FIG. 13 is an elevation of the other side thereof;

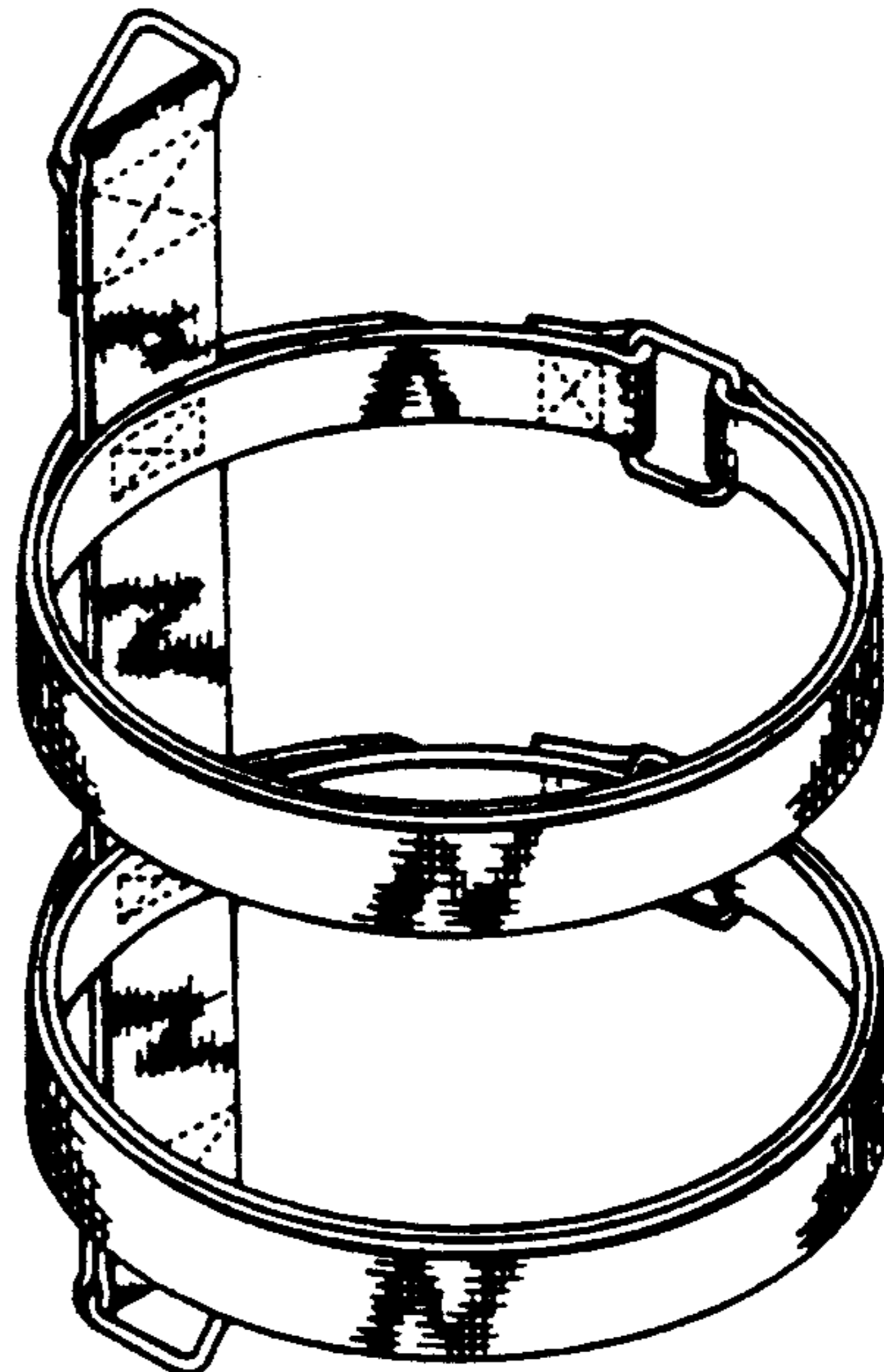
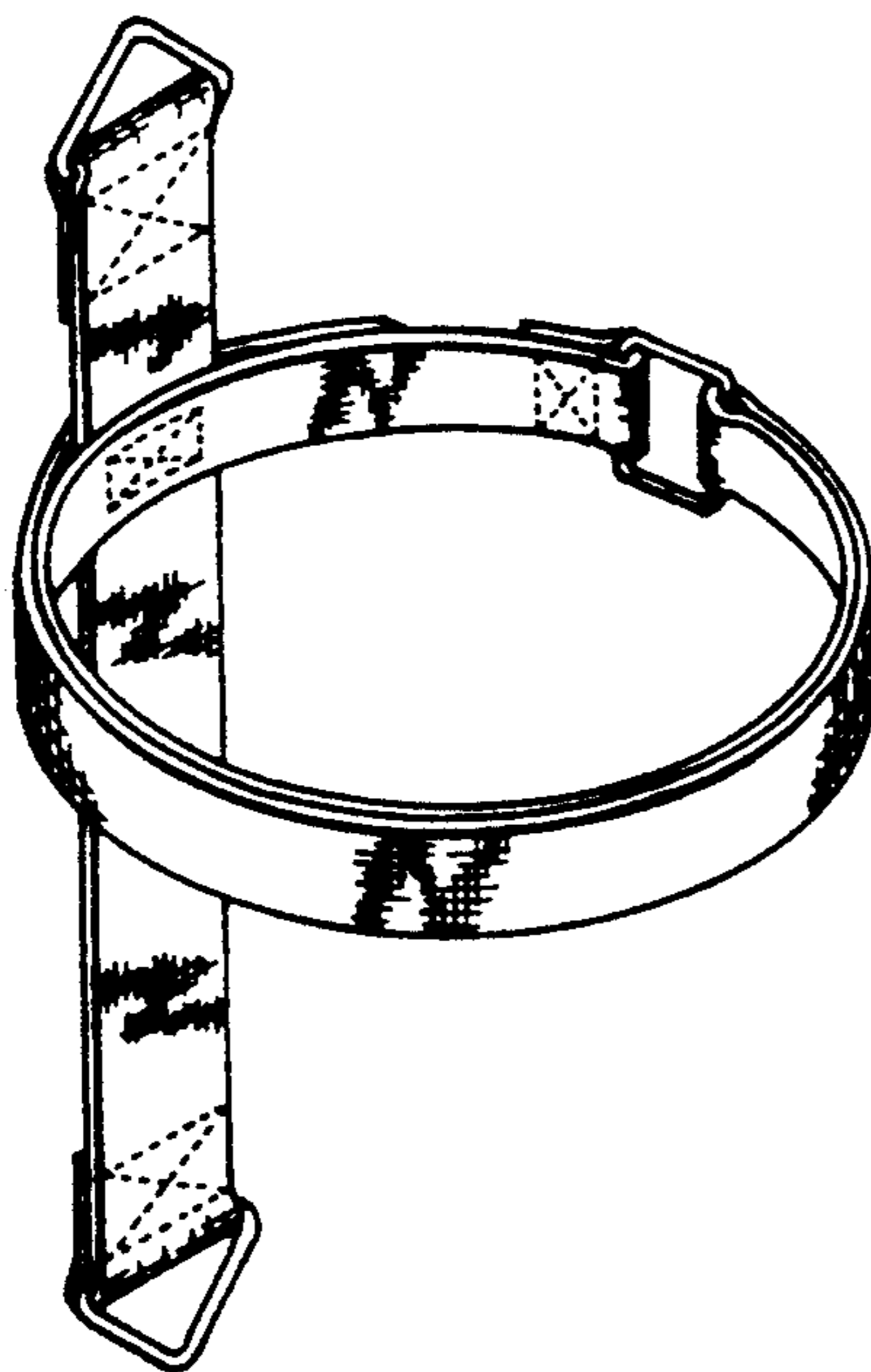
FIG. 14 is a top plan thereof, the bottom plan being a mirror image;

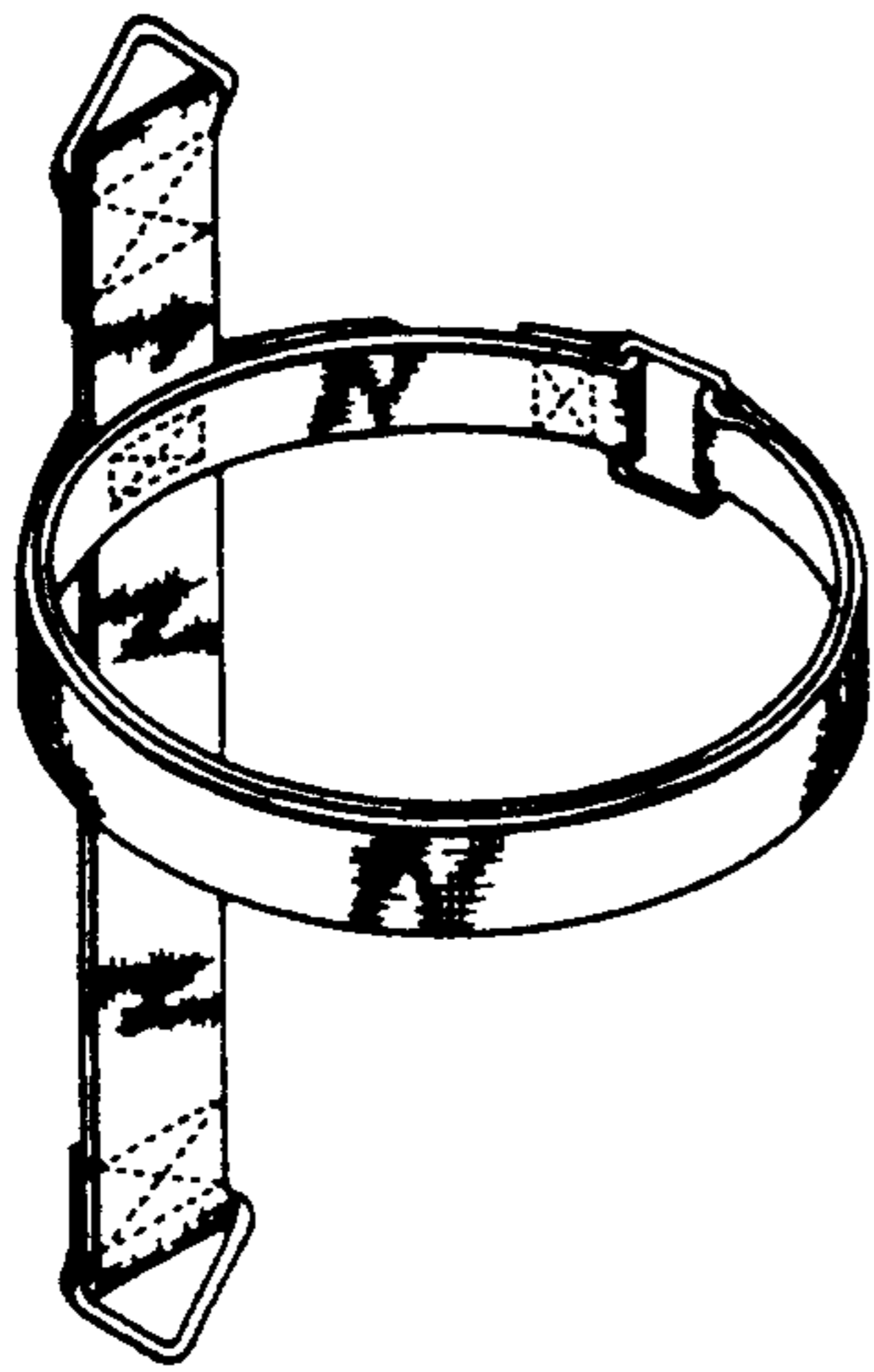

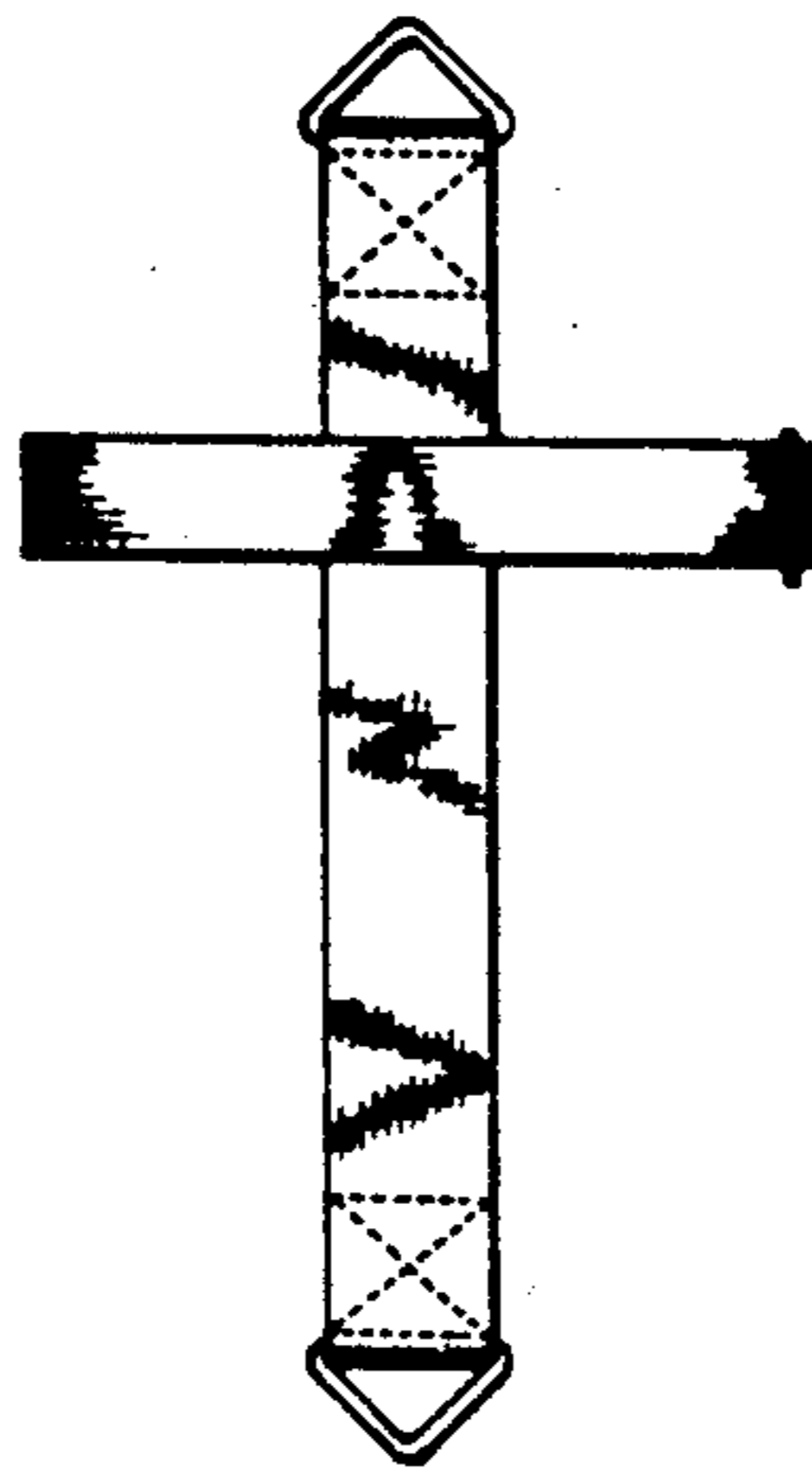

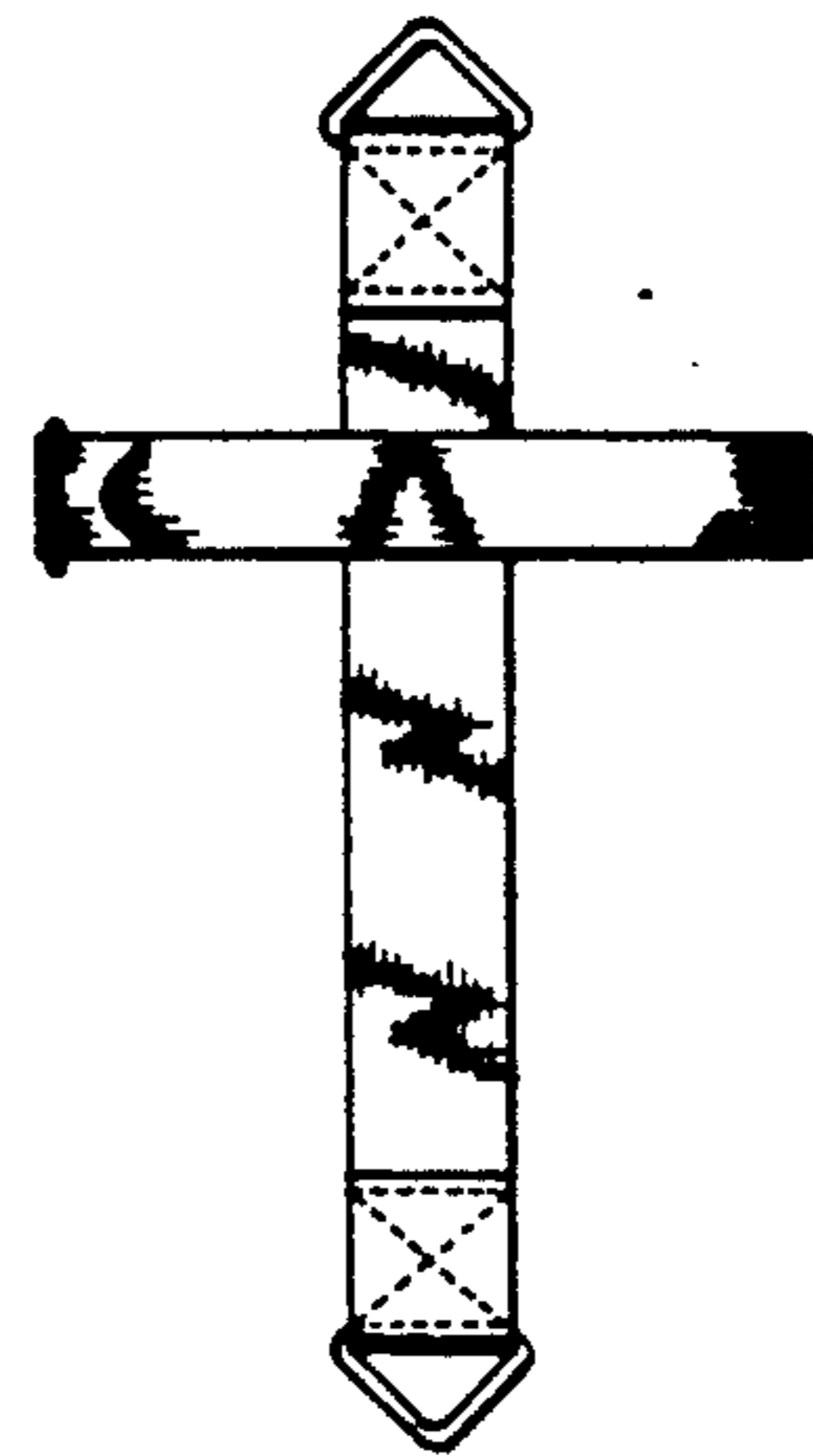

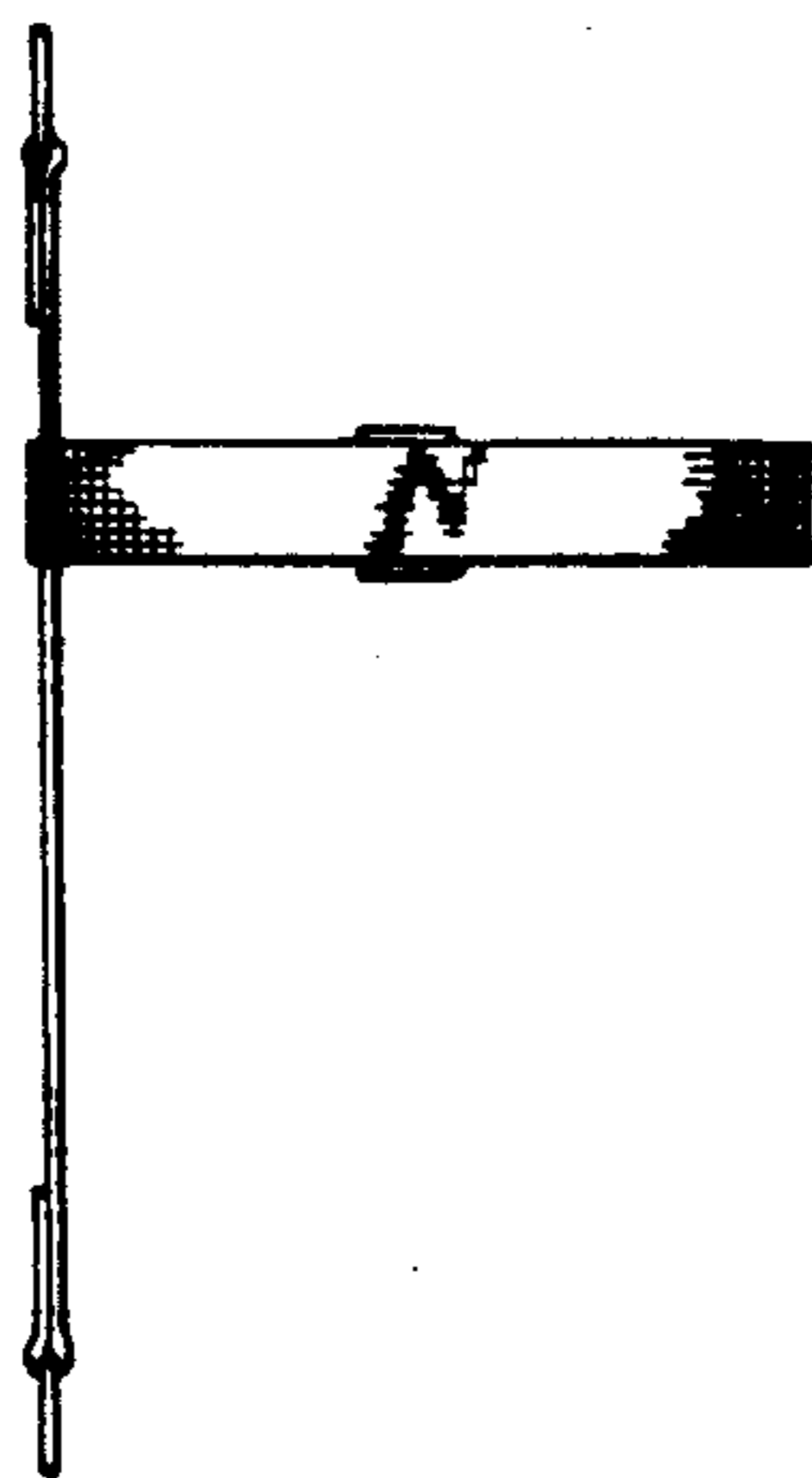

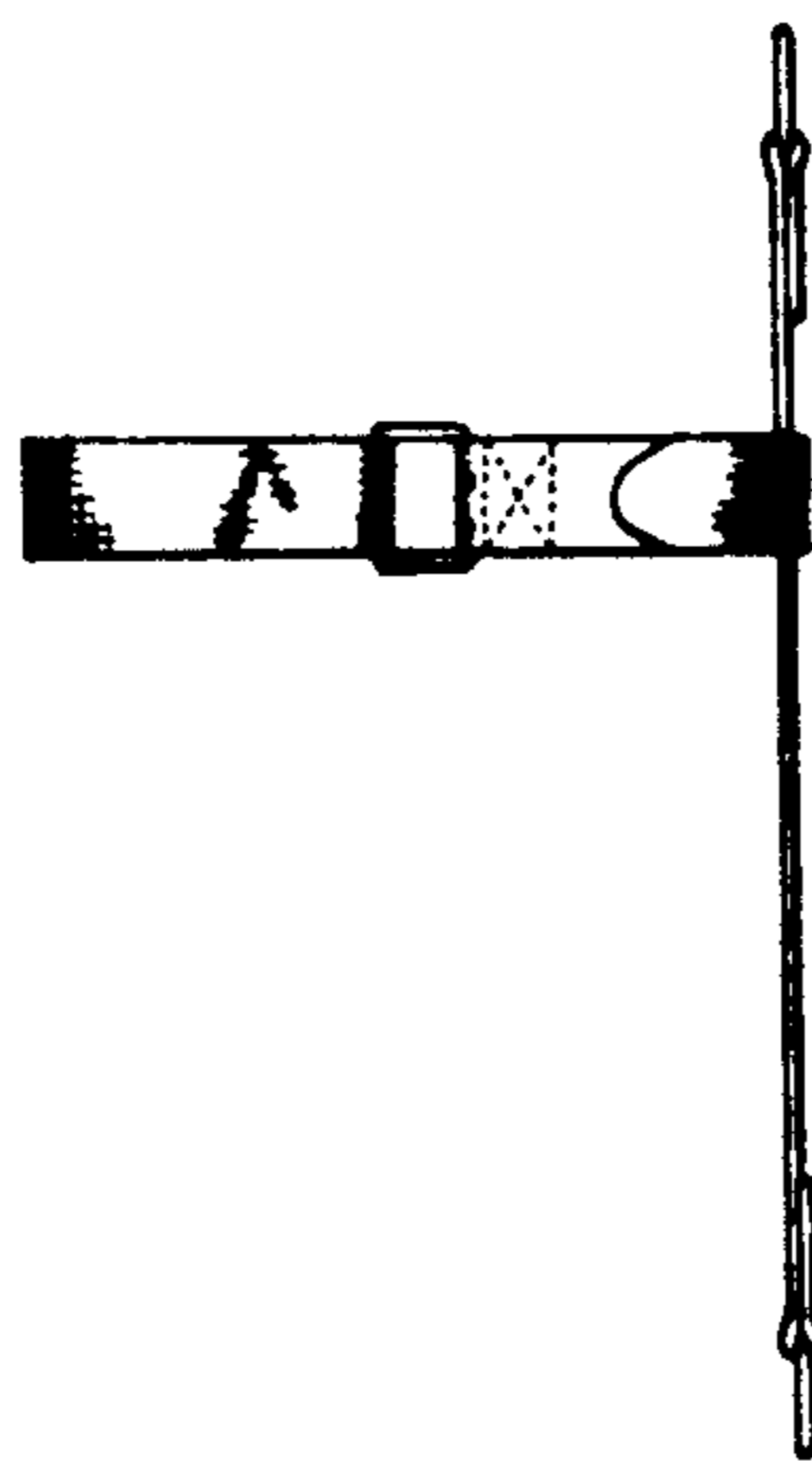

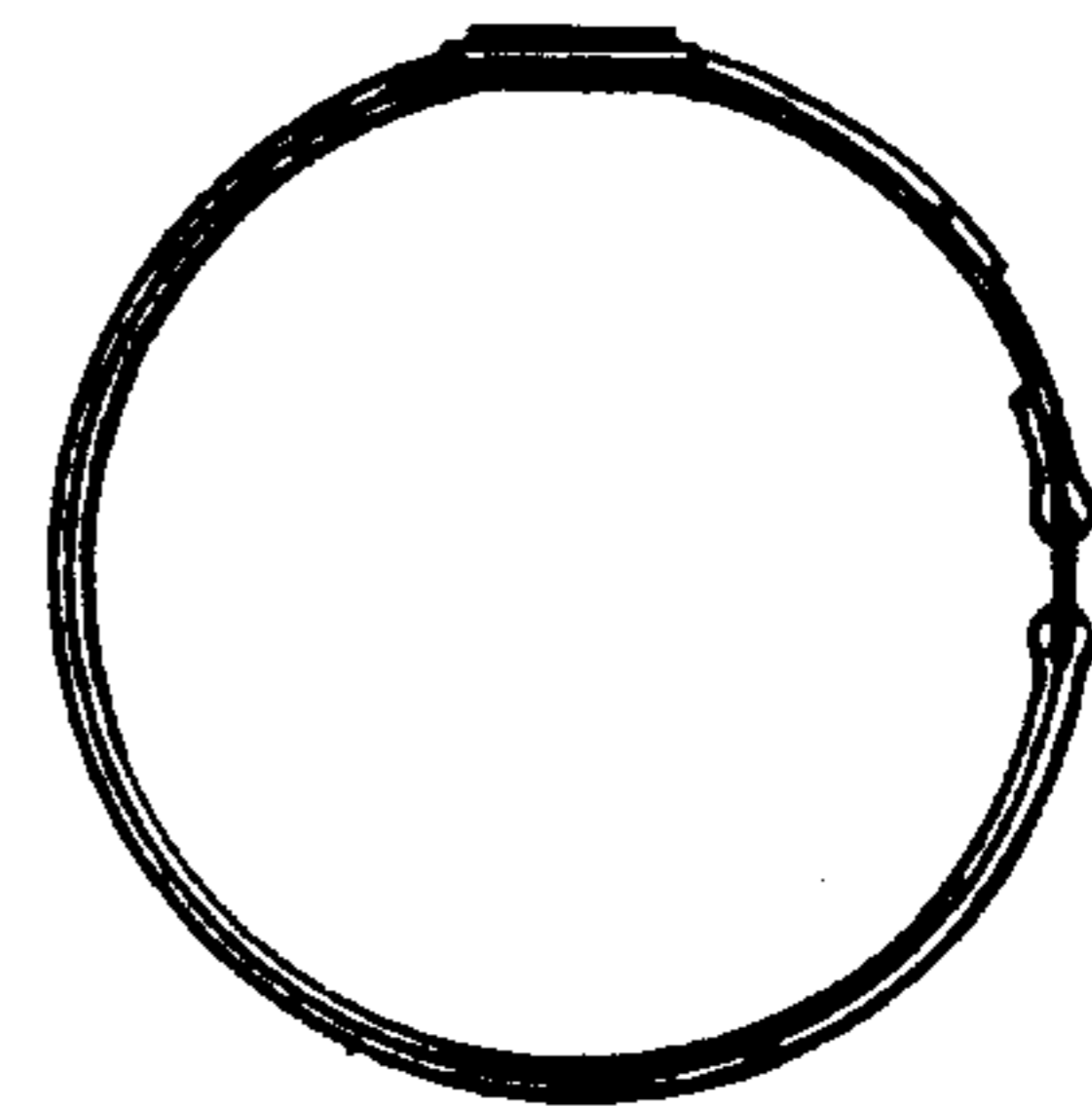

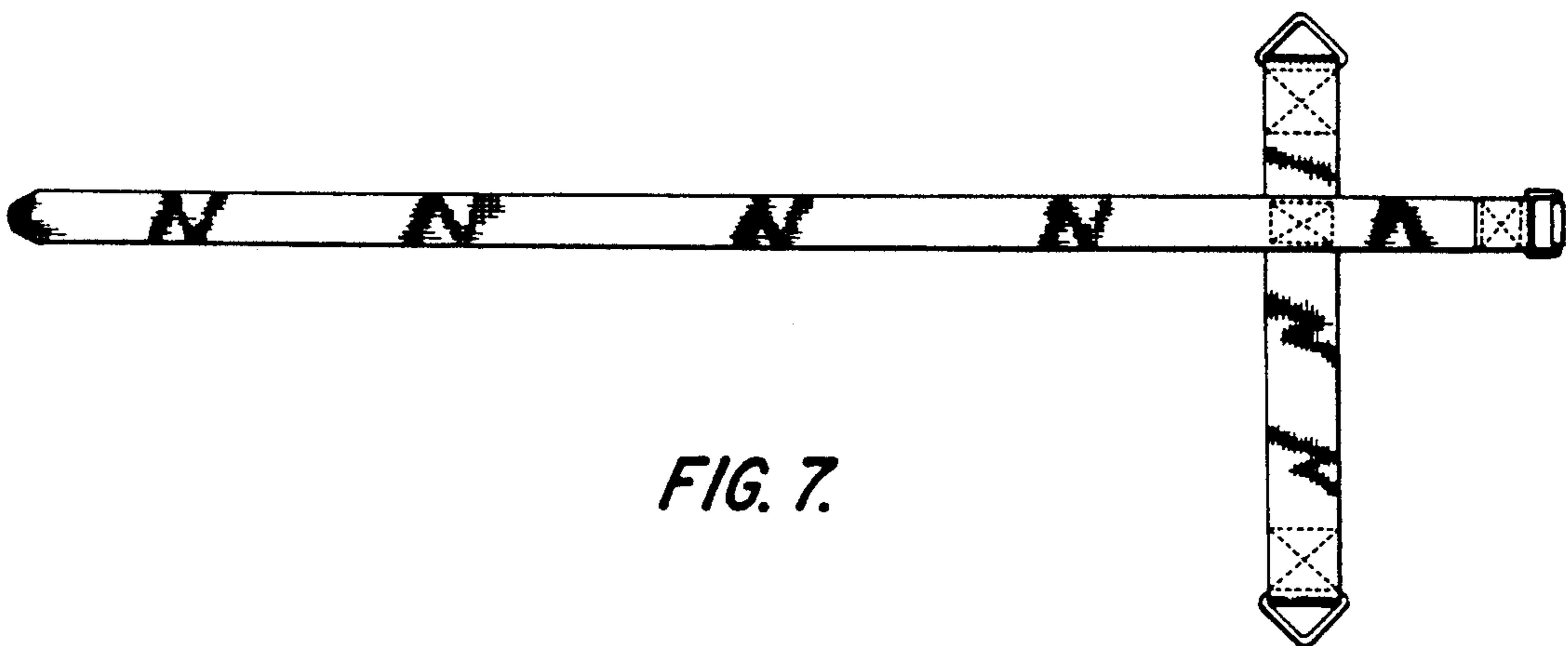

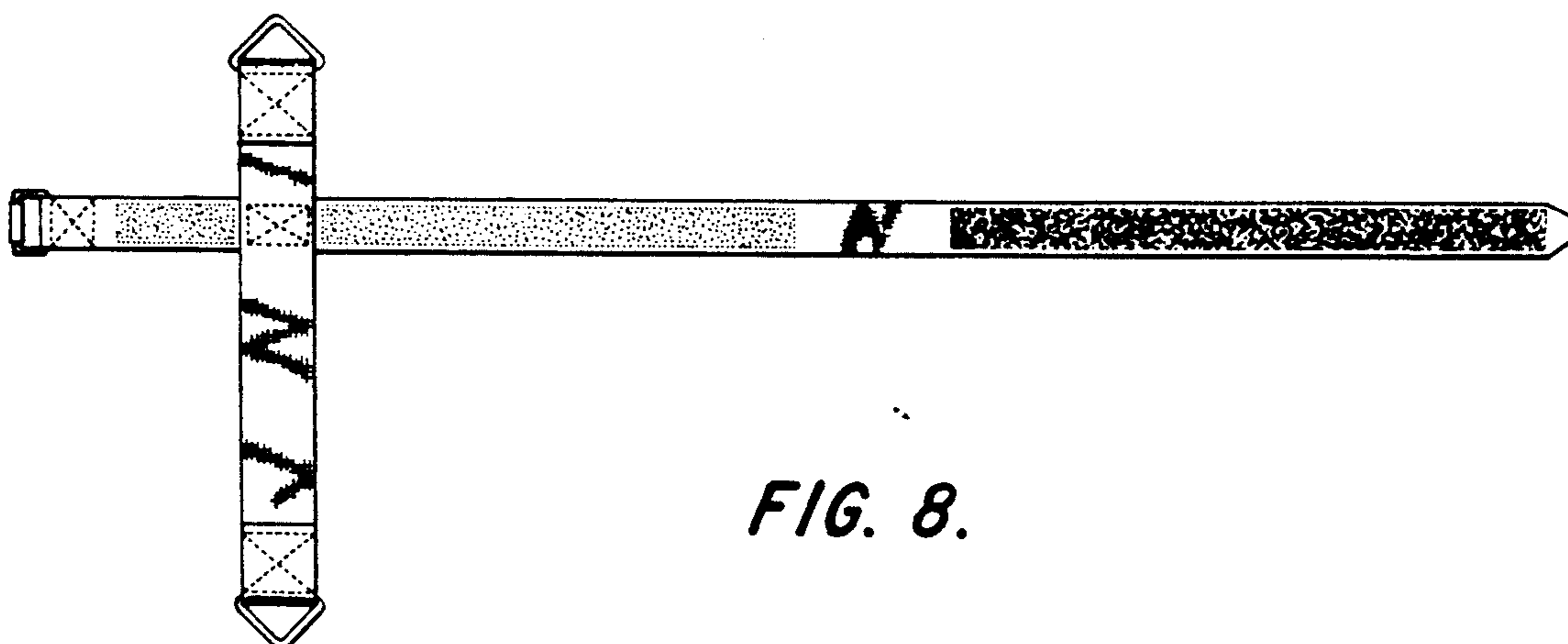

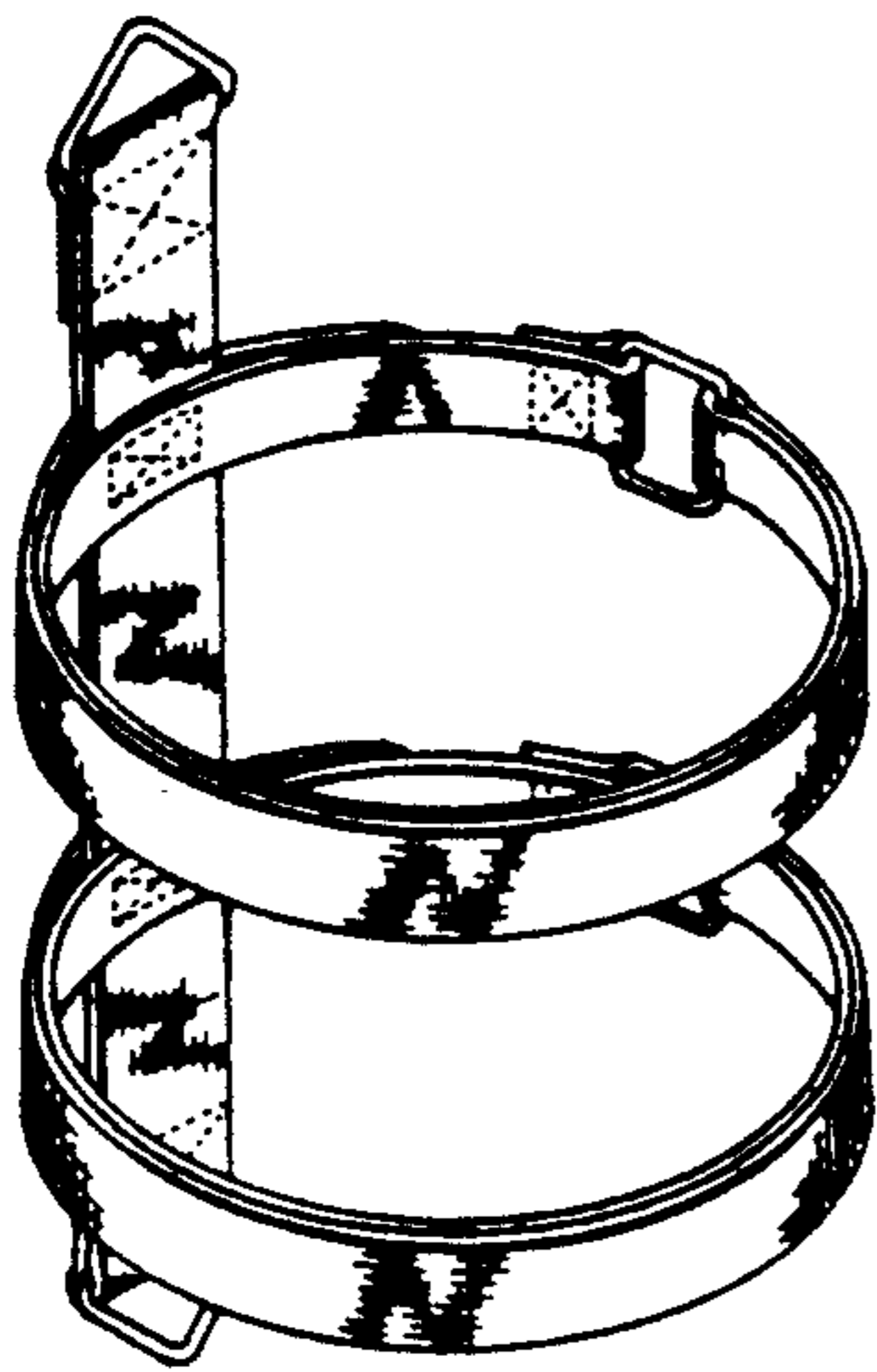

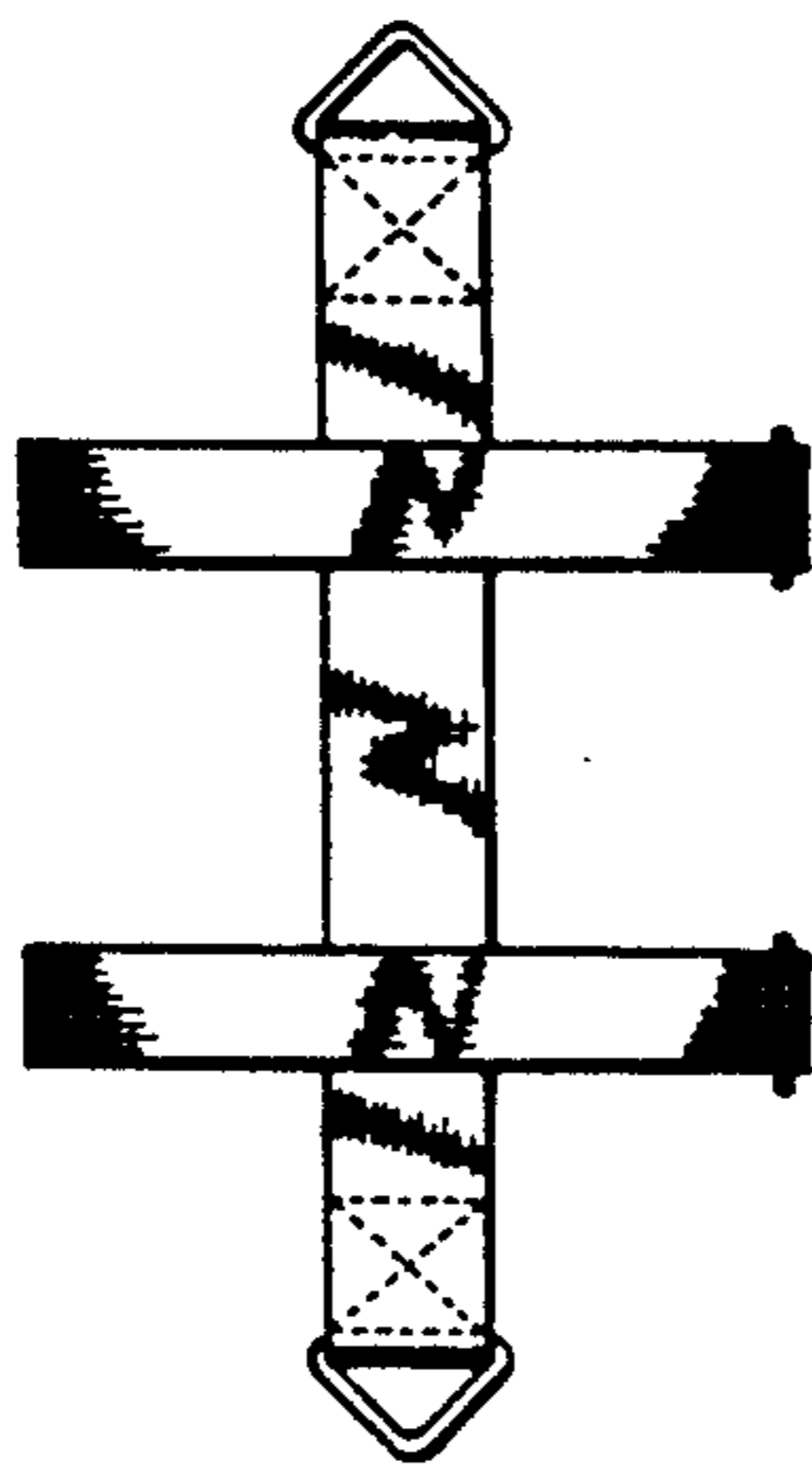

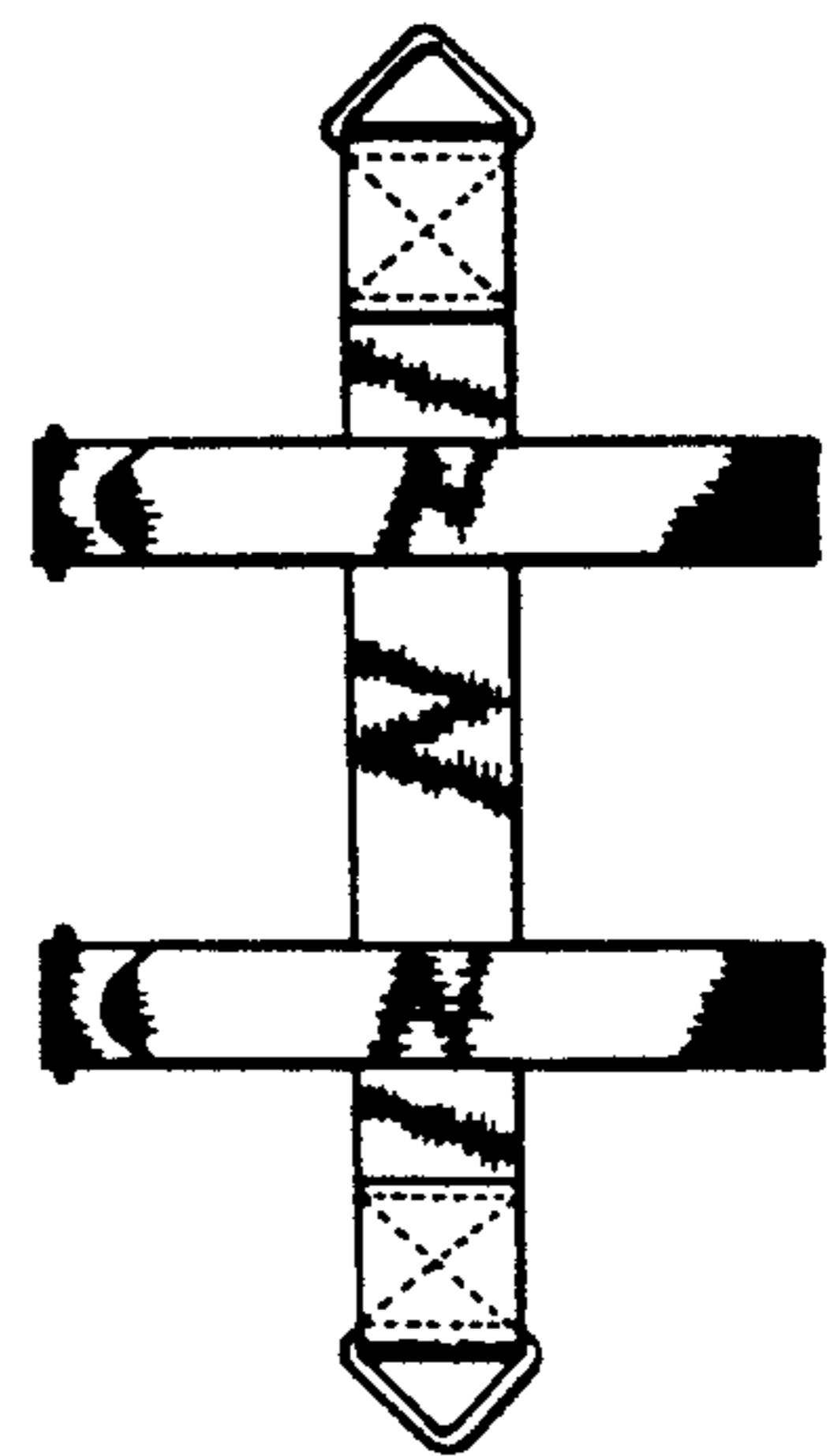

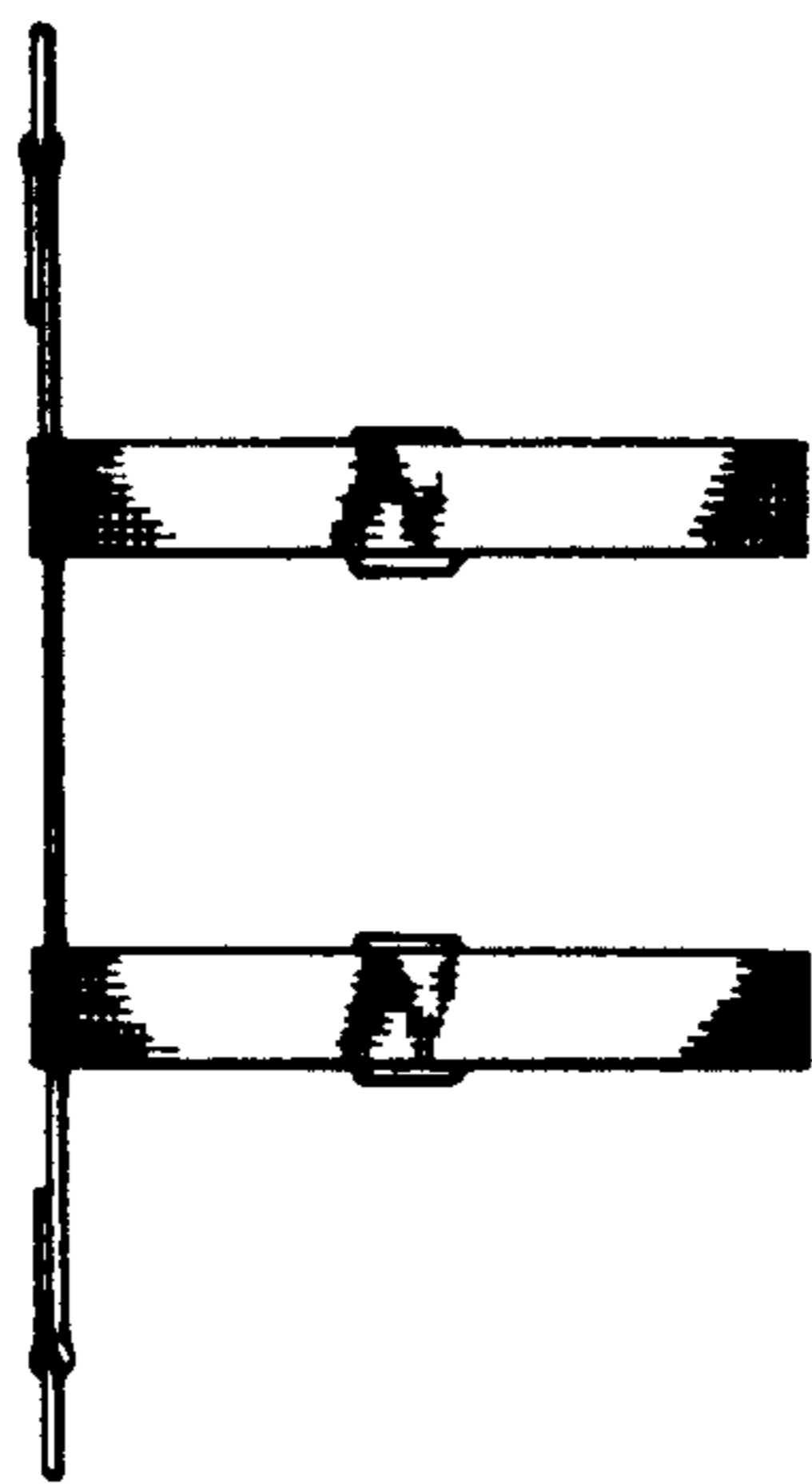

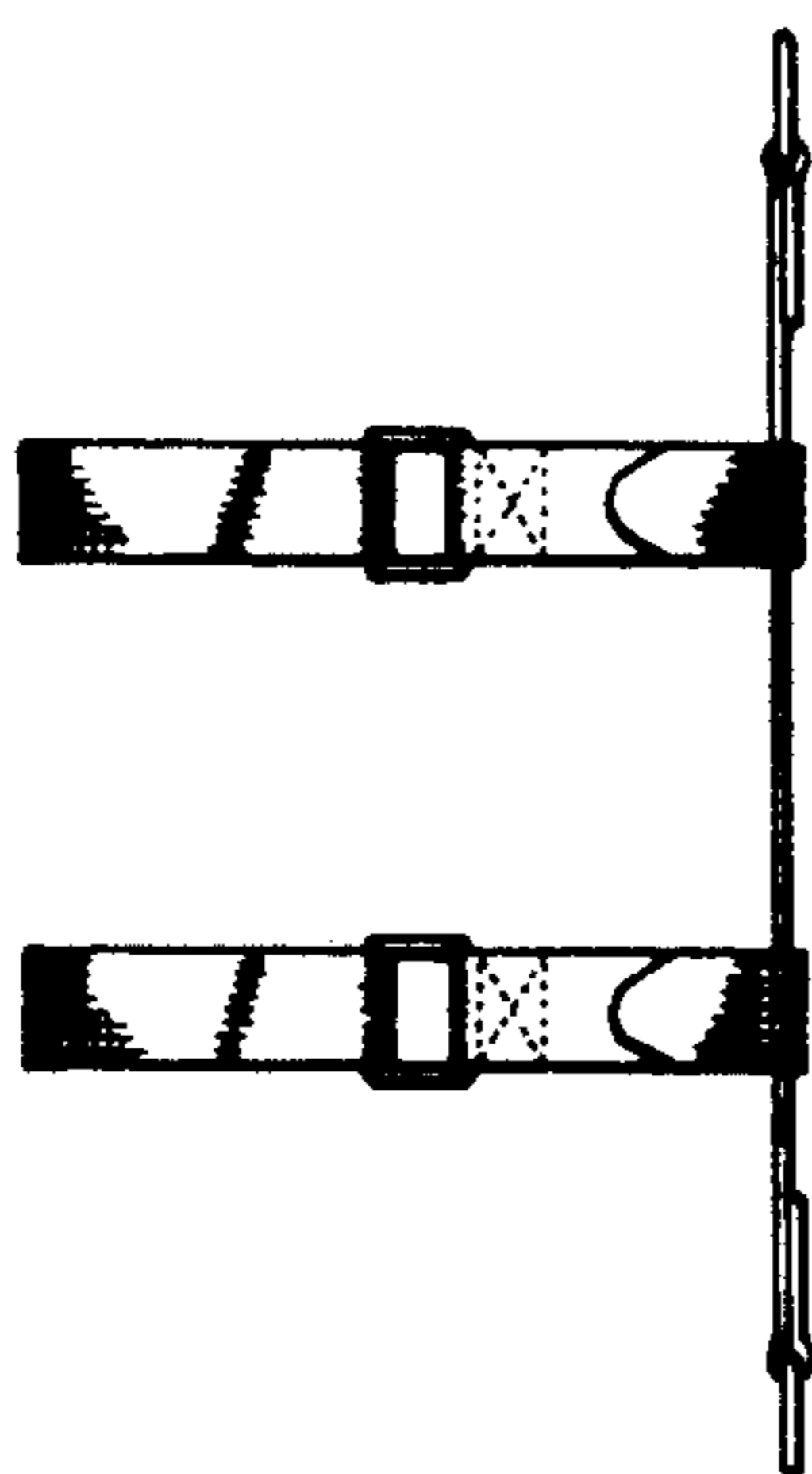

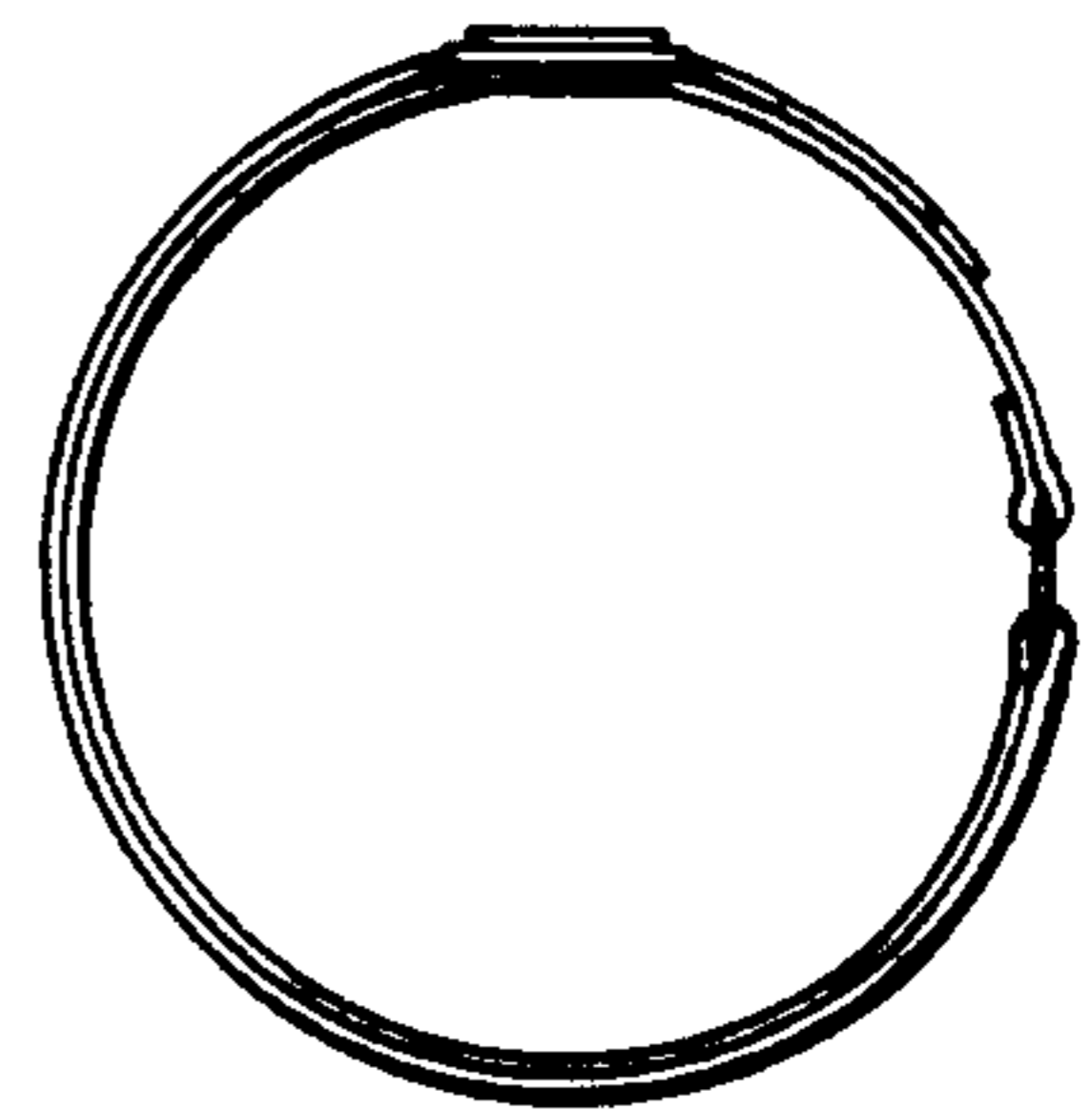

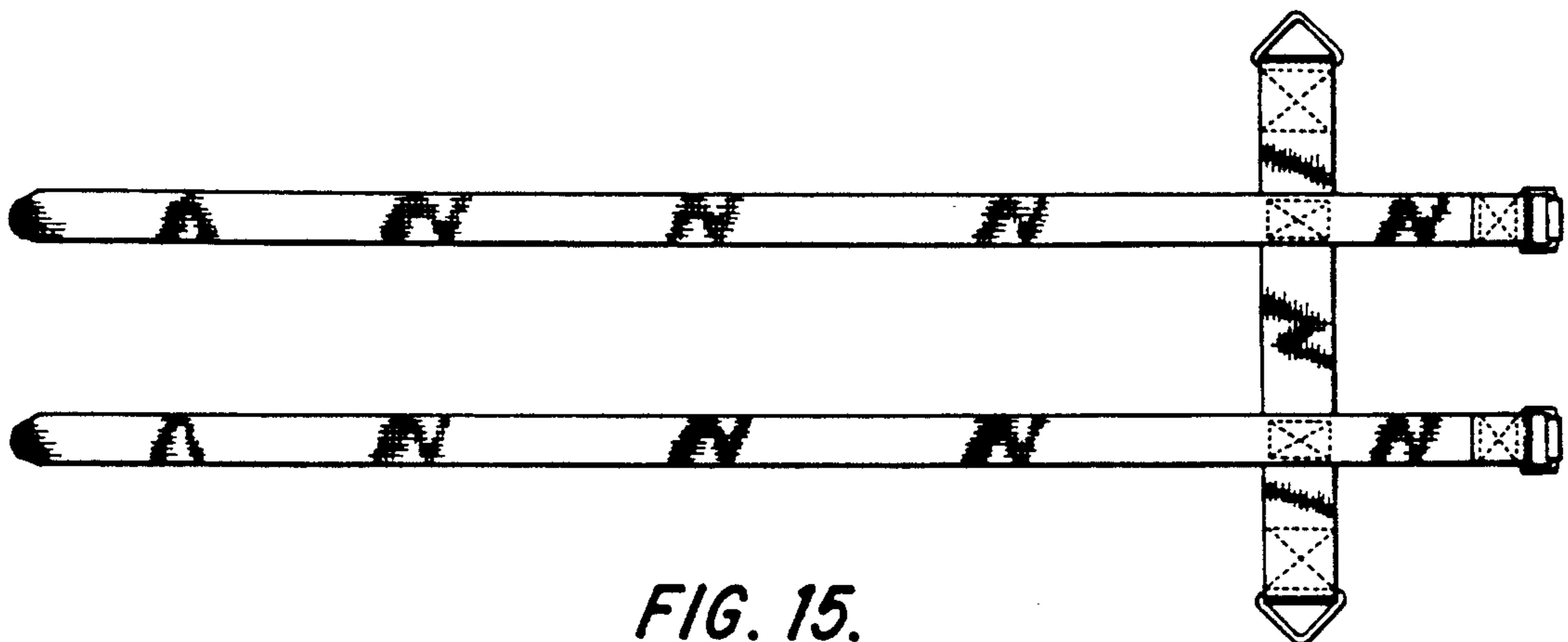

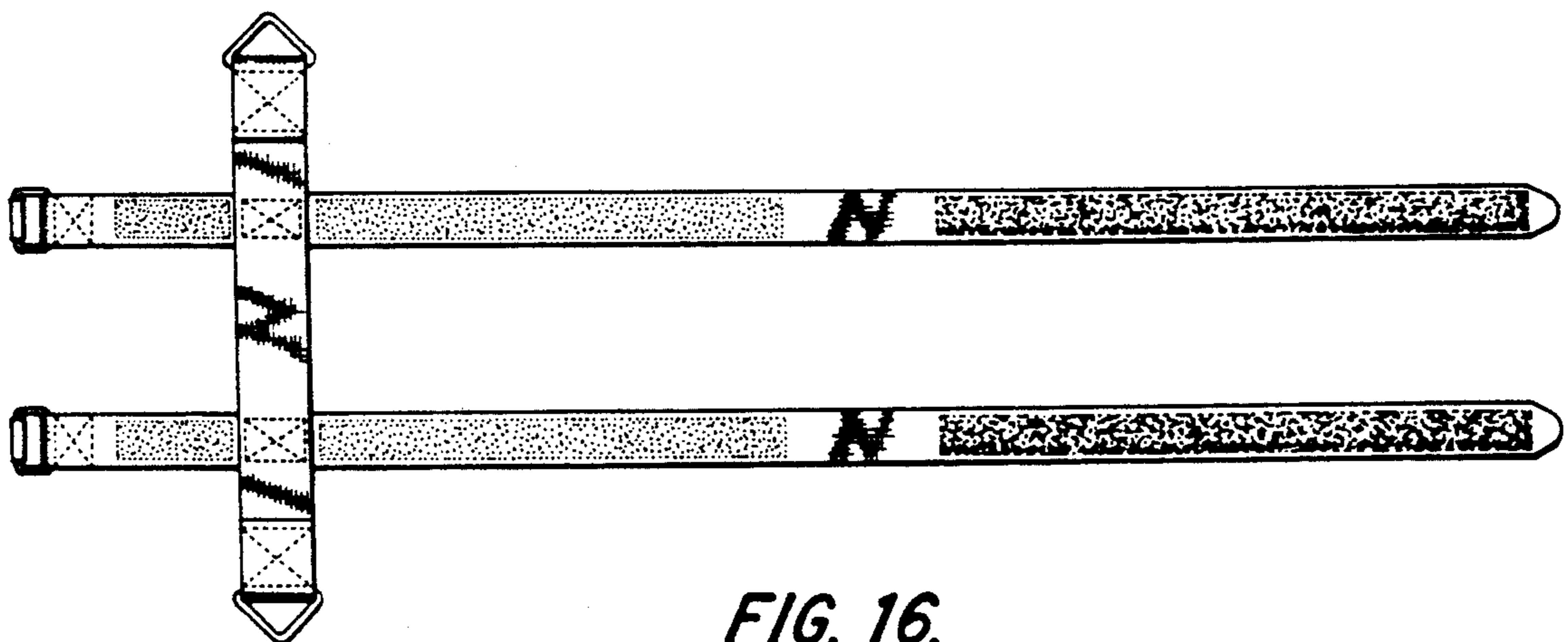
