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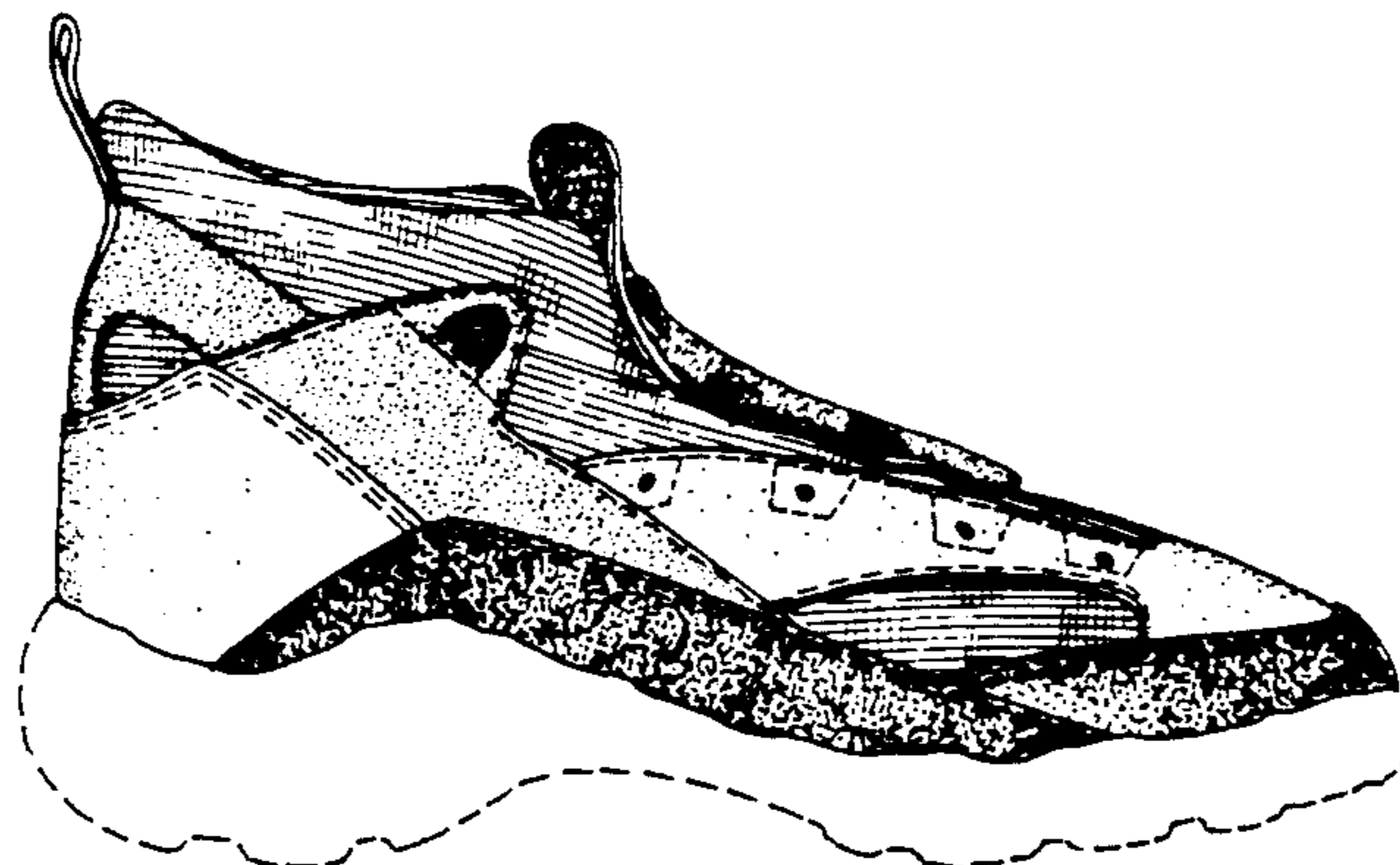
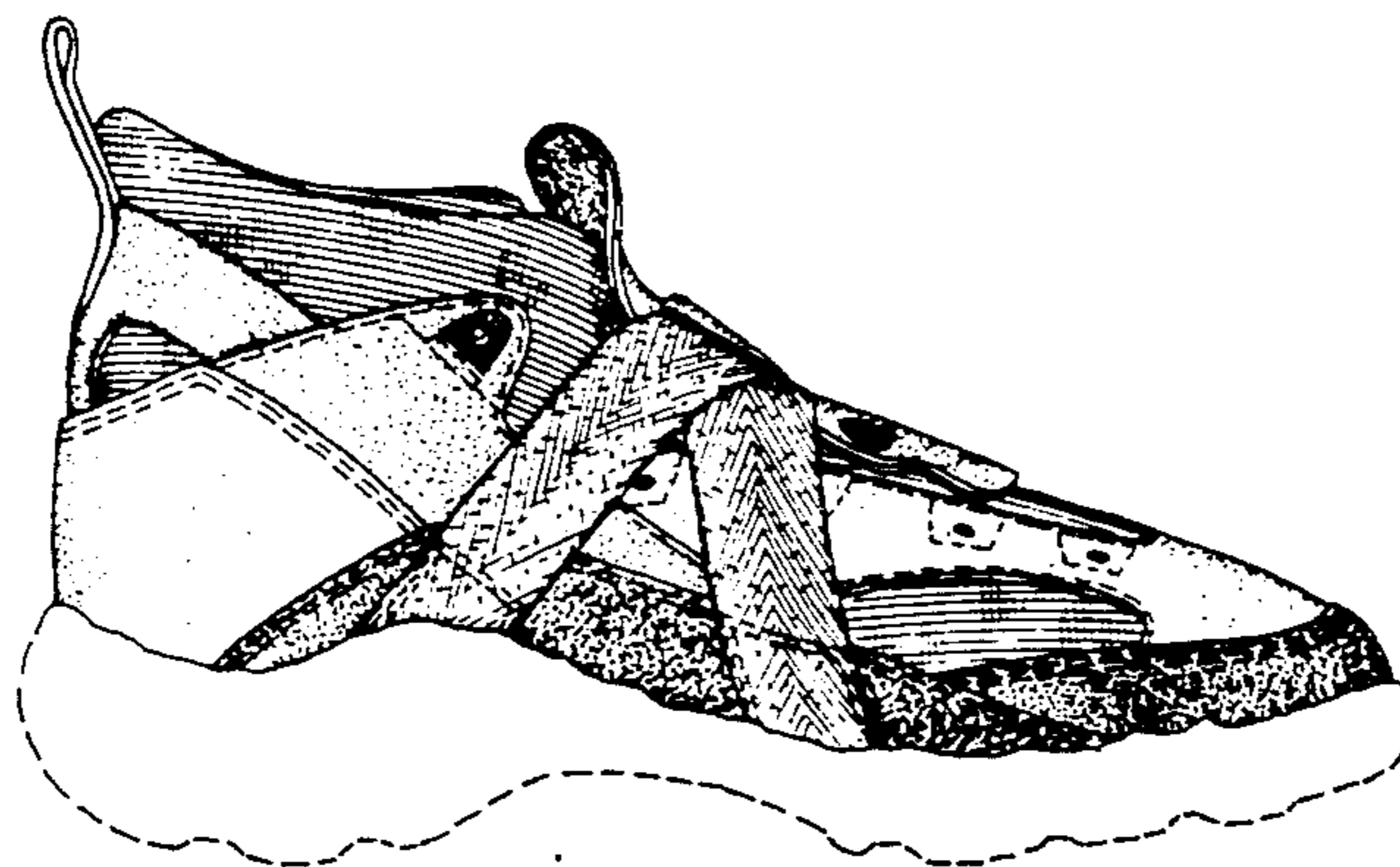

DESCRIPTION

 The broken line showing of a shoe sole in the FIGS. is environmental only and forms no part of the claimed design.



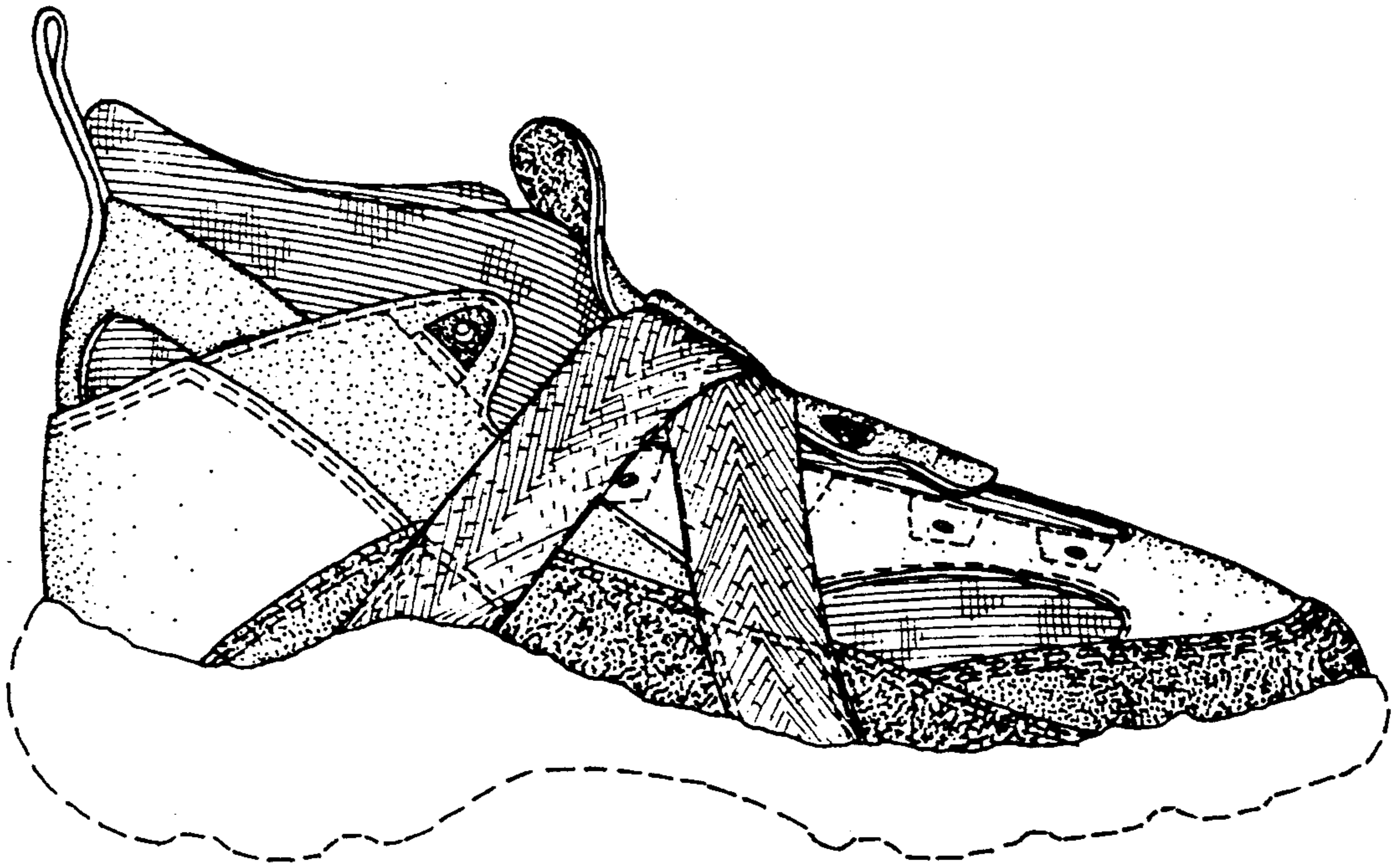

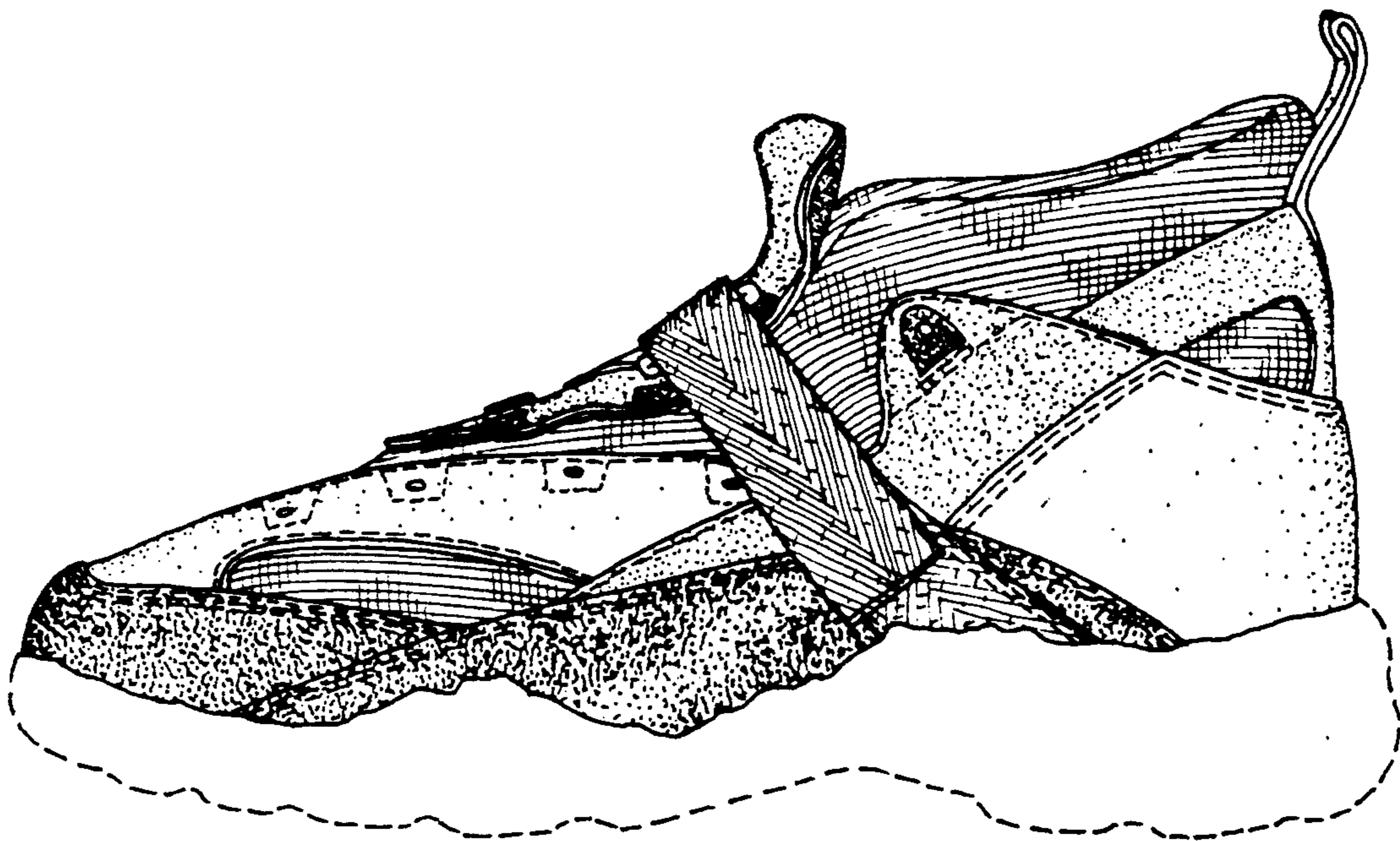

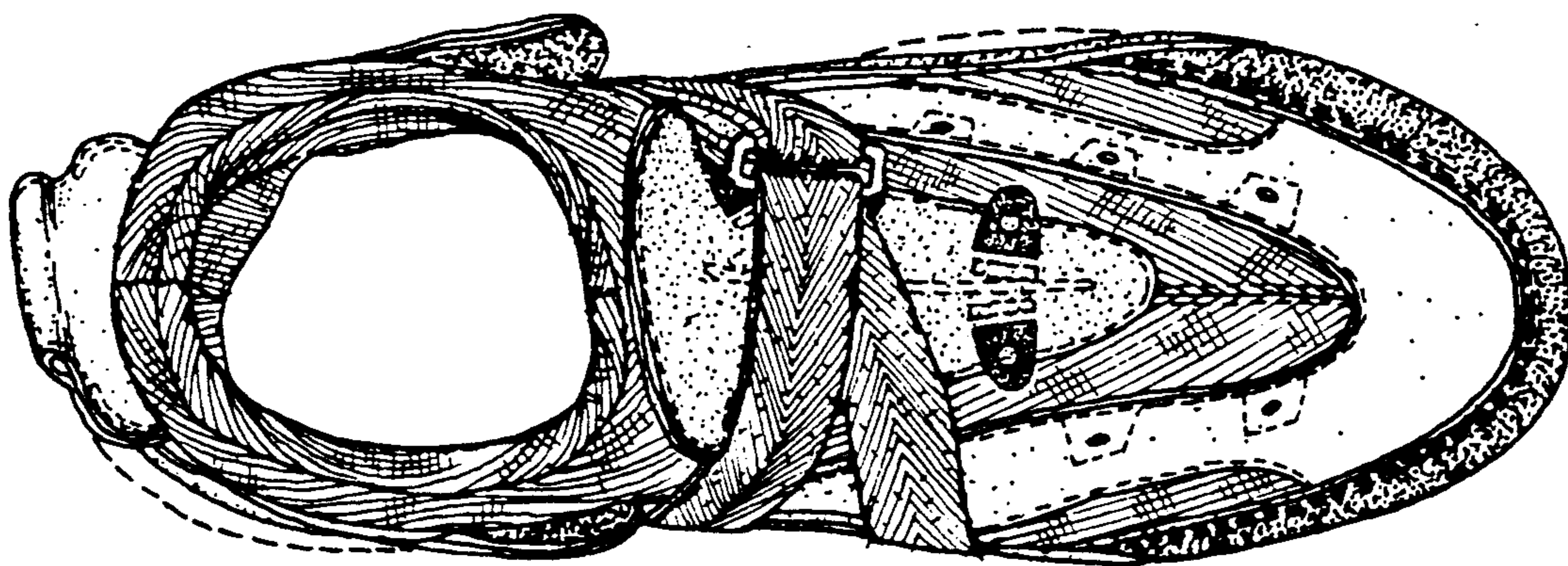

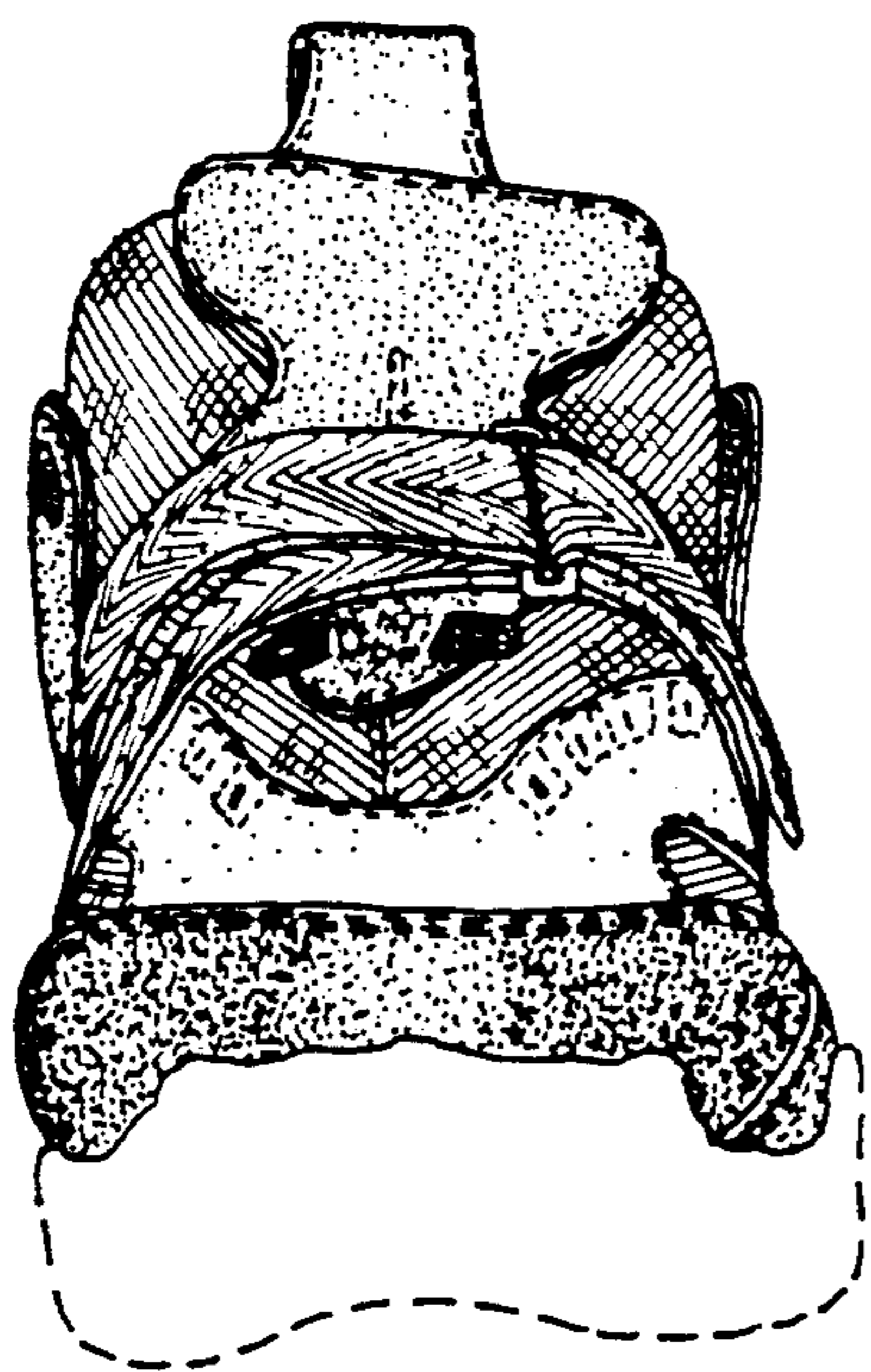

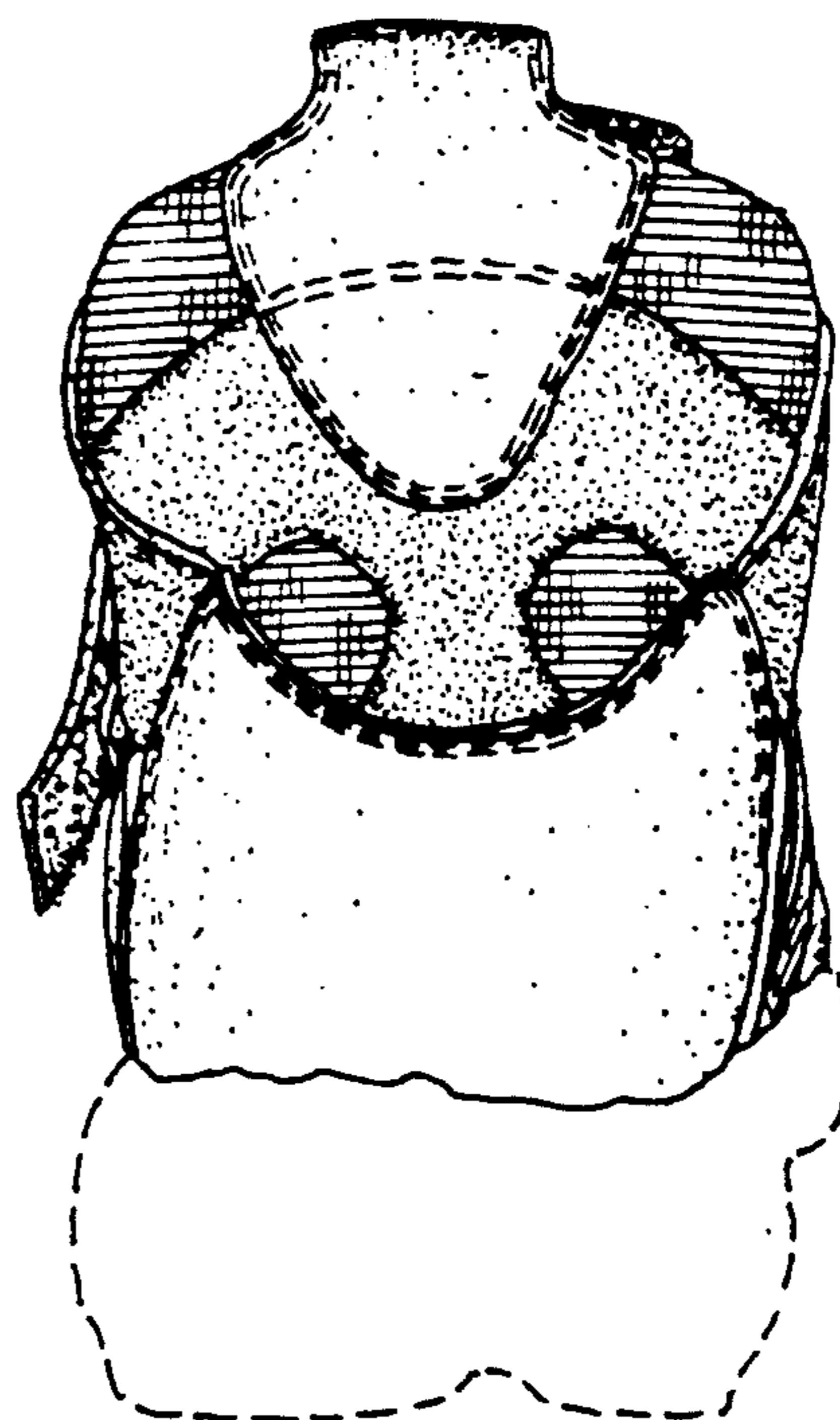

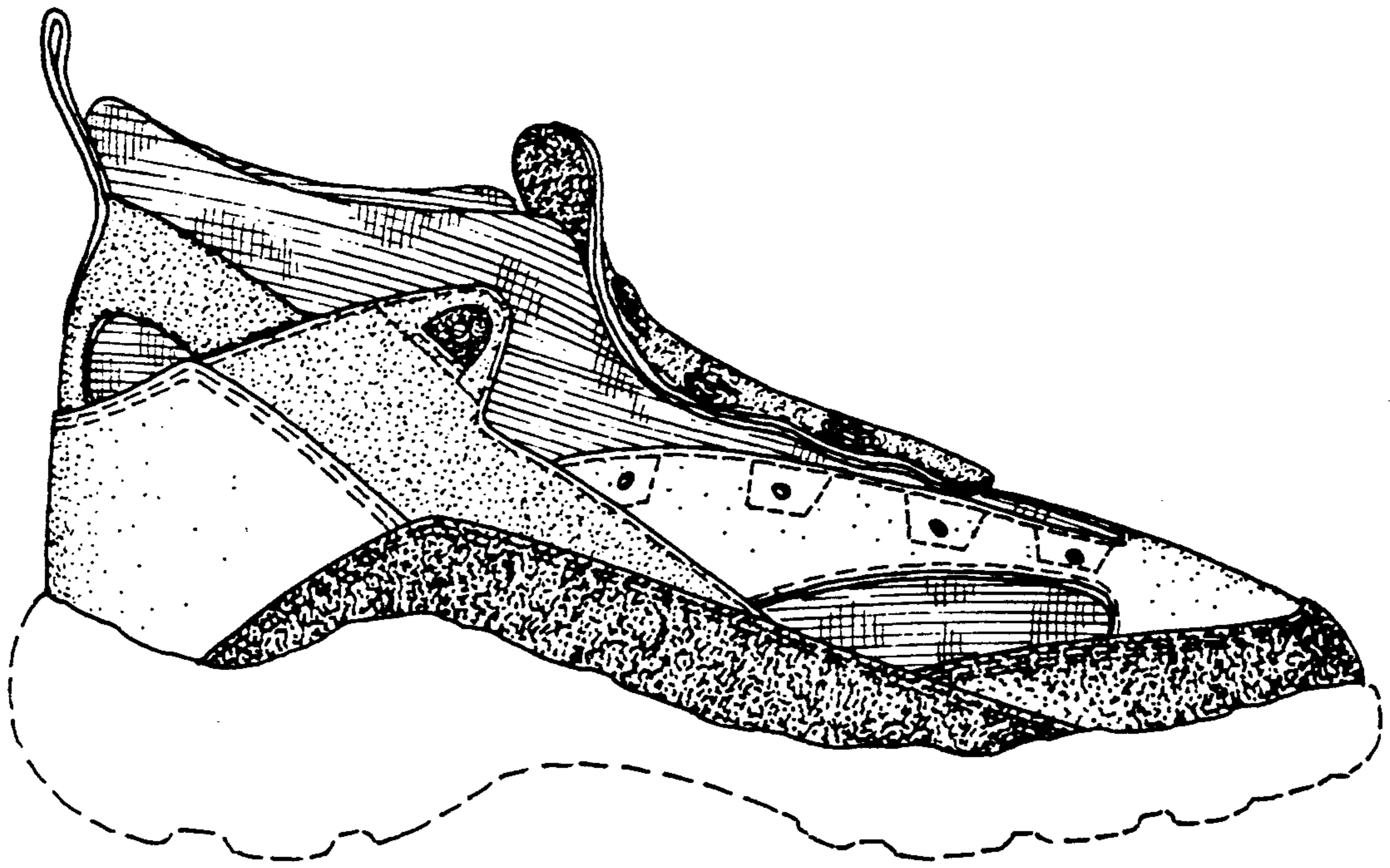

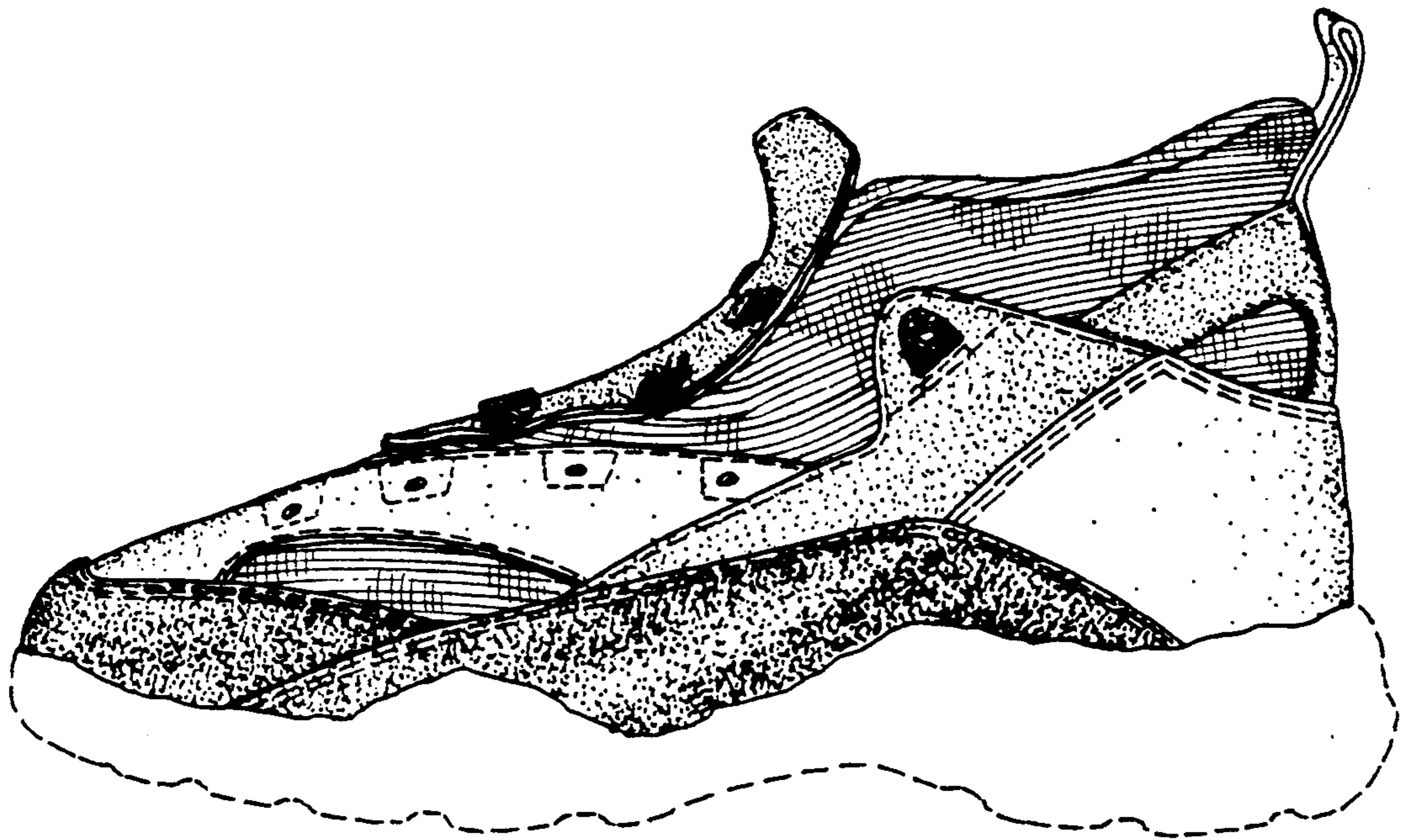

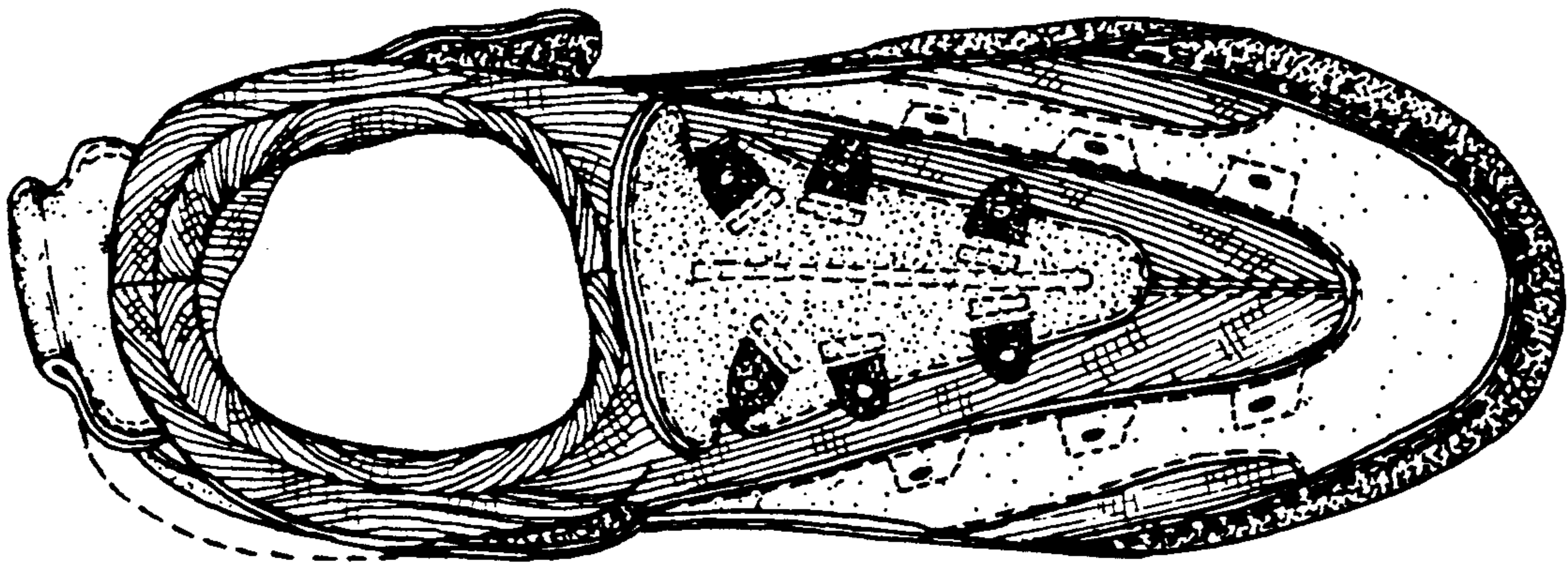

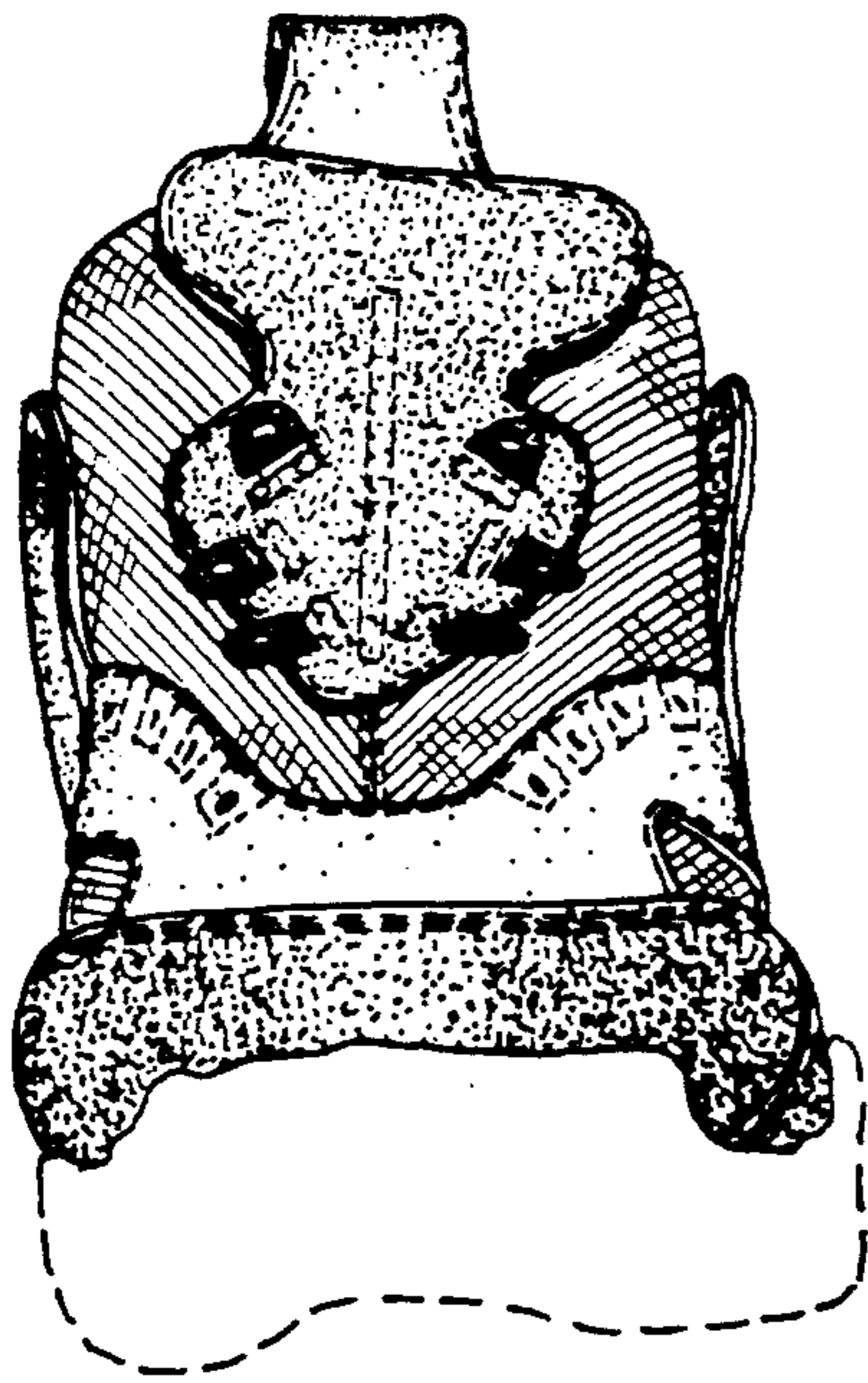

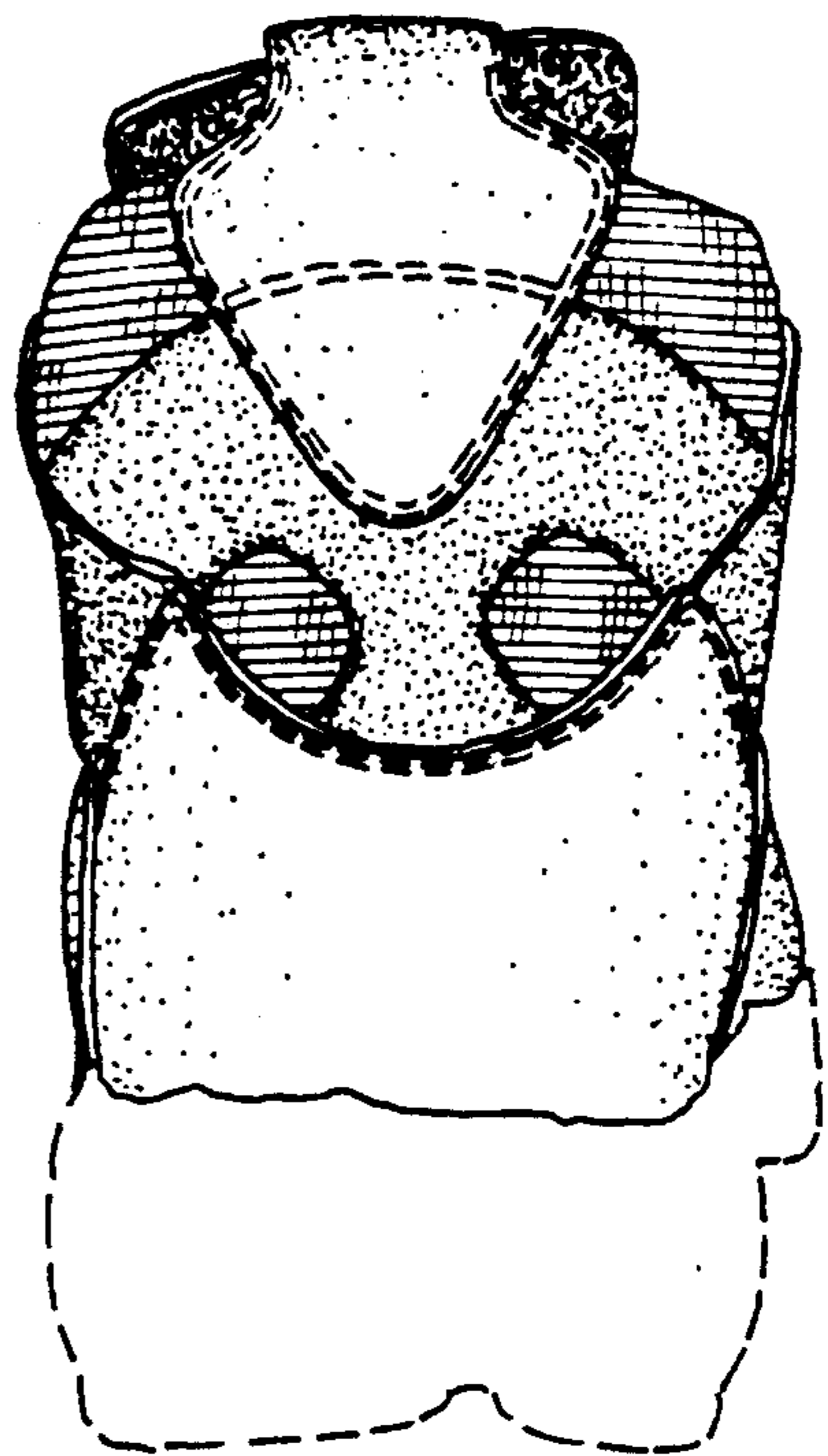
