[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shoe heel protector, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a shoe heel protector showing my new design in use;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view in use;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, which is symmetrical with a right side elevational view thereof not shown;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof.

The broken line showing of a shoe in FIGS. 1 and 2 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

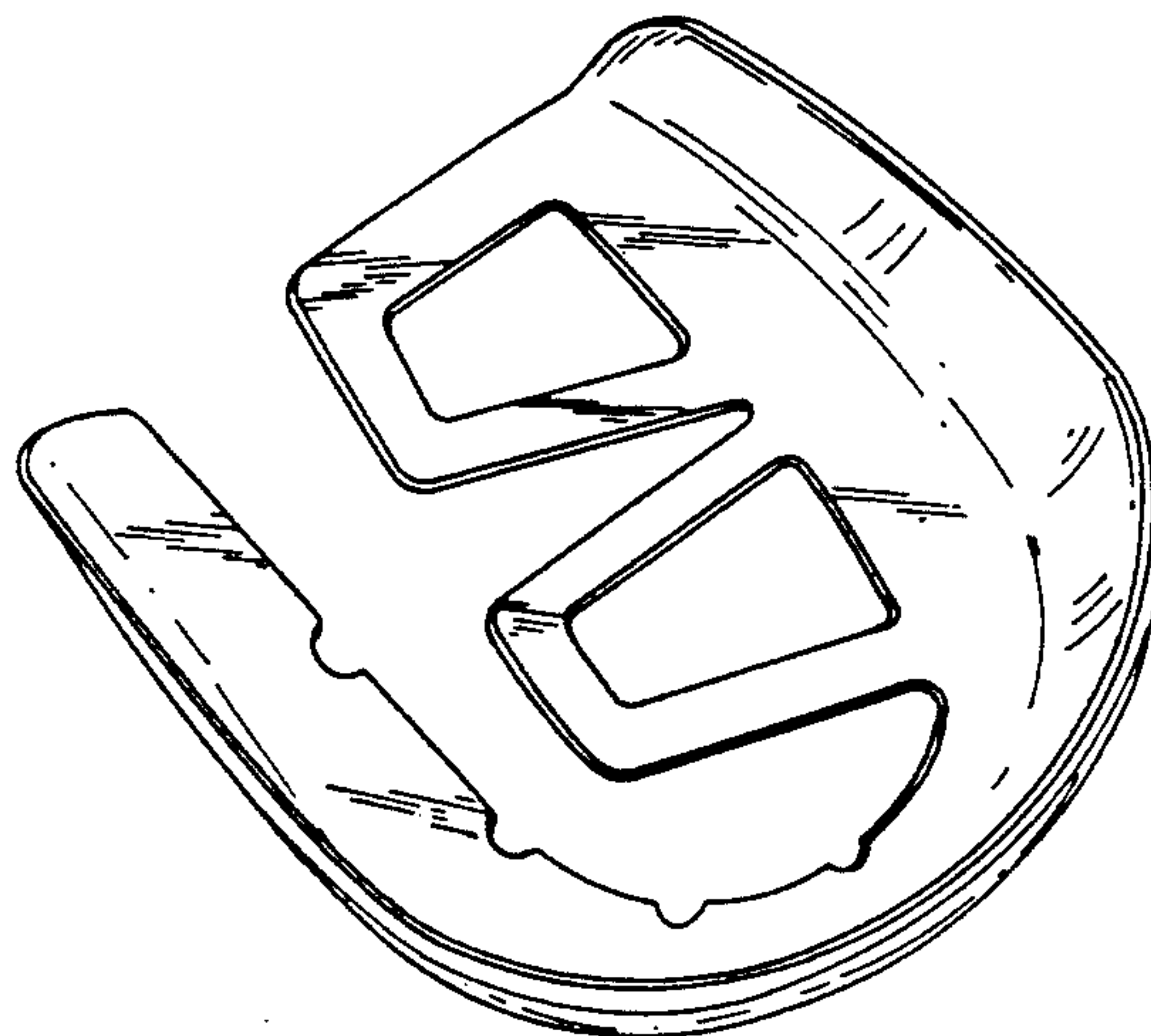
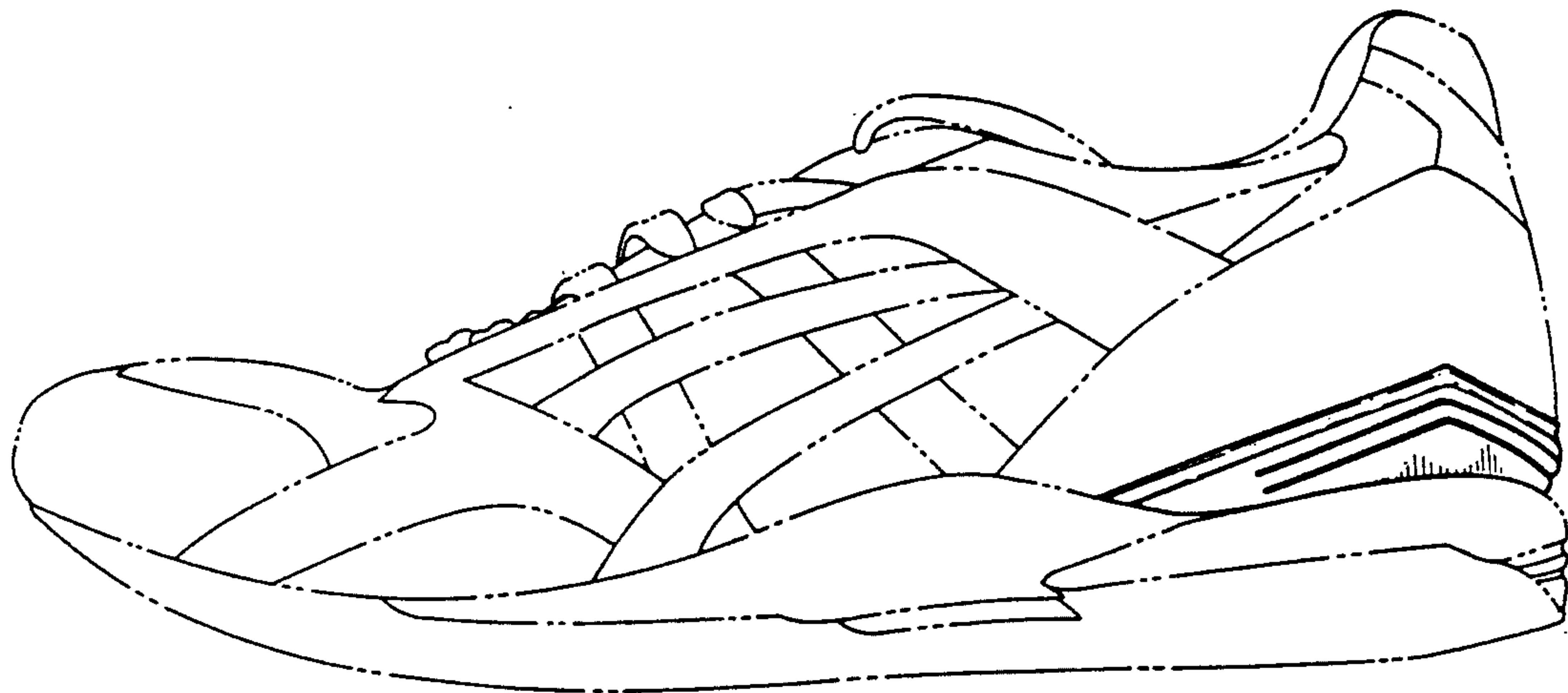

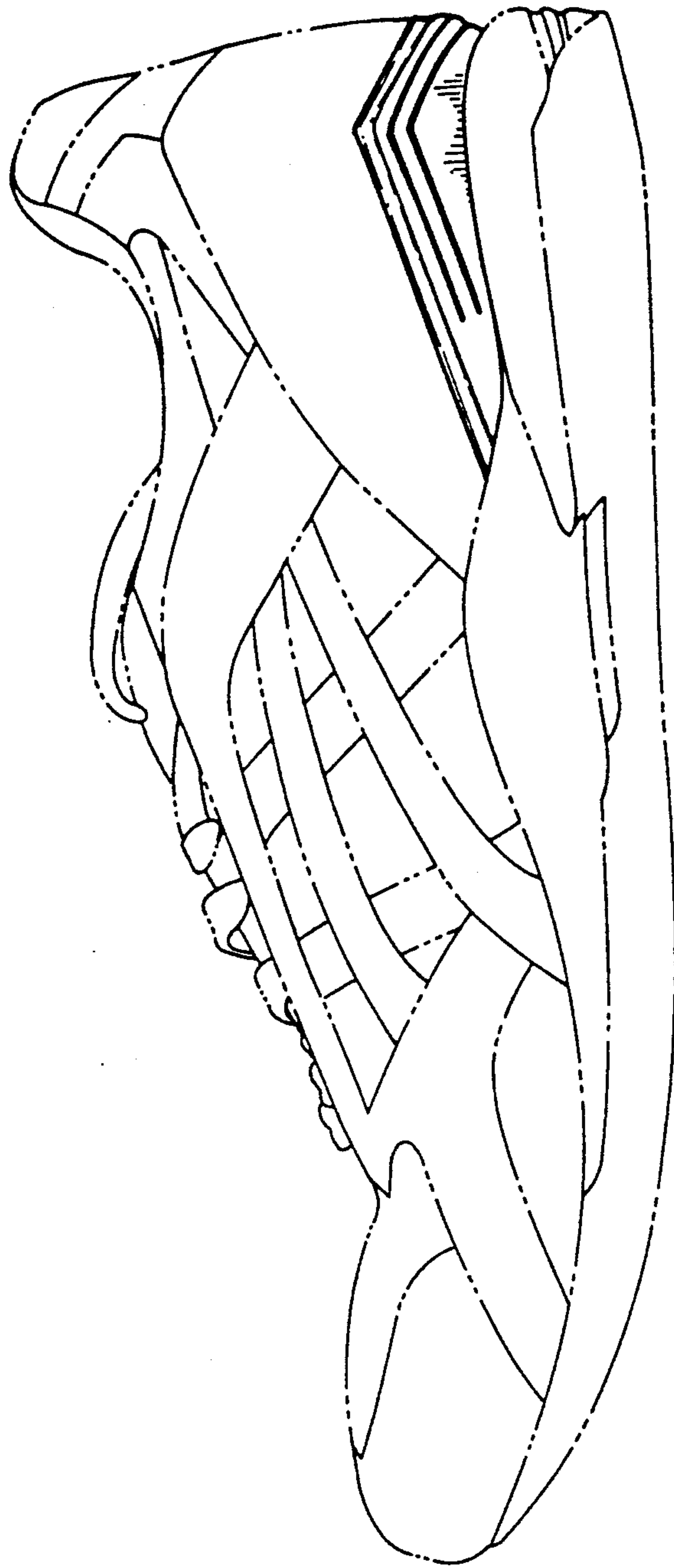

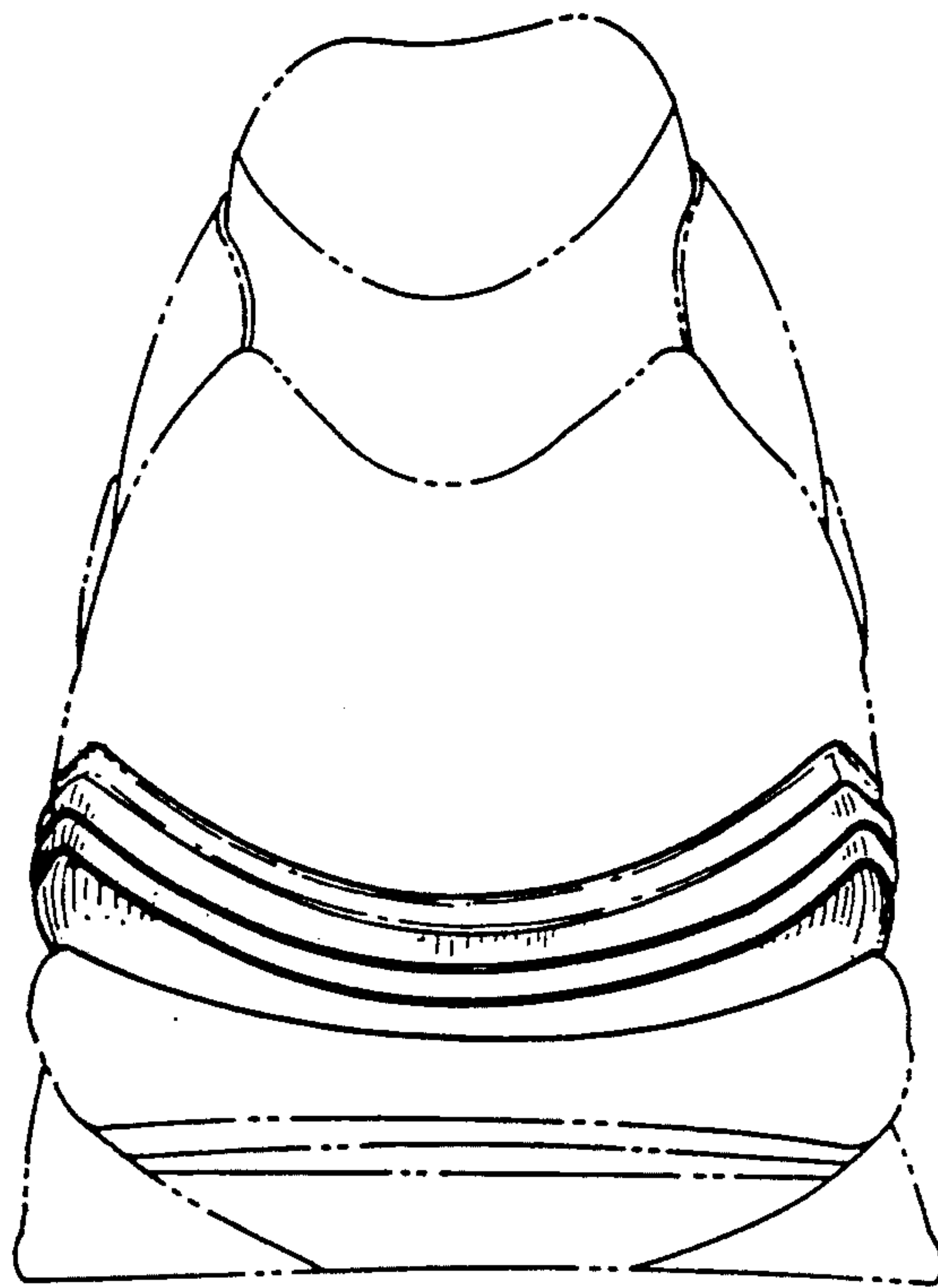

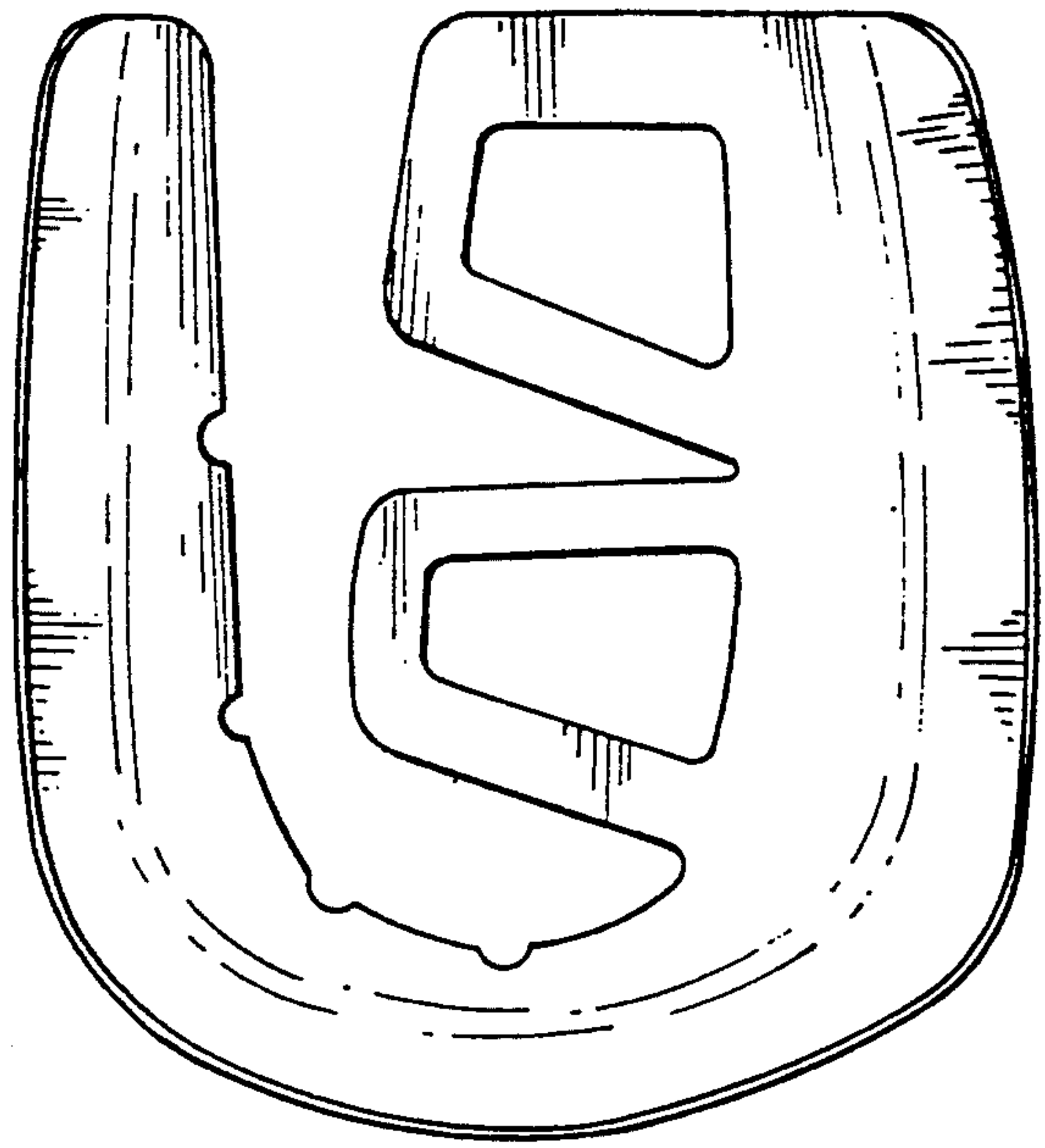

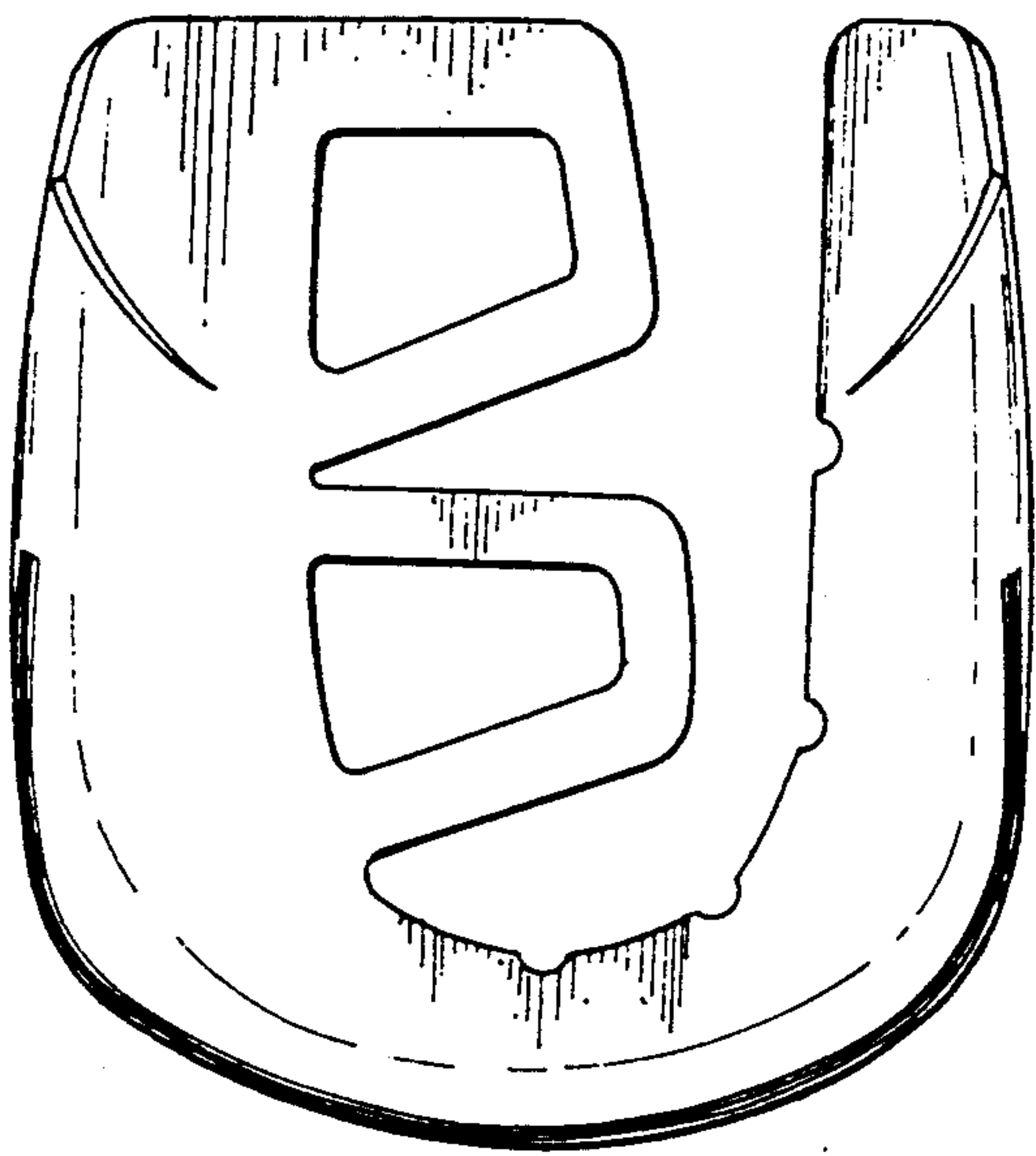

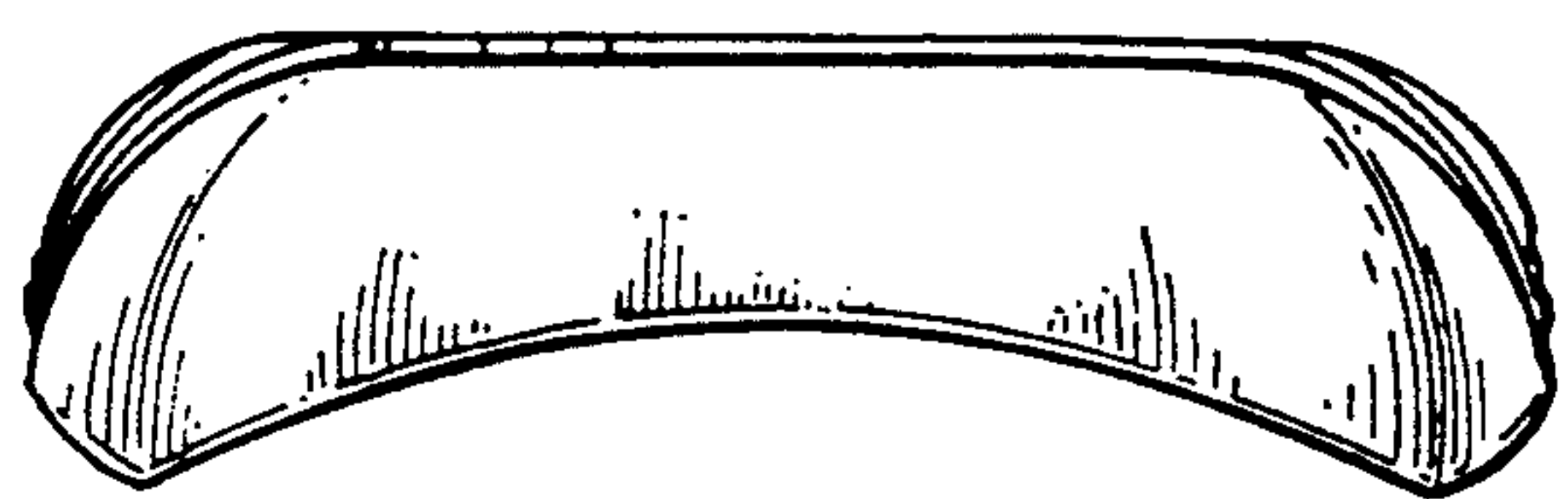

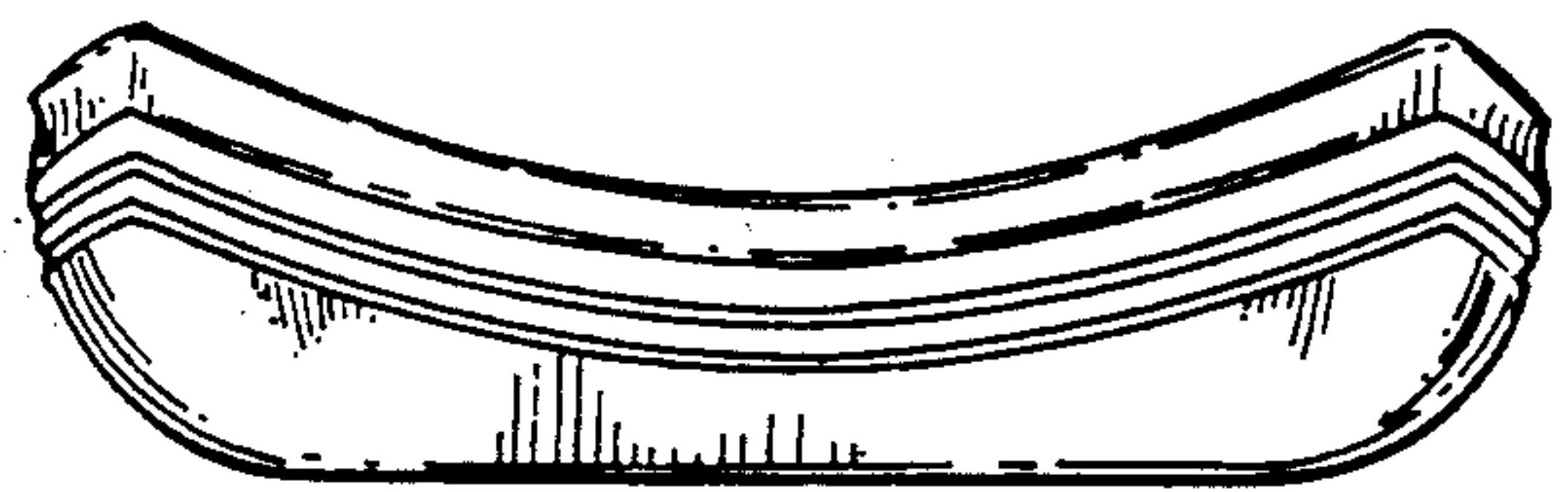
