The ornamental design for a shoe sole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a shoe sole showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side view in elevation thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side view in elevation thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof.
The dotted lines are environmental only and form no part of the claimed design.

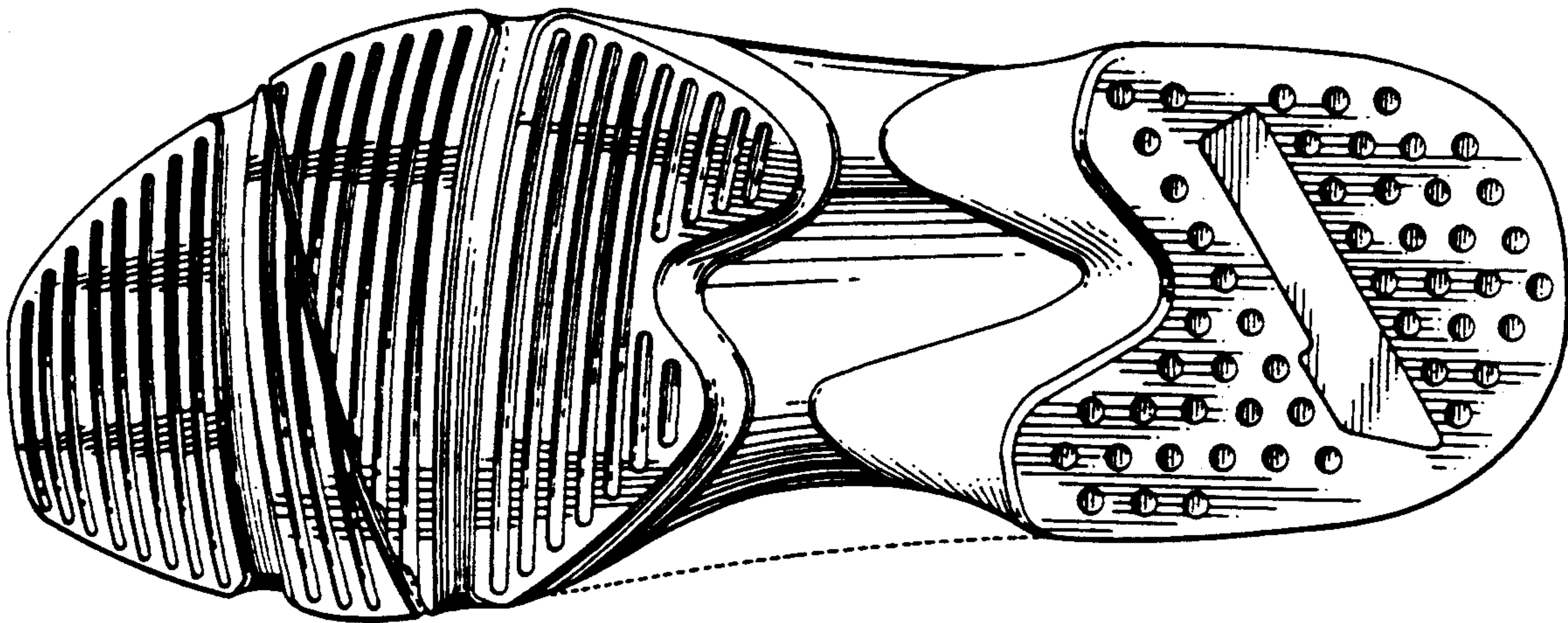

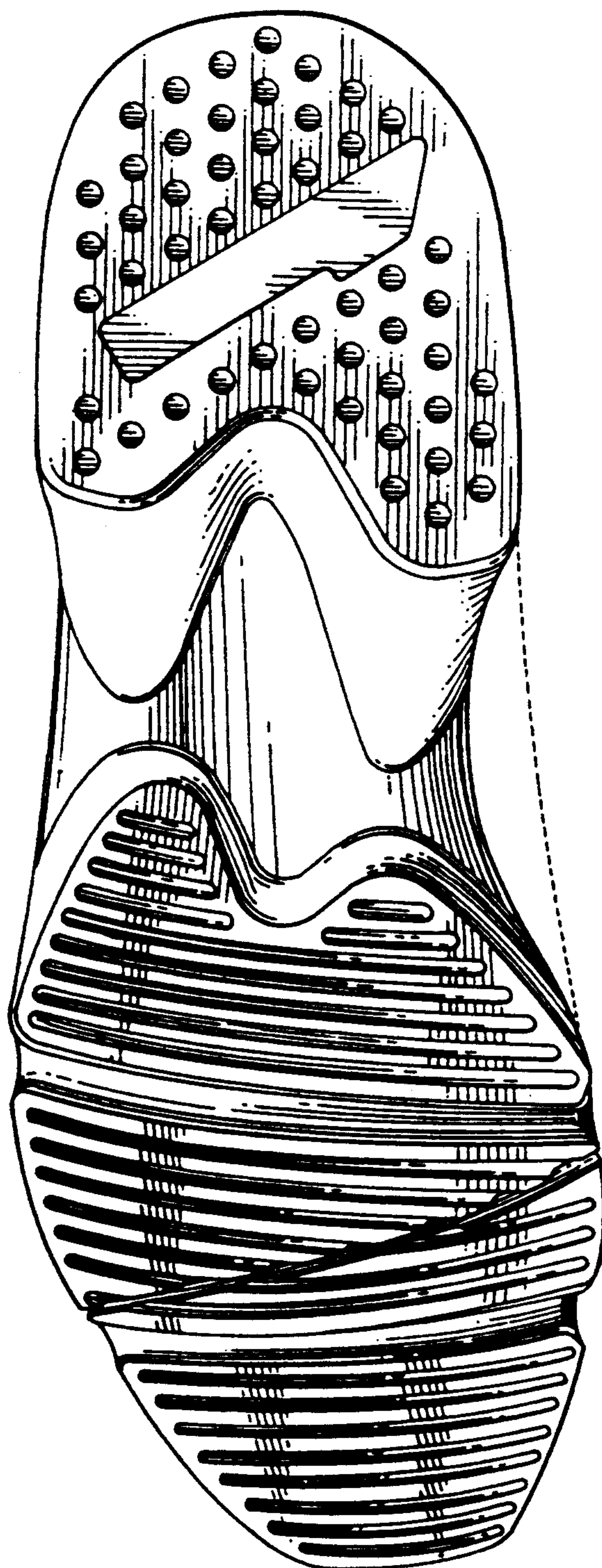

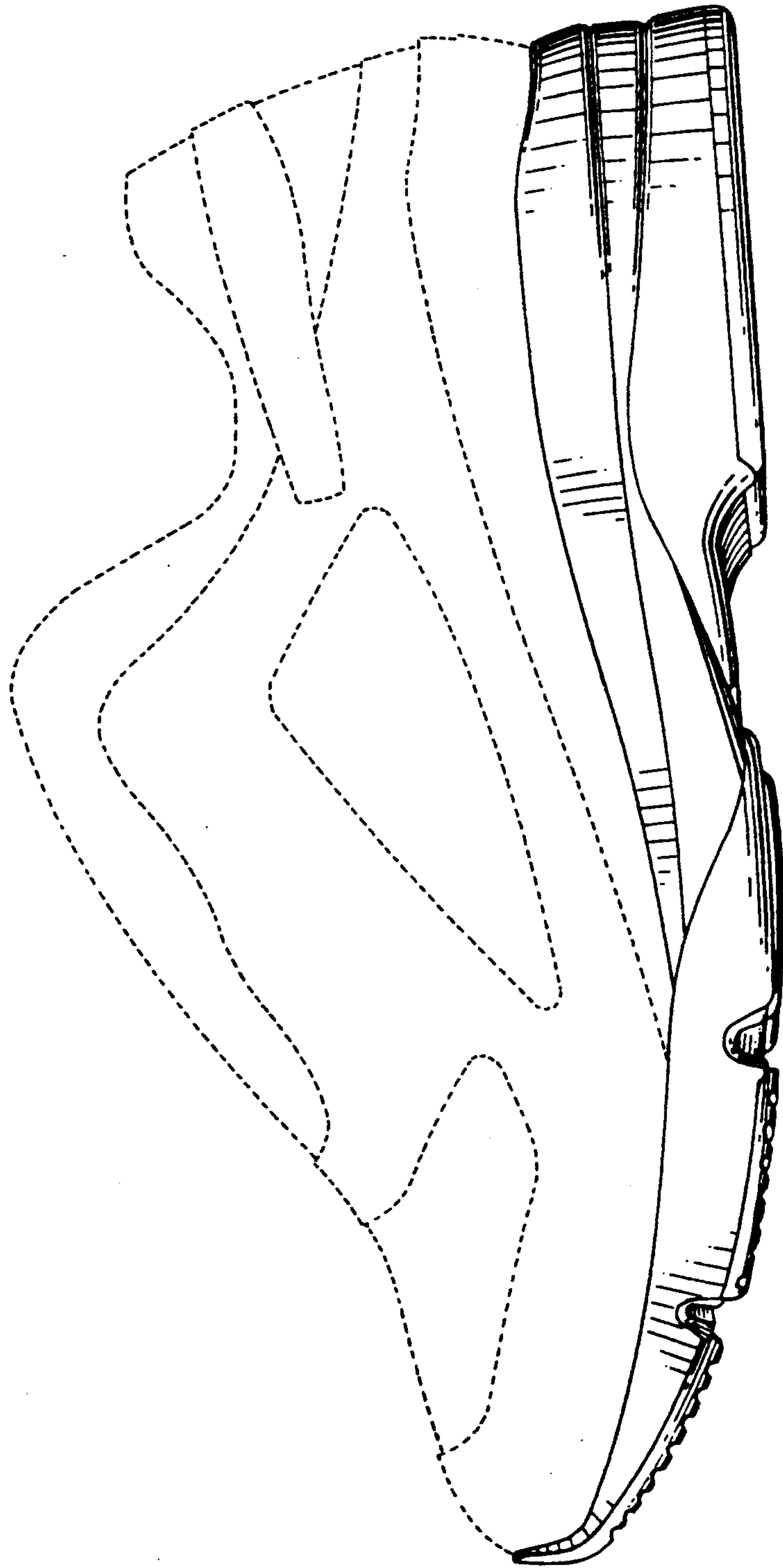

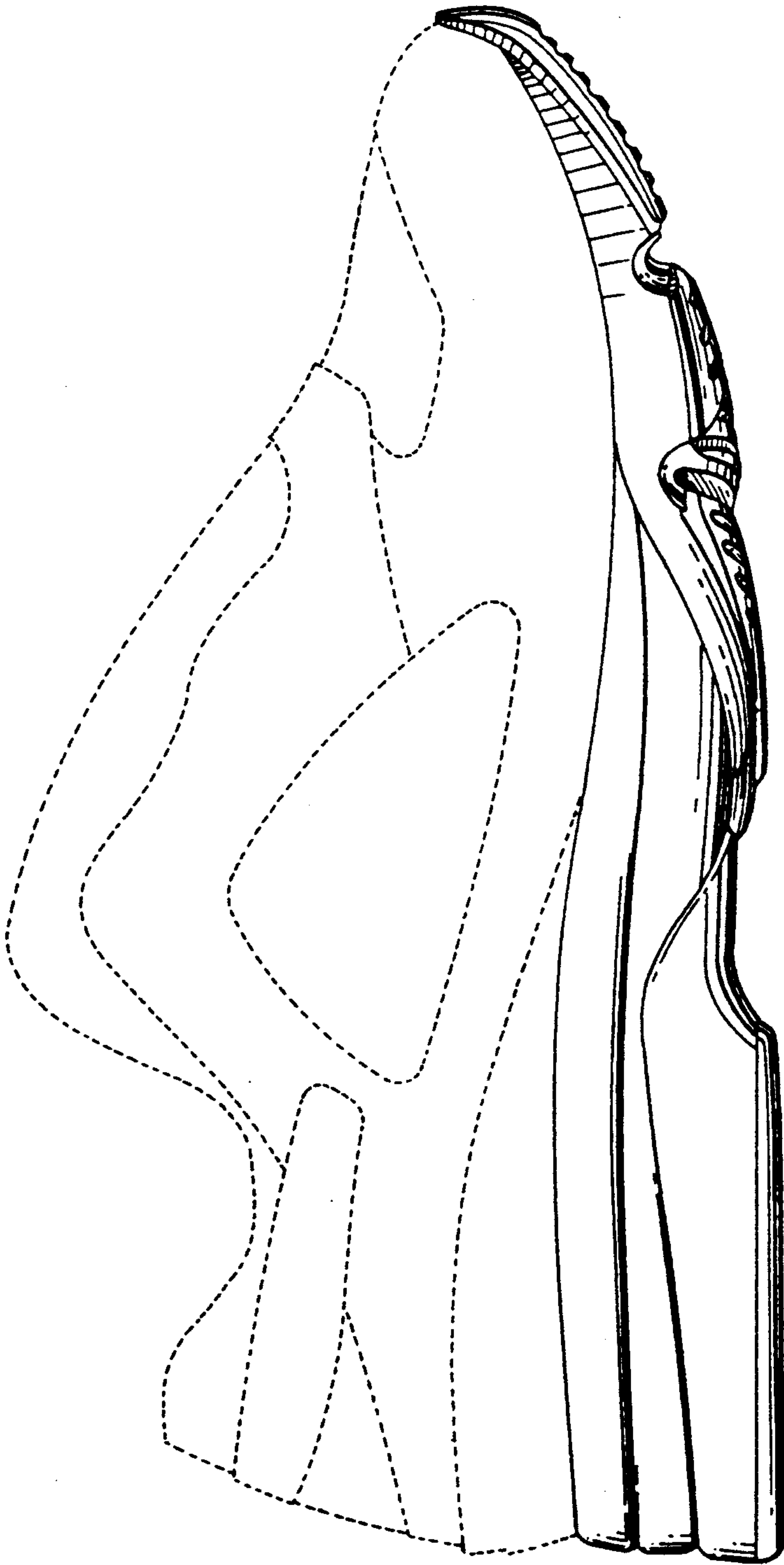

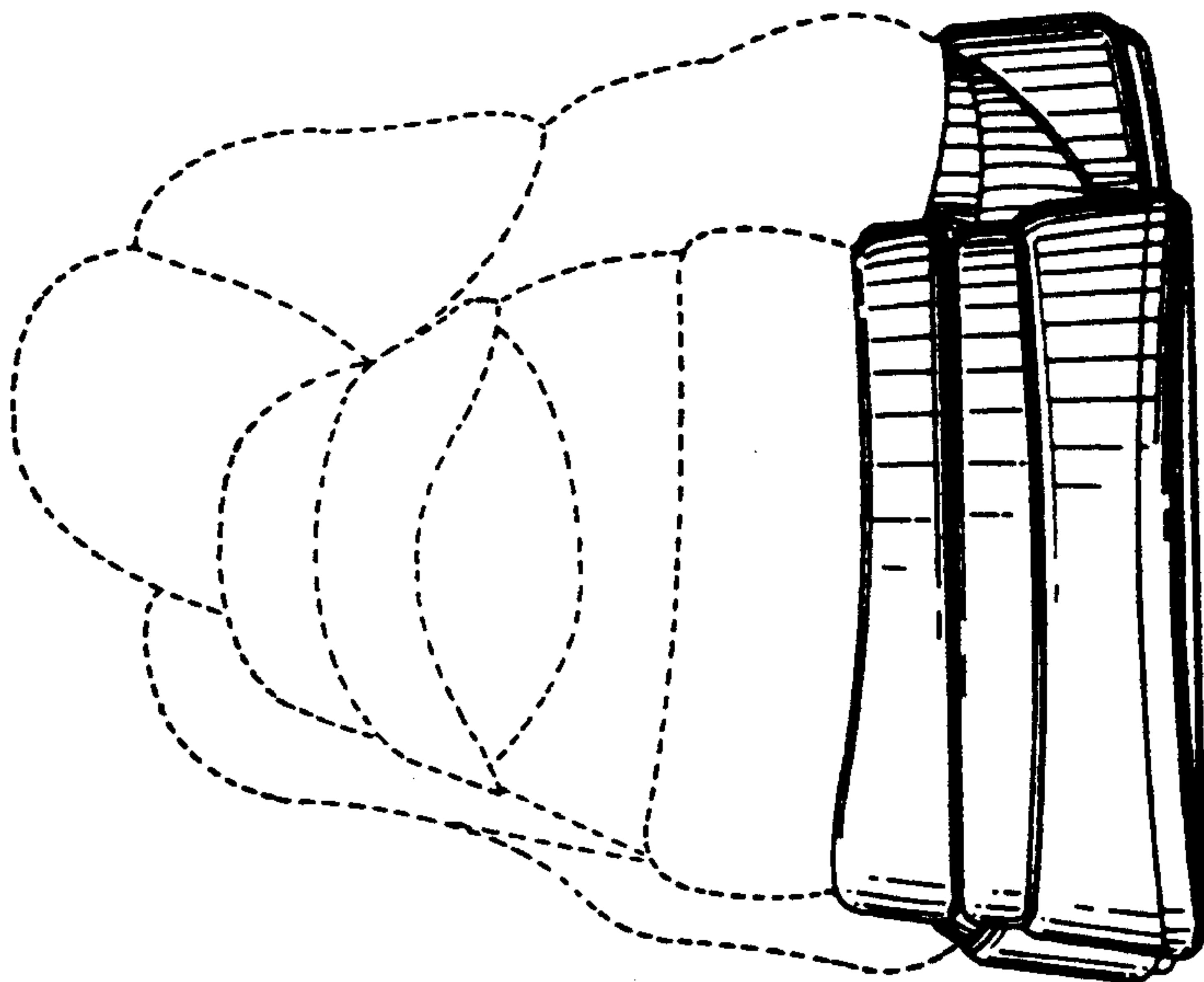
