FIG. 3 is an enlarged rear elevational view thereof;

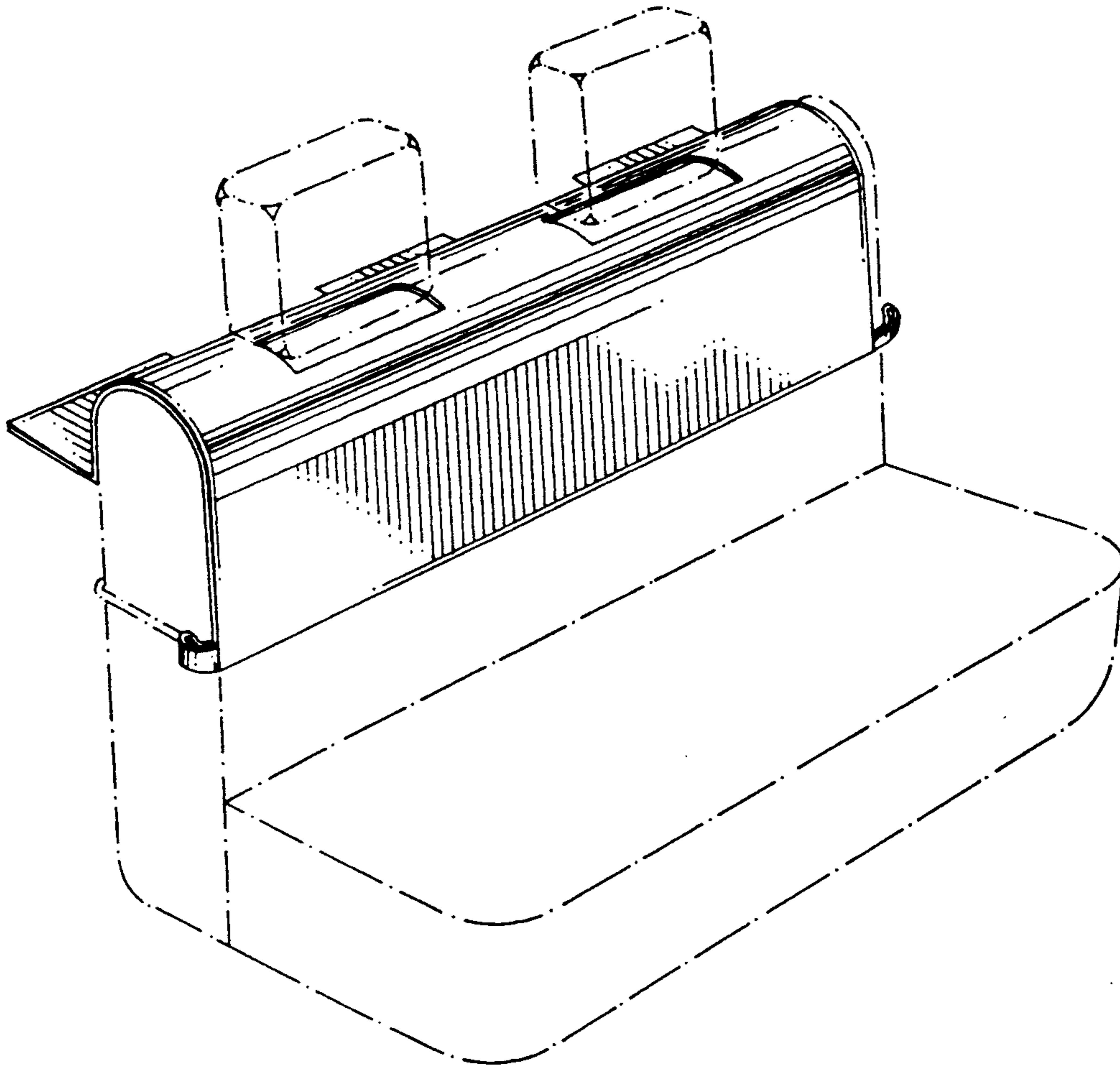
FIG. 4 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof; and,

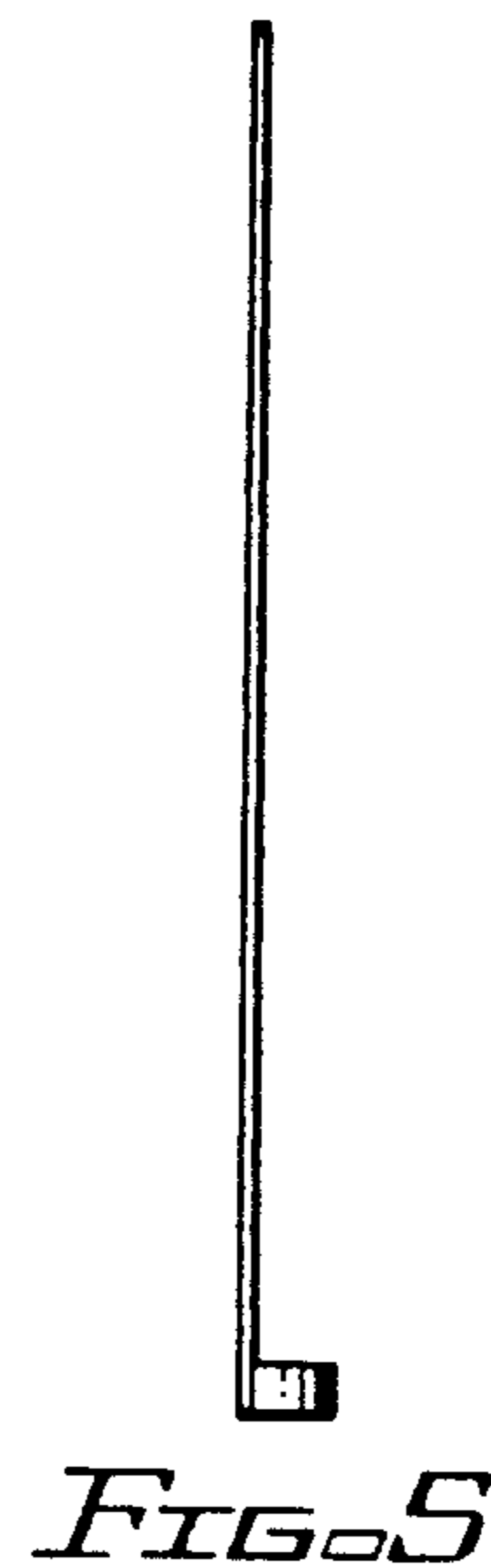
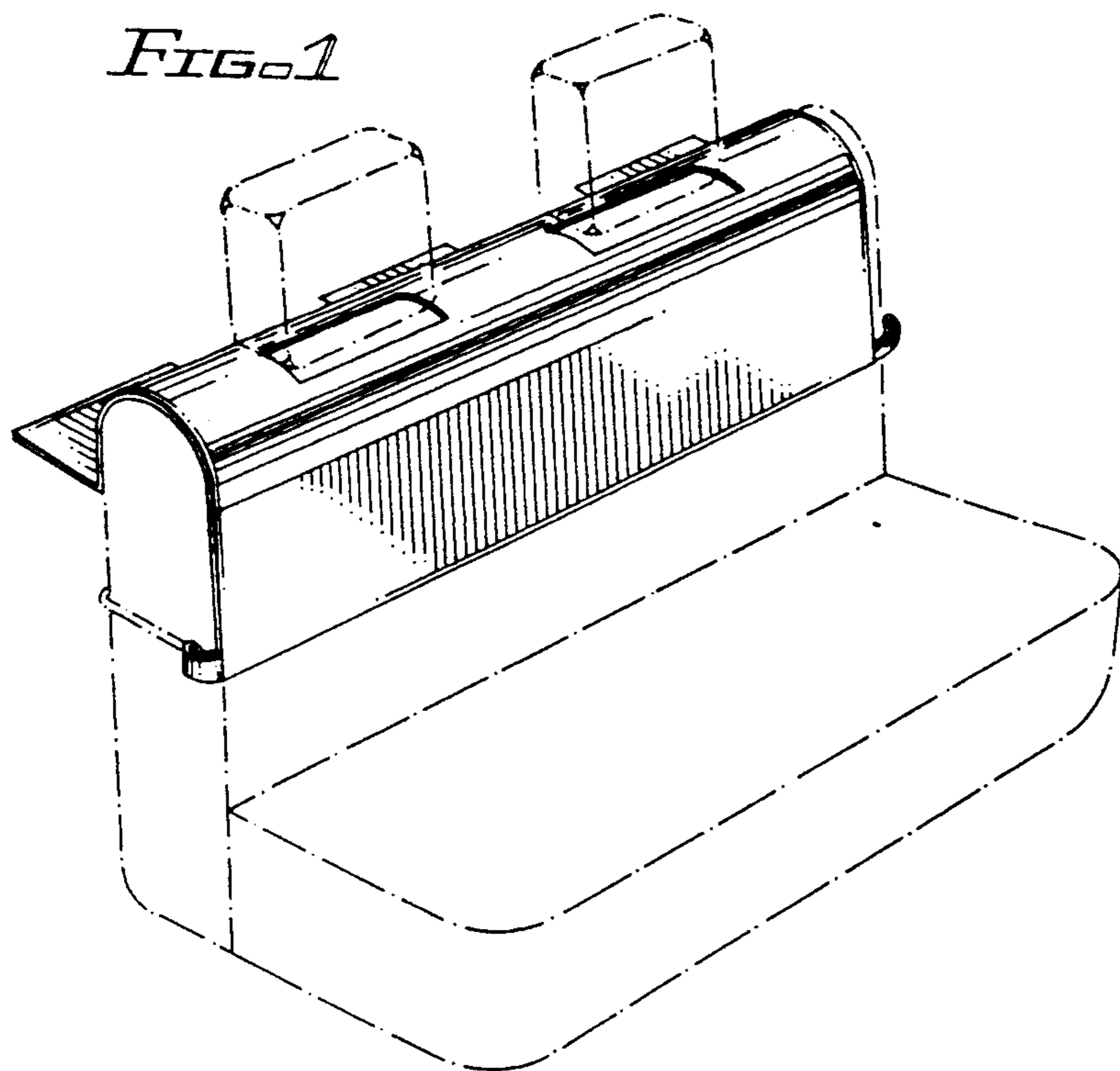

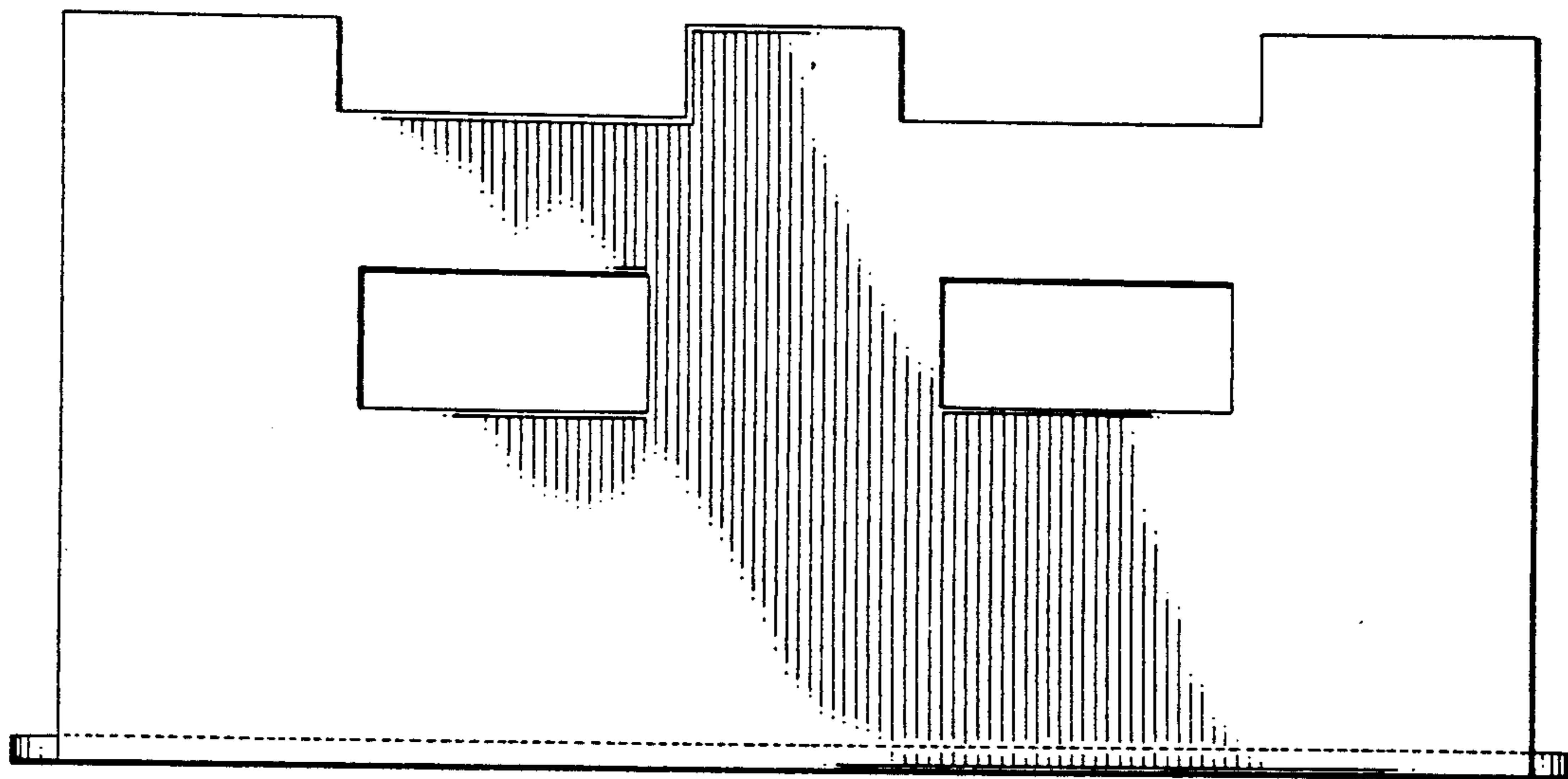

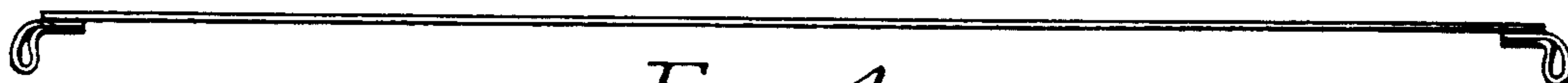
