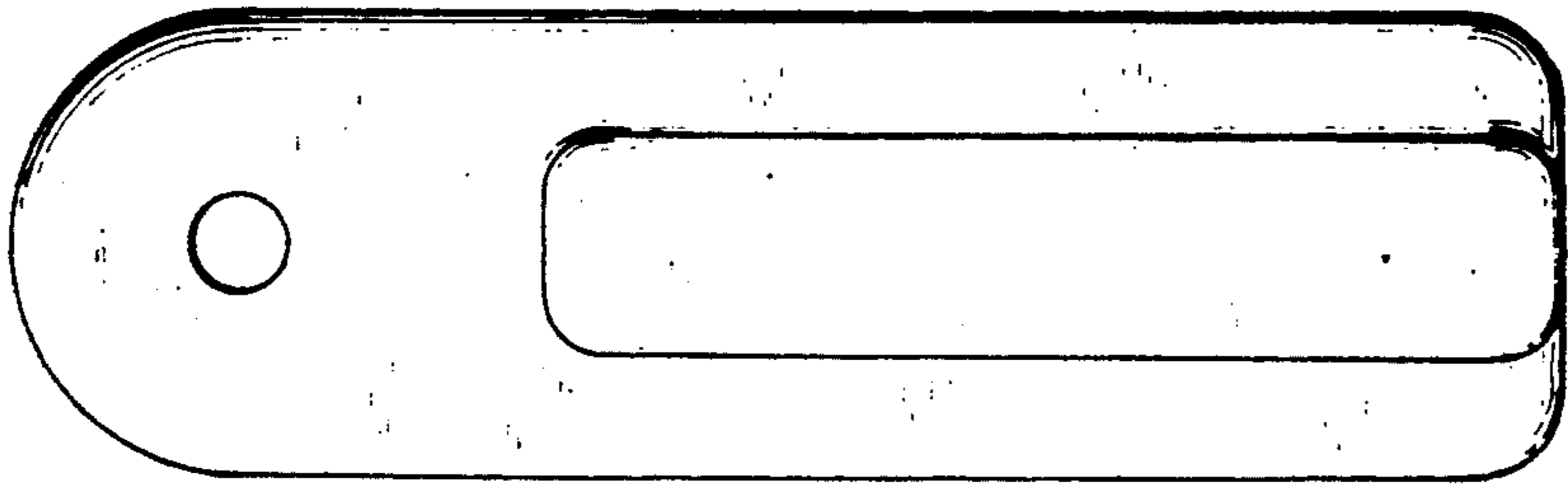

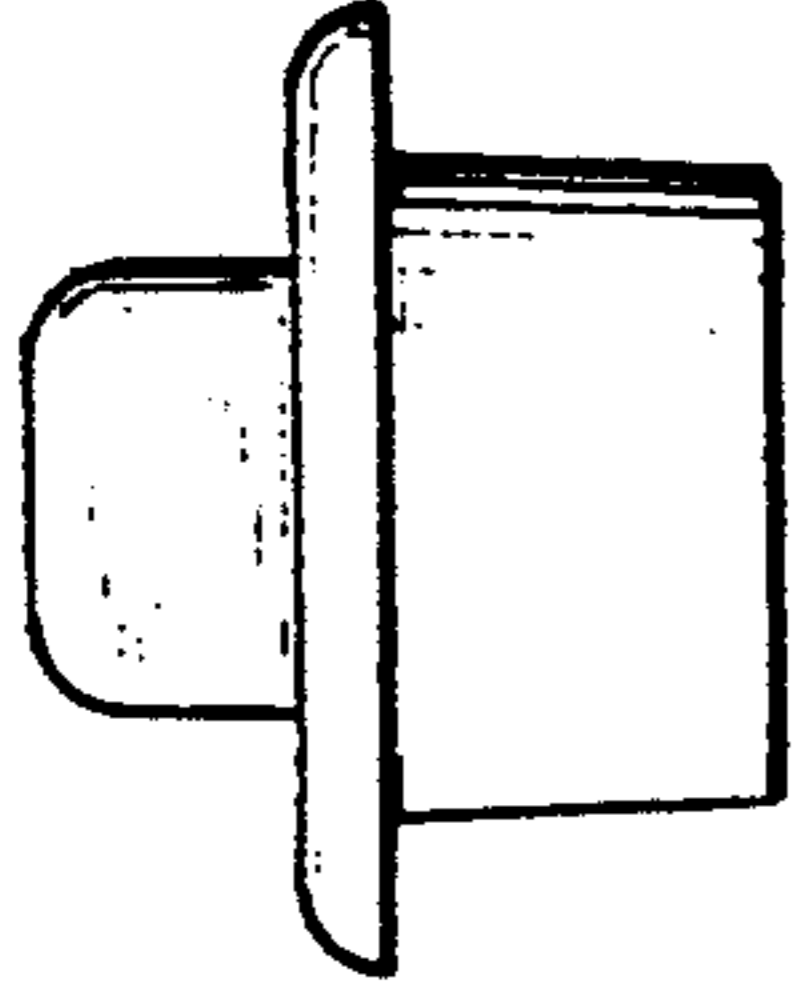

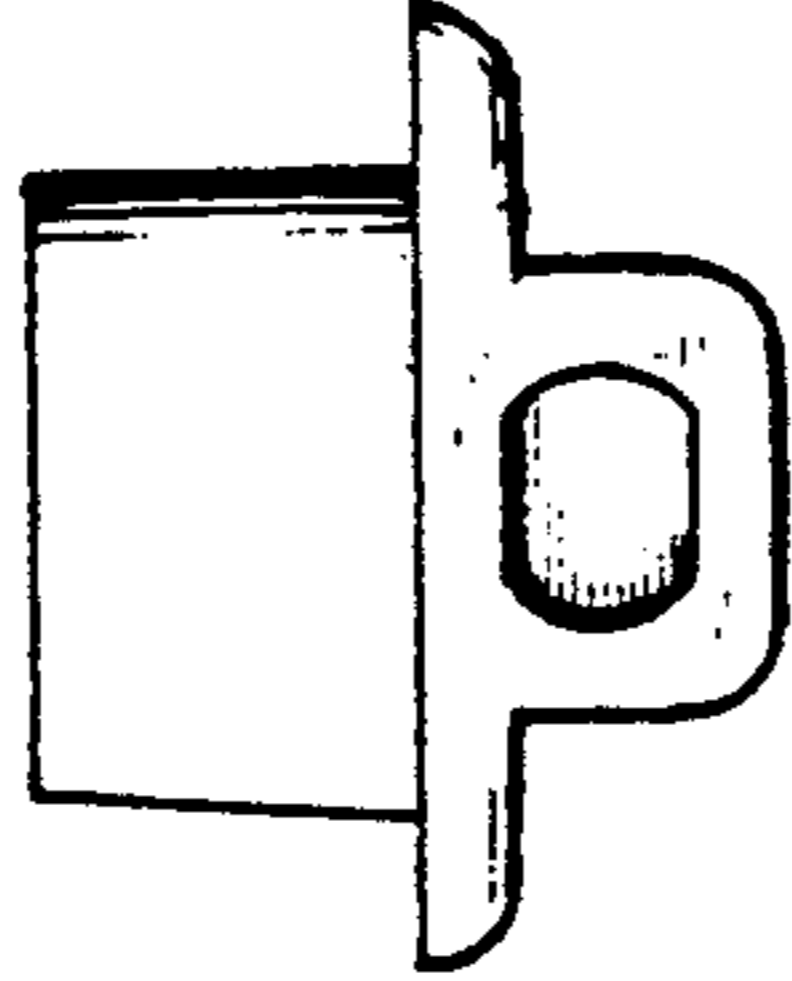

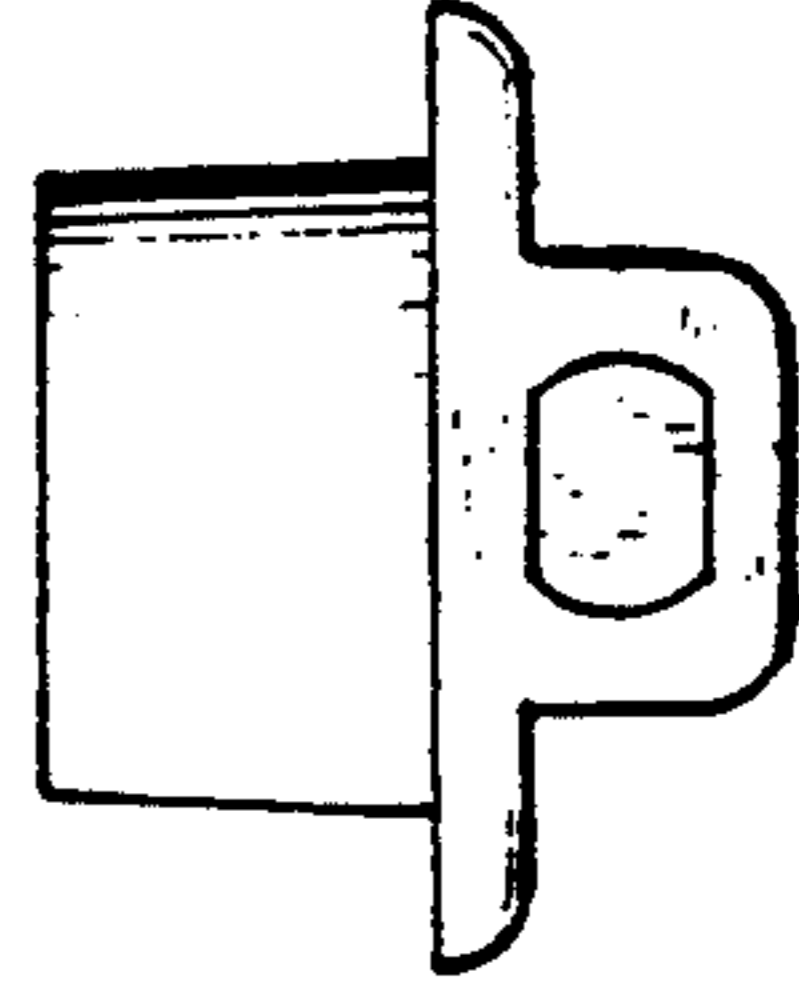
