FIG. 1 is a perspective view of physical exercise showing our new design;

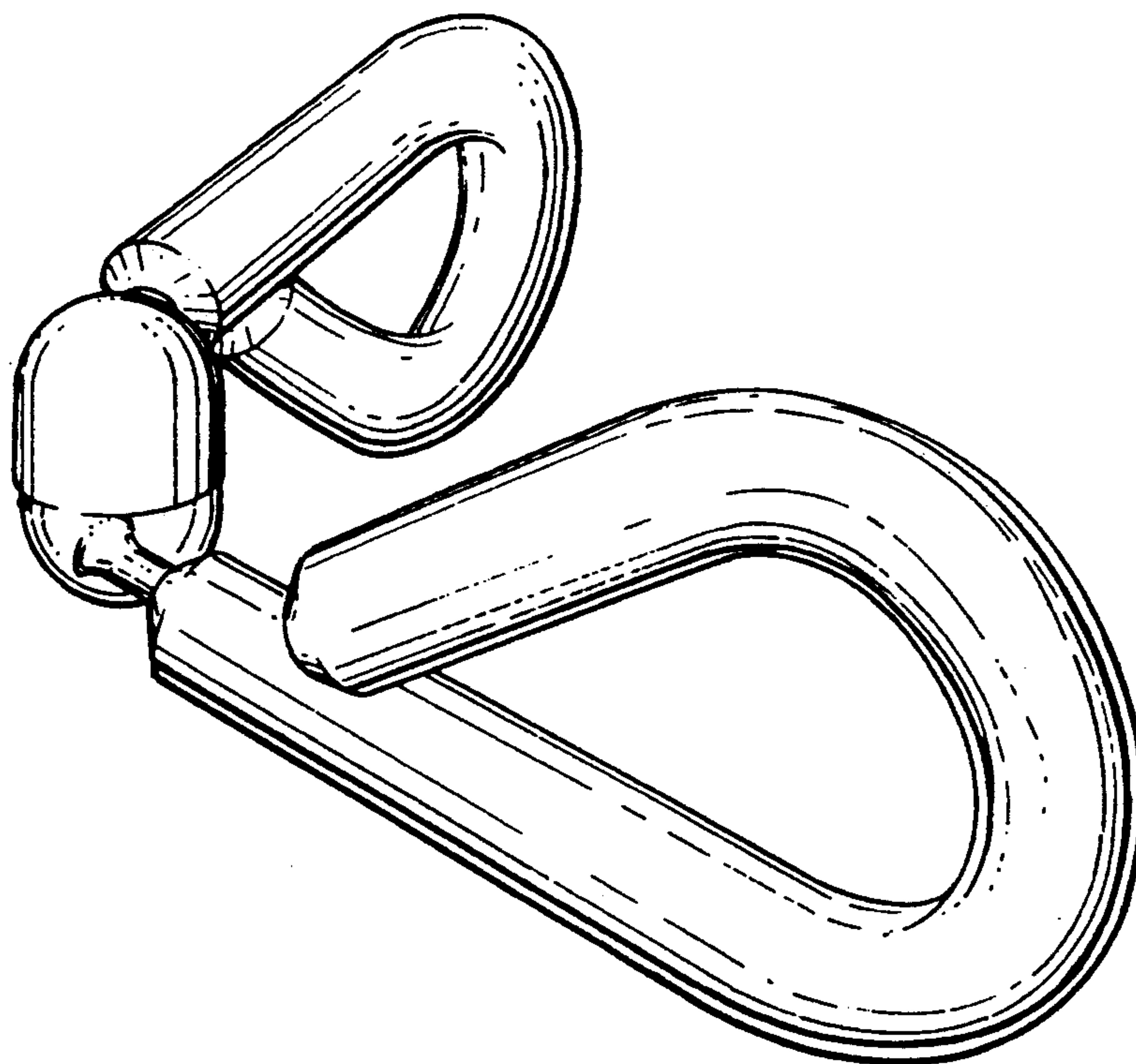
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



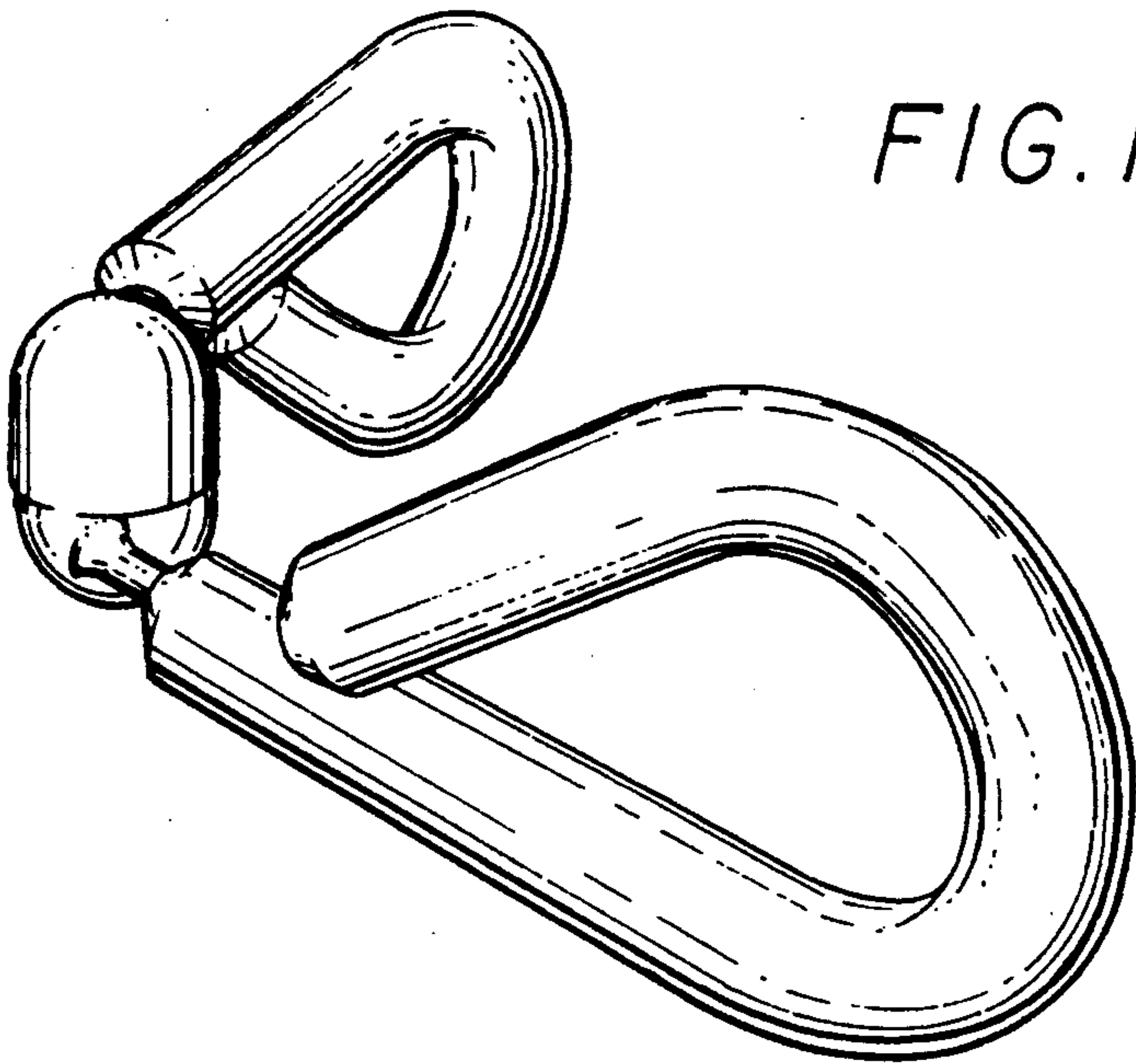

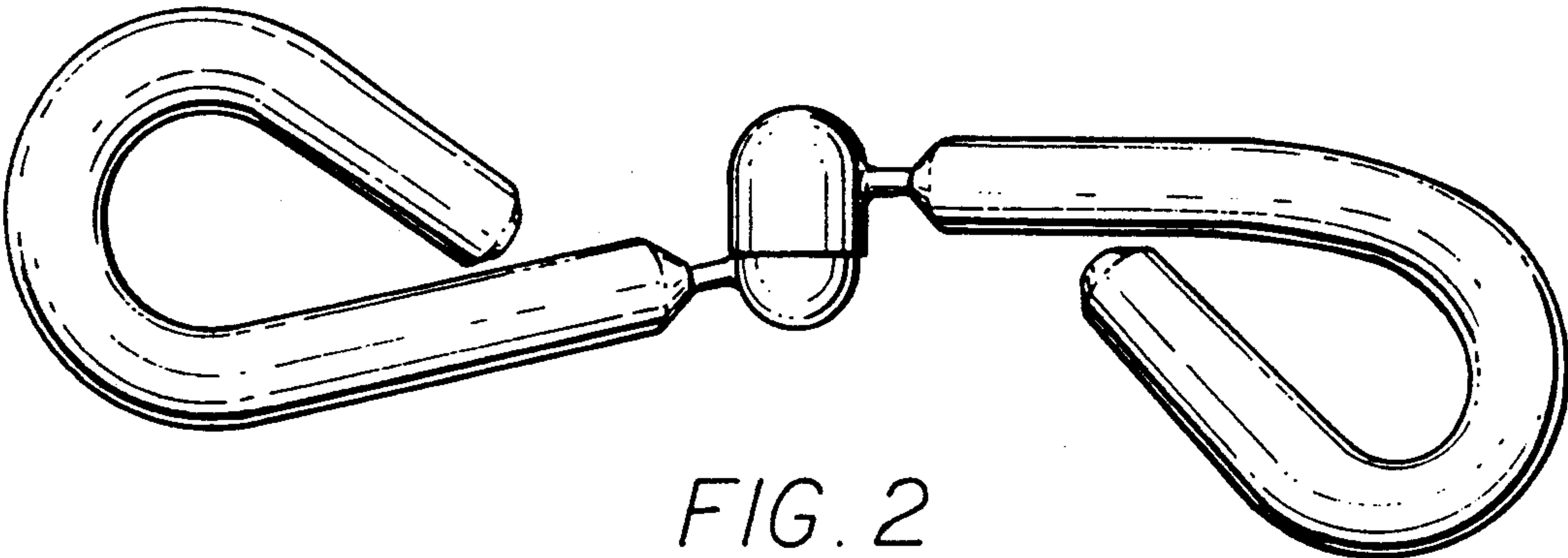

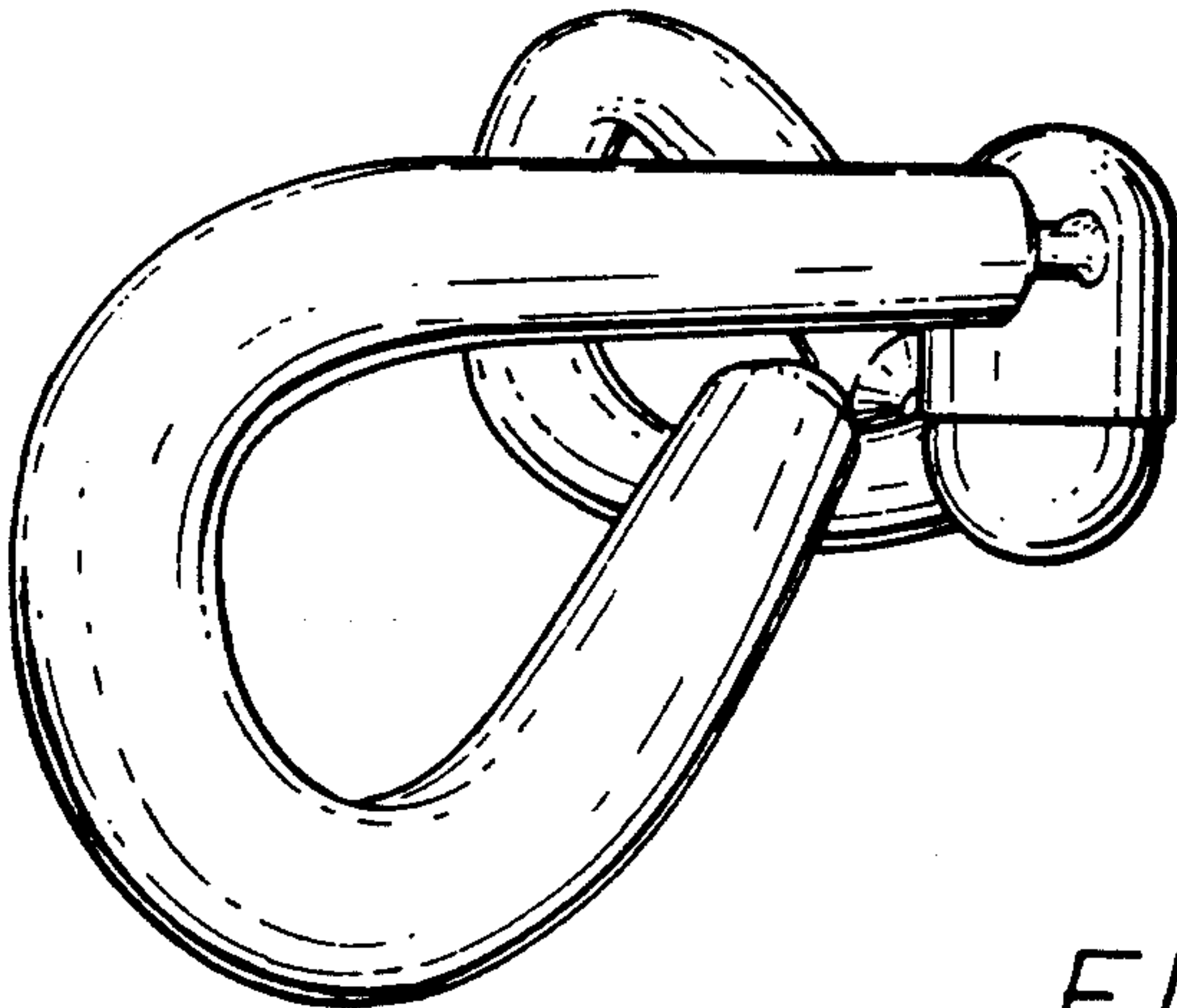

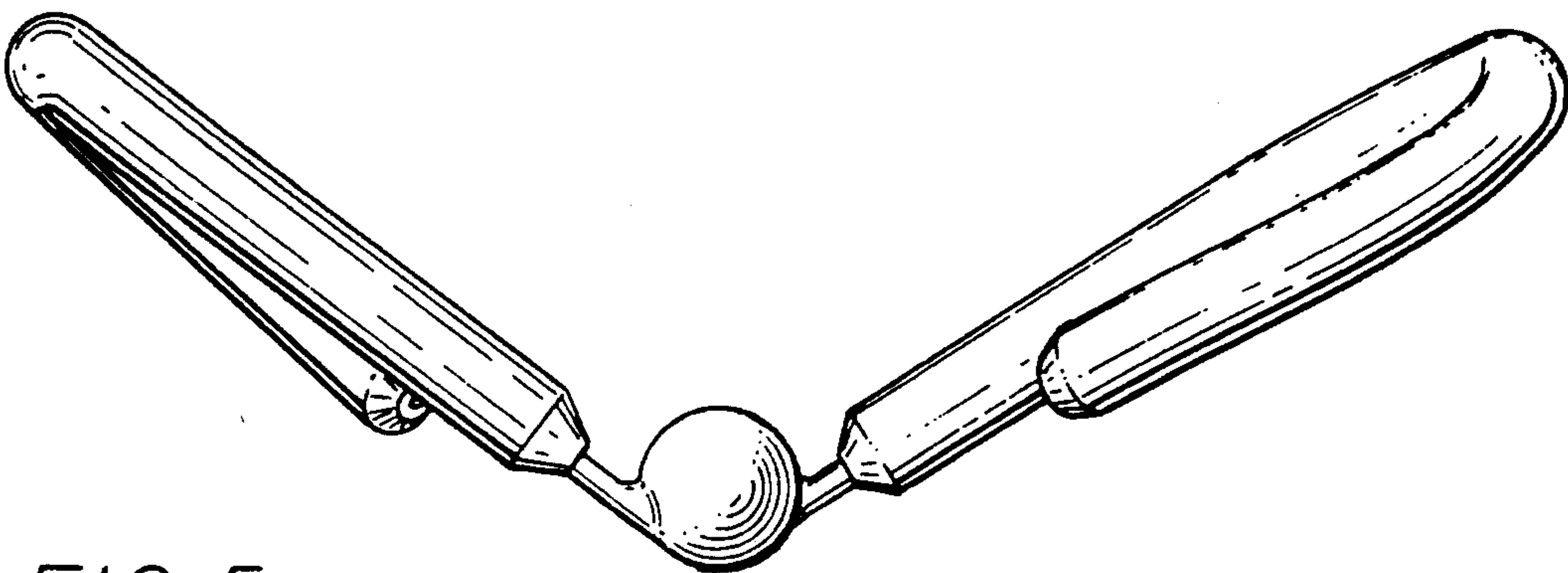
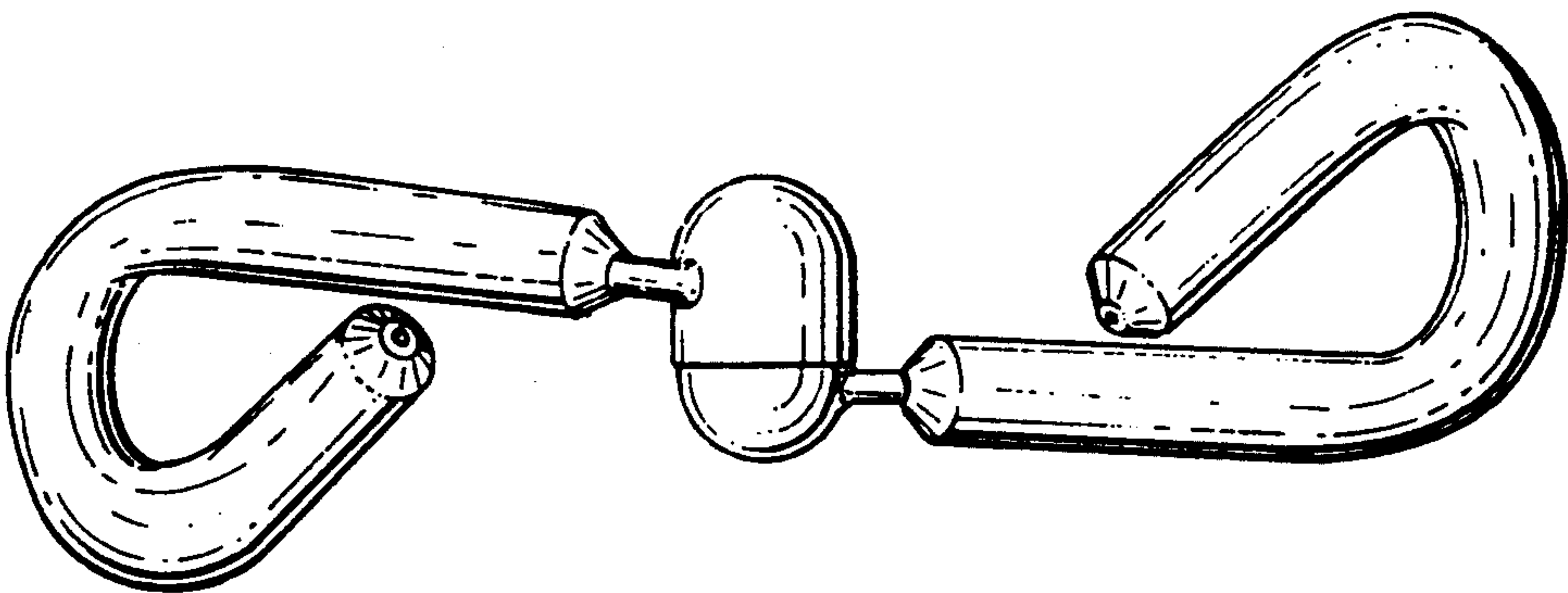

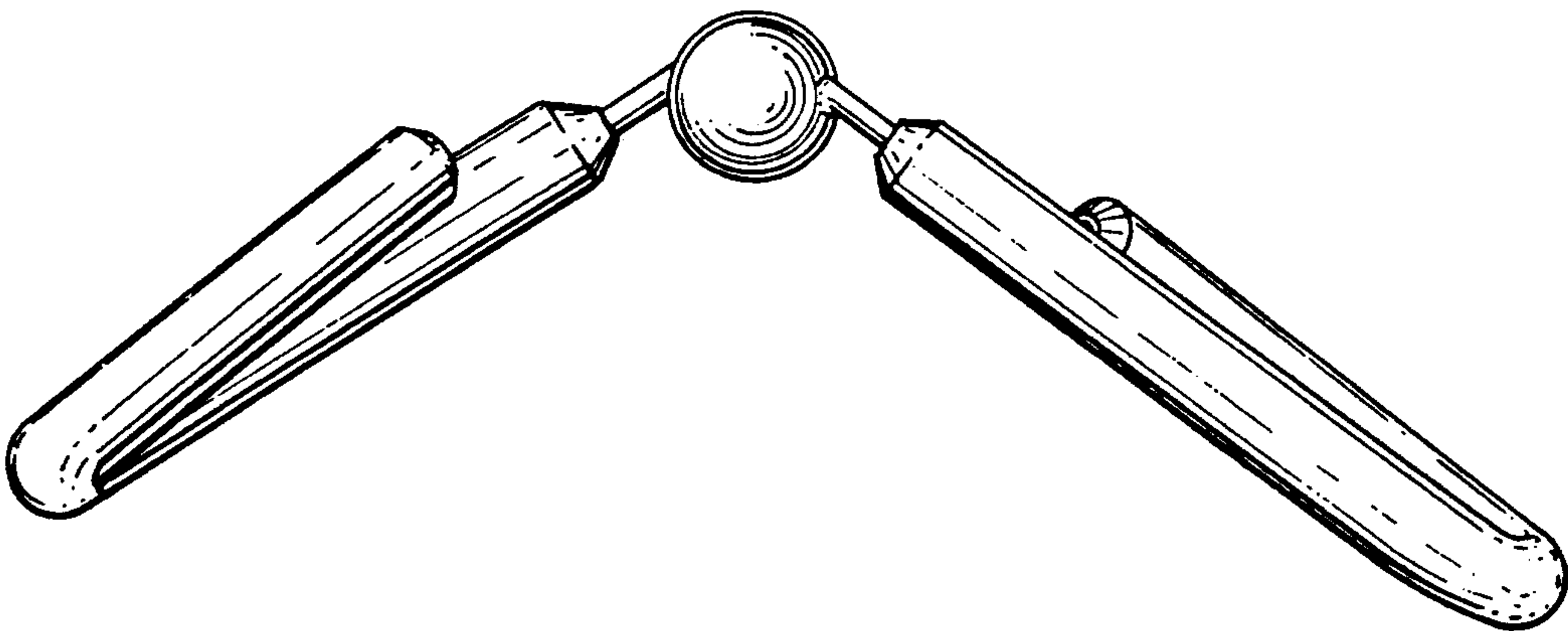
