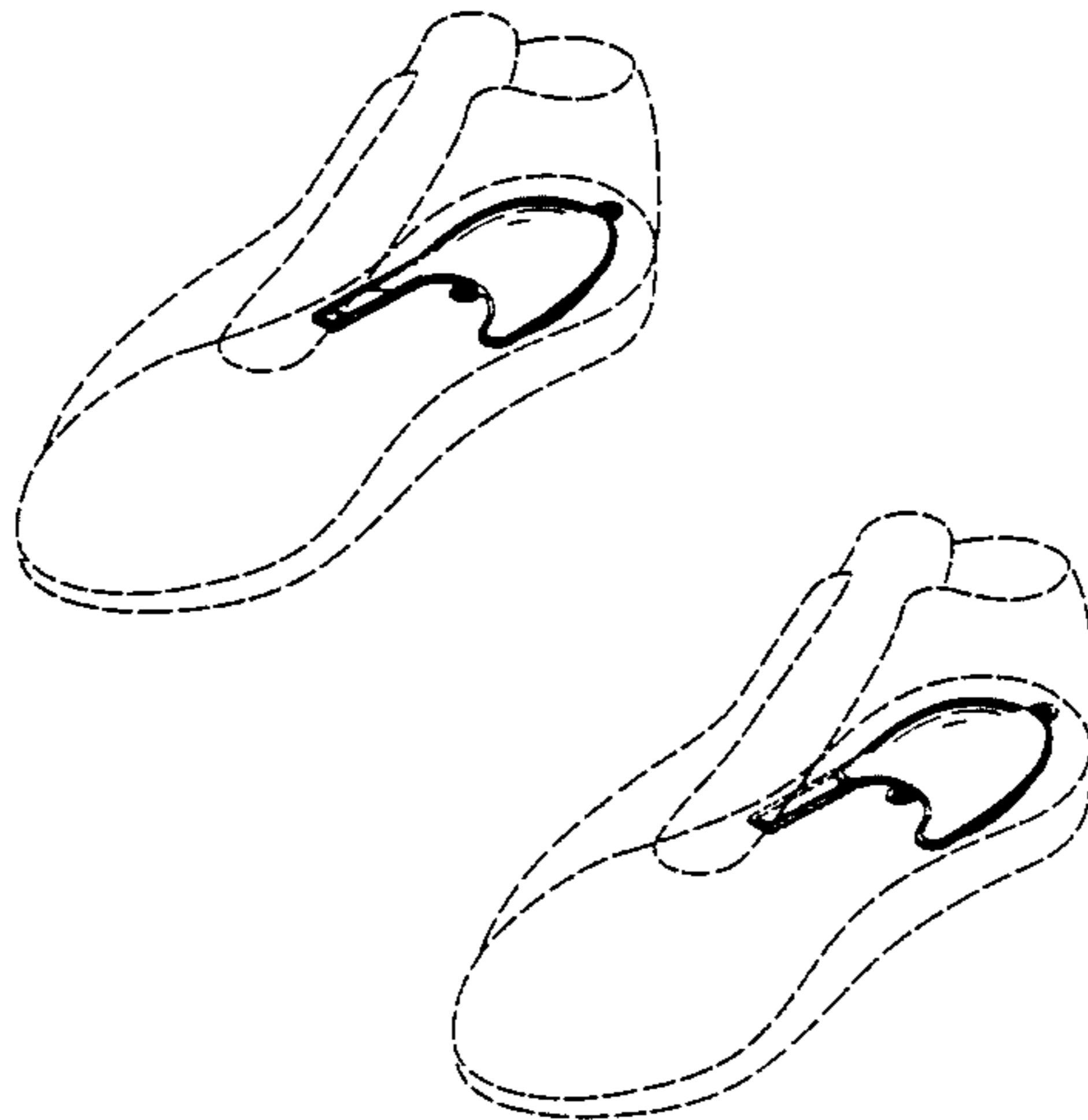

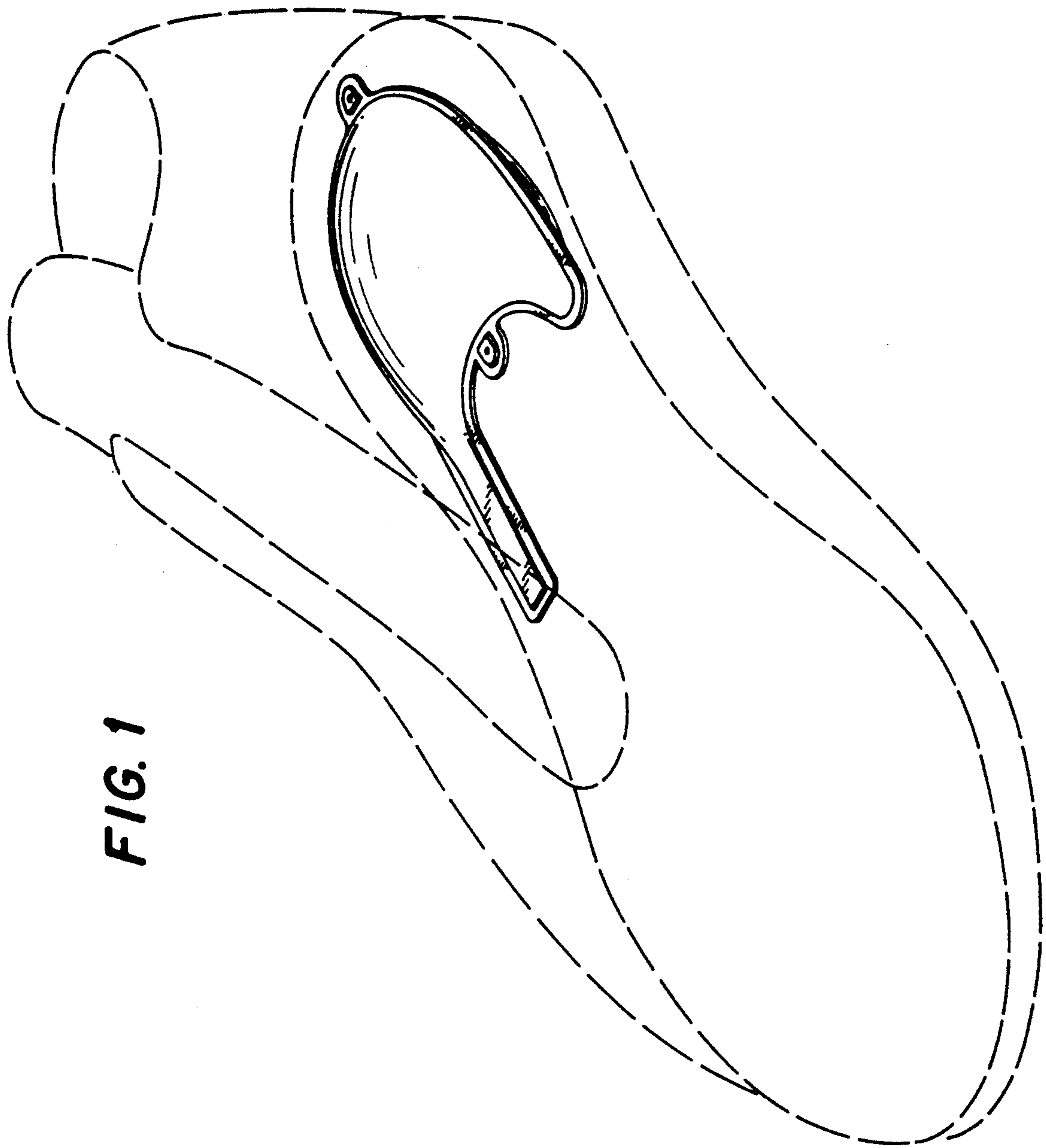
### [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bladder for a shoe sole, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

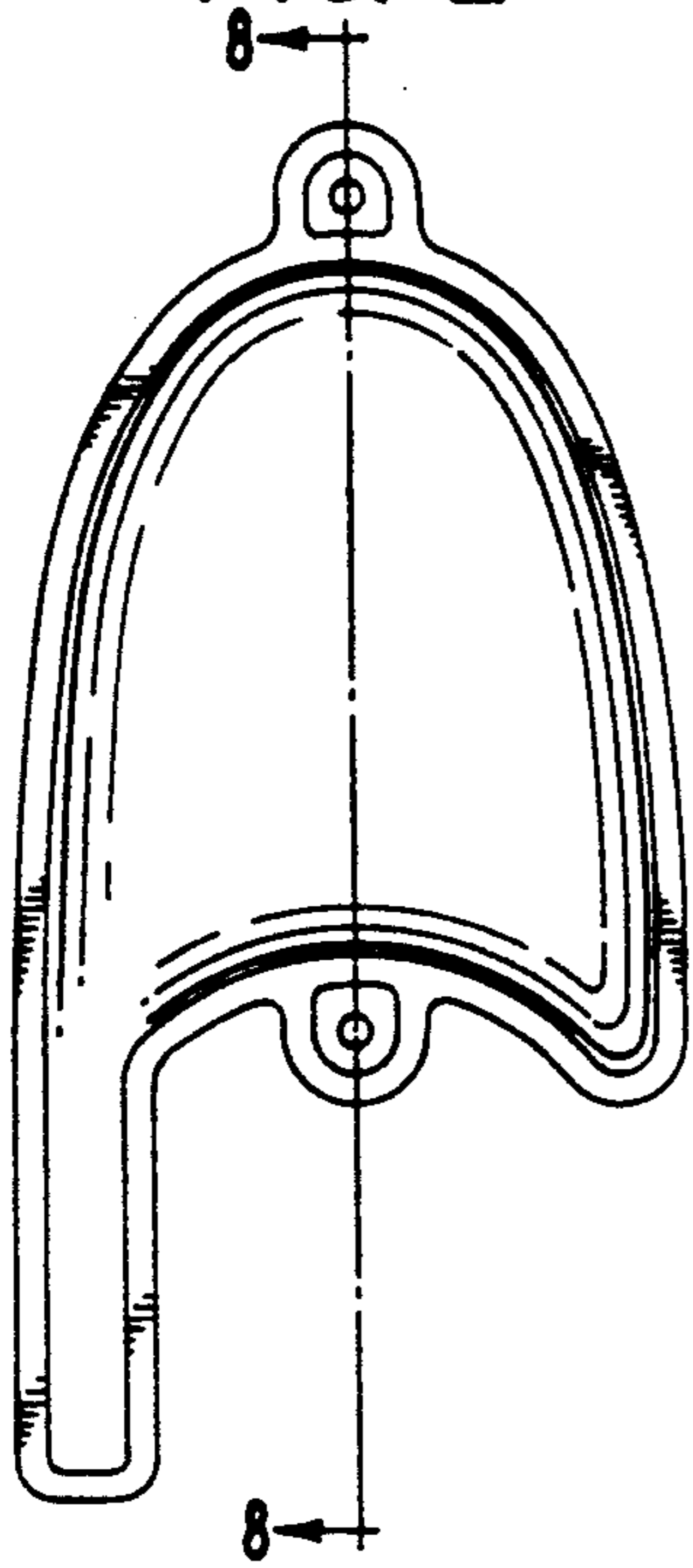
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bladder for a shoe sole showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a front view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 8 is a cross-sectional view taken along the line 8-8 of FIG. 2;  
FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a bladder for a shoe sole showing an alternate embodiment of my new design;  
FIG. 10 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 12 is a front view thereof;  
FIG. 13 is a rear view thereof;  
FIG. 14 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 15 is a right side elevational view thereof; and,  
FIG. 16 is a cross-sectional view taken along the line 16-16 of FIG. 10.  
The broken line showing of a shoe in FIGS. 1 and 9 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



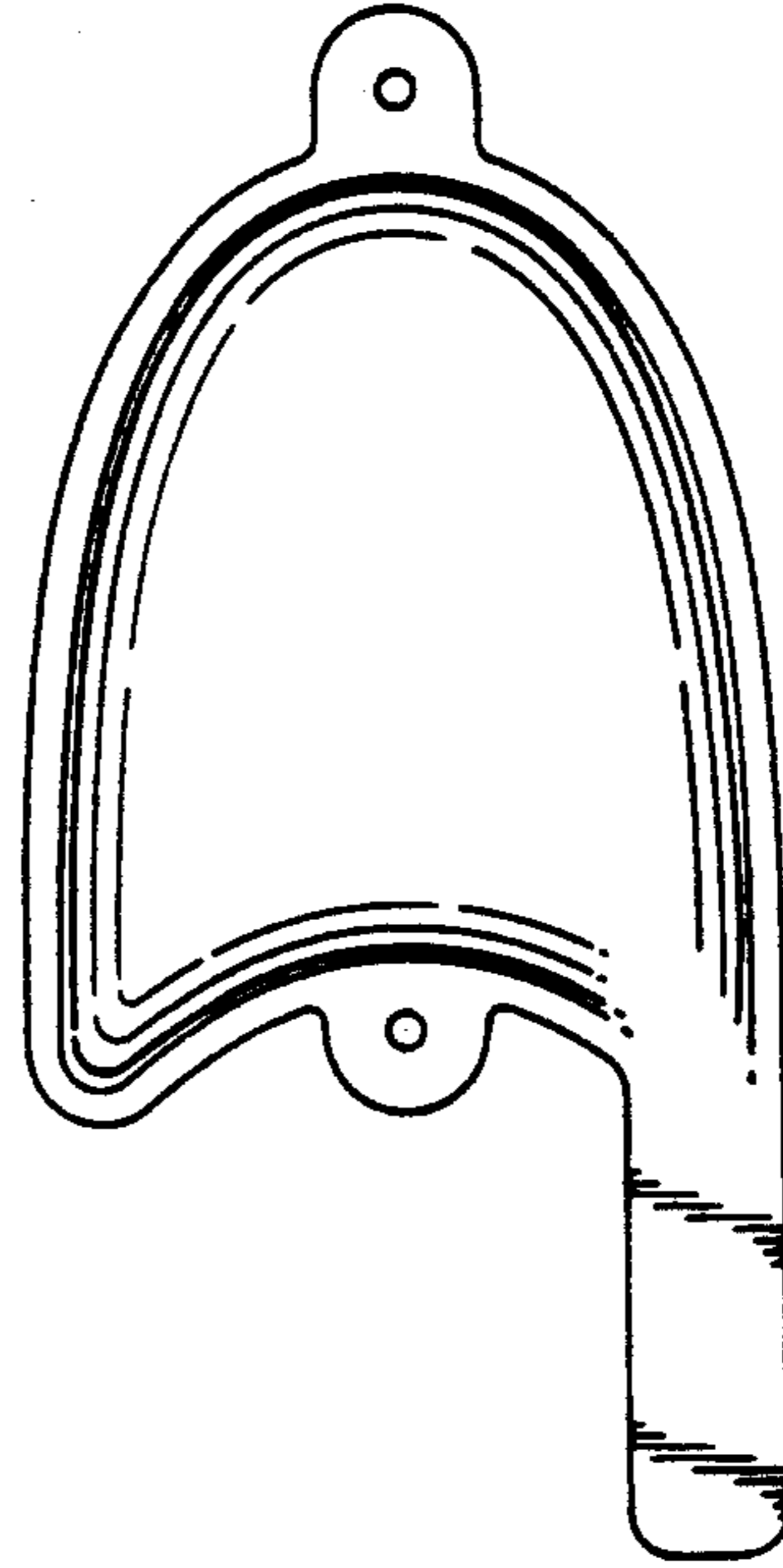

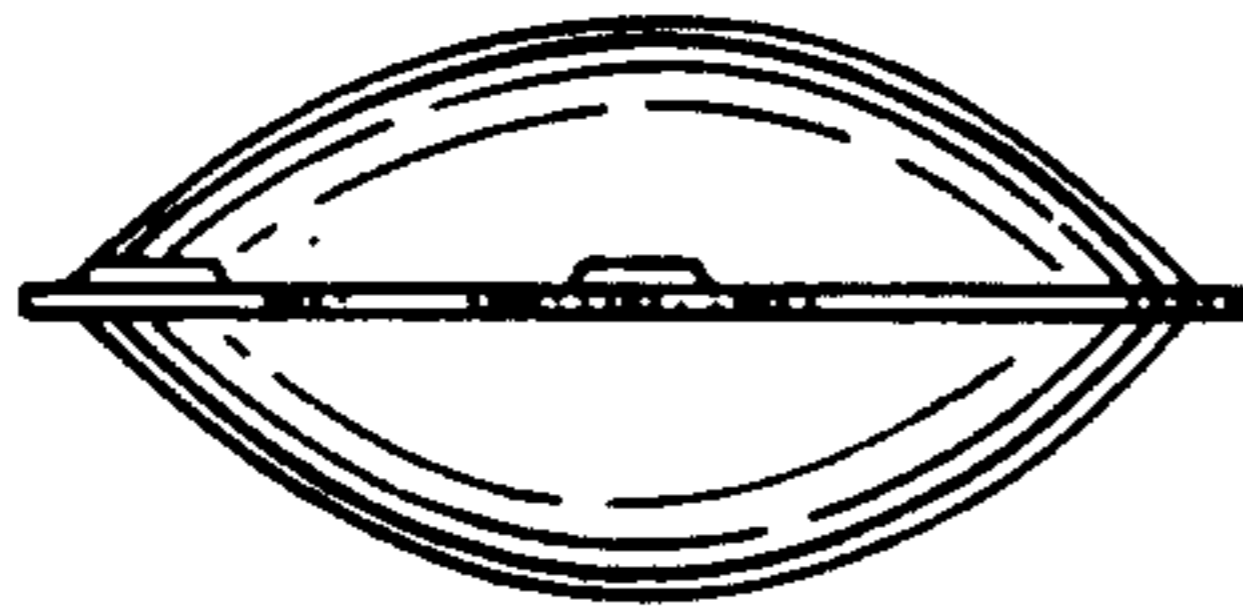

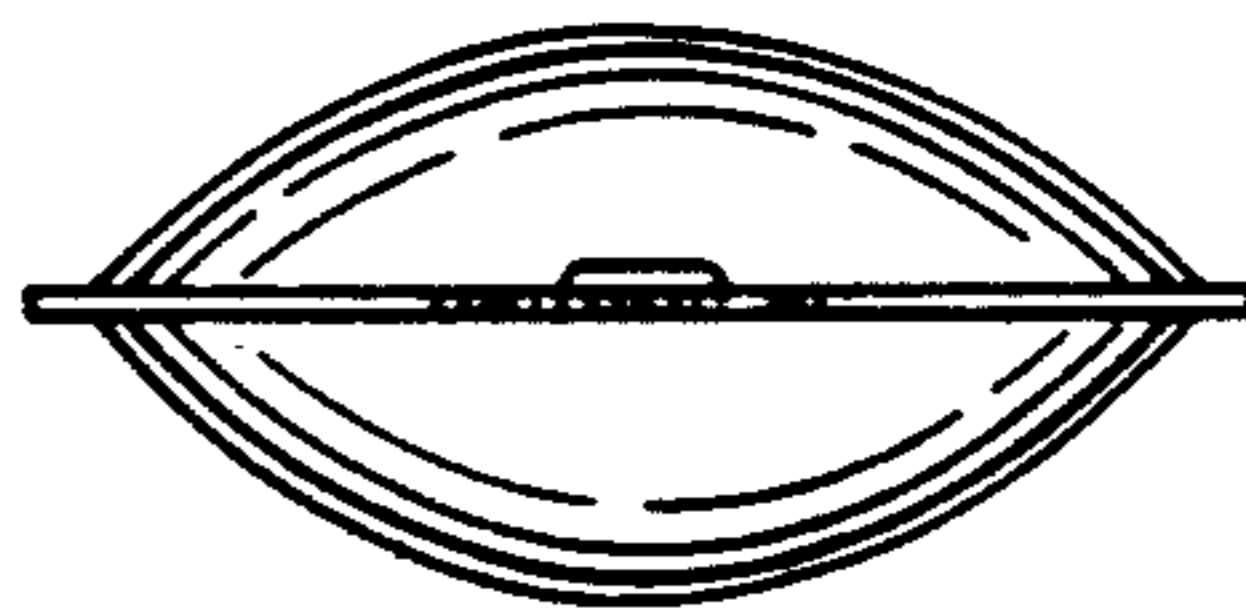

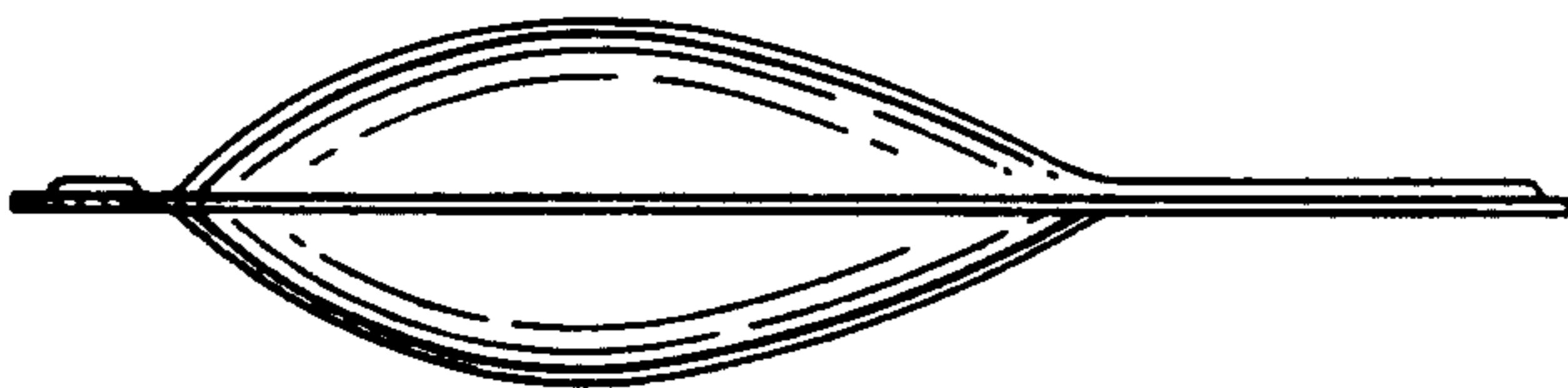

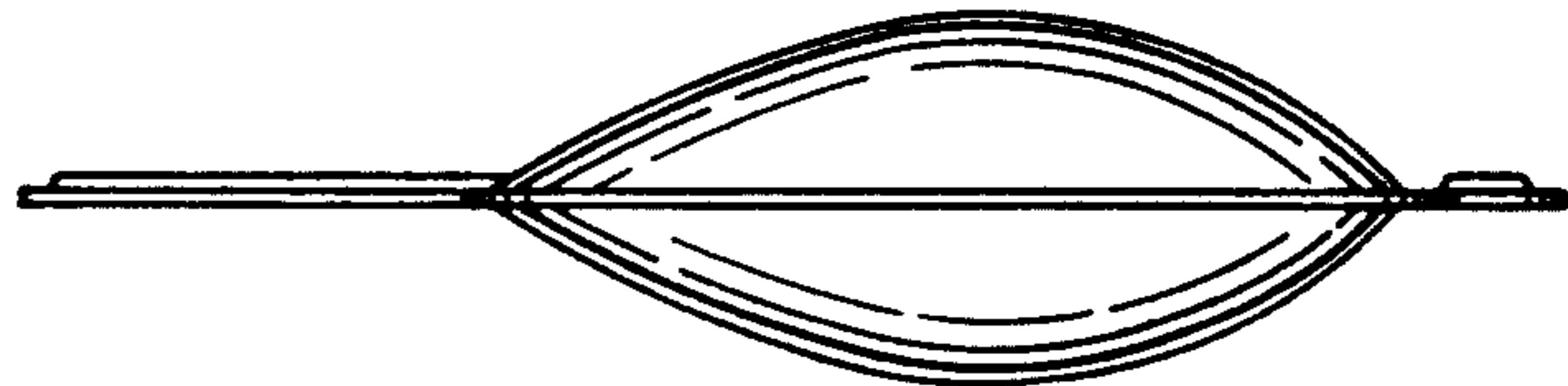

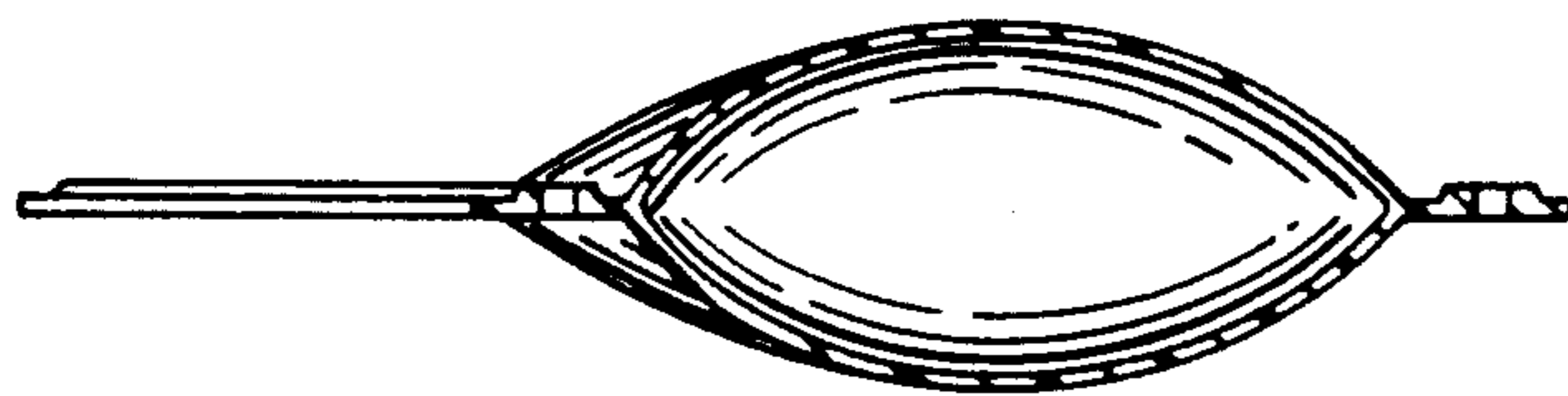

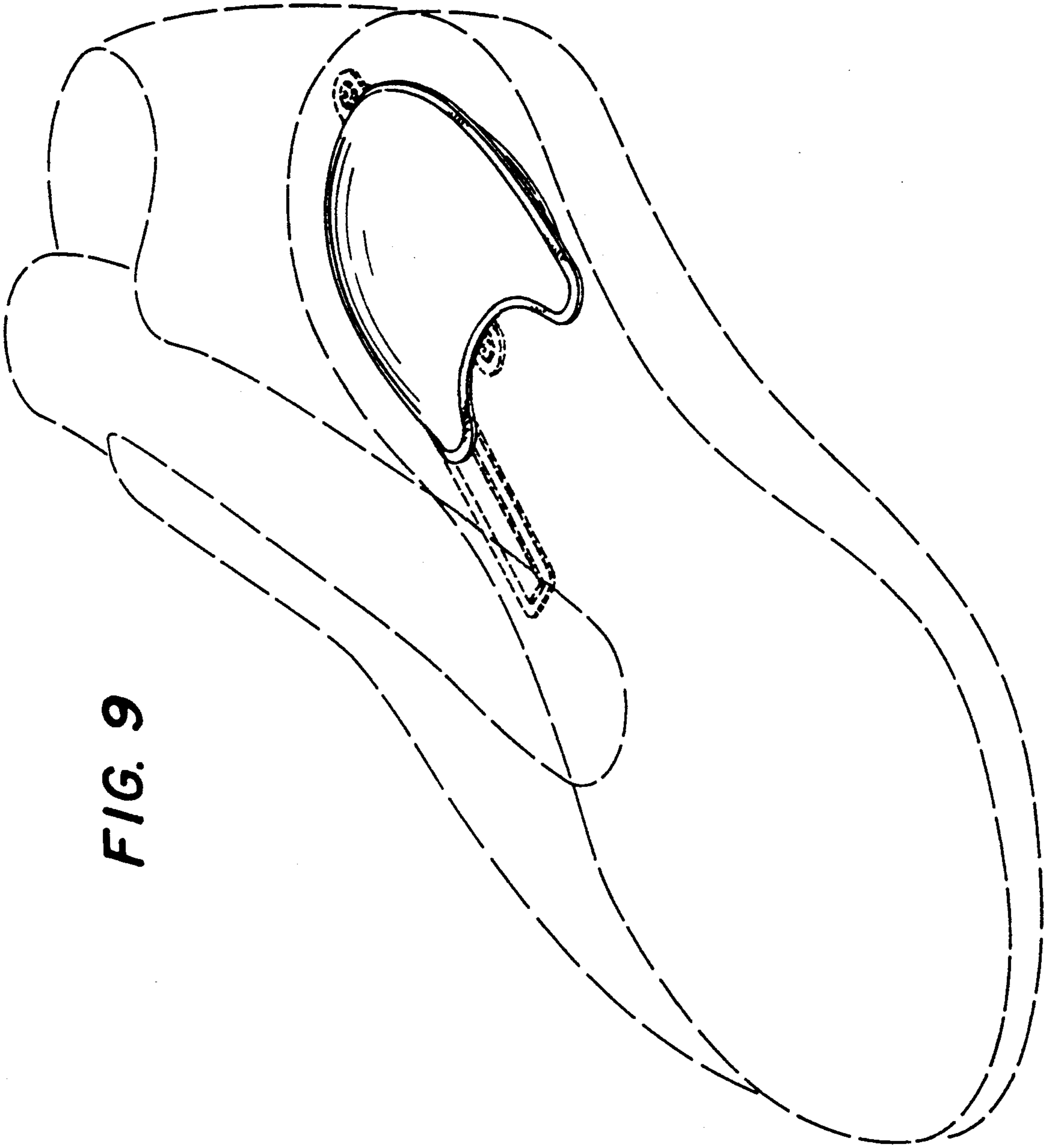

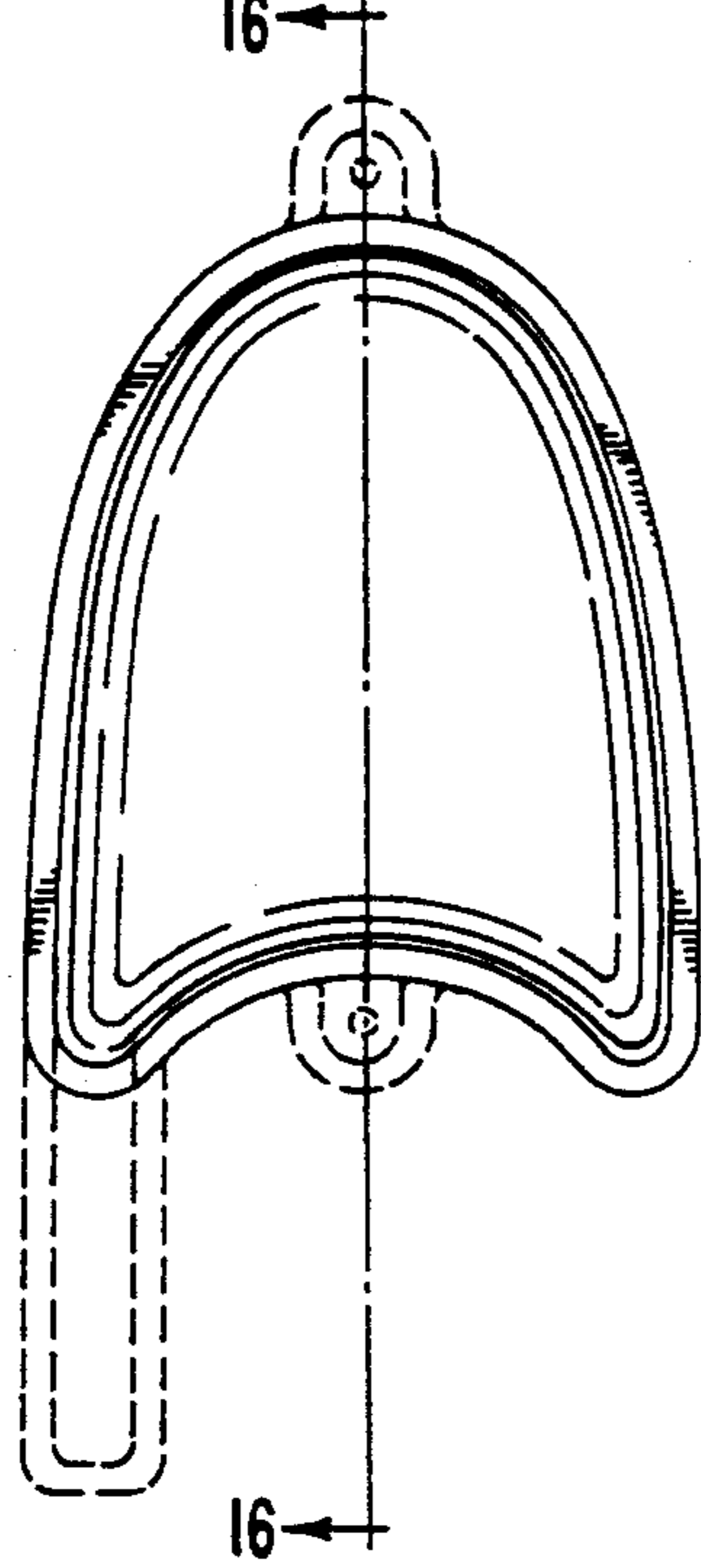

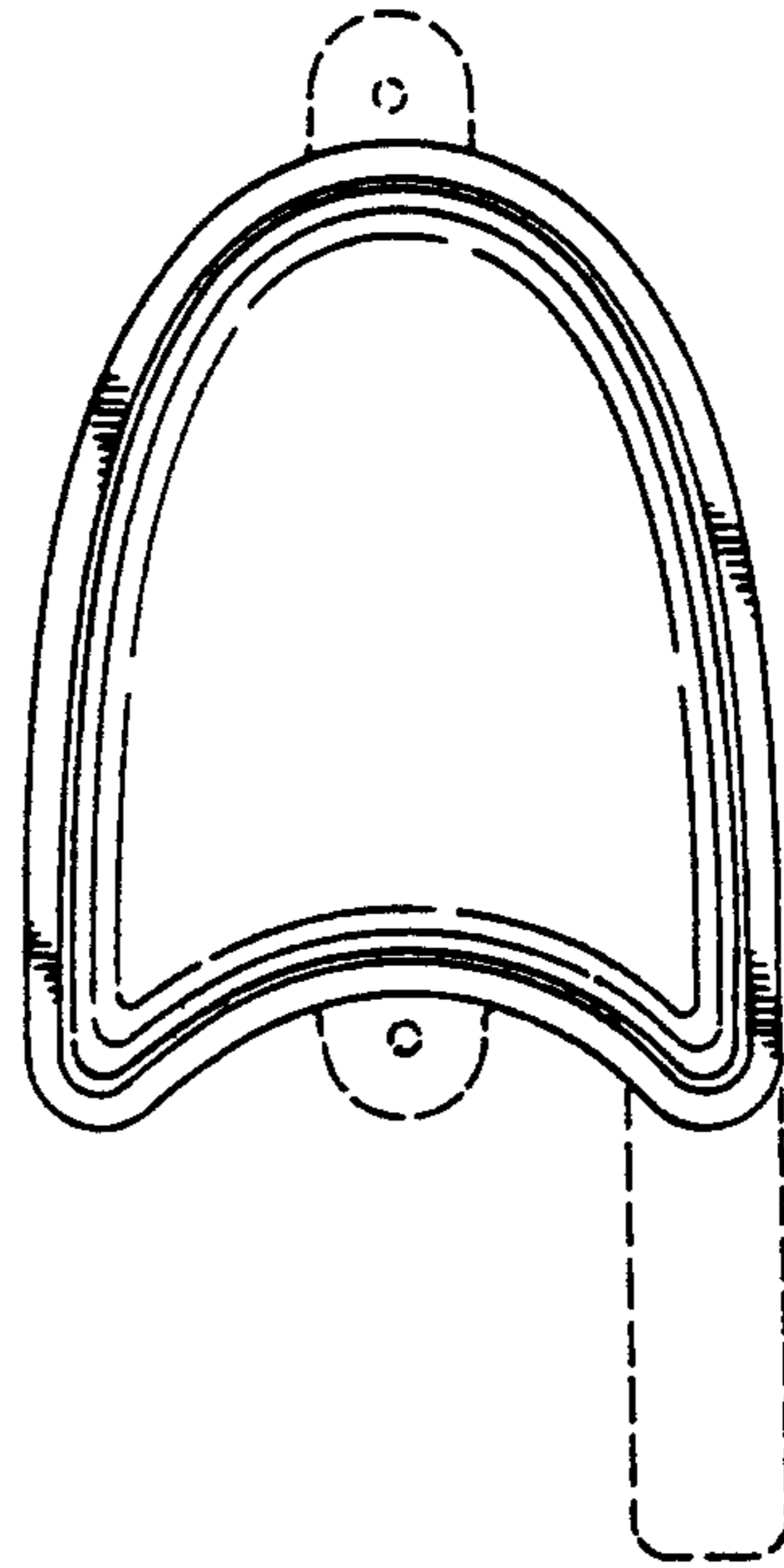

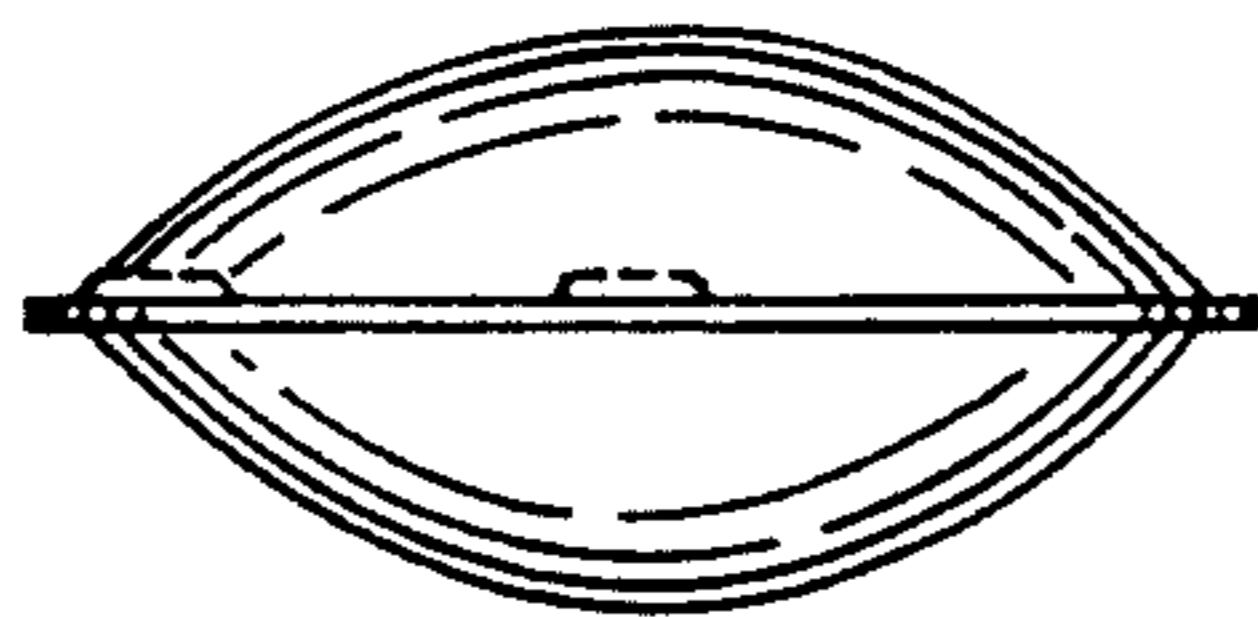

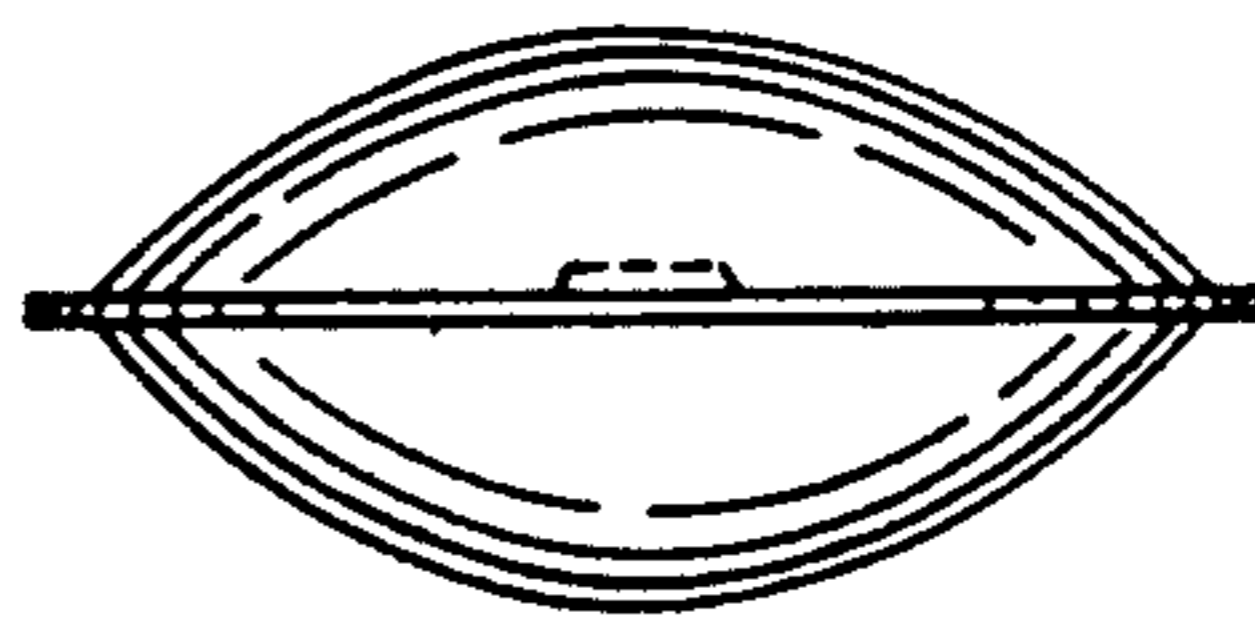

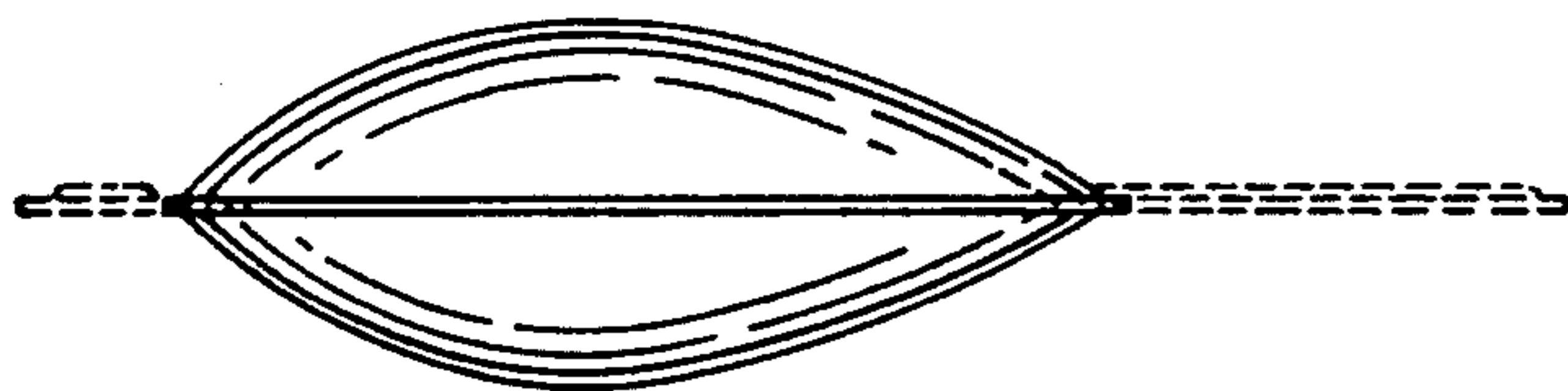

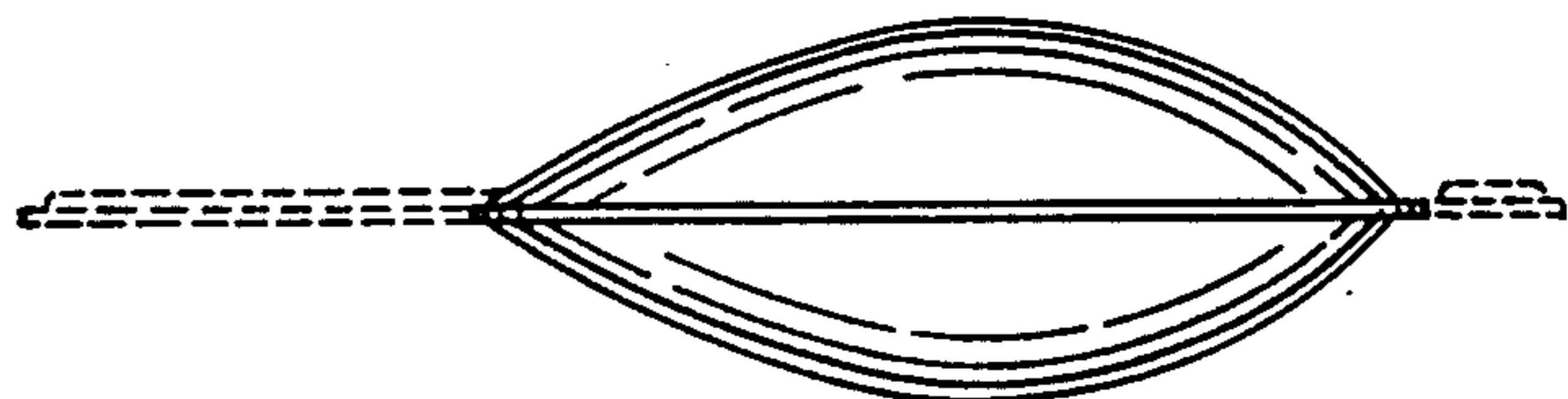
